FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment, identical to the first embodiment except for the surface of the top insert region.

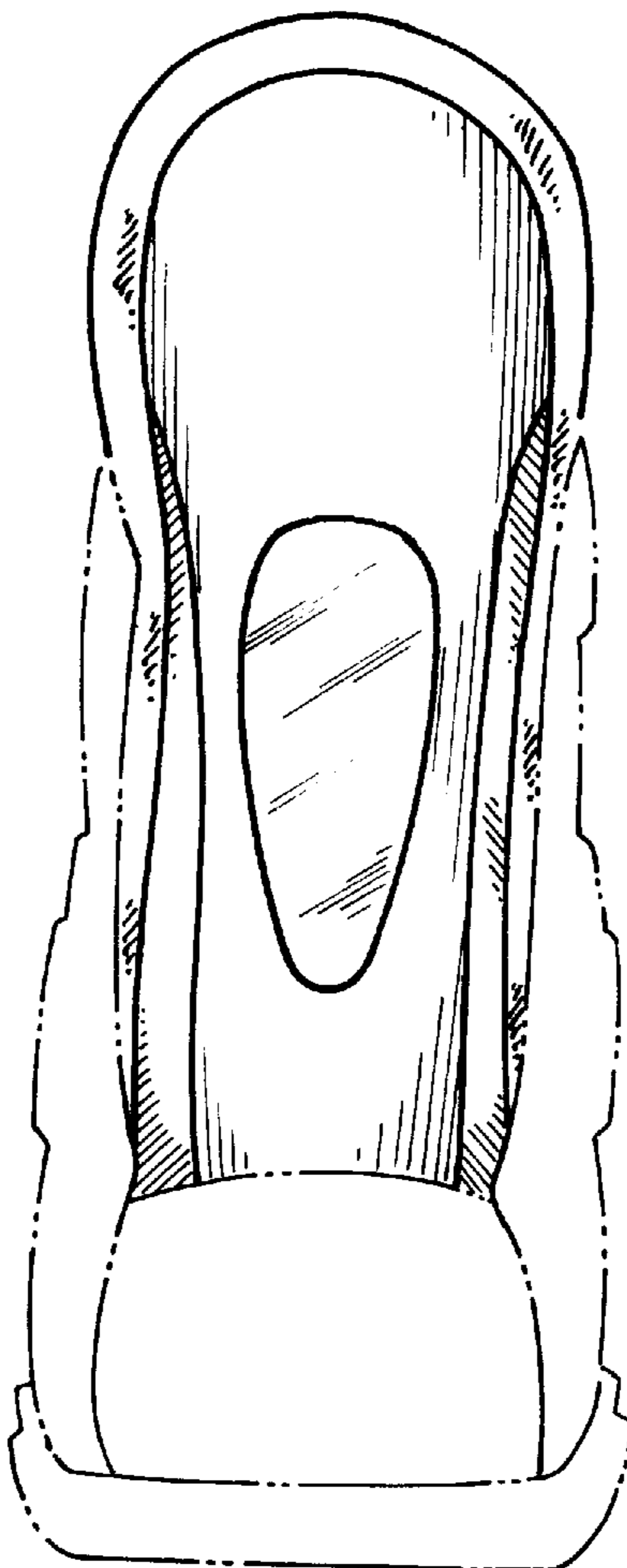

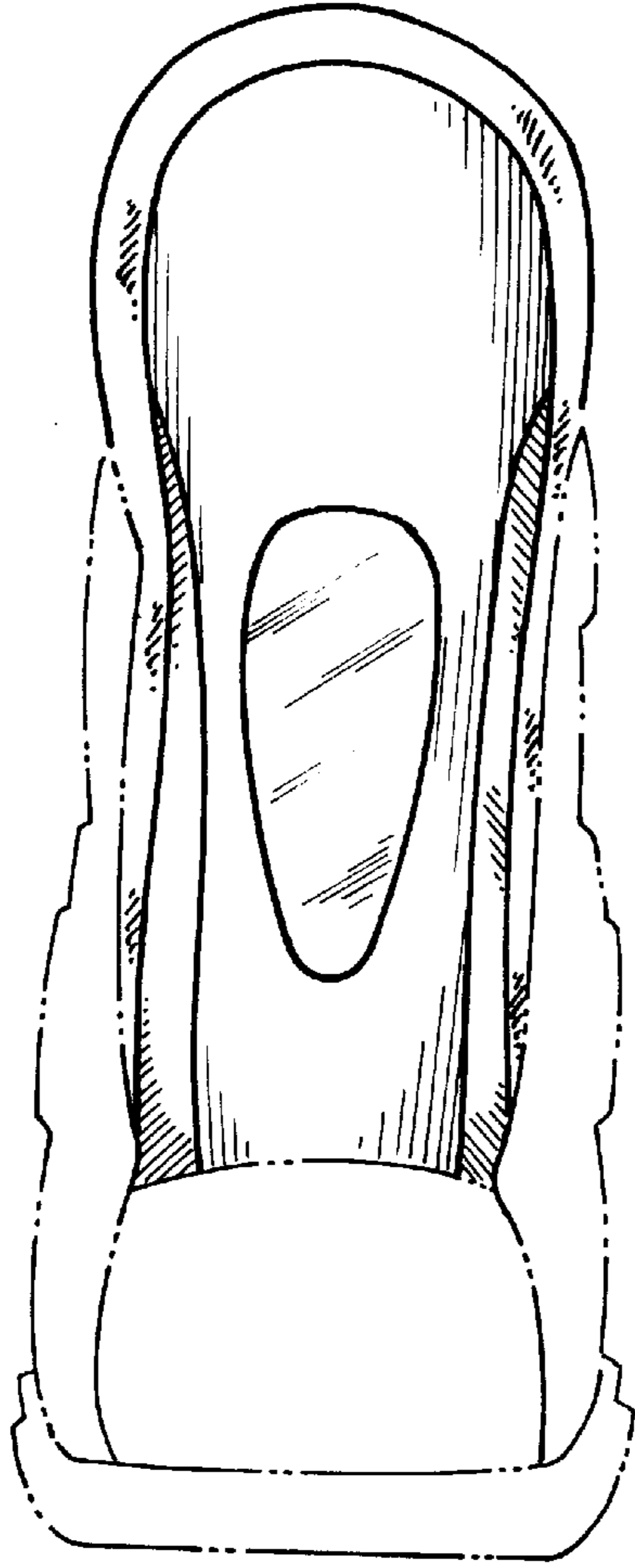

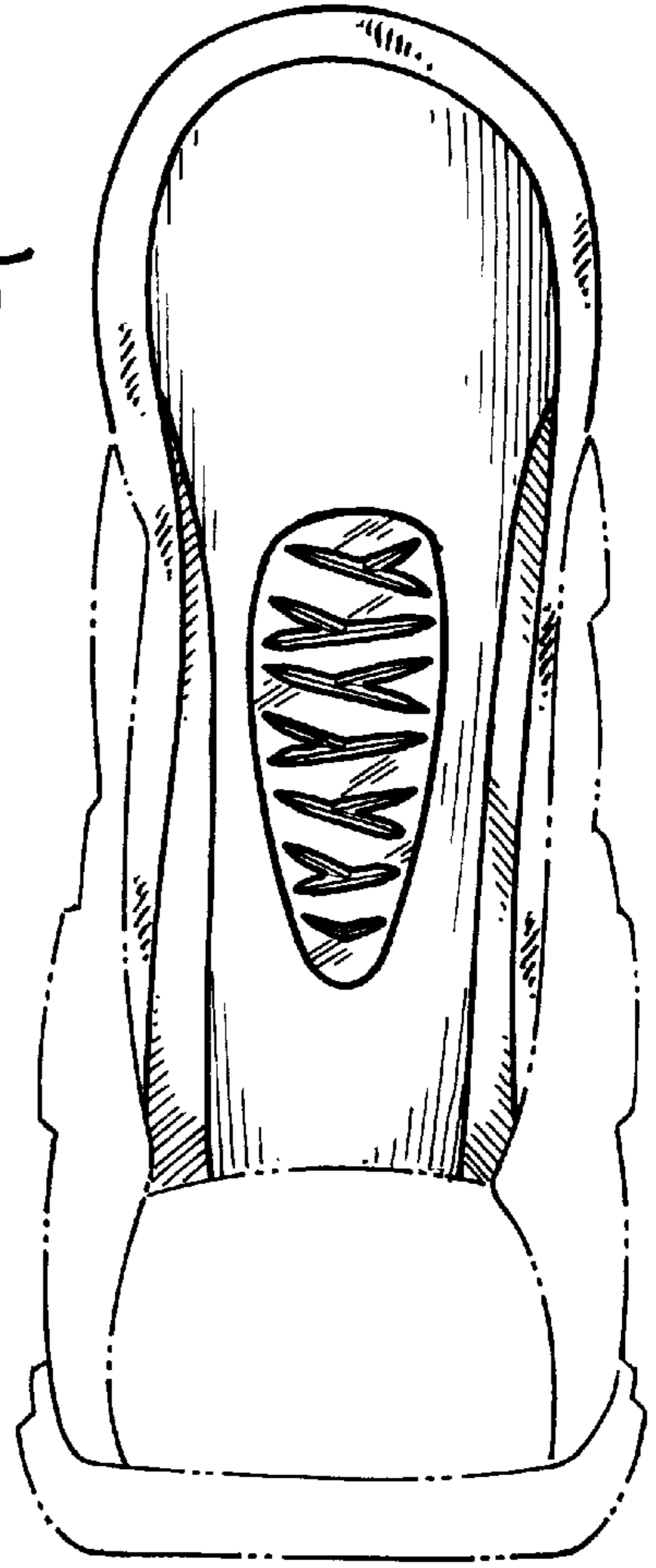
