### [57] CLAIM

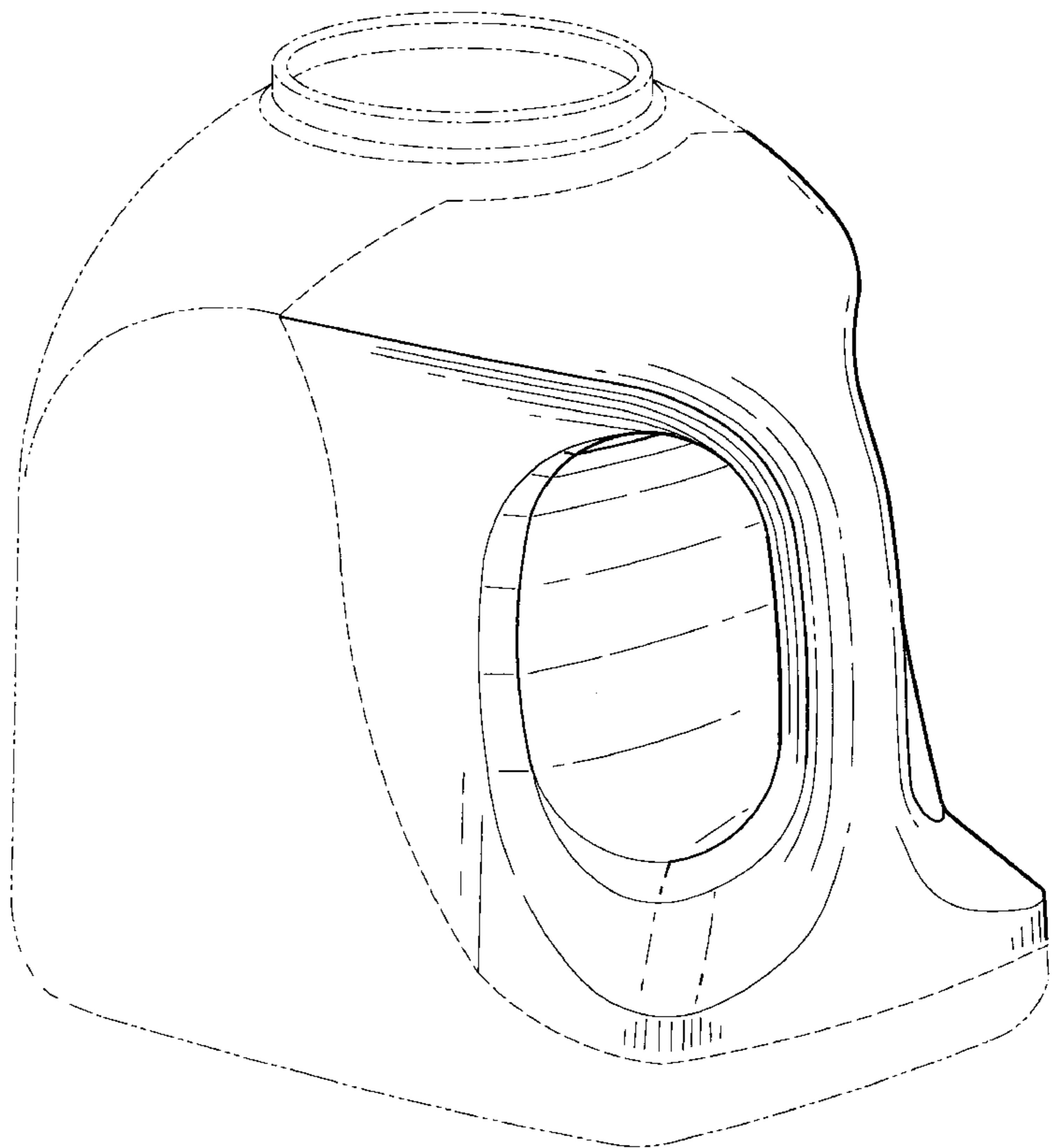
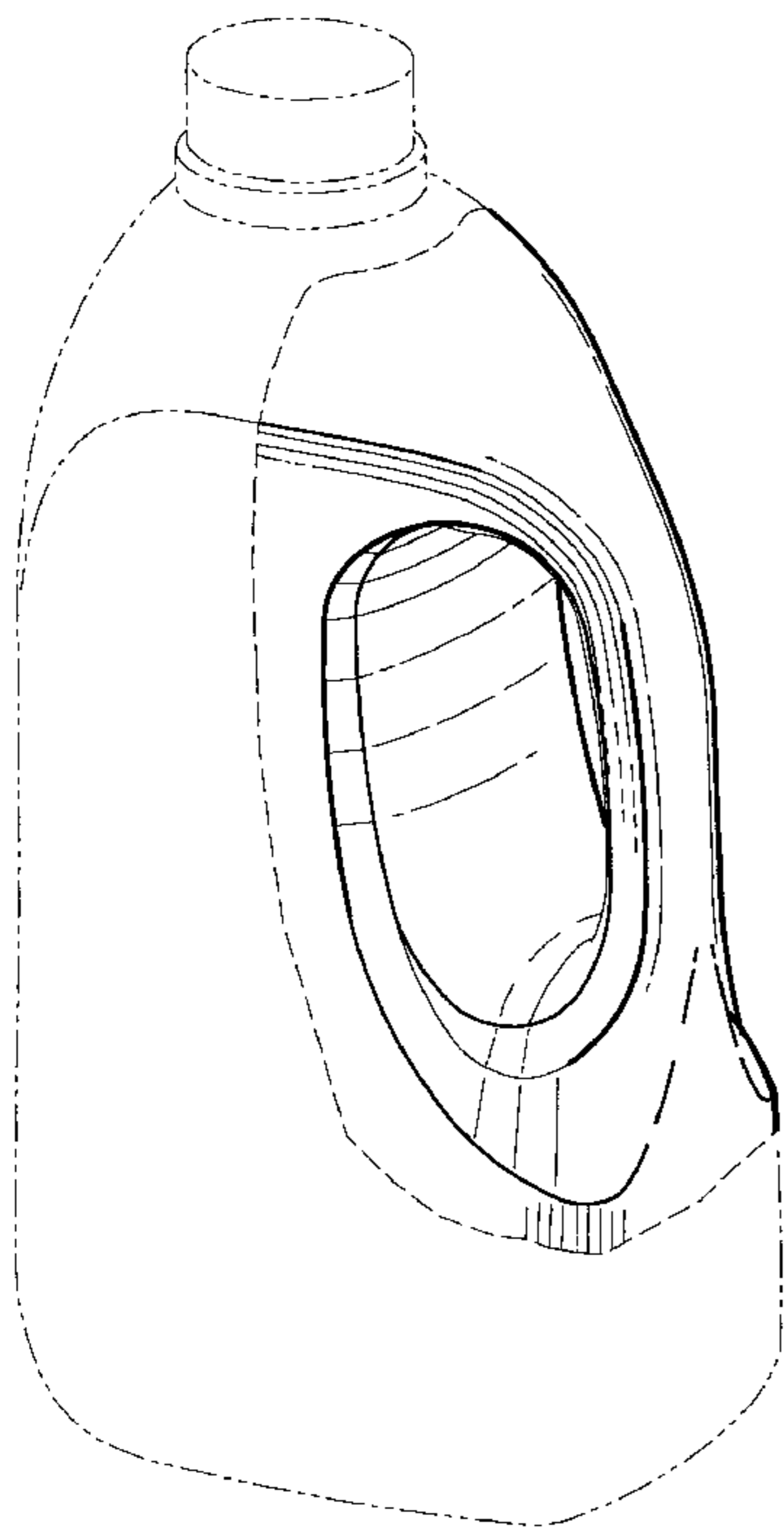
