DESCRIPTION

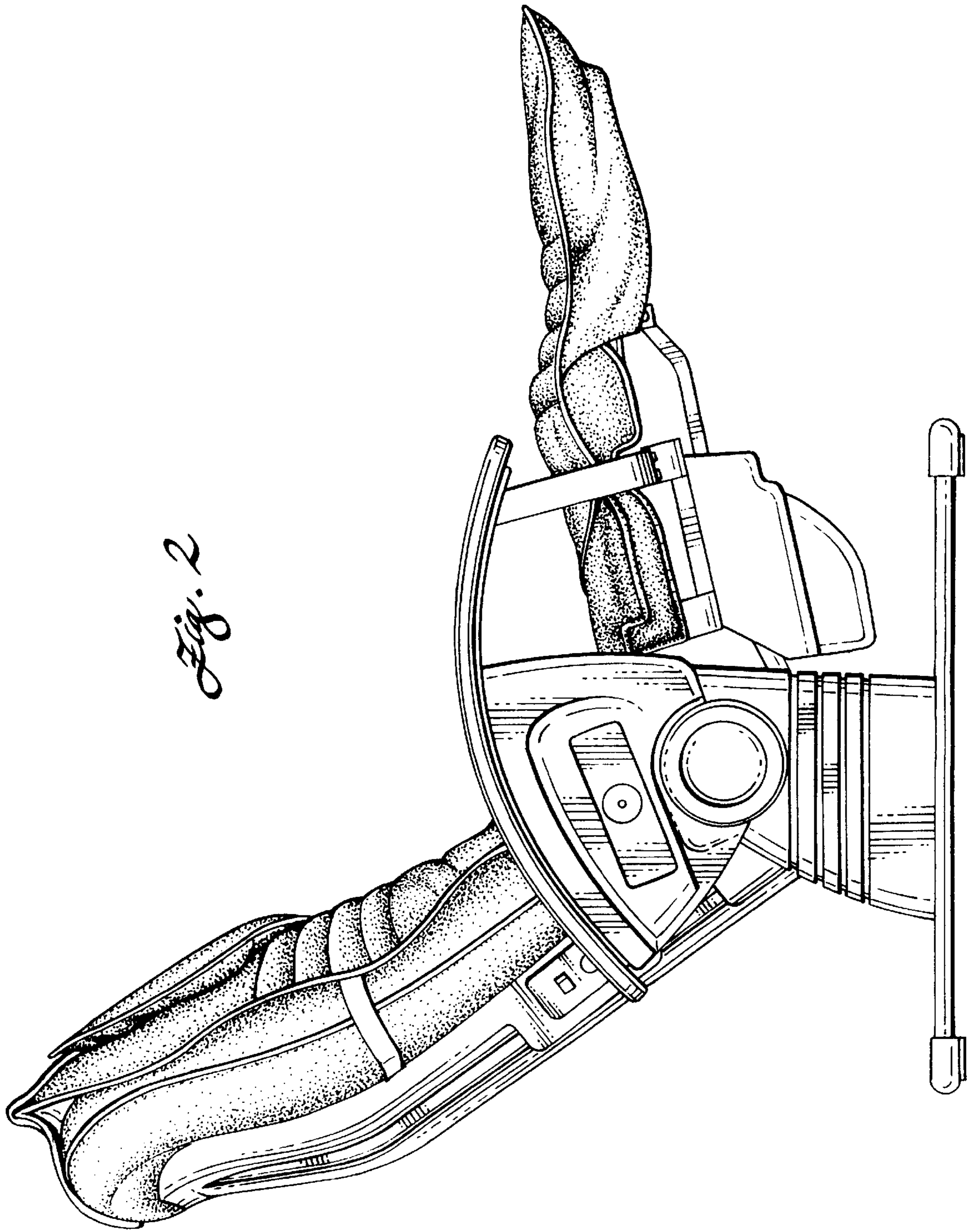
