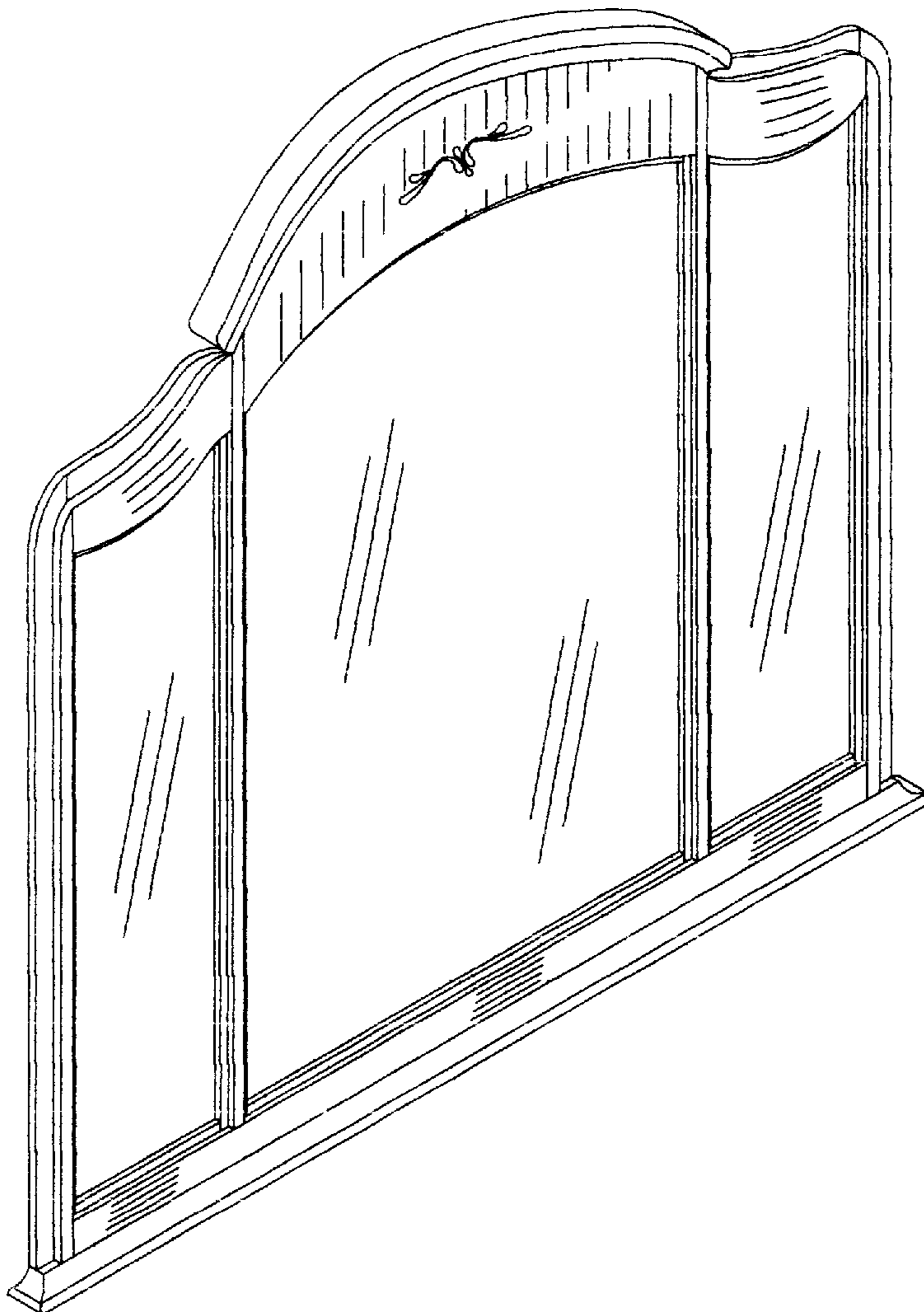
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 