DESCRIPTION

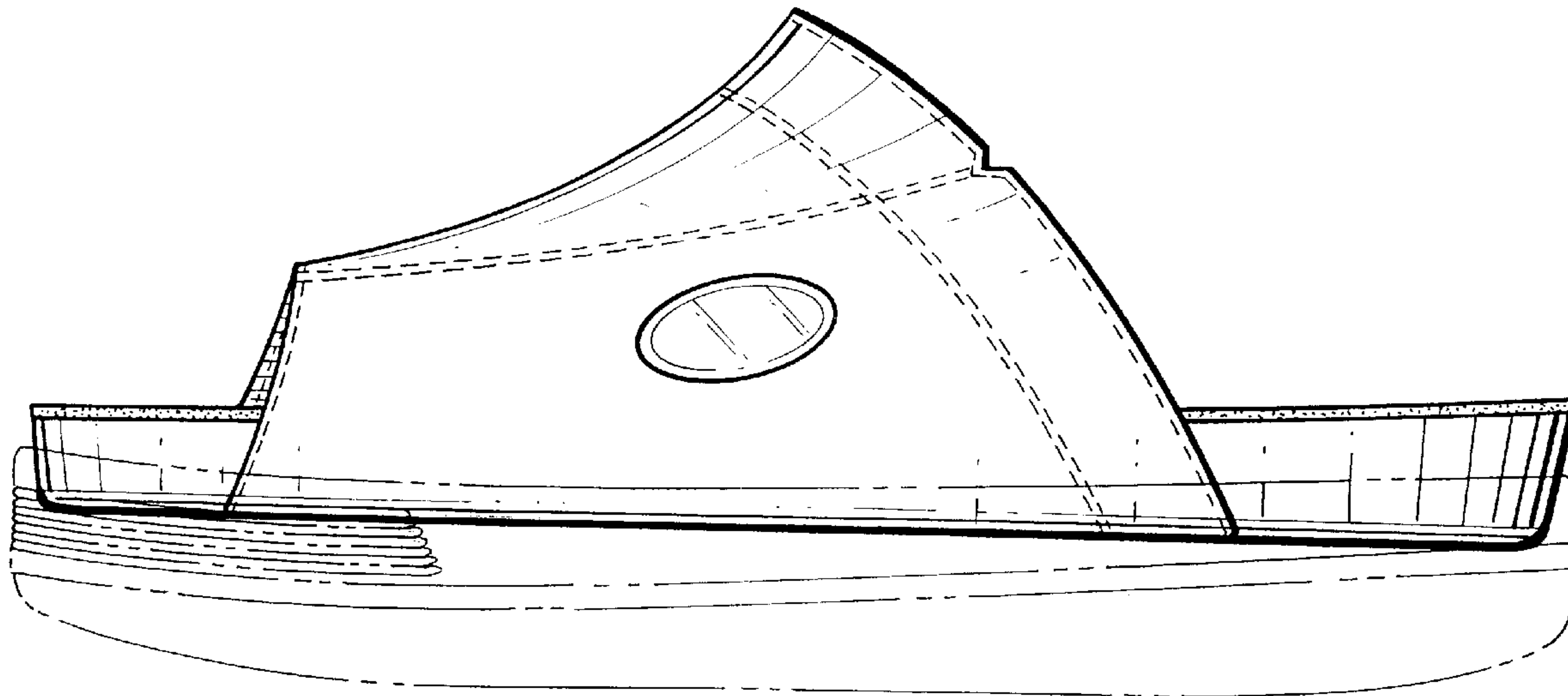

