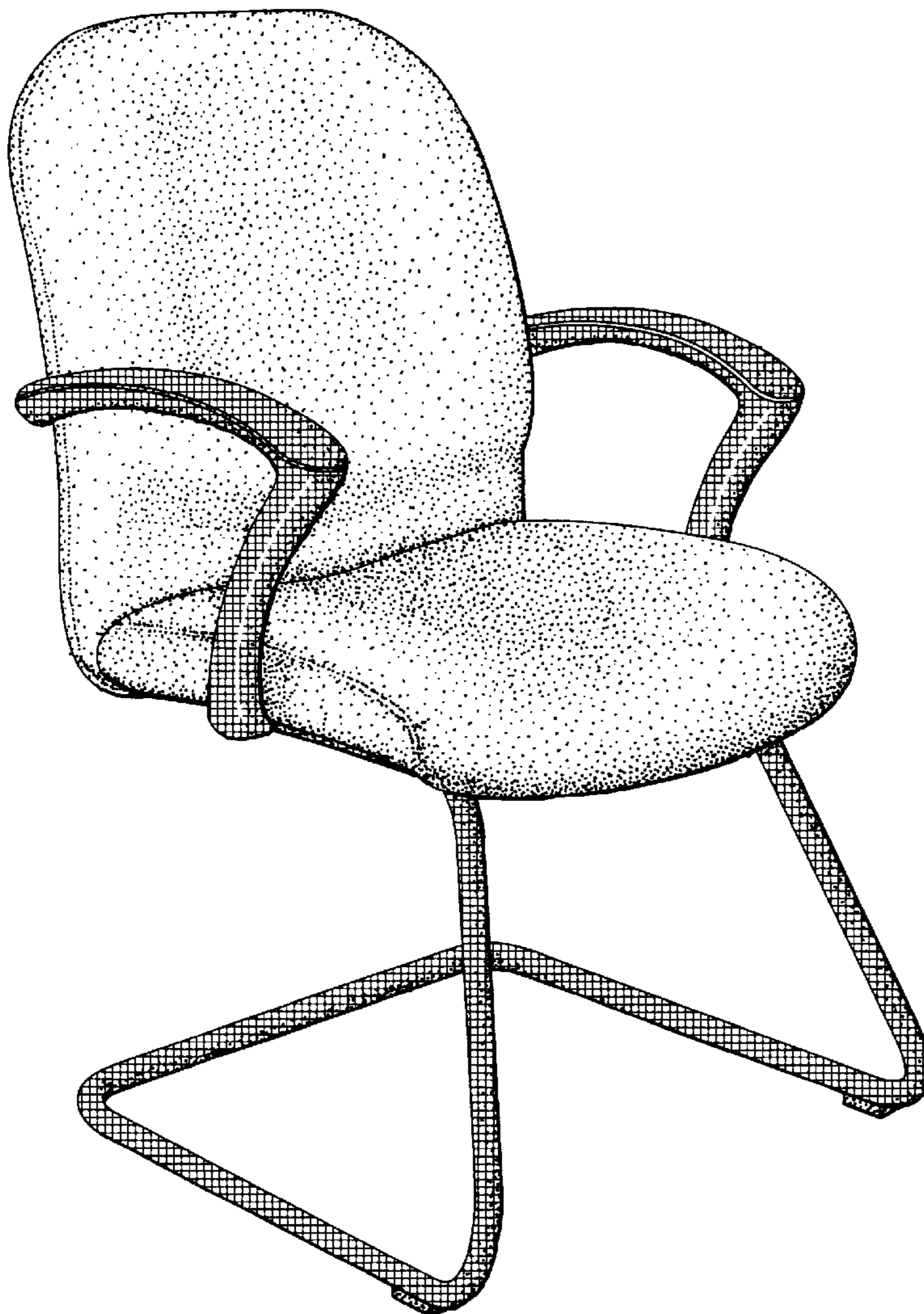
FIG. 1 is a