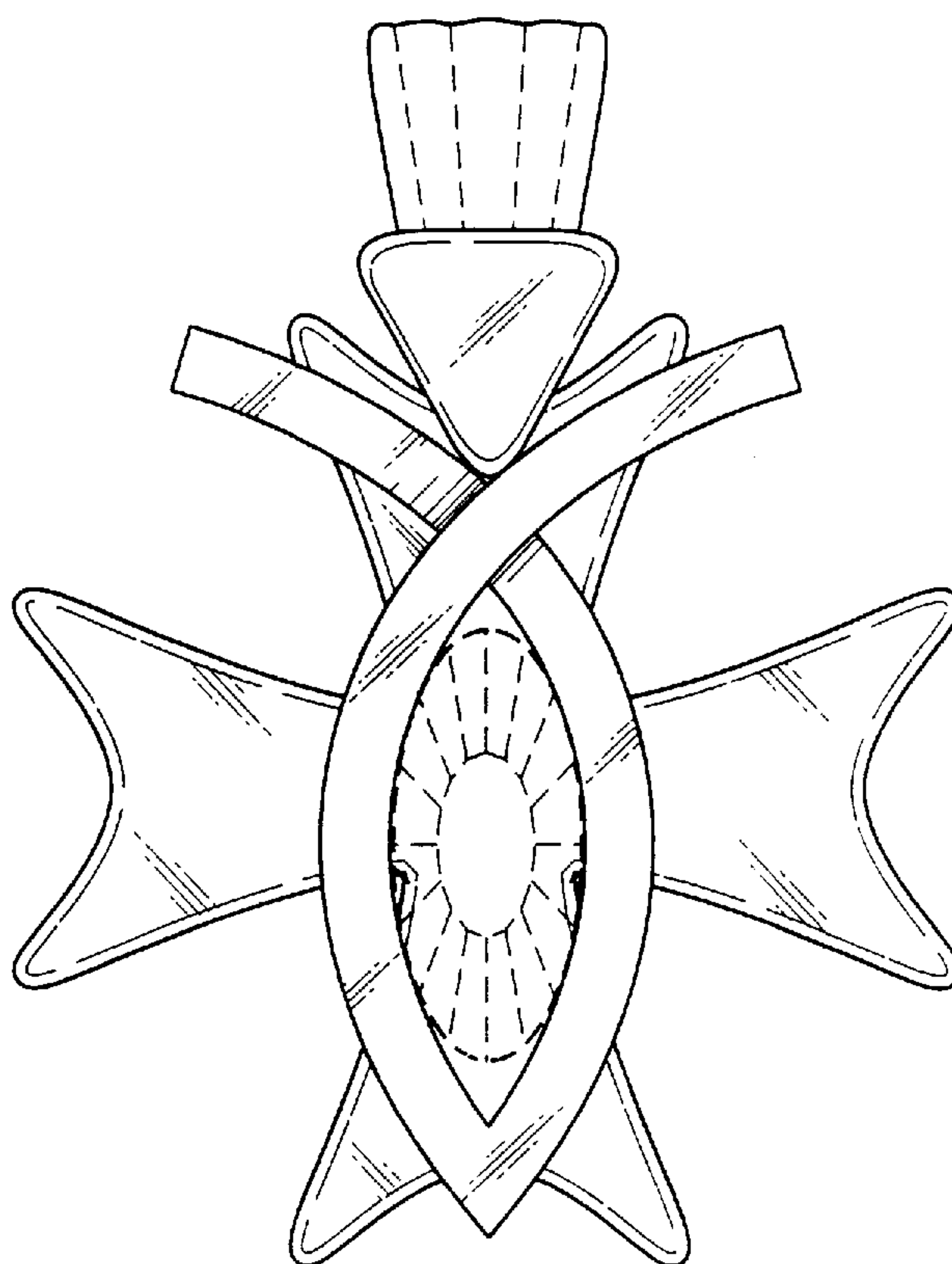
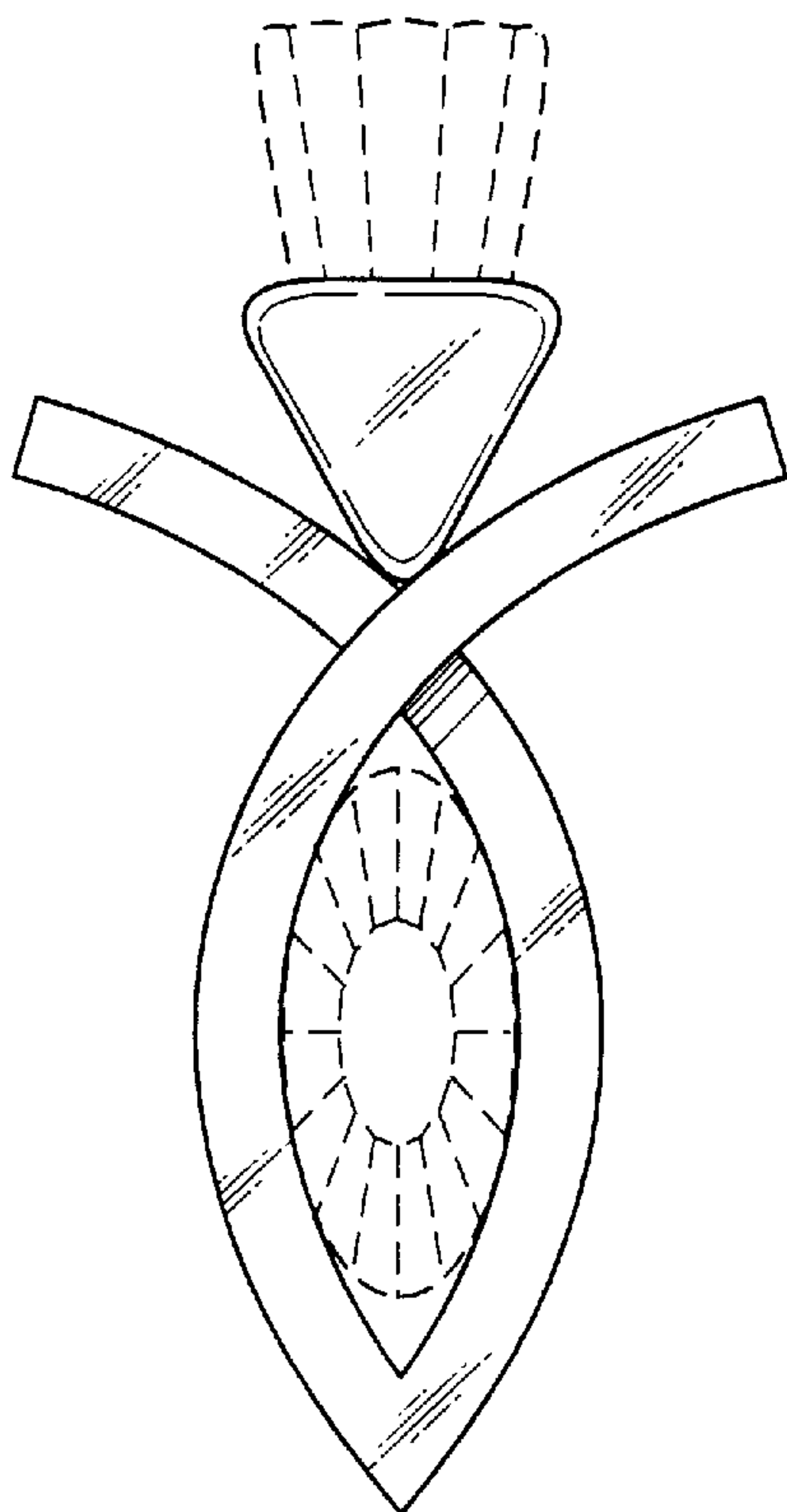