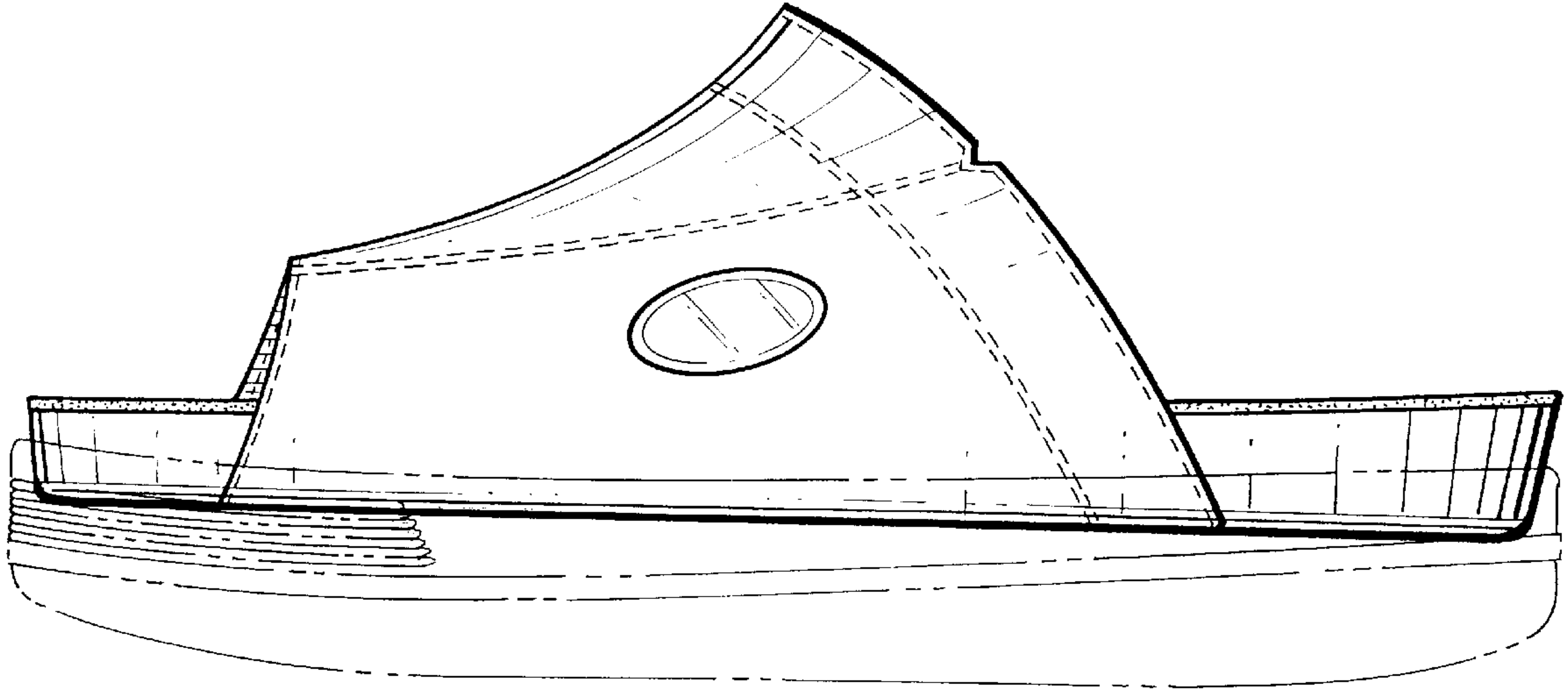

