In a third embodiment of the design (illustrated in FIGS. 5–8), the peripheral edge of the canopy is ornamented in red.

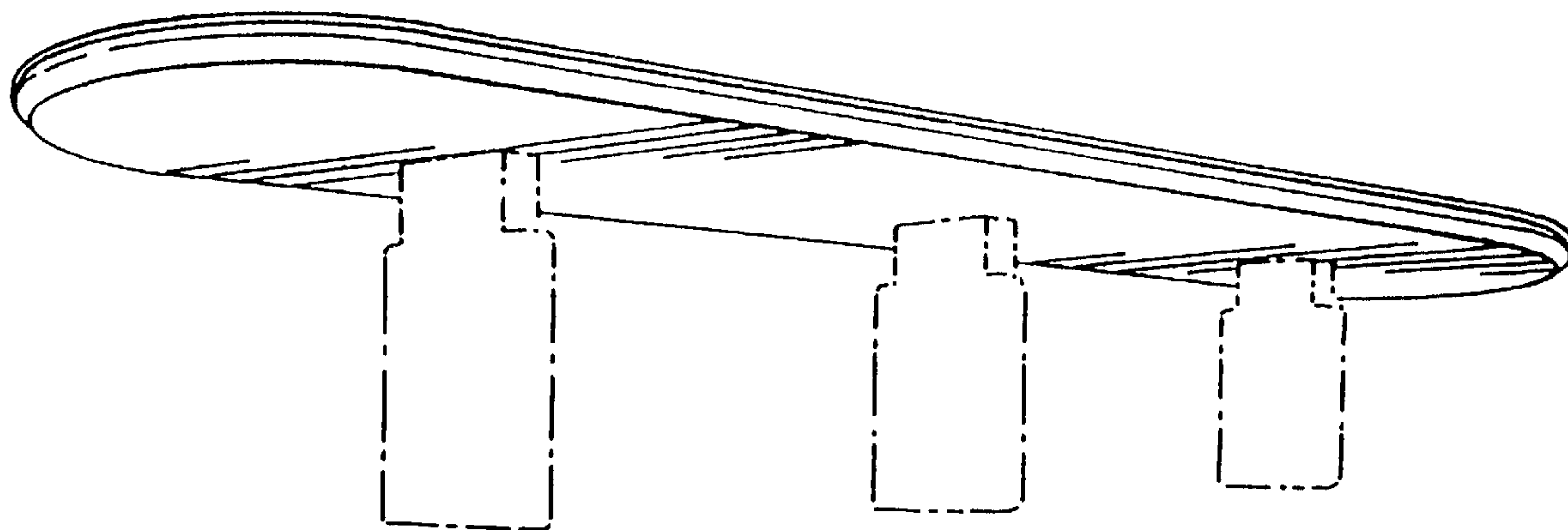
The dotted lines showing the fuel pumps