The ornamental design for a combined hair curling iron and support with timer switch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the combined hair curling iron and support with timer switch showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a back elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

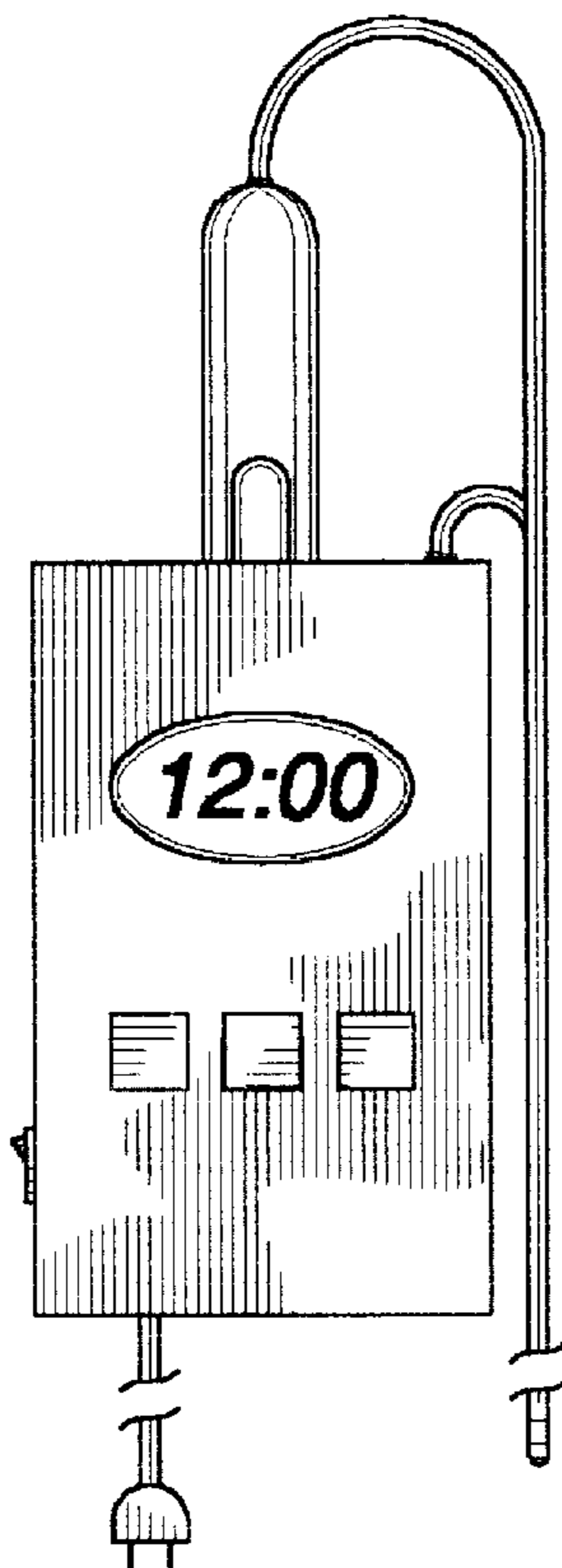
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

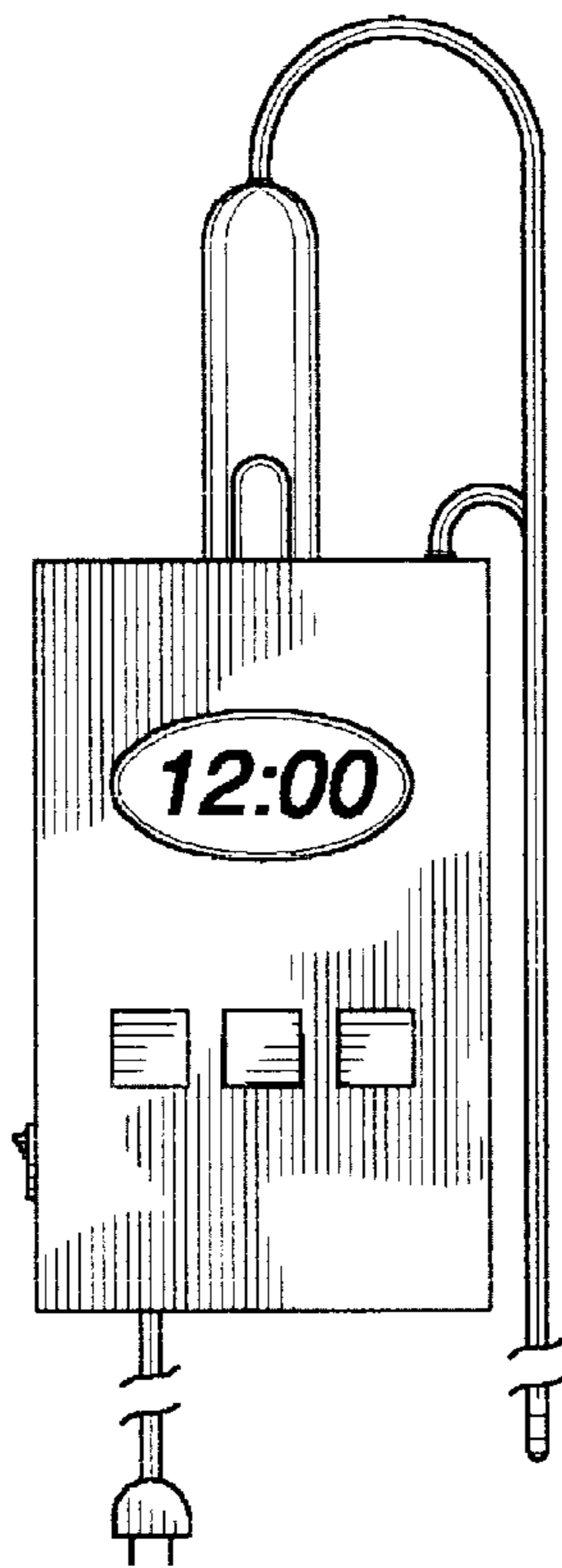

