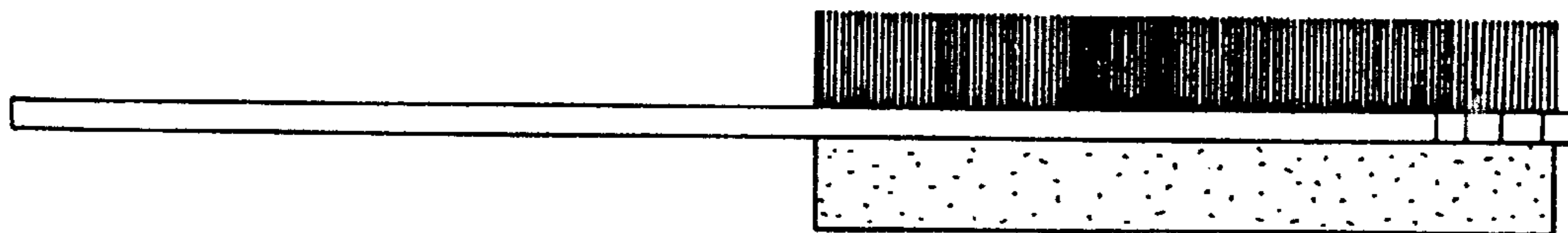
FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a brush with callus remover

