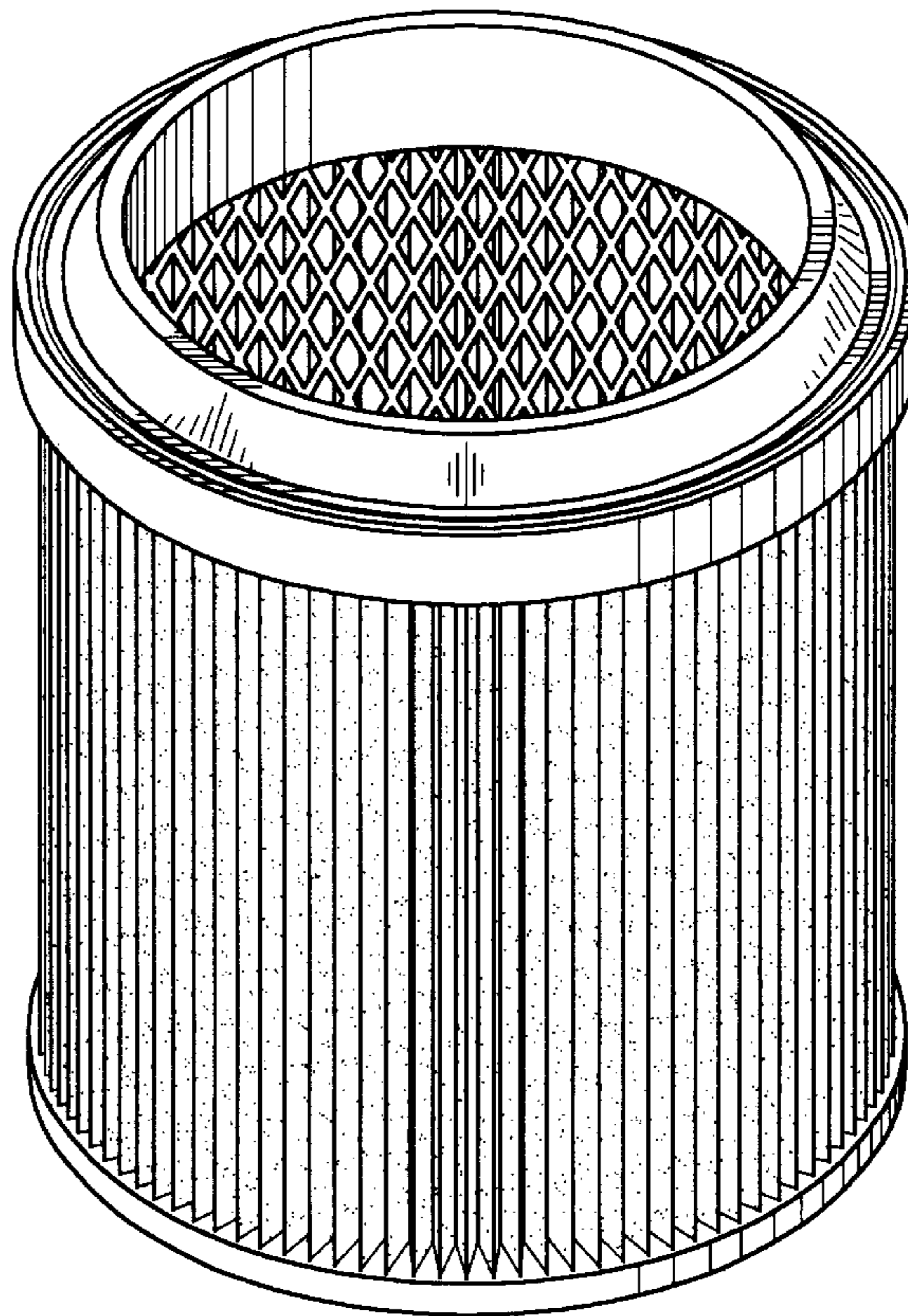
