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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vehicular coat hook unit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the vehicular coat hook unit showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right end elevation of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left end elevation of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation of FIG. 1;

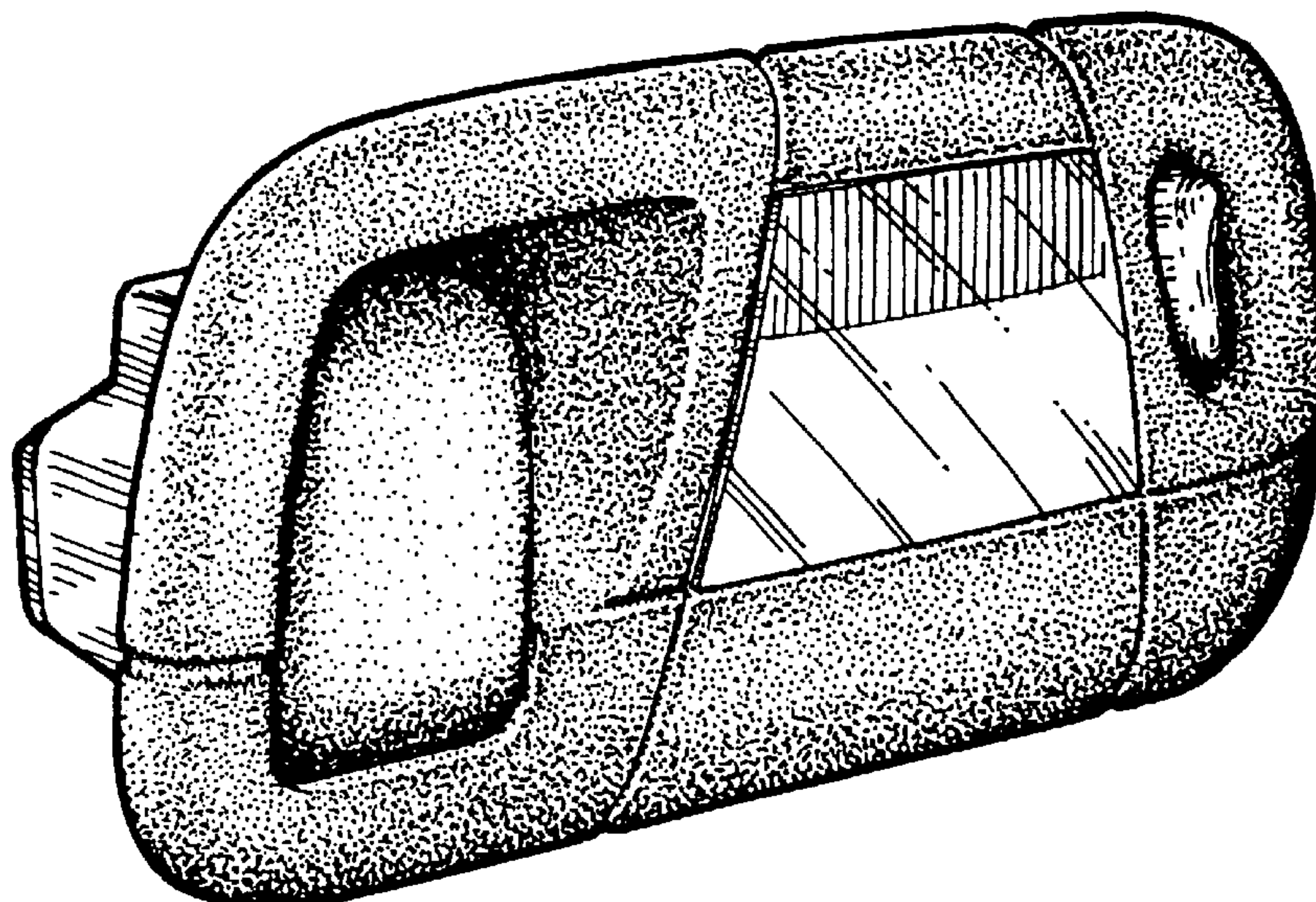
FIG. 8 is a front elevation