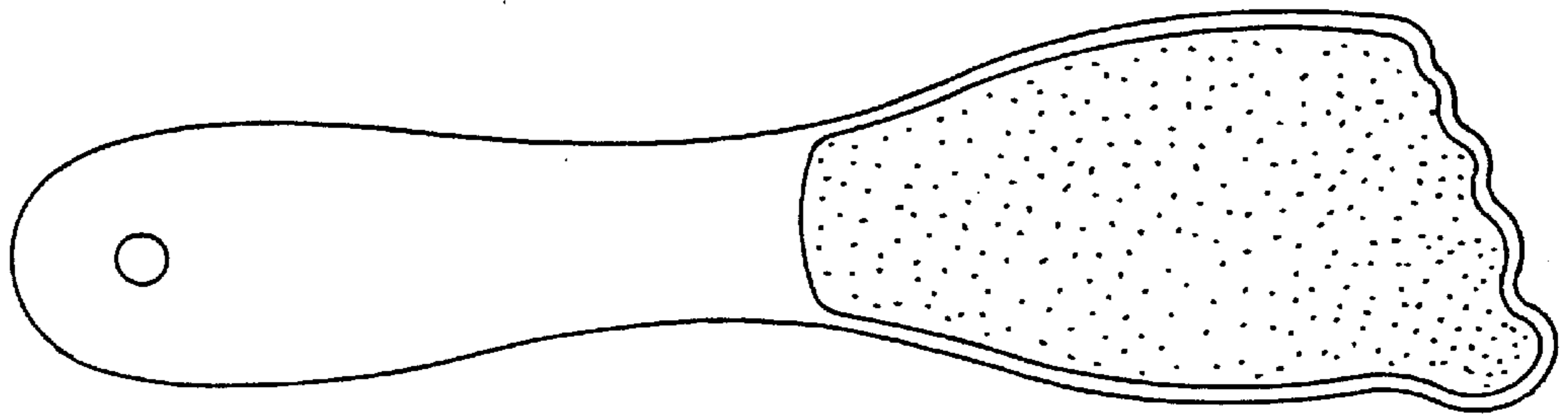

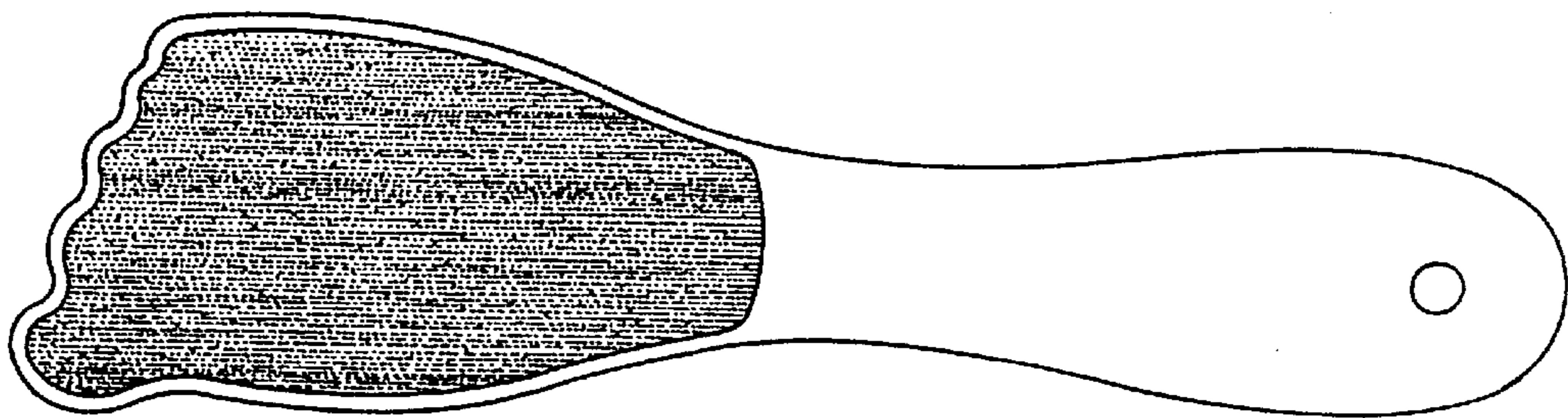

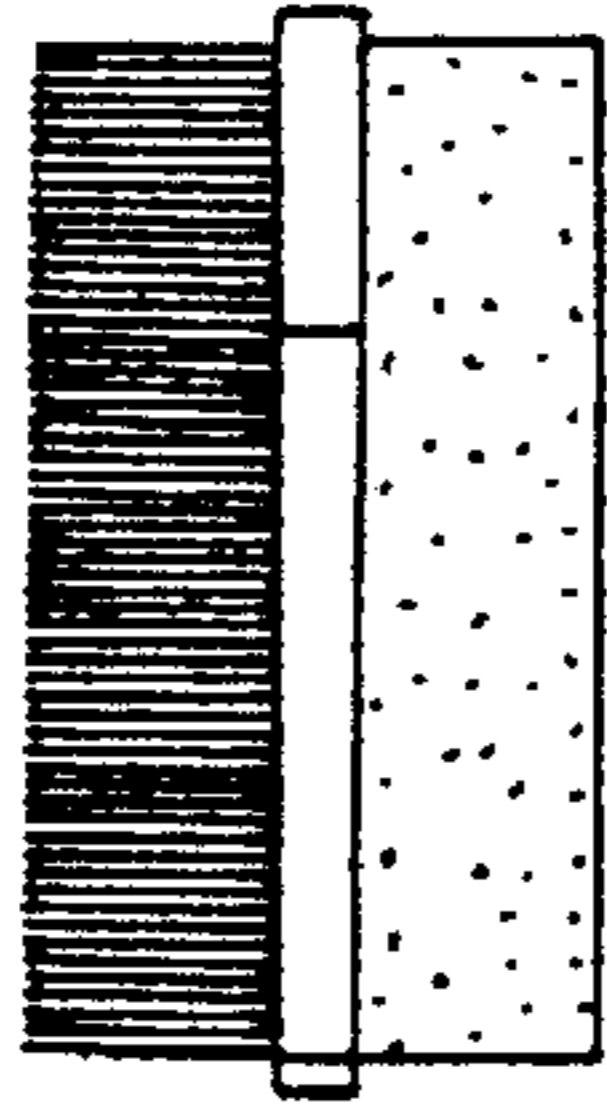