front three-quarter perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

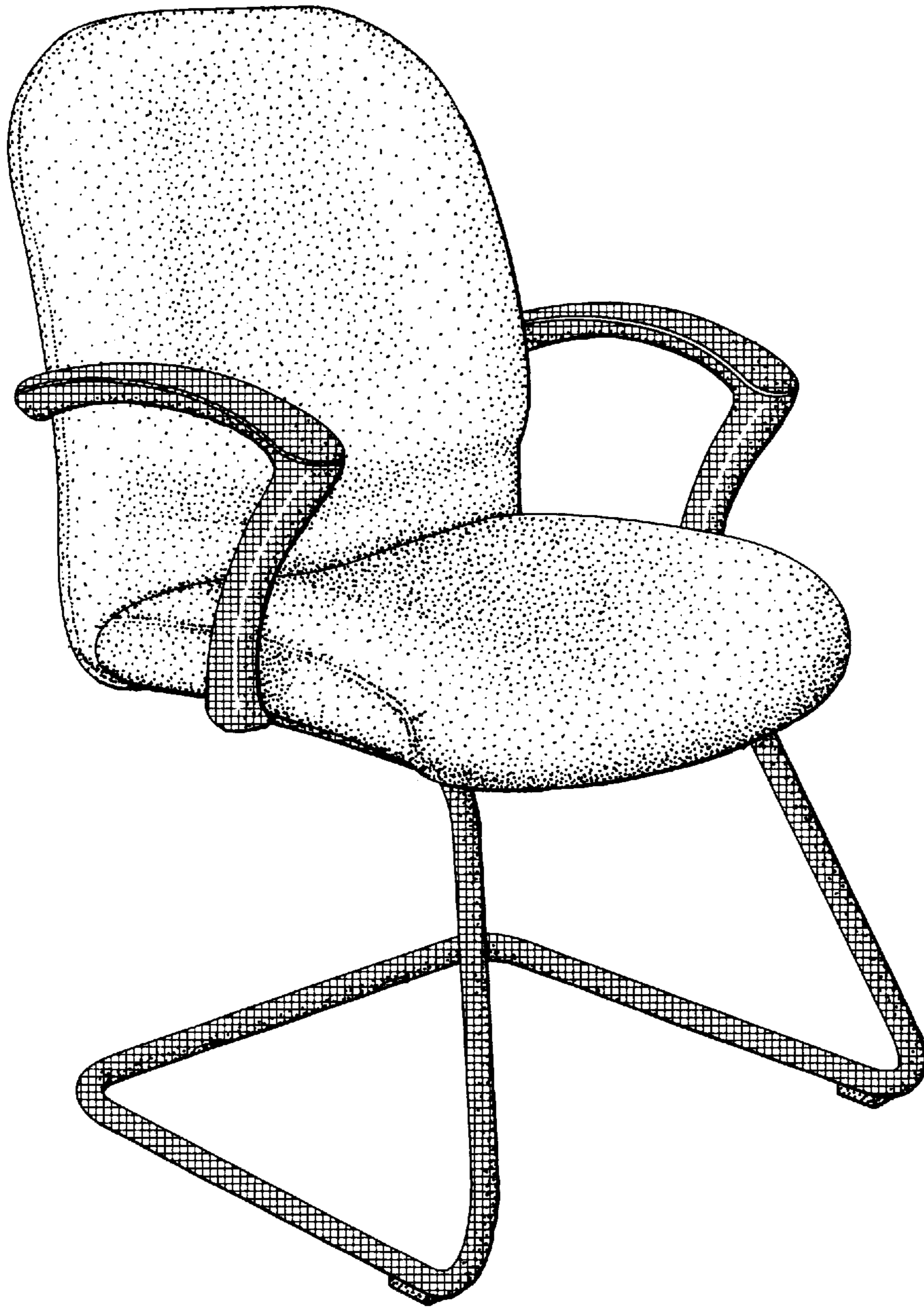

