[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a leg for a game machine, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a leg for a game machine showing my new design; The broken lines showing of a game machine and legs is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of the claim;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The rear surface of the leg is unornamented.

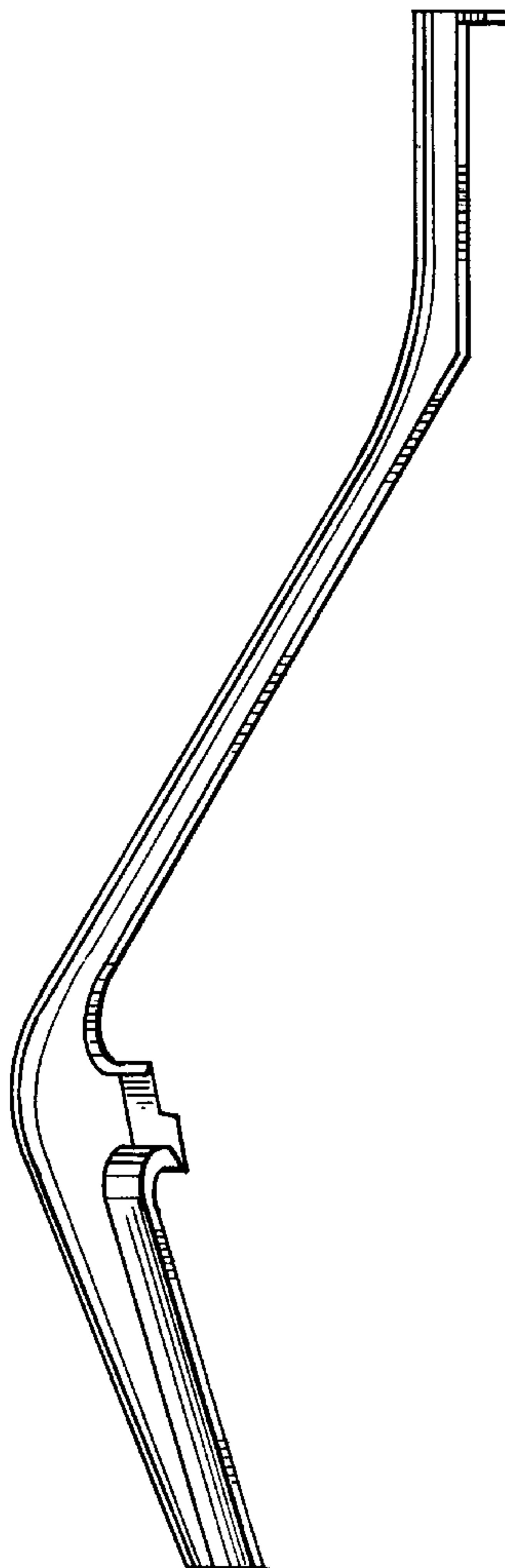
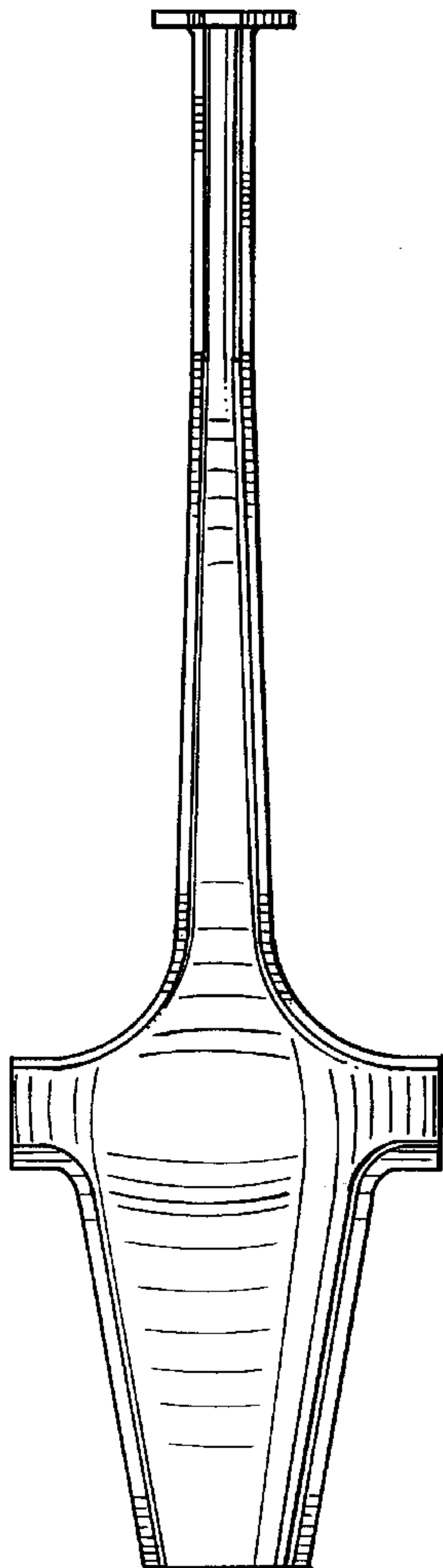

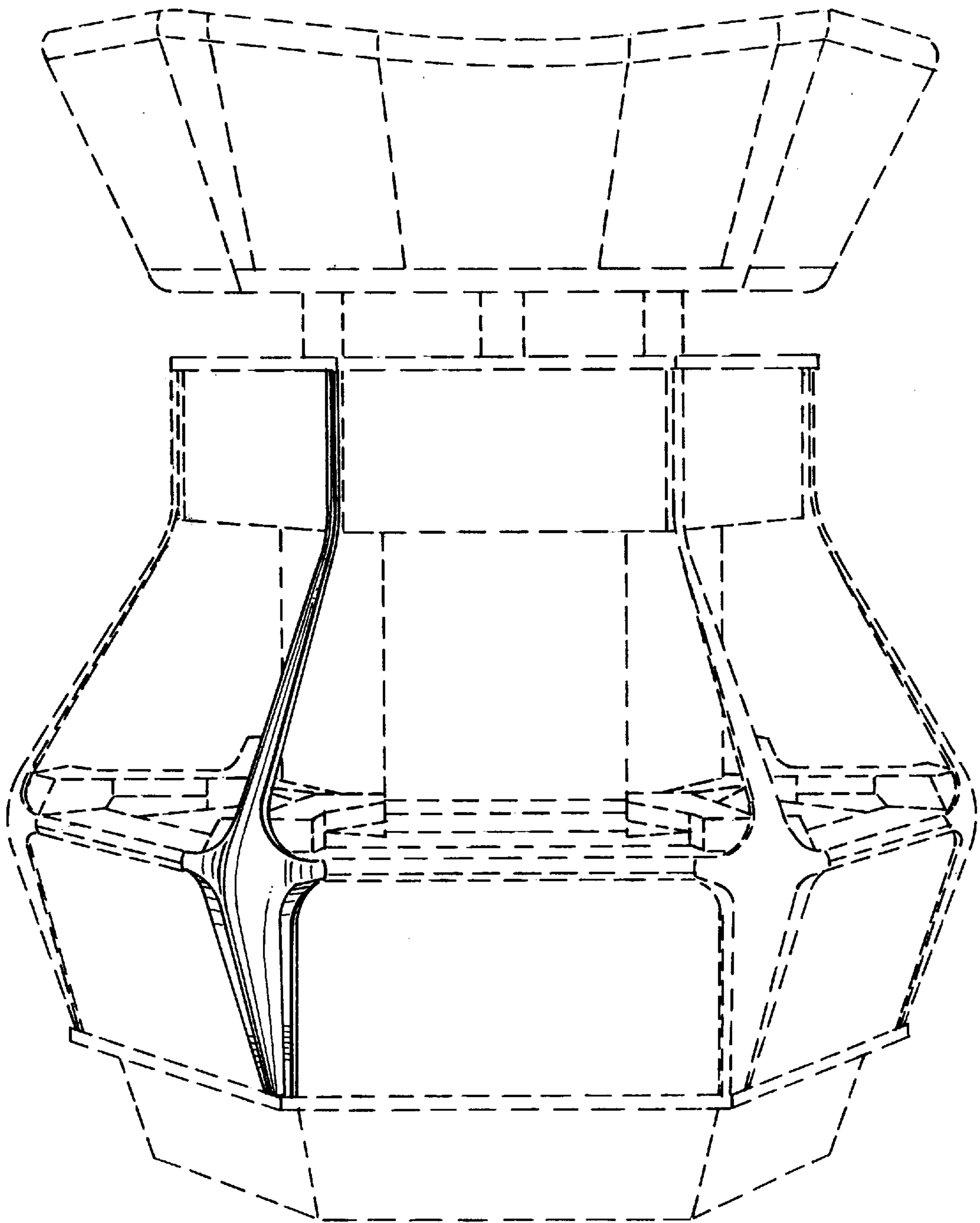

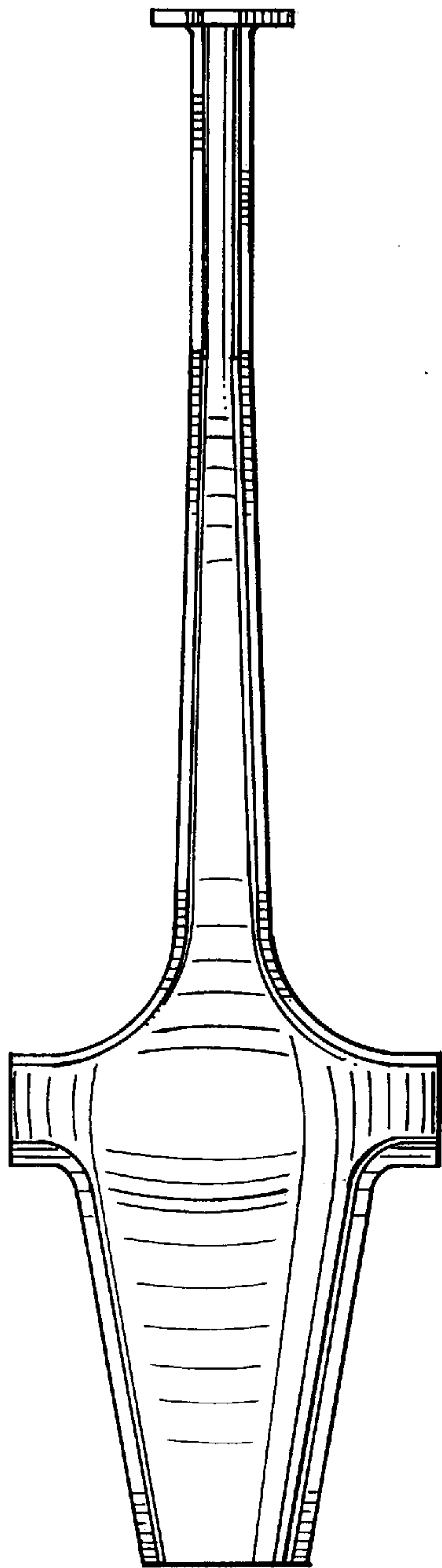
