DESCRIPTION

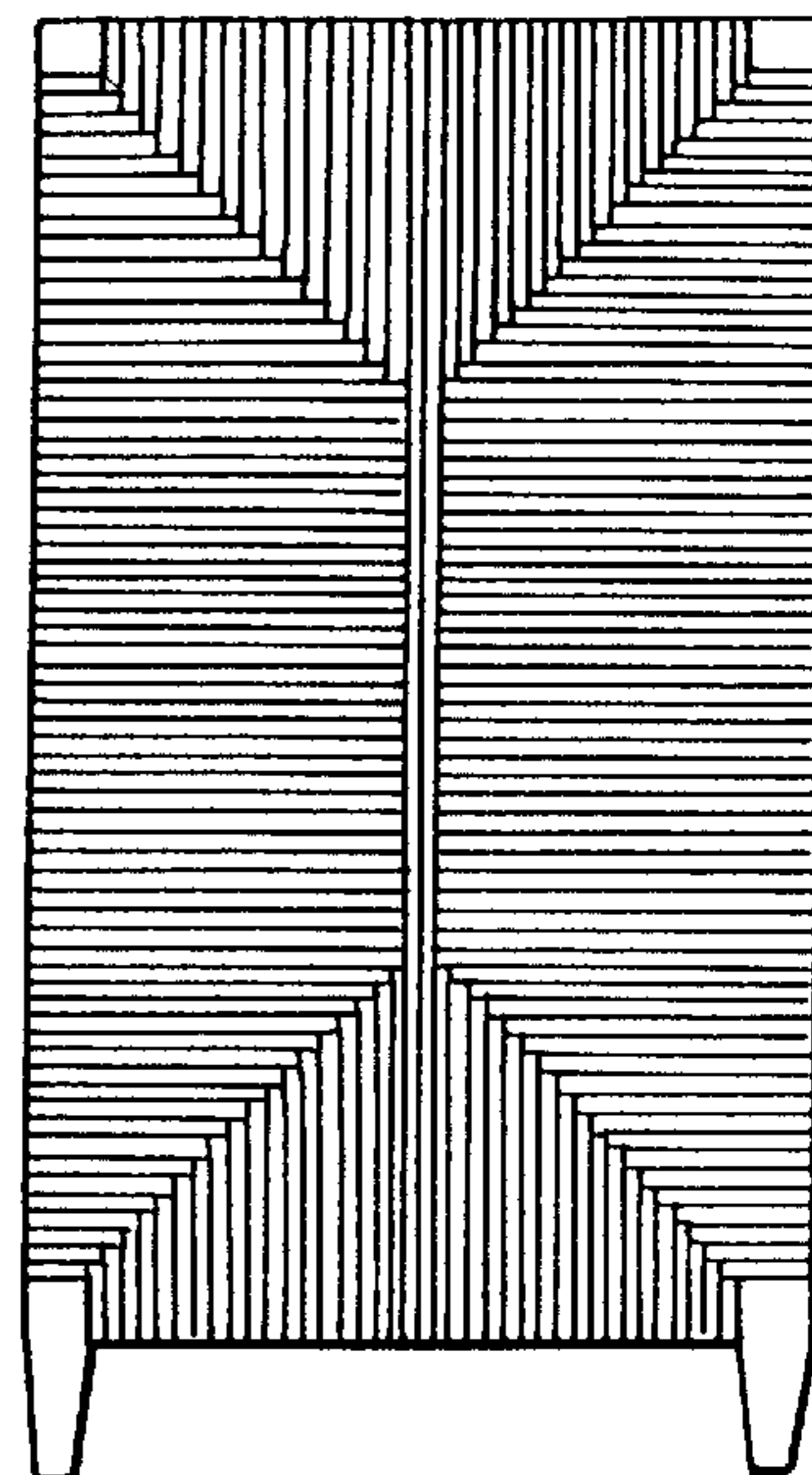
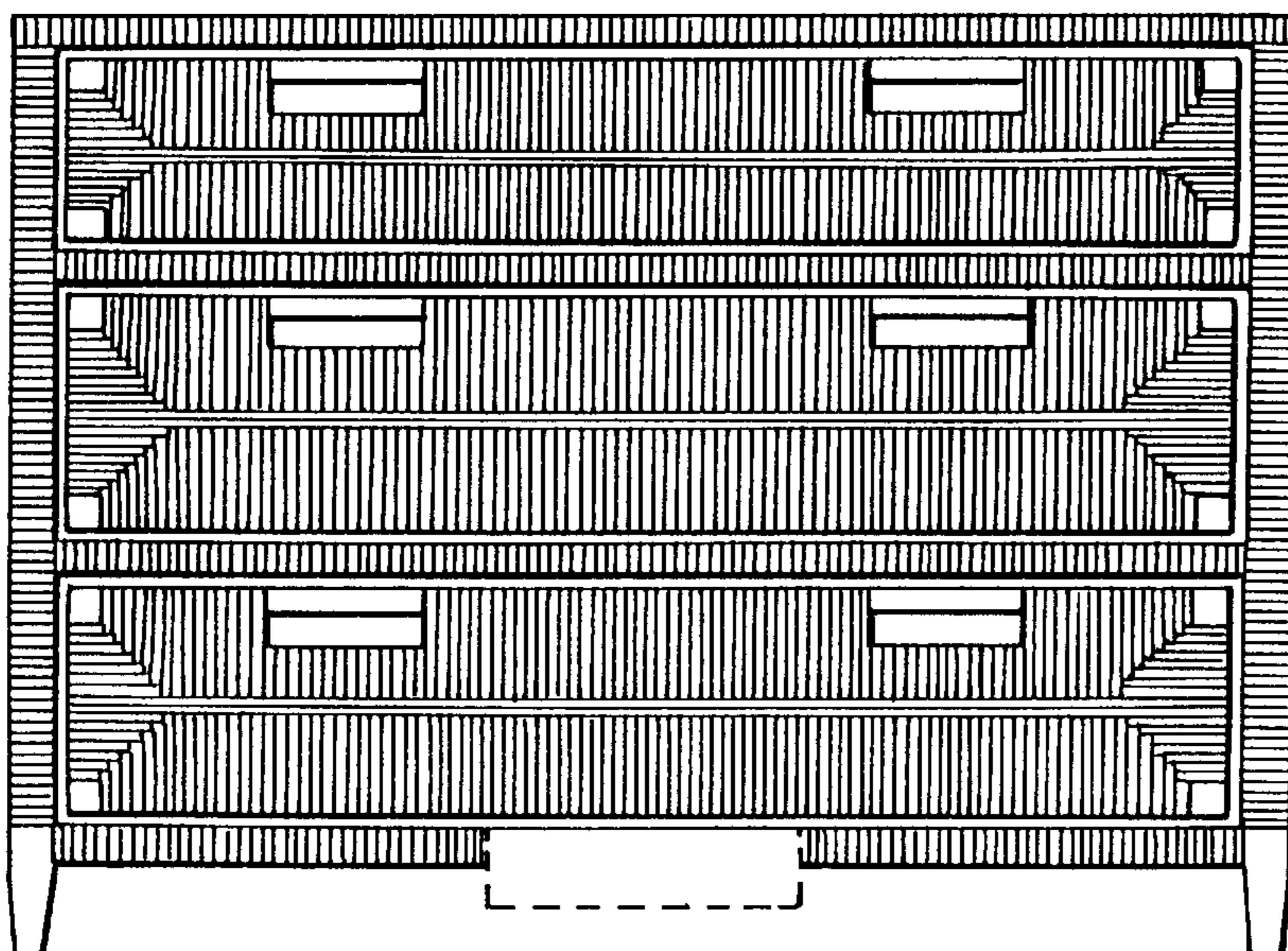