The ornamental design for a bottle handle, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle handle, embodying our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a back view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of an alternative embodiment of our bottle handle;  
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a back elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 8 is a top view thereof.

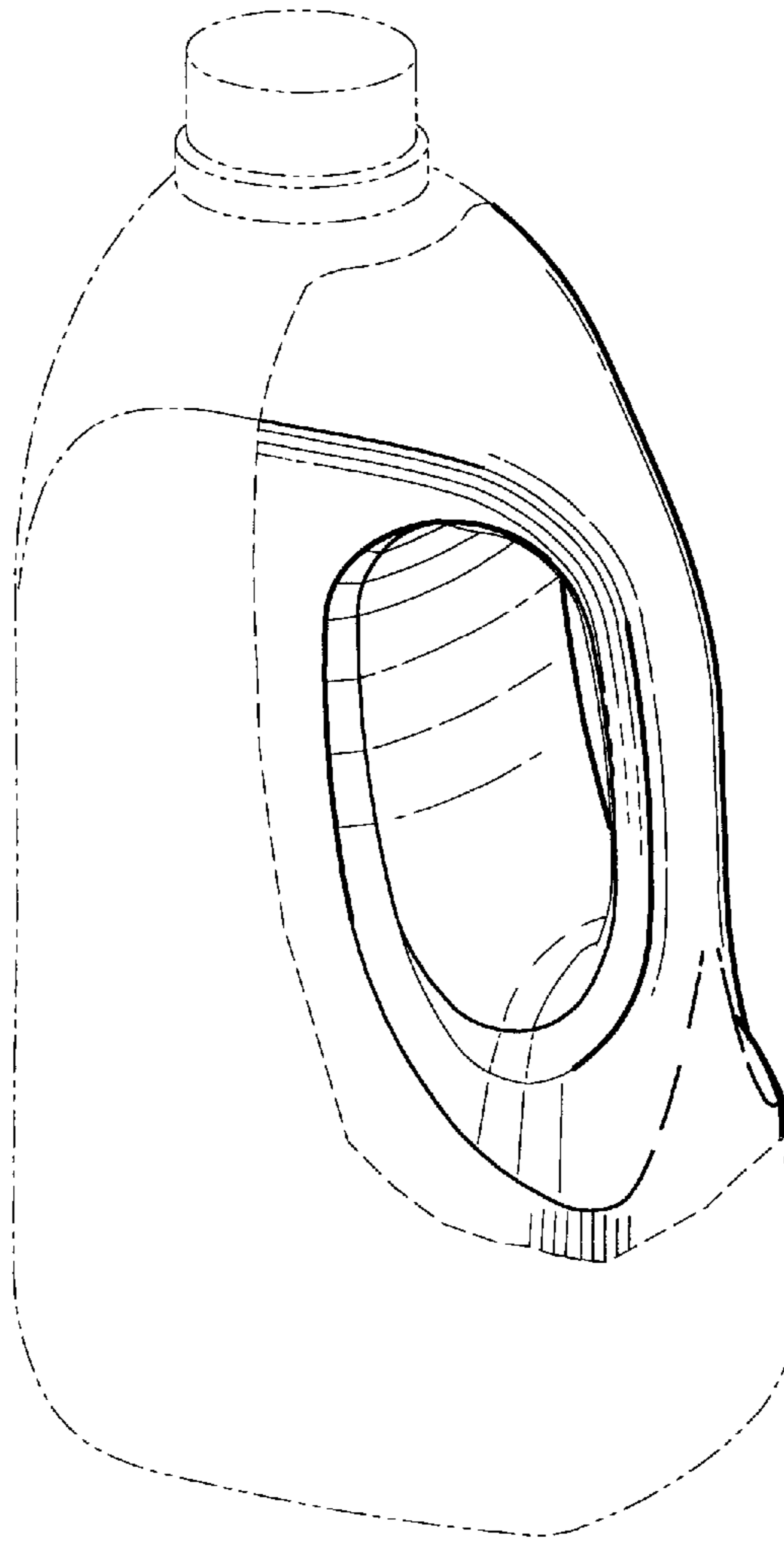

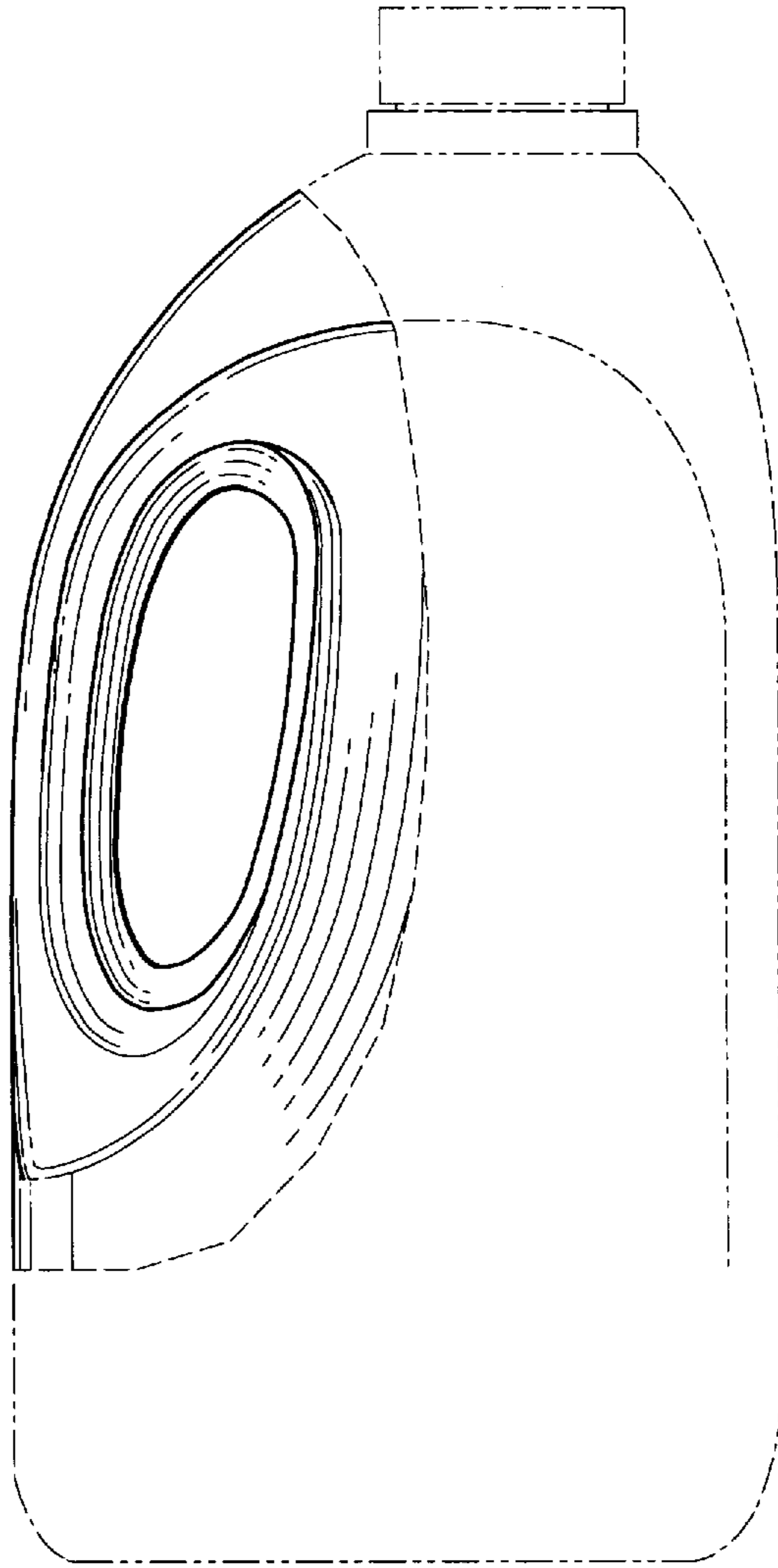

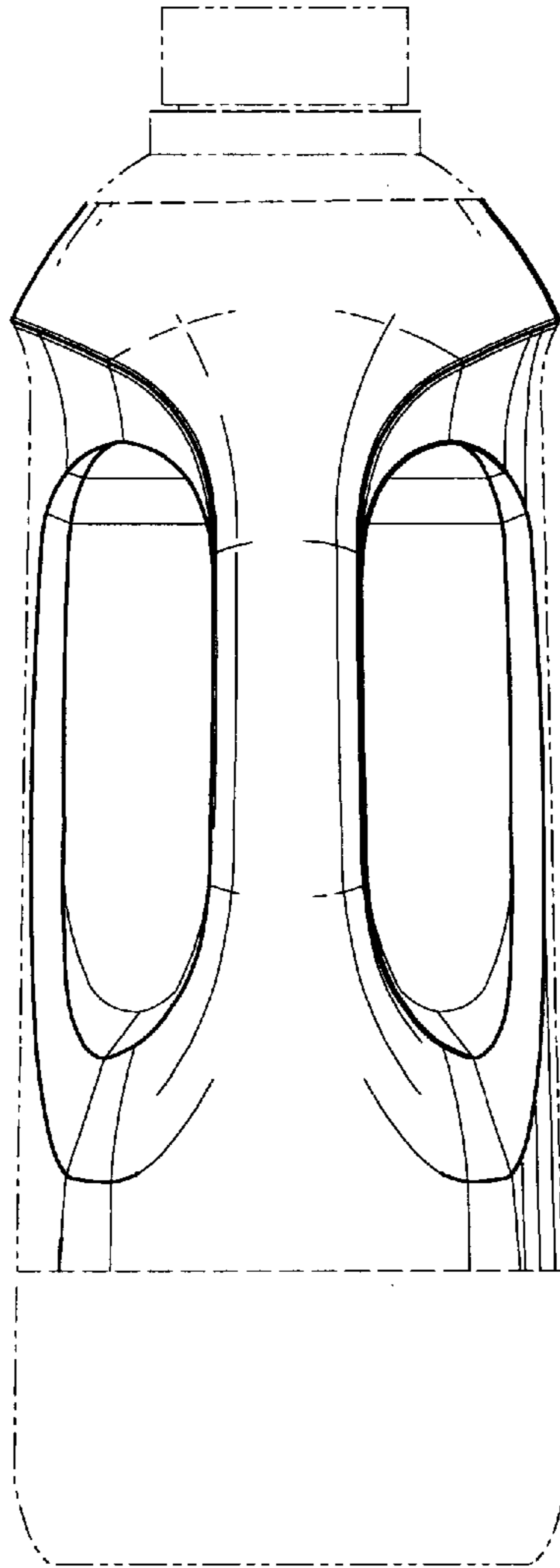