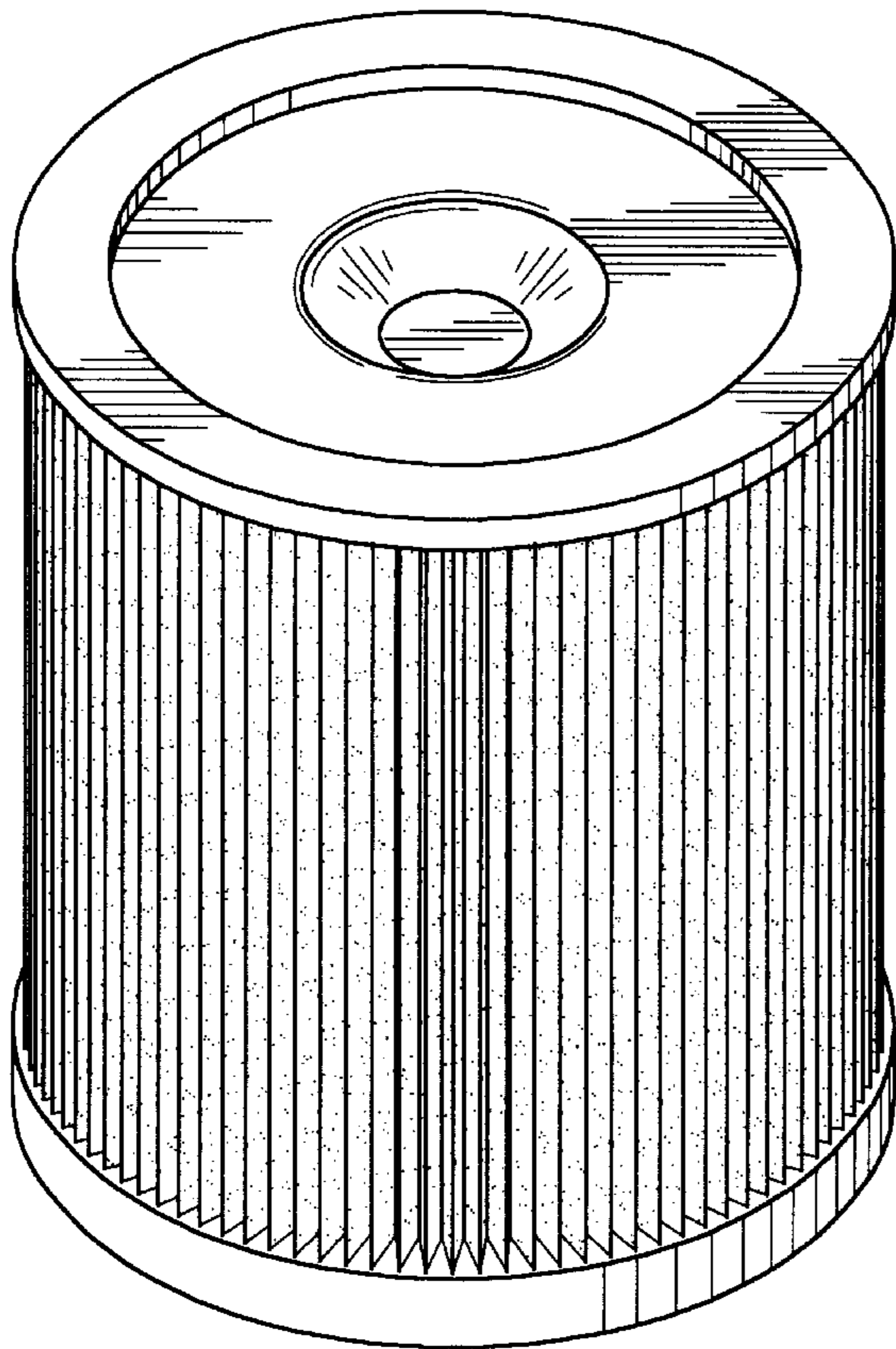
