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[57] CLAIM

We claim the ornamental design for a bail pull for furniture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of our bail pull for furniture;

FIG. 2 is a front view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side view of FIG. 1, the side opposite being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 in FIG. 2, which shows the design of the mounting area;

FIG. 5 is a top view of FIG. 1; the bottom being a mirror image;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of our bail pull for furniture, the bail pull having a translucent appearance;

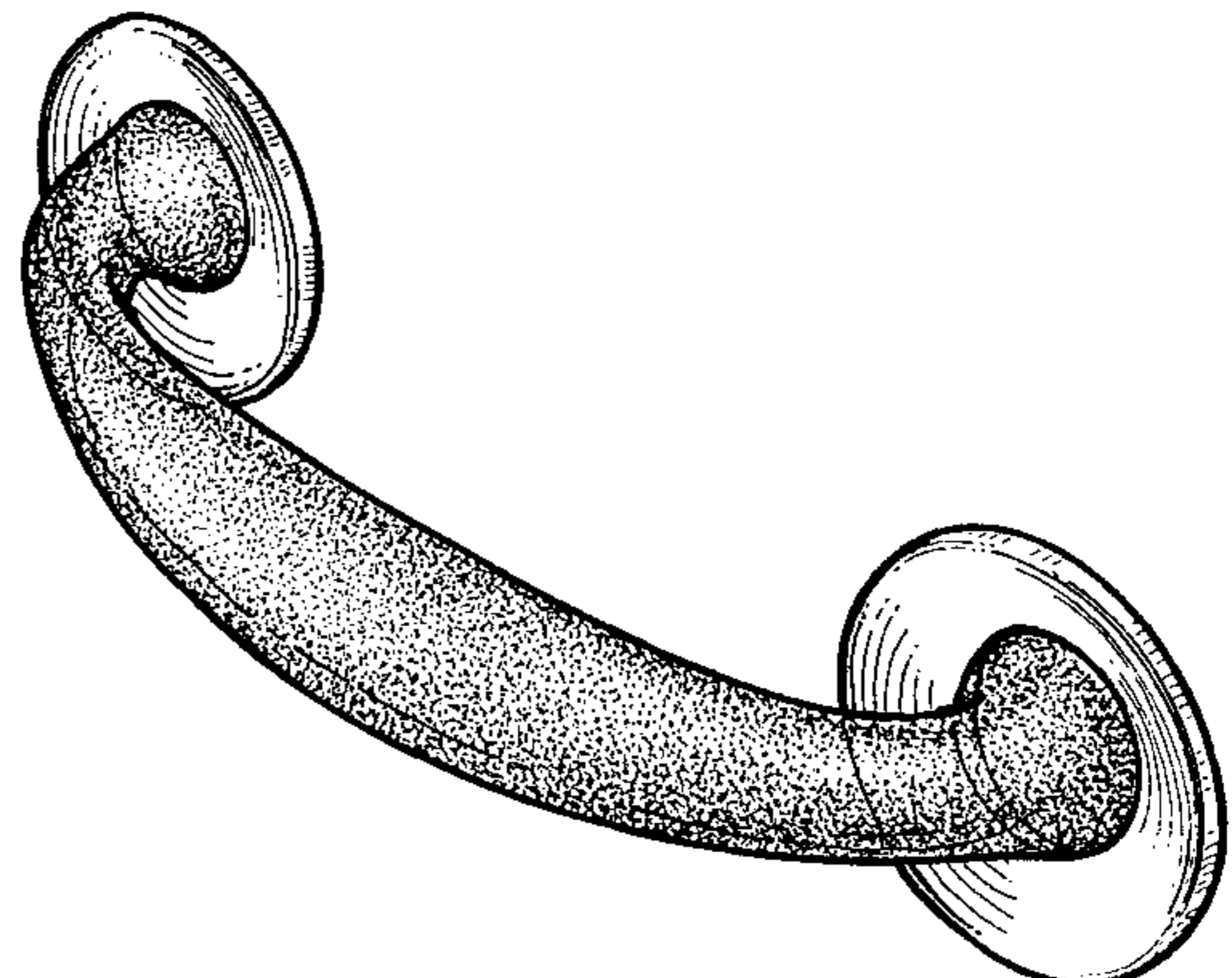
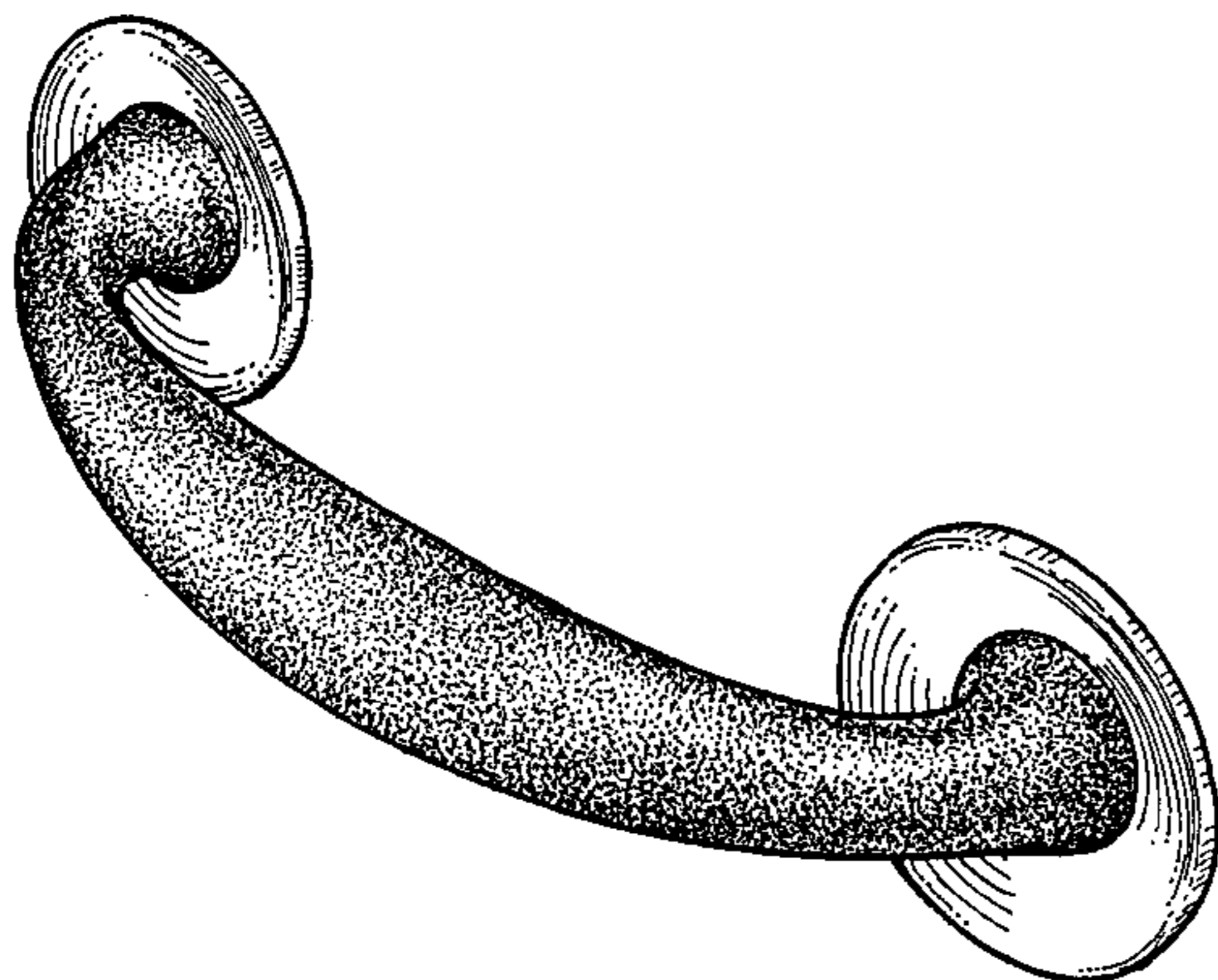
FIG. 7 is a front view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a side view of FIG. 6, the side opposite being a mirror image;

