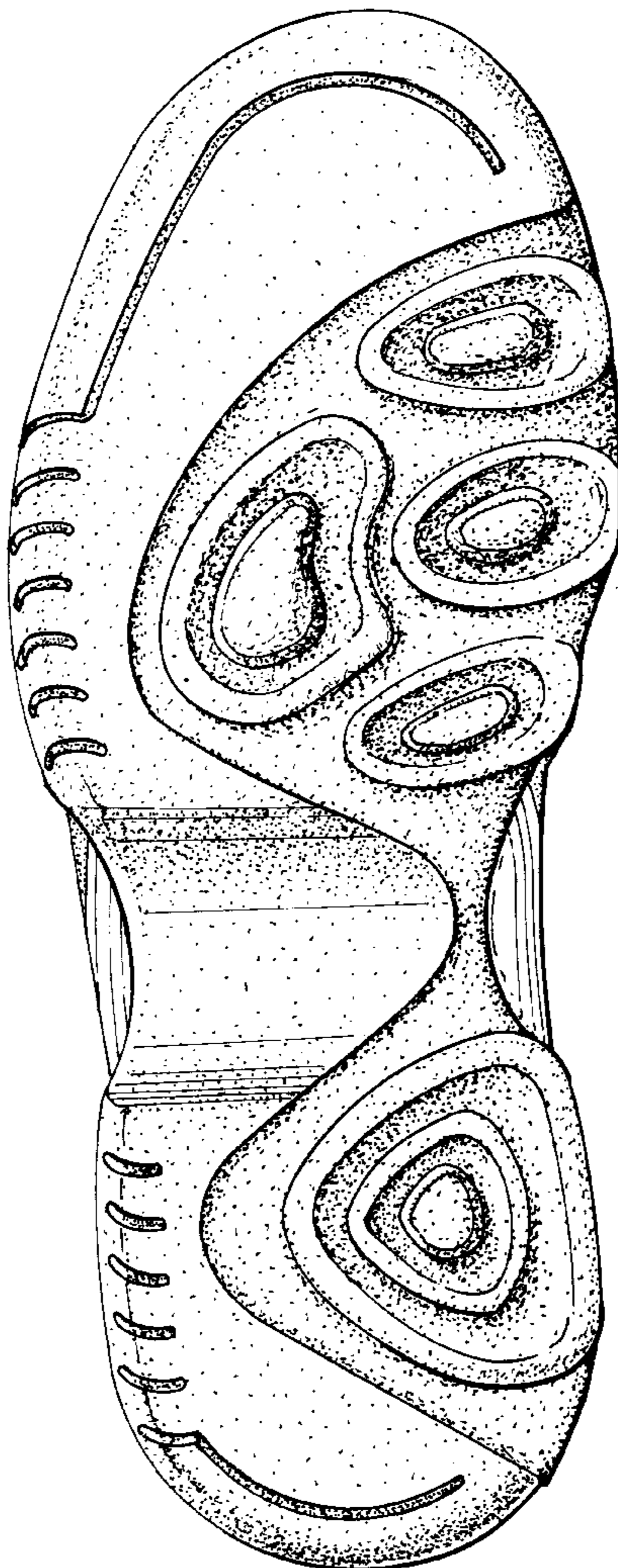
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom right perspective view of a shoe sole showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The broken line drawing of a shoe upper in FIGS. 1-6 is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of the claimed design.

