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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a filter basin, which can hold silt-collecting sock and sorbent material, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, perspective view of a filter basin, which can hold silt-collecting sock and sorbent material, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front side view thereof, the back side appearing essentially the same;

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof with the top, perforated mesh plate removed;

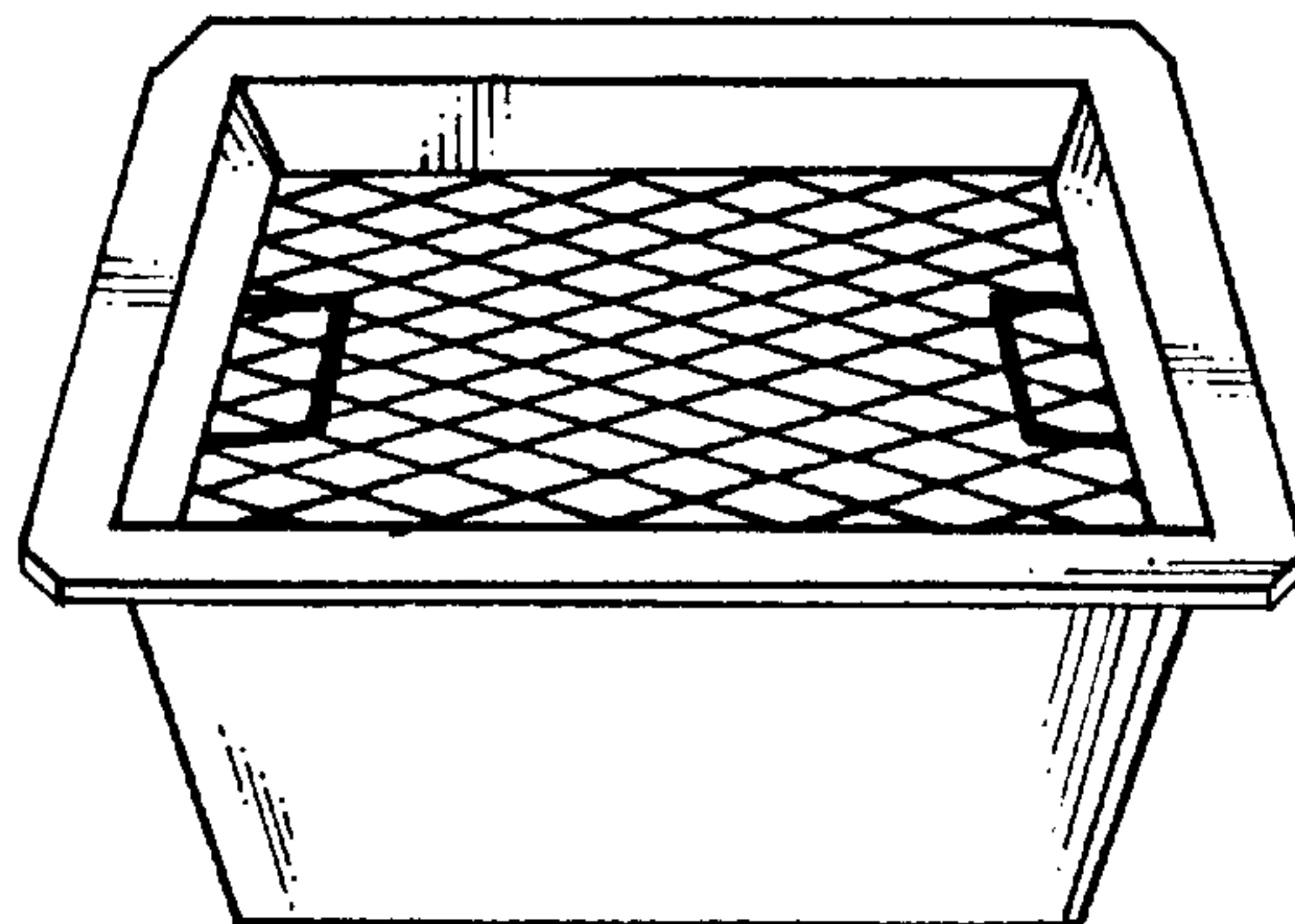
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment of a filter basin which can hold silt-collecting sock and sorbent material, showing our new design, the top, front, back, left and right side, and bottom views appearing substantially as shown in FIGS. 1–5 except for the squared off corners.

