**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top view of an upper portion of a bottle, embodying our new design;

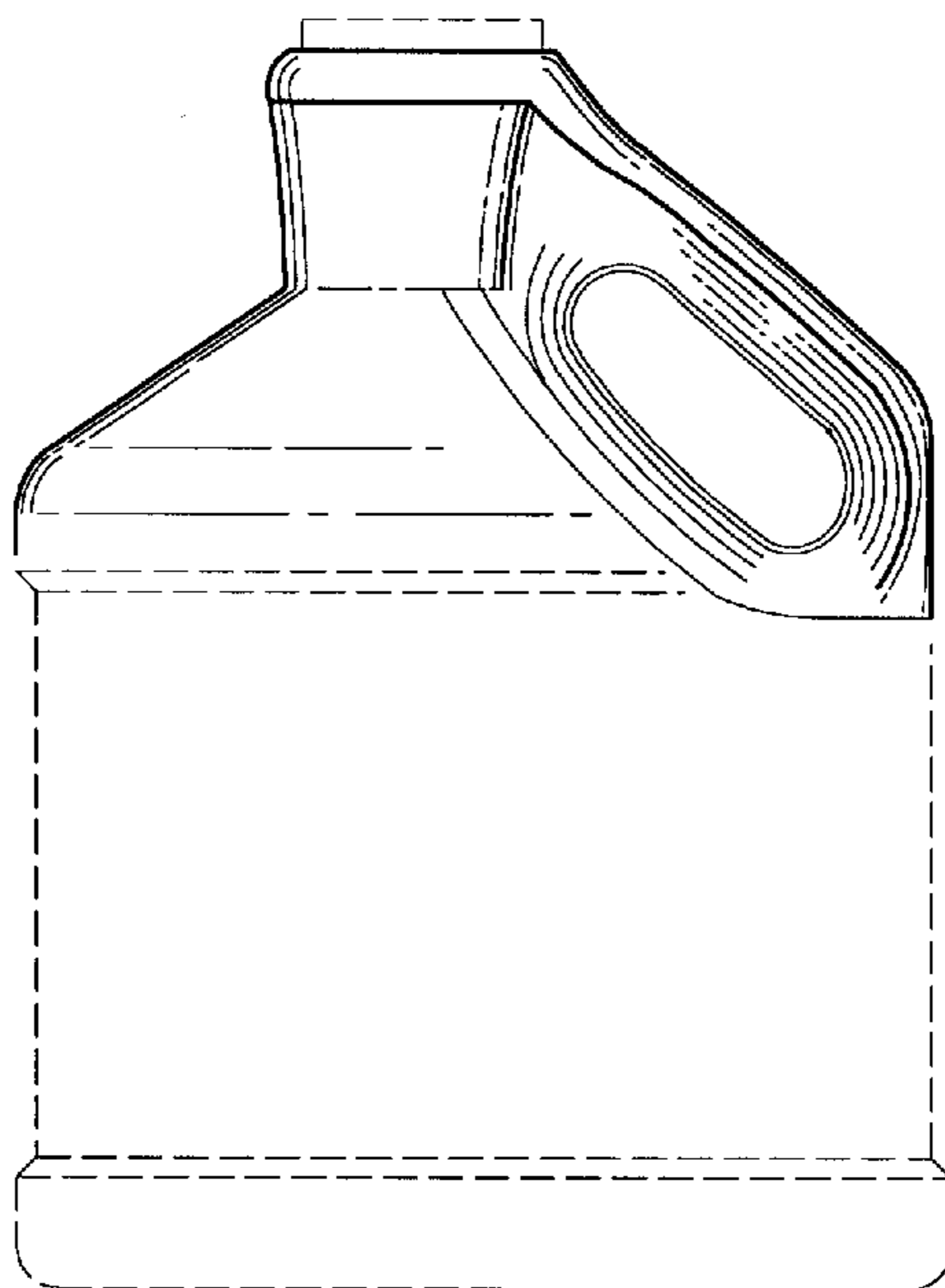
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

