FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of the Christmas light strand;

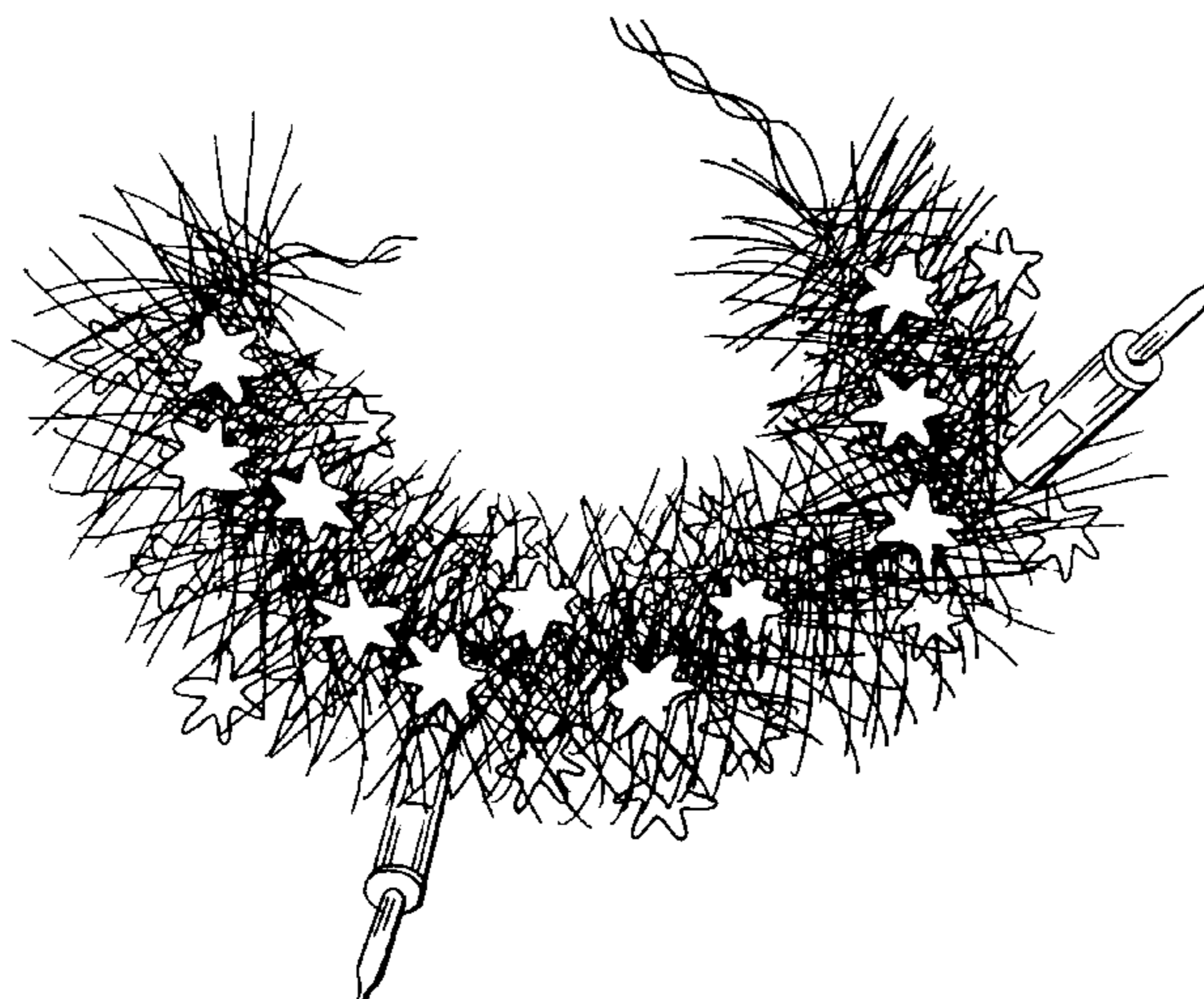
