[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a disposable absorbent article chassis, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The FIGURE is a top plan view of a disposable absorbent article chassis, embodying my new design, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image.

The side and end elevational views are plain and unornamented and of a thin conventional thickness.

The broken lines shown in the figures are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed invention.
