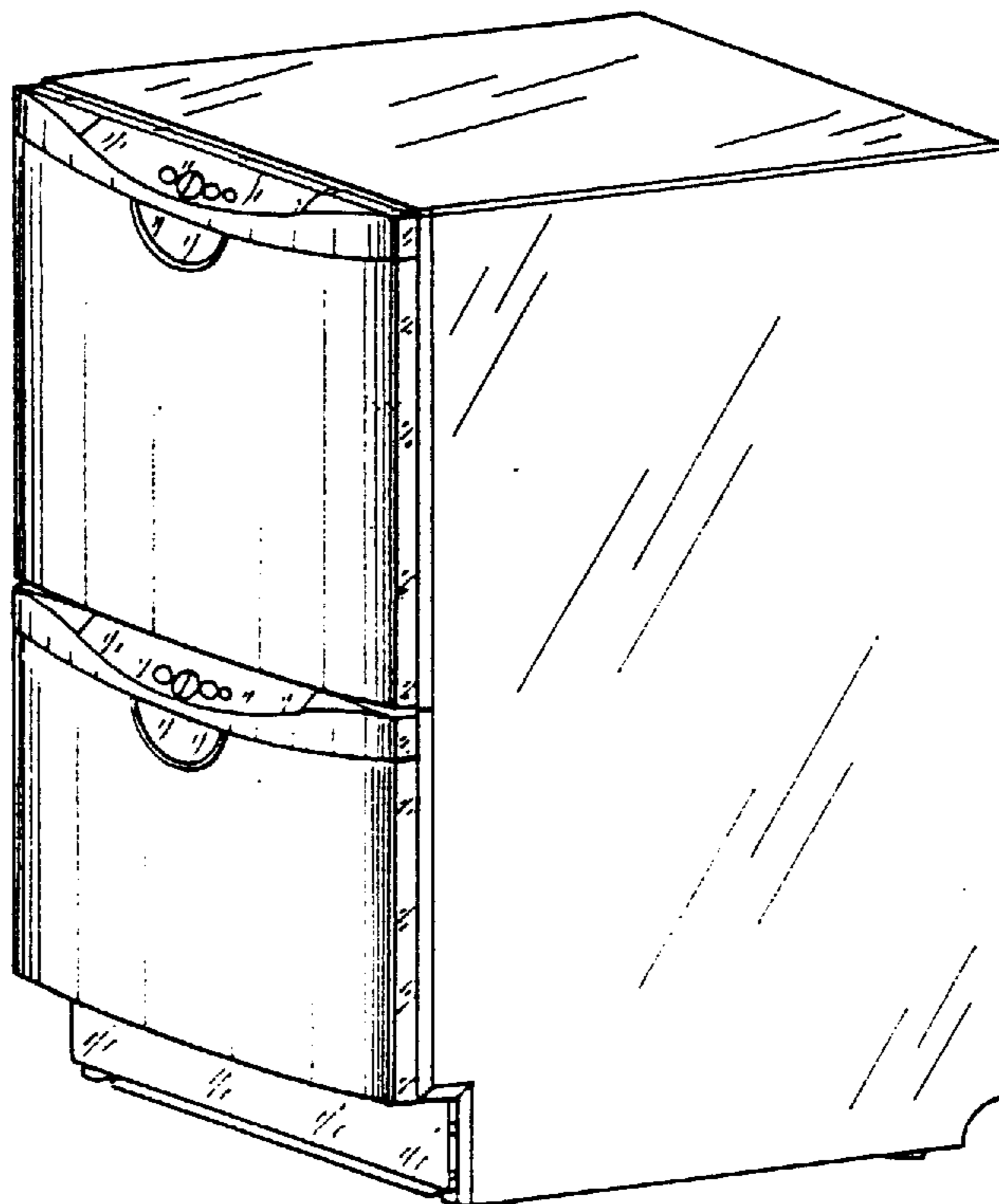
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a dishwasher as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a dishwasher;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof, the undisclosed opposite side being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof.