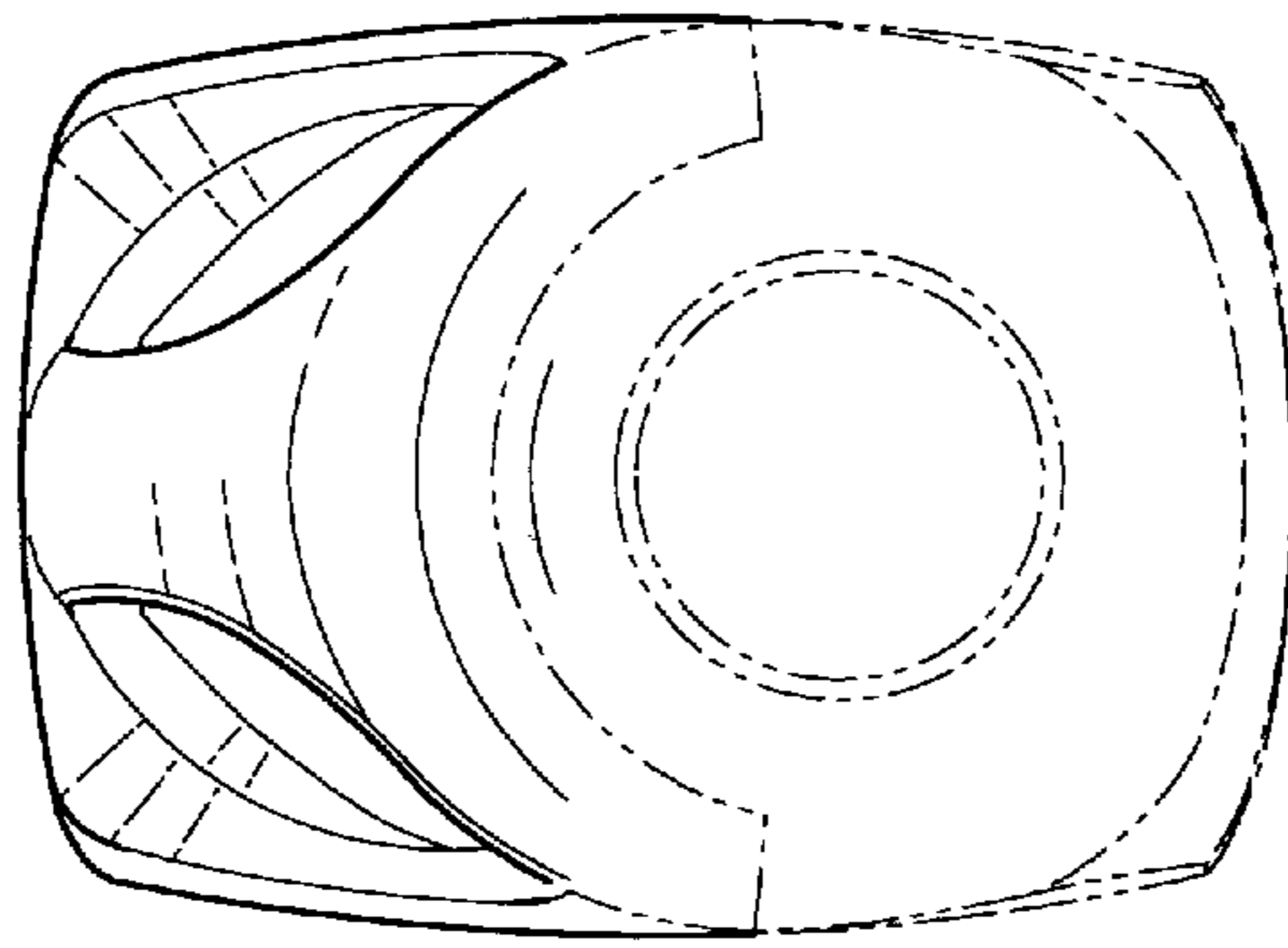

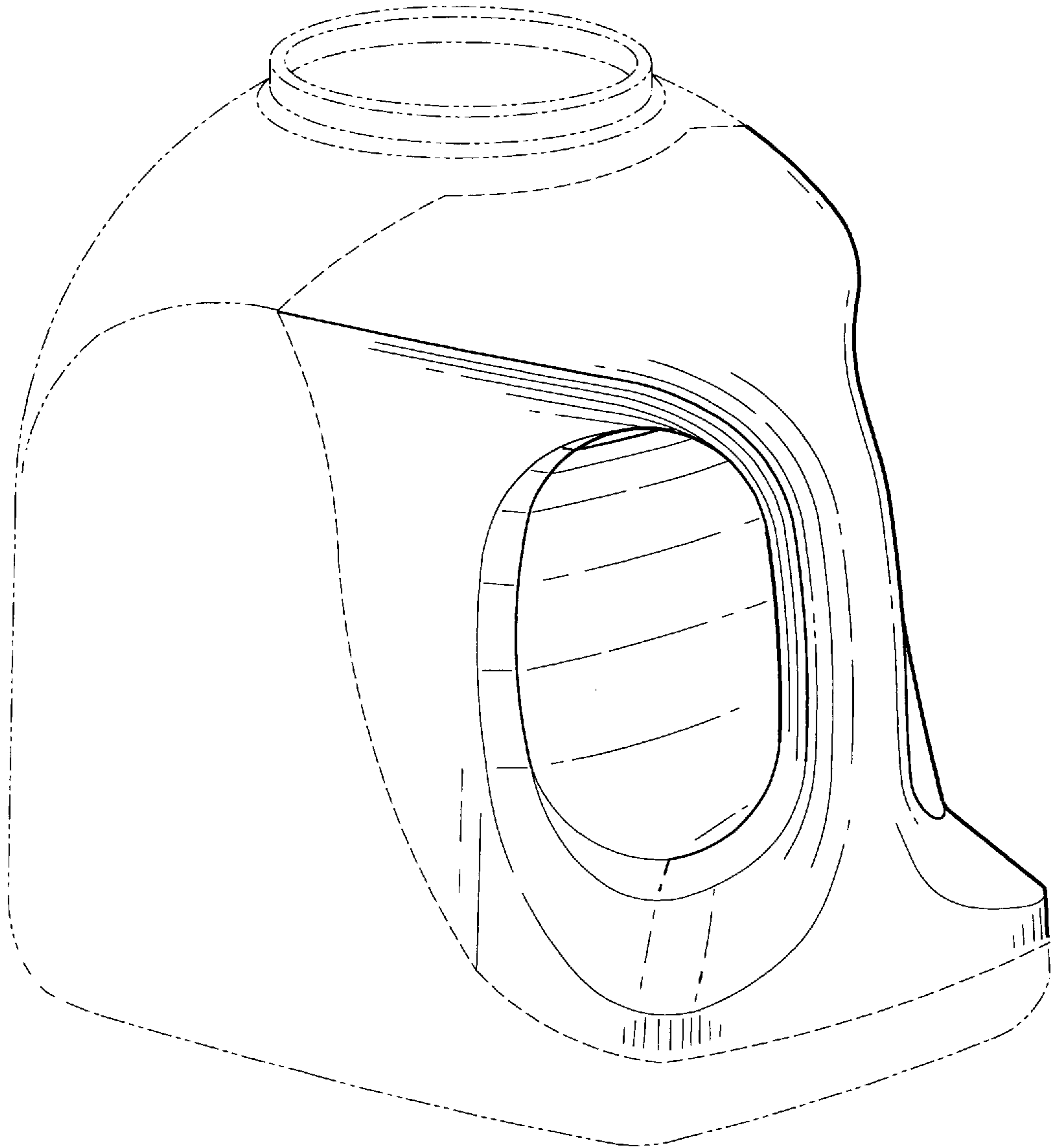

