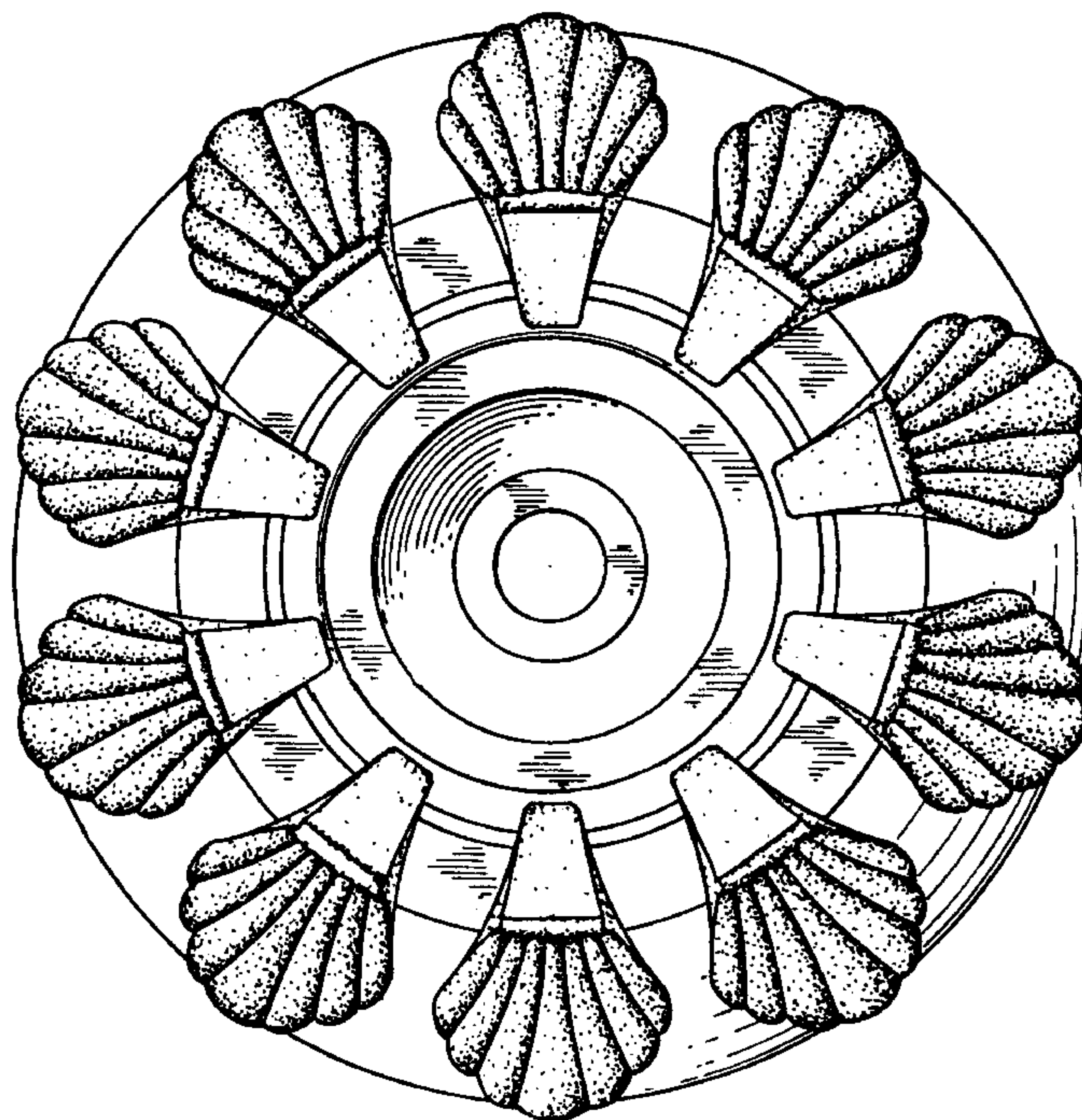
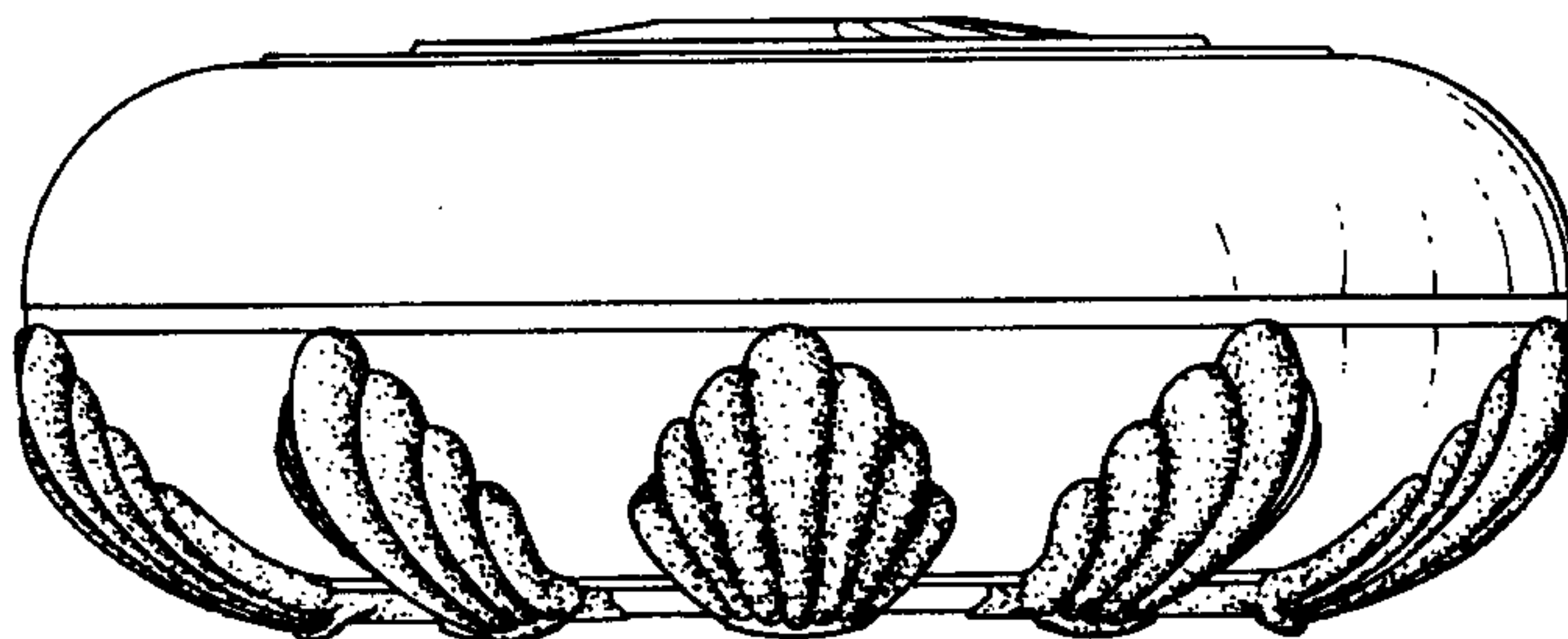