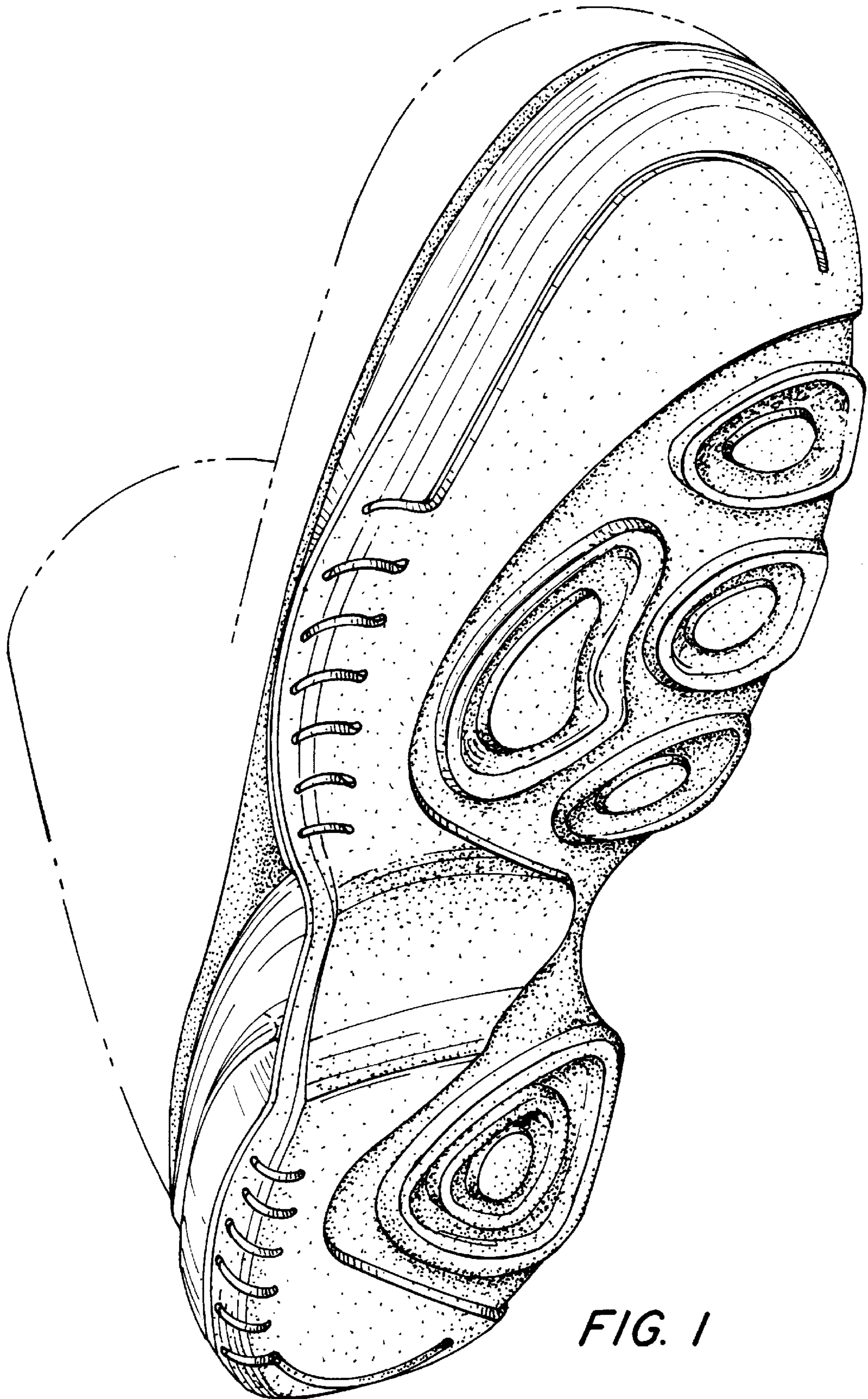

