DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a safety razor handle showing my new design as seen from the top and right side; FIG. 2 is a perspective view as seen from the bottom and right side thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof (showing a shaving unit attachment in broken lines for illustrative purposes); FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevation being a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 8 is a perspective view as seen from the top and right side; and, FIG. 9 is a perspective view as seen from the bottom and right side thereof. The broken line disclosure of the shaving unit and underlying structure is for illustrative purposes only and does not constitute a part of the claimed design.

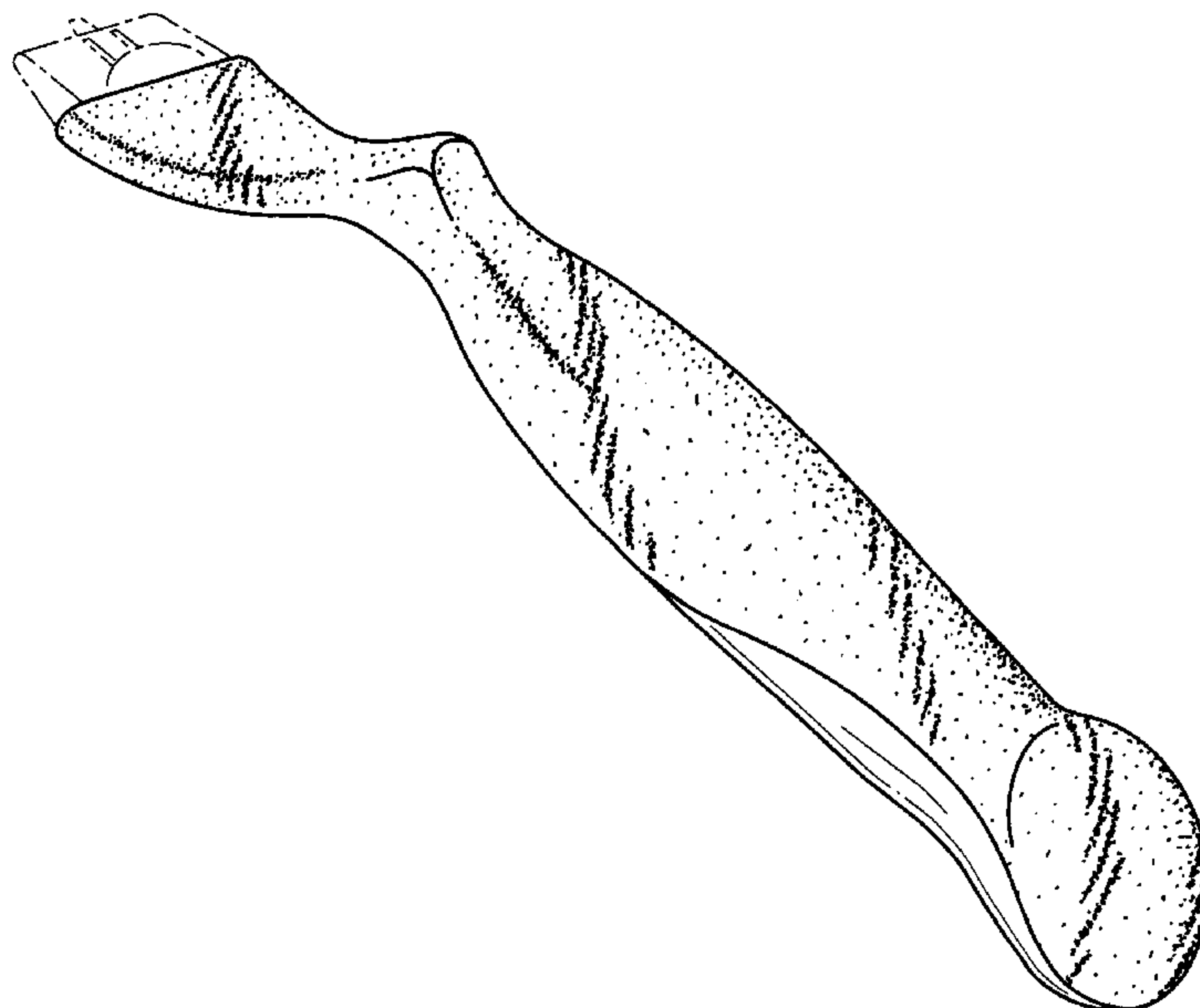

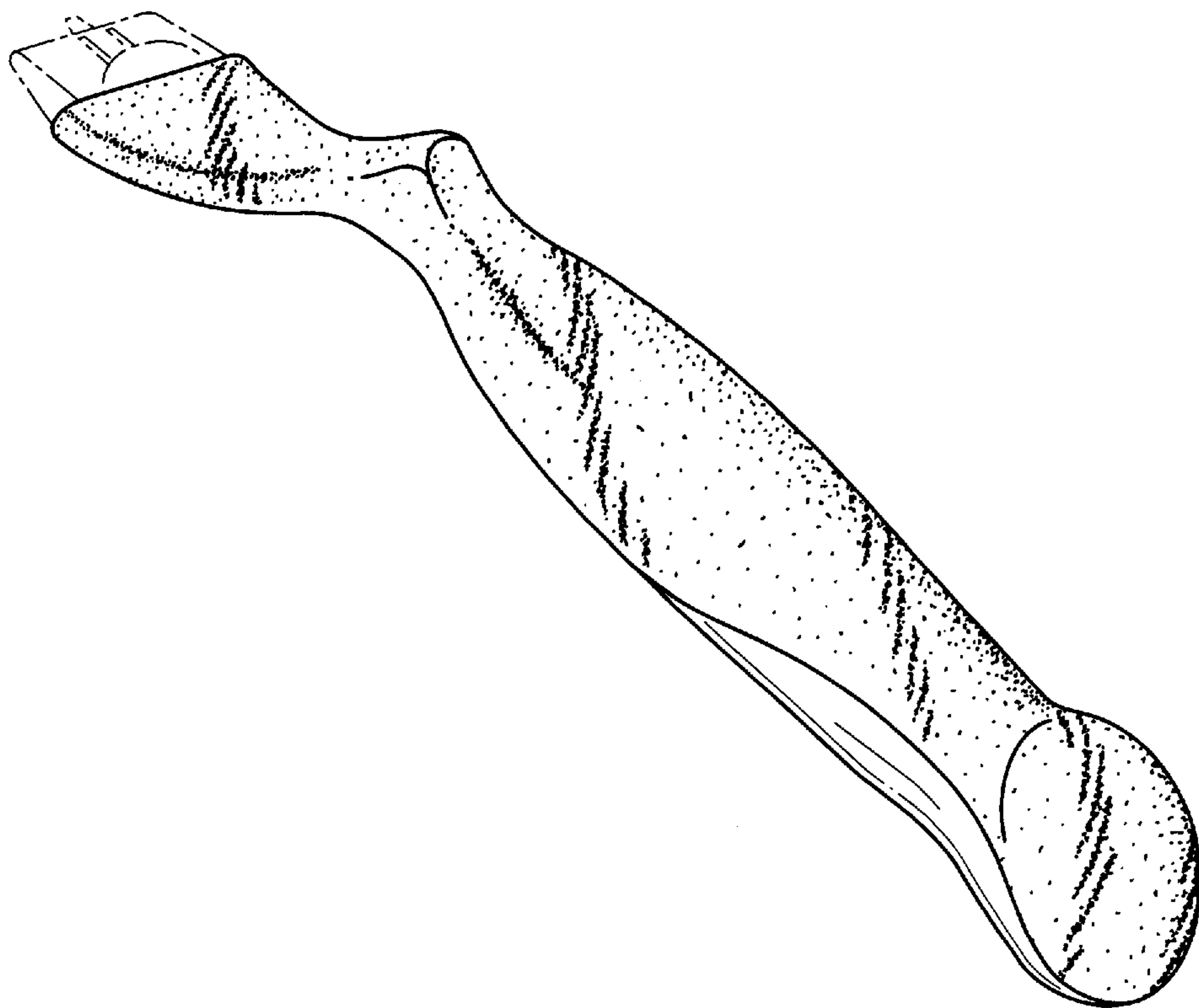