The ornamental design for a jewelry charm, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a jewelry charm showing my new design;

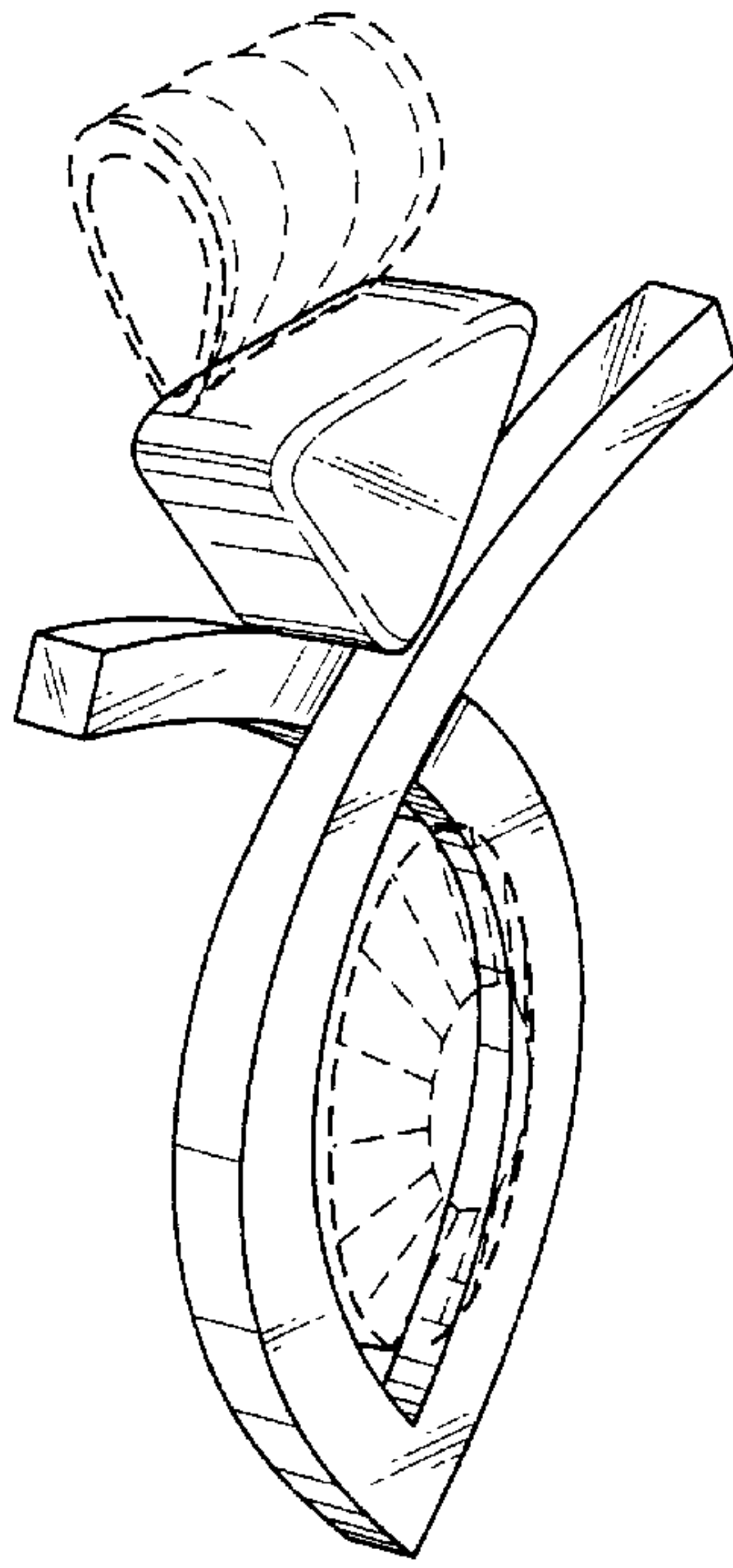

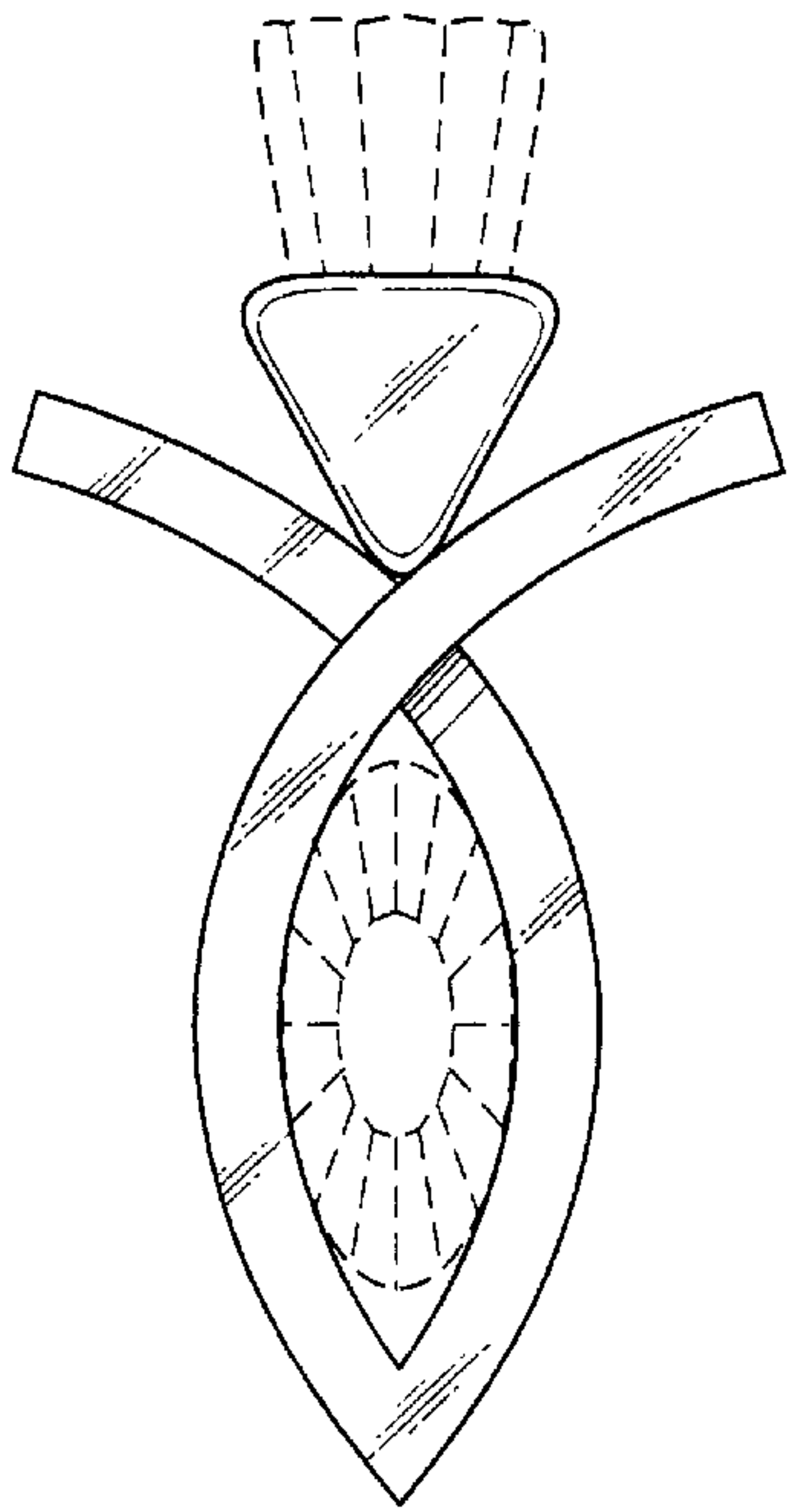

