FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the chair comprising my new design;

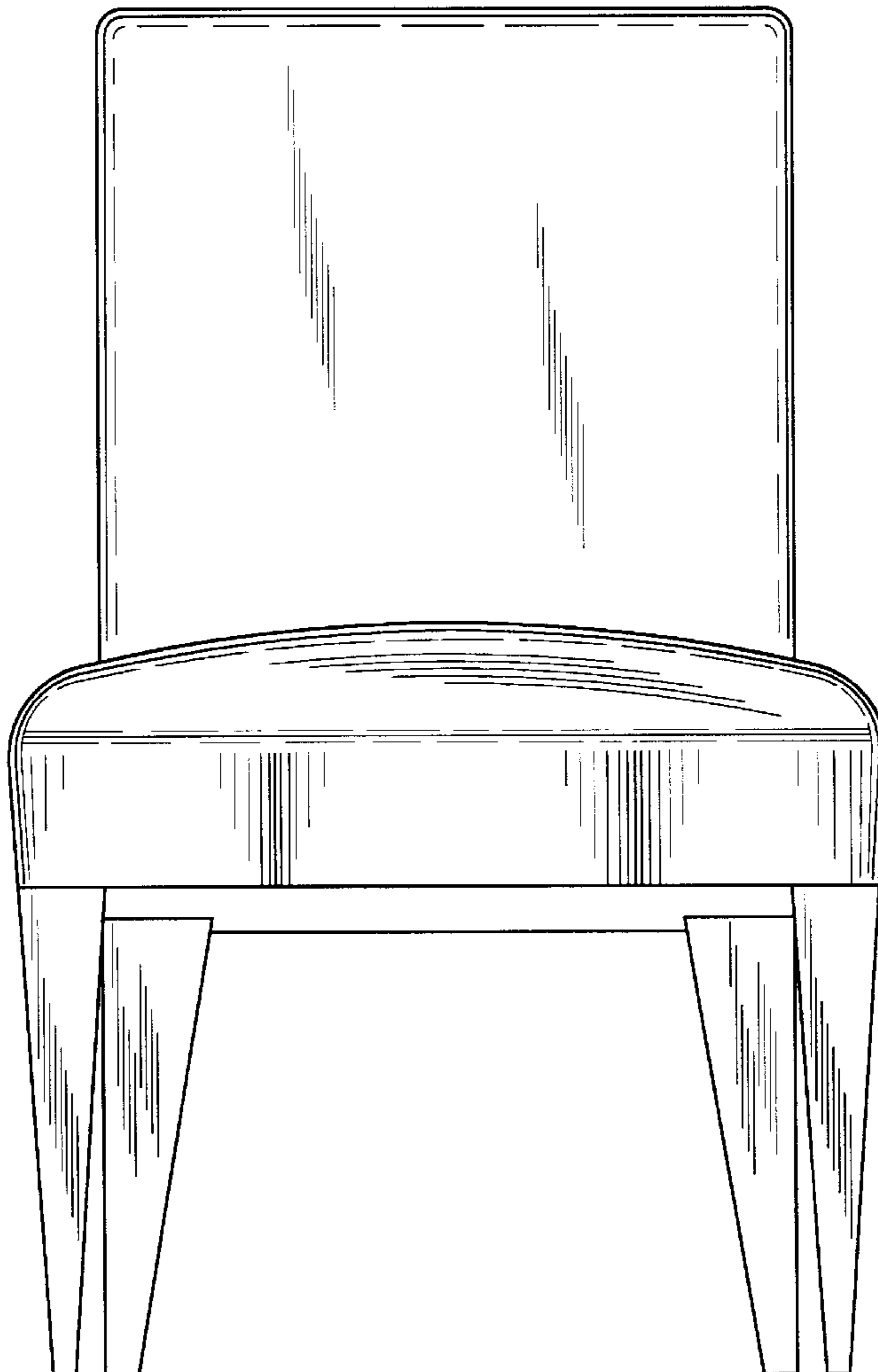