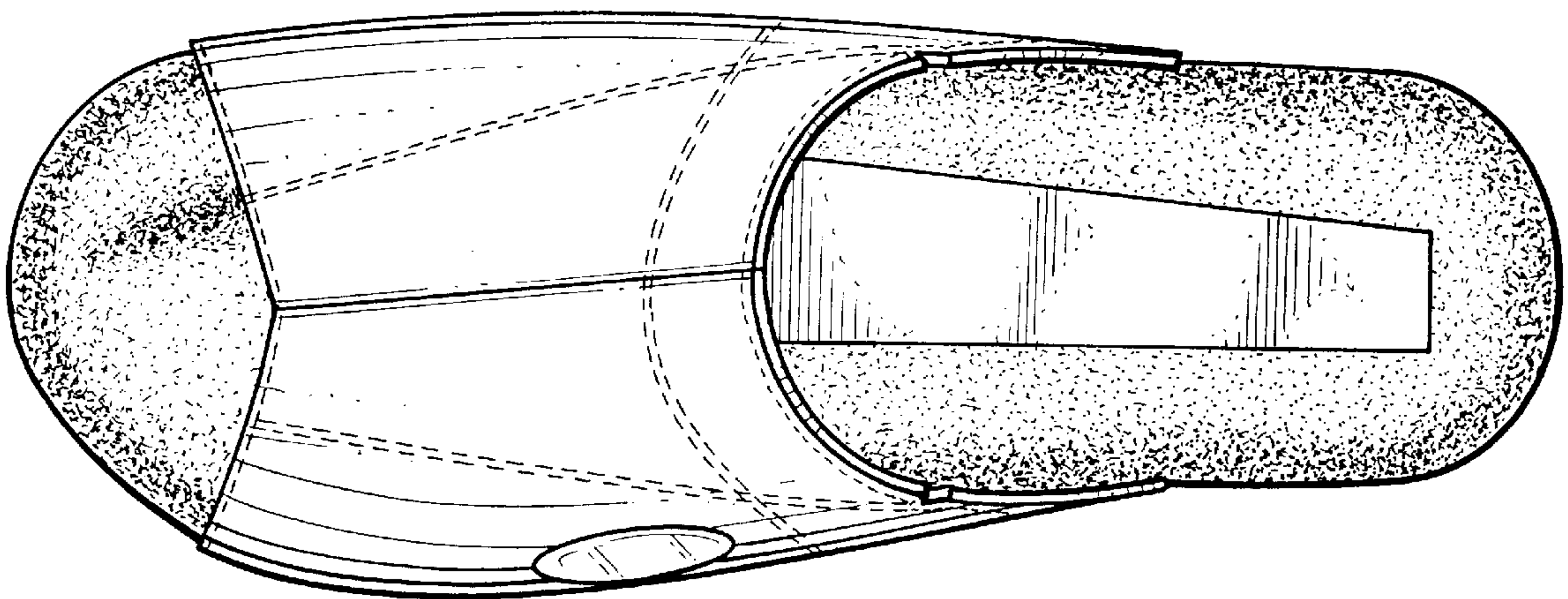

