DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a isometric view of a tissue ablation device showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side-elevational view of the tissue ablation device shown in FIG. 1. The opposite side of the tissue ablation device corresponds to that shown in FIG. 1;

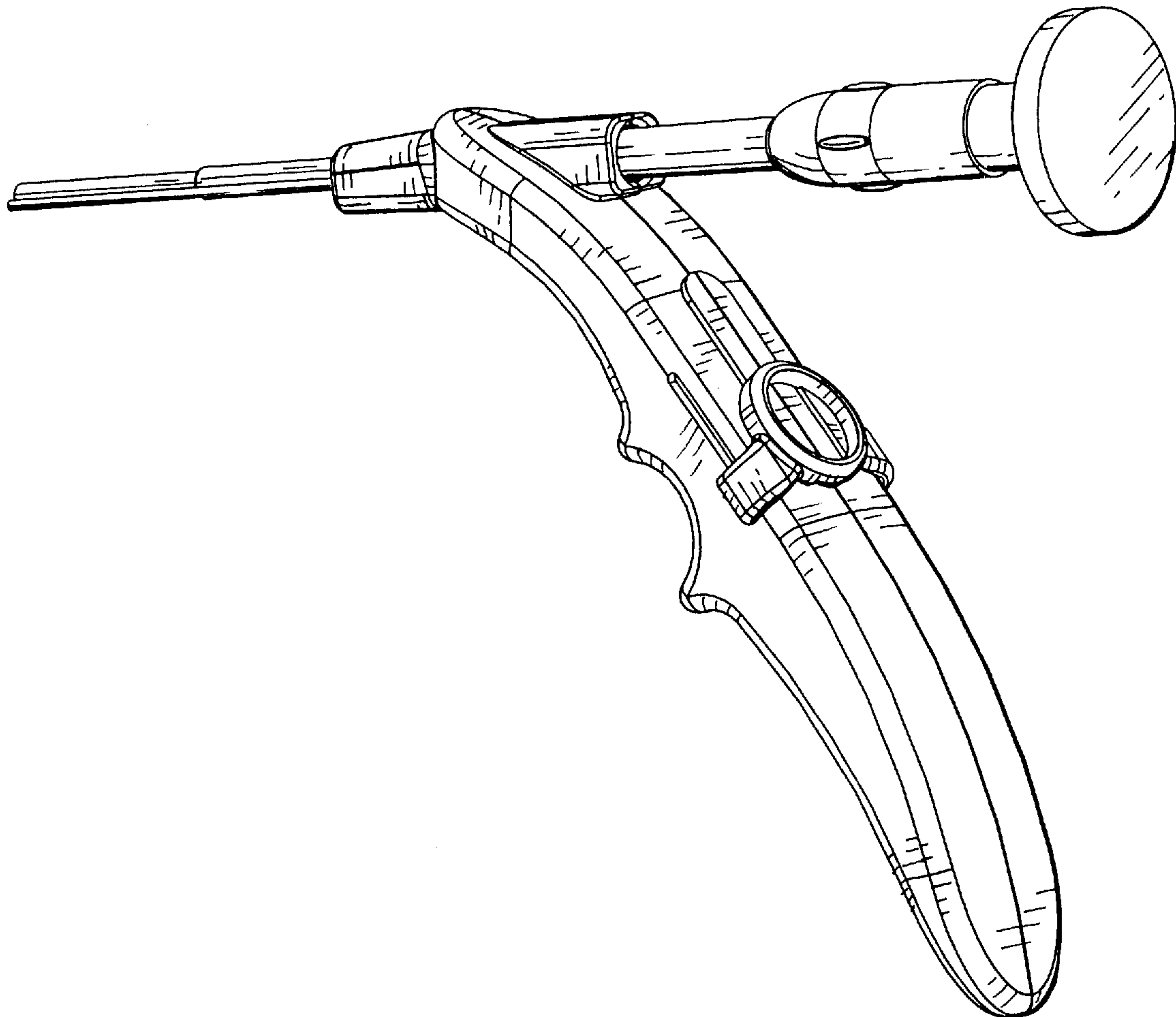
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the tissue ablation