The broken-line showing of environmental structure in FIG. 4 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

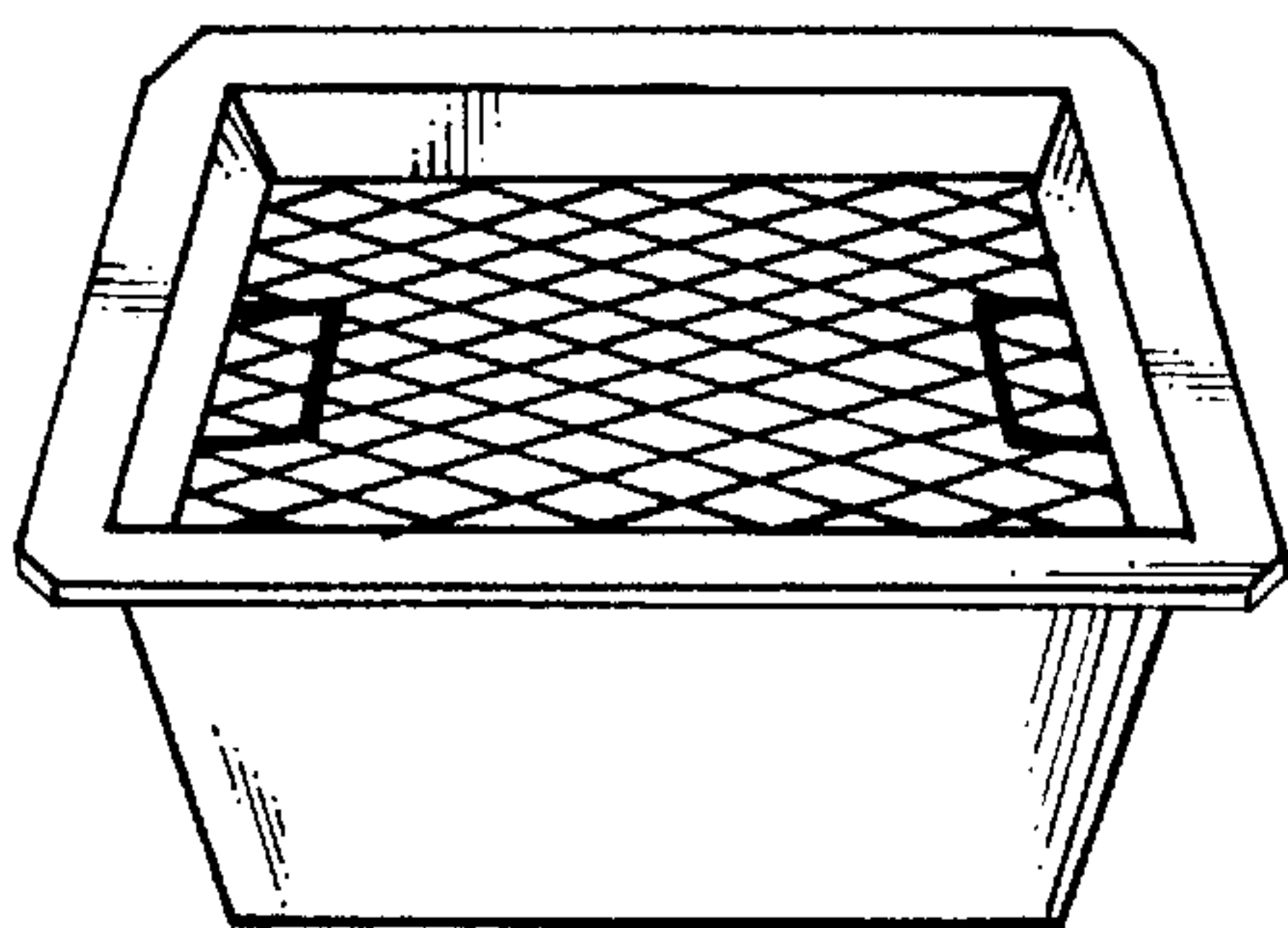