[57] CLAIM

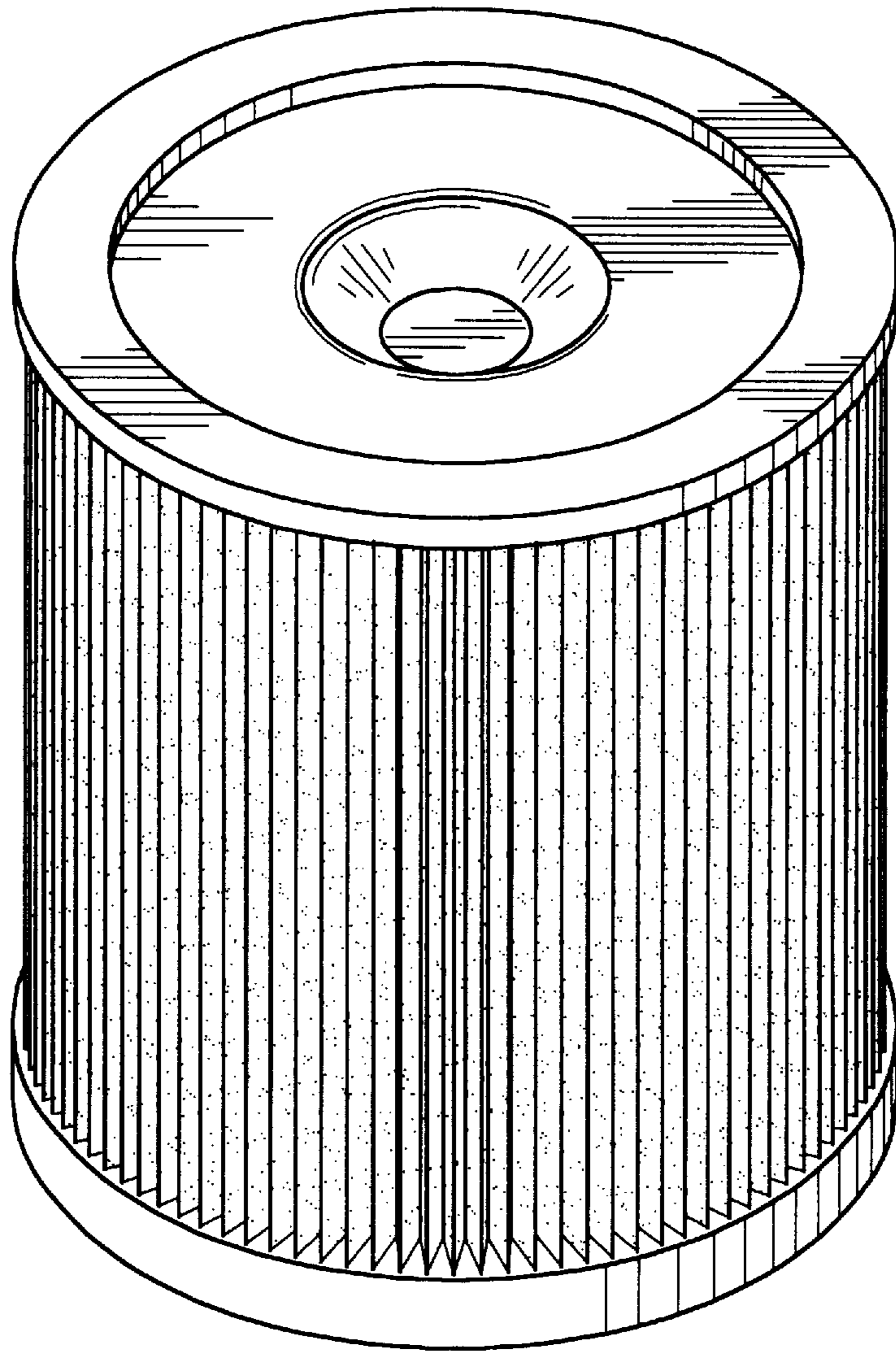

