DESCRIPTION

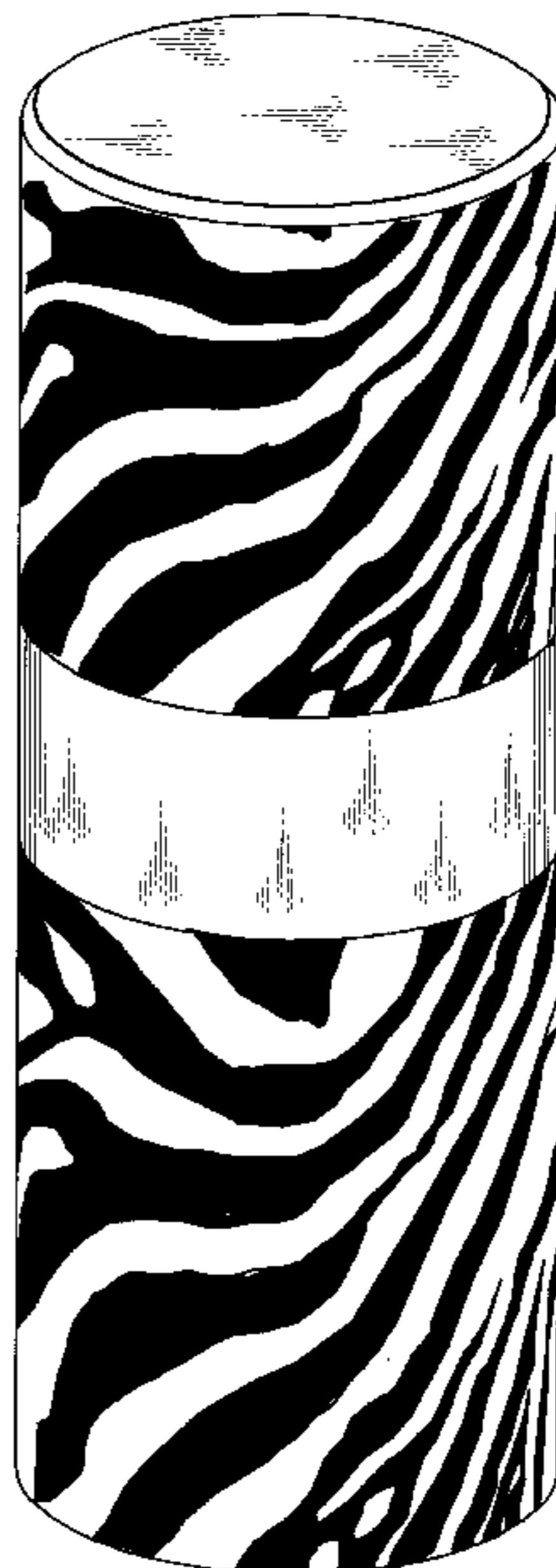