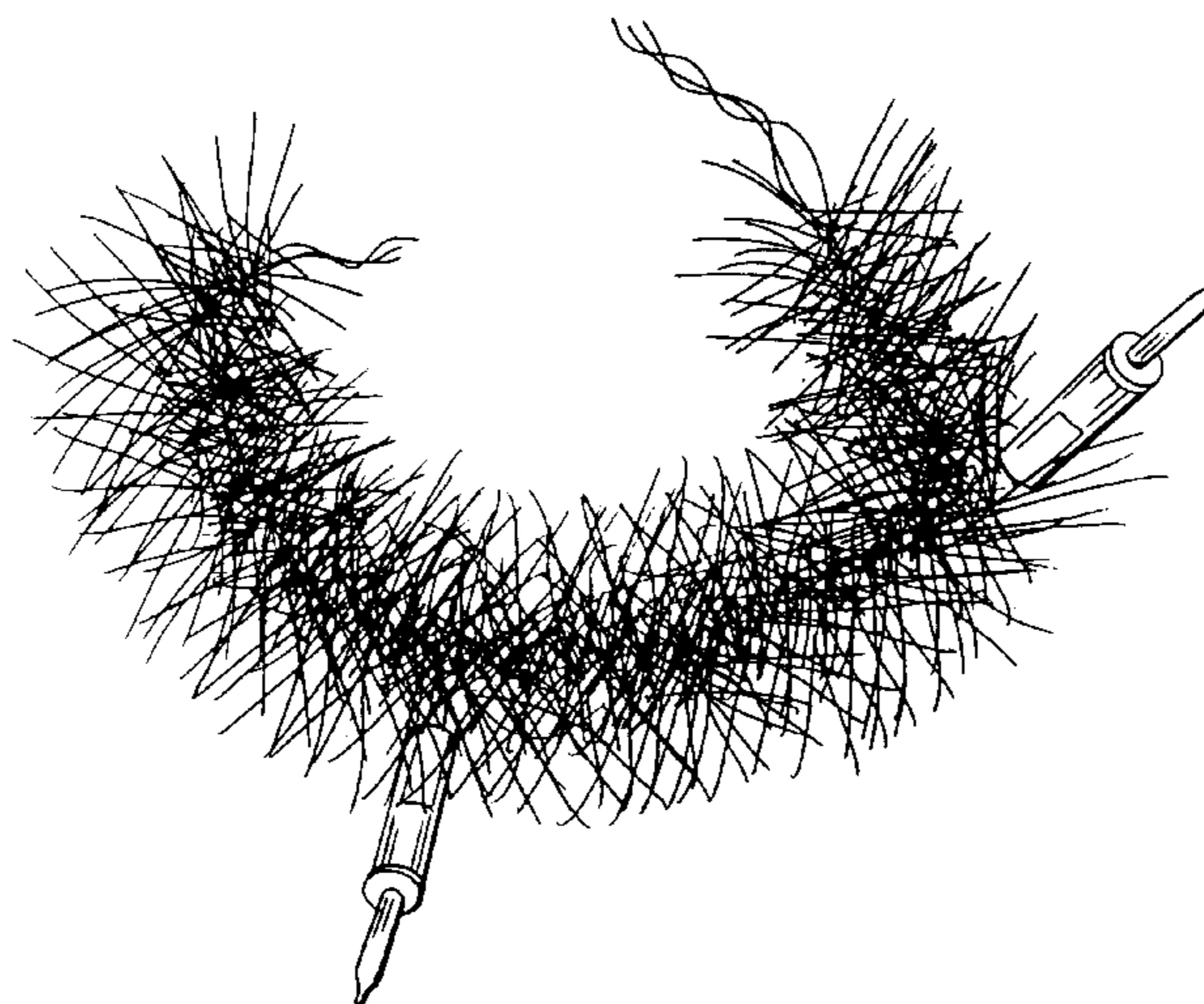
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

