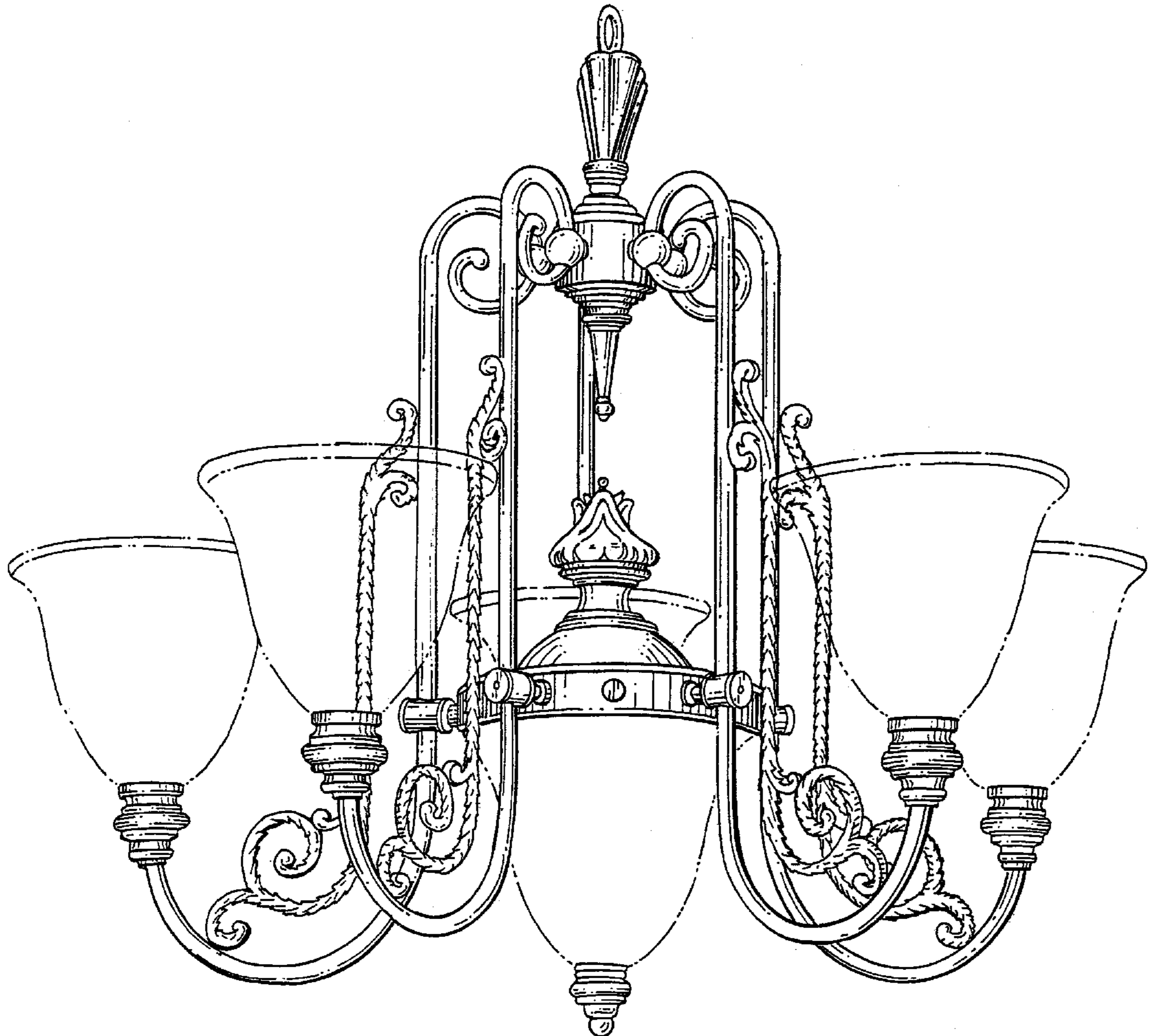
Features shown in broken lines are shown for environment only and do not form a part of the design claimed. The design as shown in FIG. 2 repeated every 72° about the vertical axis.