and a building are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

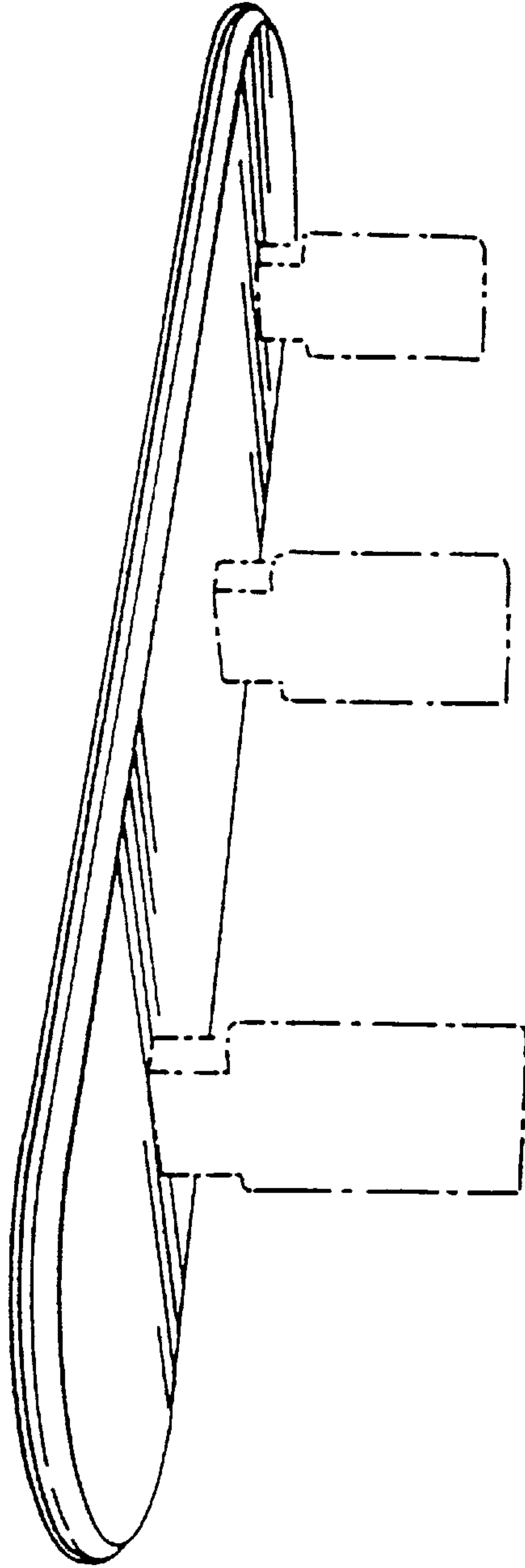