1 is a top view of the tri-view mirror showing my new design;

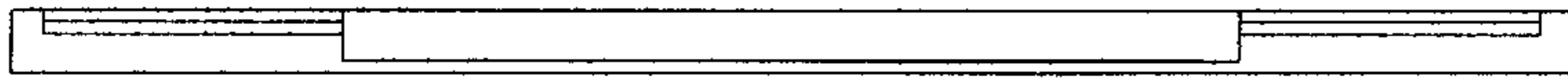

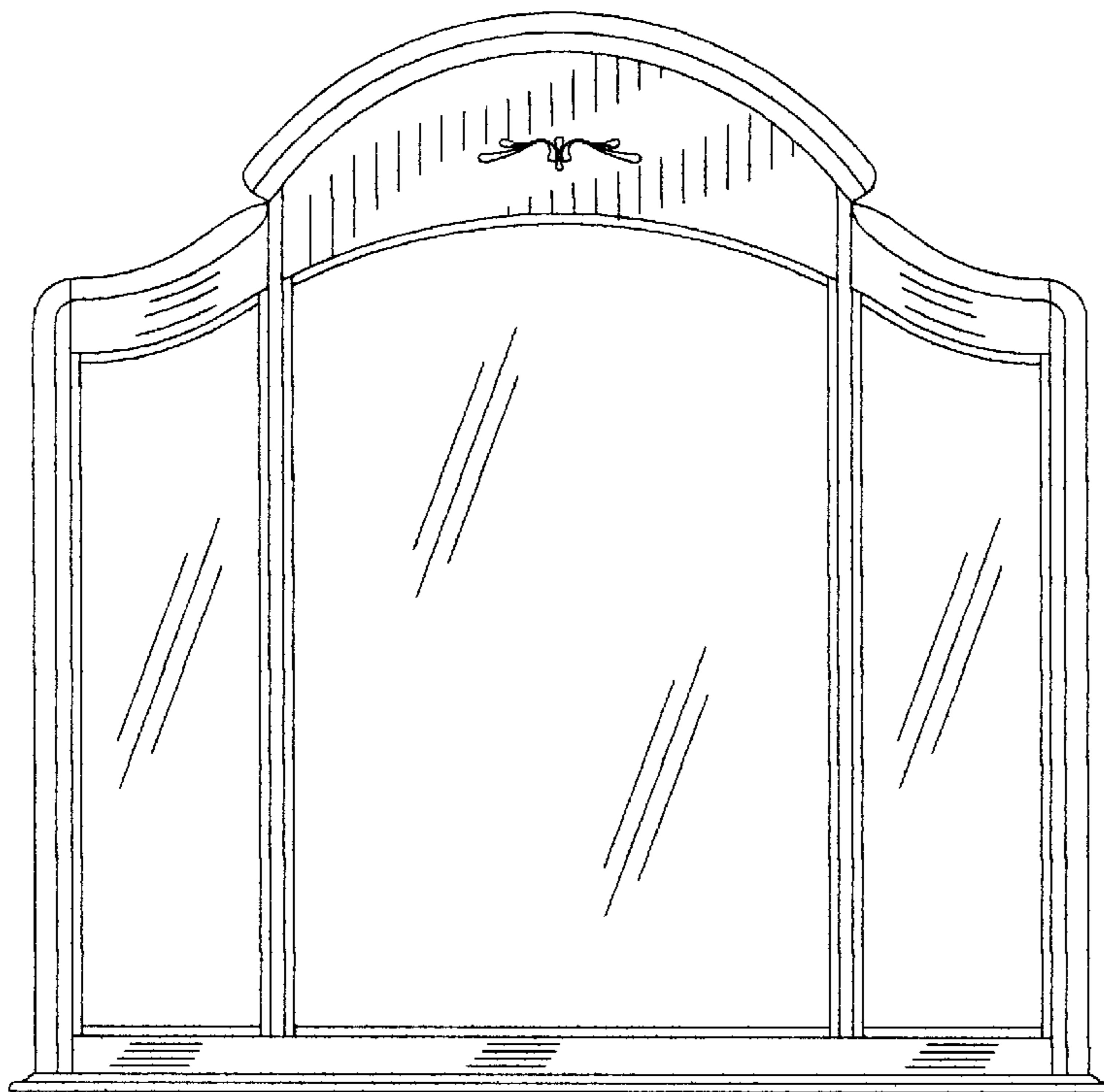

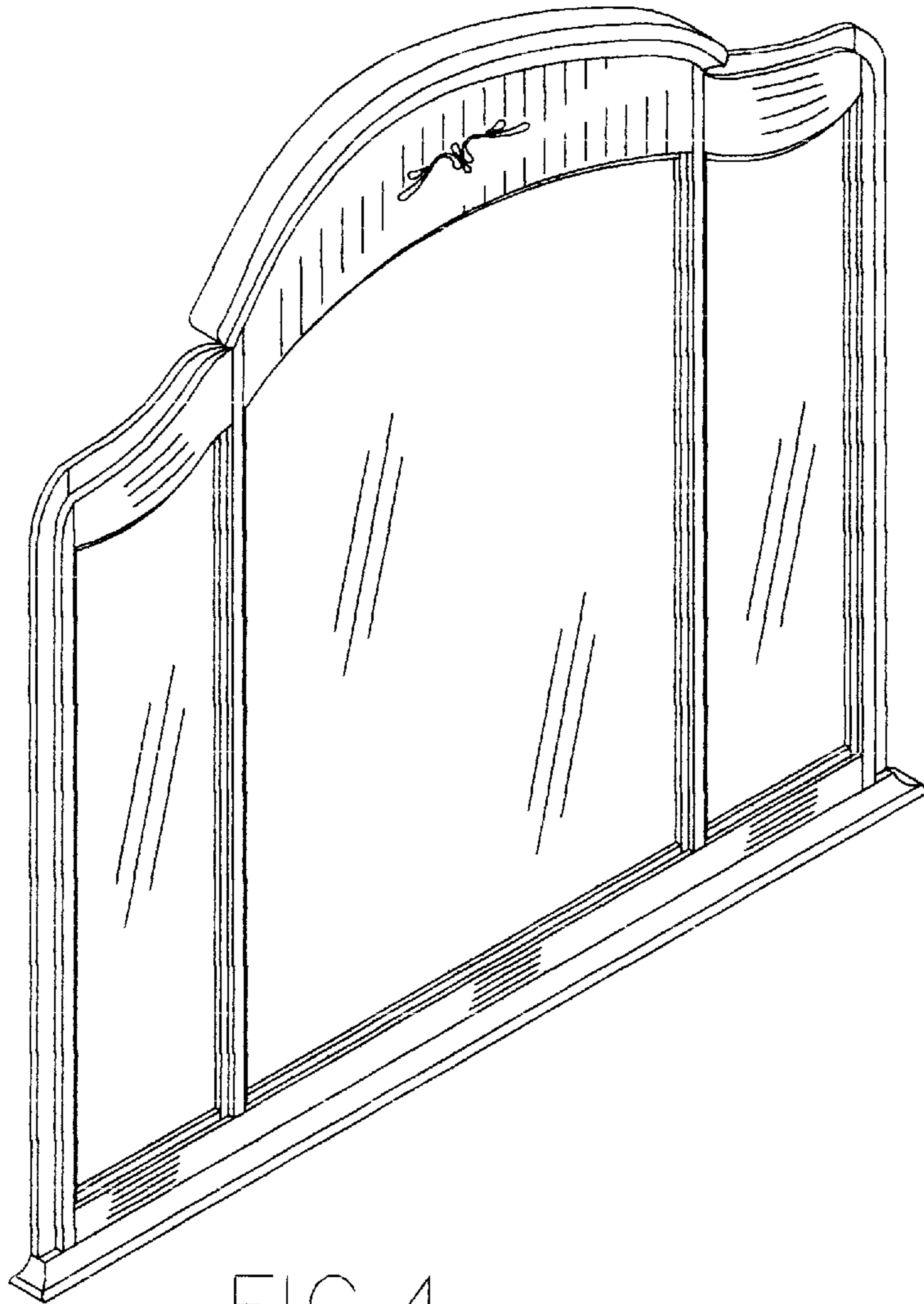