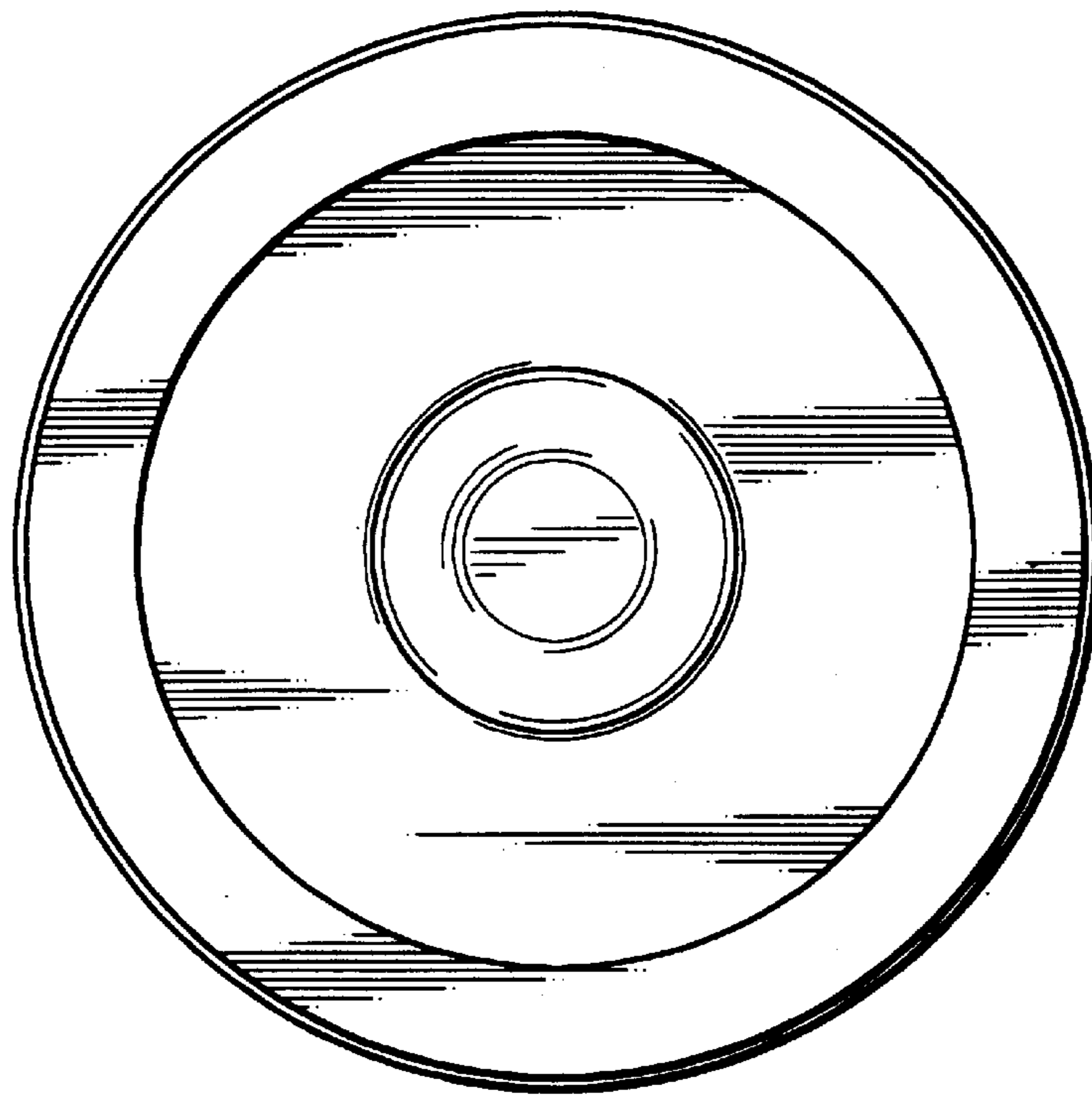