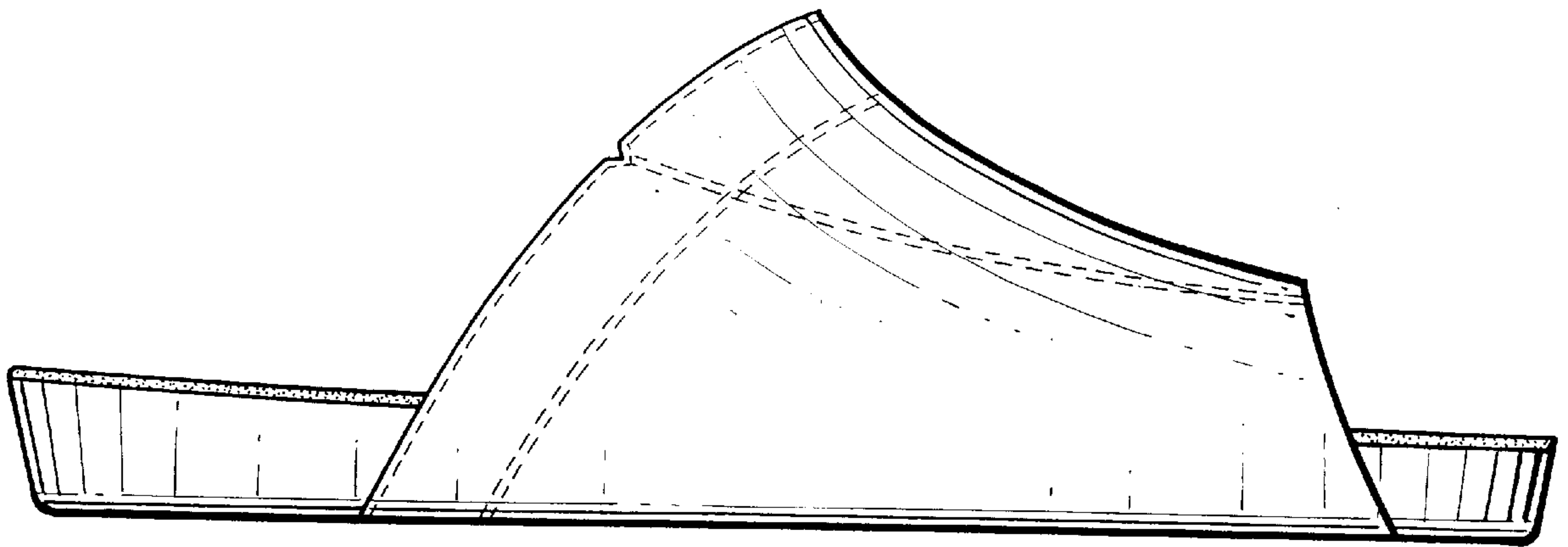

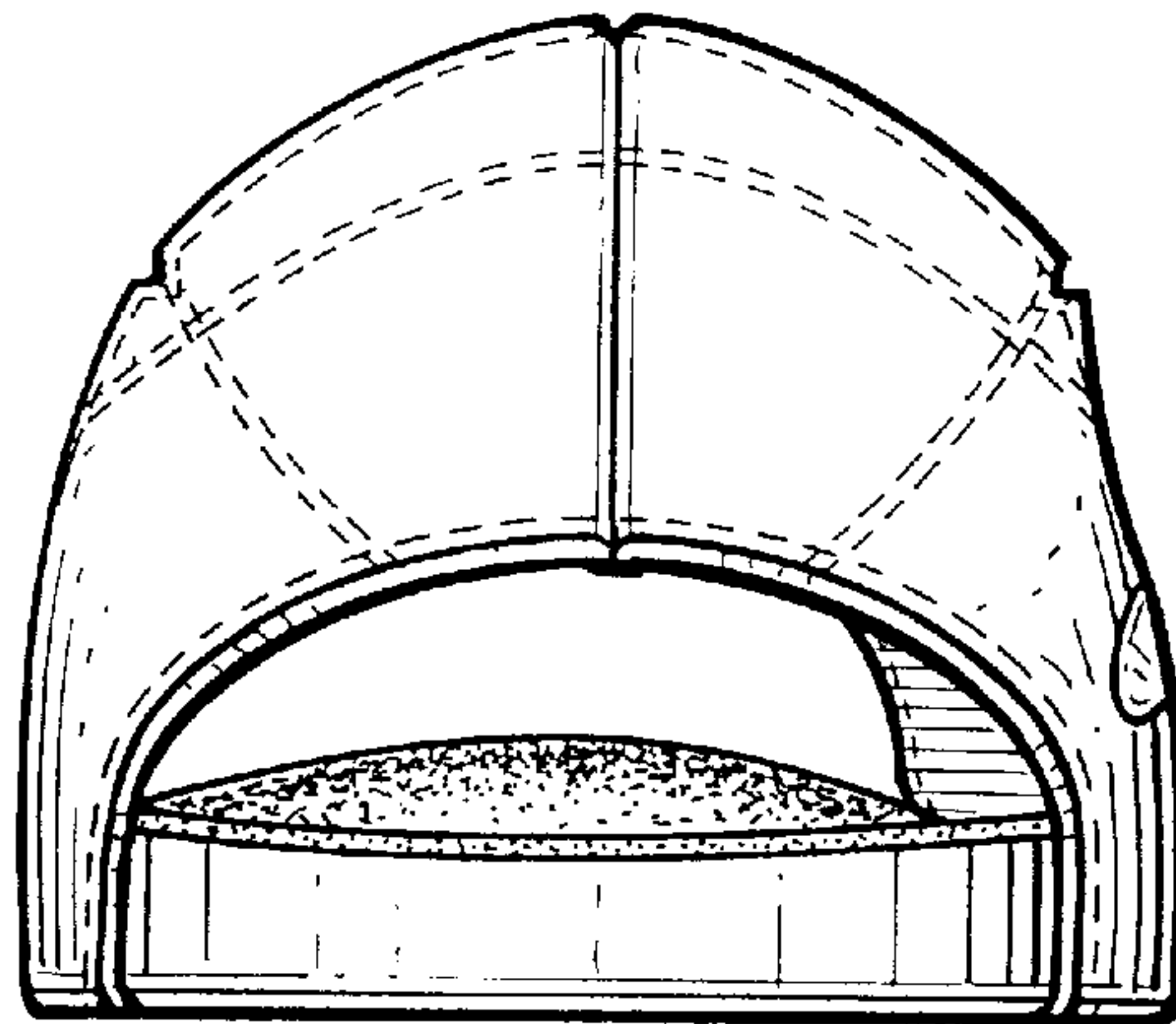