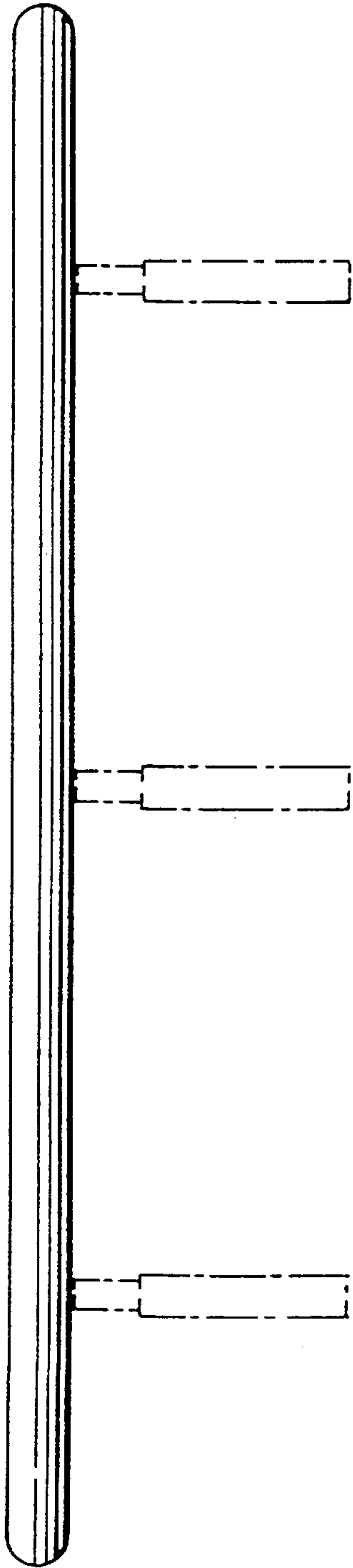

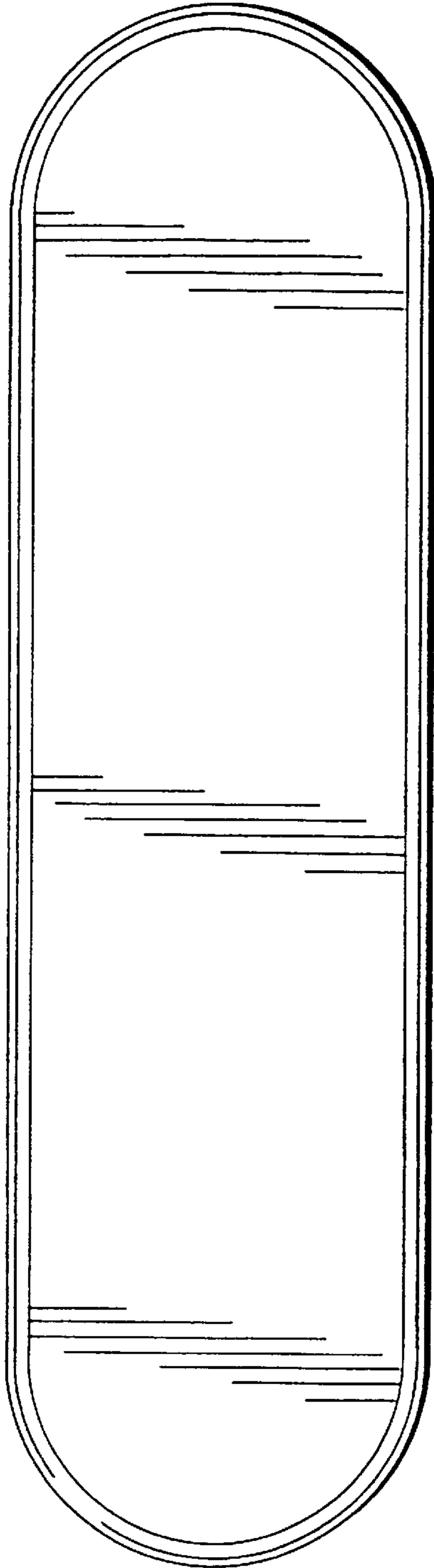