device shown in FIG. 2;

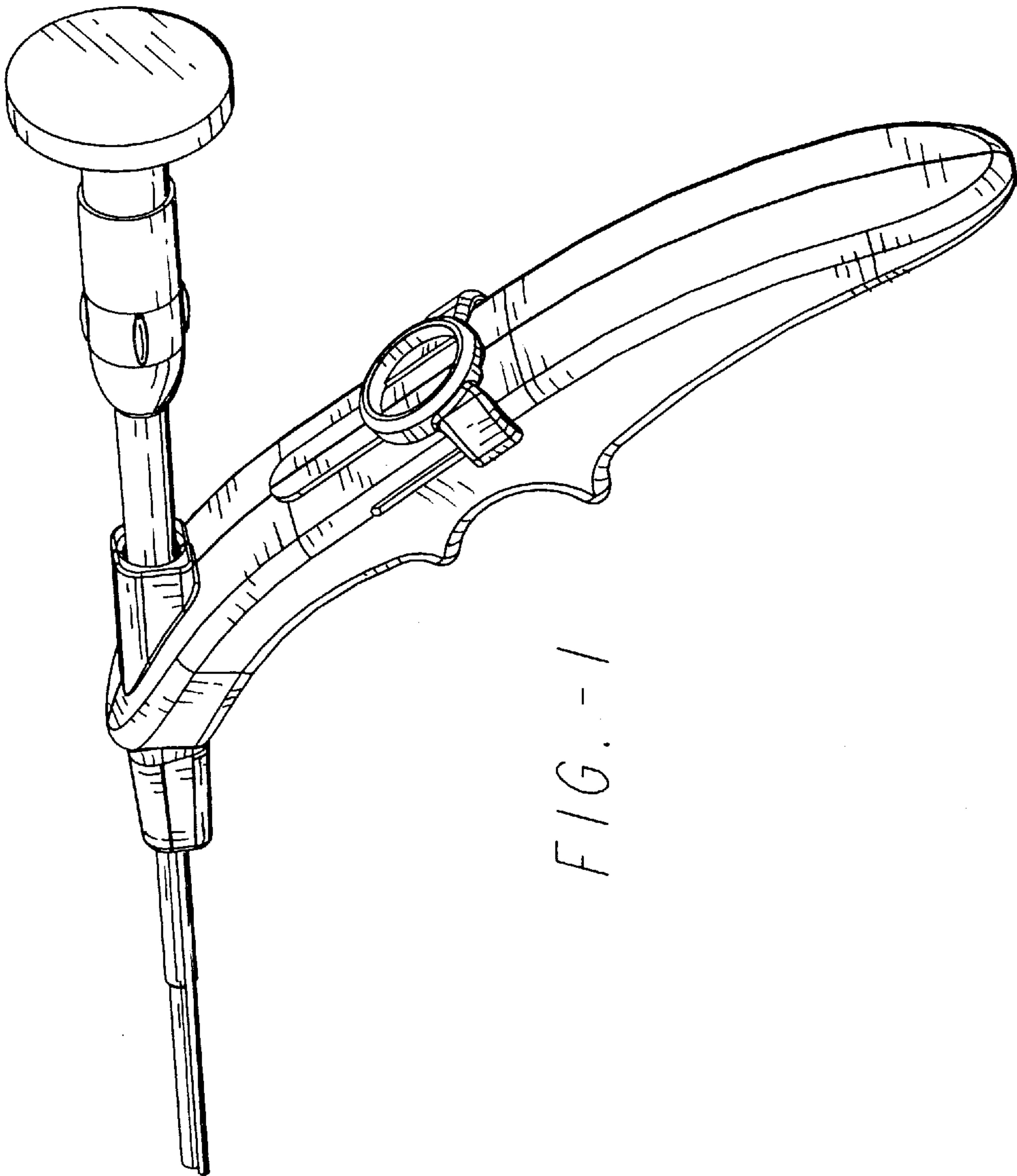

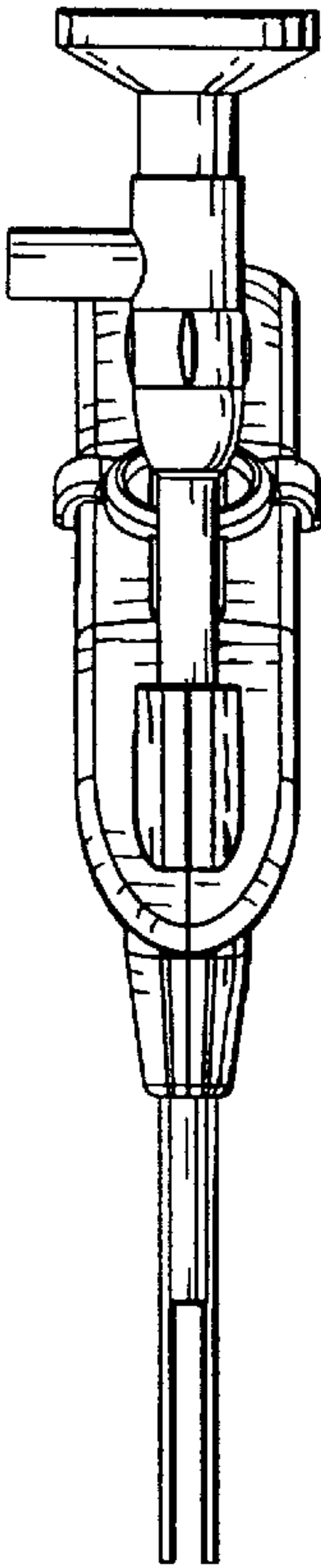

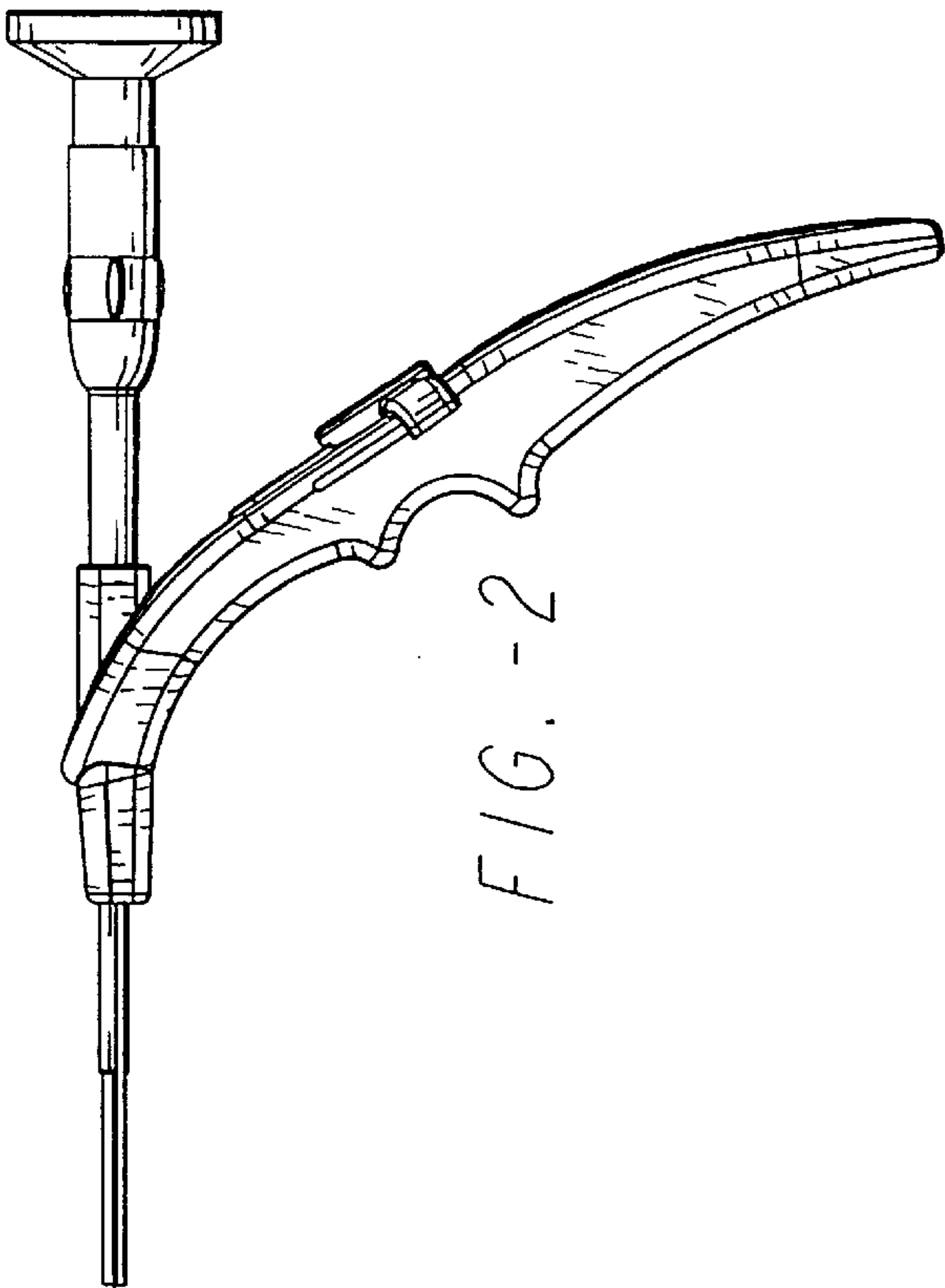