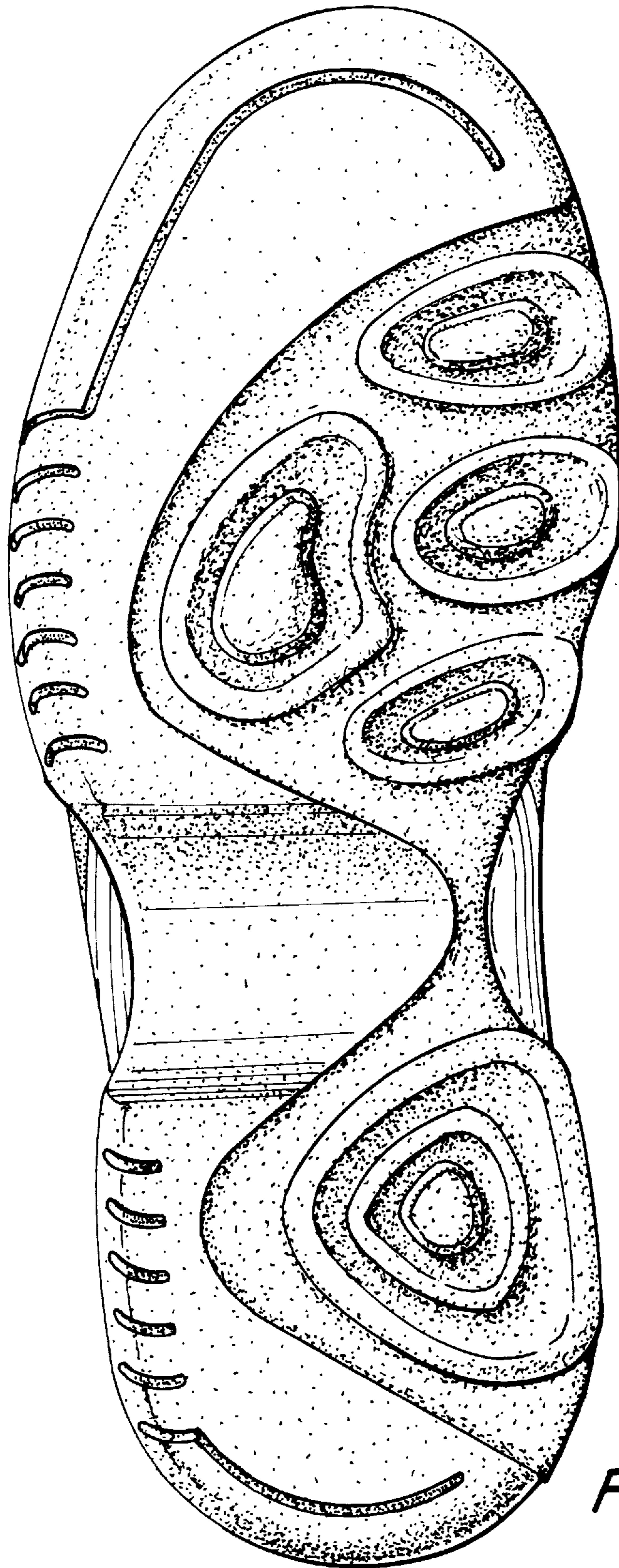