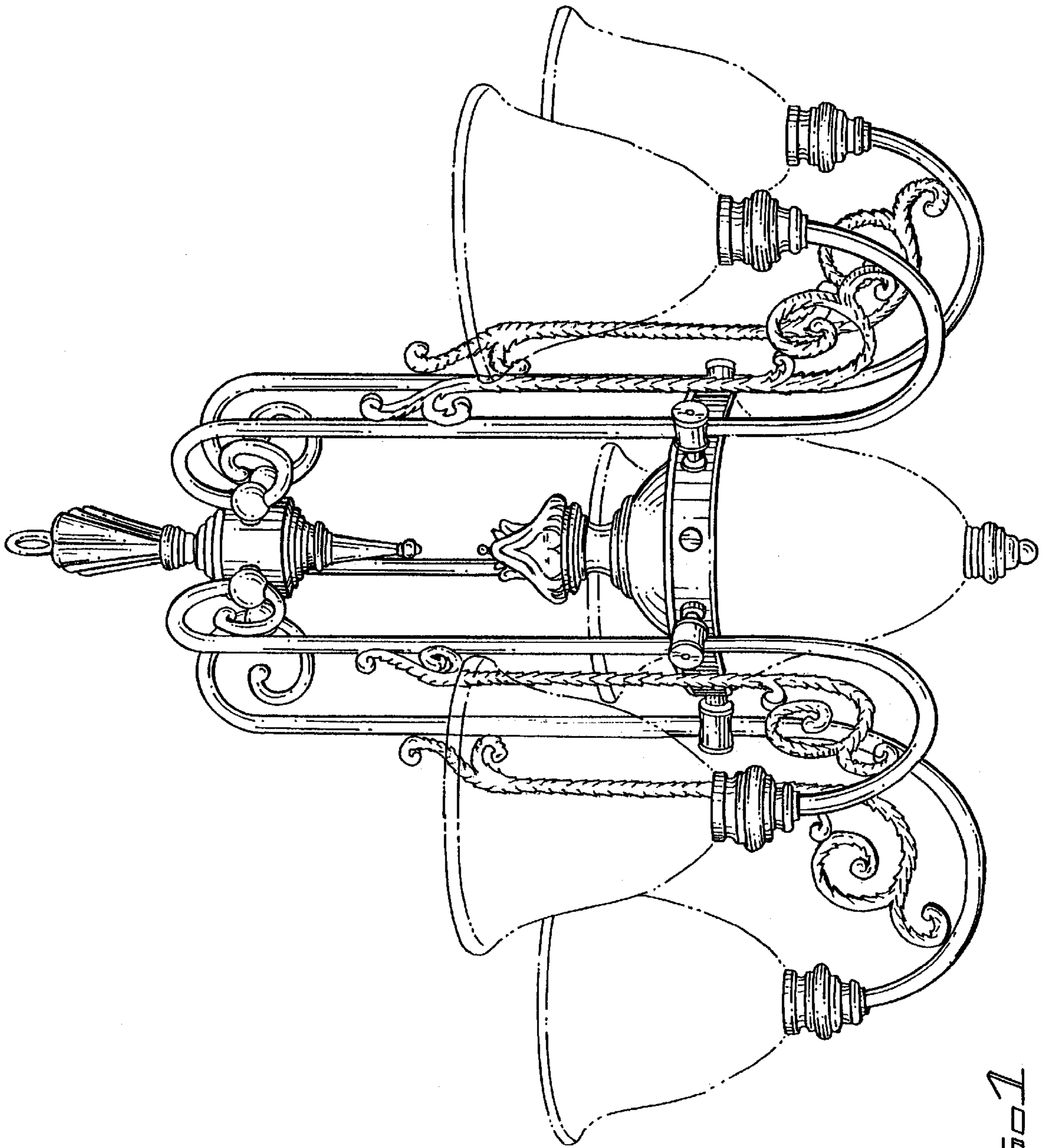