FIG. 1 is a sideview of a ceiling fan housing, with the view being identical from the left and right sides, and from the front and back;

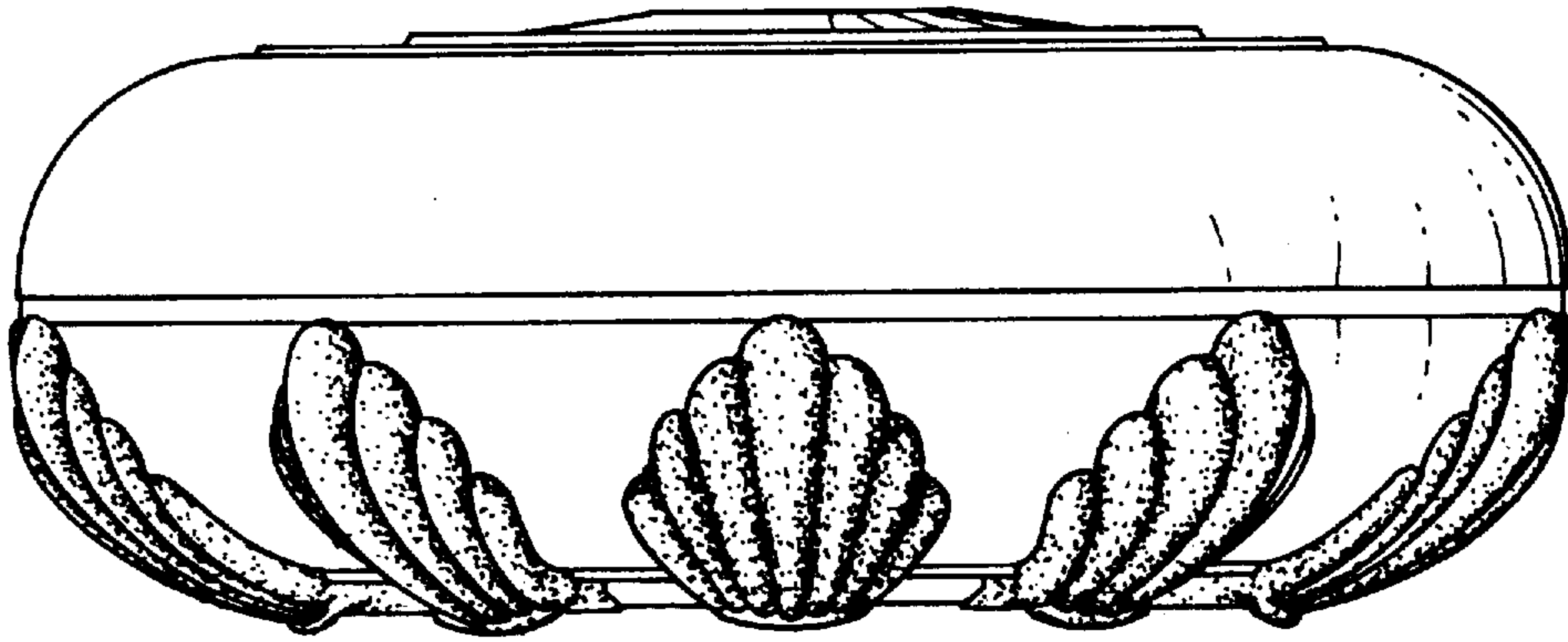