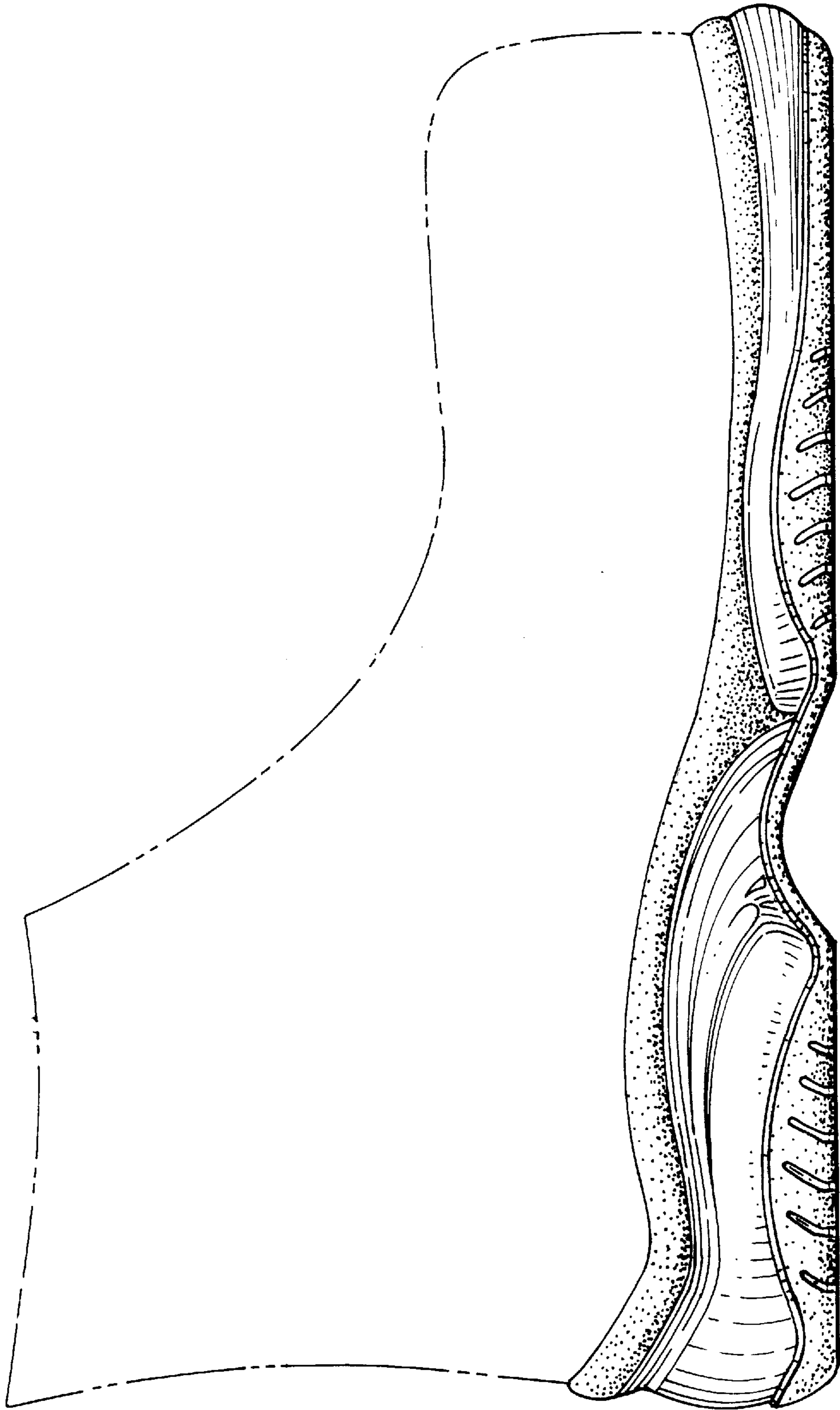

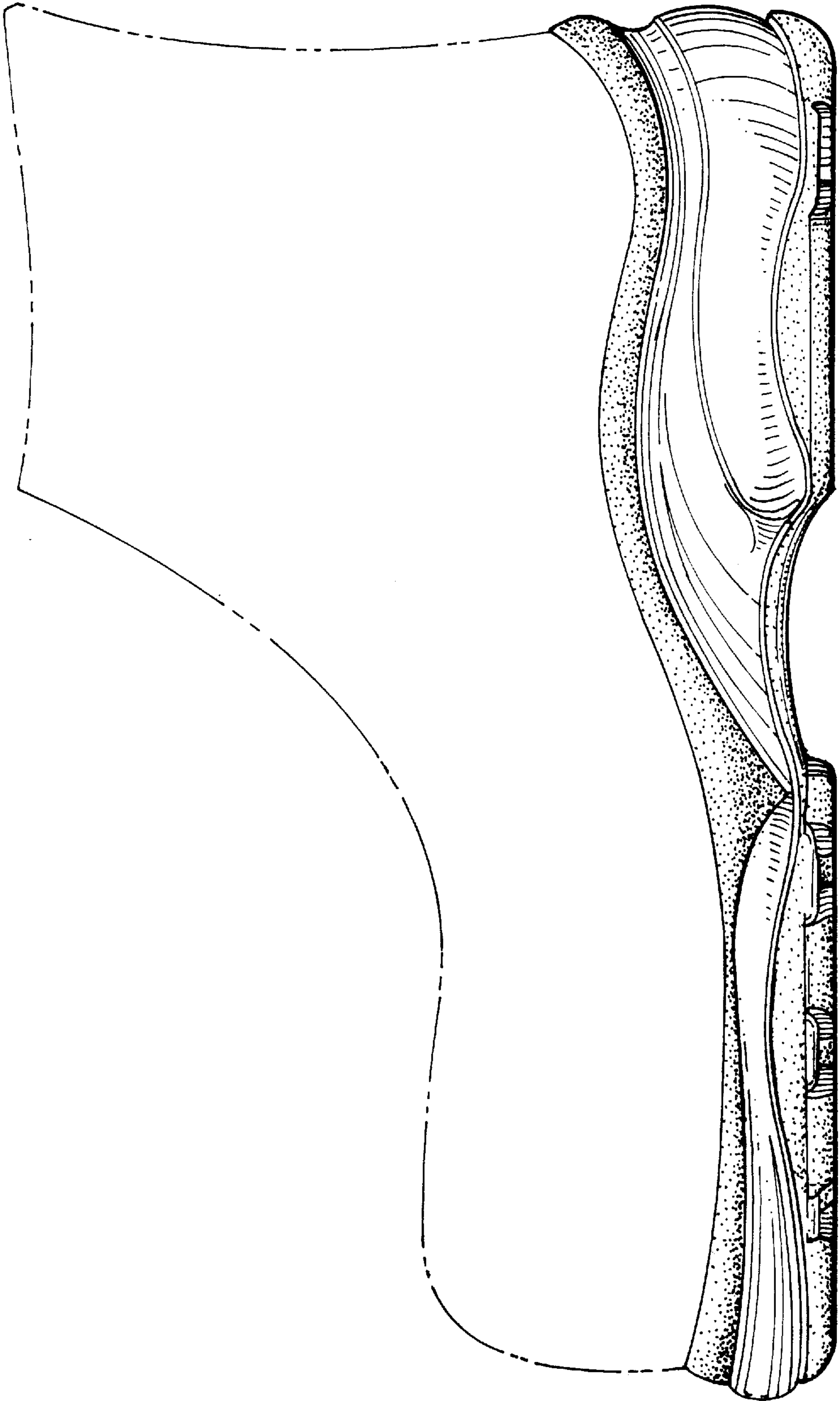

