The ornamental design for a visor organizer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a visor organizer of my inventive design having a mesh pocket, the mesh pocket is shown open in this figure;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the visor organizer;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the visor organizer;

FIG. 4 is a rear view of the visor organizer;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the visor organizer;

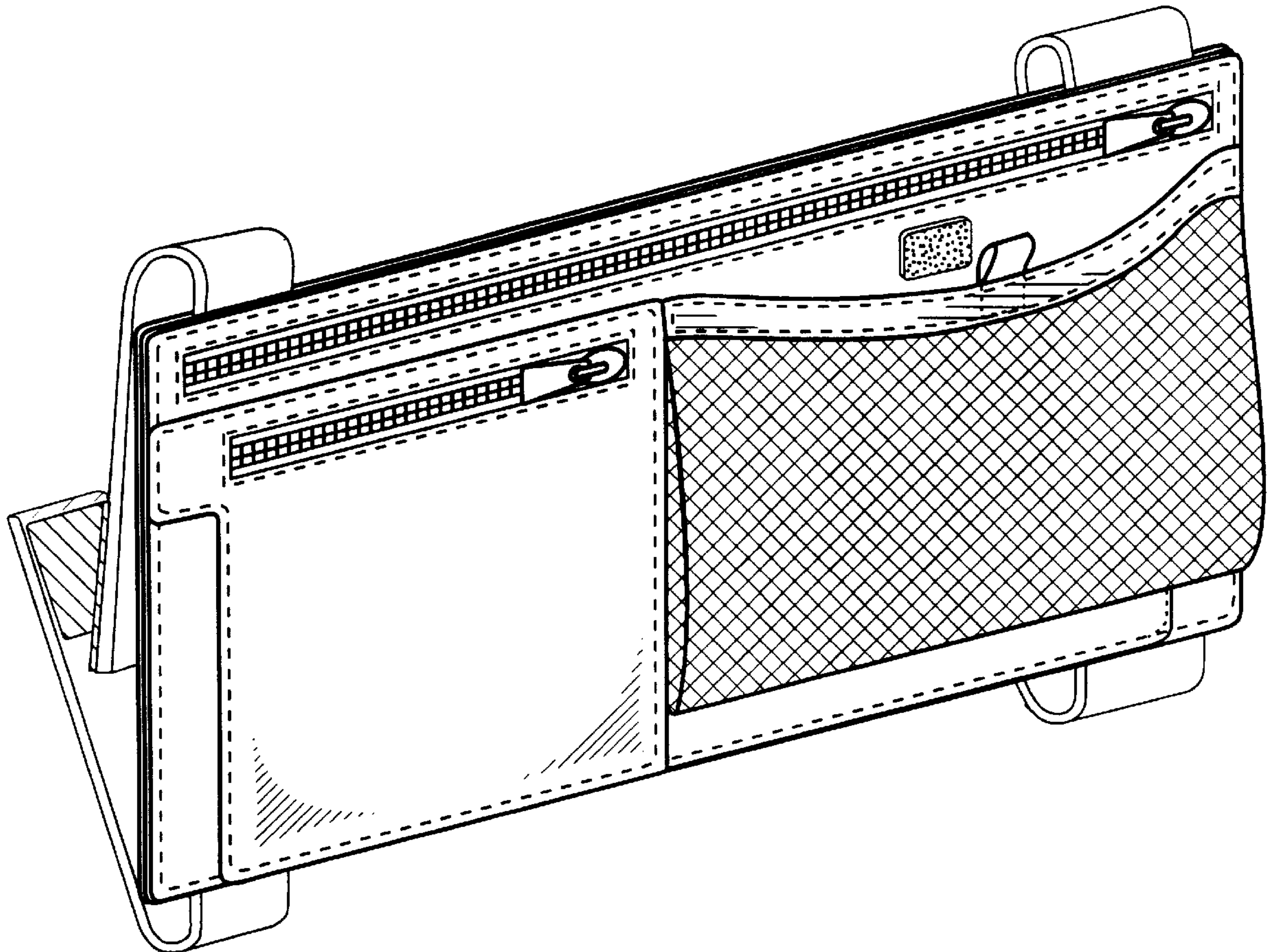
FIG. 6 is a right side view of the visor organizer; and,

FIG. 7 is a left side view of the visor organizer.