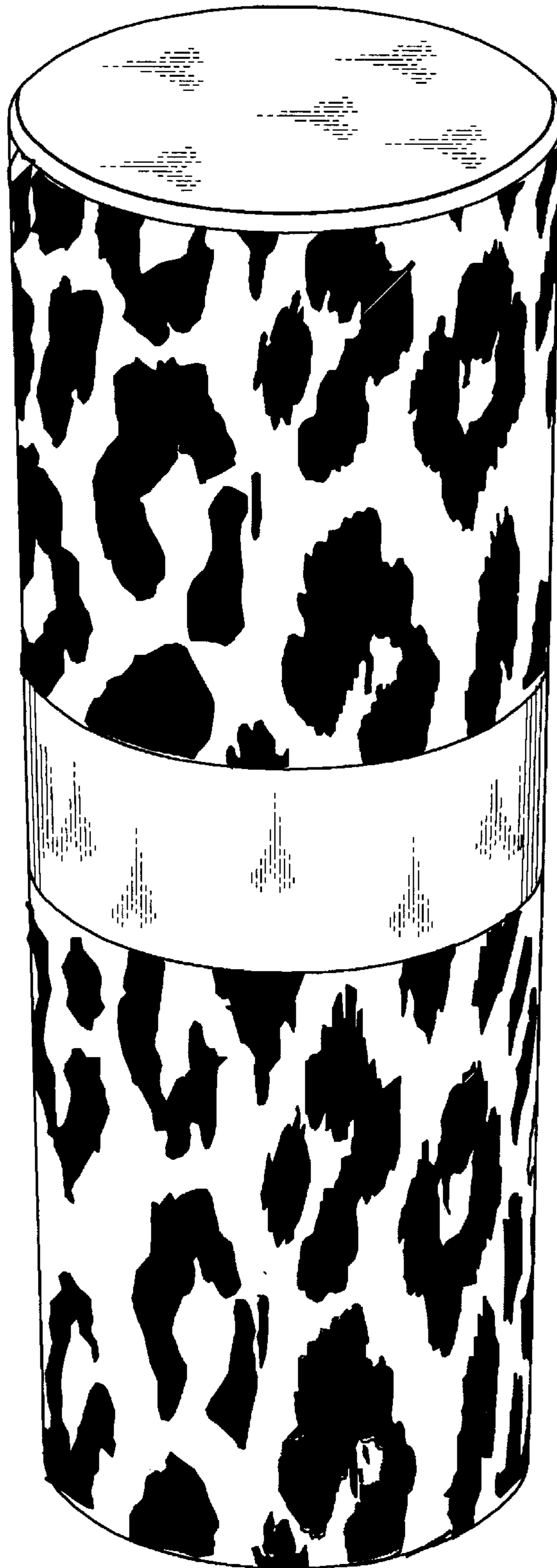

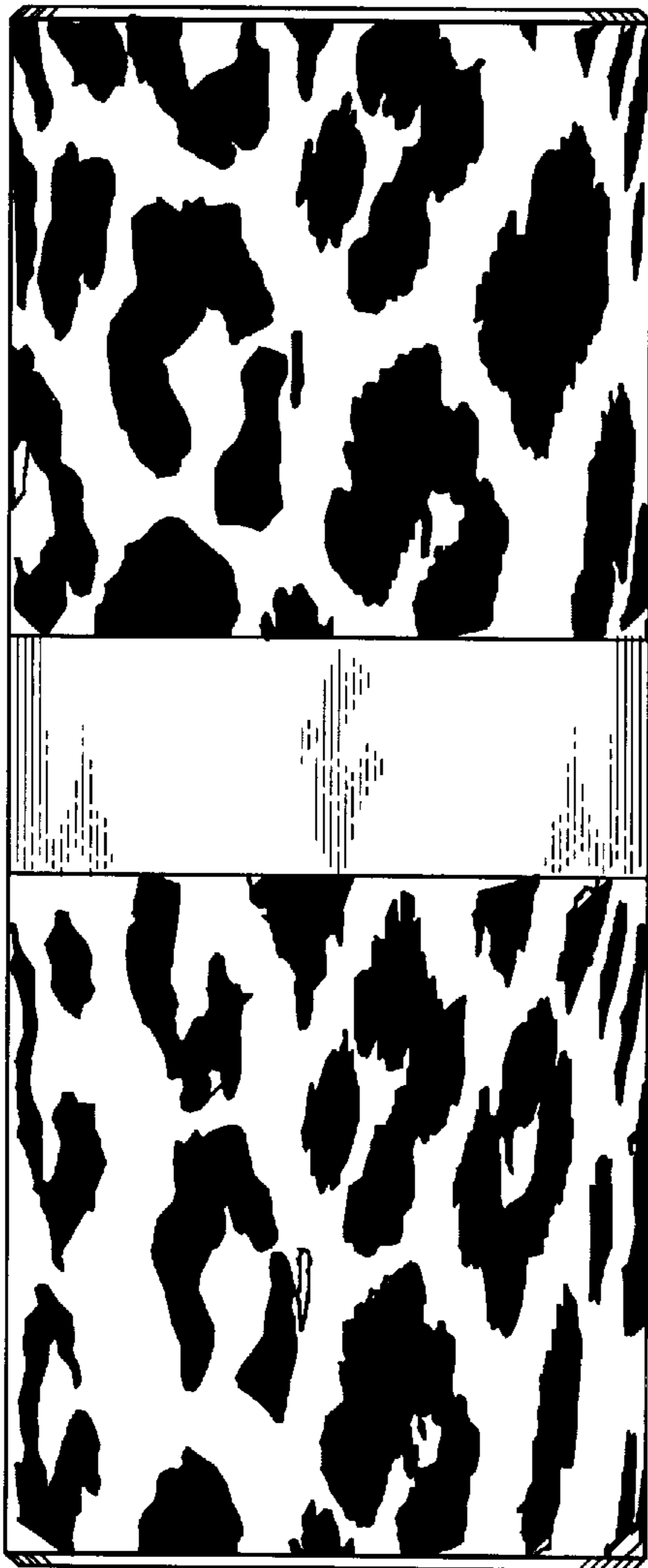