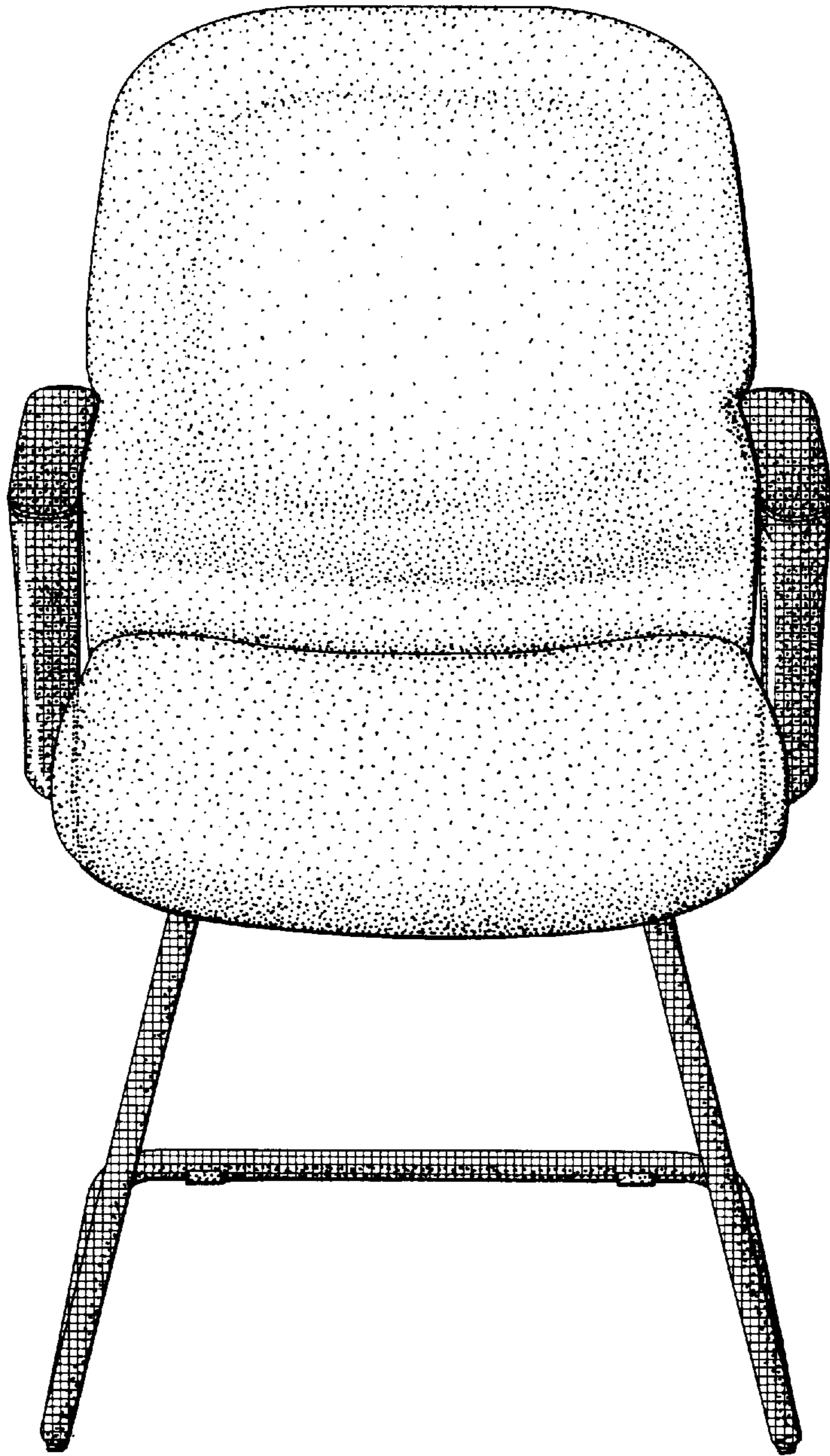