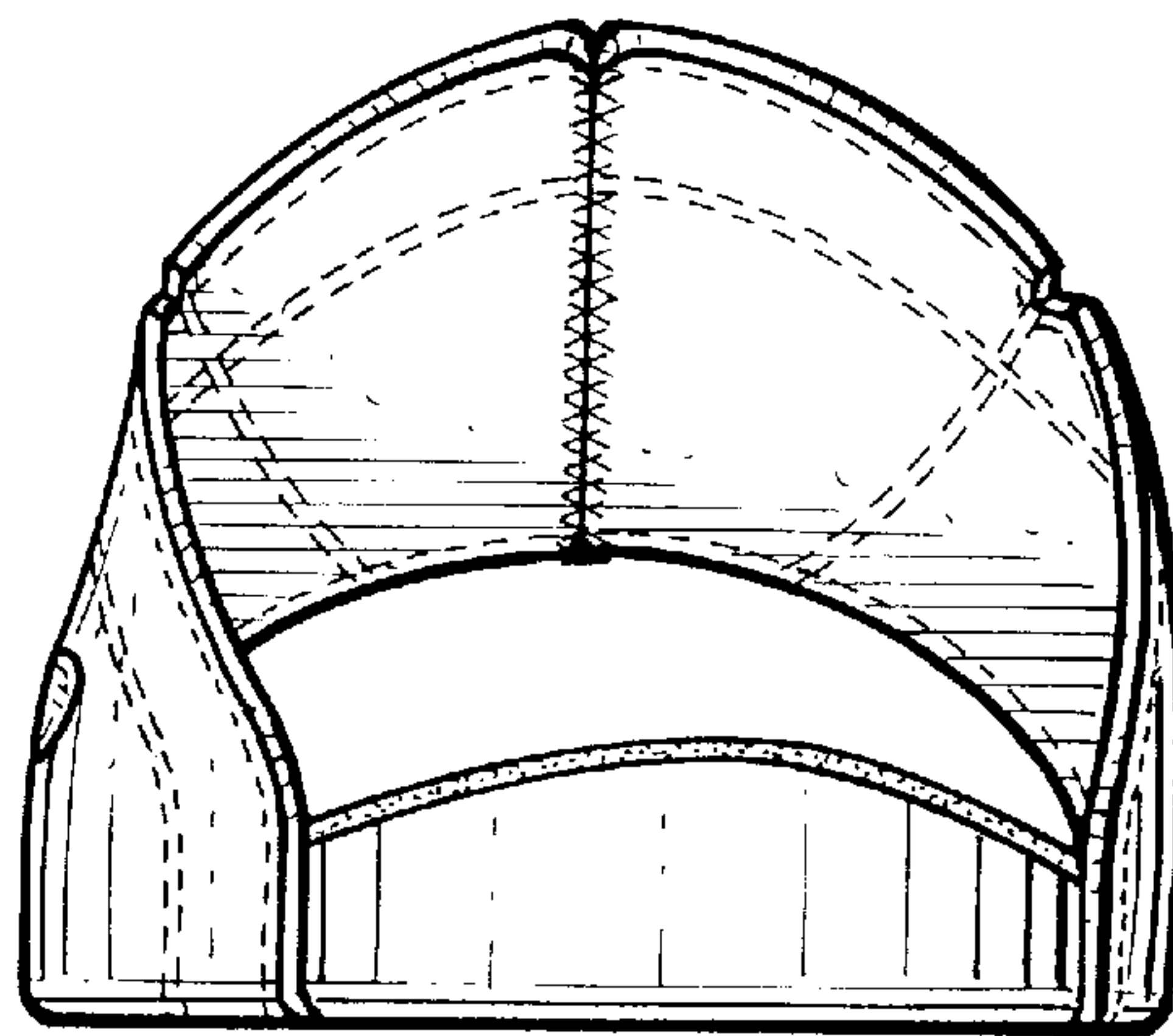
