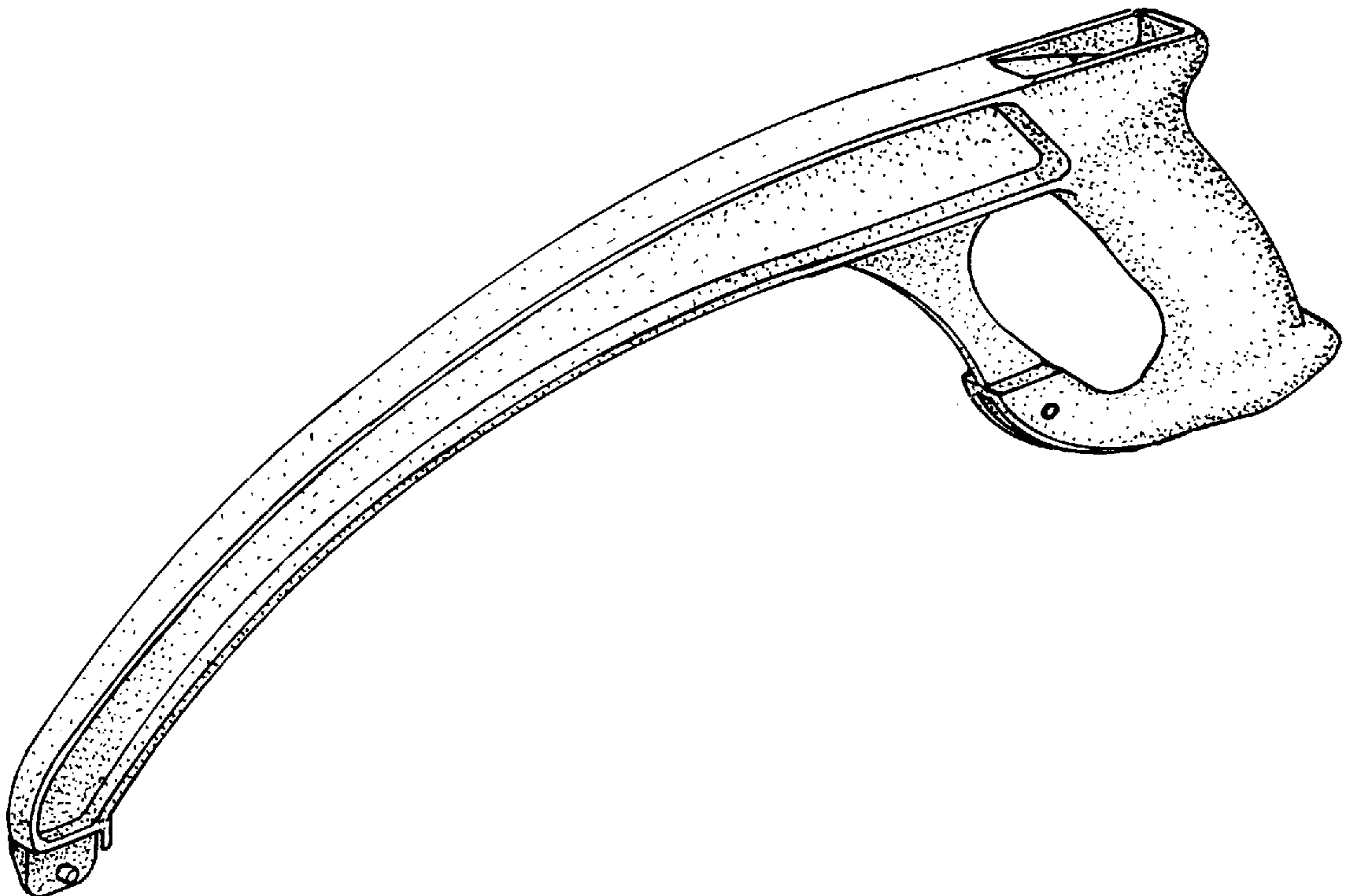
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a hacksaw frame, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a hacksaw frame showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an opposite side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a sectional view thereof taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 1 and looking toward the rear thereof;
FIG. 8 is a sectional view thereof taken along the line 8—8 of FIG. 1 and looking toward the front thereof; and,
FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof.