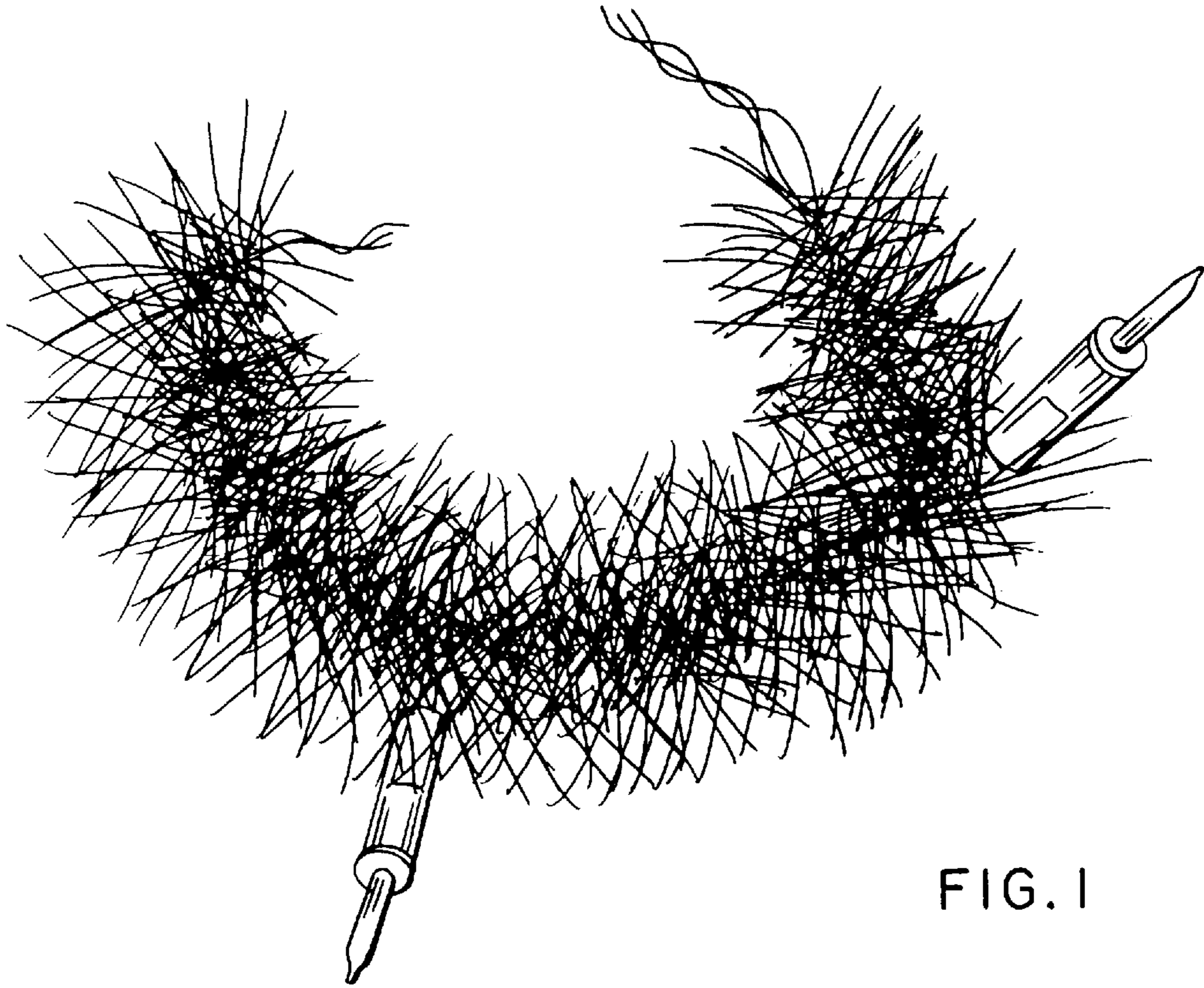