FIG. 9 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 9—9 in FIG. 7, which shows the design of the mounting area; and,

FIG. 10 is a top view of FIG. 6, the bottom being a mirror image.

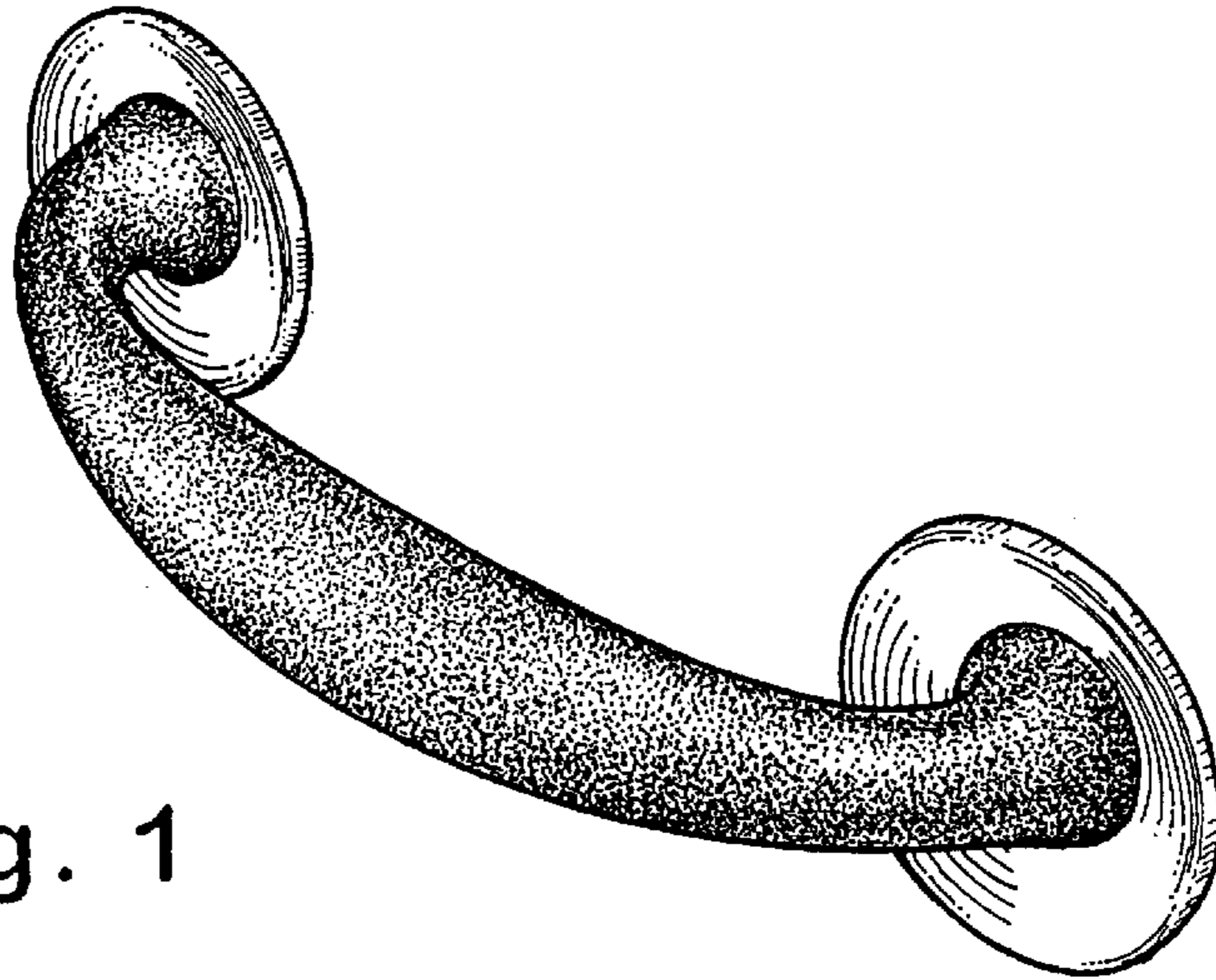

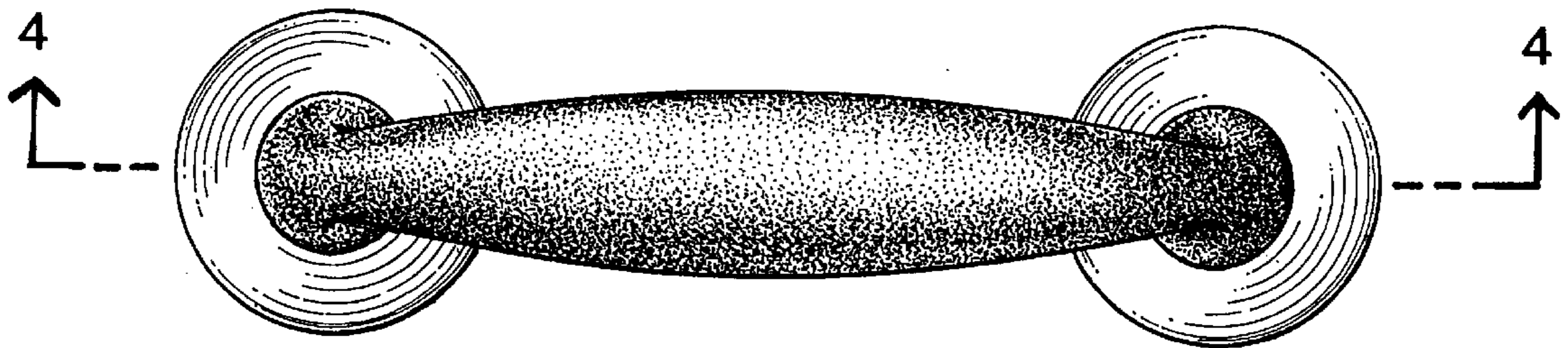

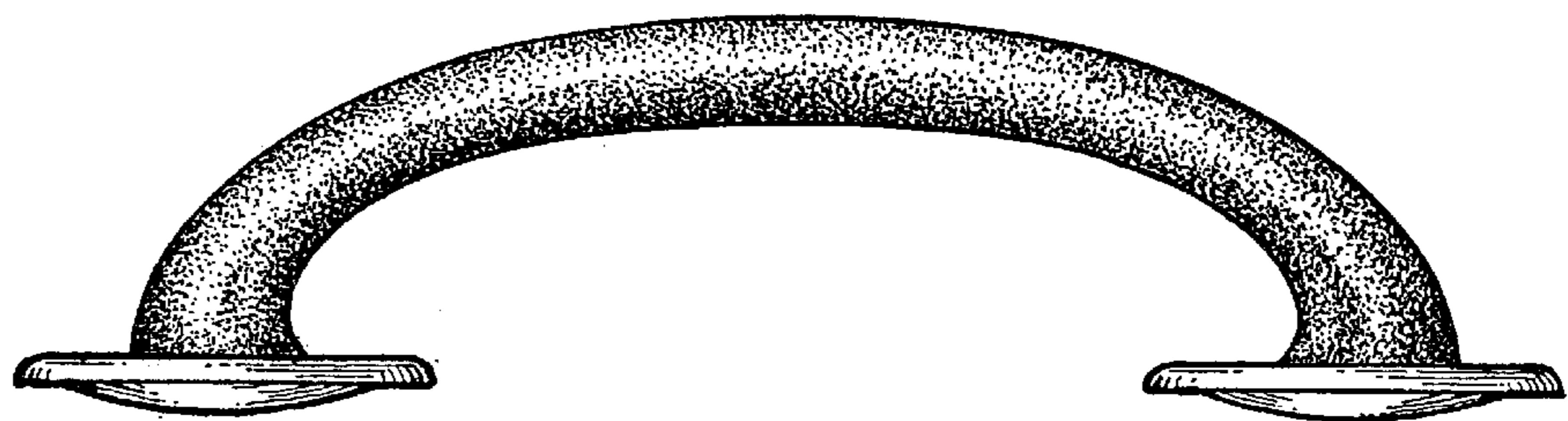