of FIG. 1 illustrating the coat hook portion pivoted to its lowered position;

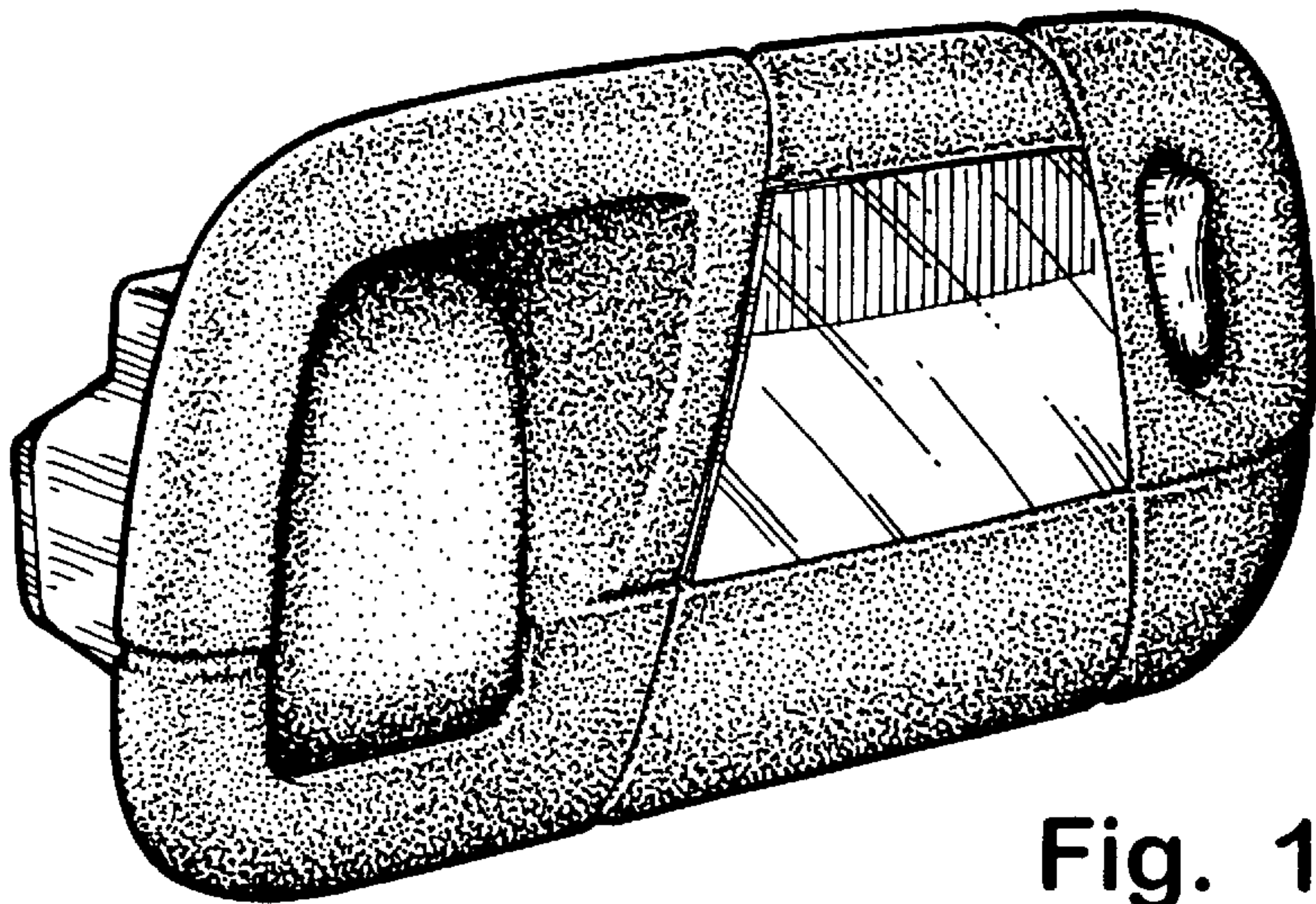

