We claim the ornamental design for a doll, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a doll showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a front view of the doll;
 FIG. 3 is a back view of the doll;
 FIG. 4 is a side elevation of the doll as seen from the right side of FIG. 2.
 FIG. 5 is a side elevation of the doll as seen from the left side of FIG. 2.
 FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and,
 FIG. 7 is a top view thereof.

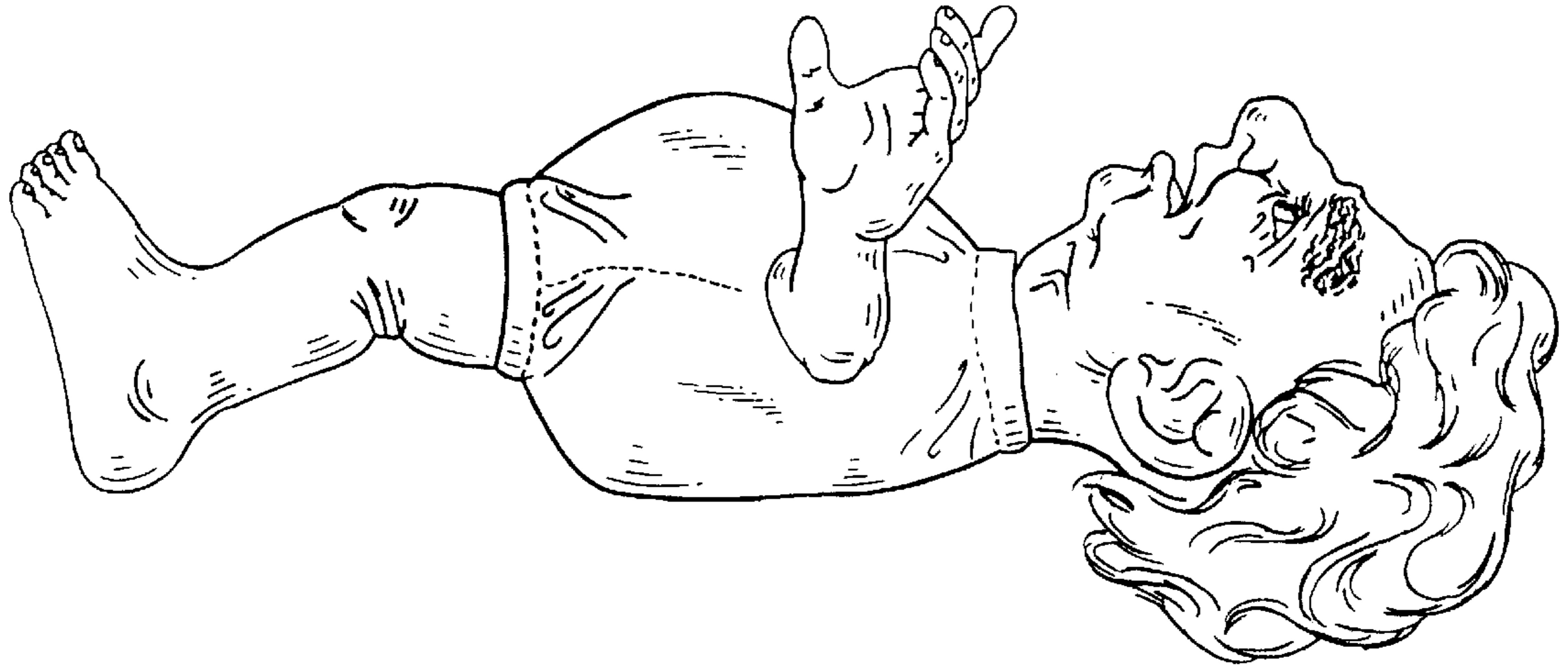

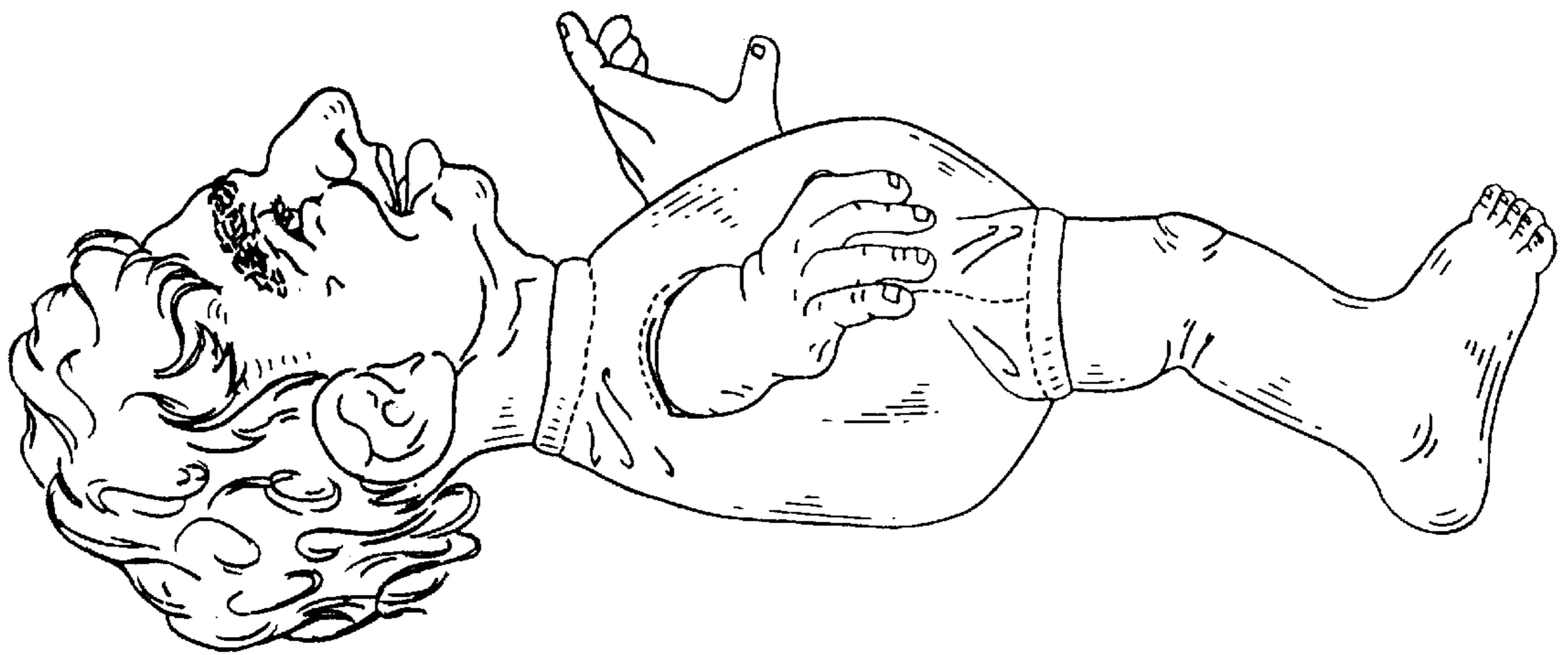

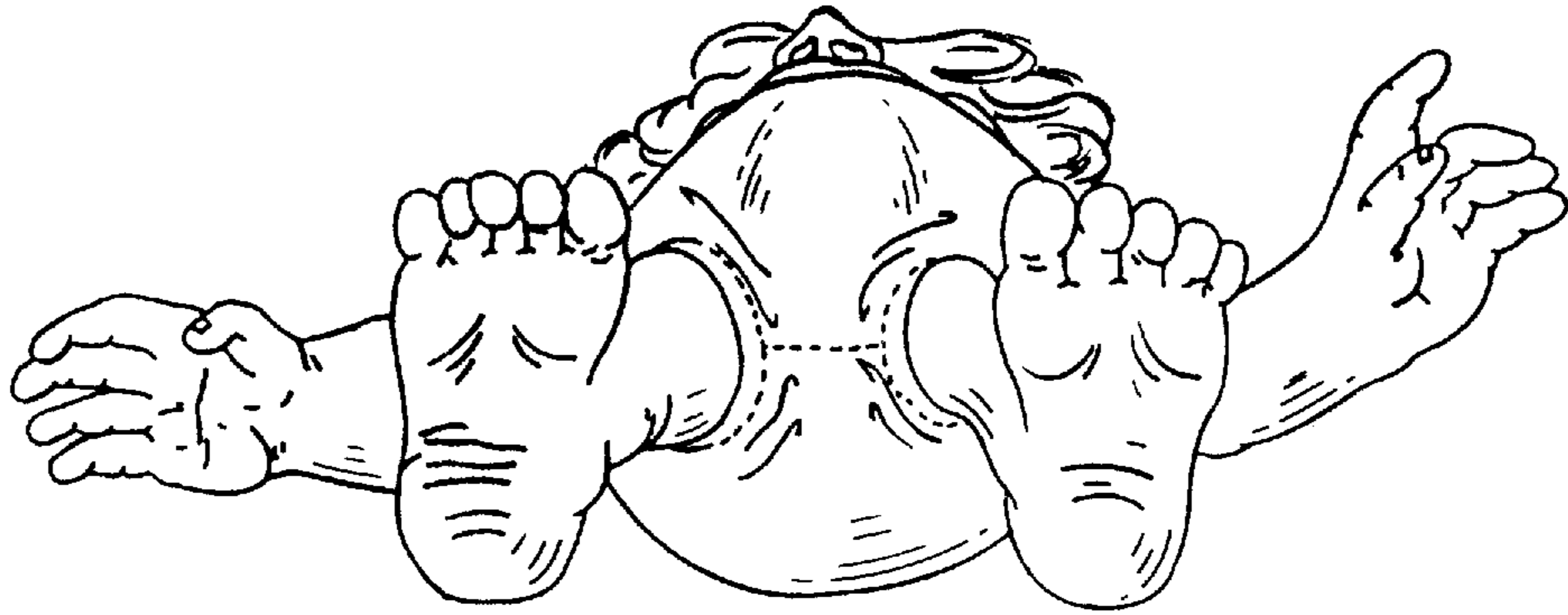