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a presently preferred embodiment of the massage chair;

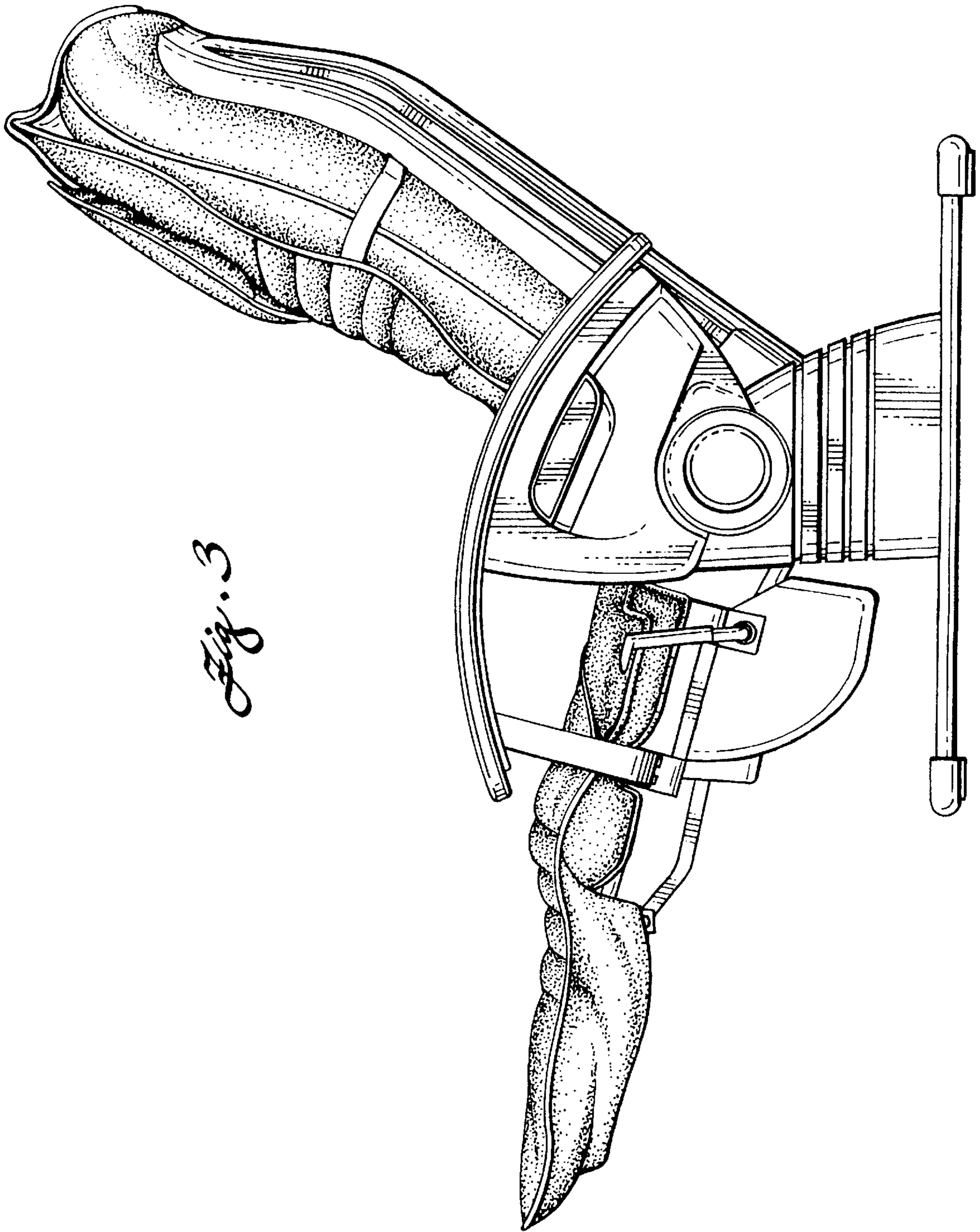