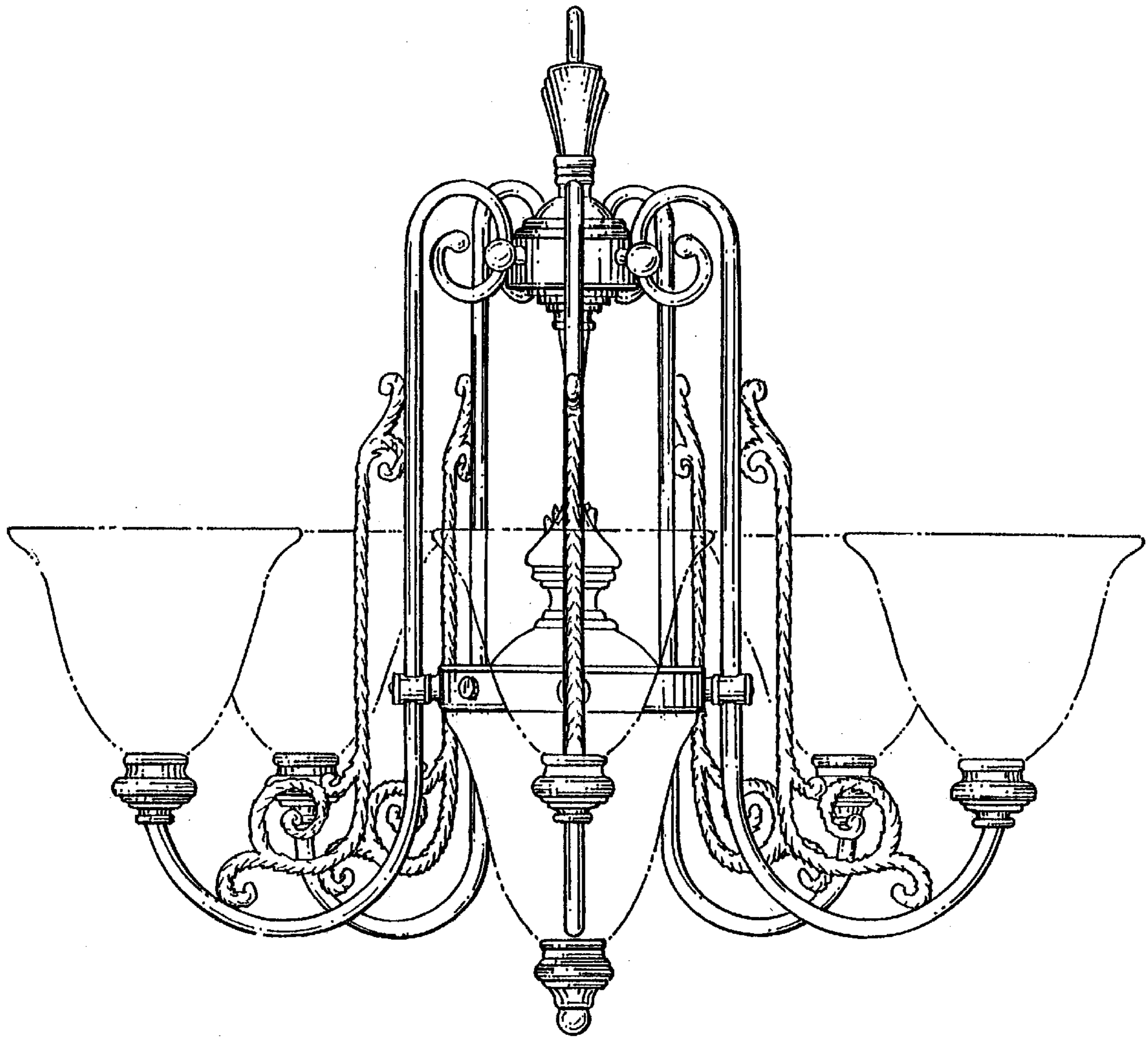