The fragmented criss-cross shading in FIGS. 1 and 2 is representative of mesh which is understood to be continuous throughout the implied area.

The dashed lines on the visor organizer are understood to represent stitching.

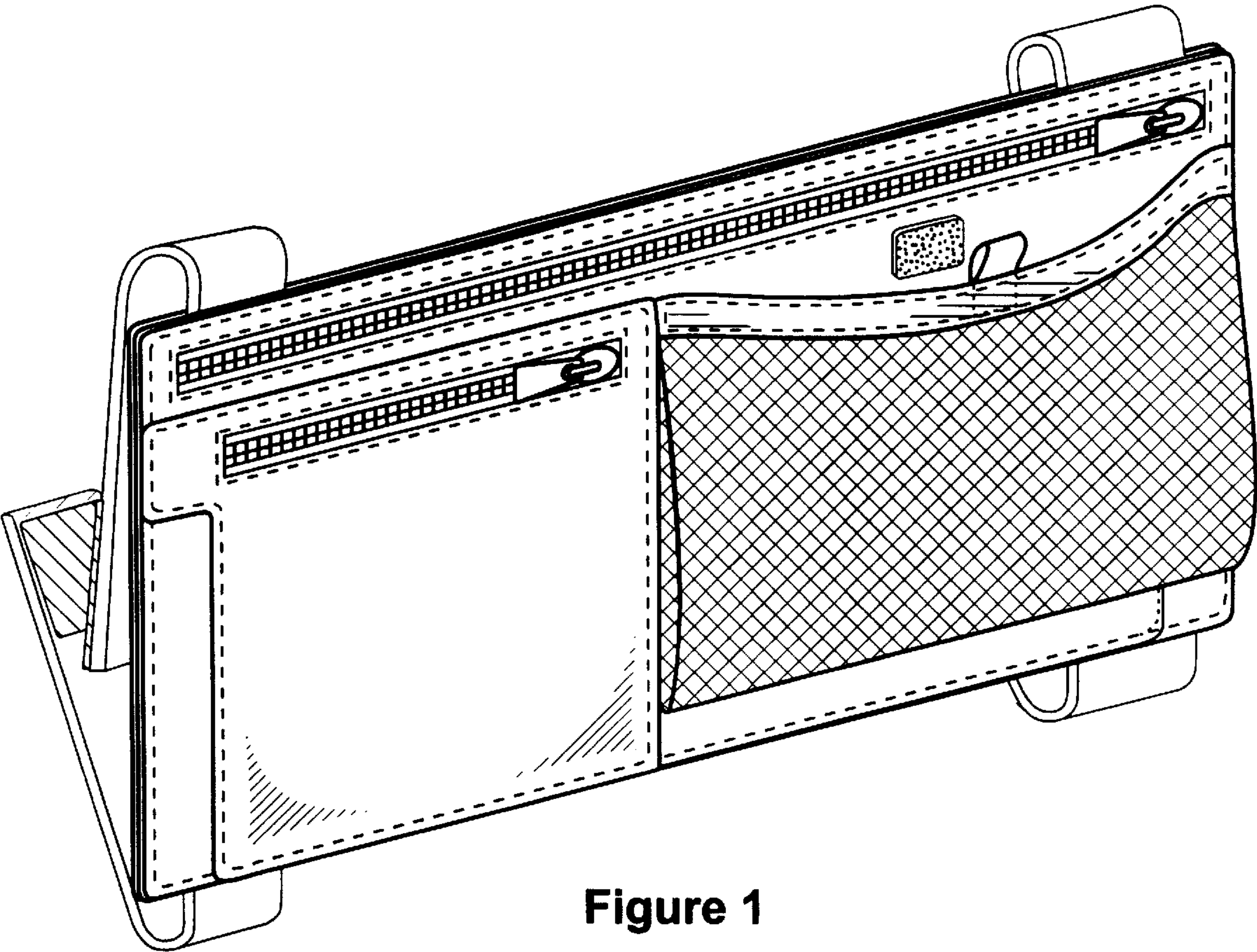

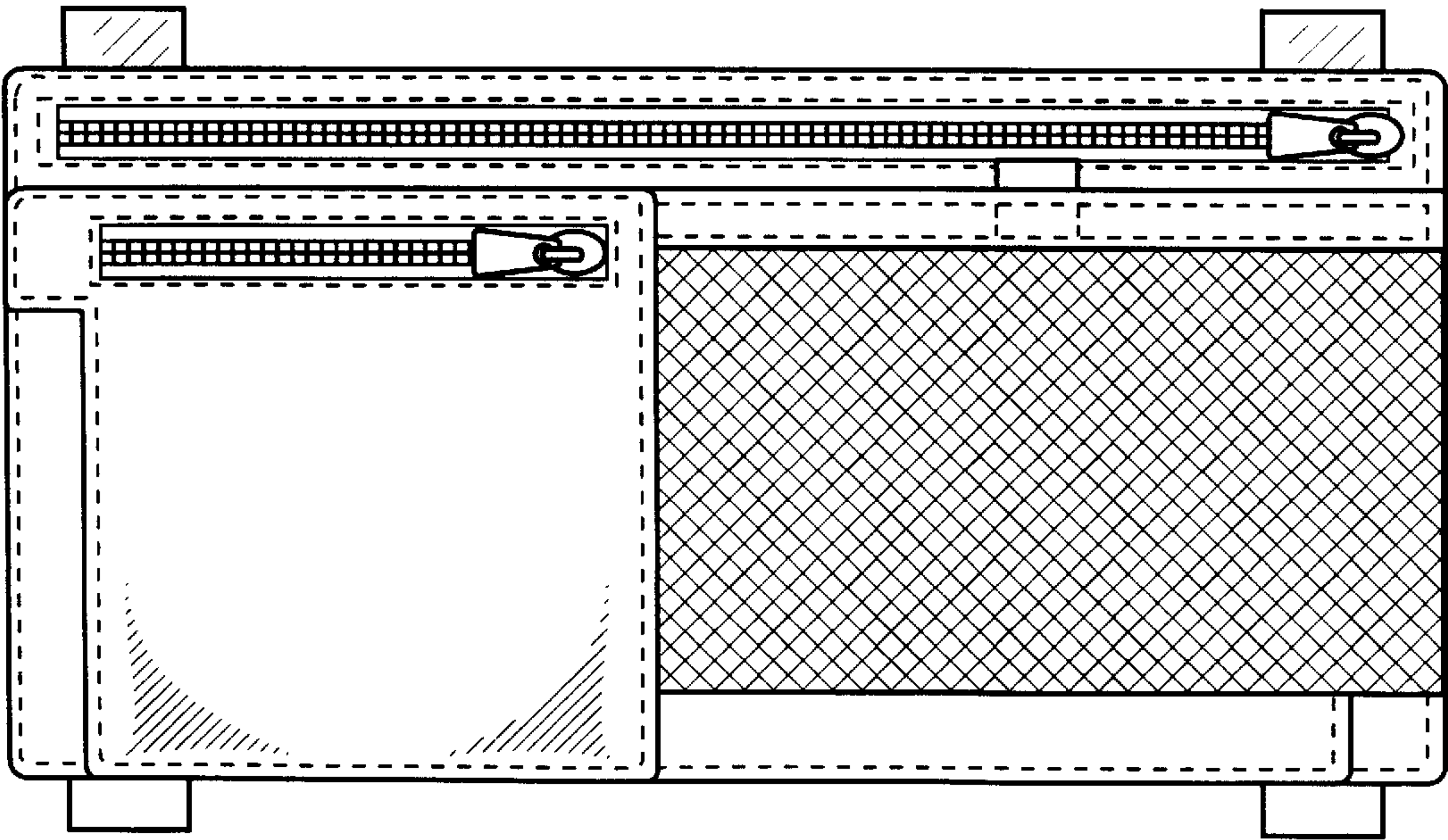

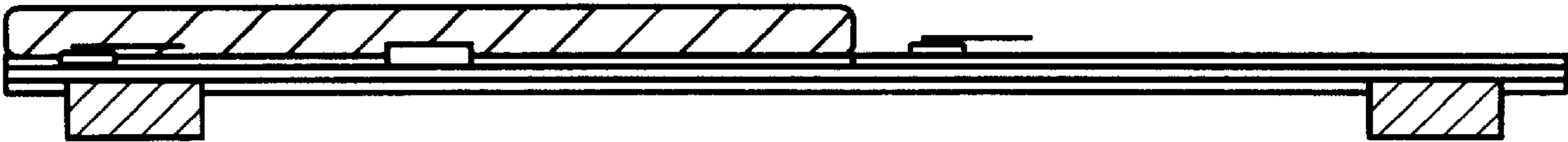