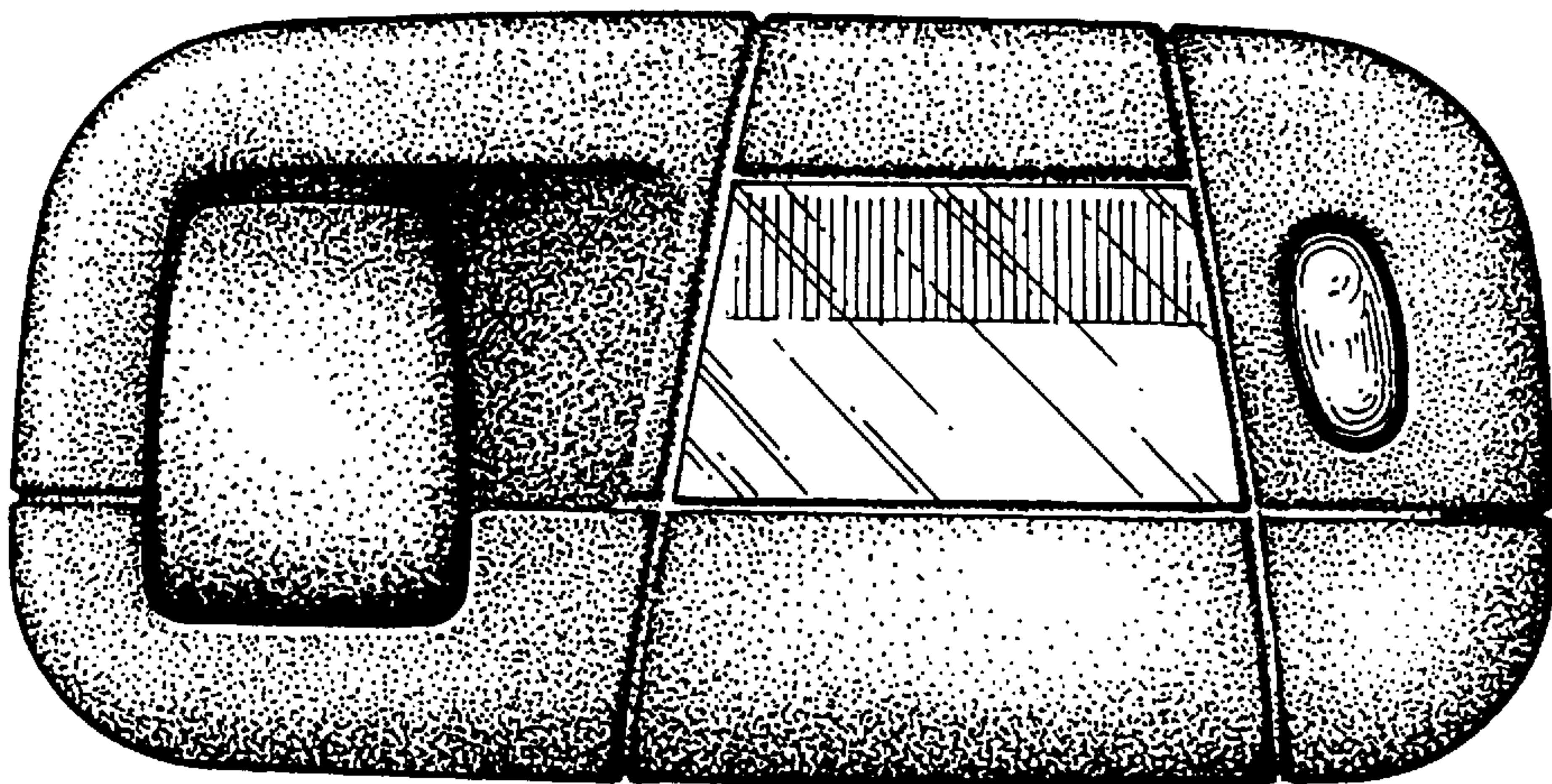

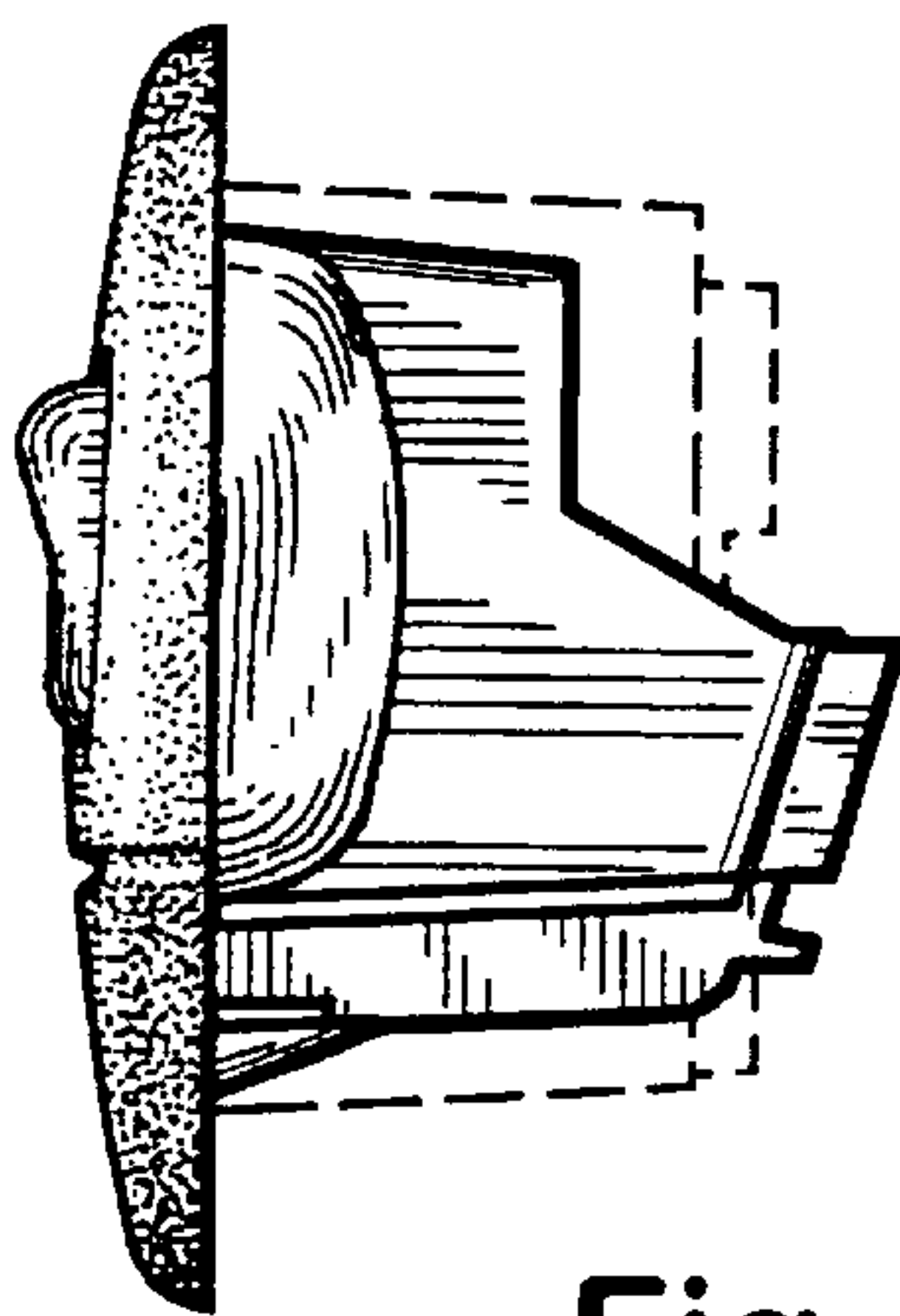

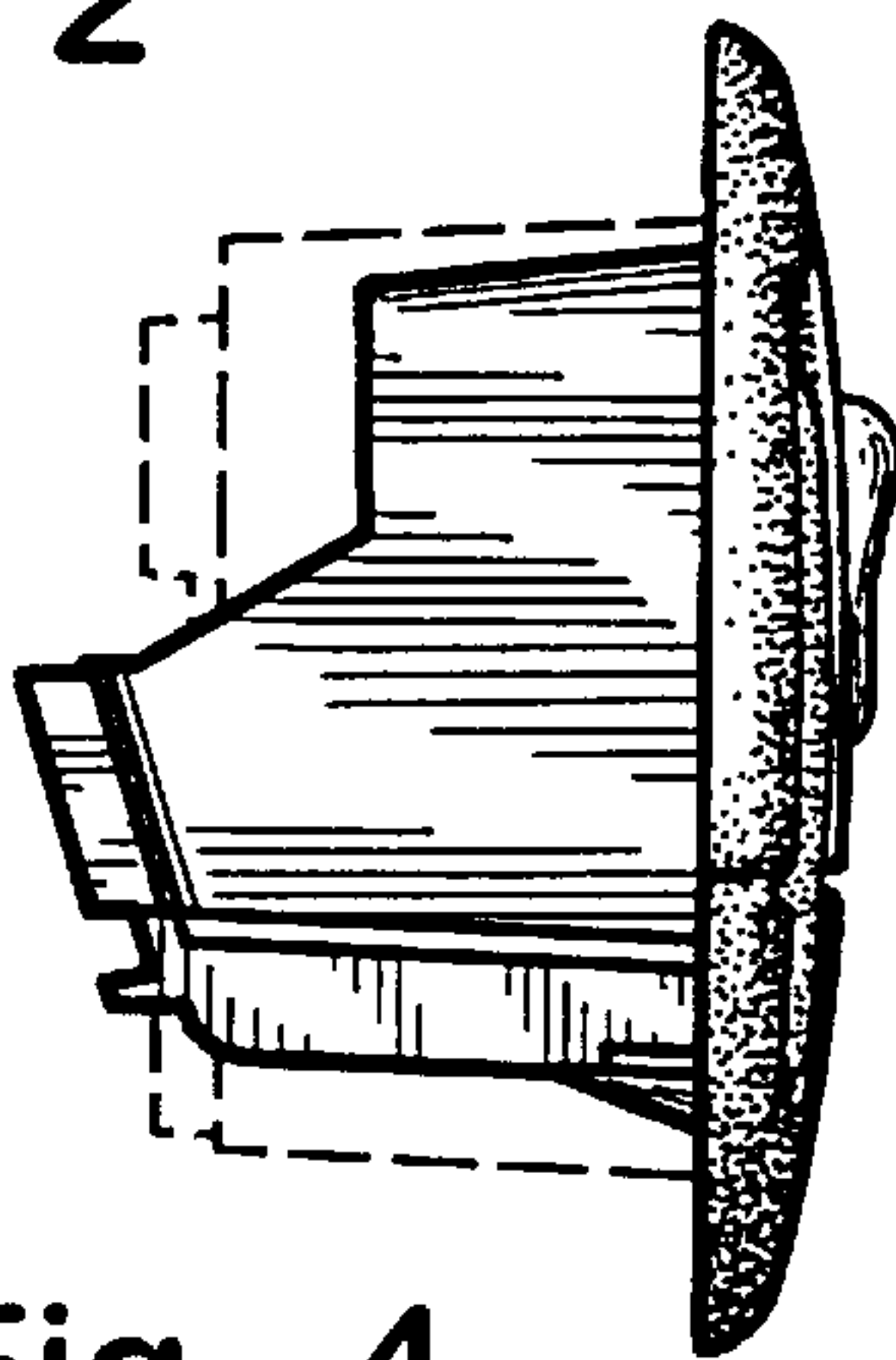