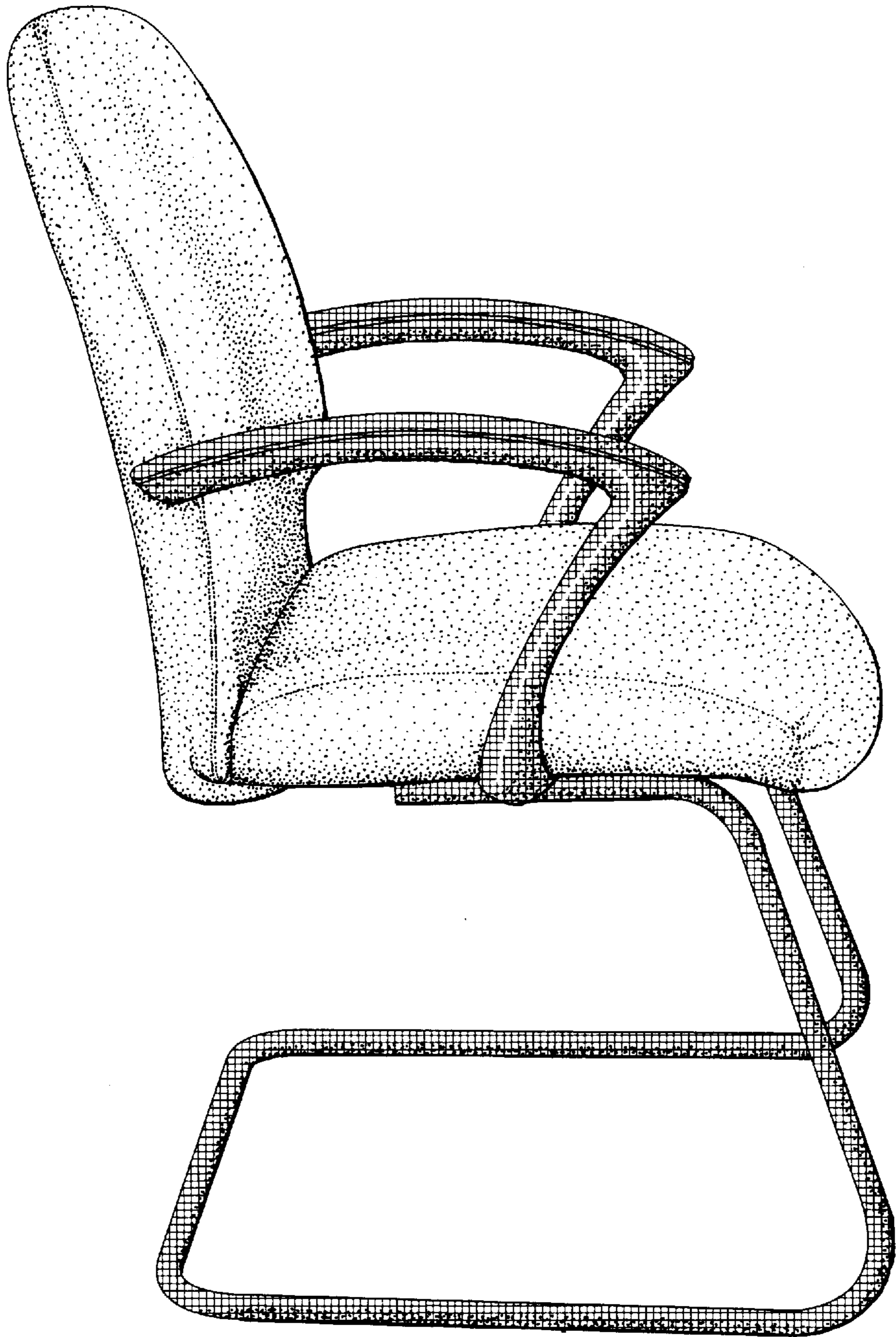