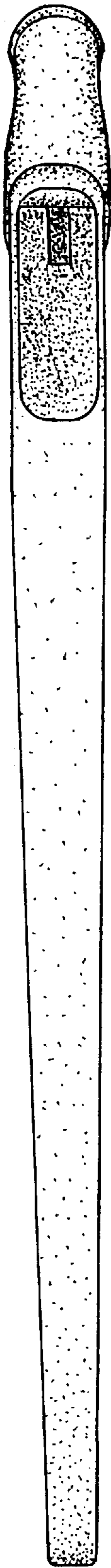

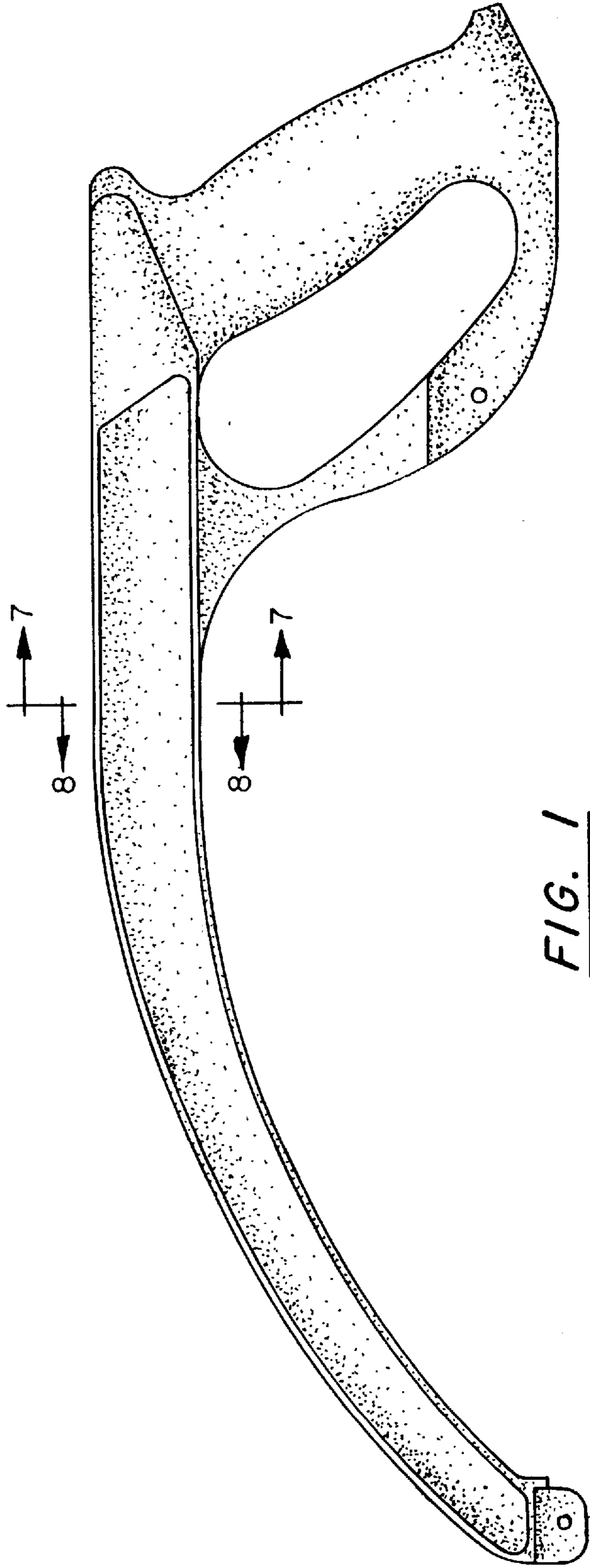