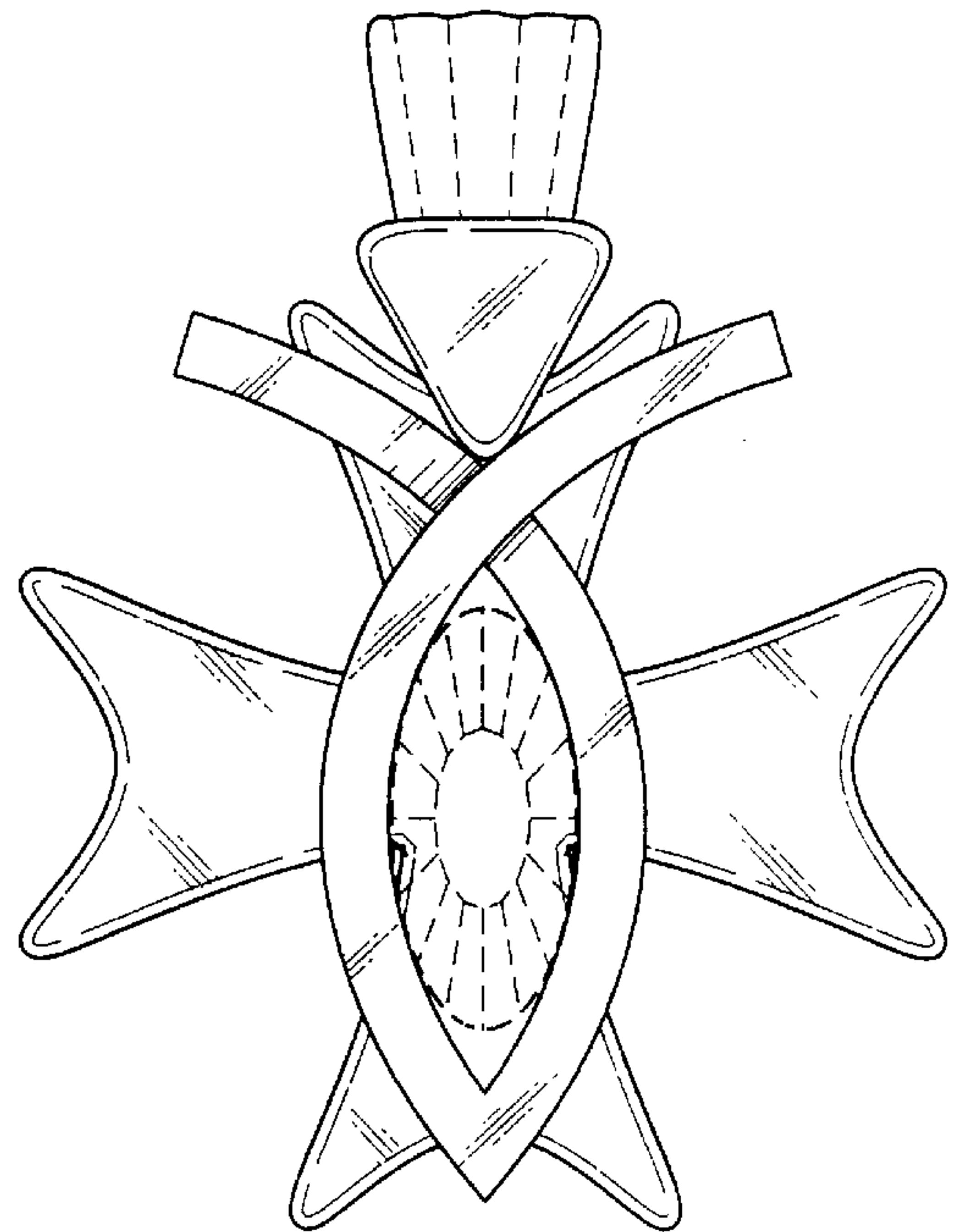

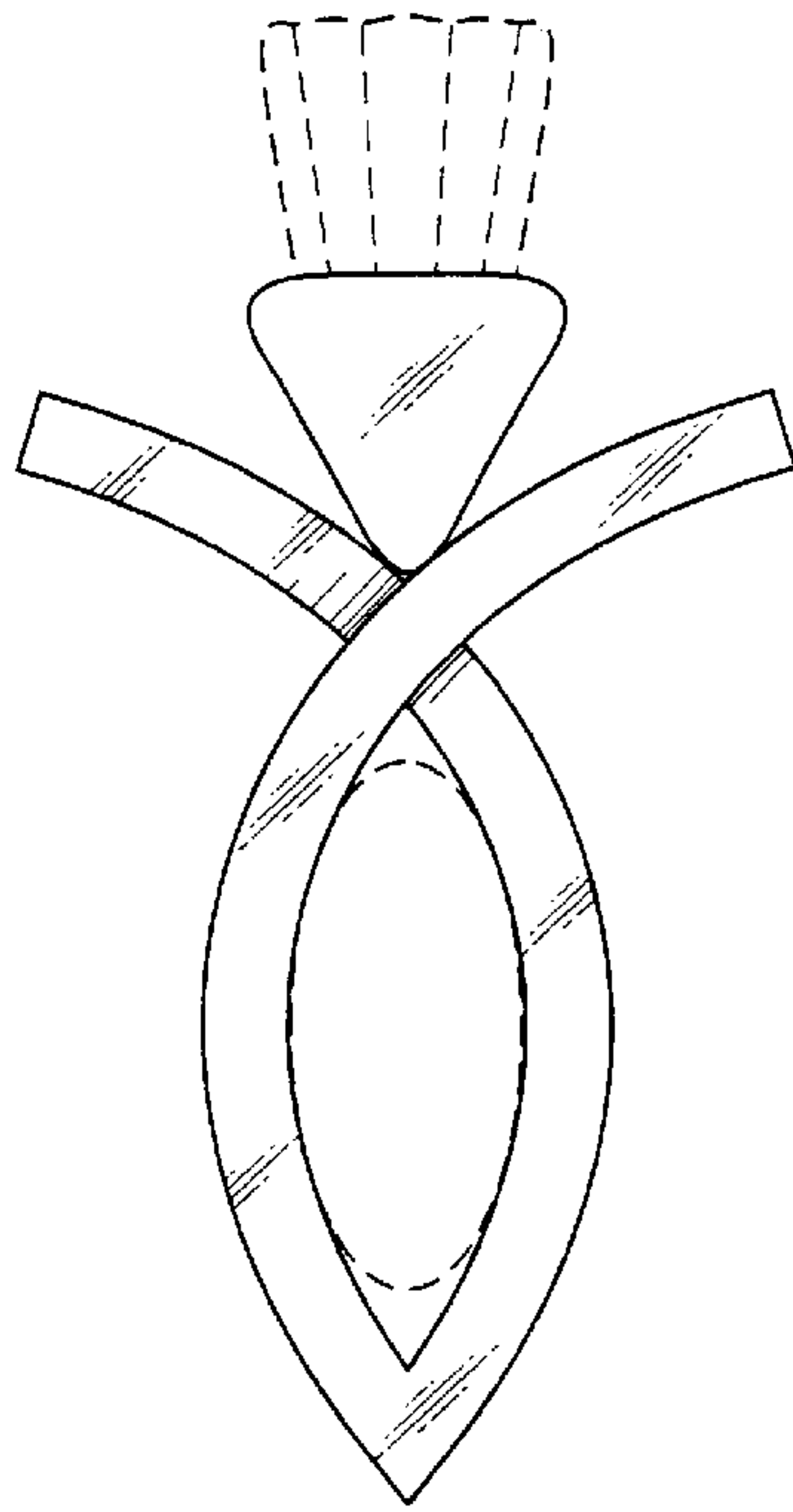