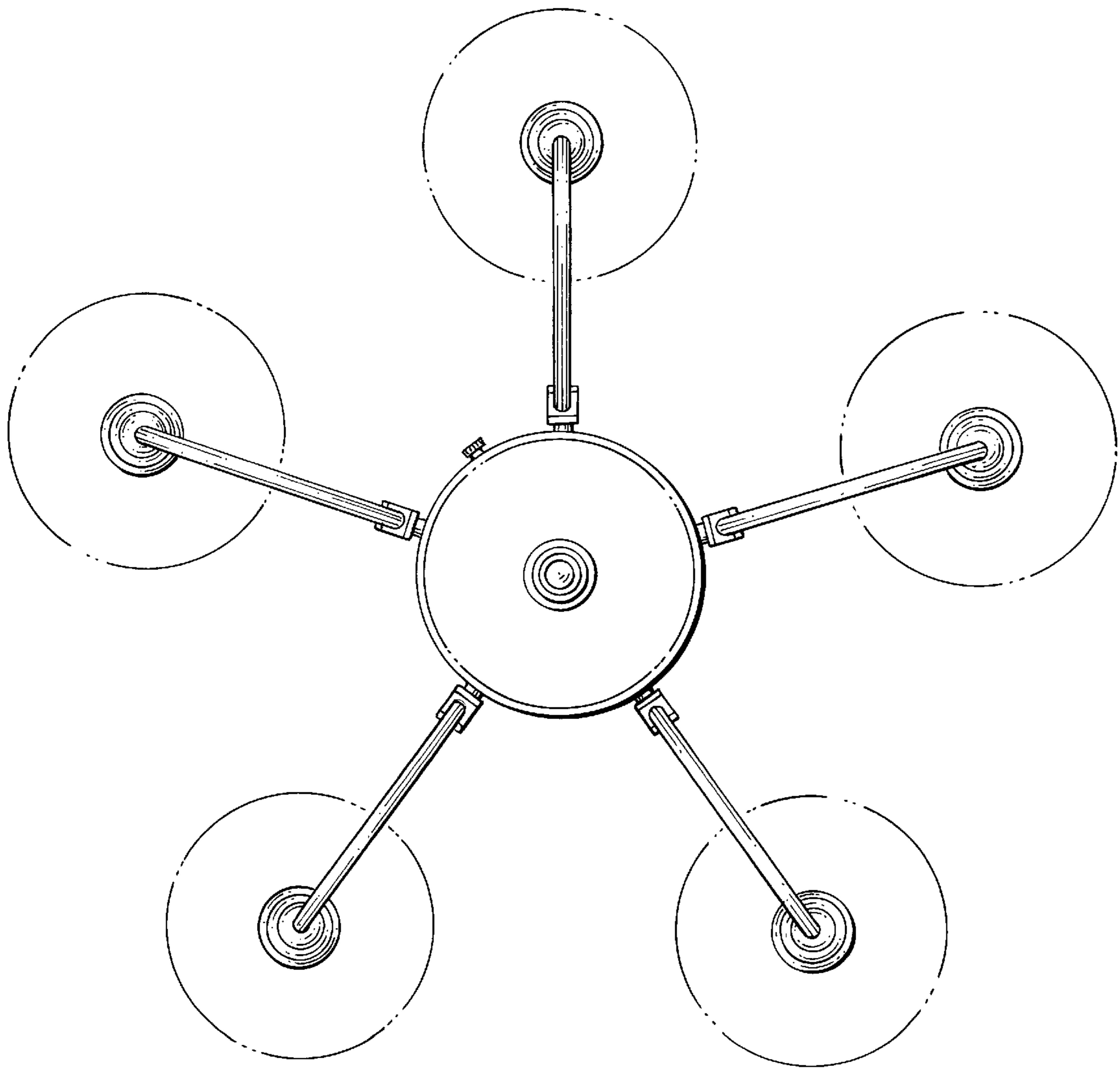