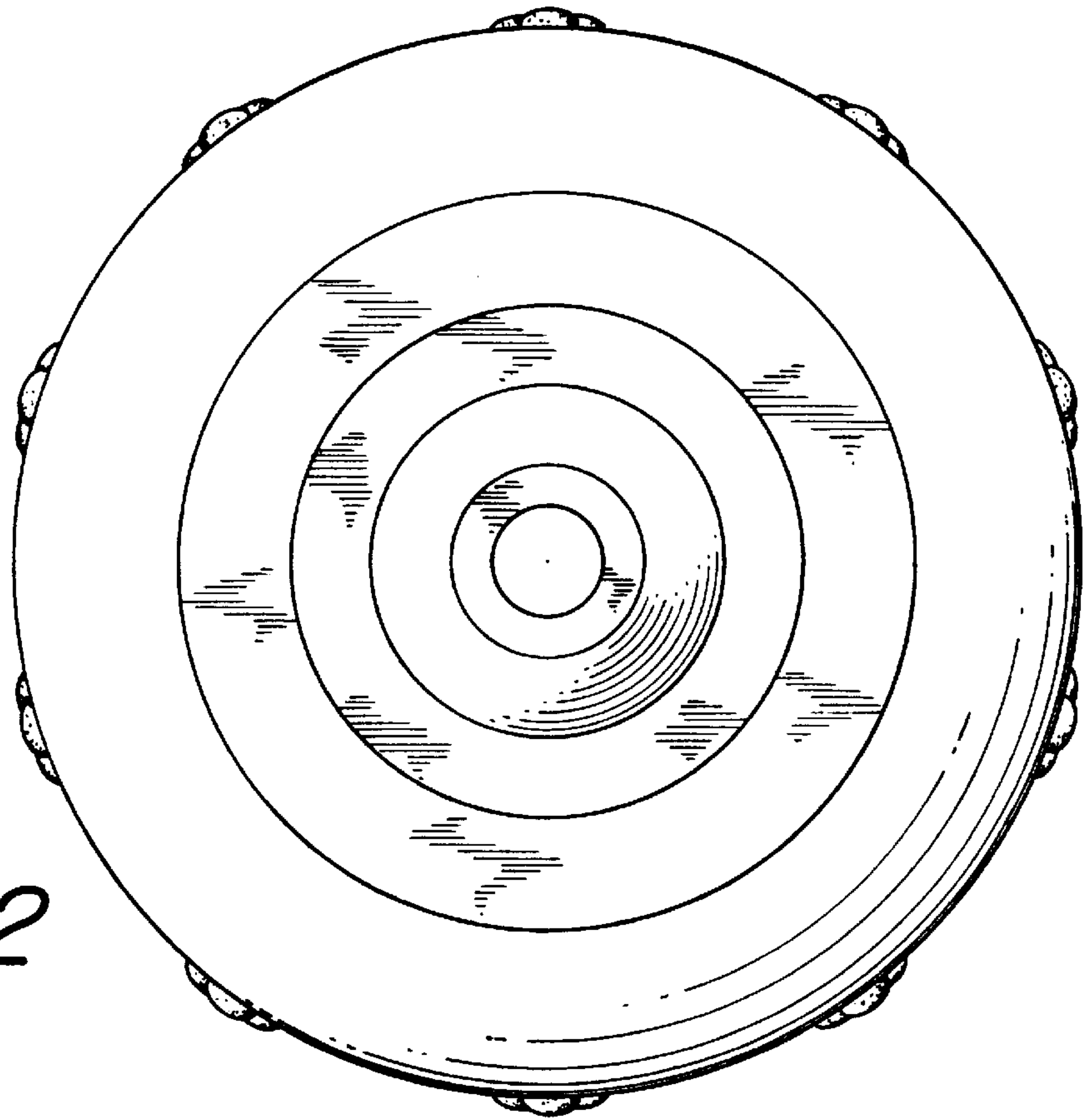

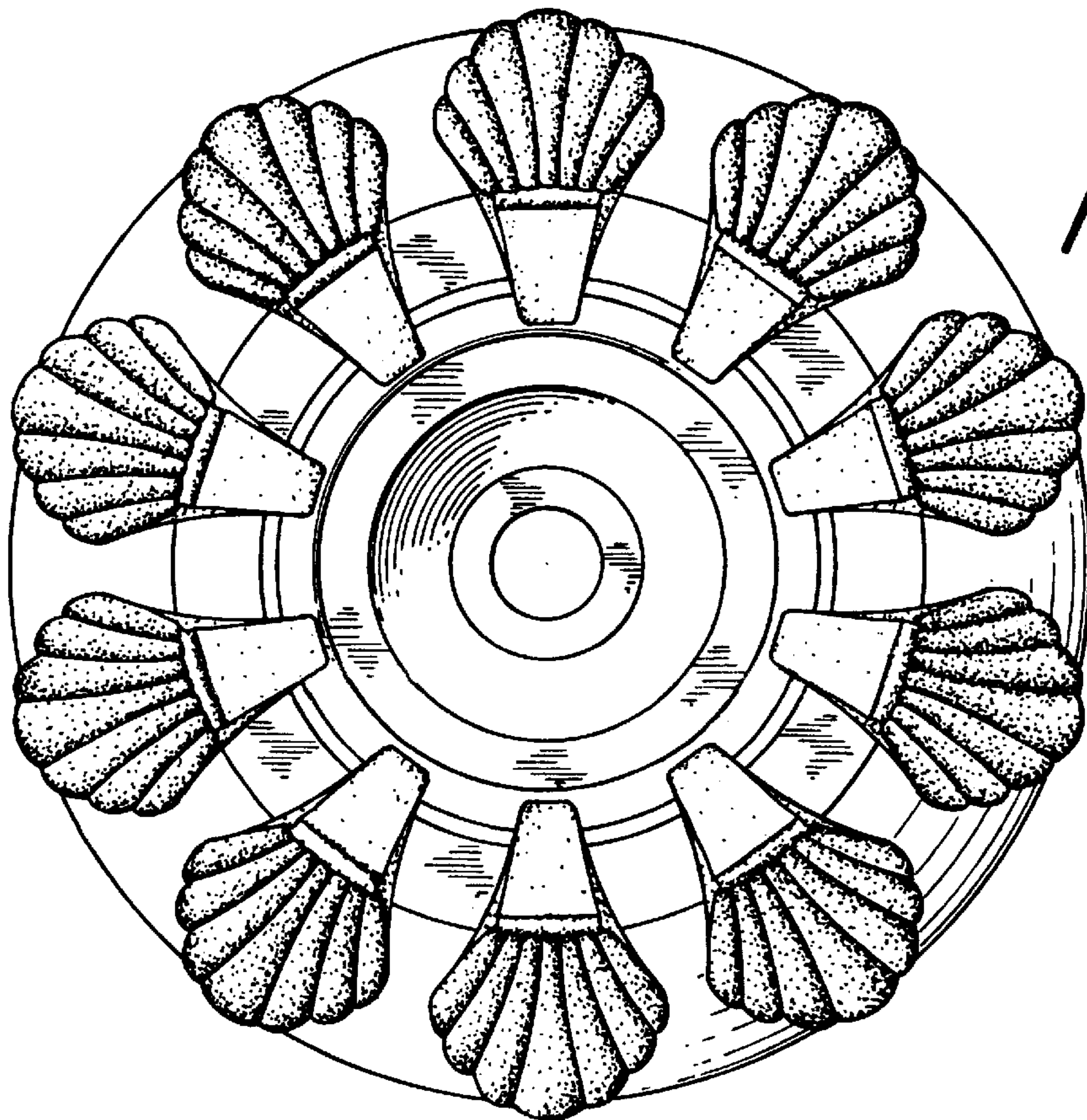
