FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a back elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof.


The broken lines depicting leg members are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.