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

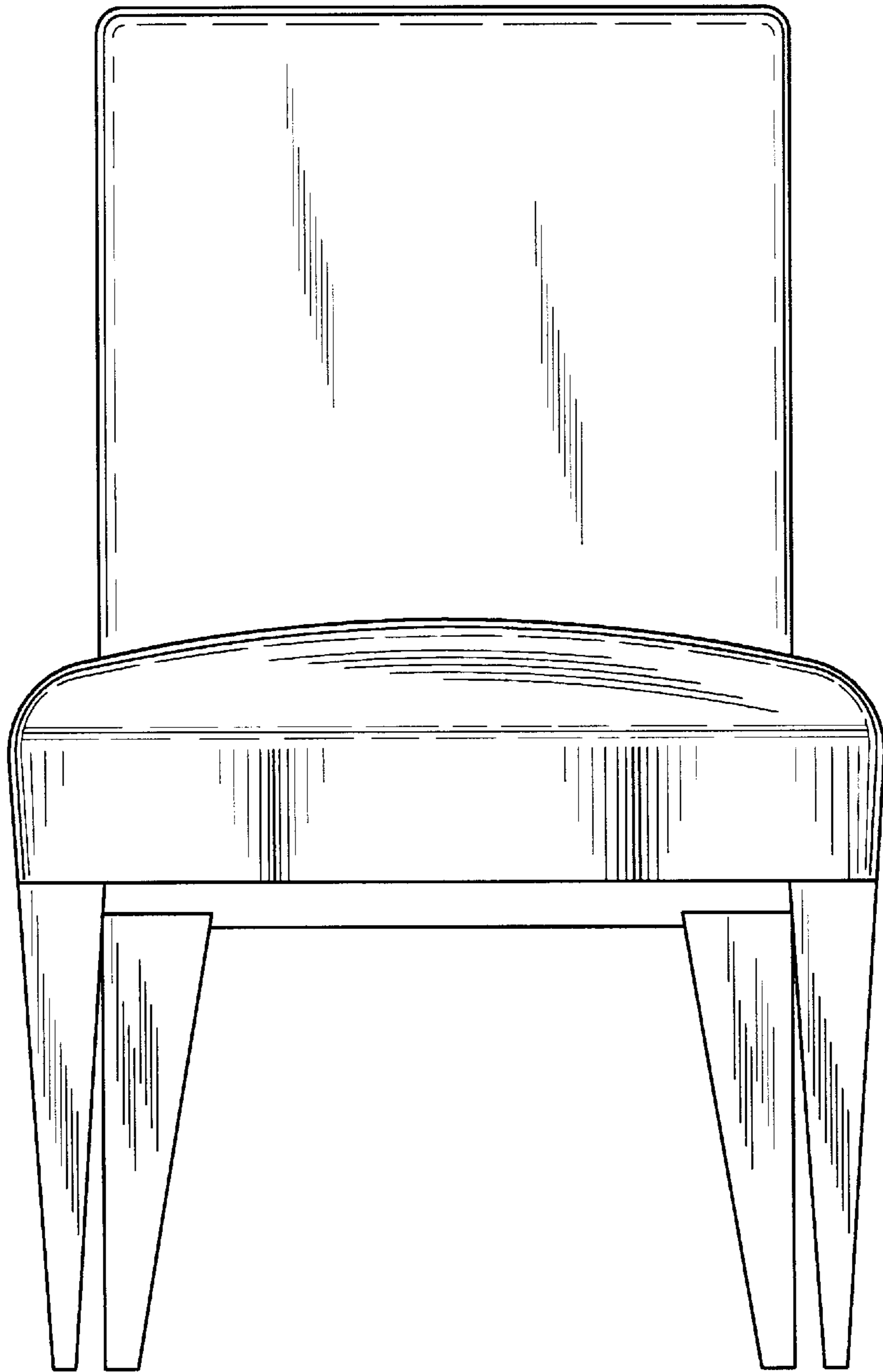

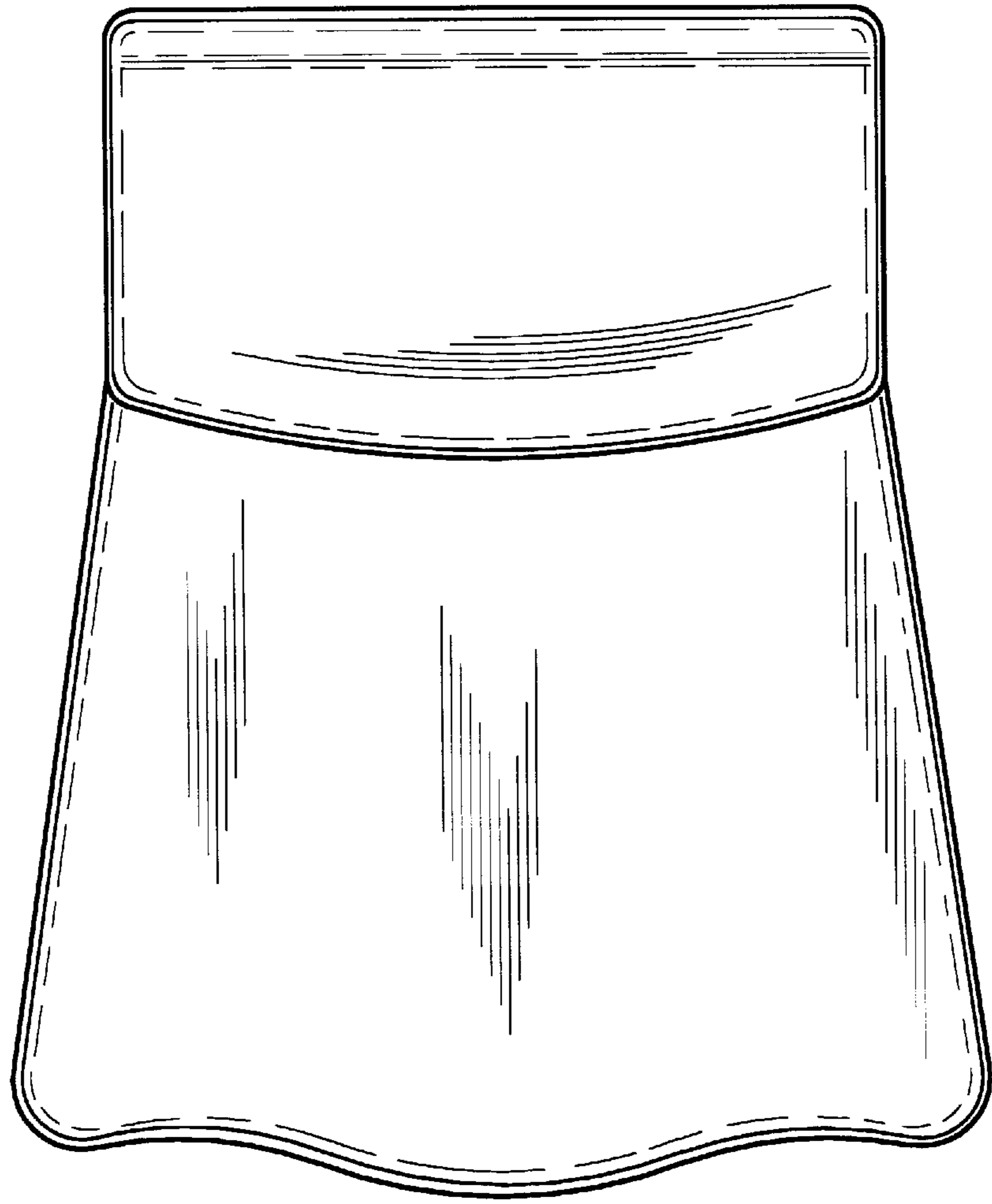