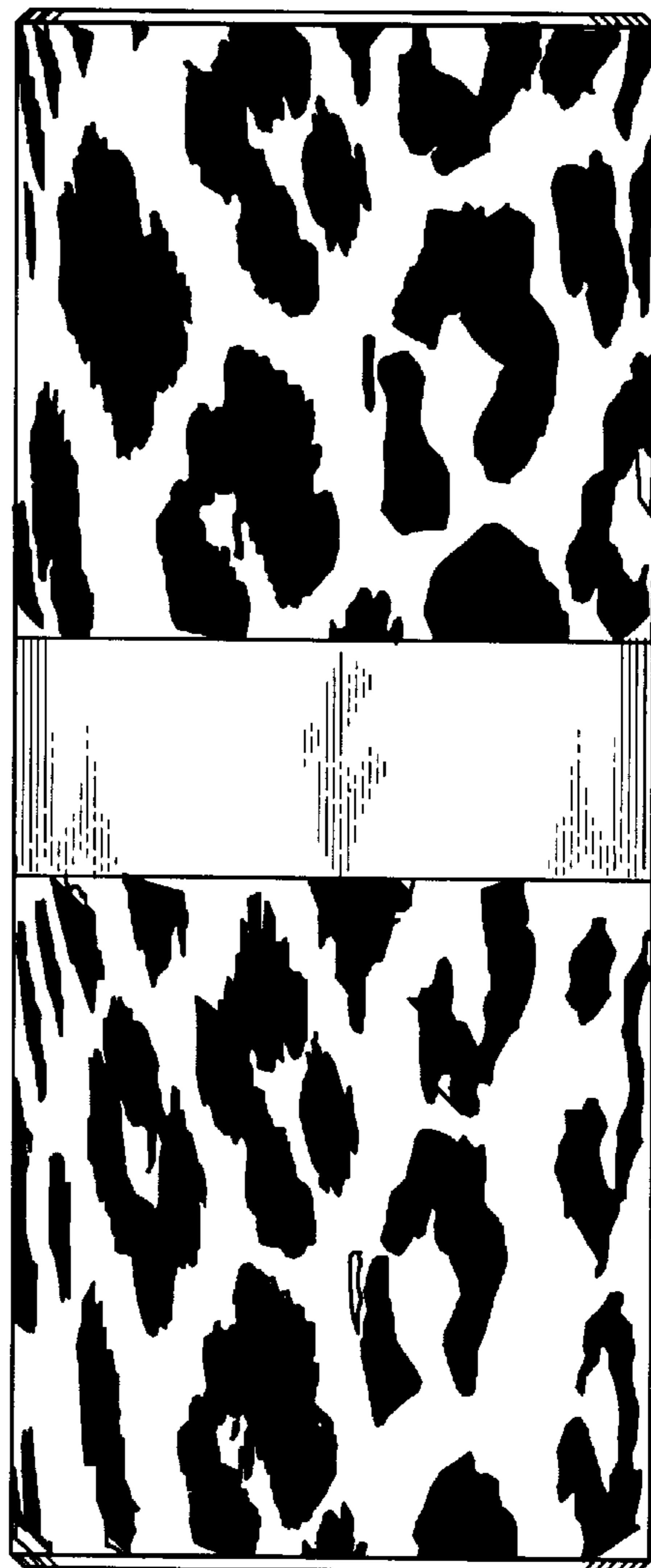