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a night stand showing my new design;

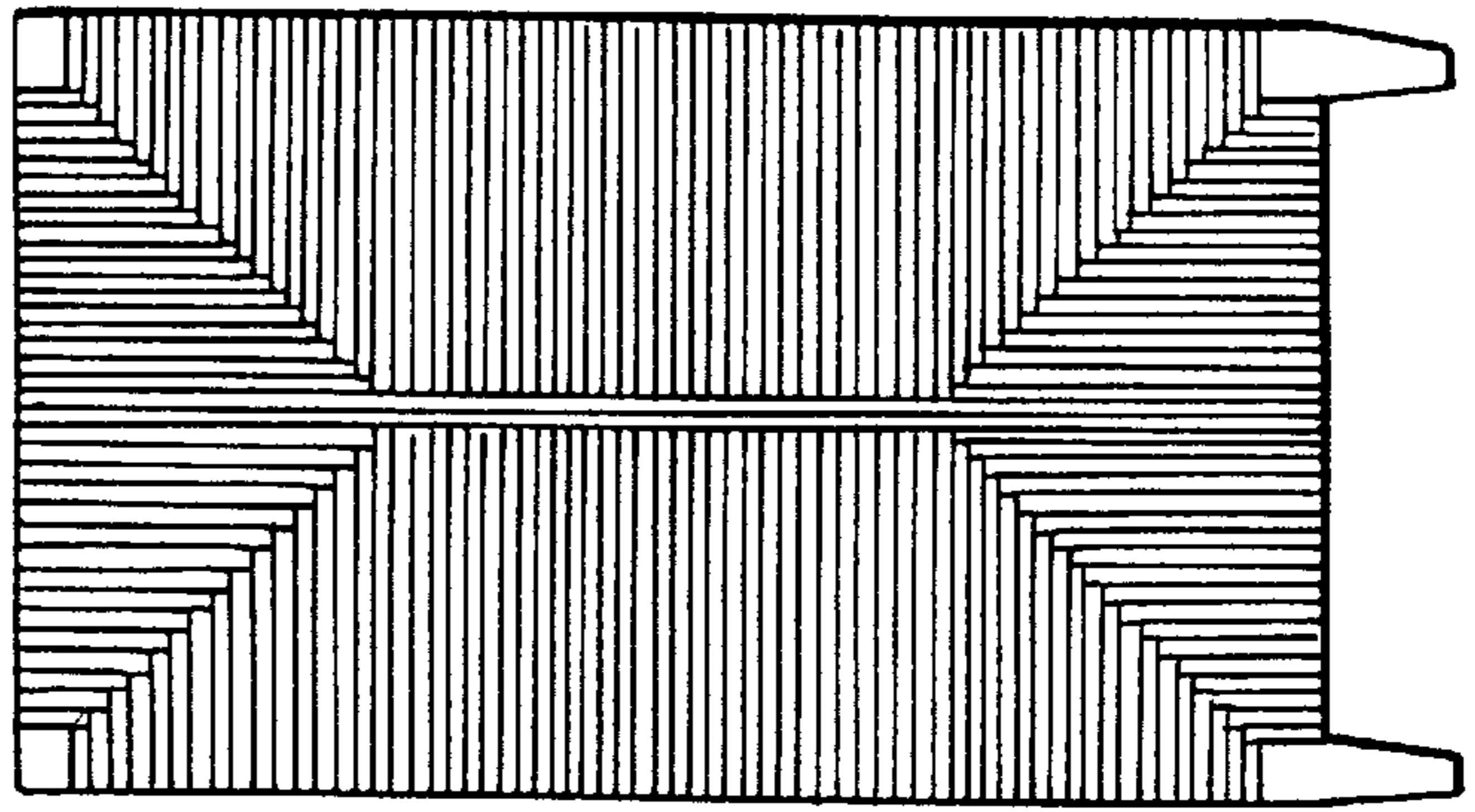