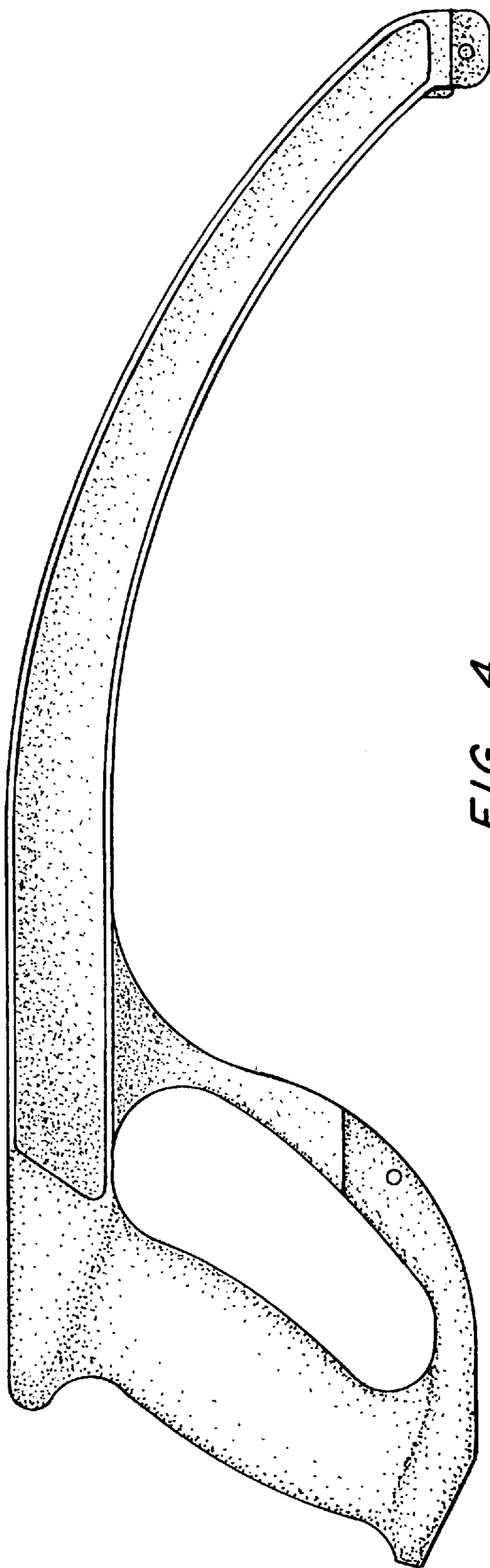