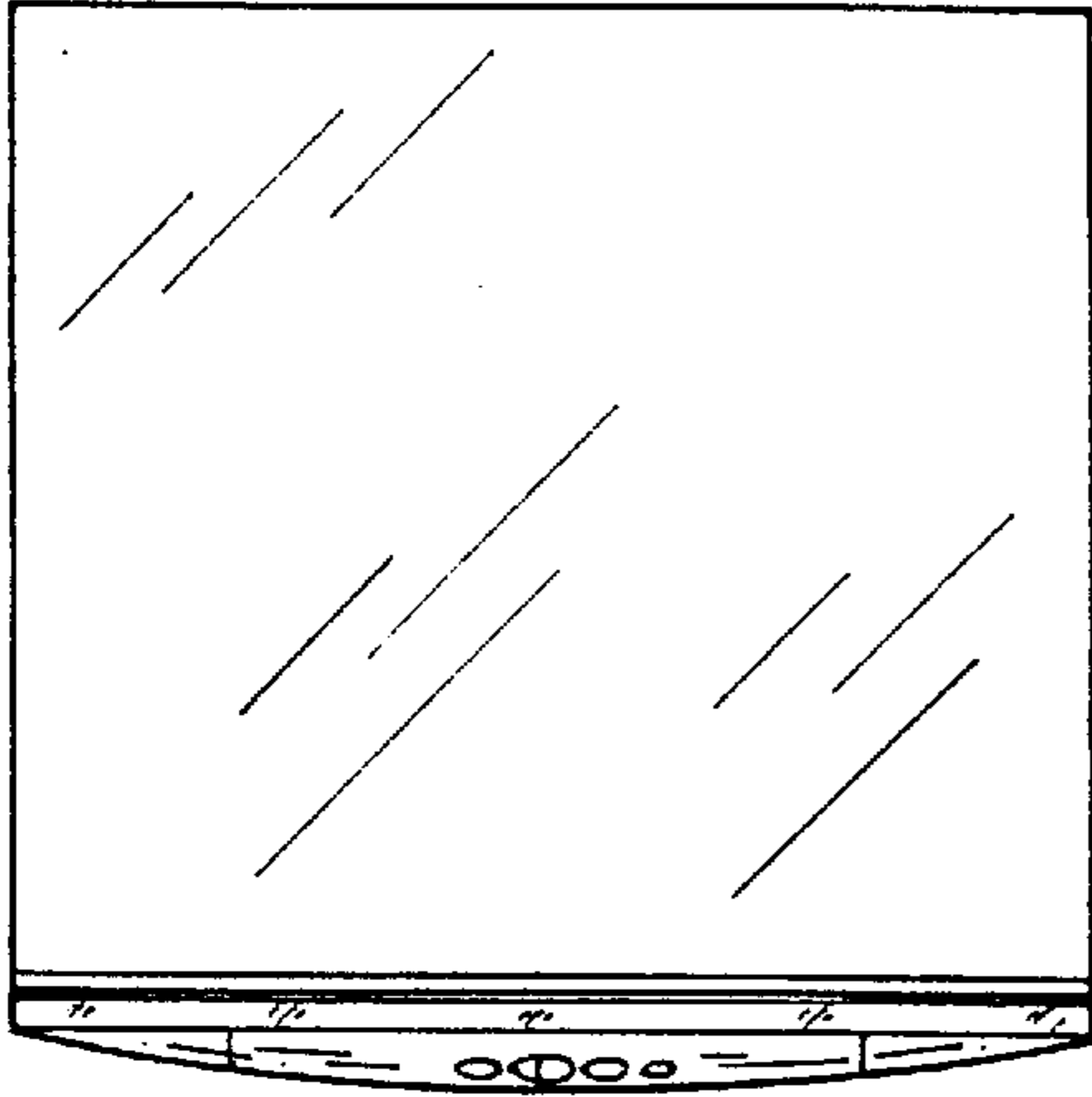