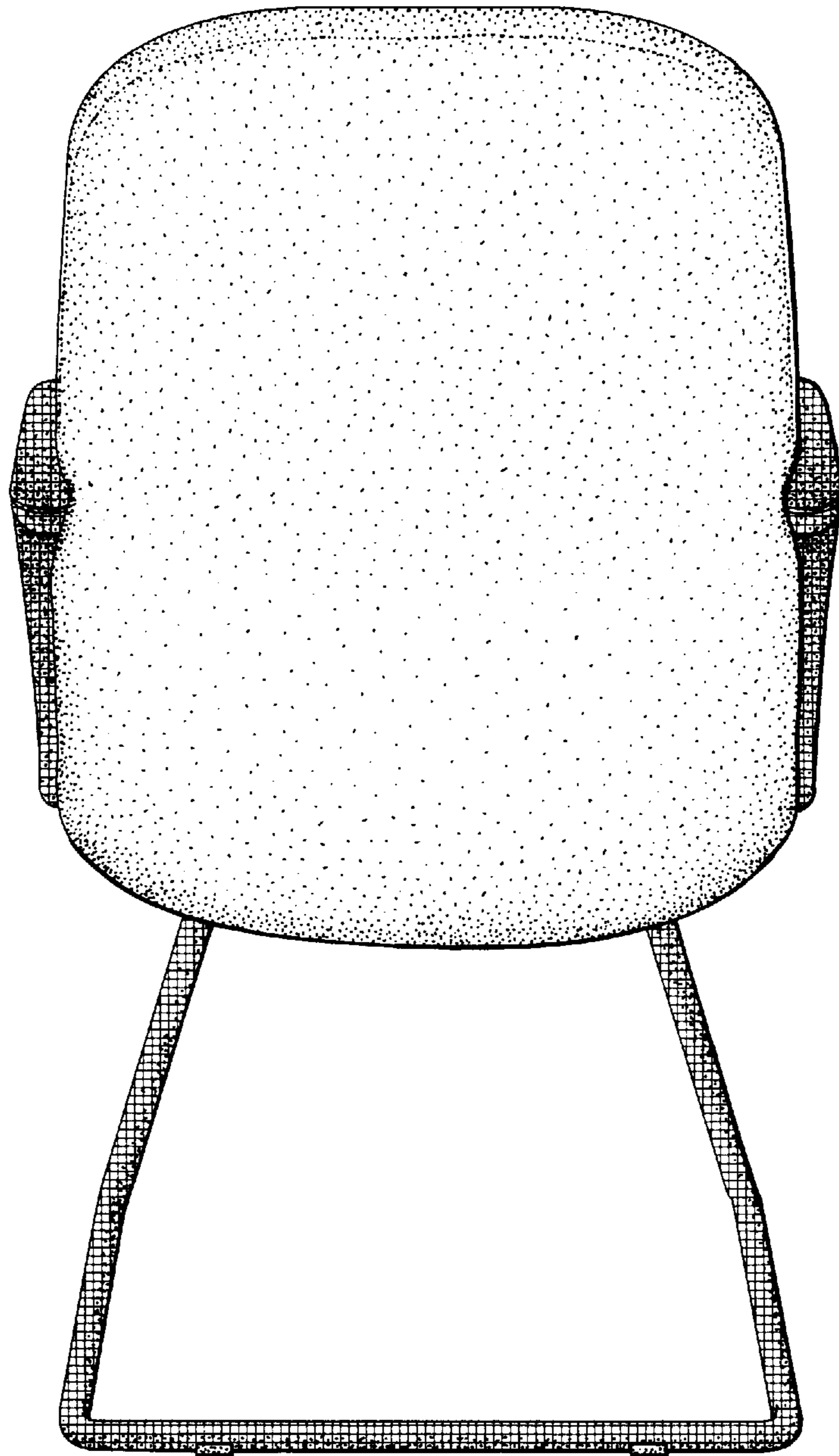

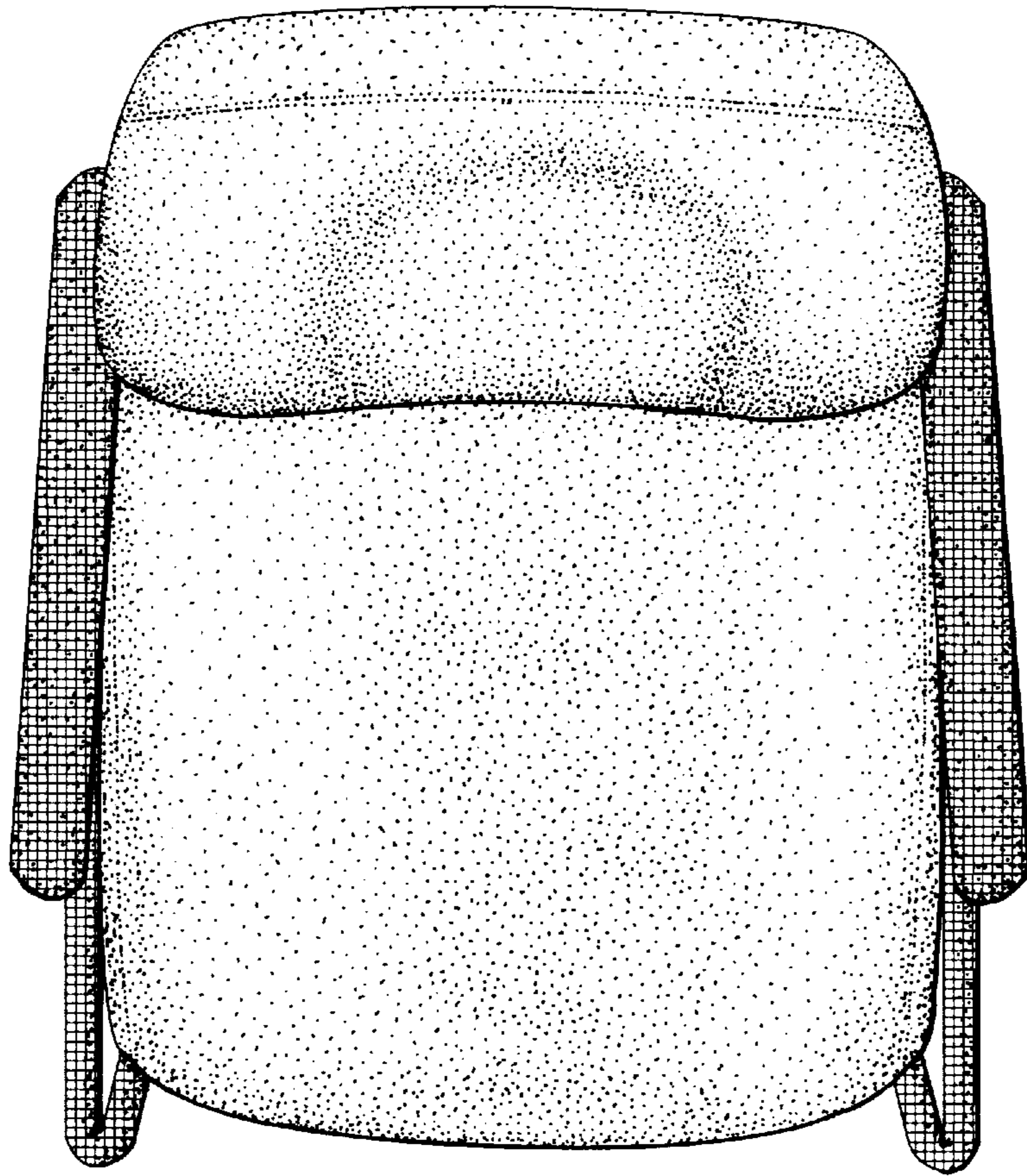

