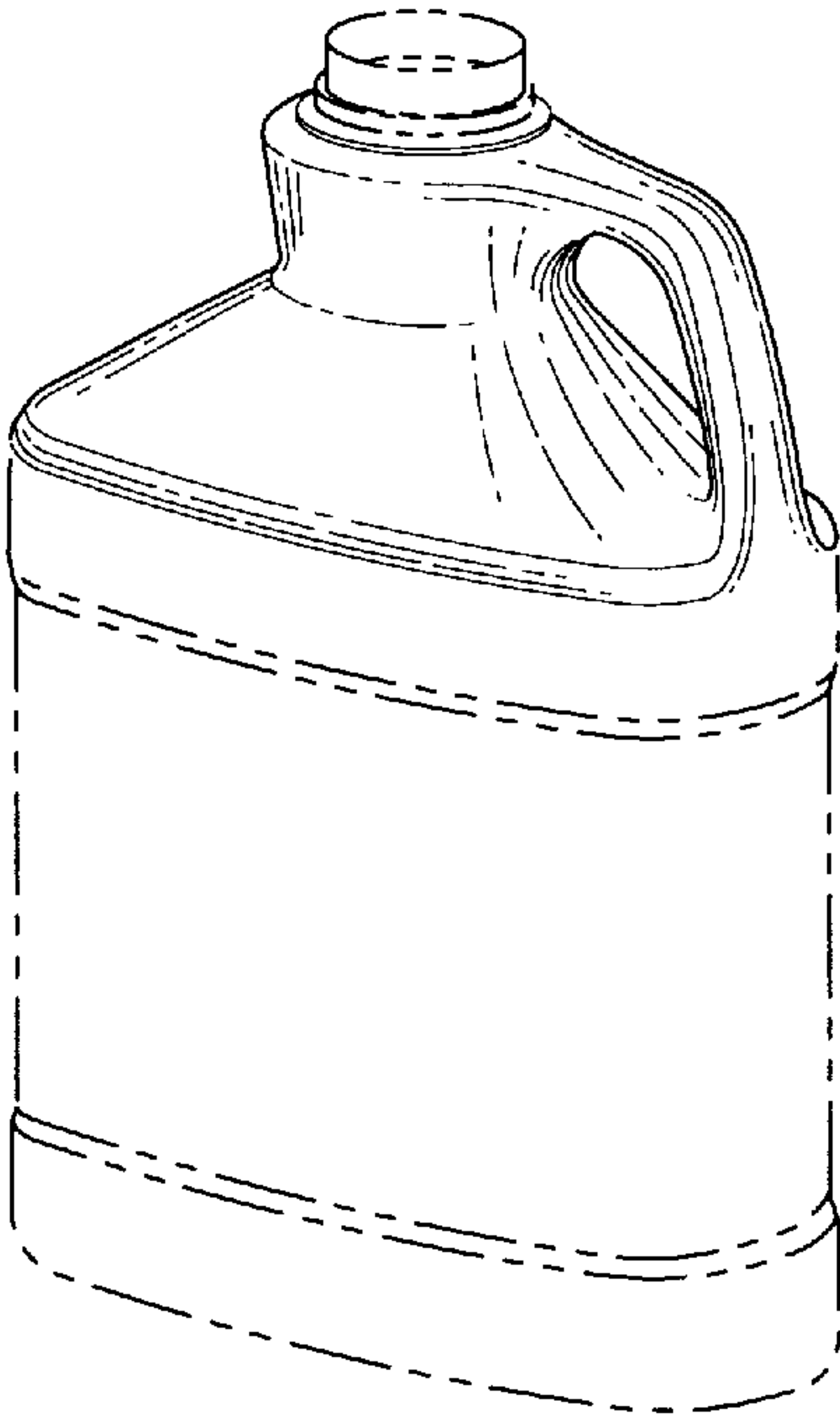
The ornamental design