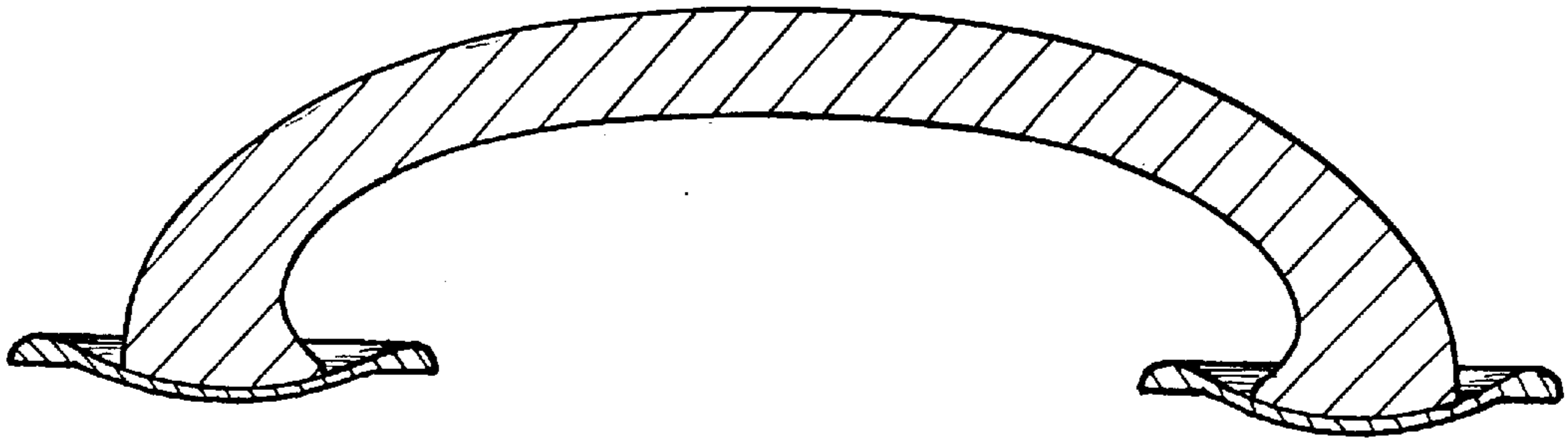

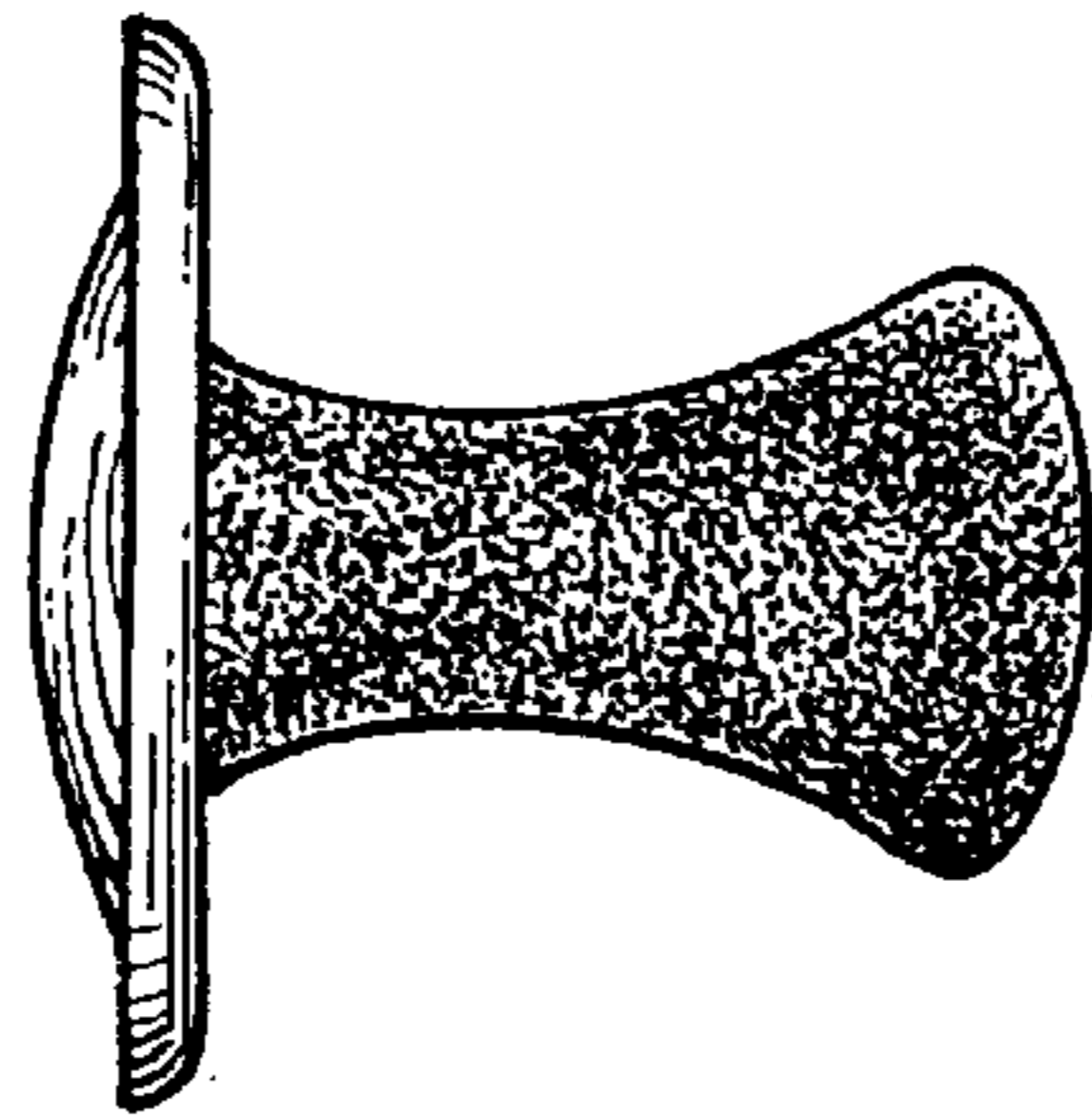