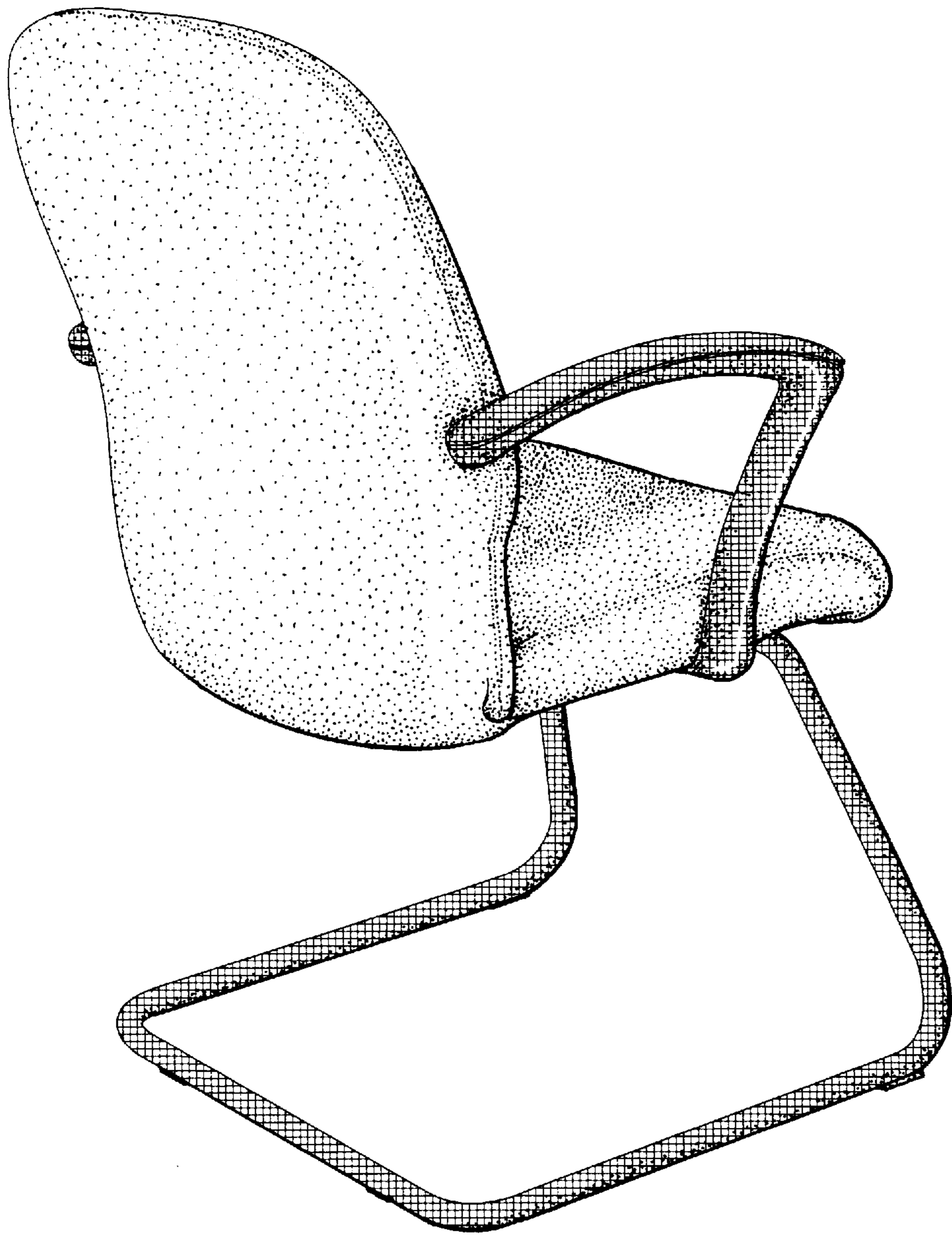
