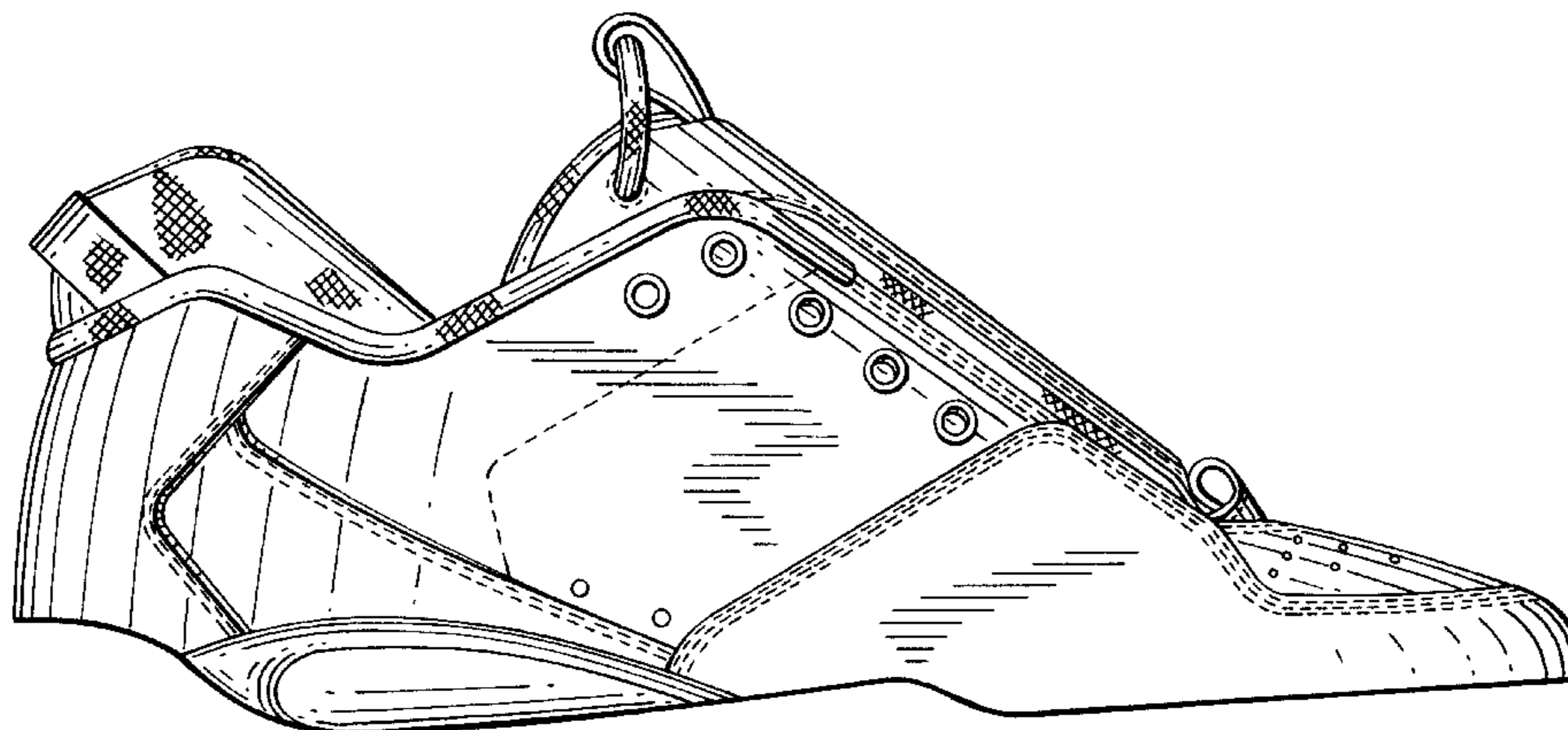
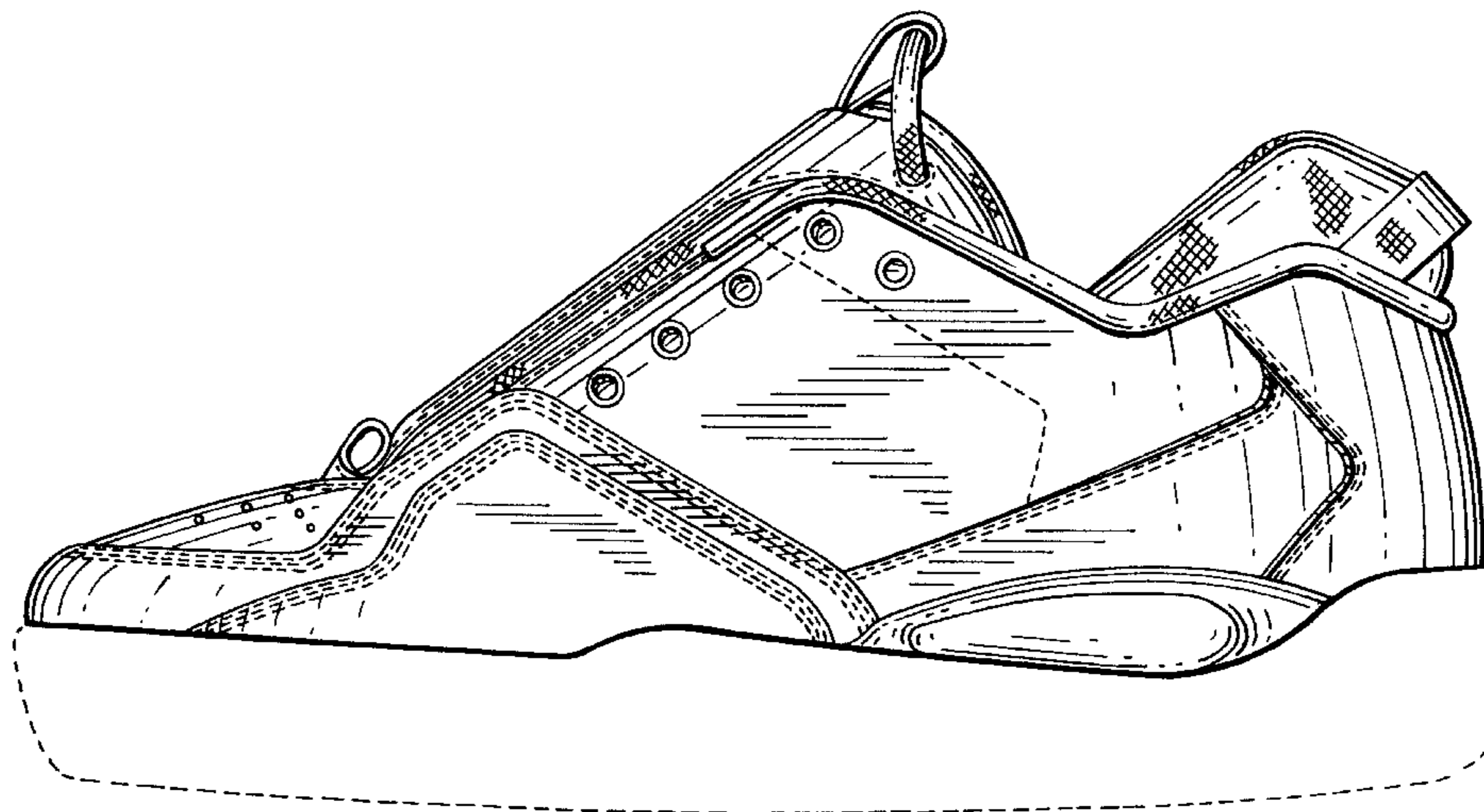
