**CLAIM** 

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of our new, original and ornamental design for a casket shell;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical;

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof in reduced scale; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof, also in reduced scale; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of our design, the rear elevational view being identical, both end elevational views being as shown in FIG. 3, the top plan view being as shown in FIG. 4 and the bottom plan view being as shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a third embodiment of our design, the rear elevational view being identical, both end elevational views being as shown in FIG. 3, the top plan view being as shown in FIG. 4 and the bottom plan view being as shown in FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment of our design, the rear elevational view being identical, both end elevational views being as shown in FIG. 3, the top plan view being as shown in FIG. 4 and the bottom plan view being as shown in FIG. 5;


FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a fifth embodiment of our design, the rear elevational view being identical, both end elevational views being as shown in FIG. 3, the top plan view being as shown in FIG. 4 and the bottom plan view being as shown in FIG. 5; and,




