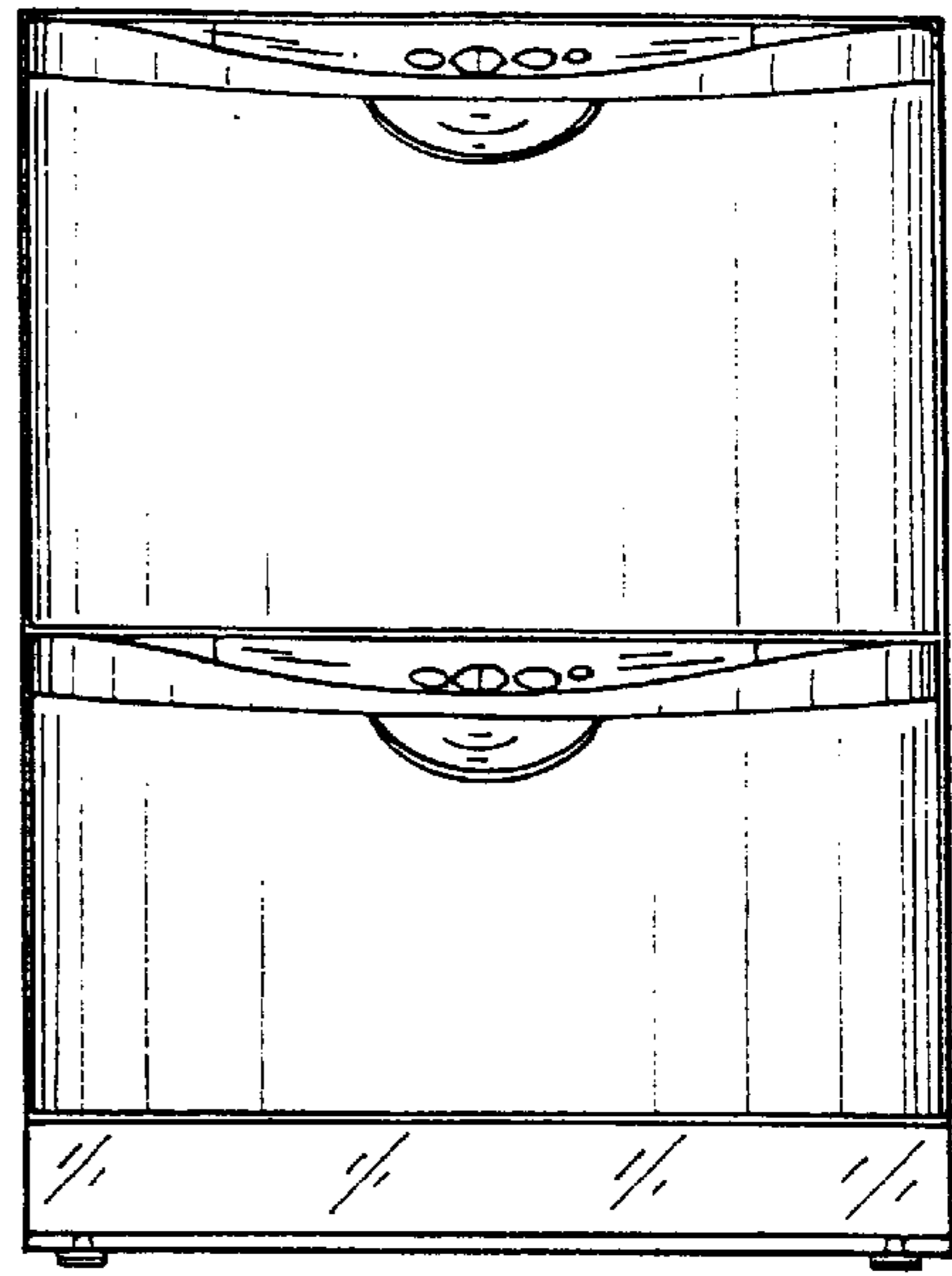