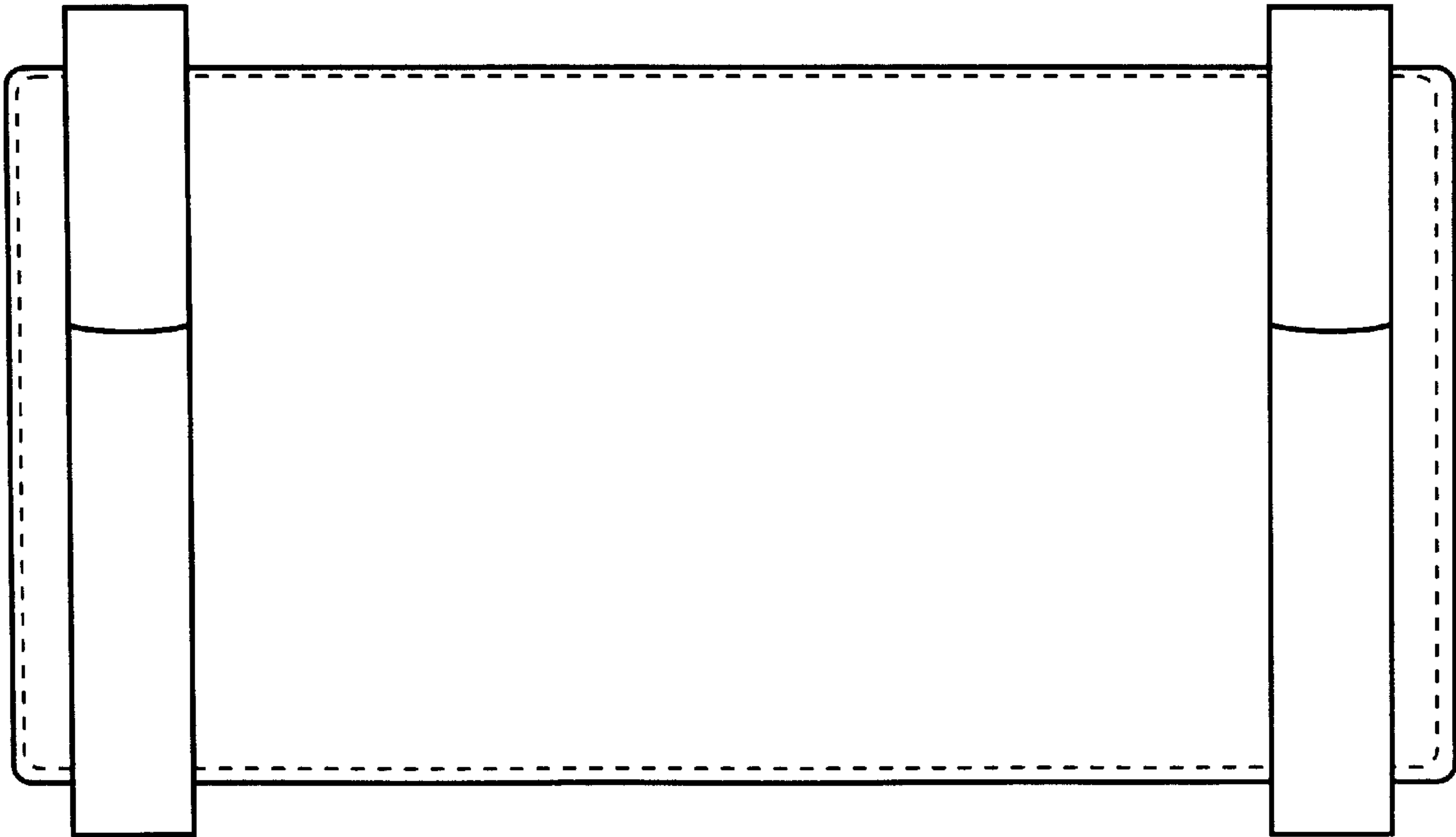

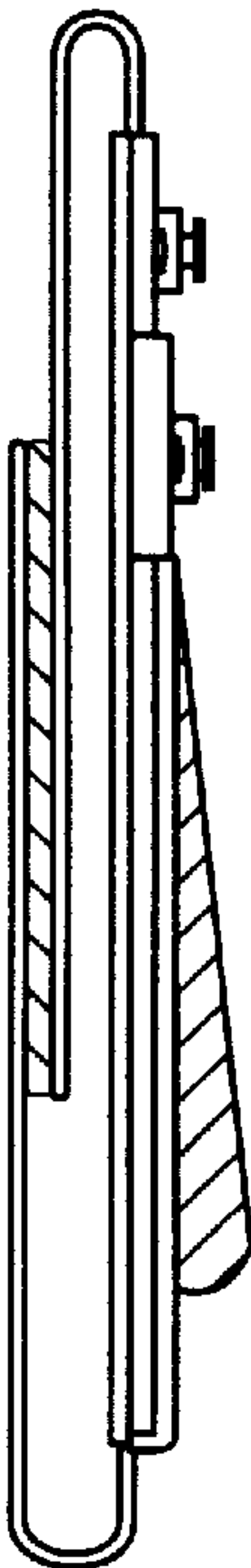

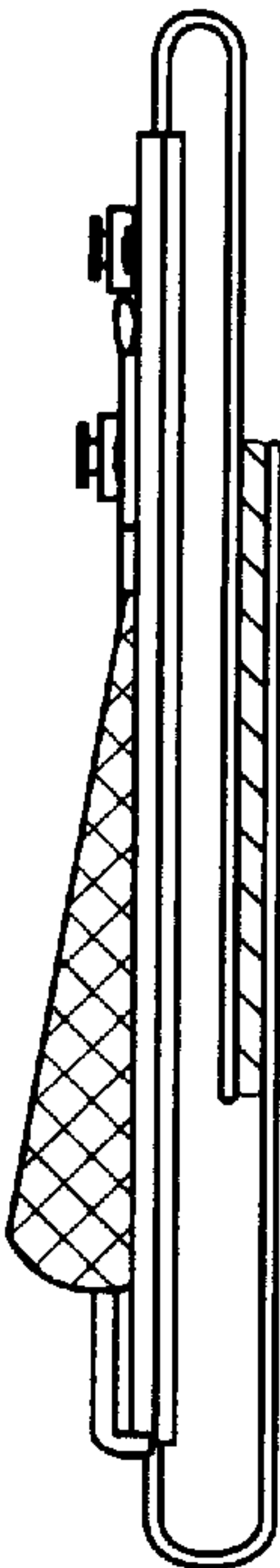