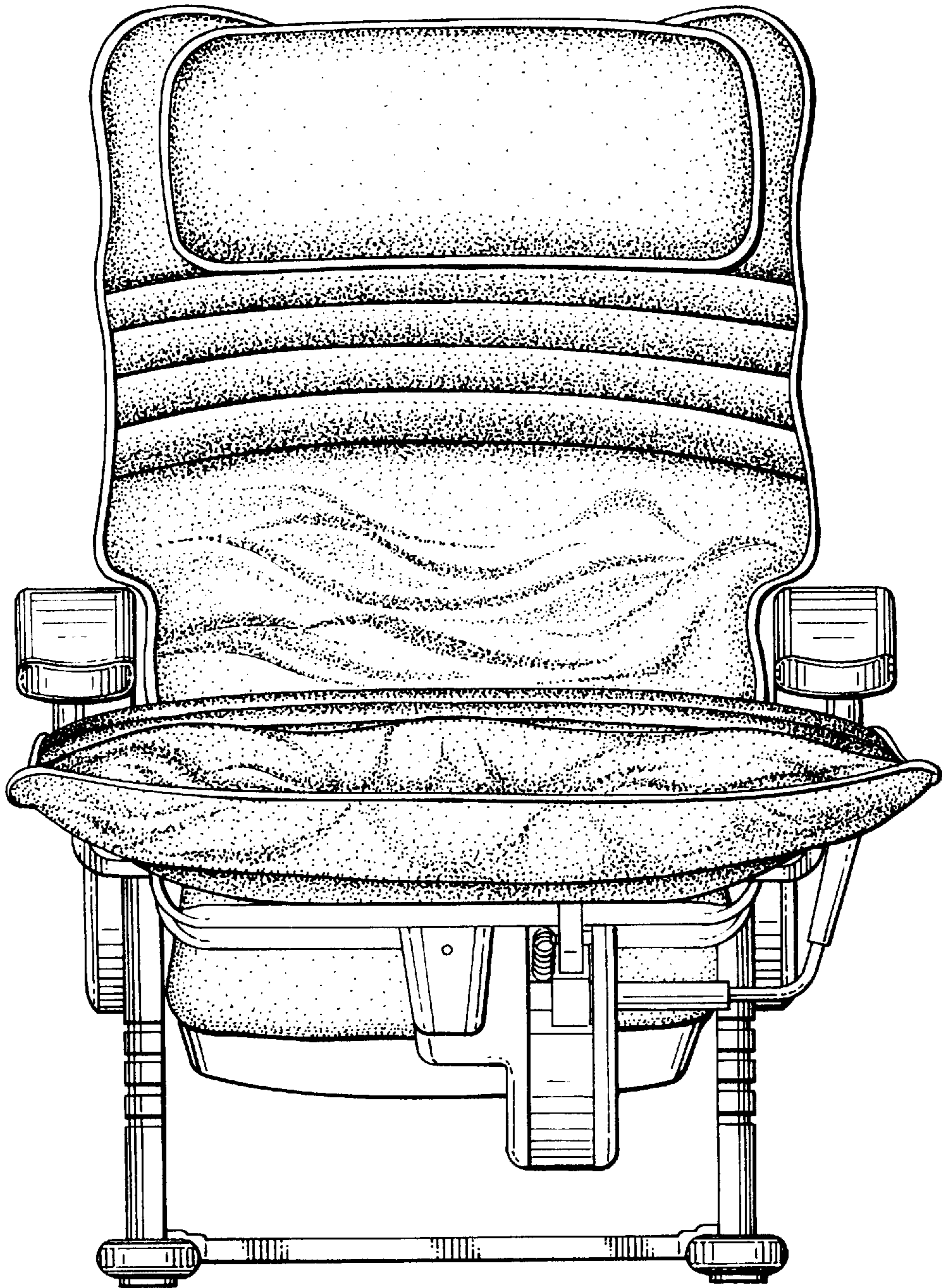