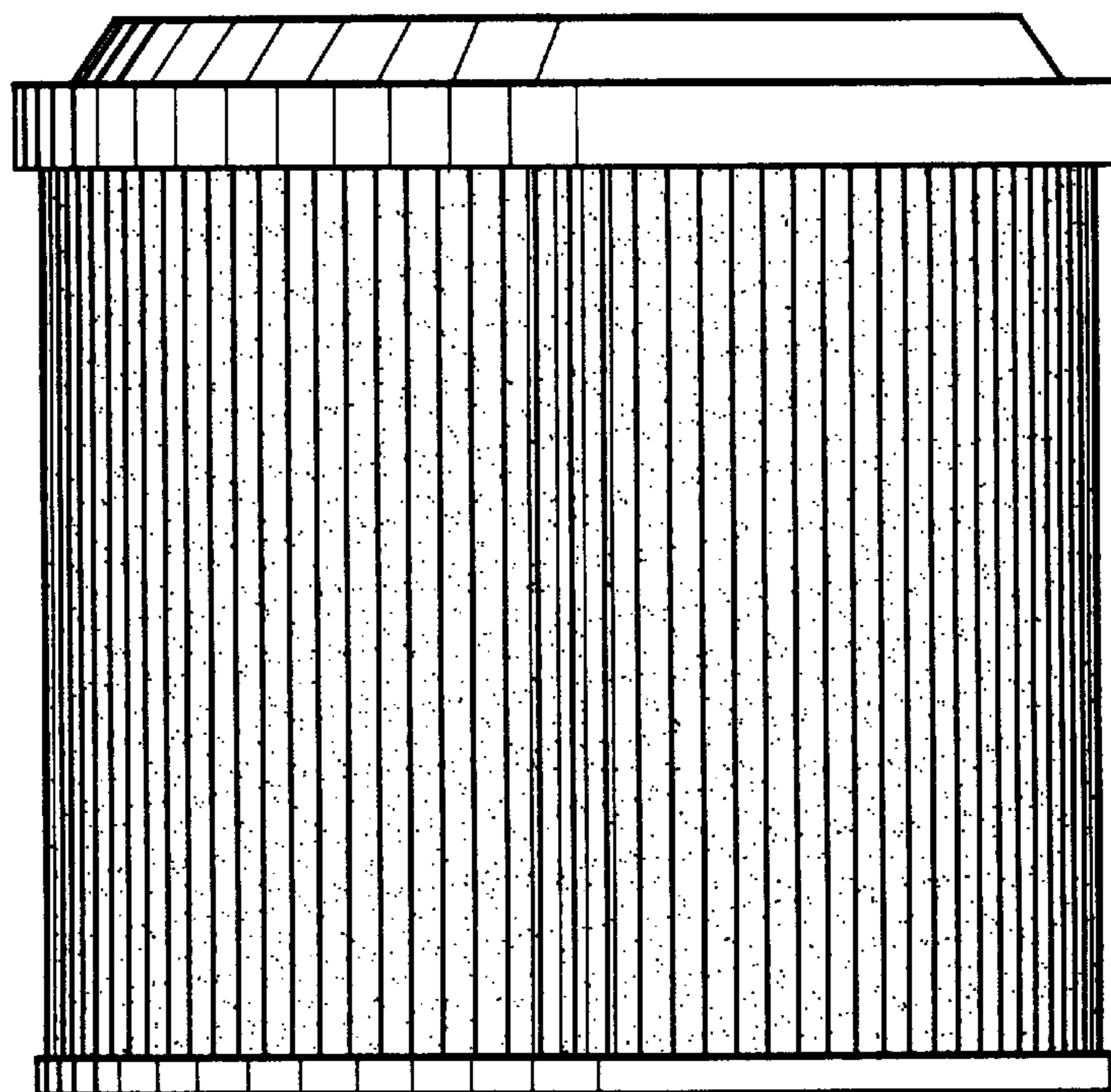