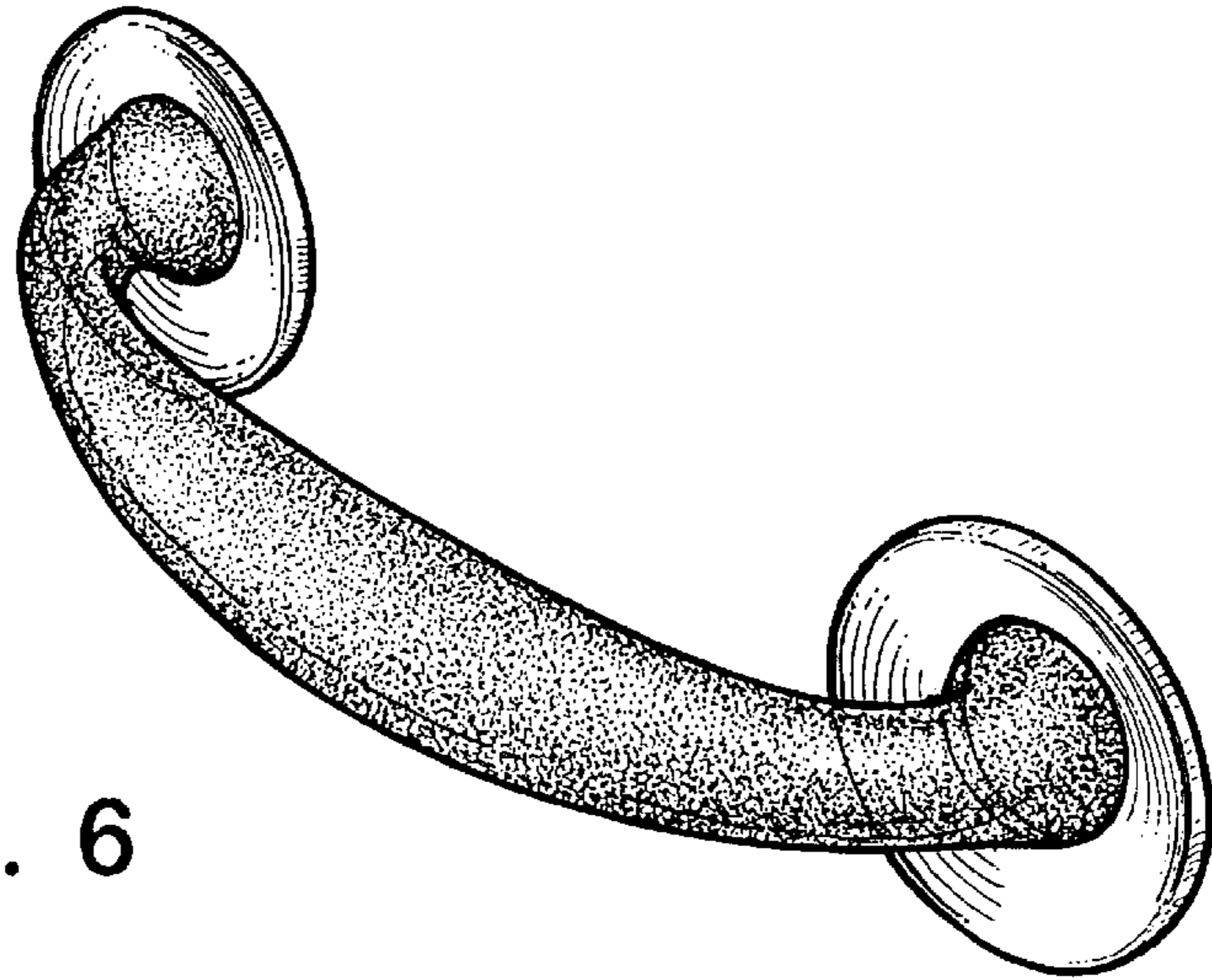

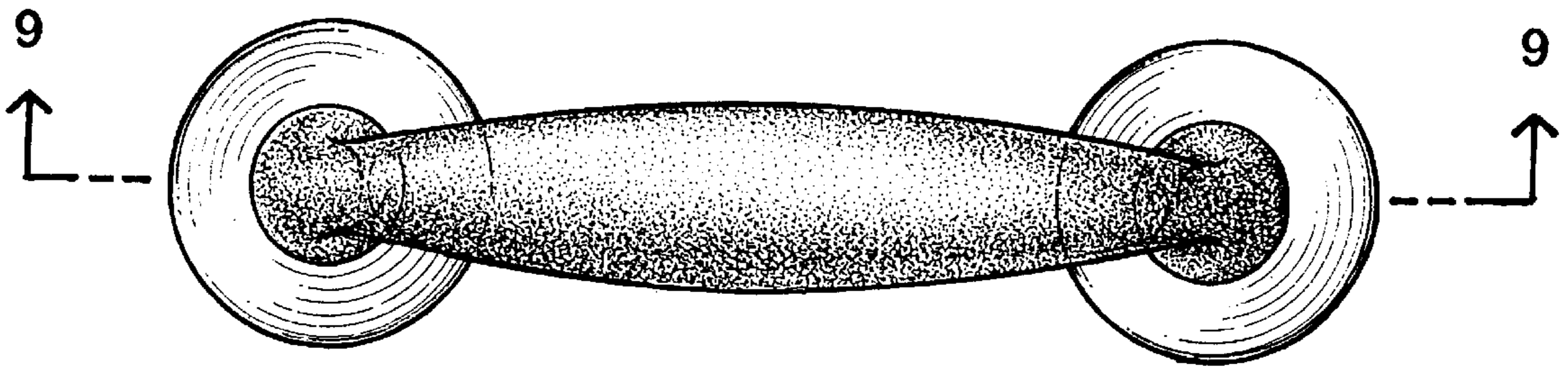

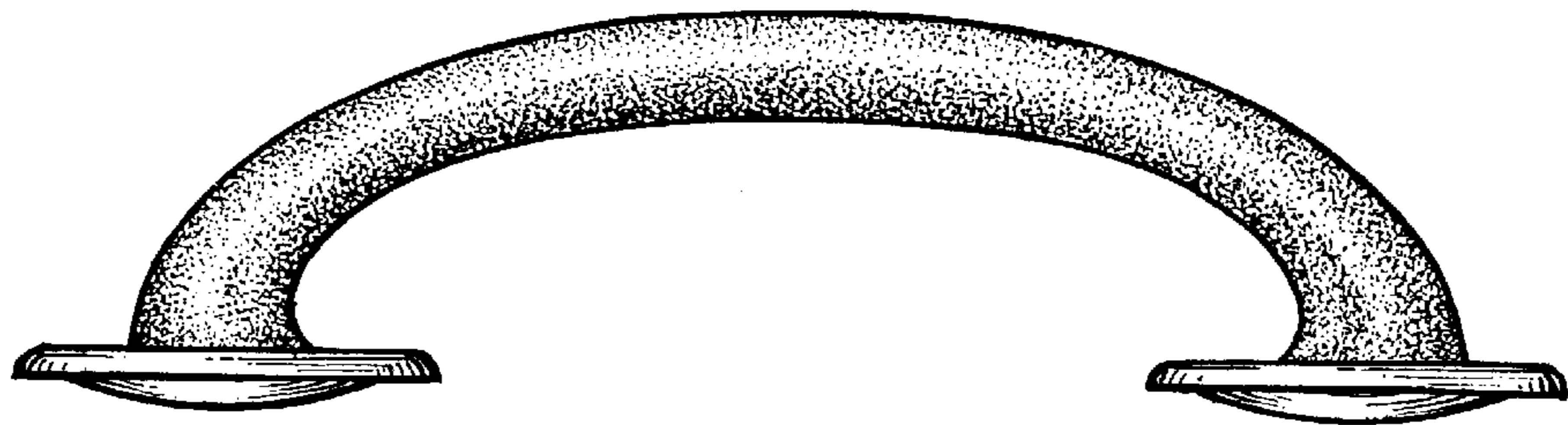