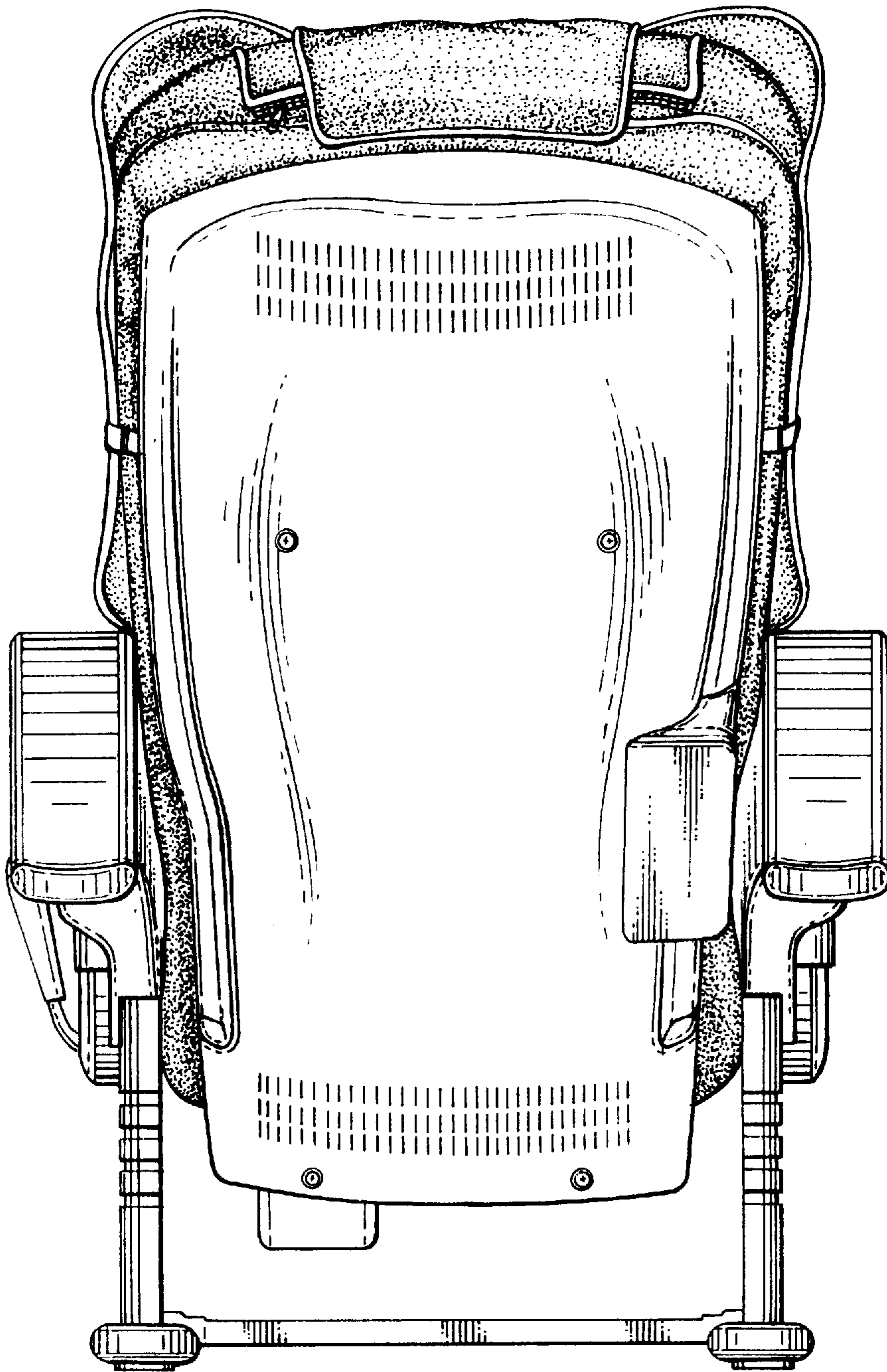
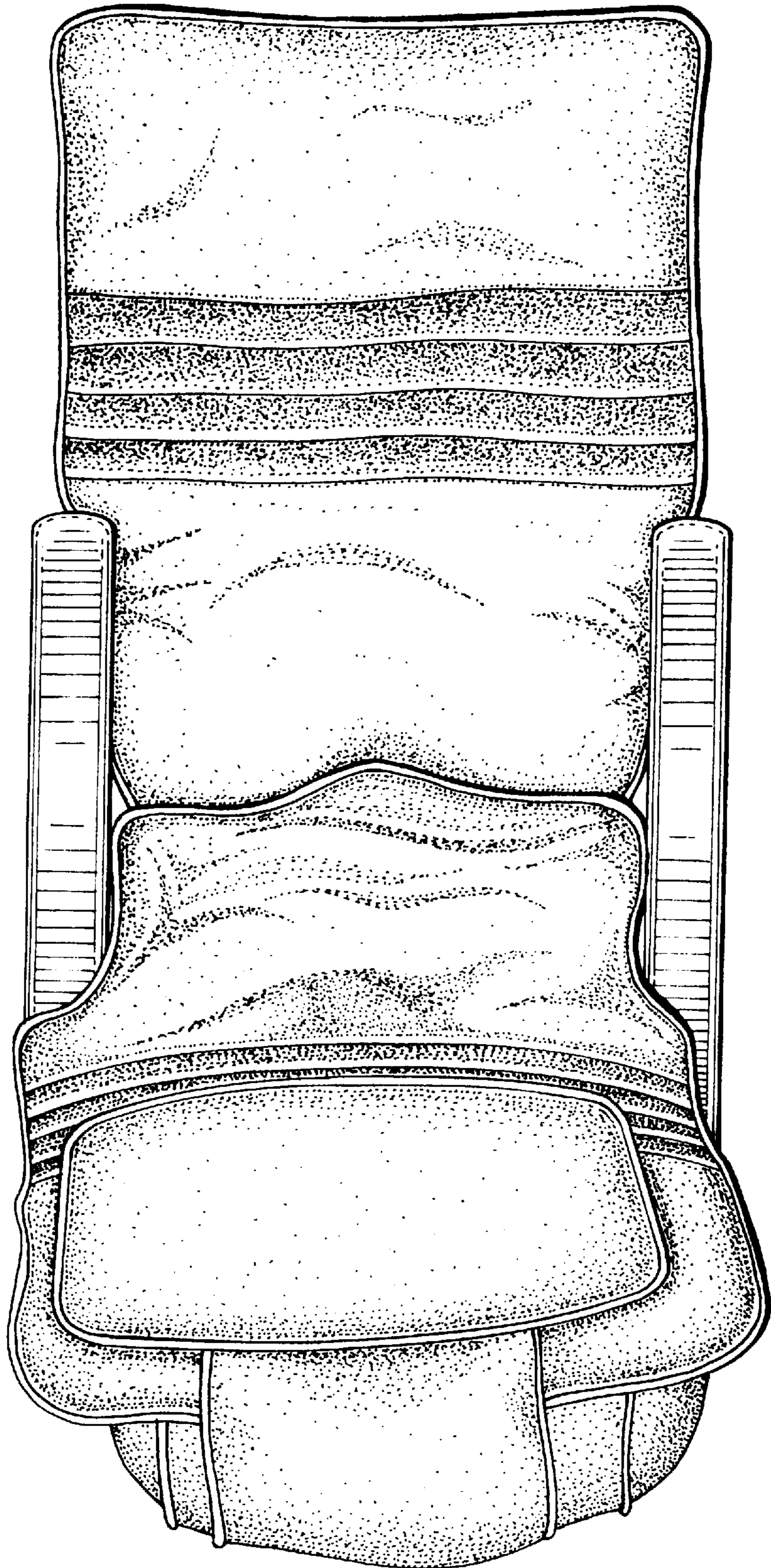

