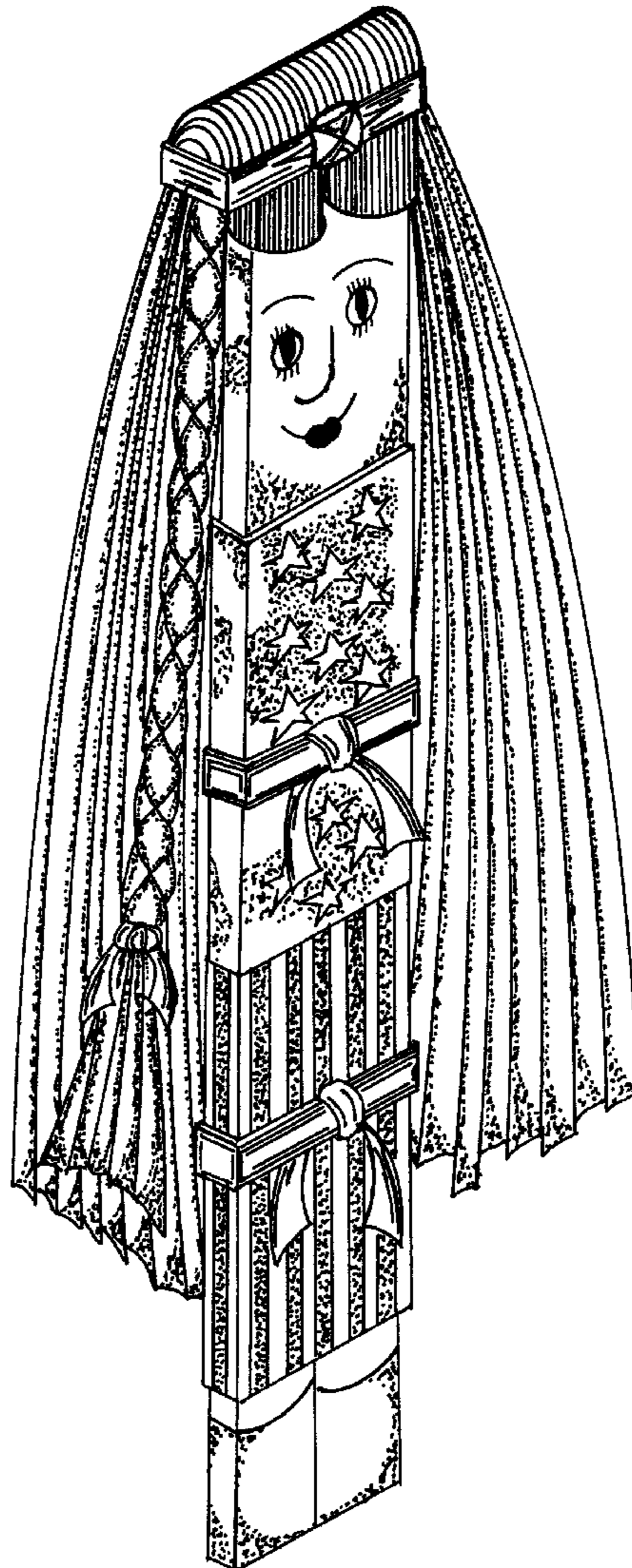
The ornamental design for a stick doll, as shown and described.

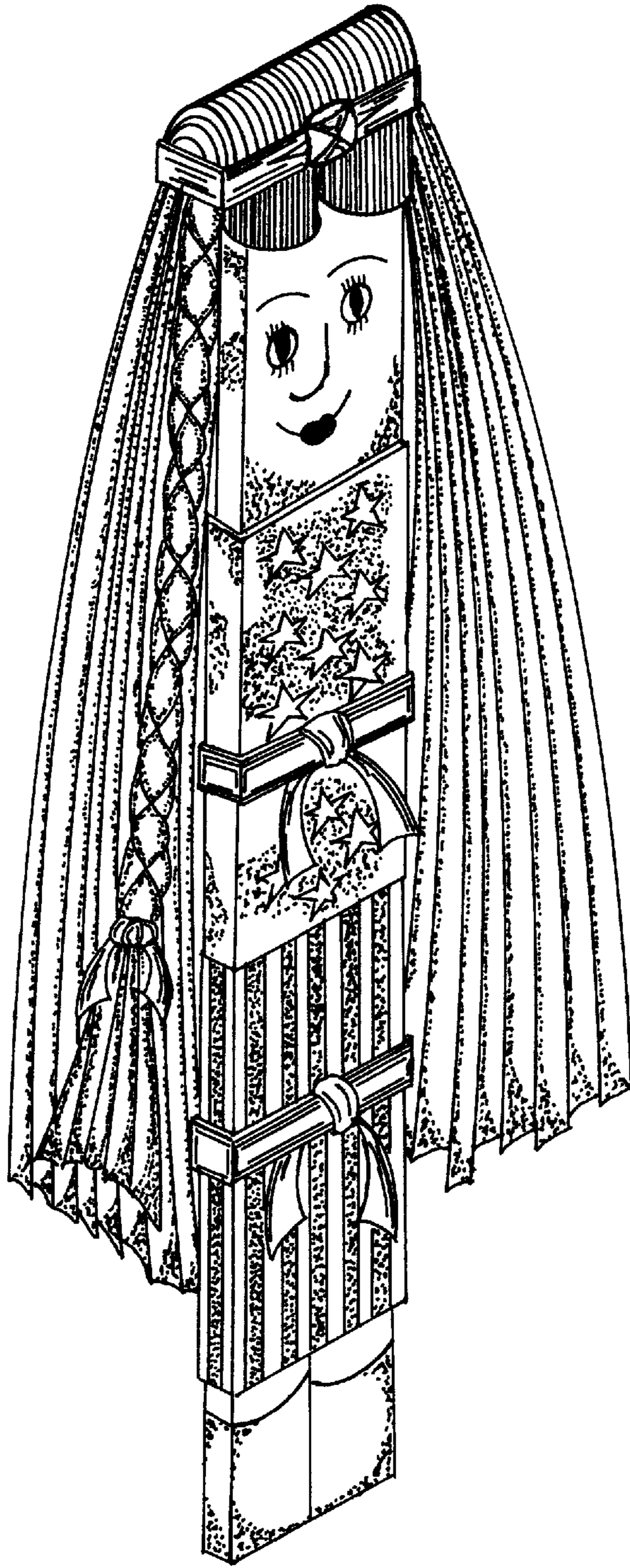