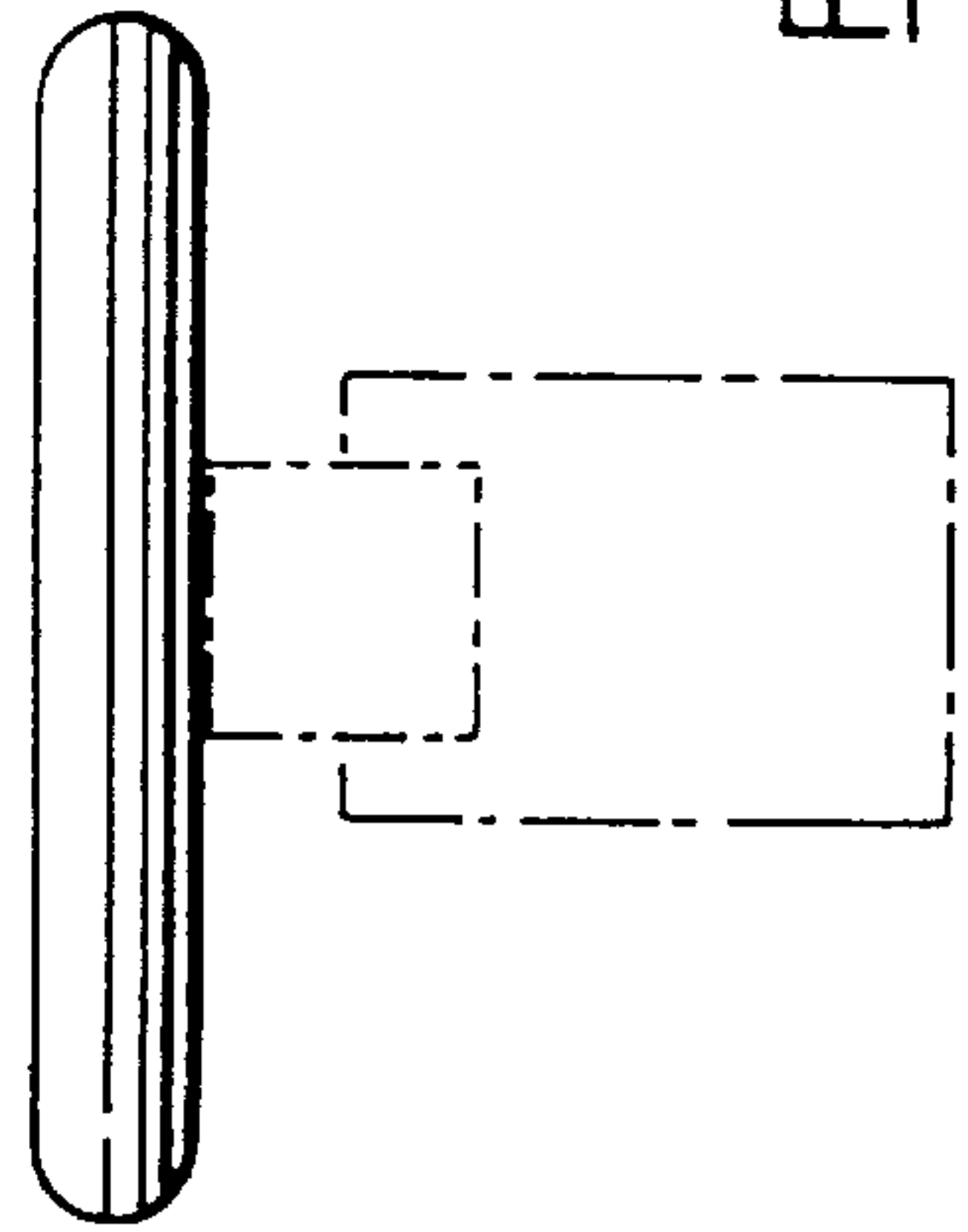
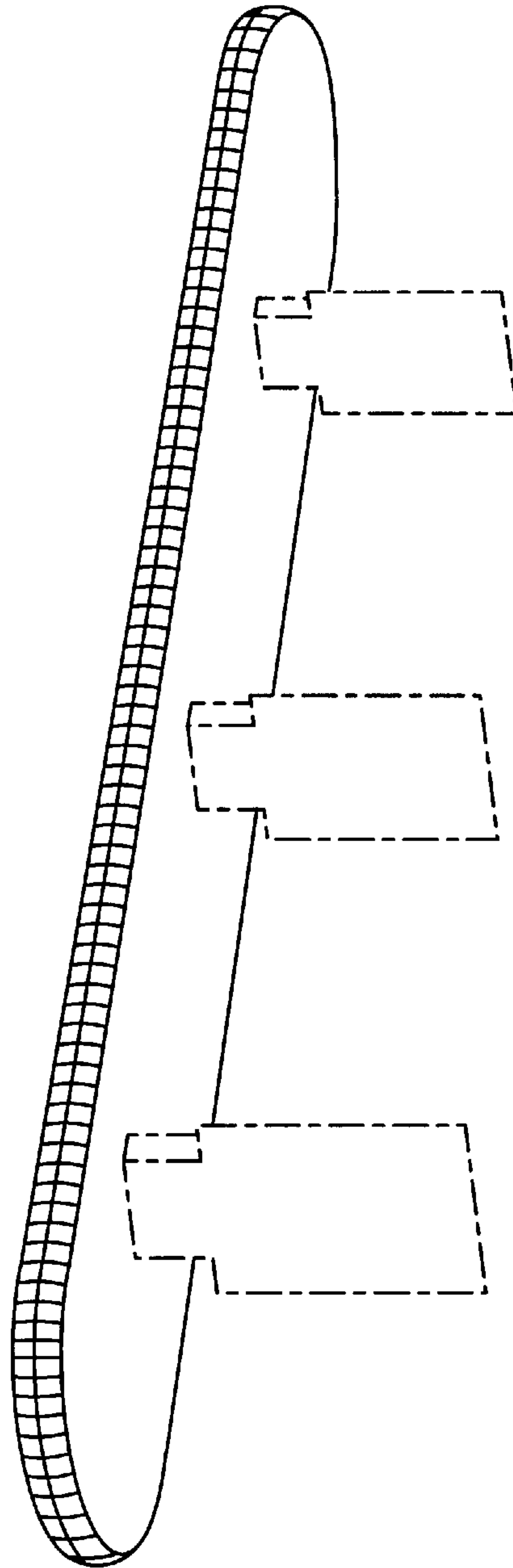

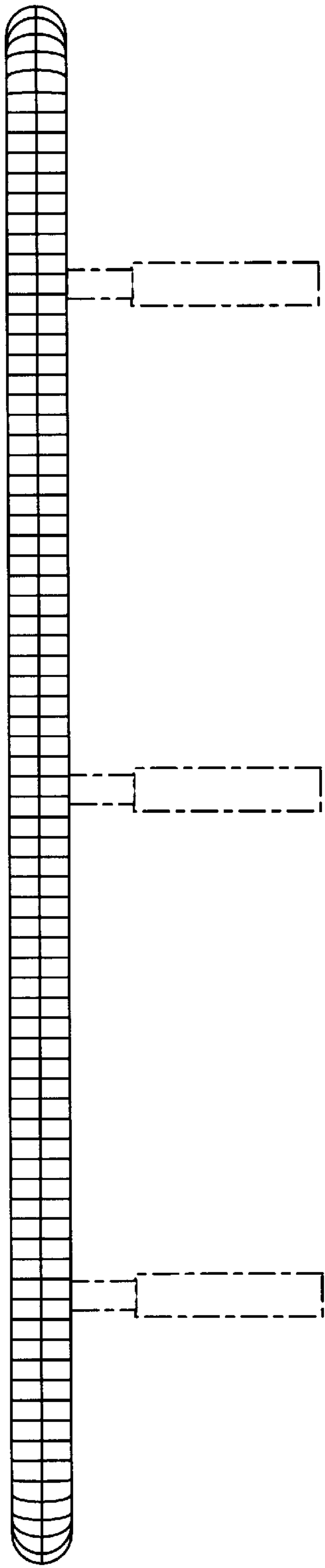