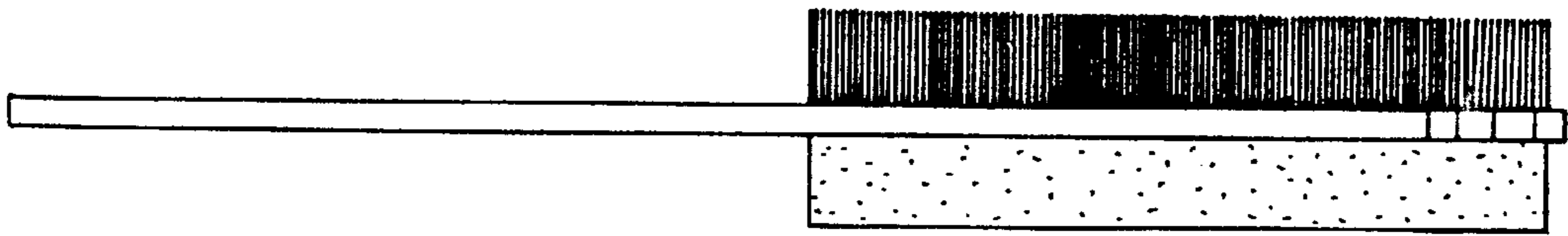

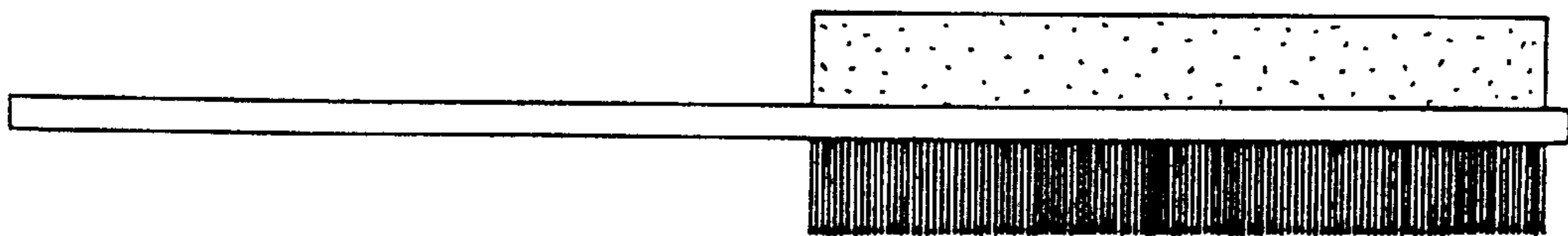

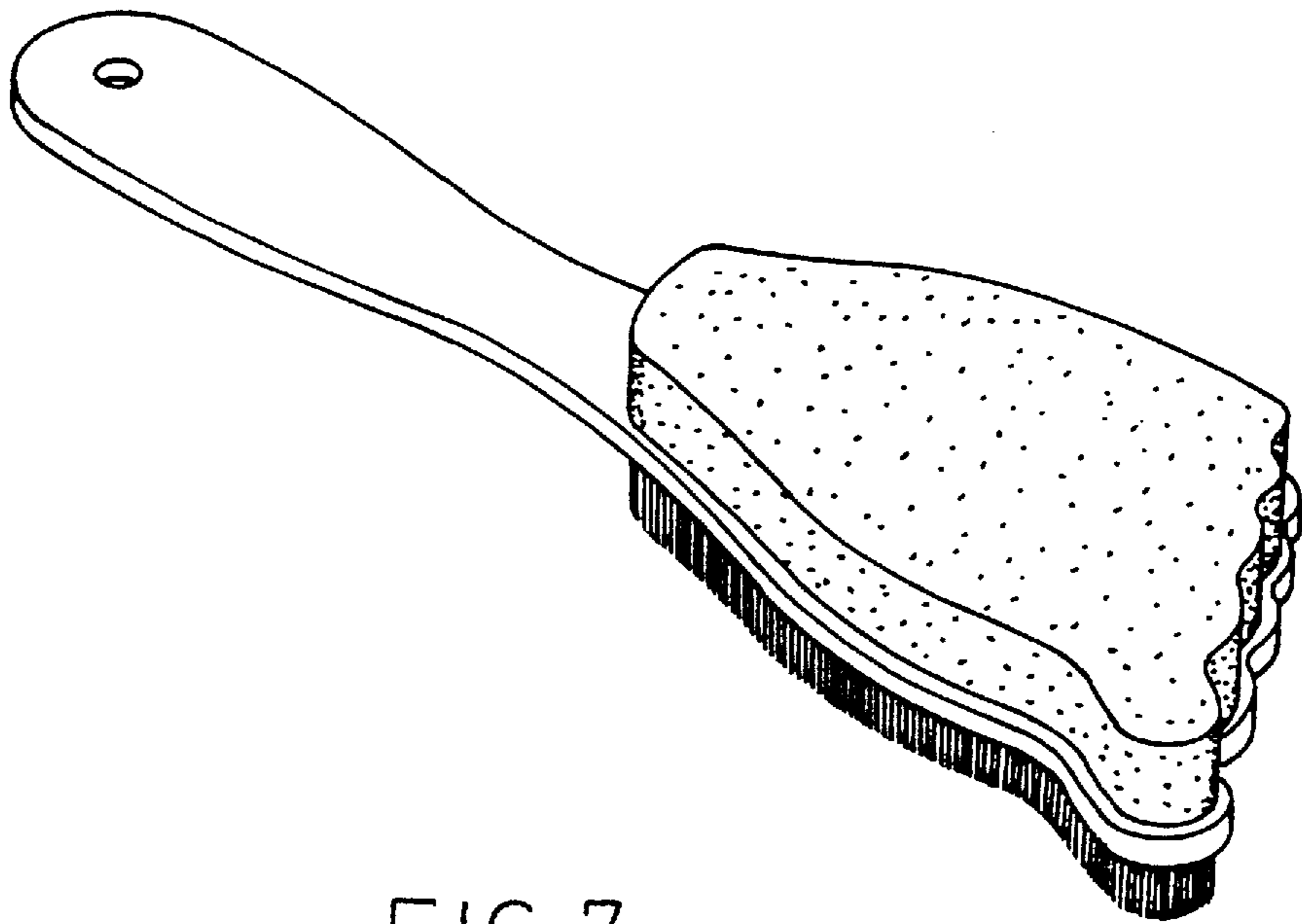