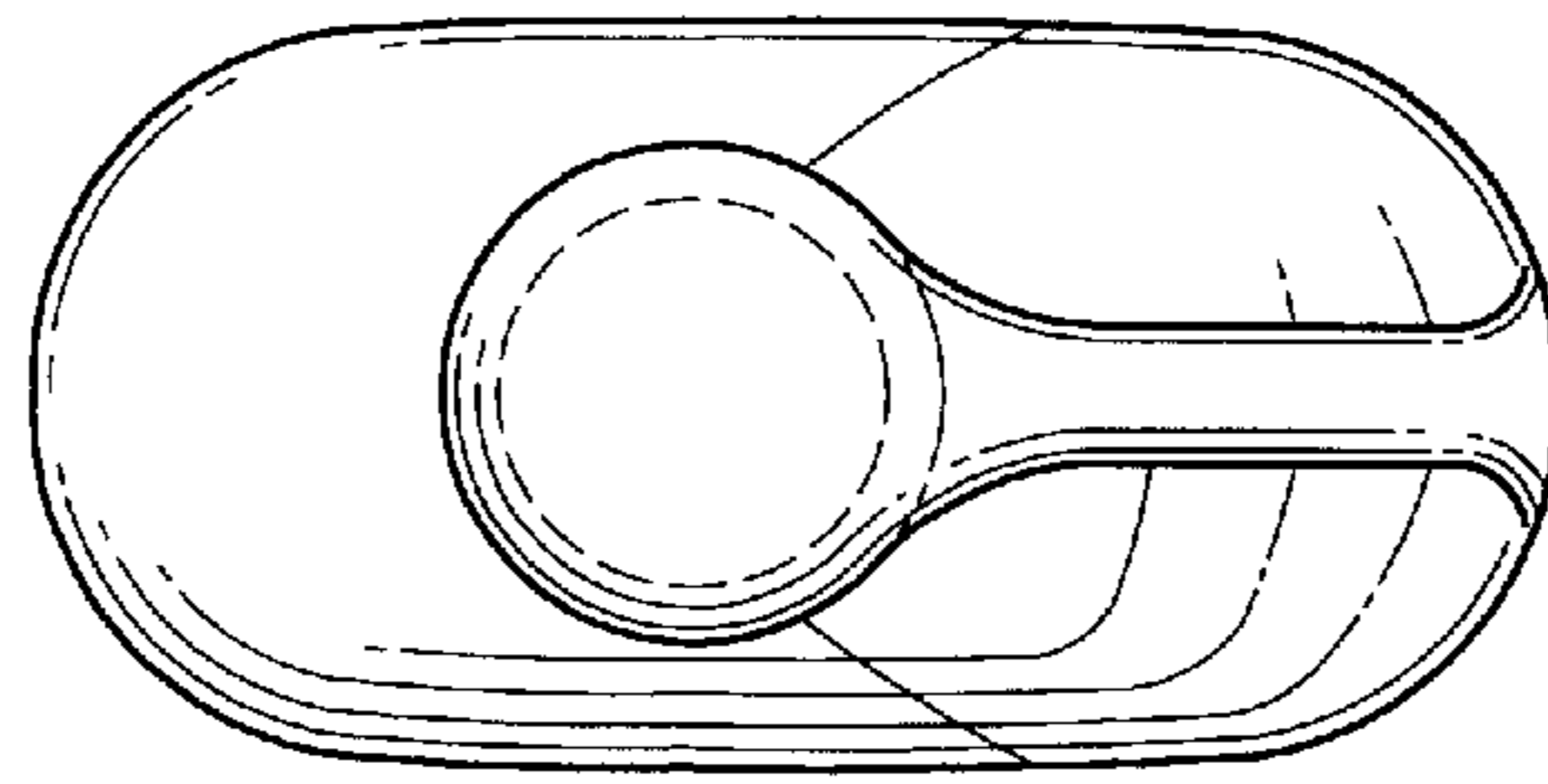

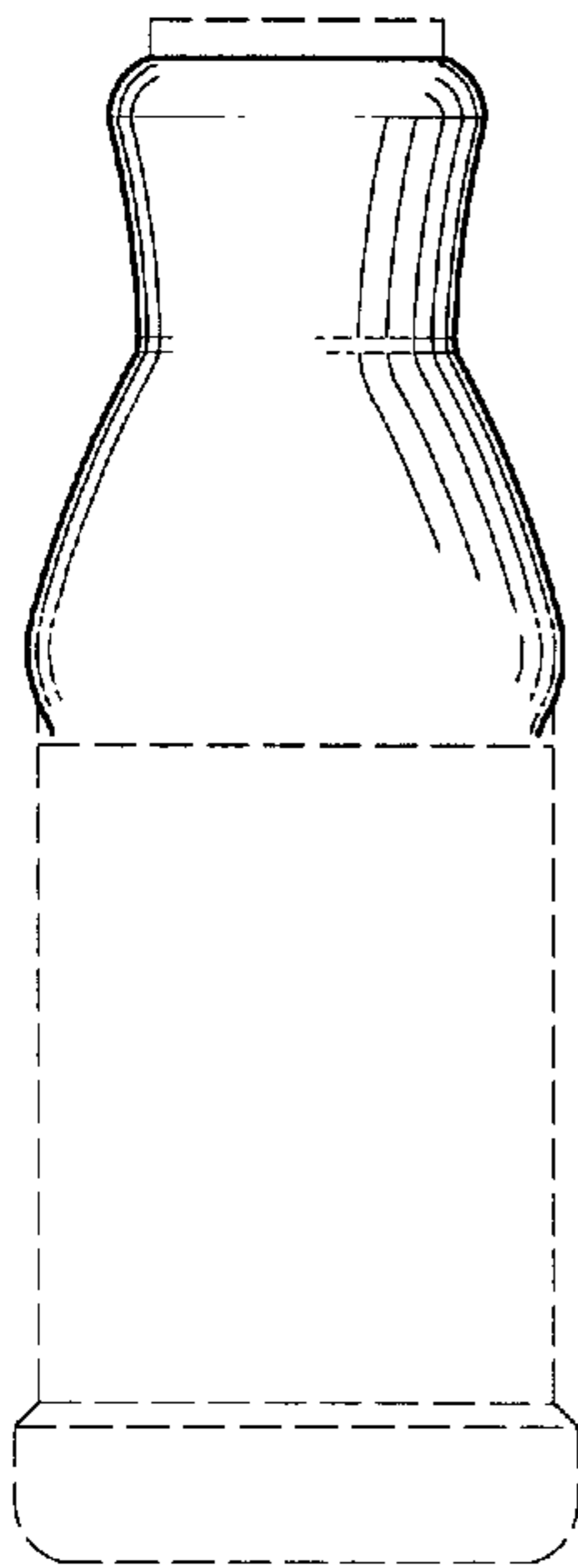