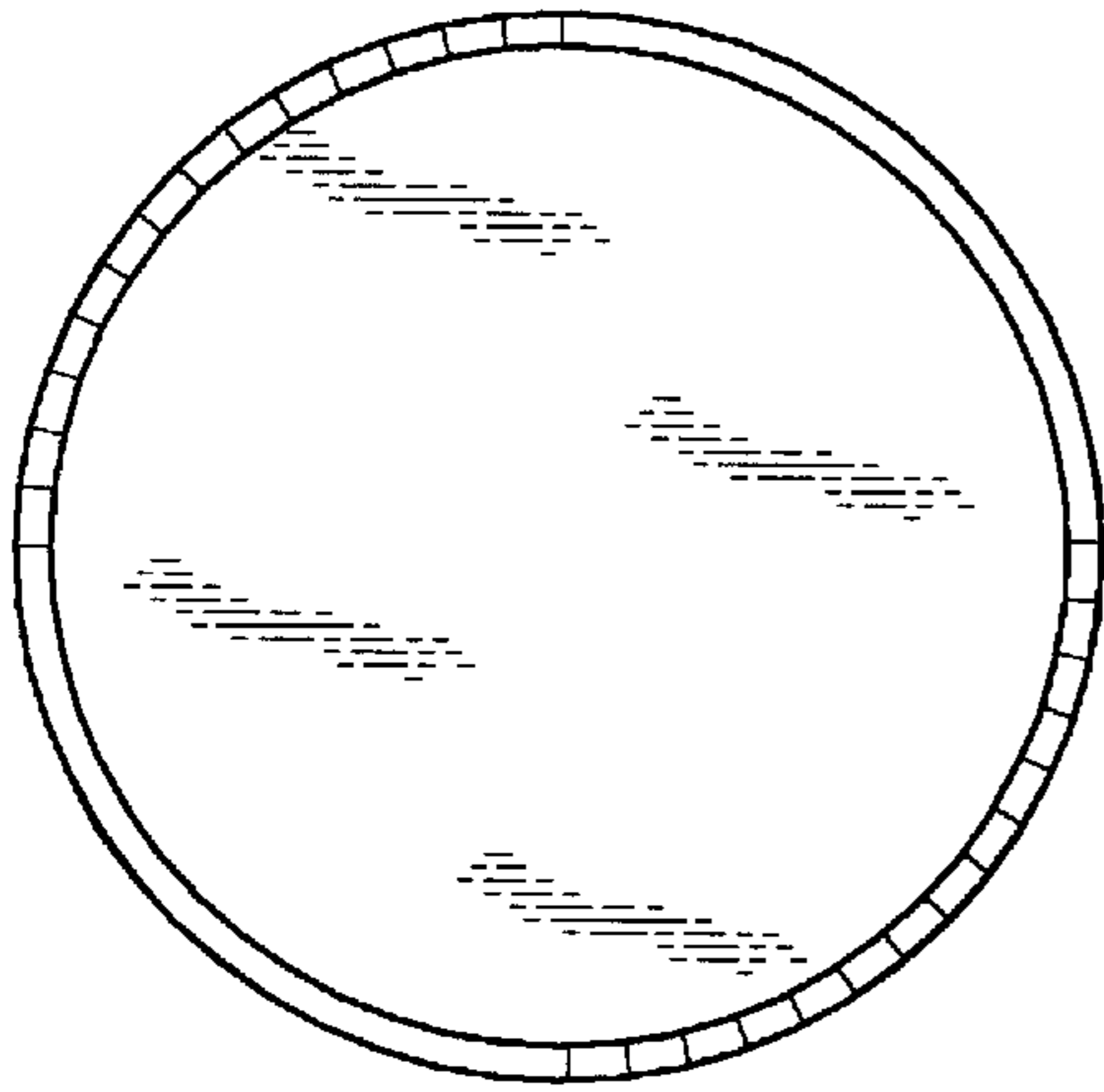