for an upper portion of a bottle, as

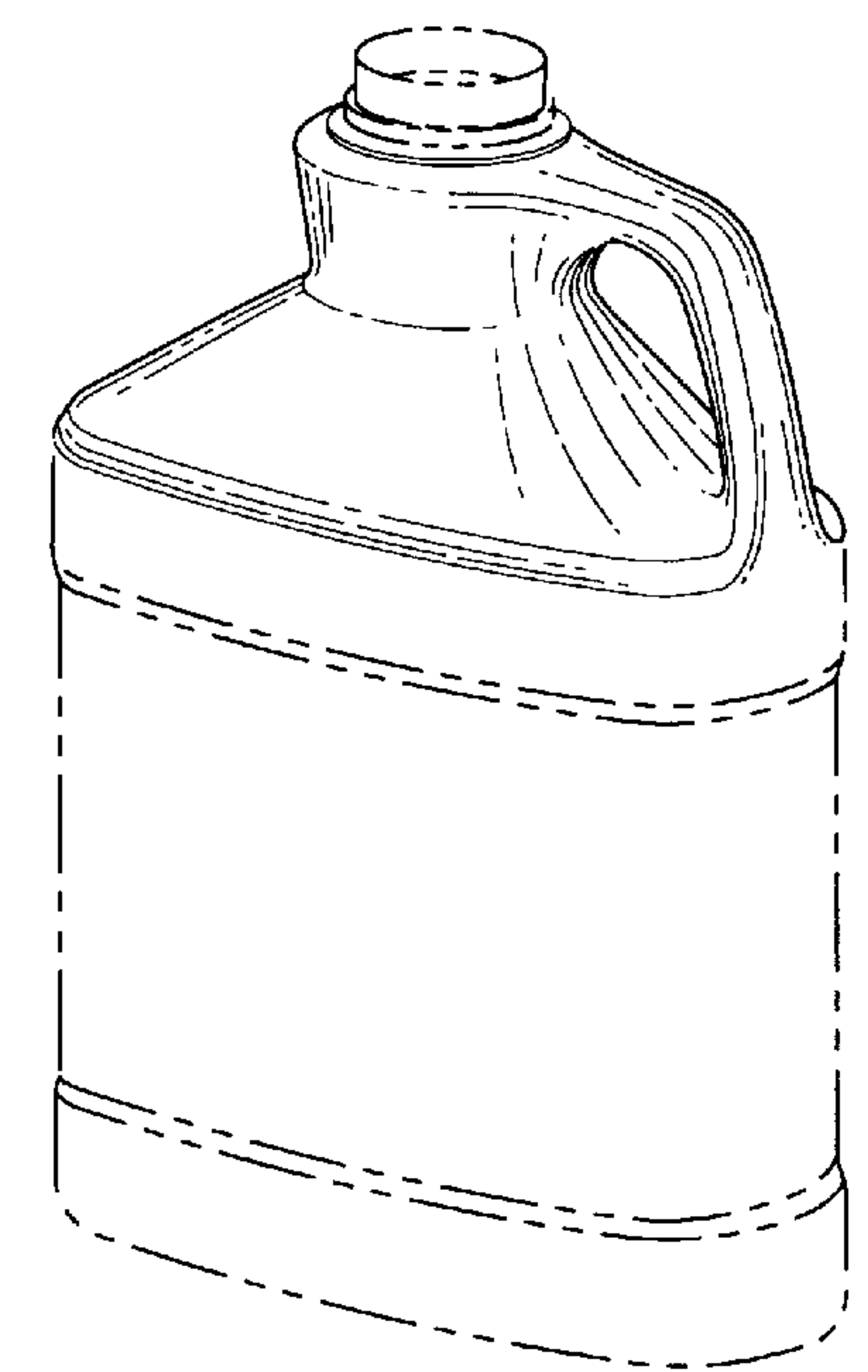