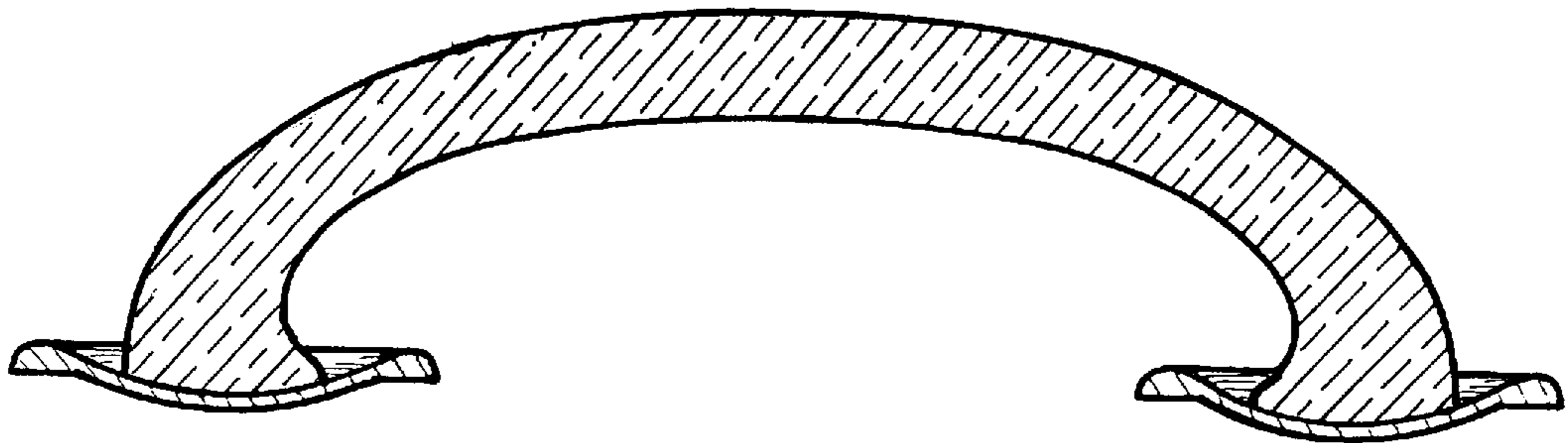

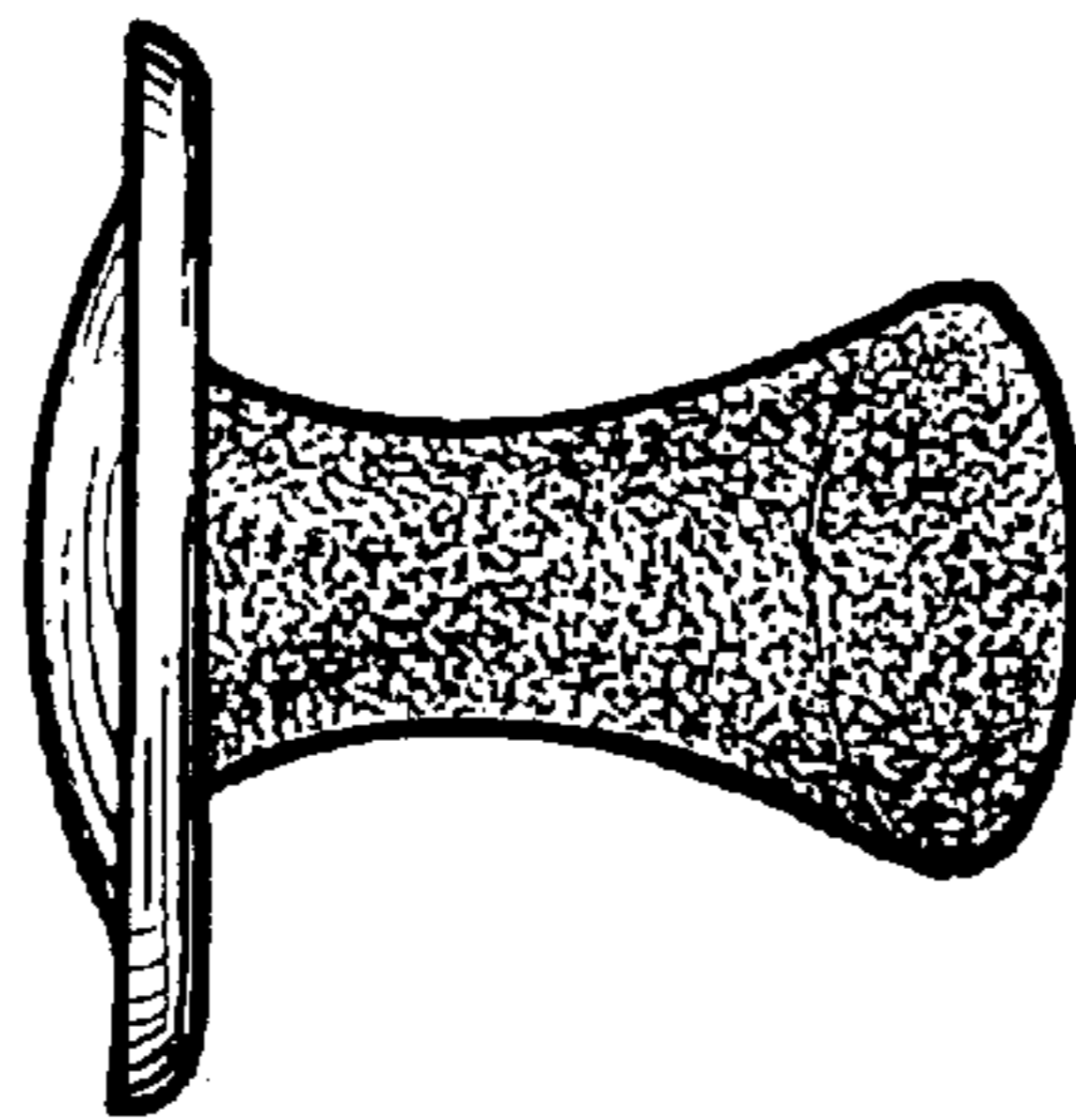