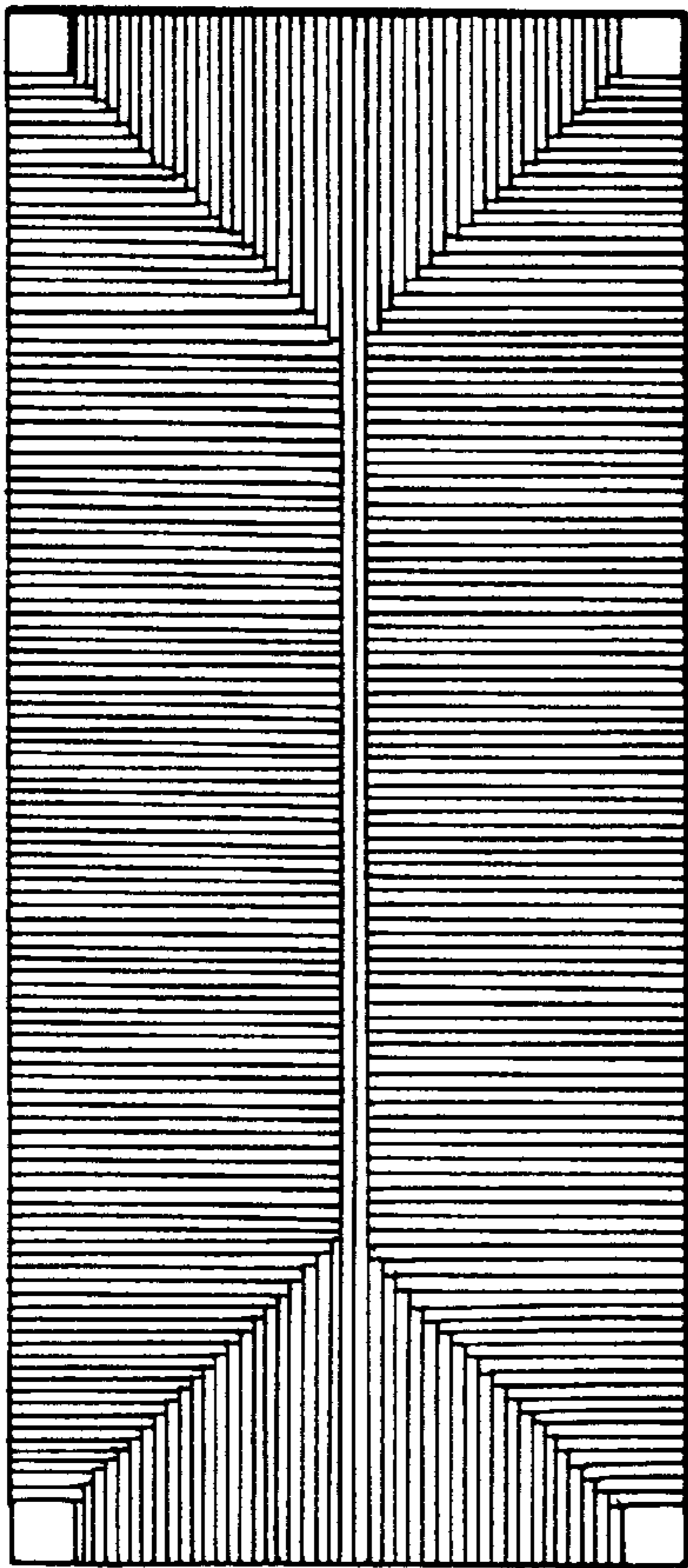

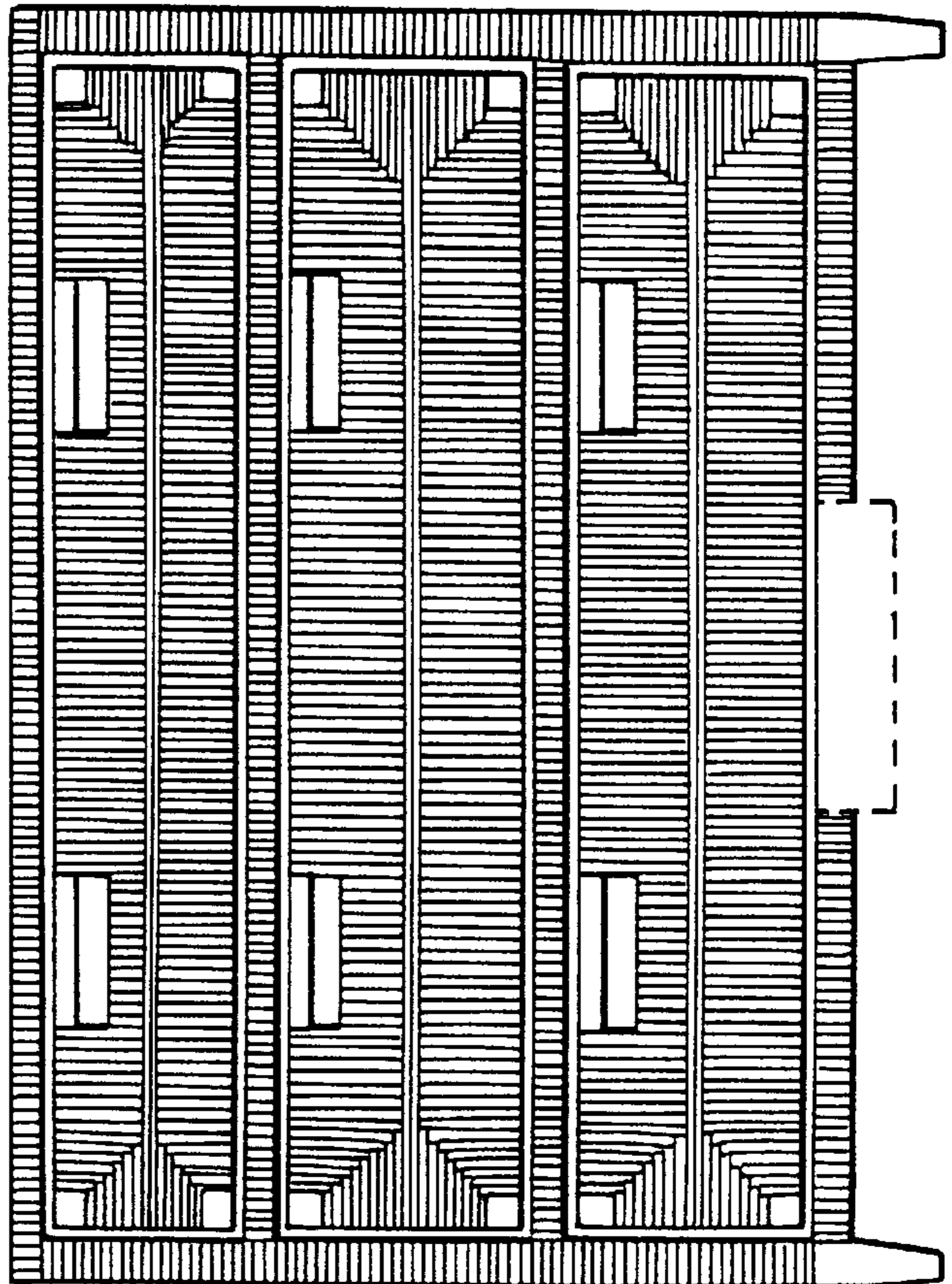