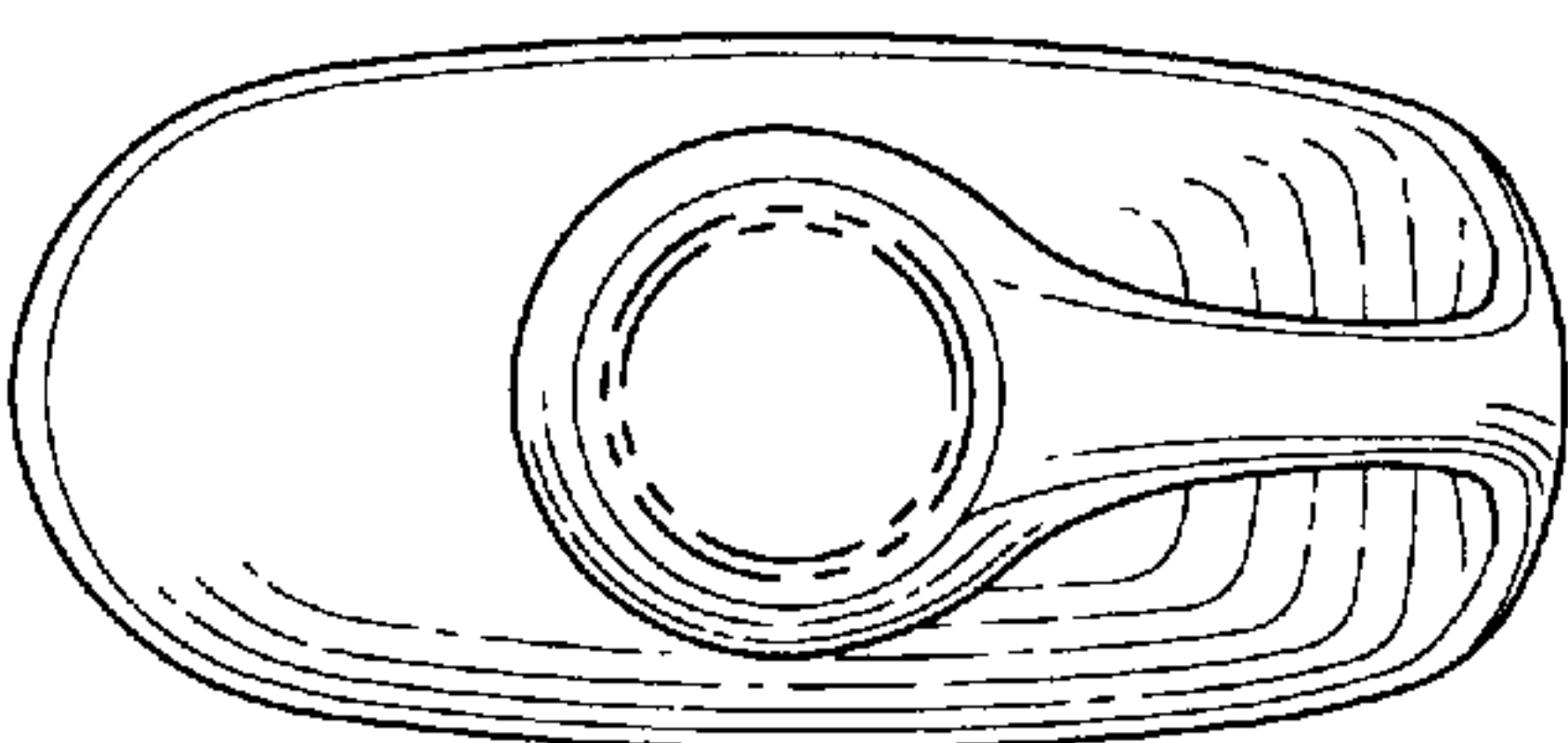