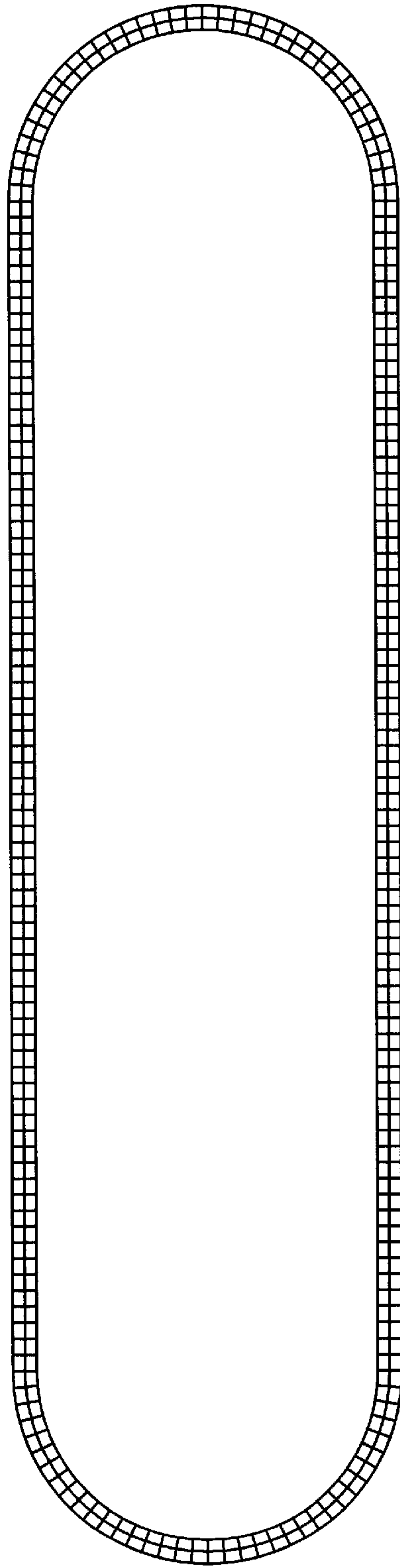

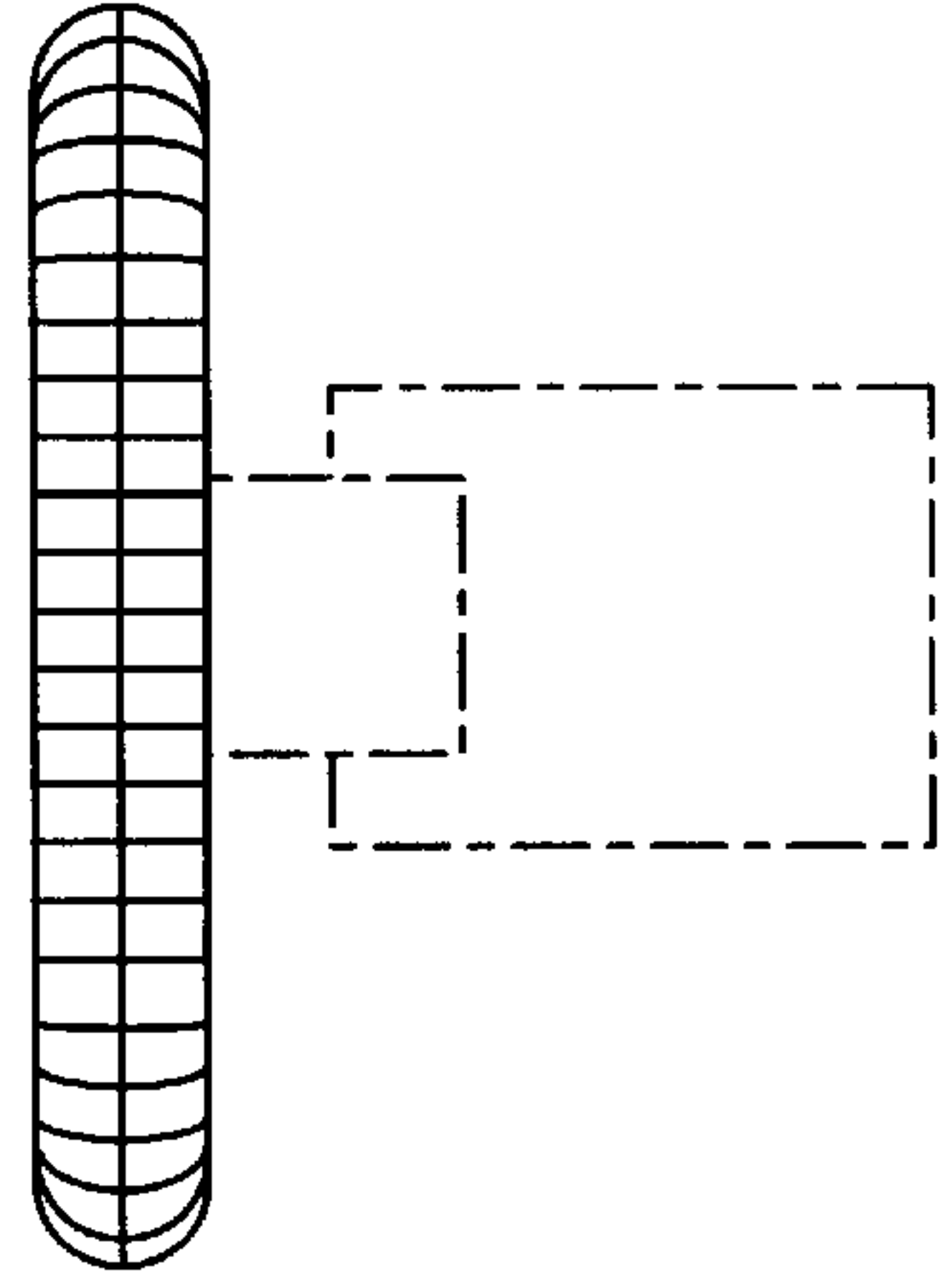