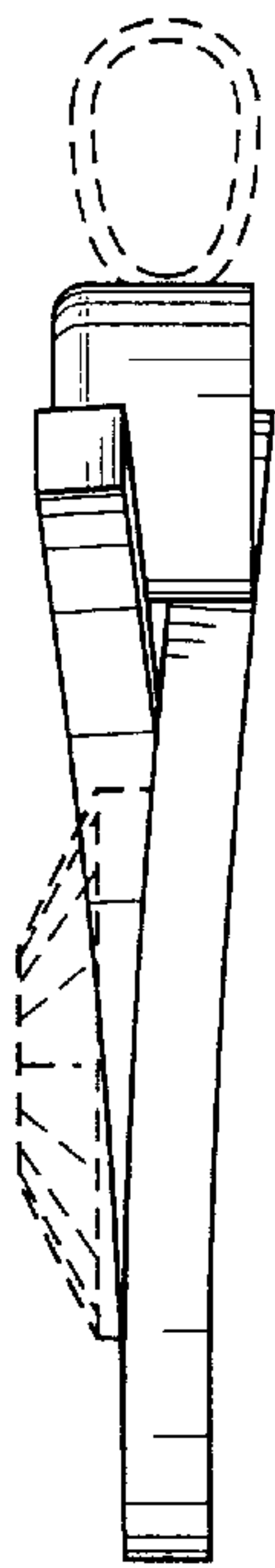