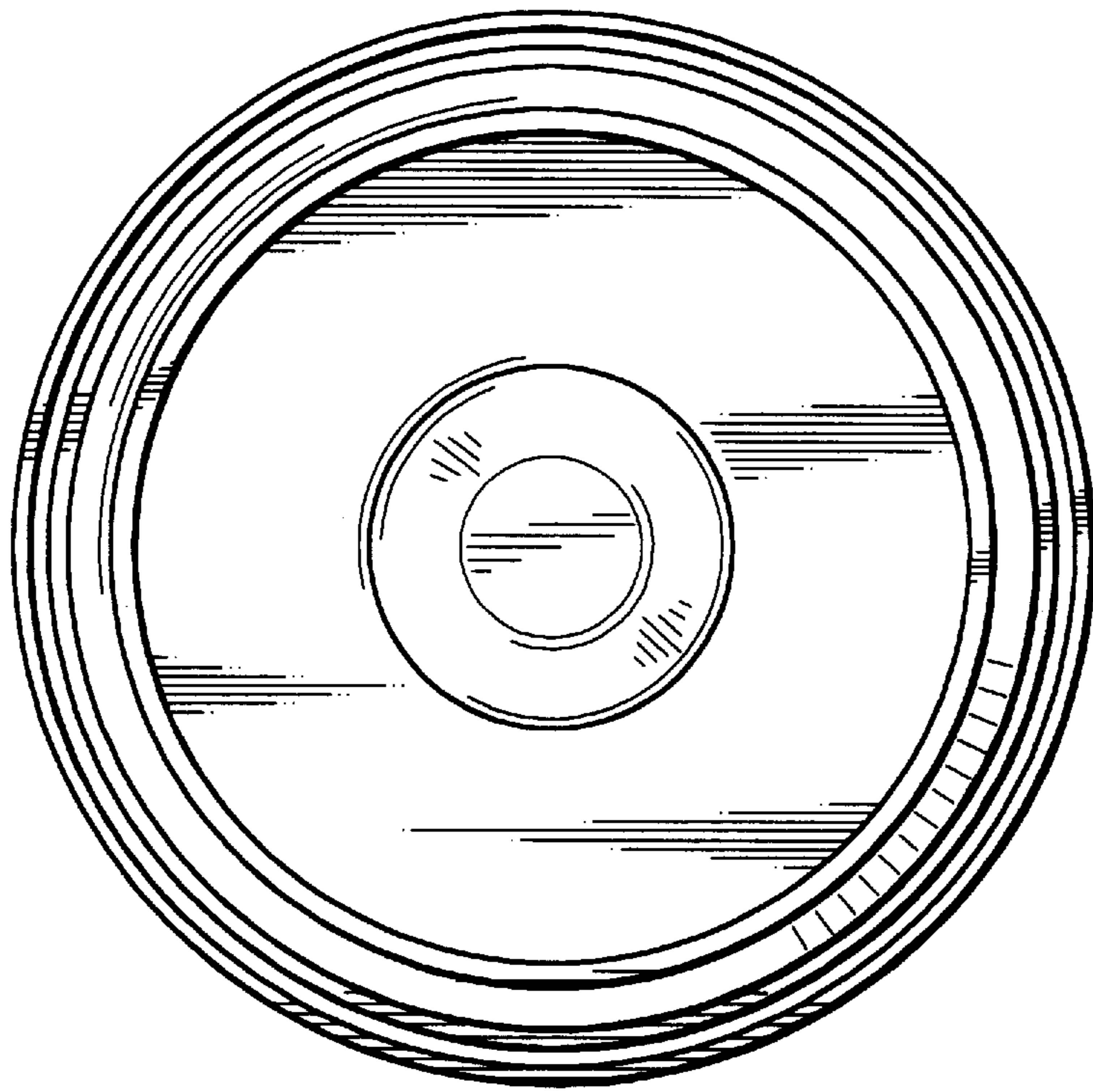