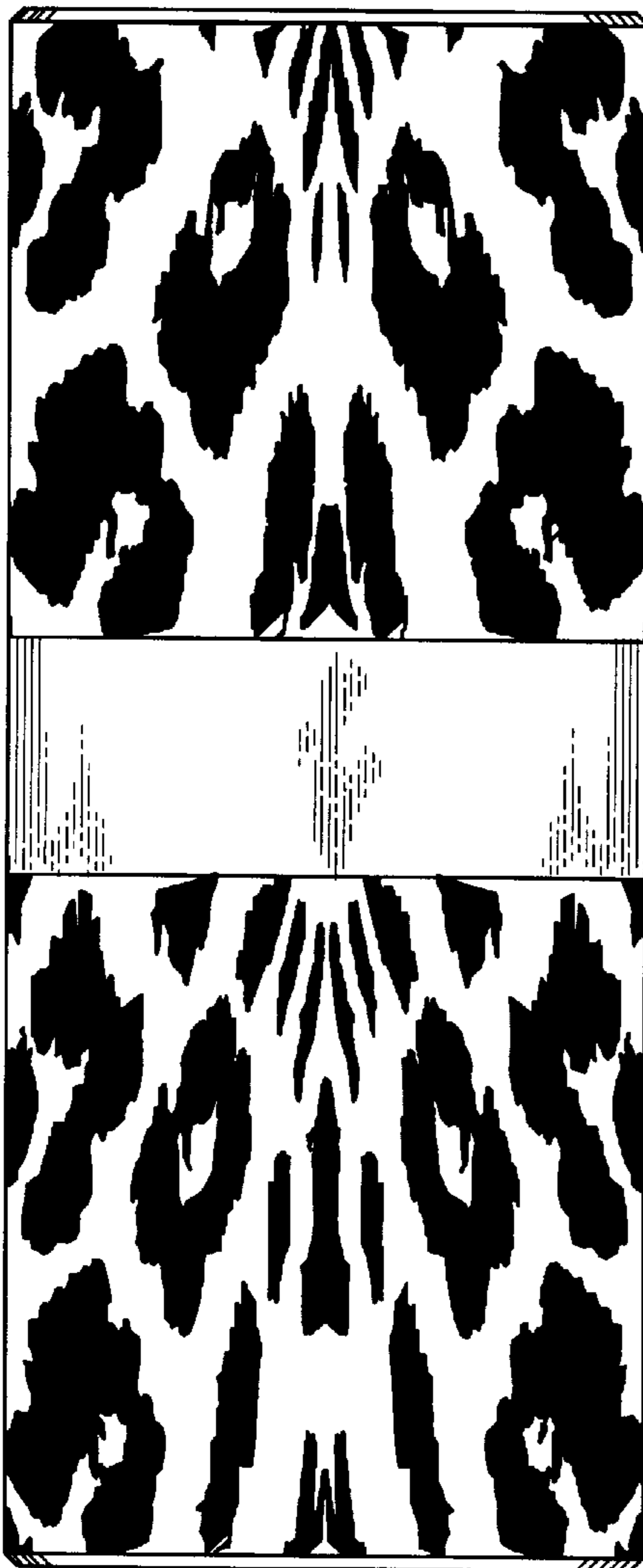

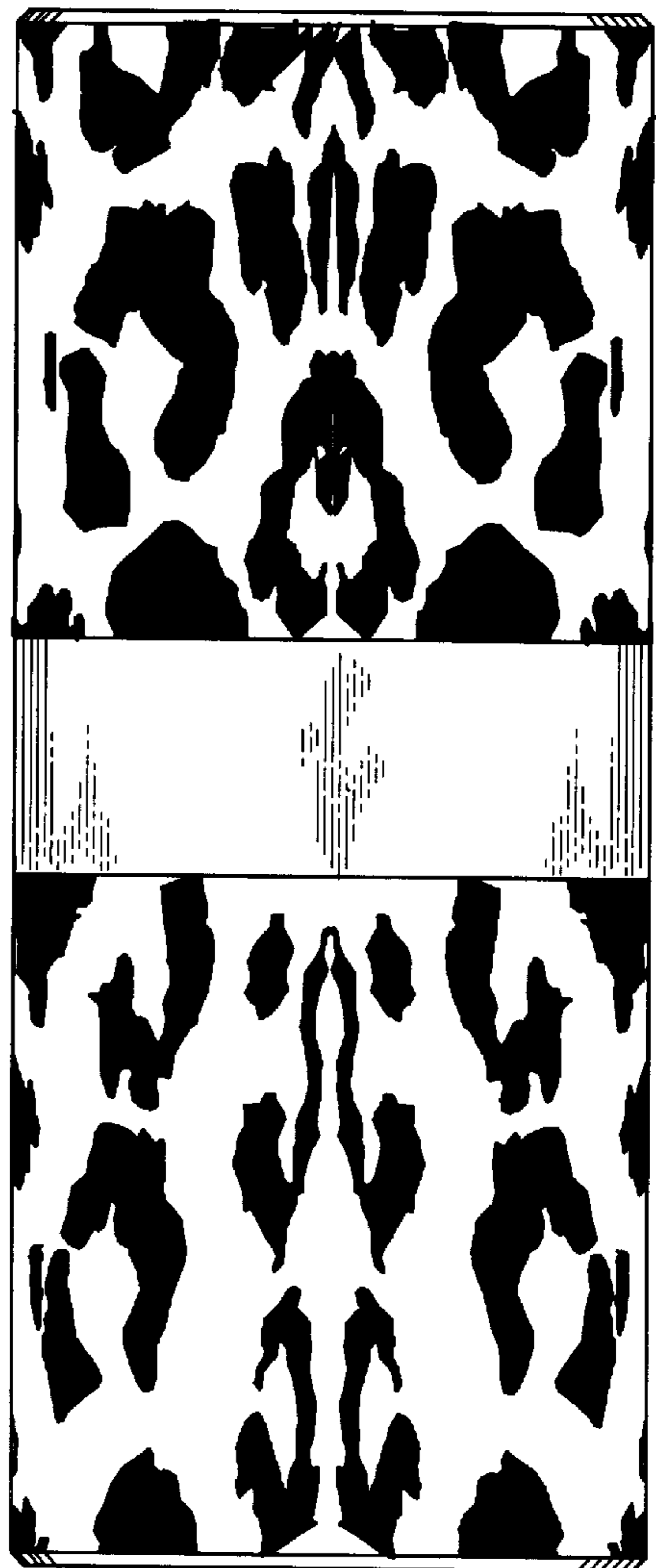