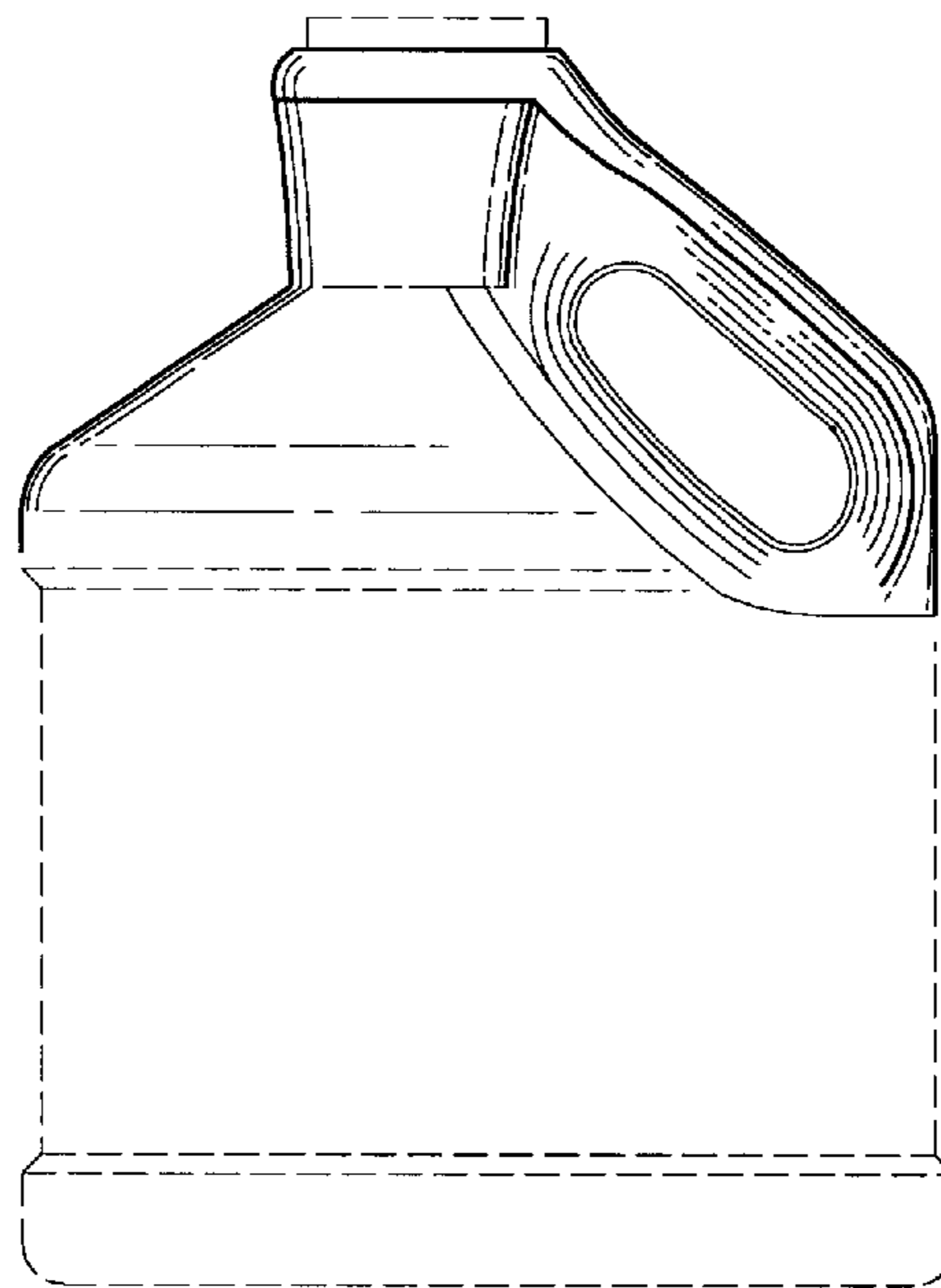

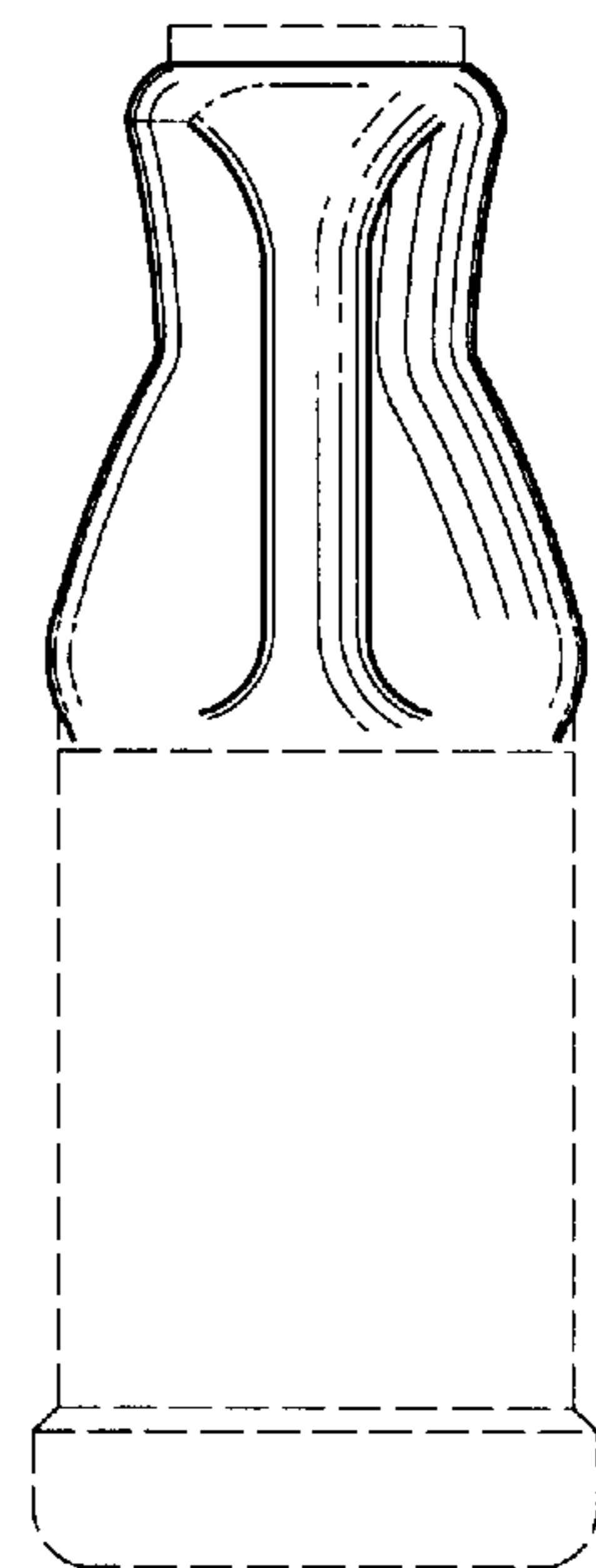