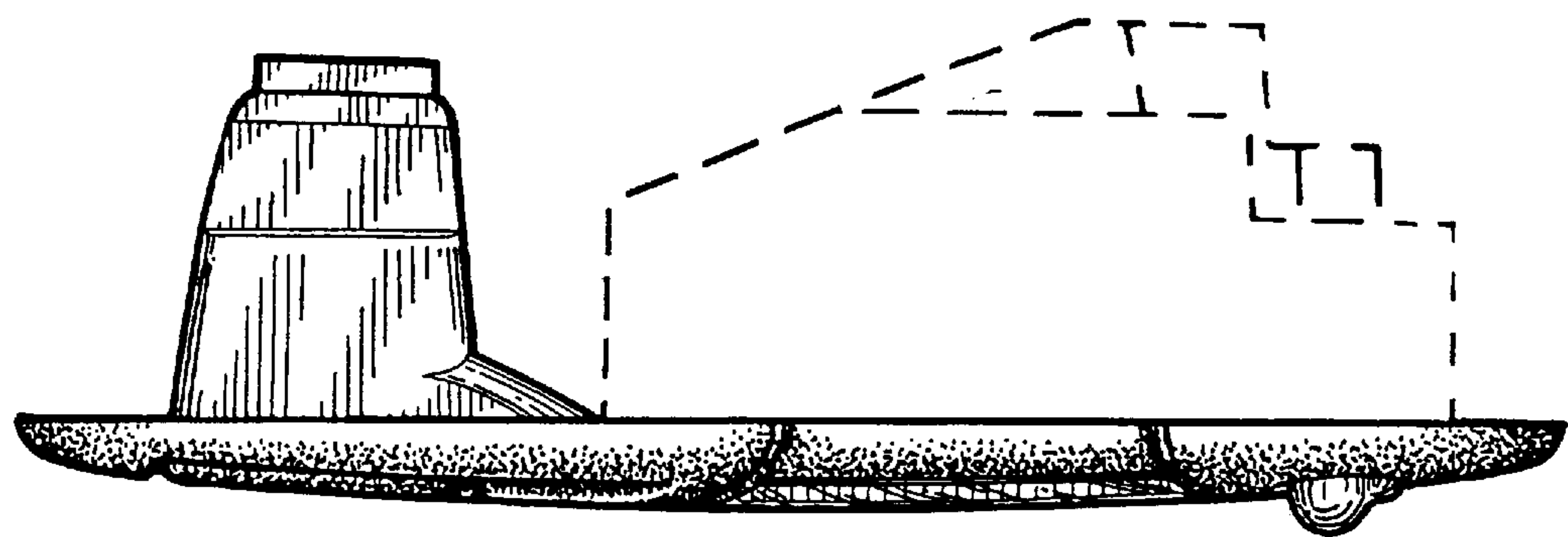

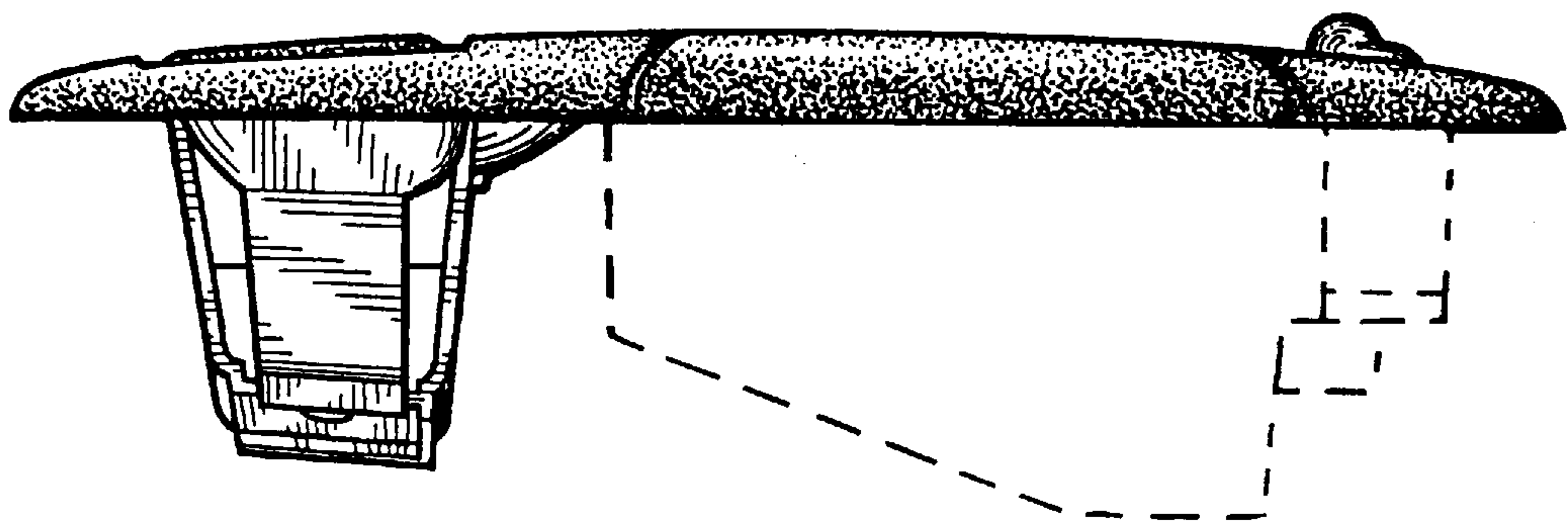

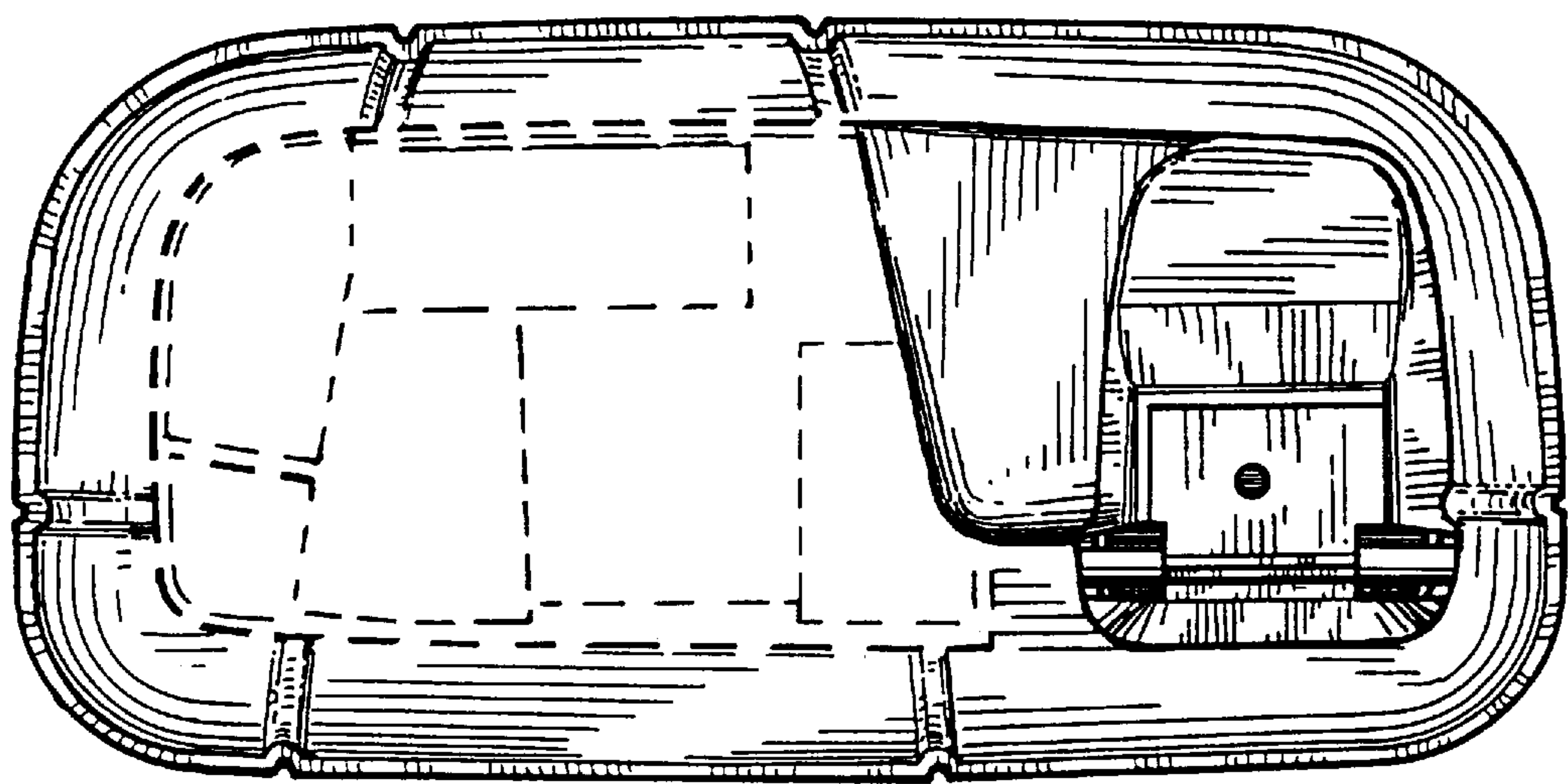