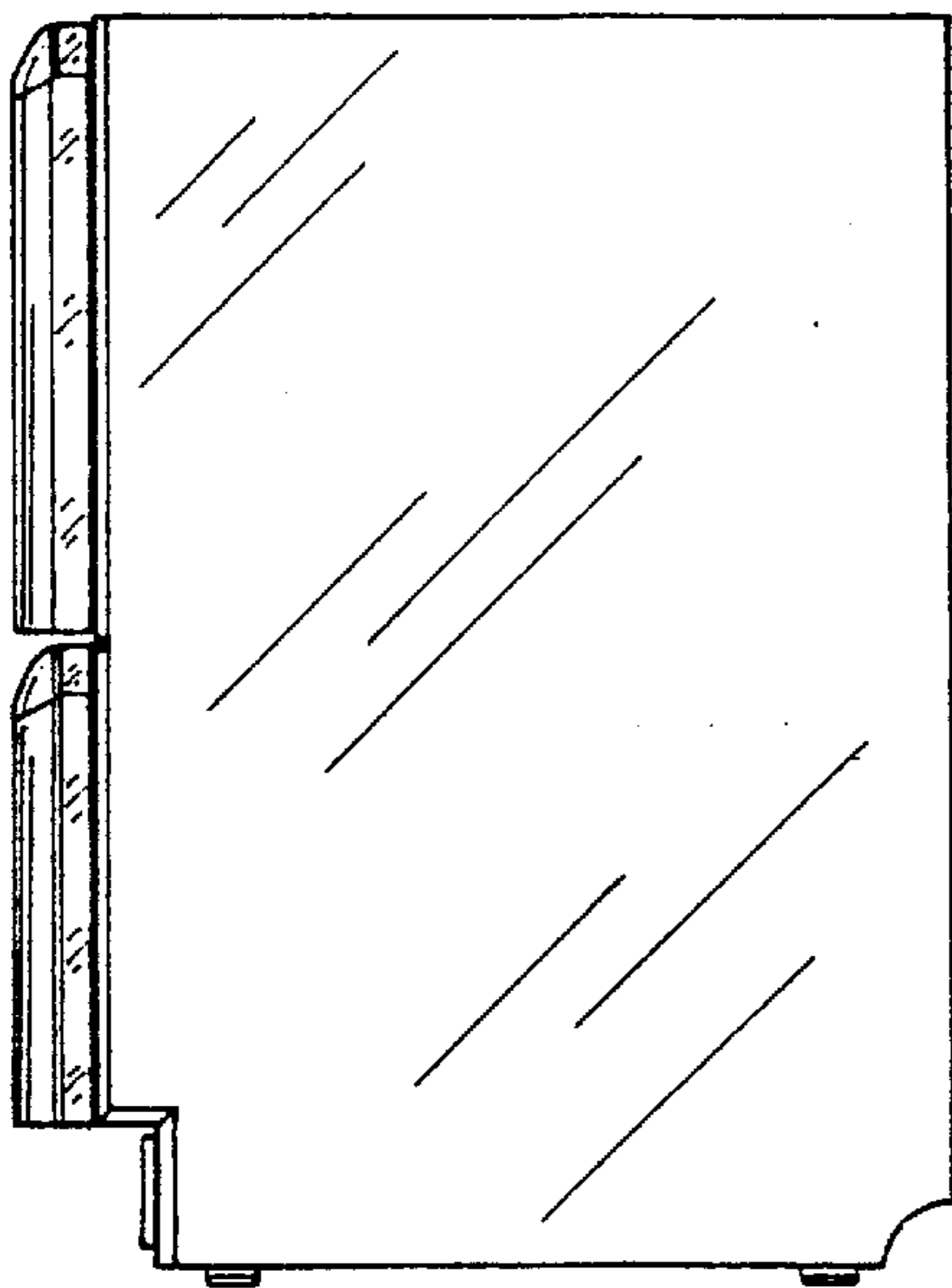