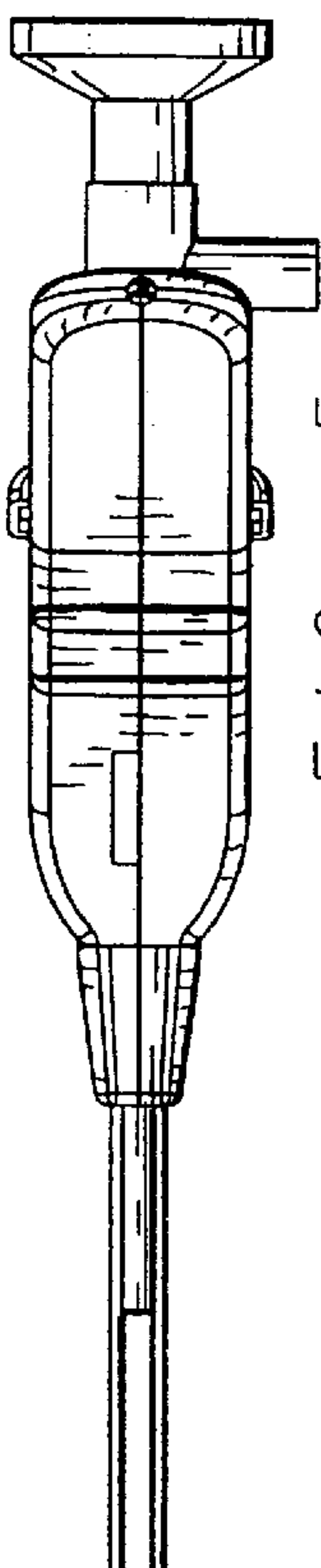

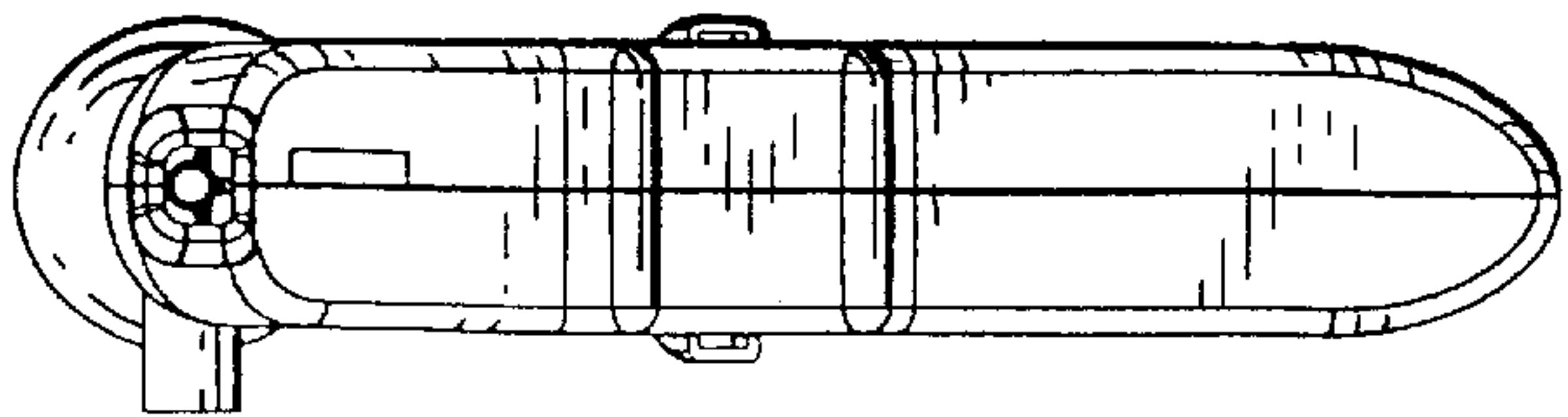

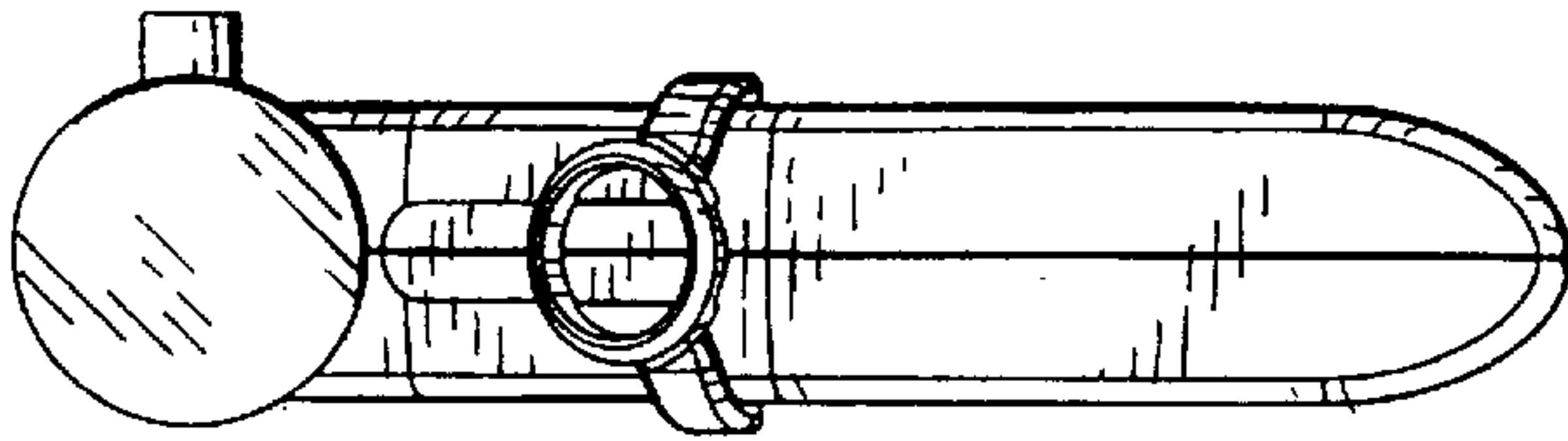