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 1 is a left side view of a shoe upper showing my new design;

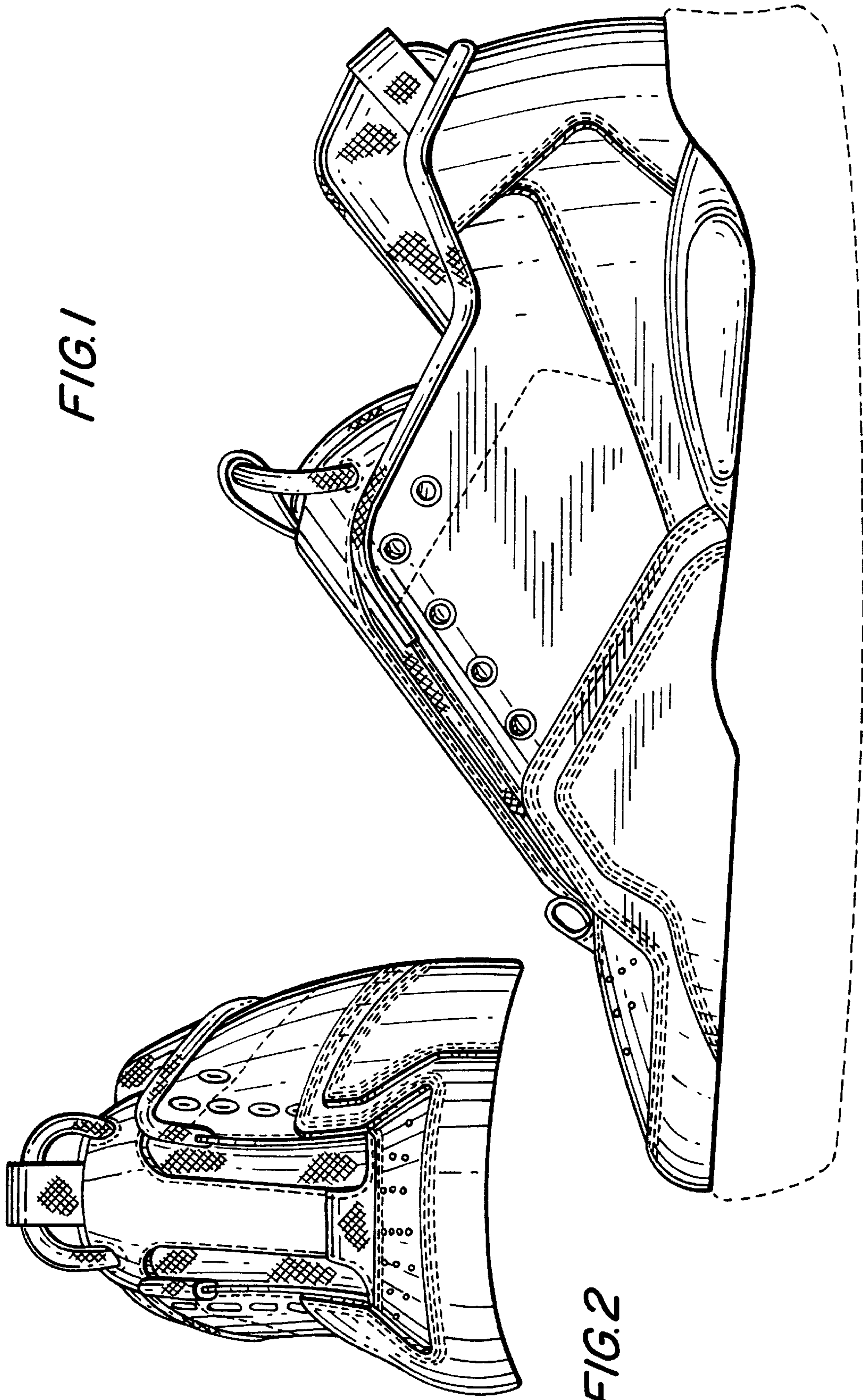
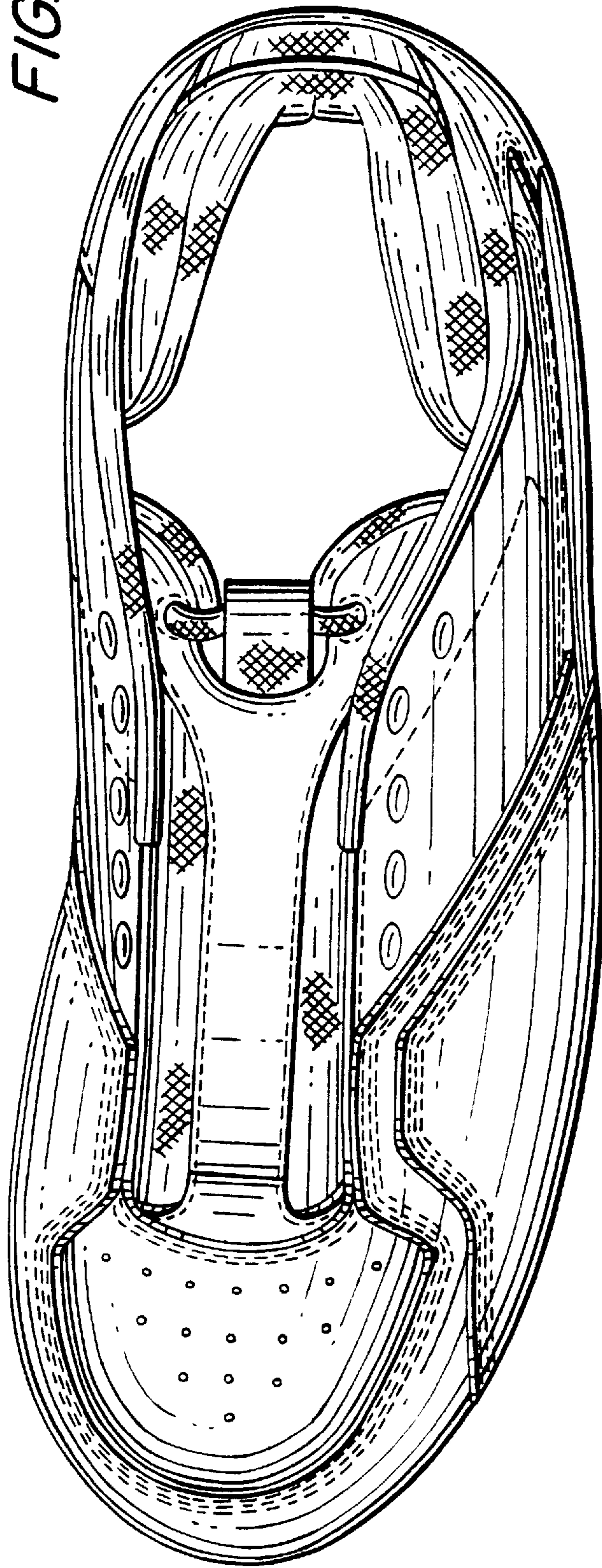