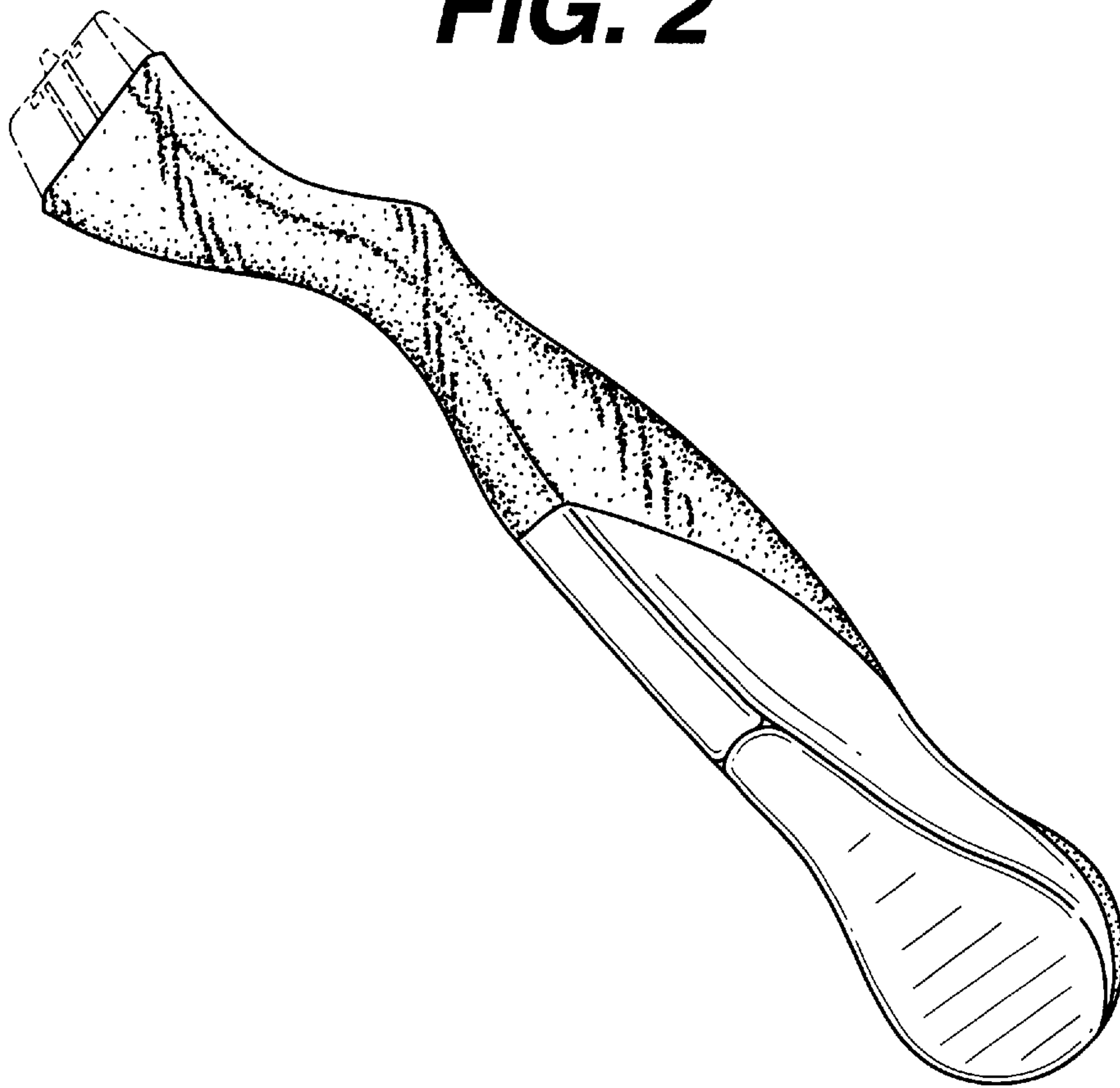

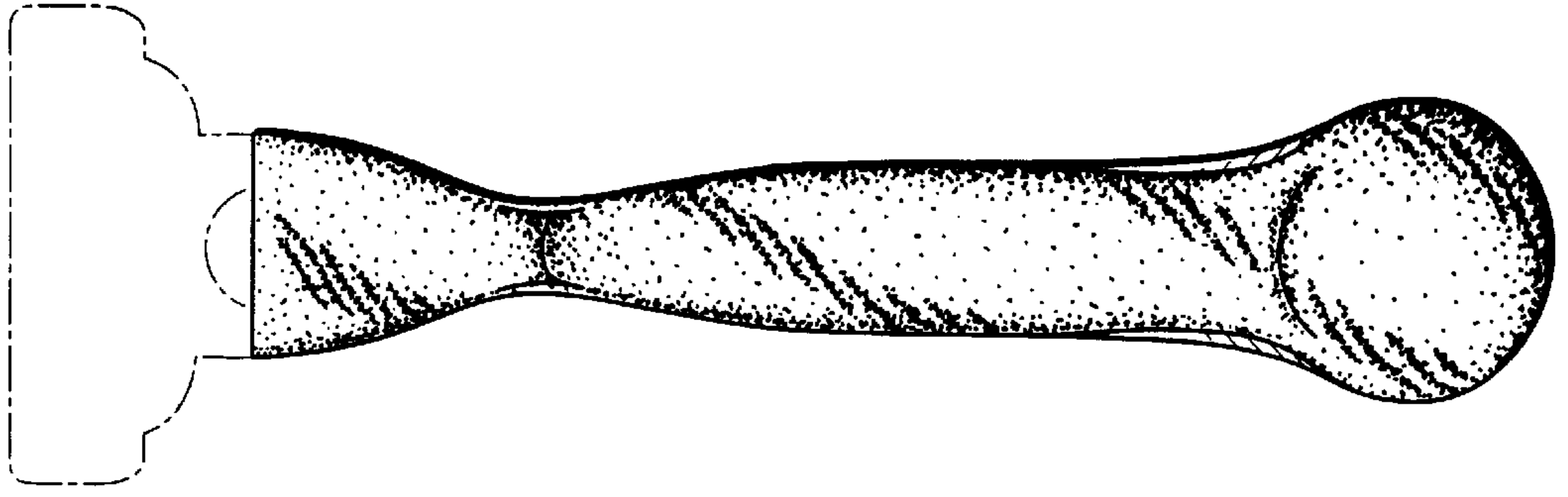

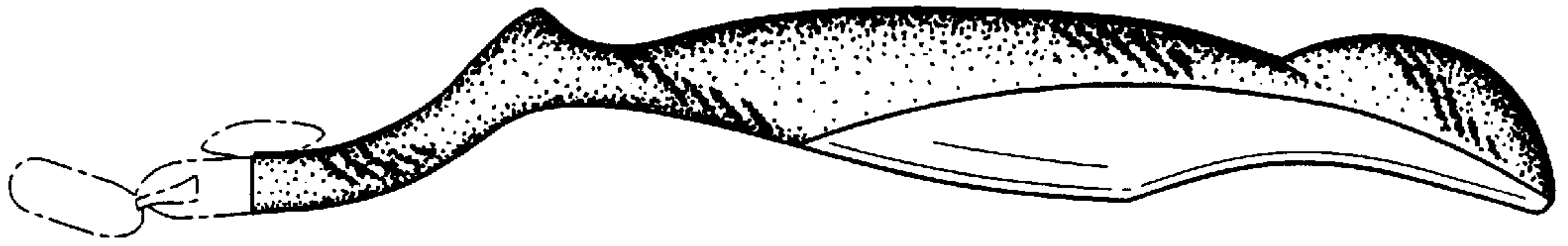

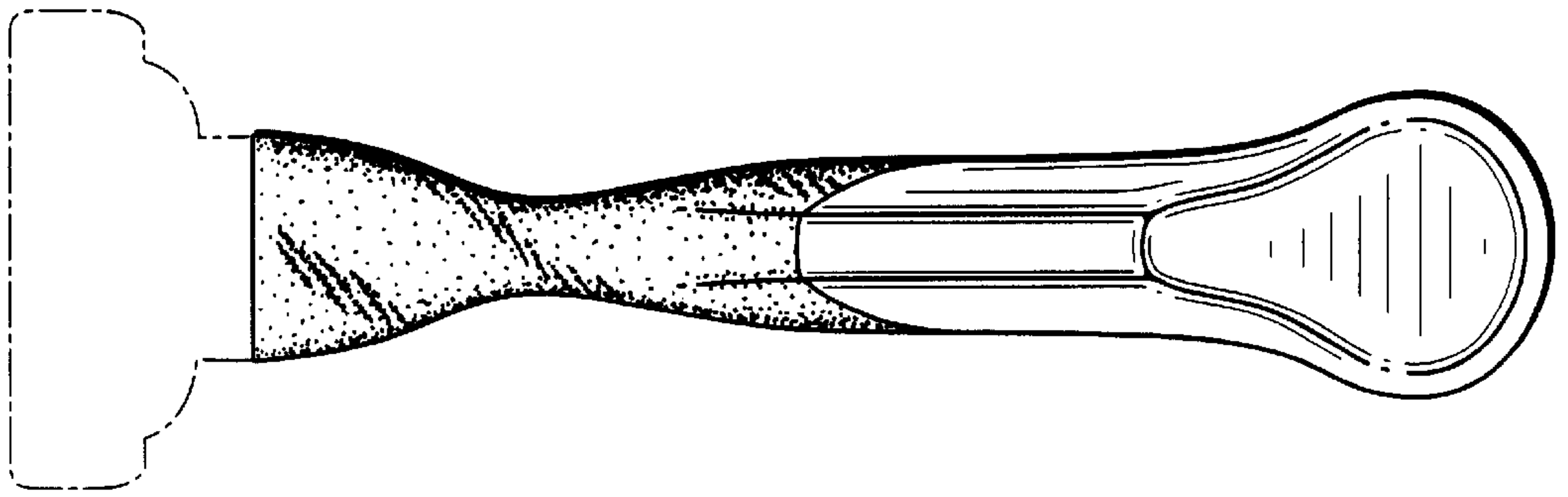

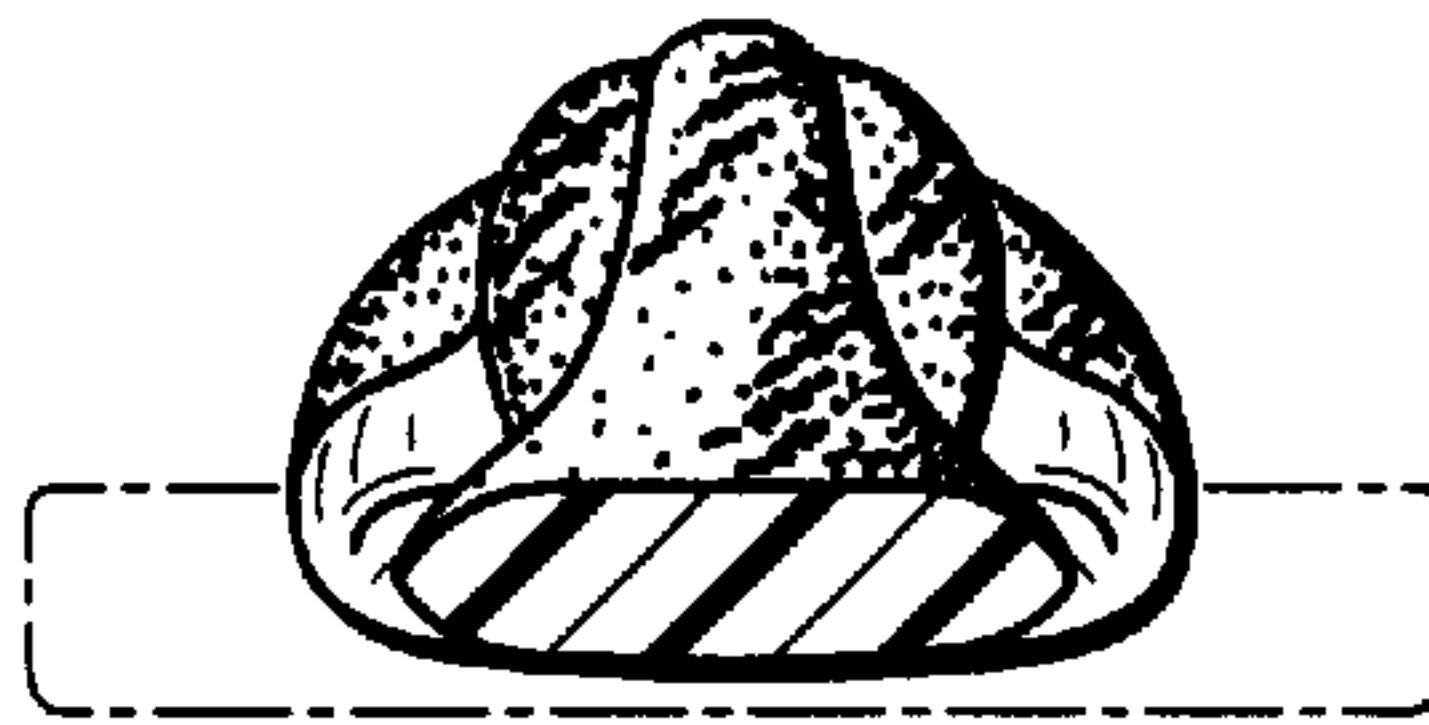