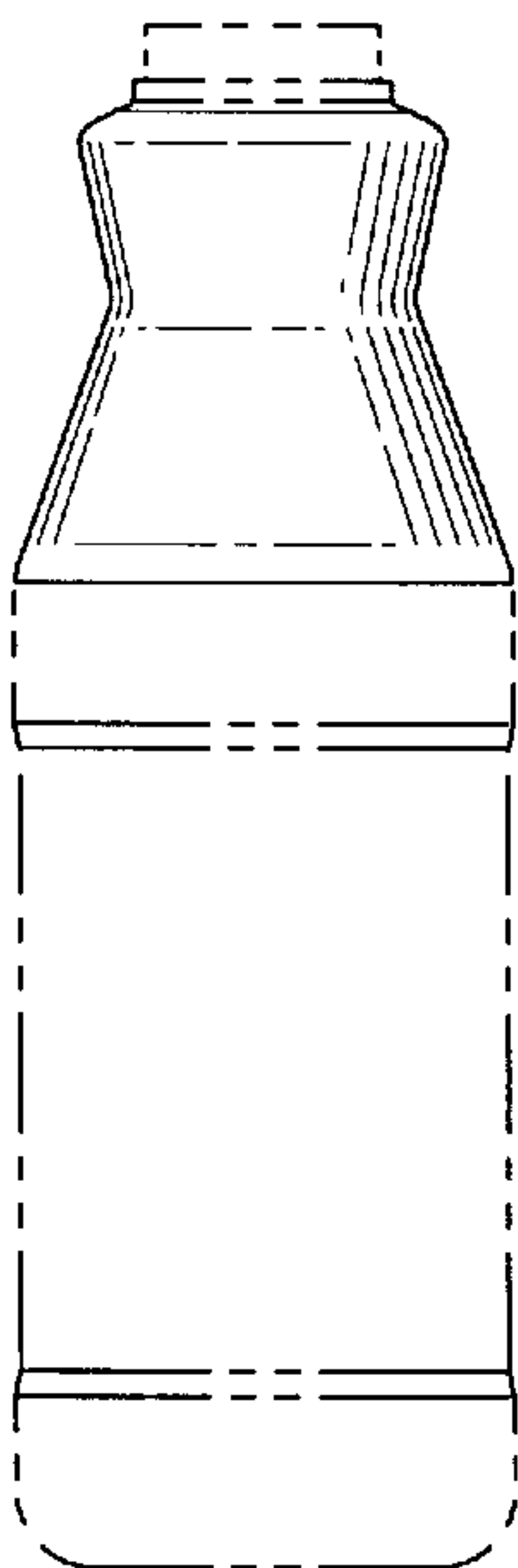

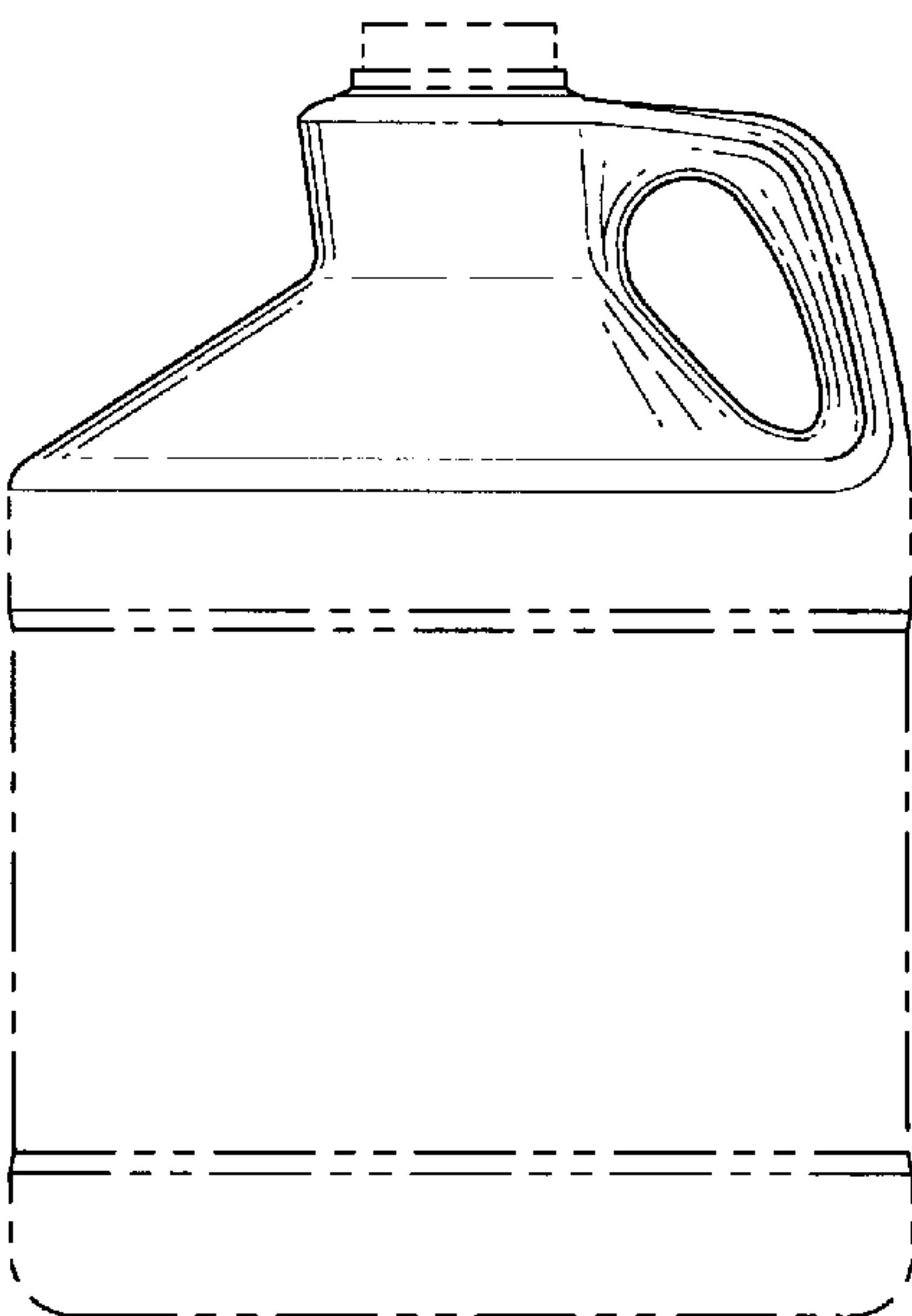