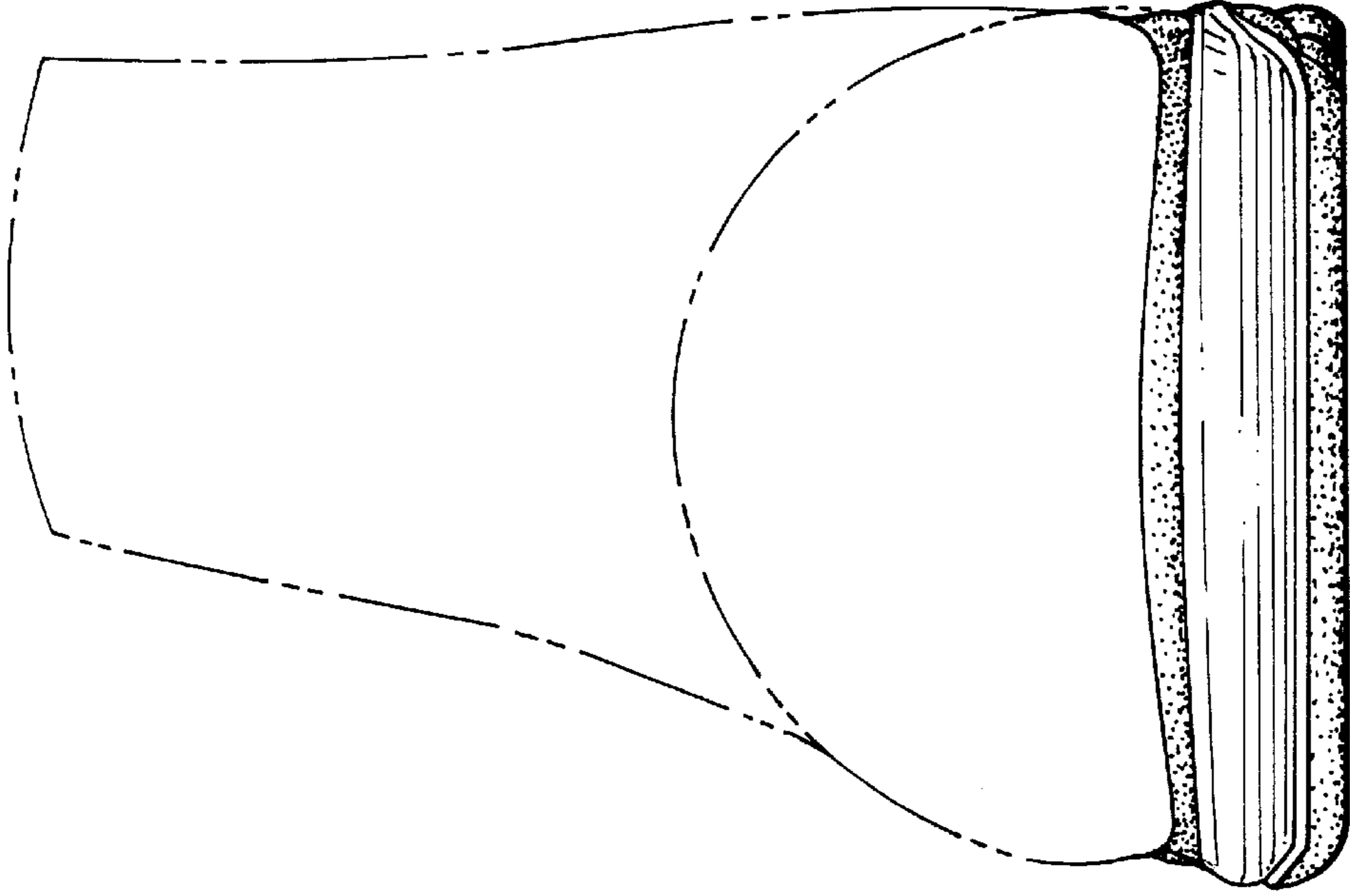