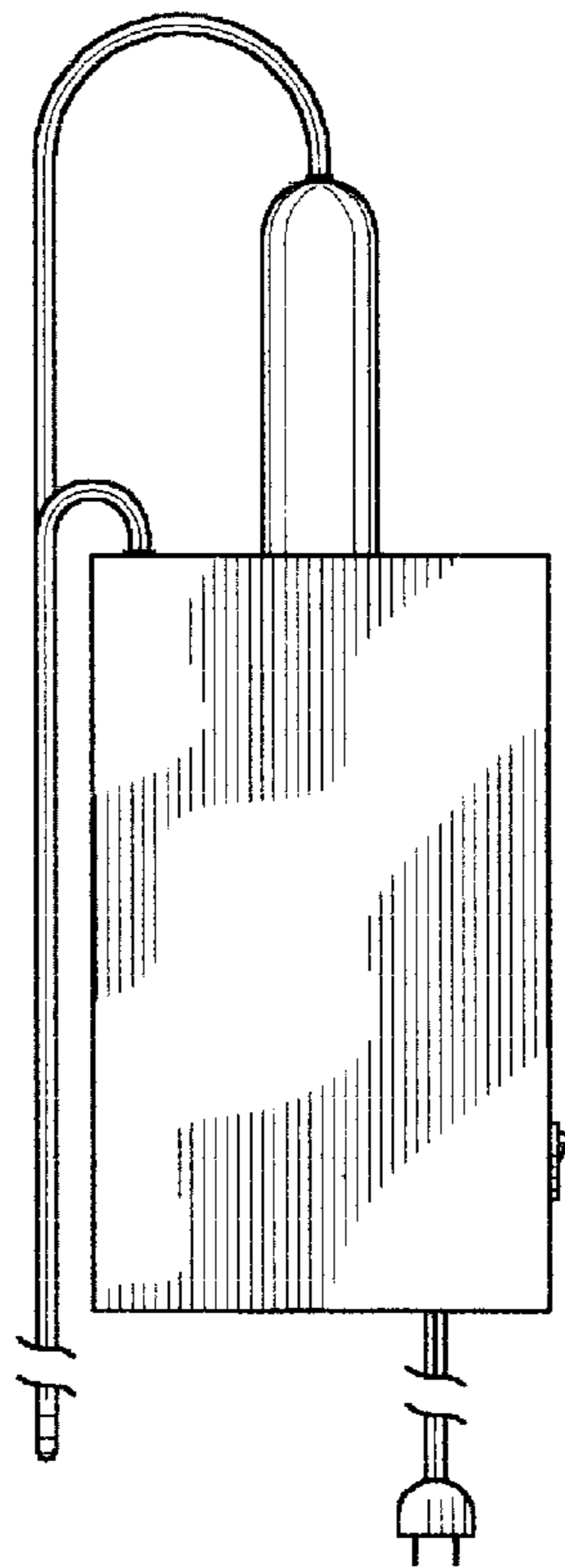

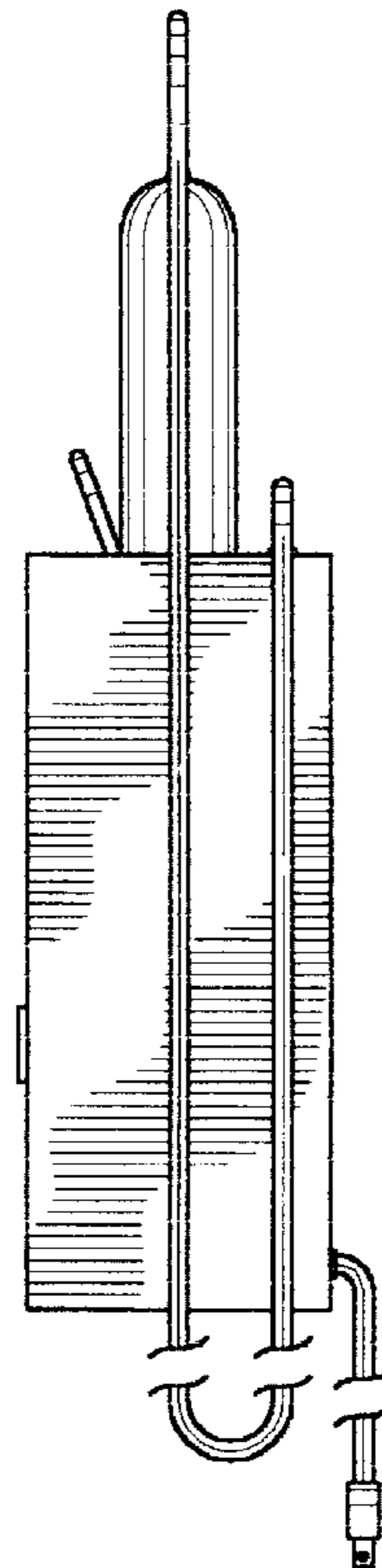

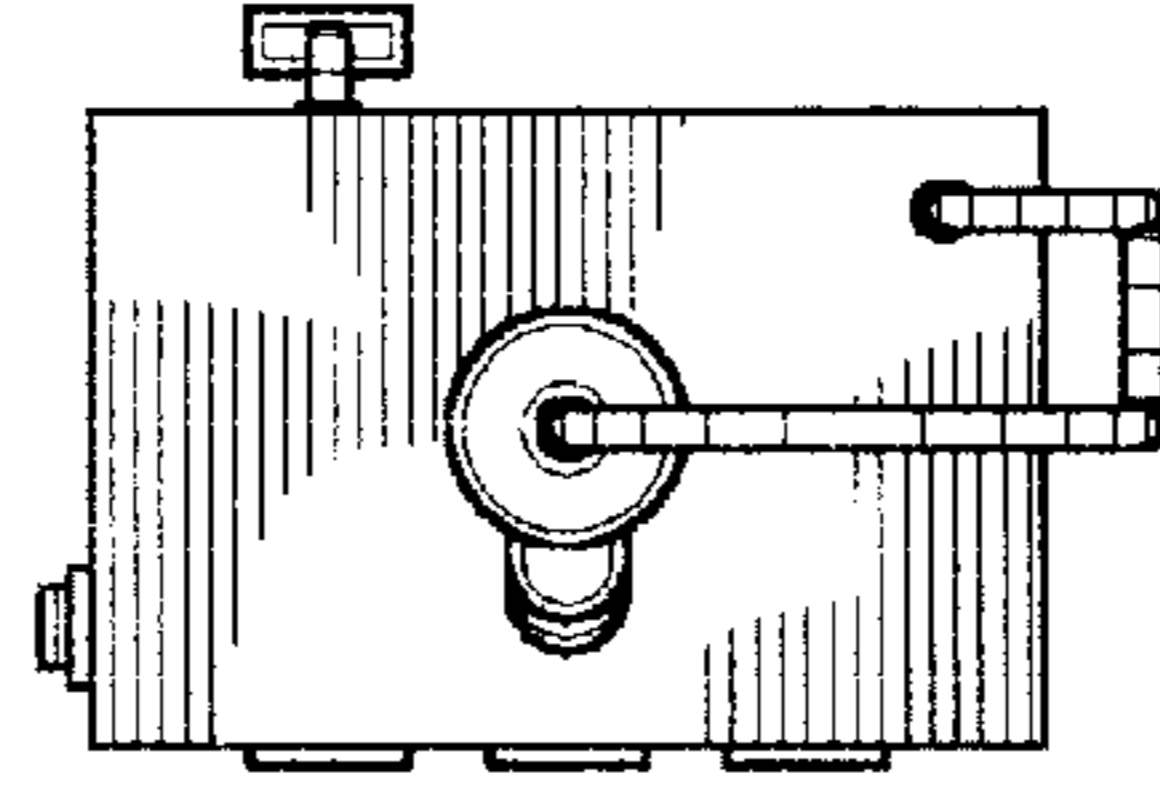

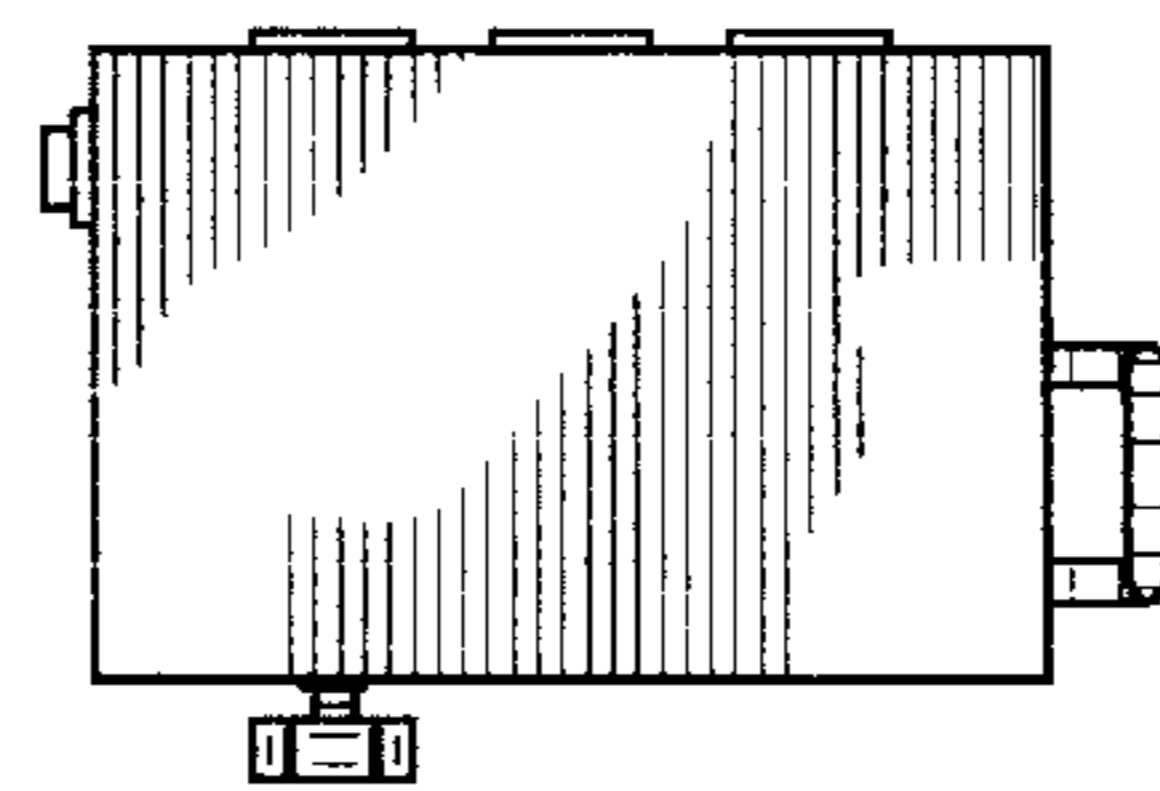