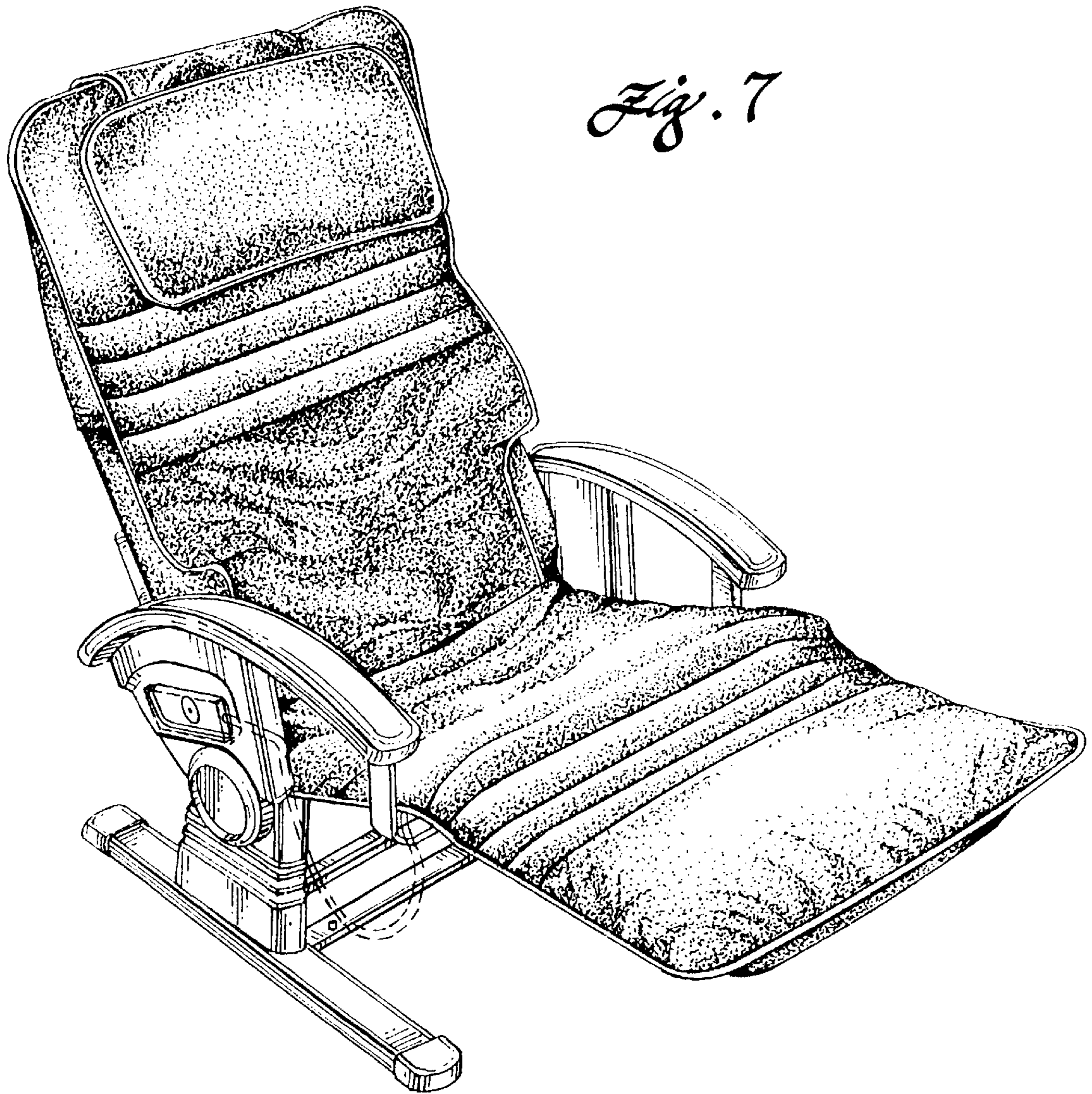