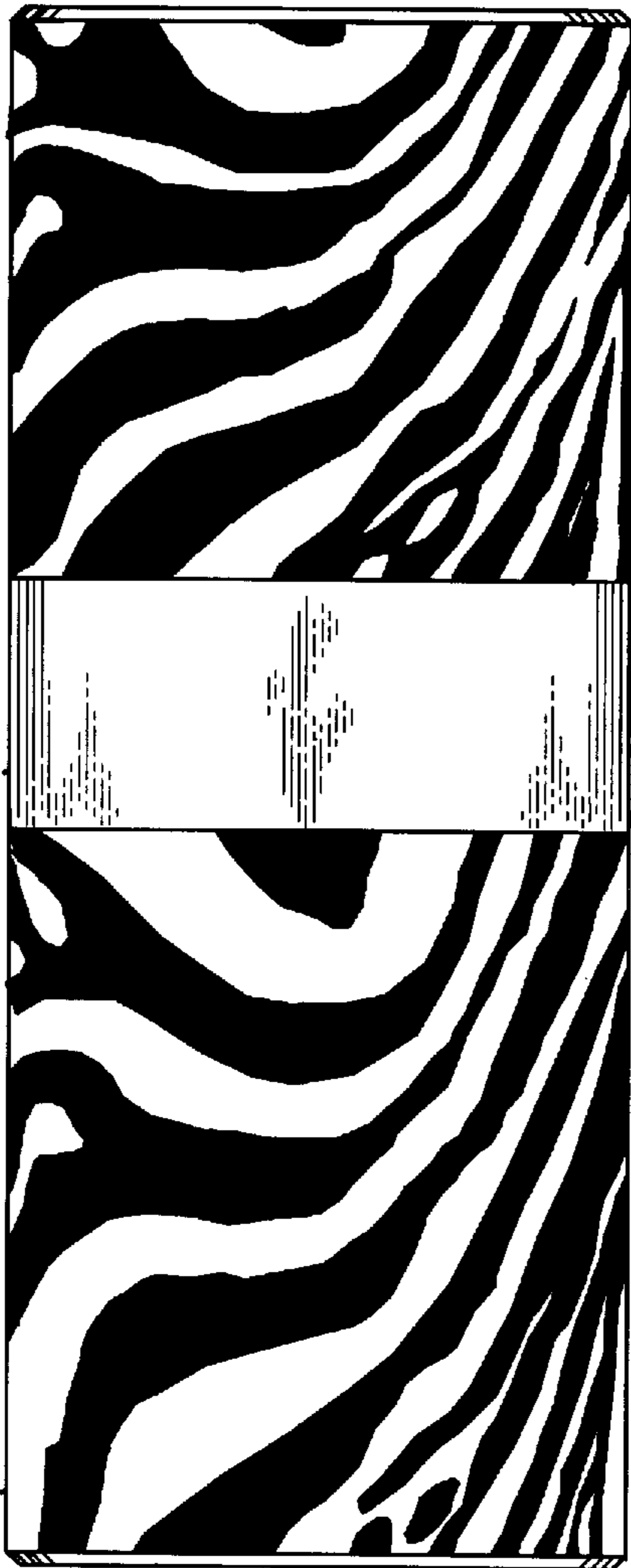