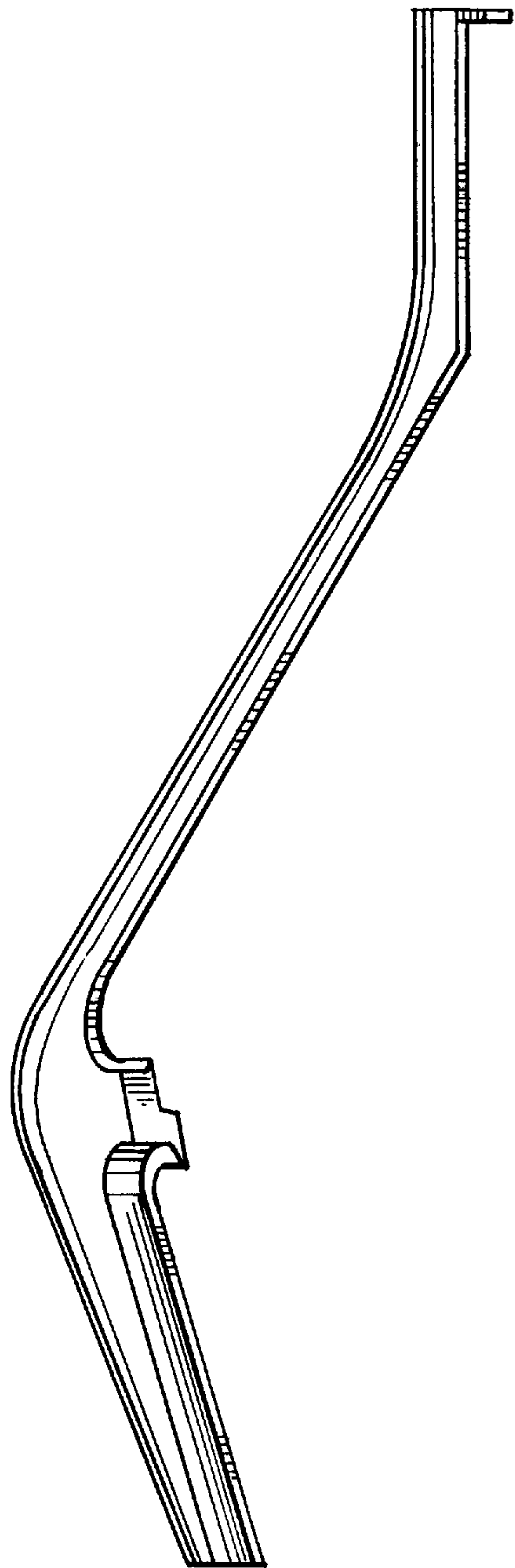

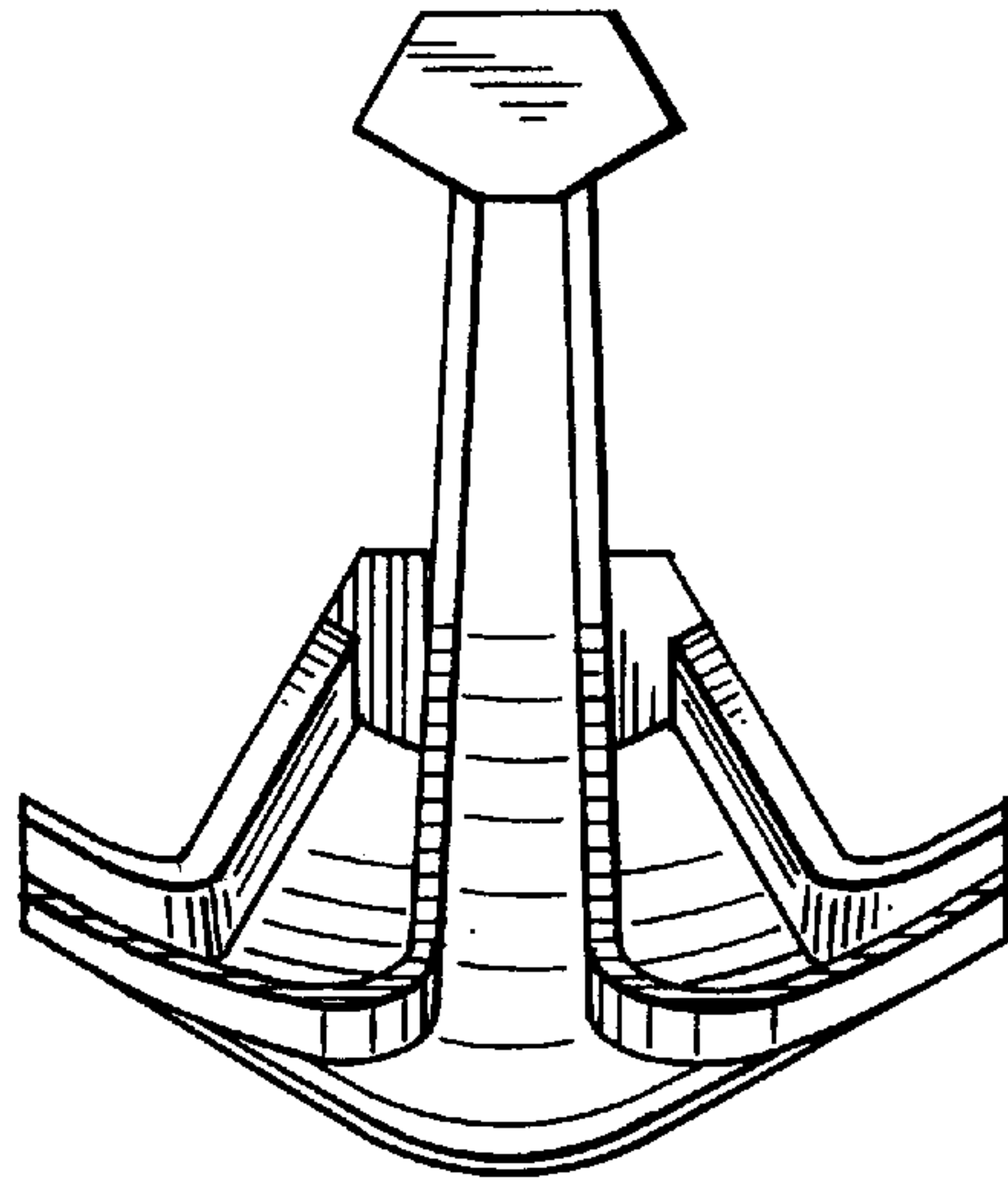

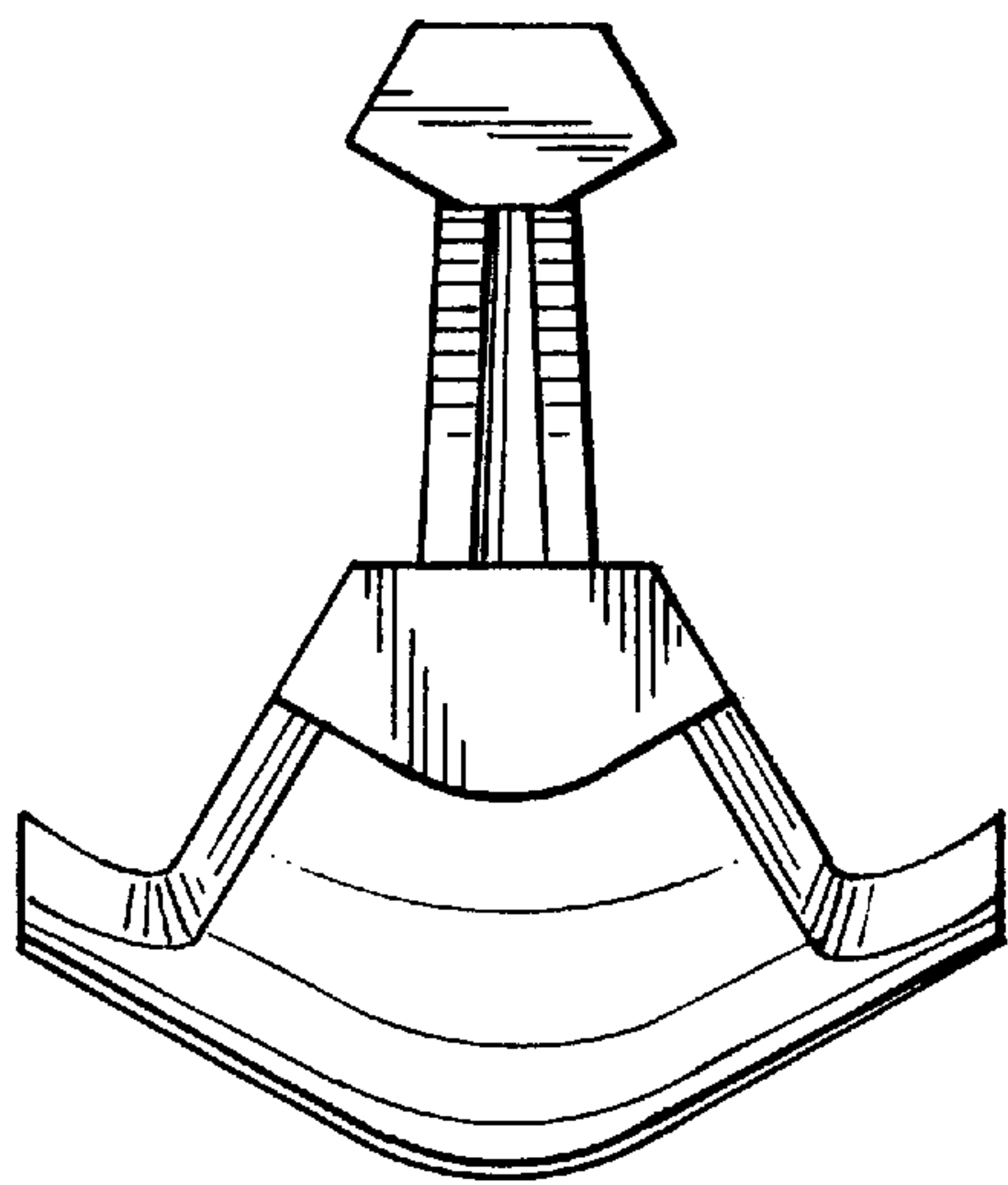