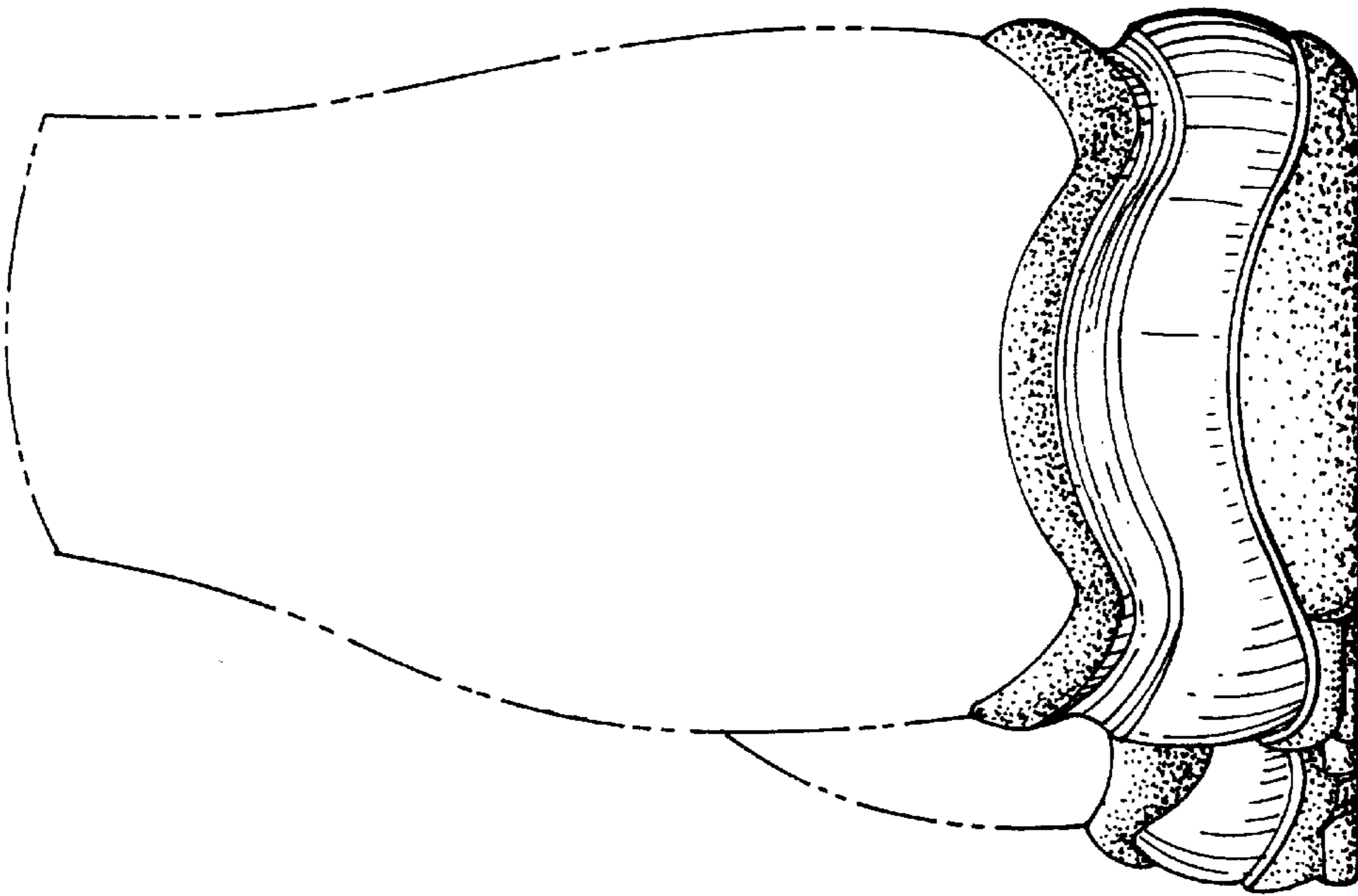