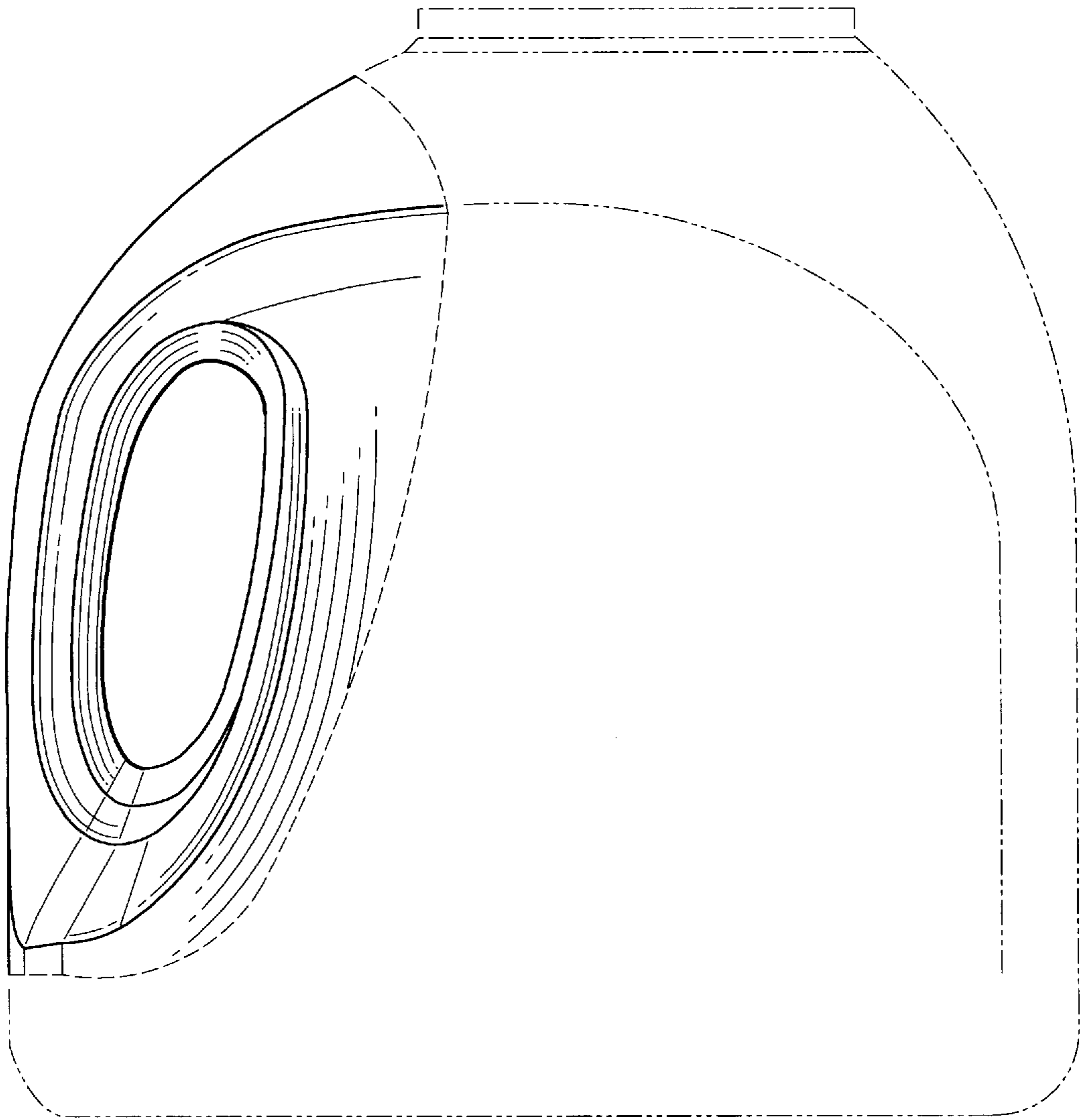

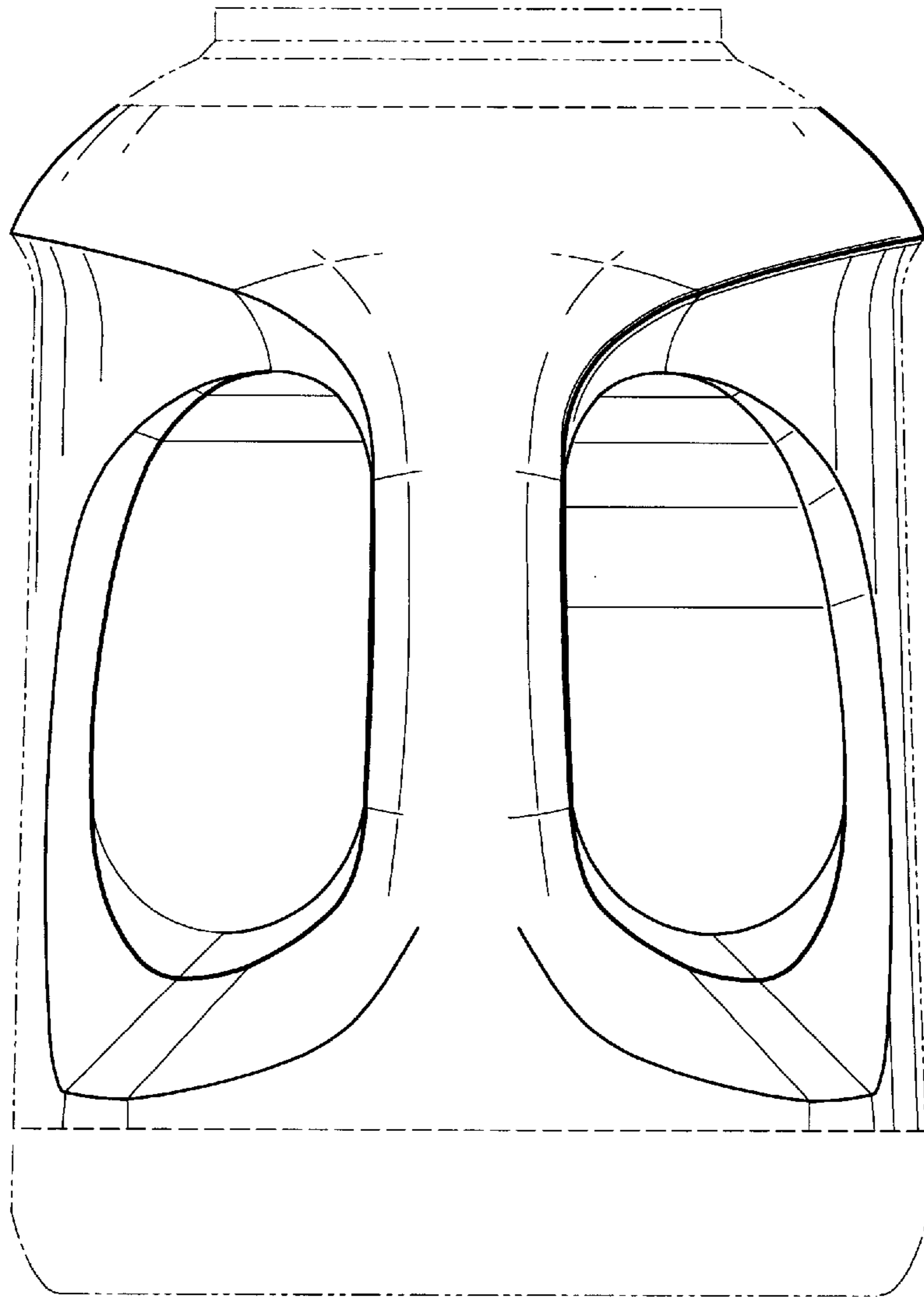

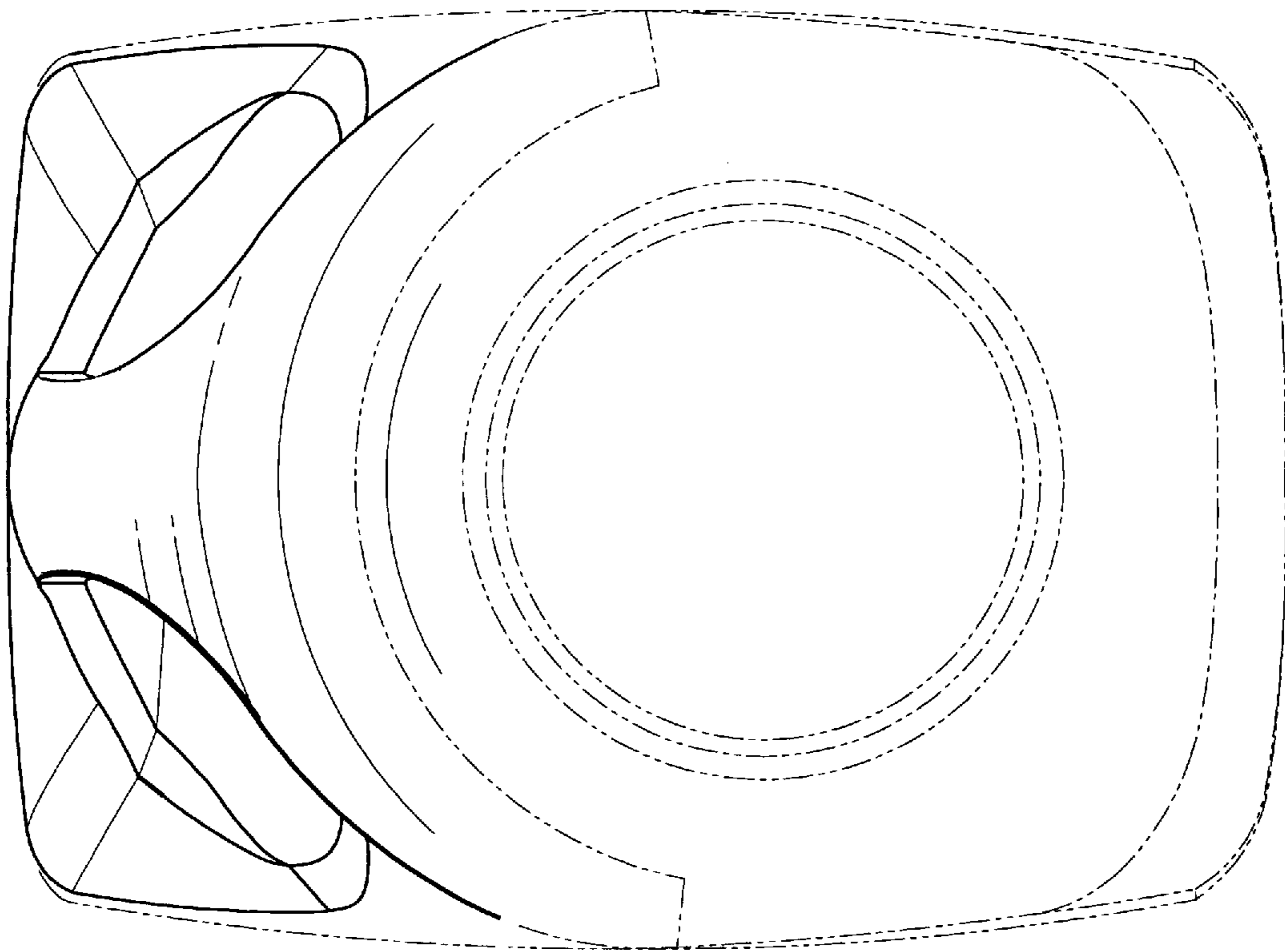