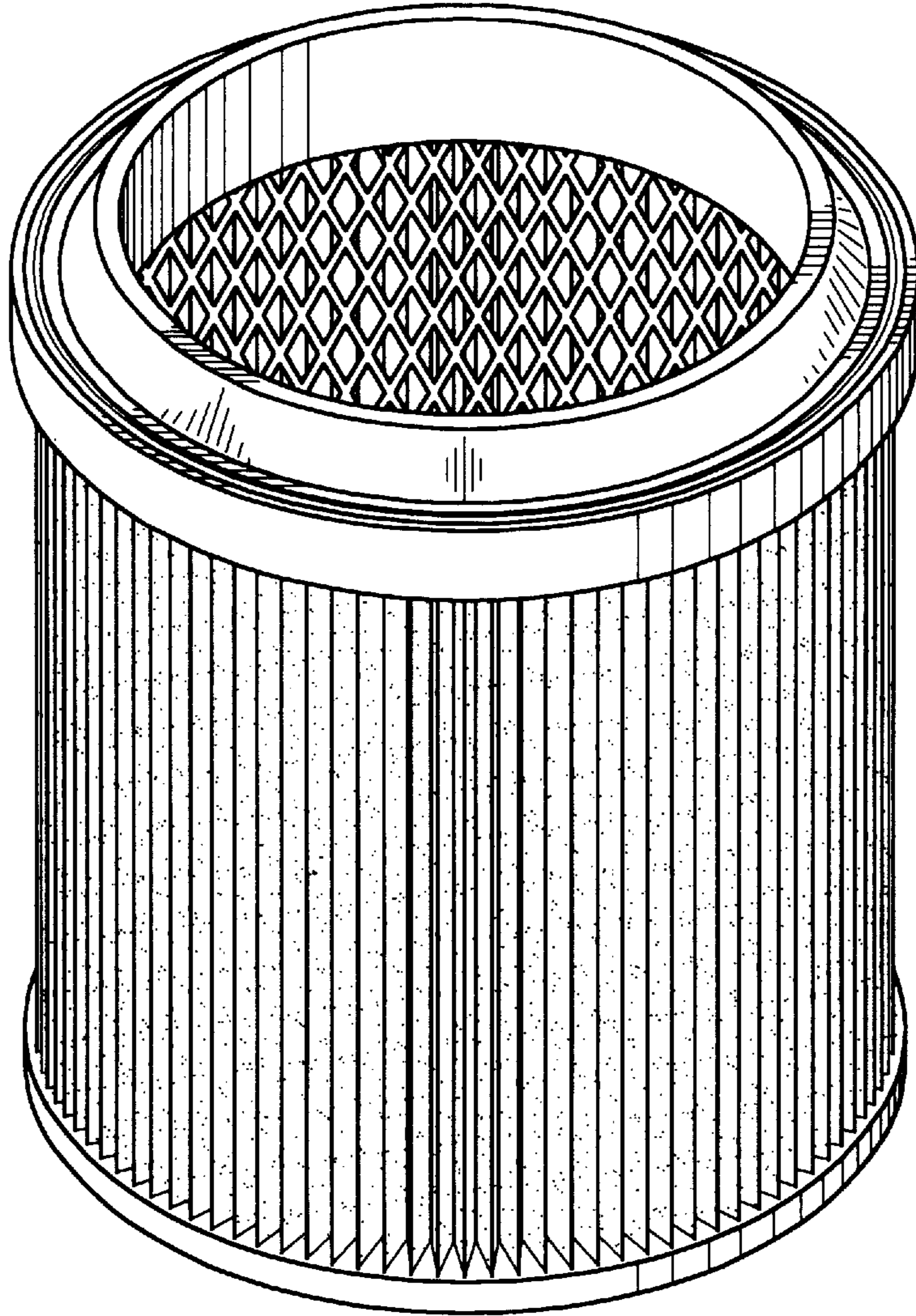