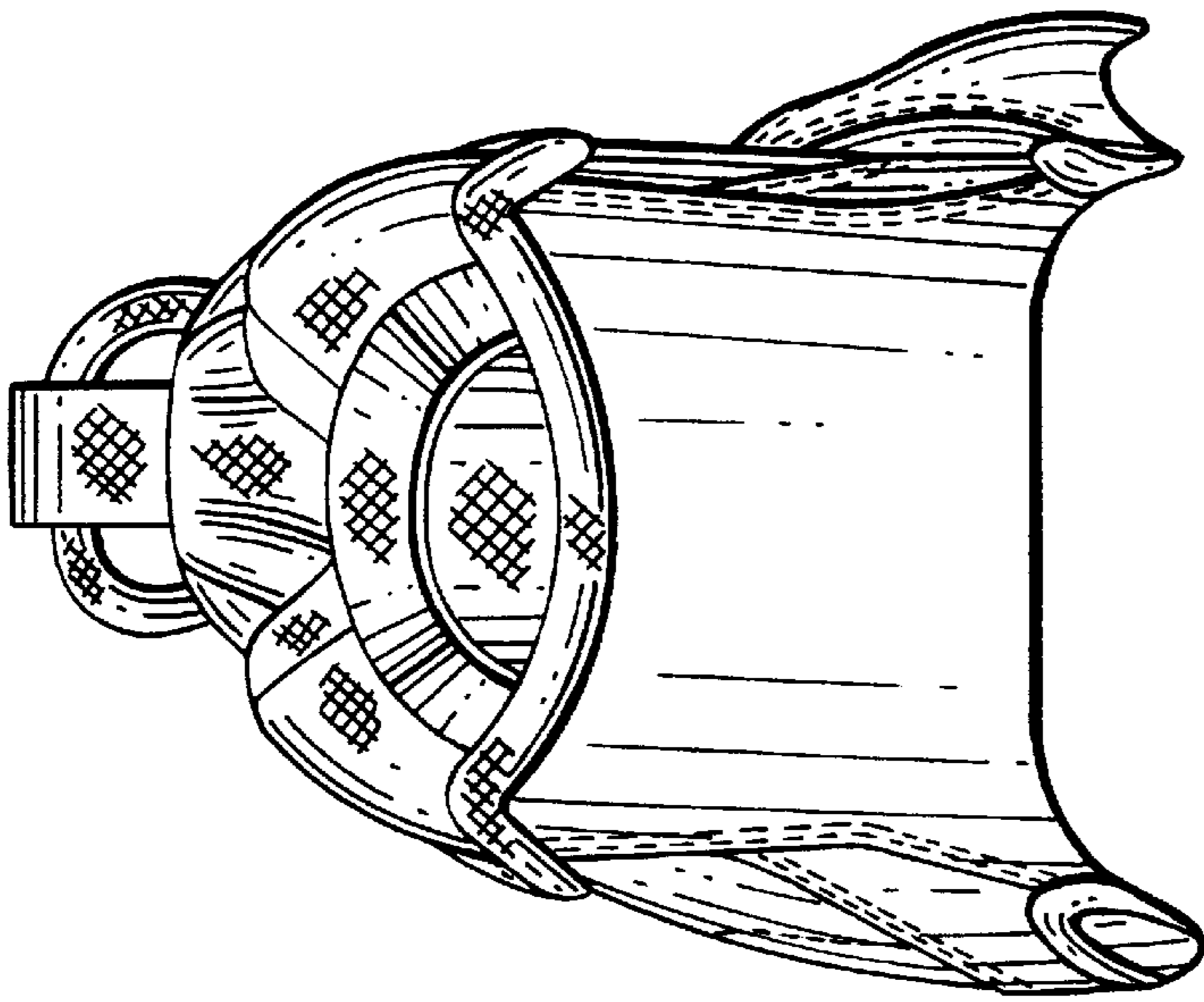

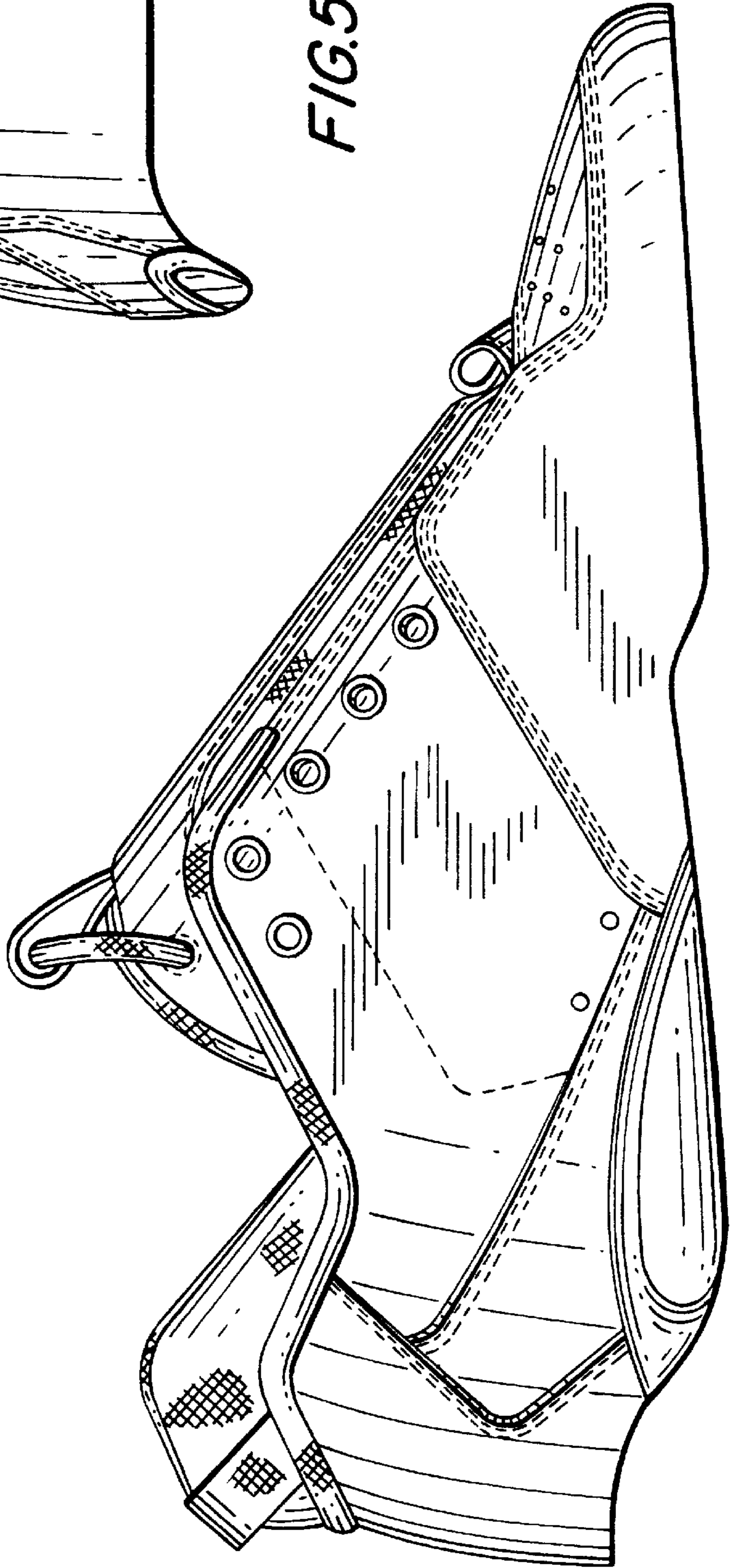