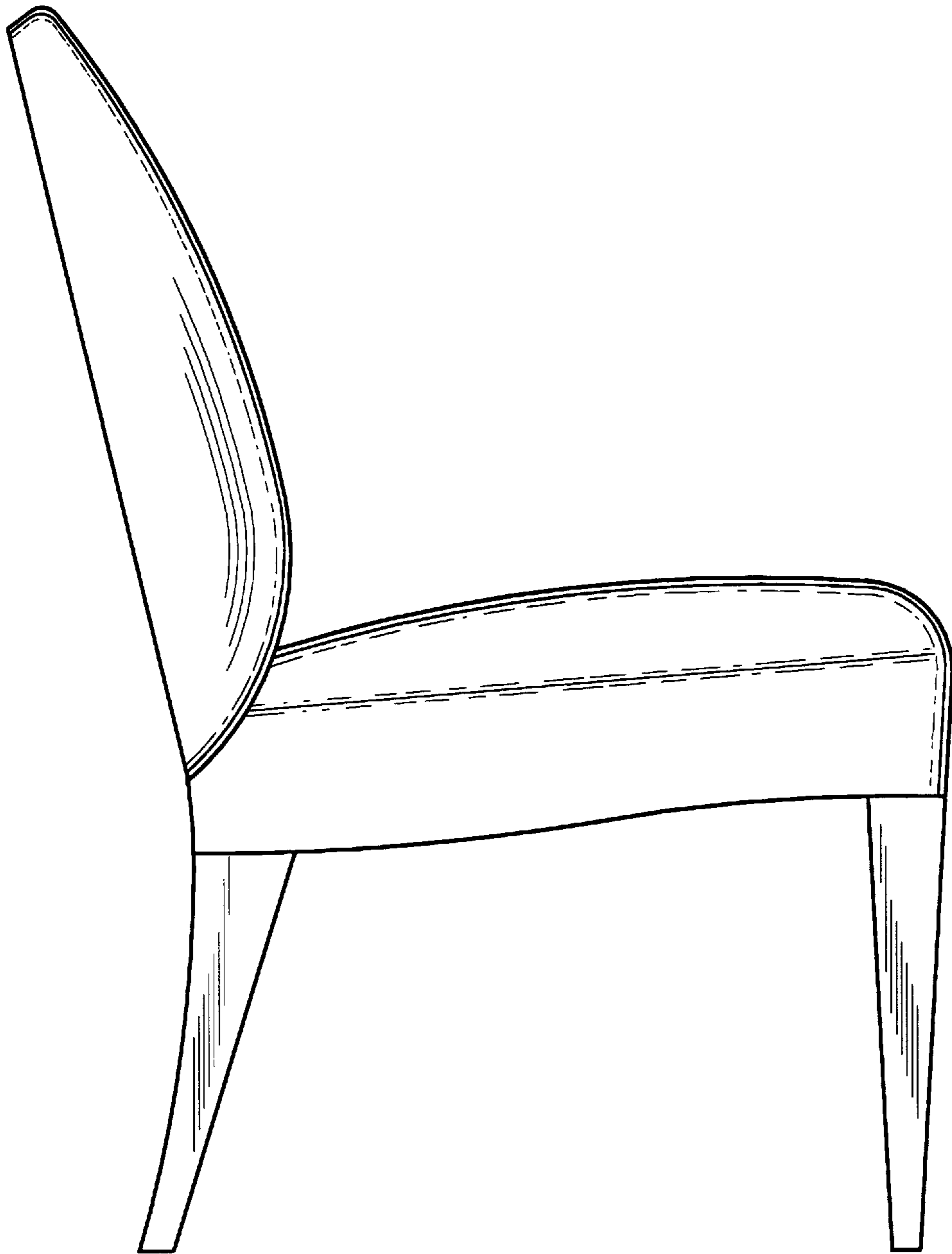