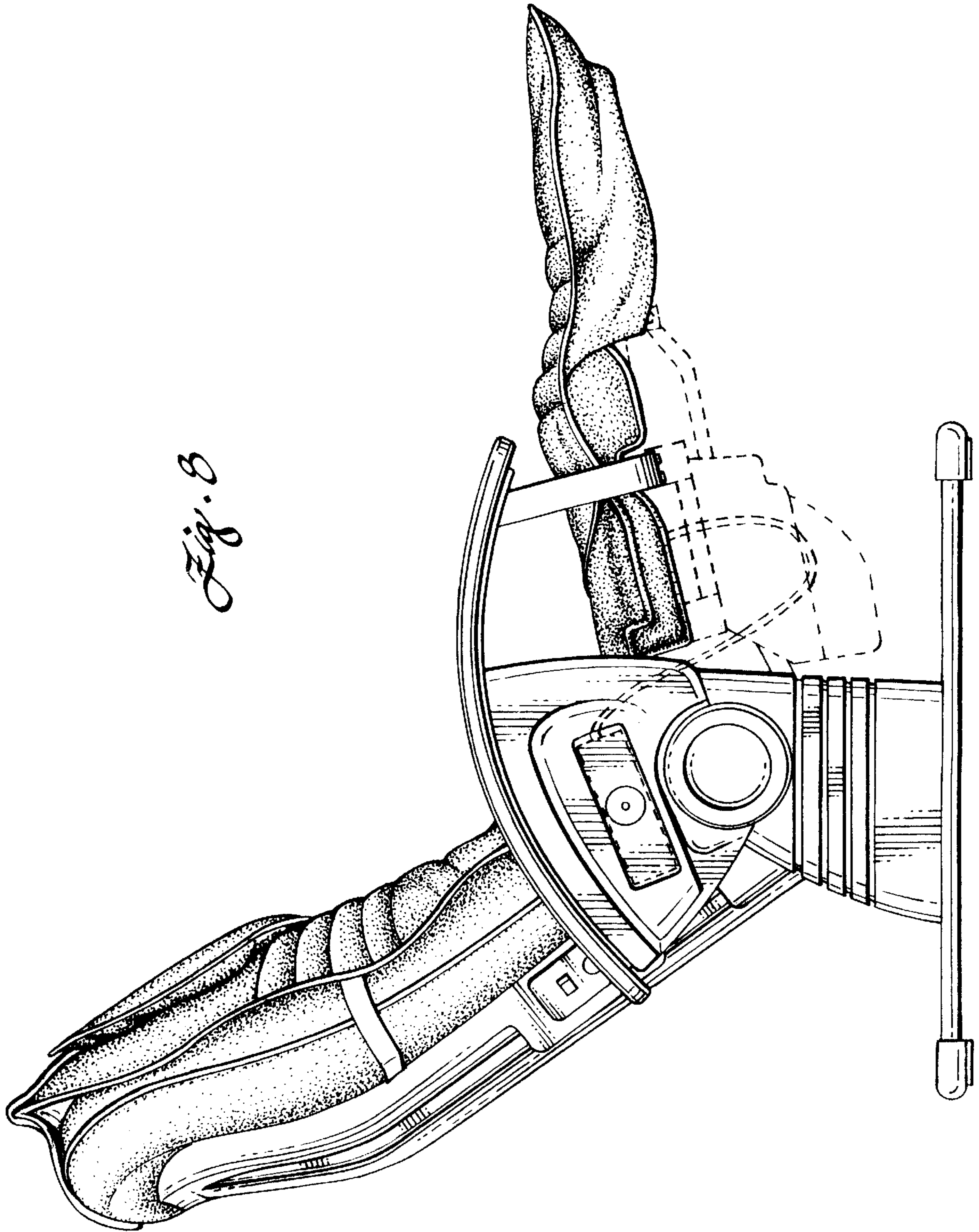

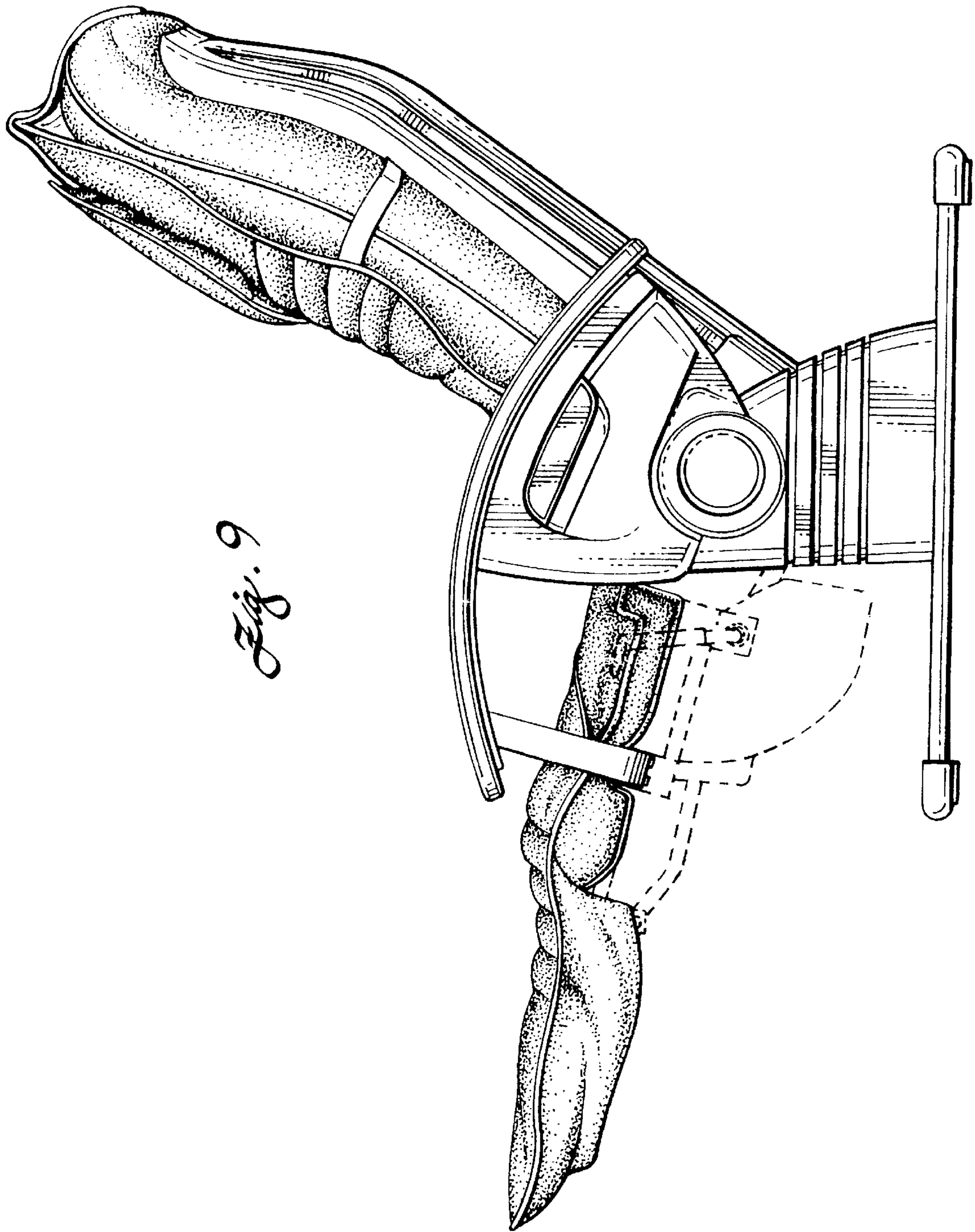