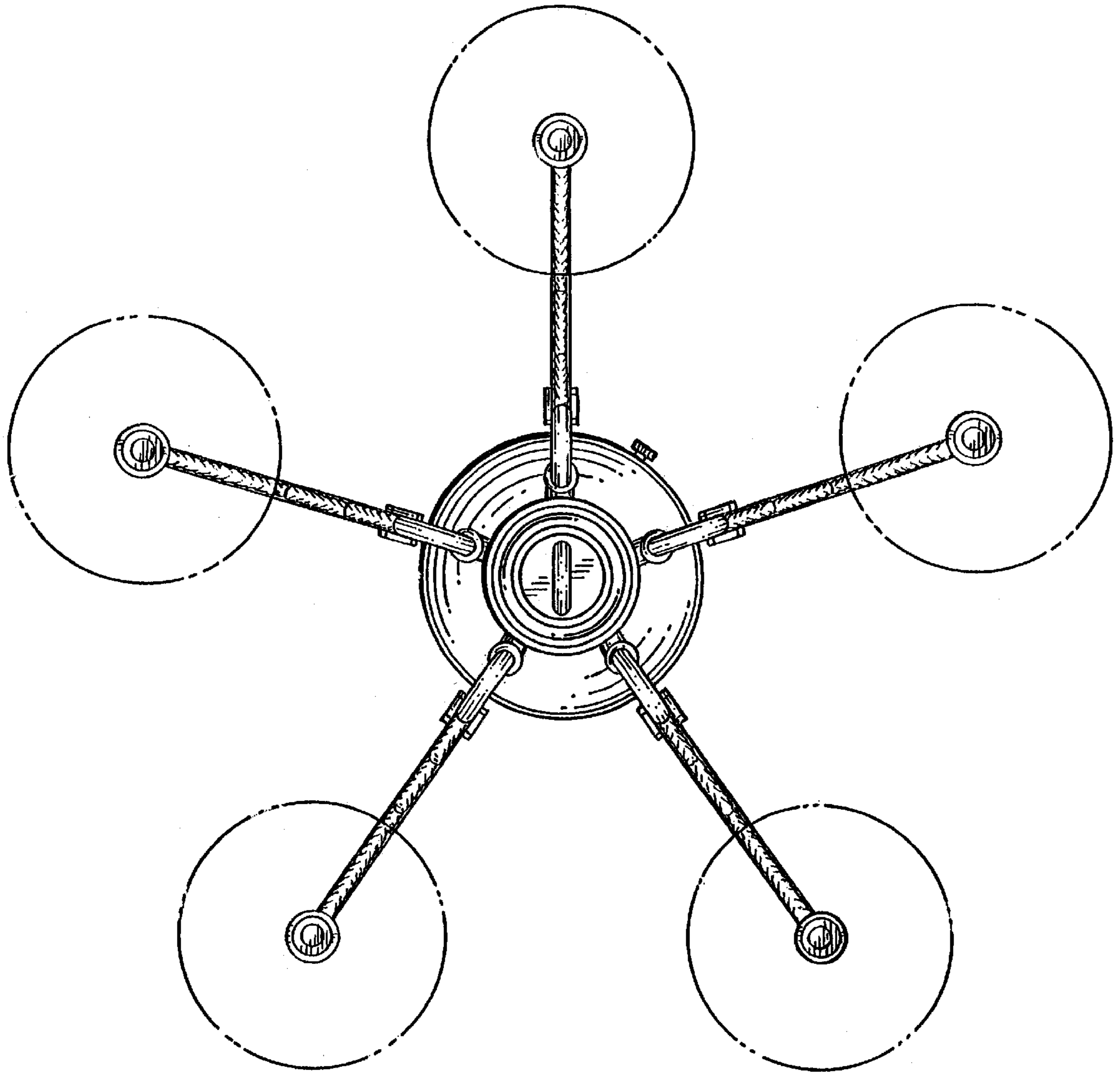