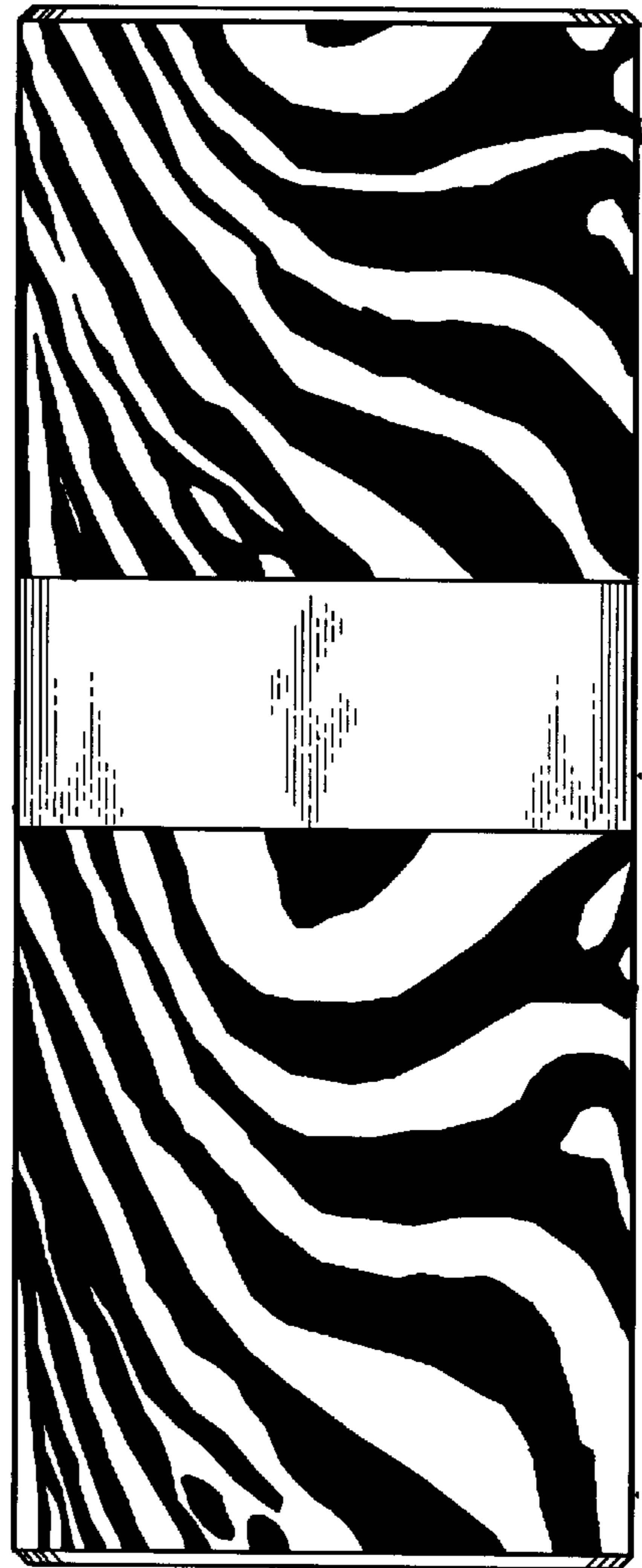

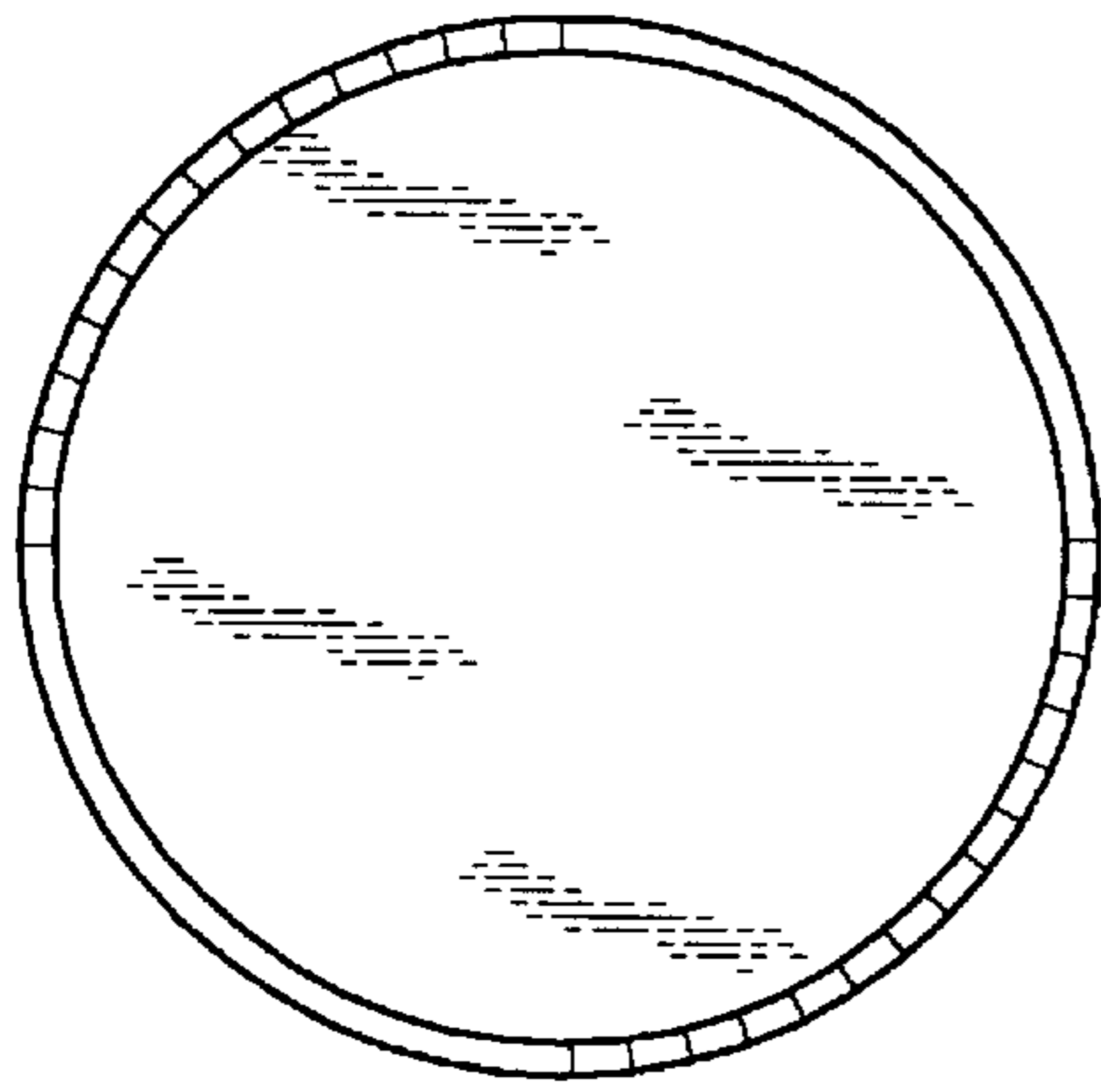