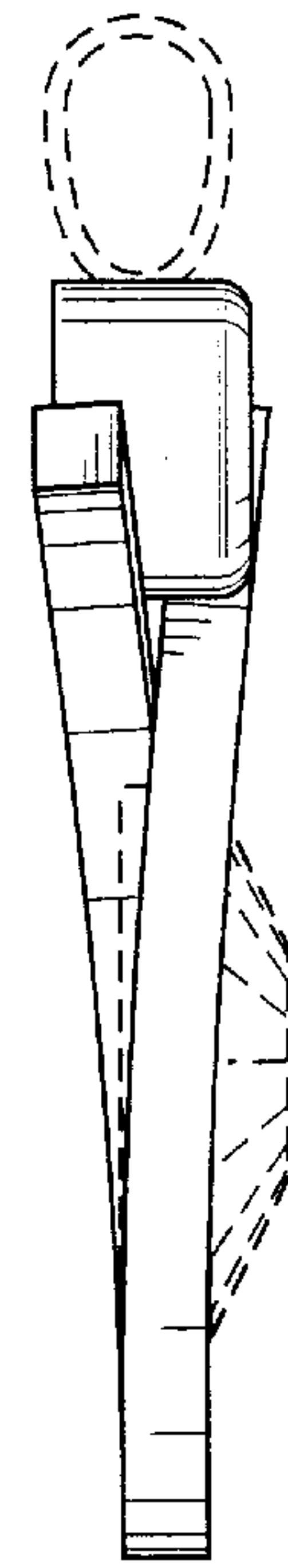

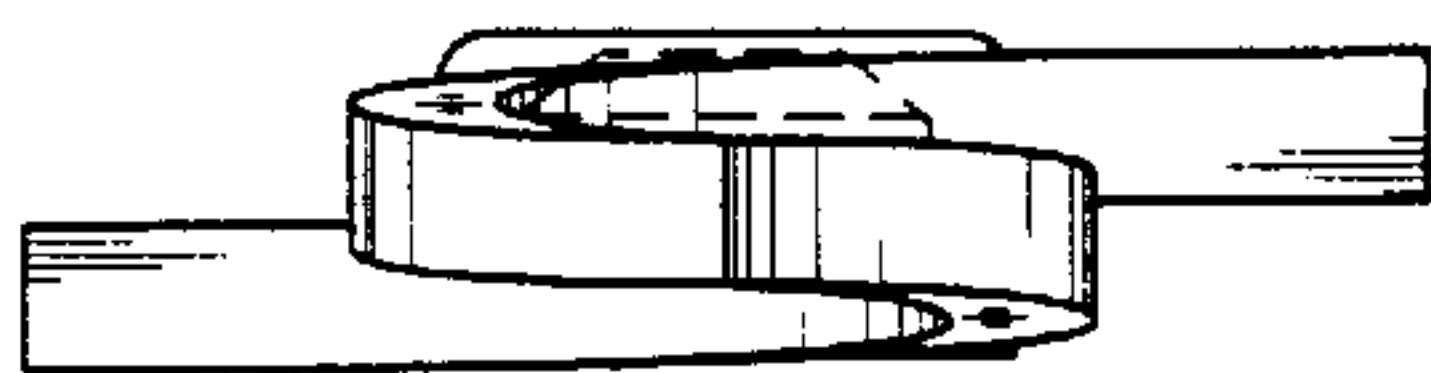