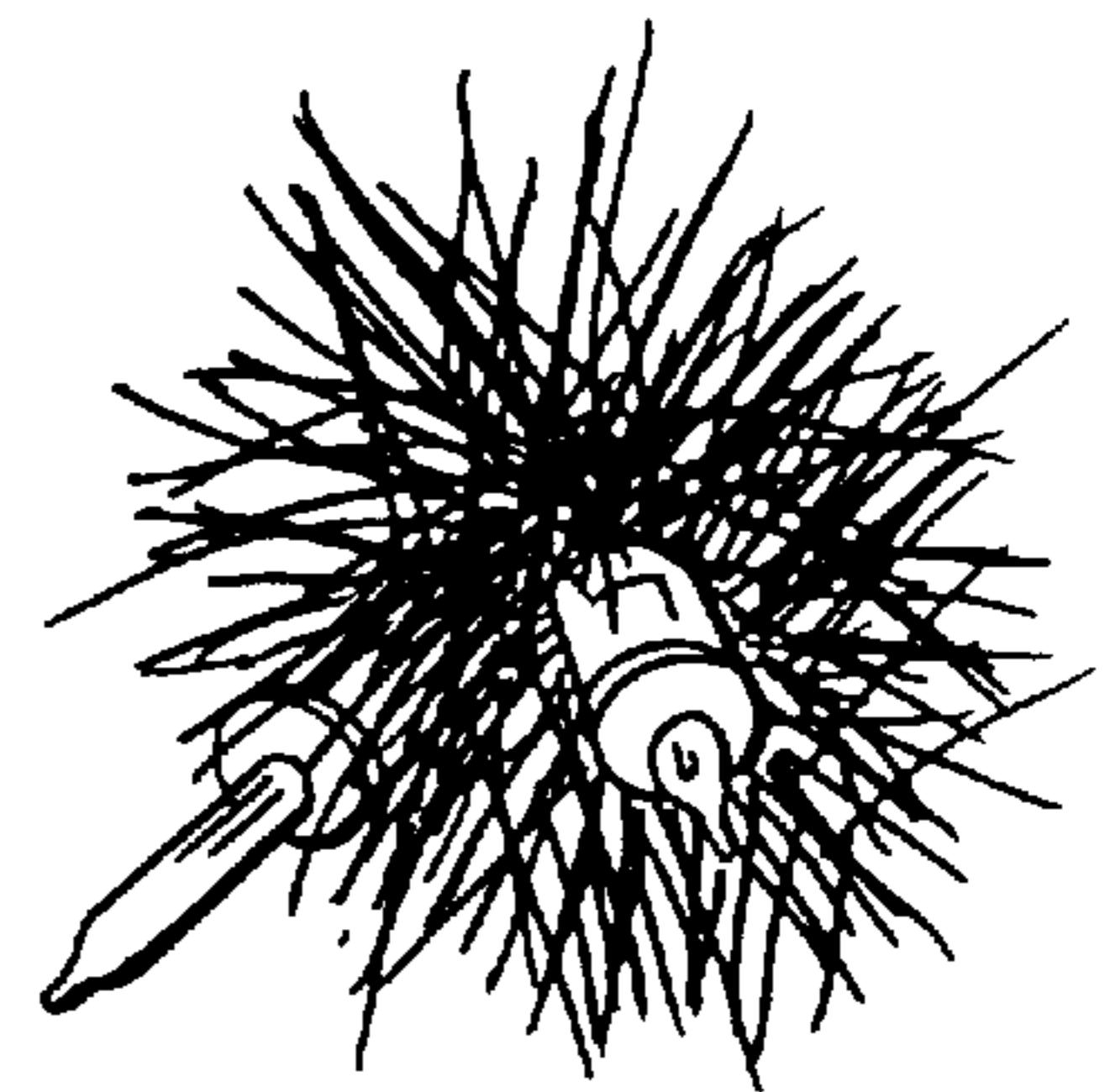

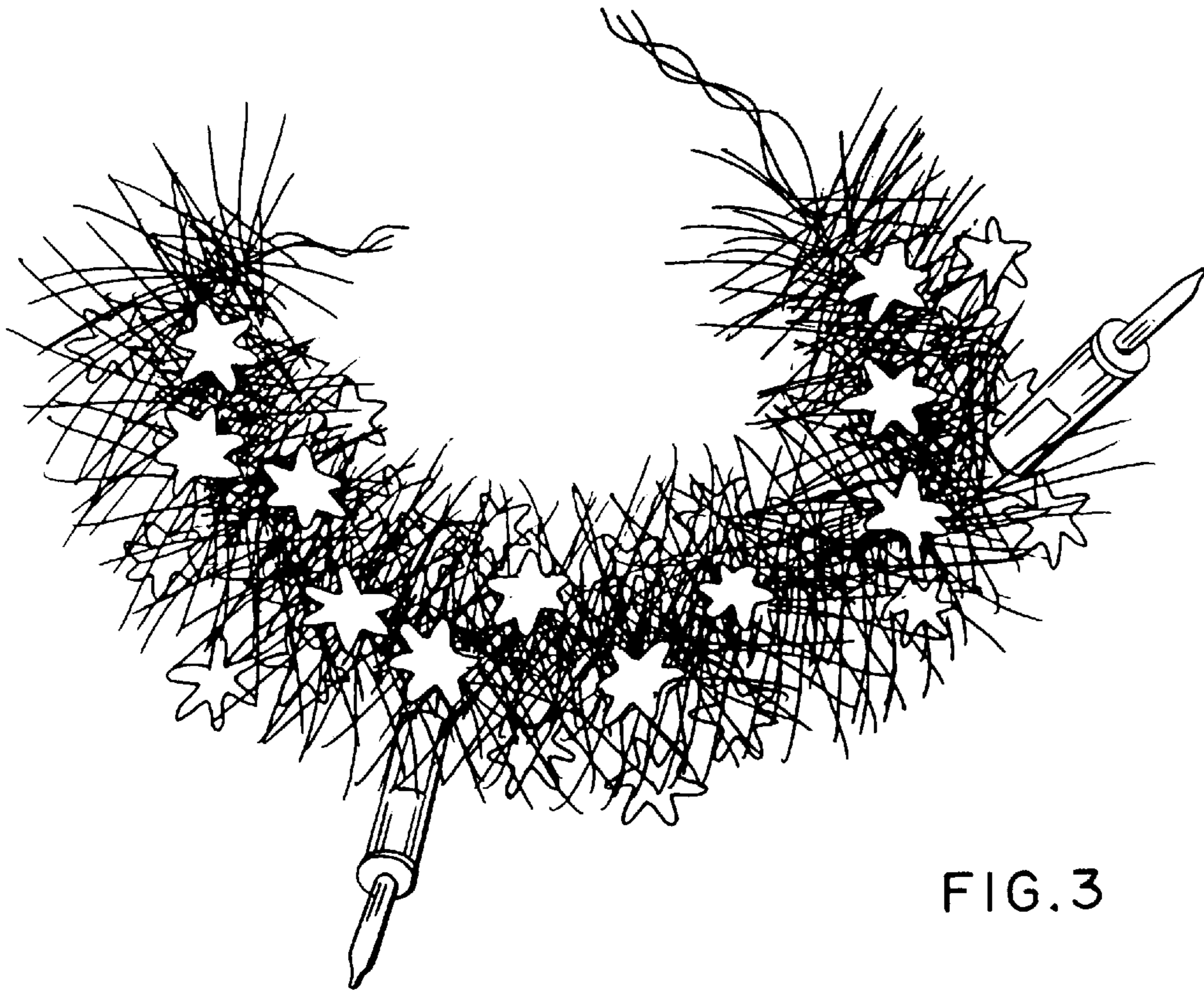