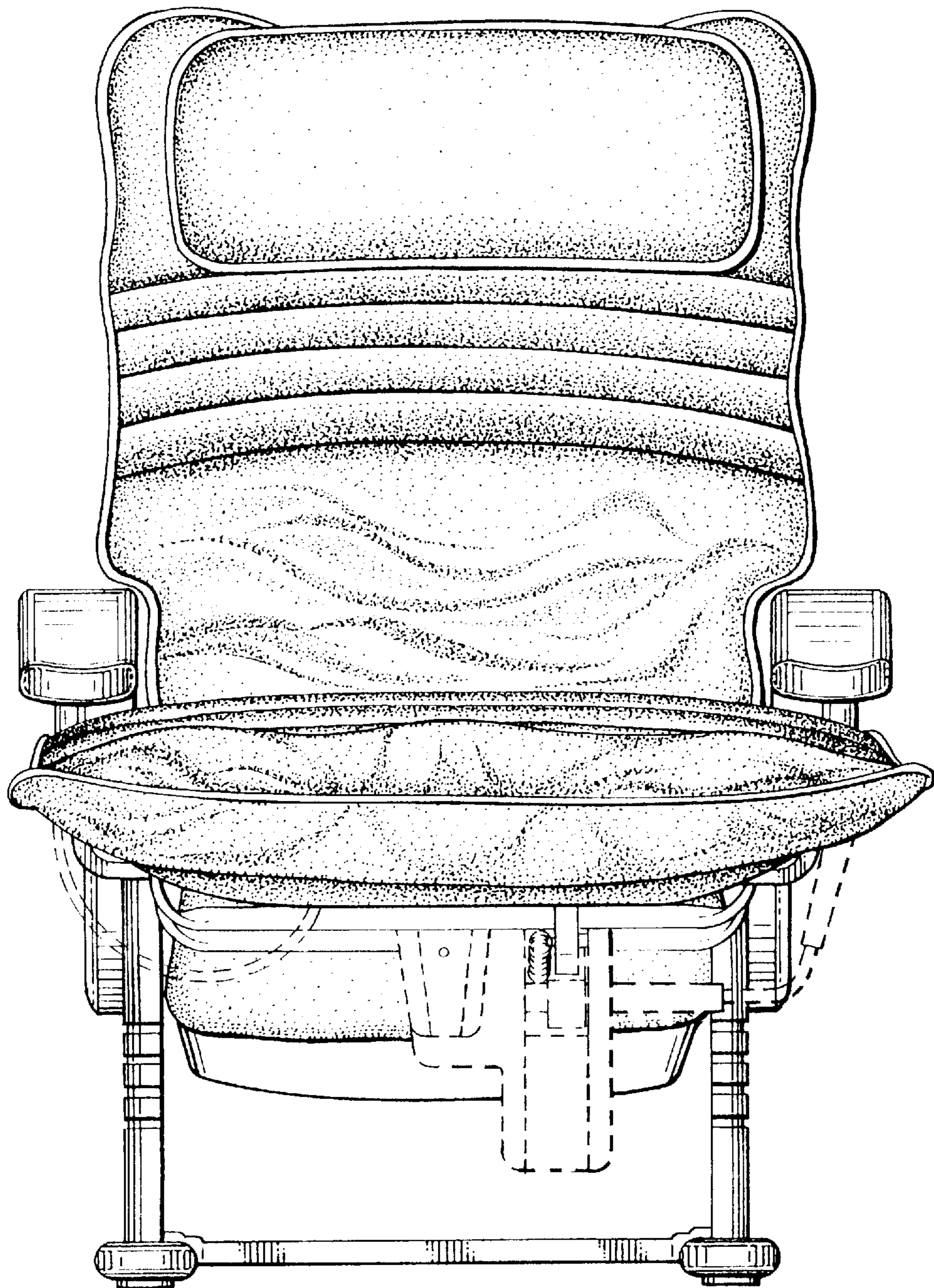