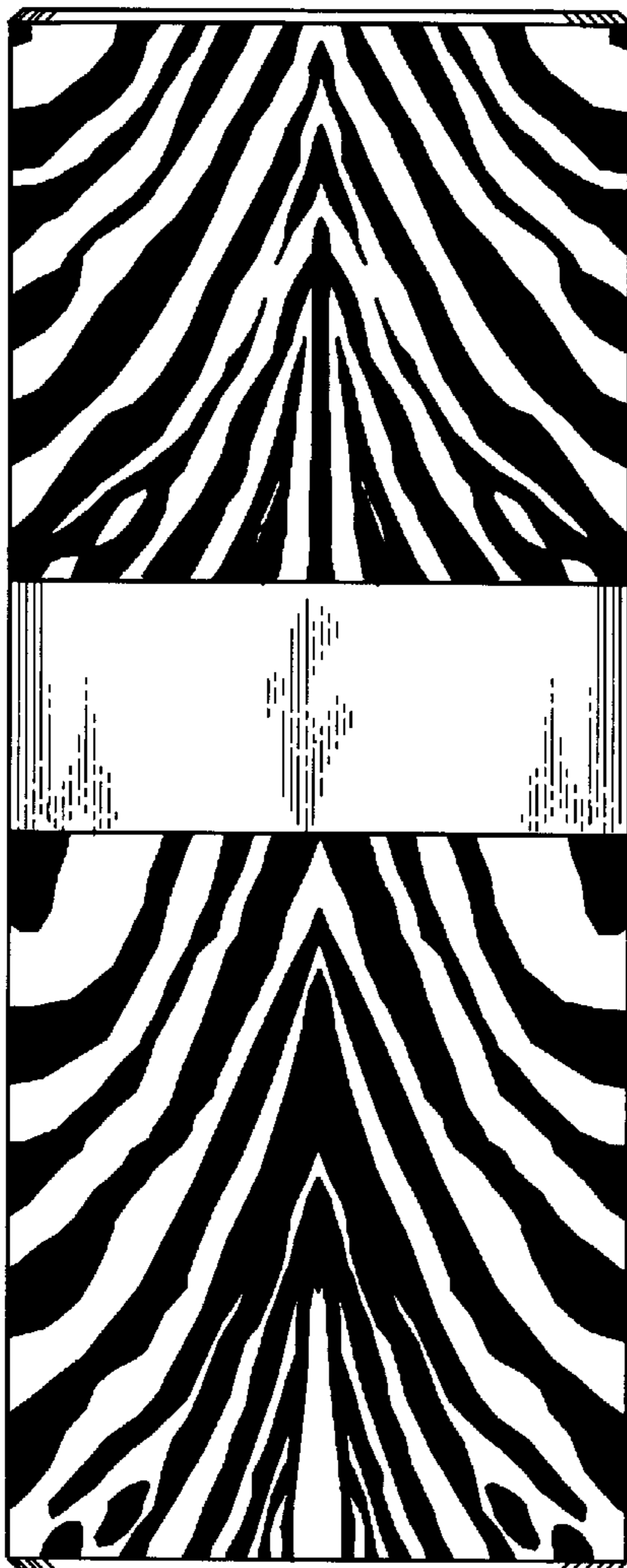