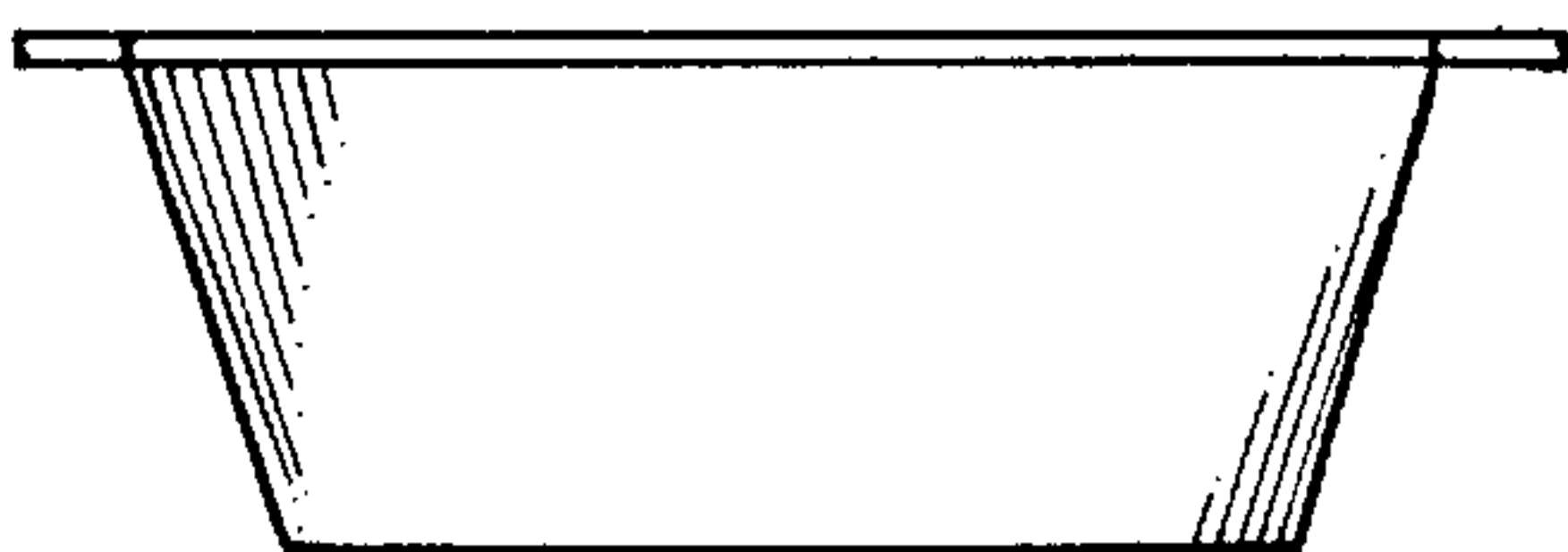