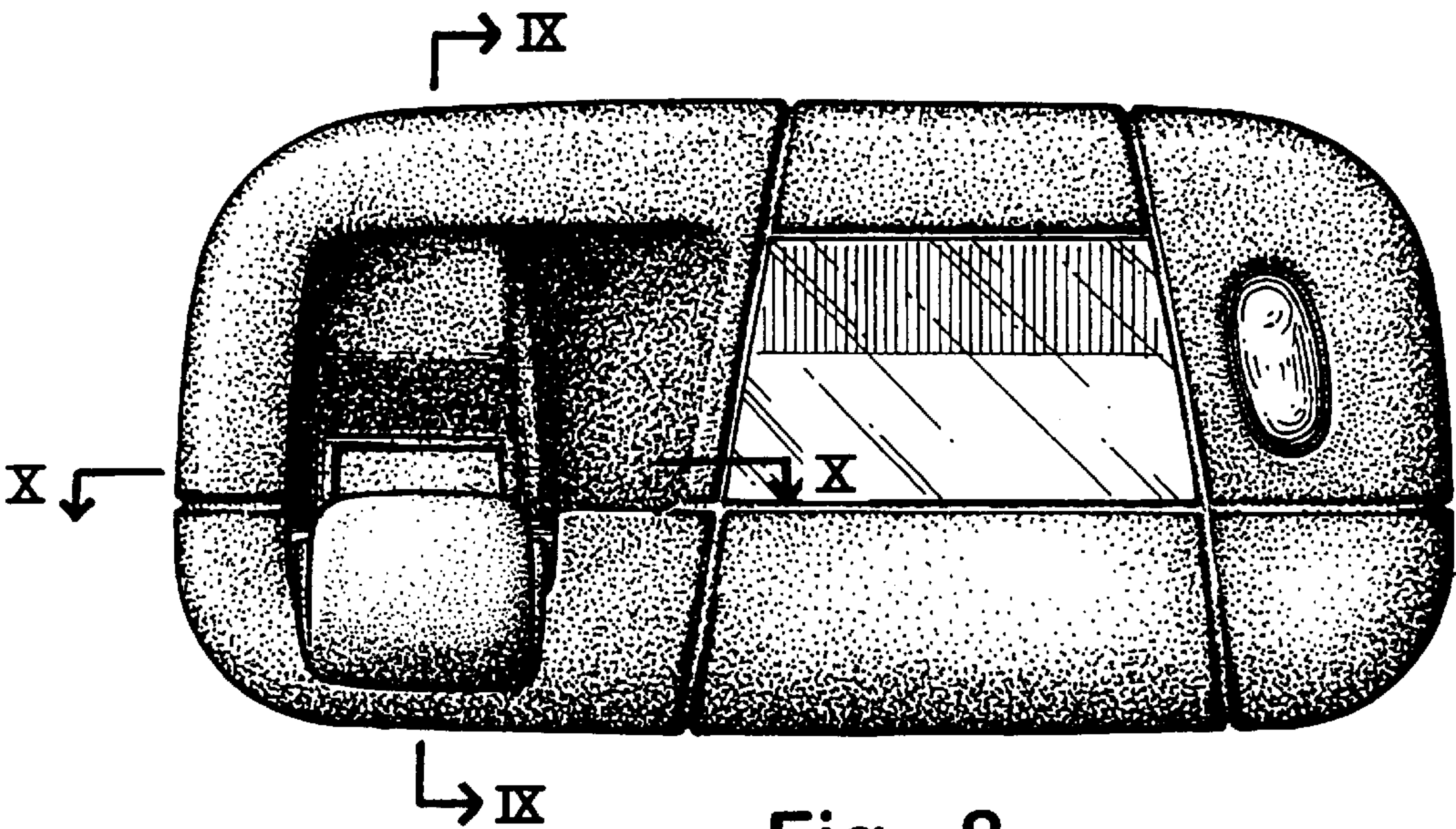

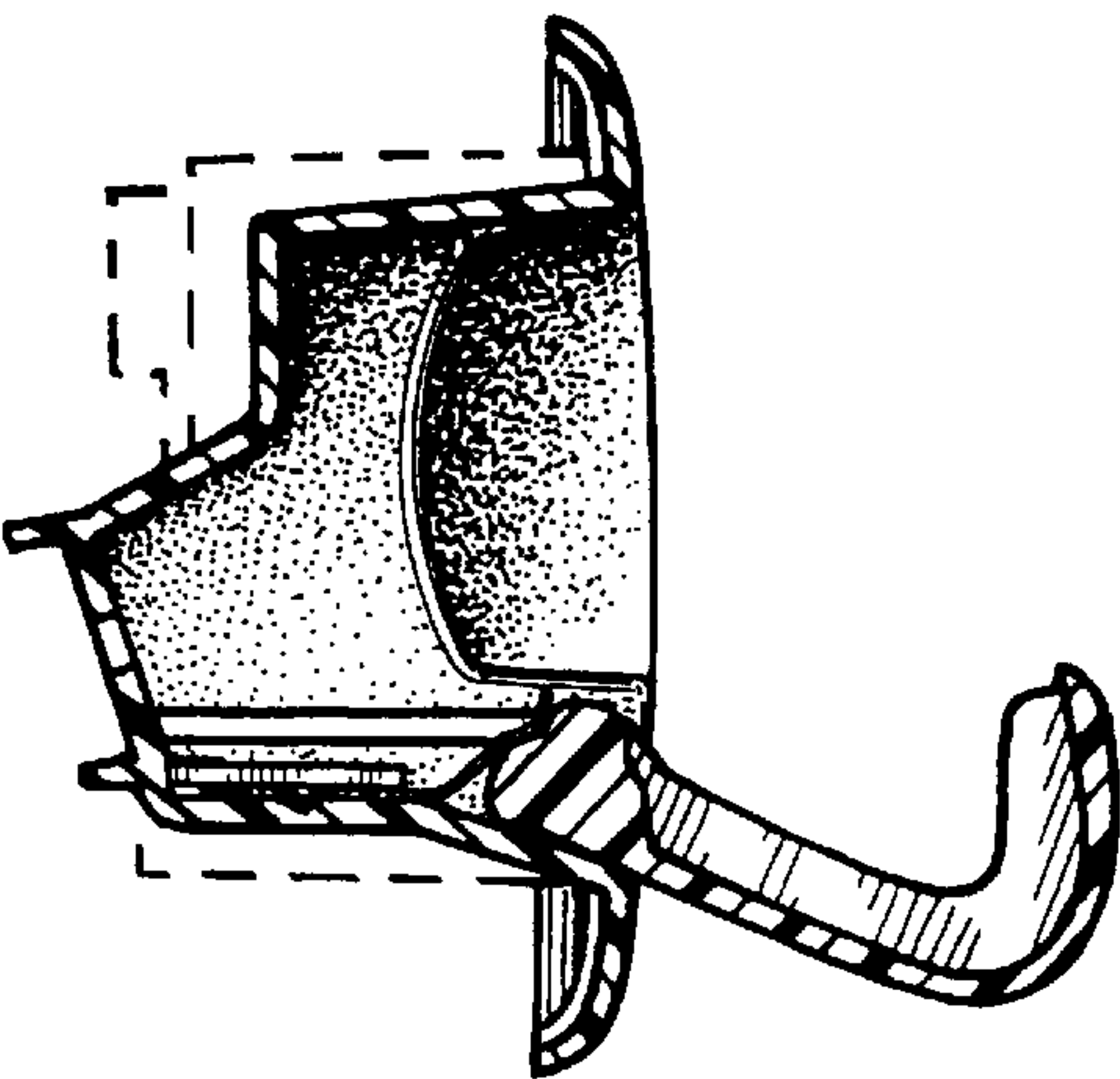

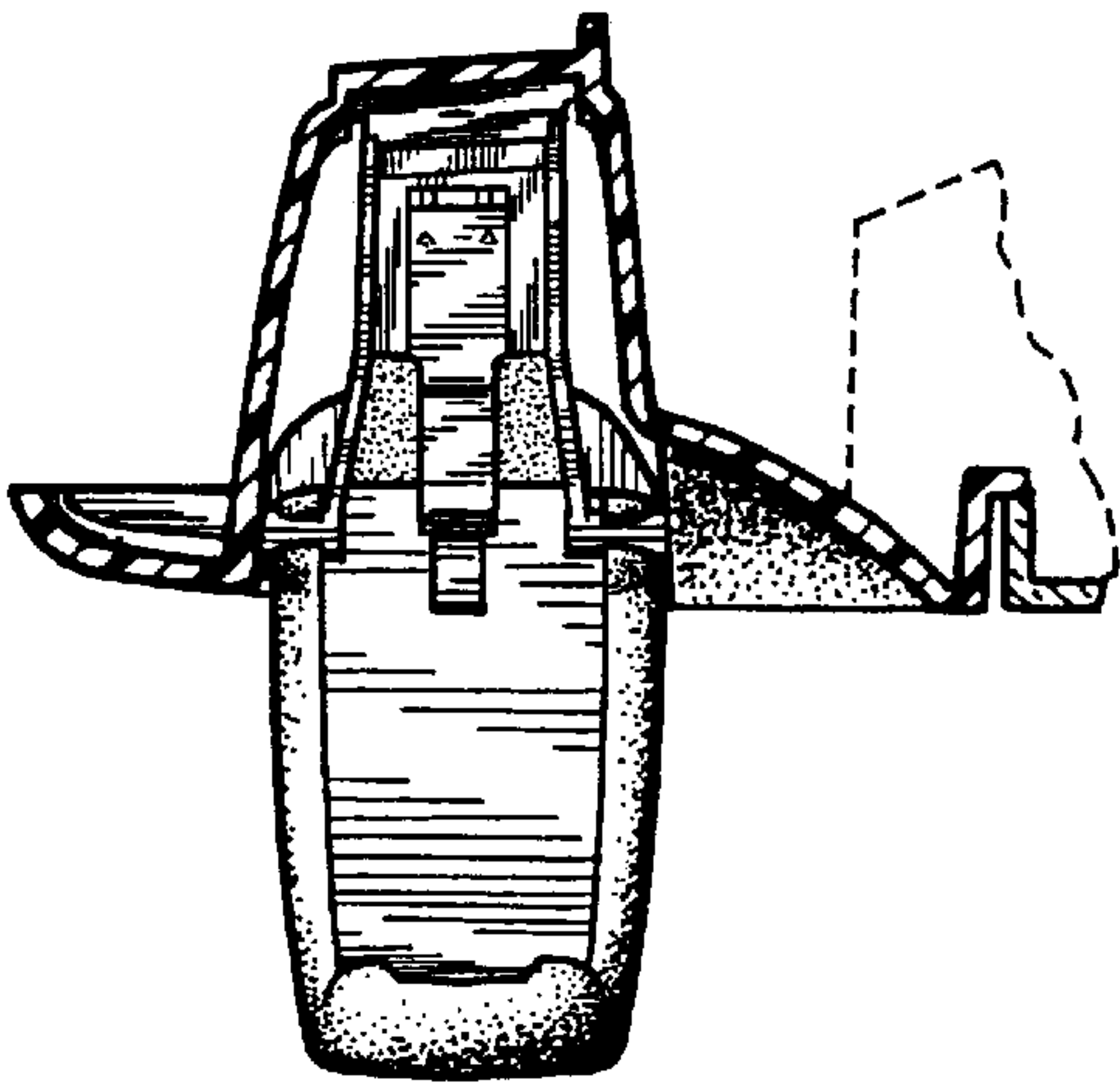