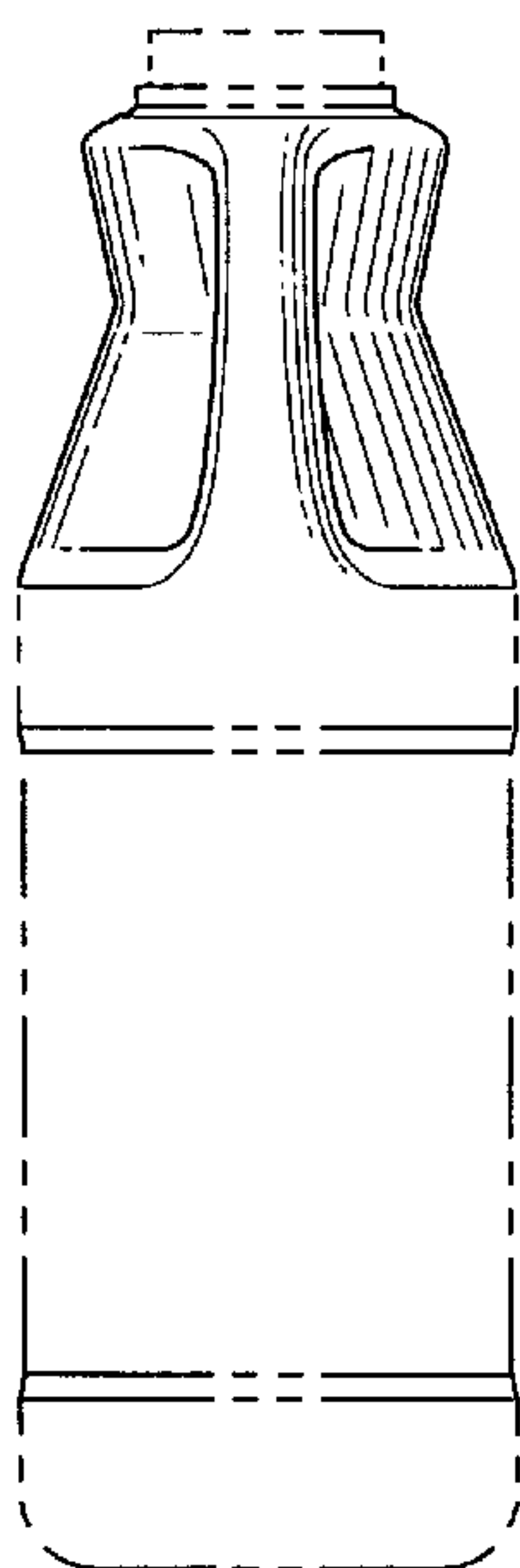