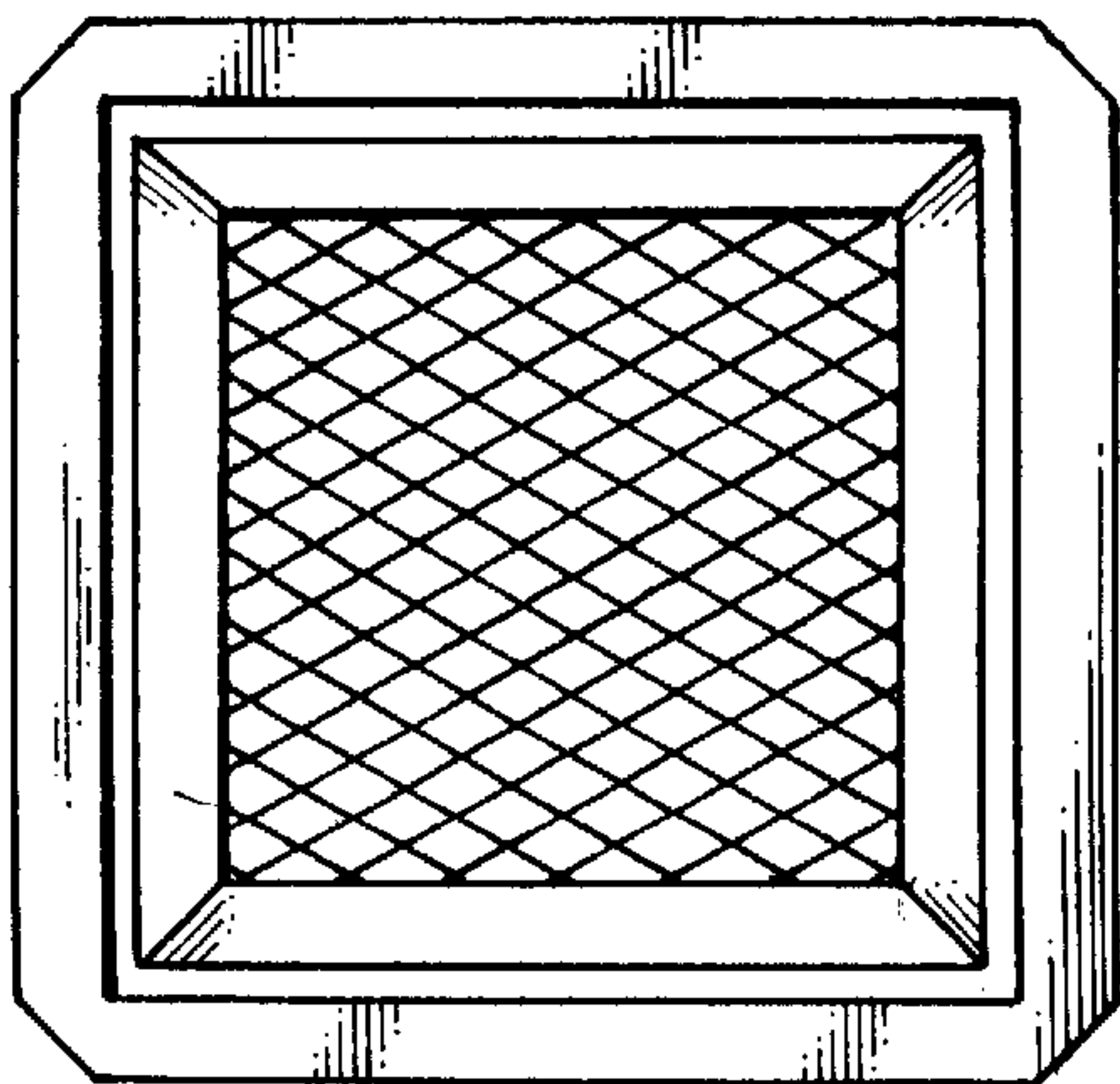

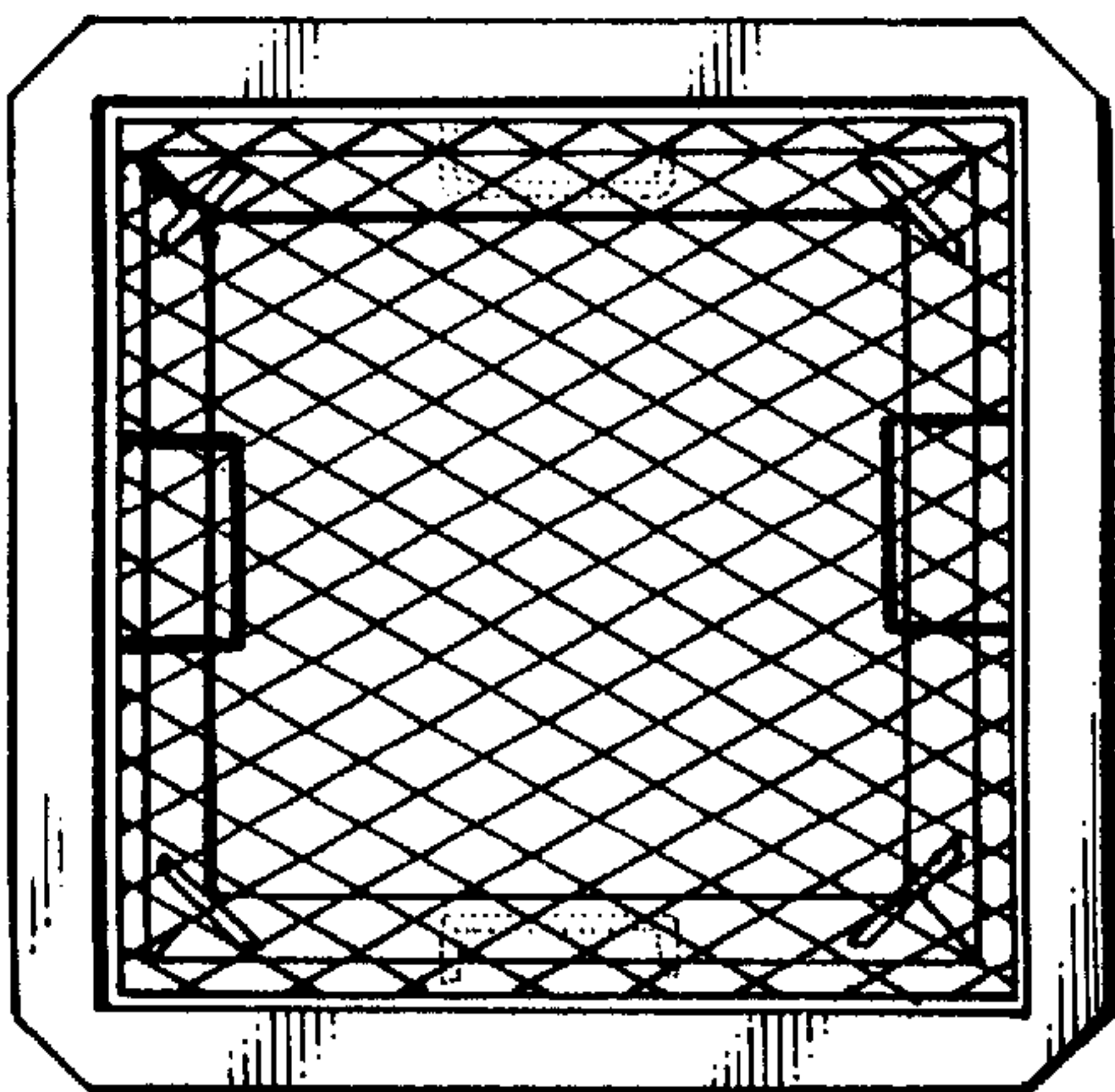