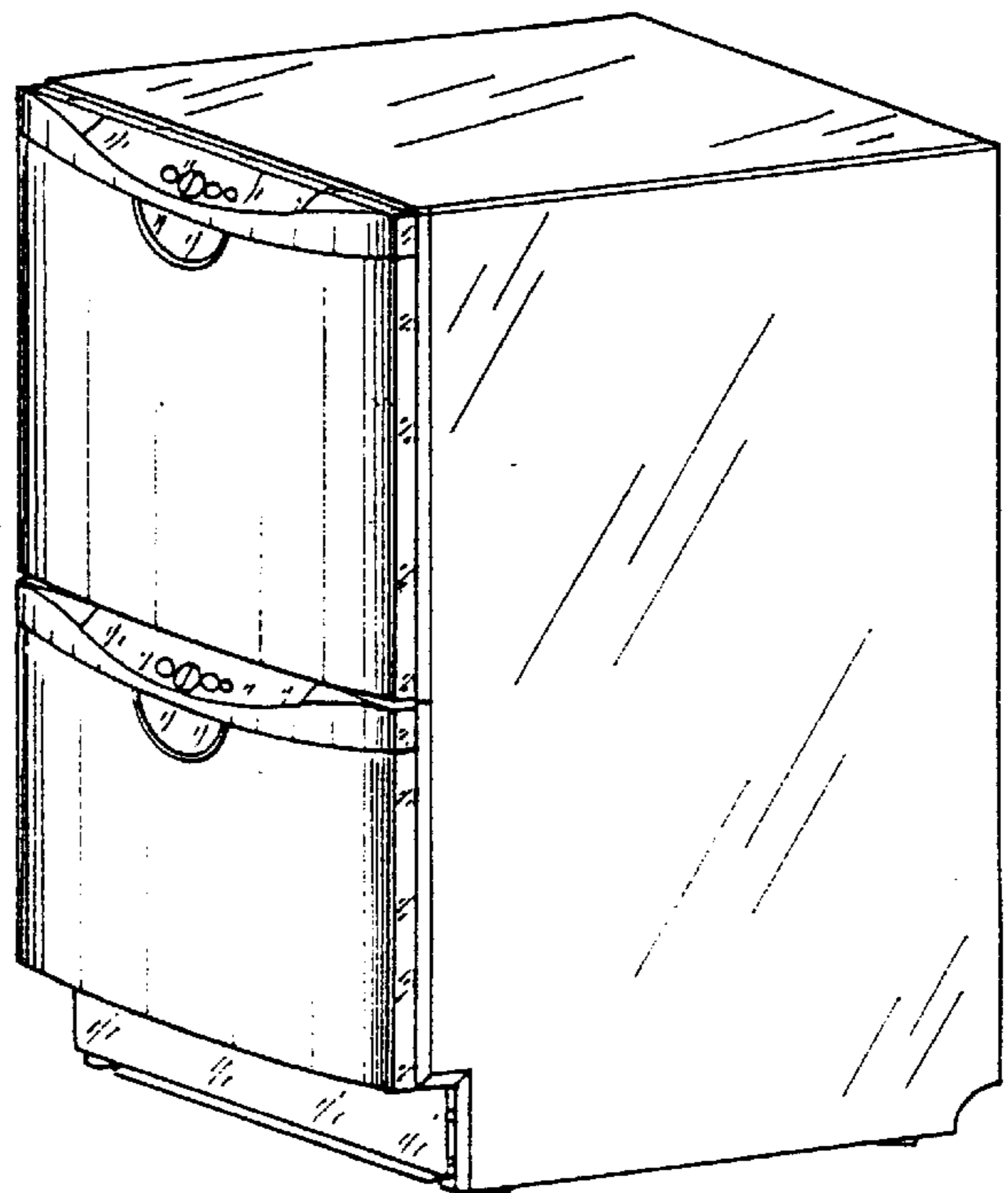