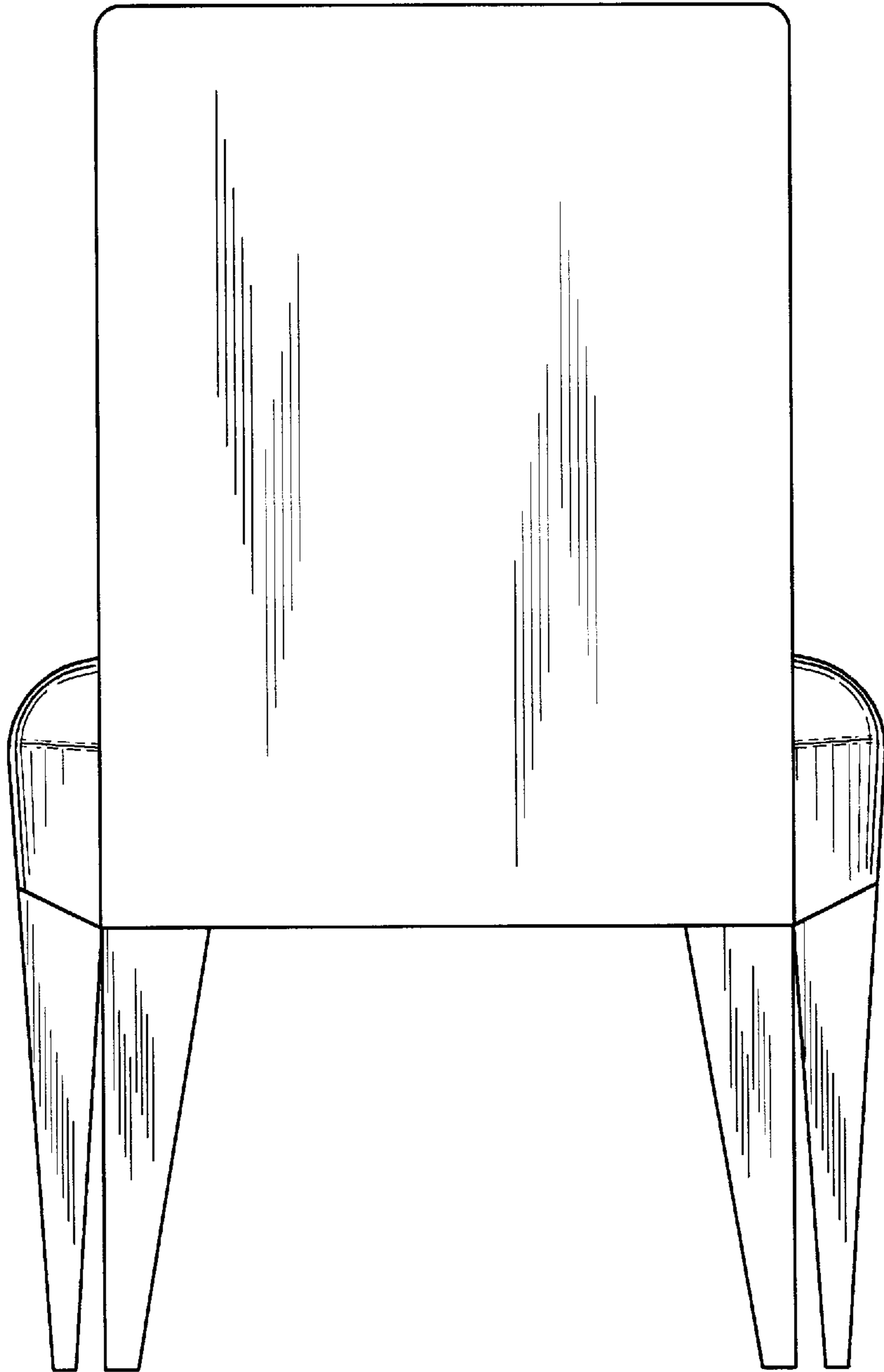

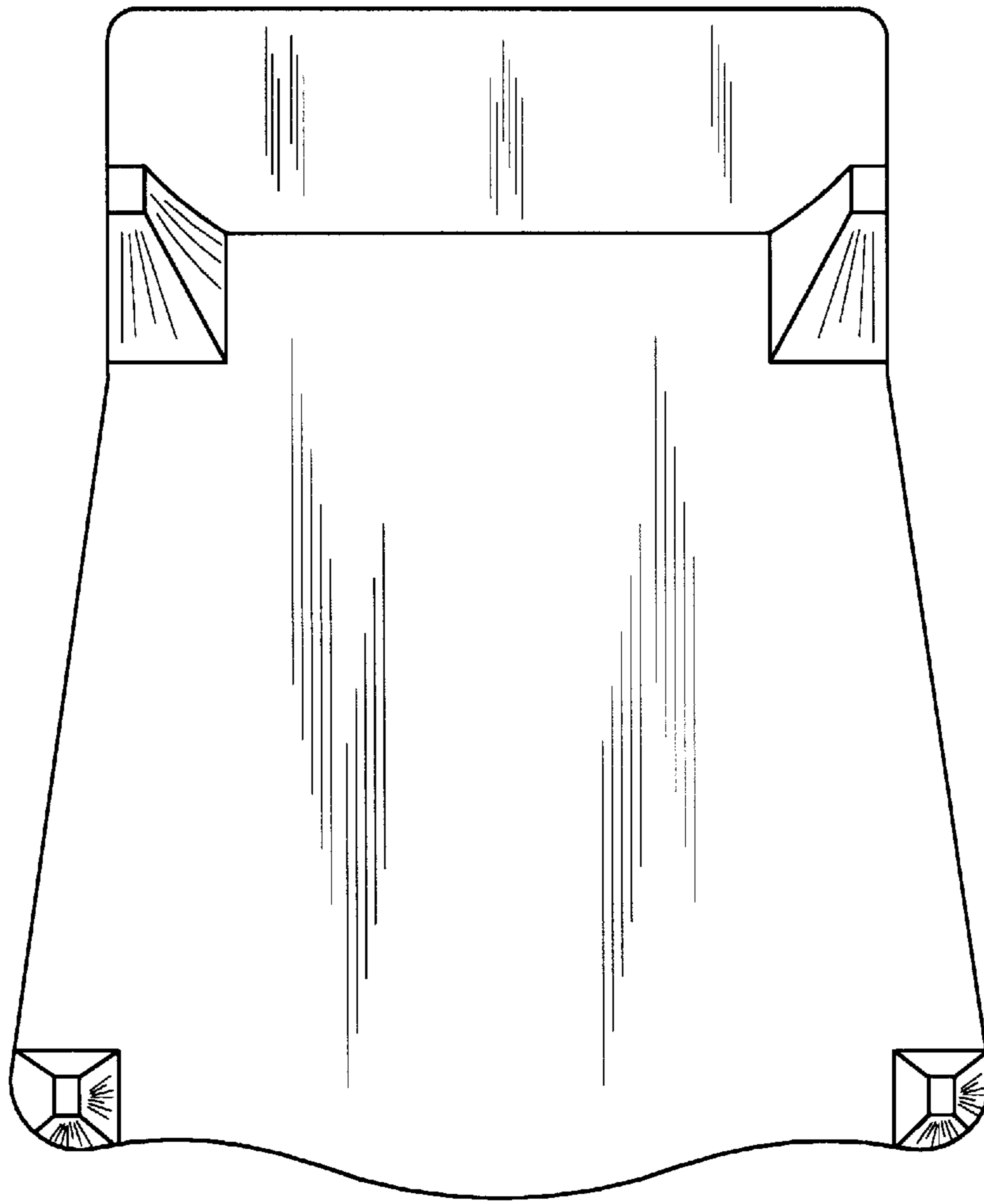