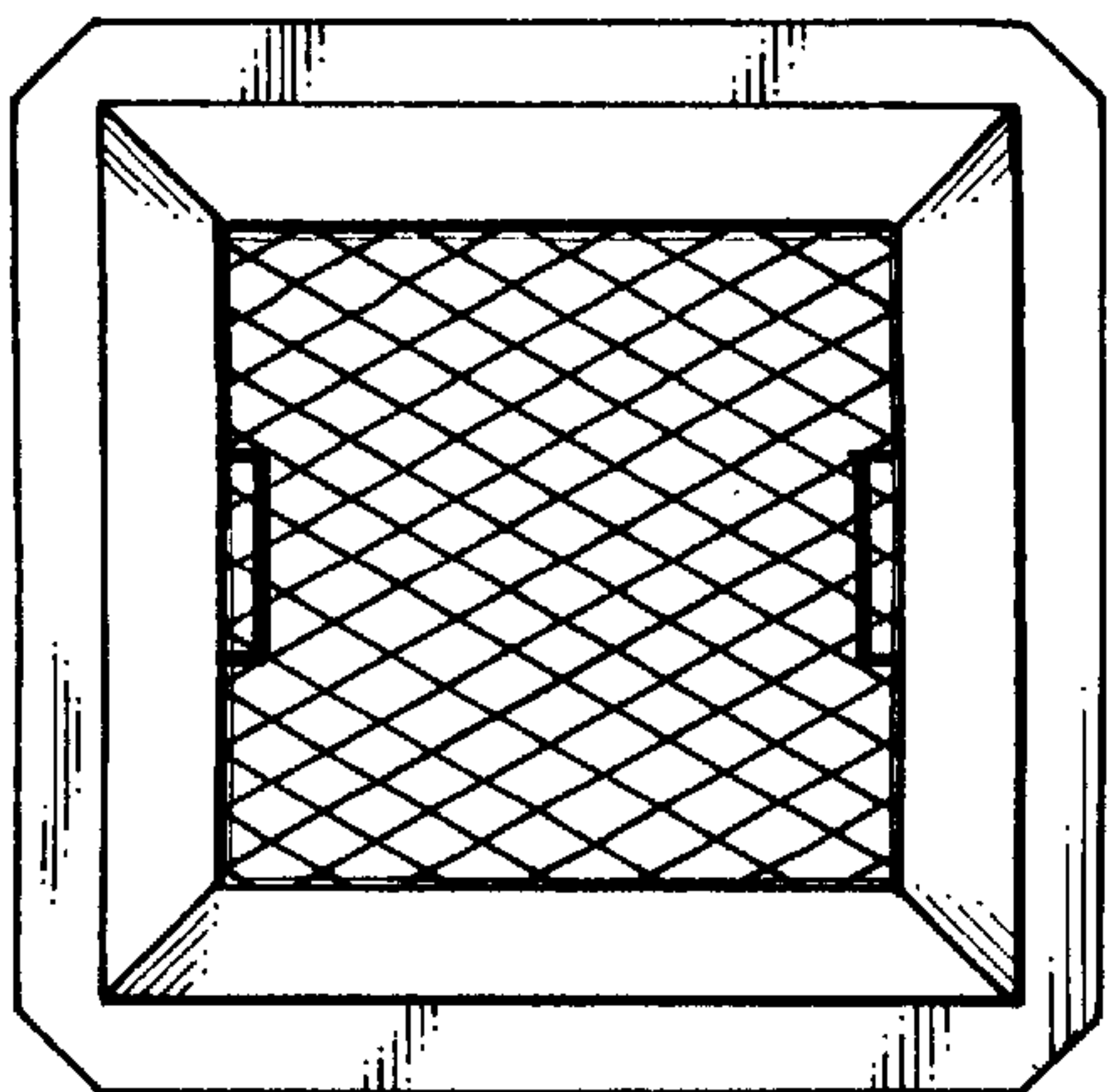

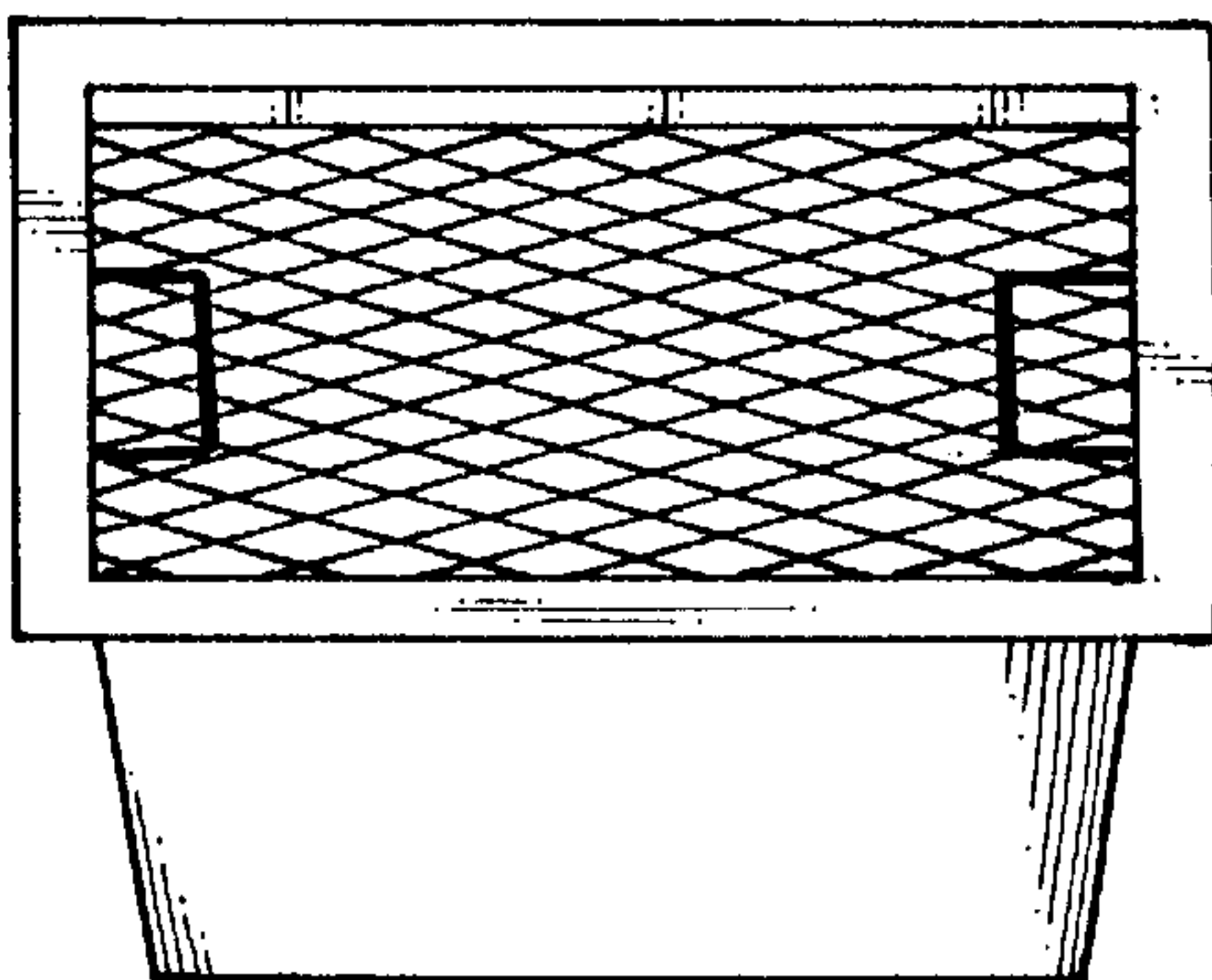