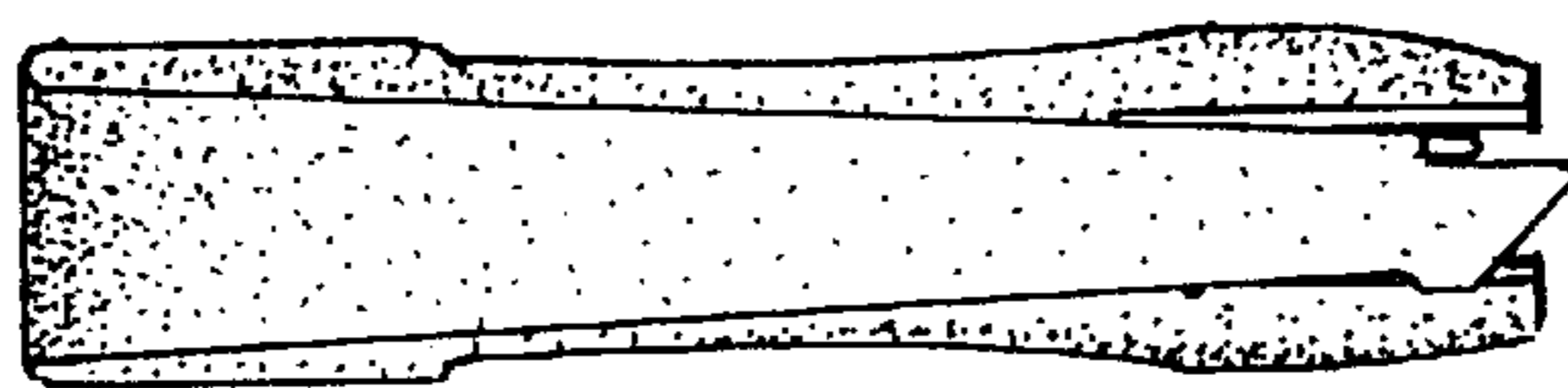

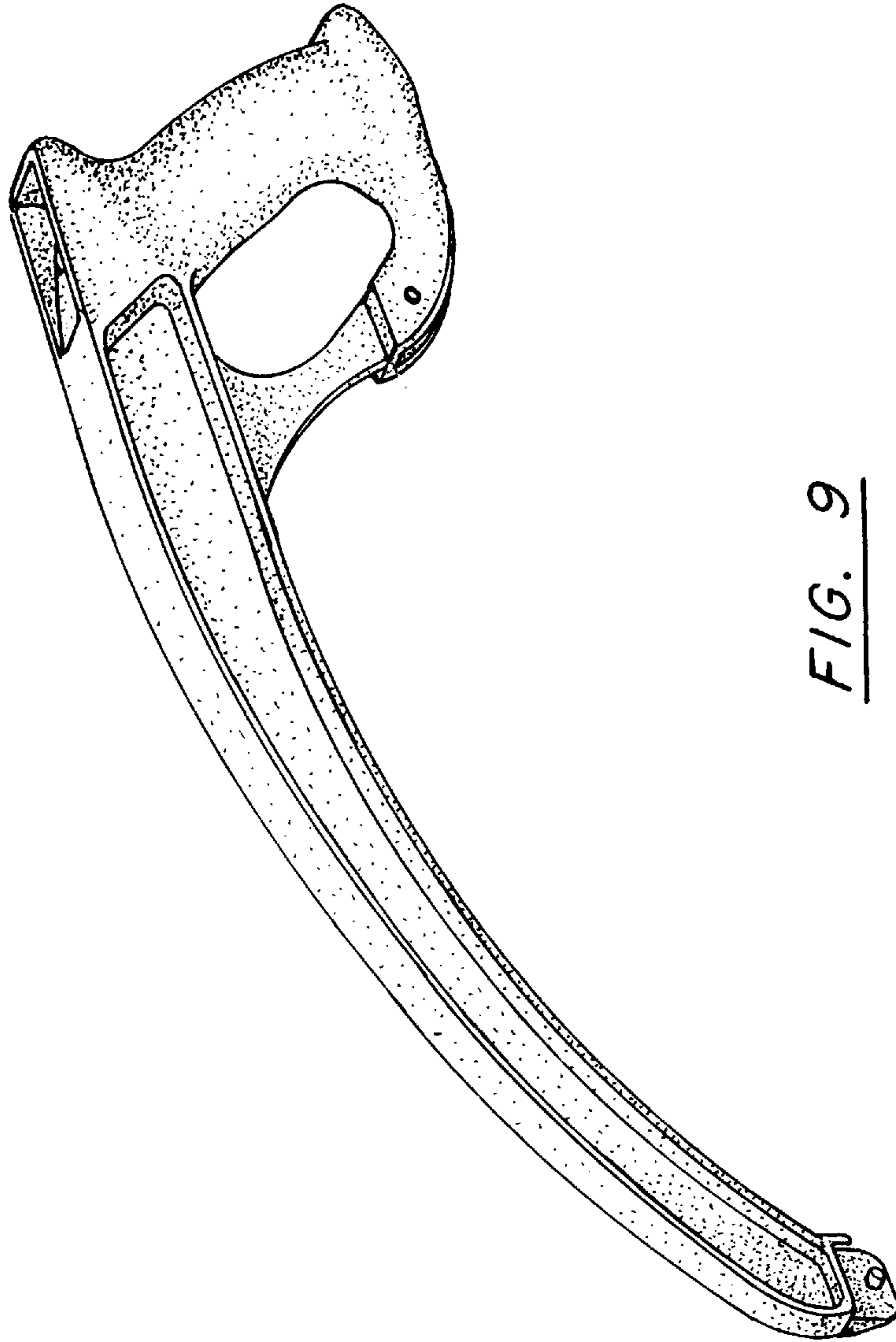
