[57] **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for an inflatable hand cover toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of an inflatable hand cover toy showing my new design, the pattern which is partially shown is understood to repeat across the exterior surface;

FIG. 2 is a side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

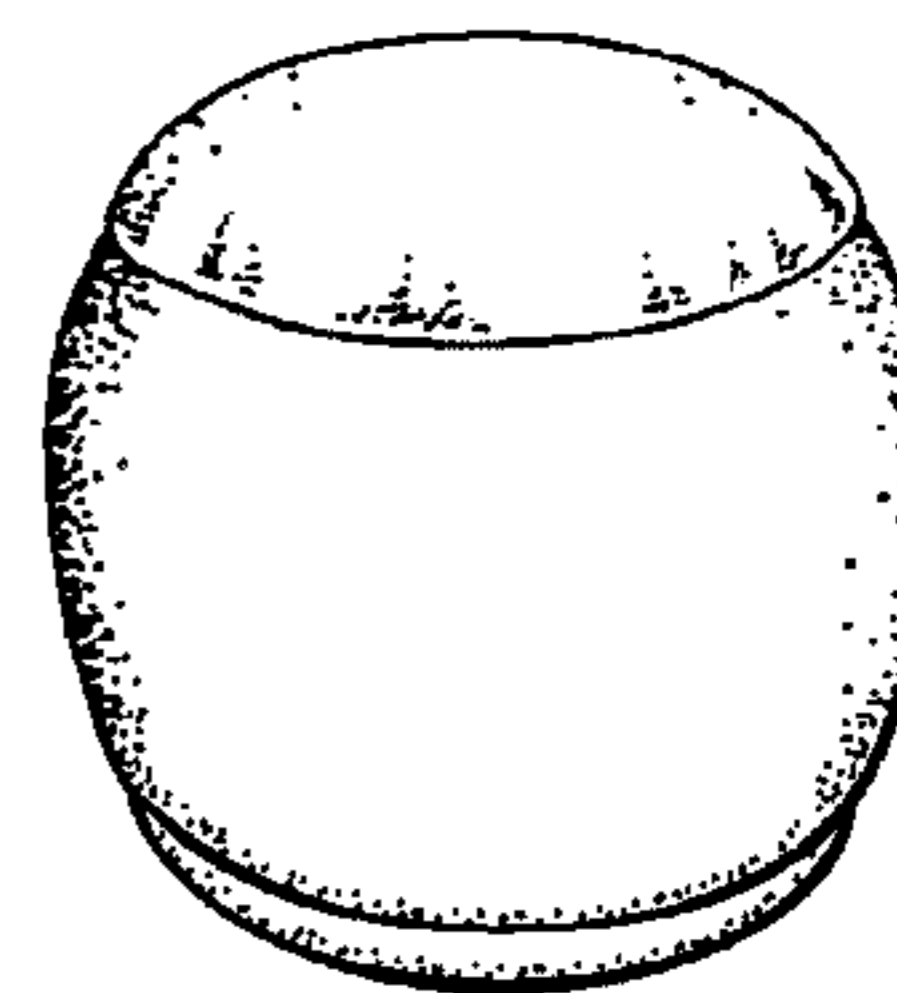
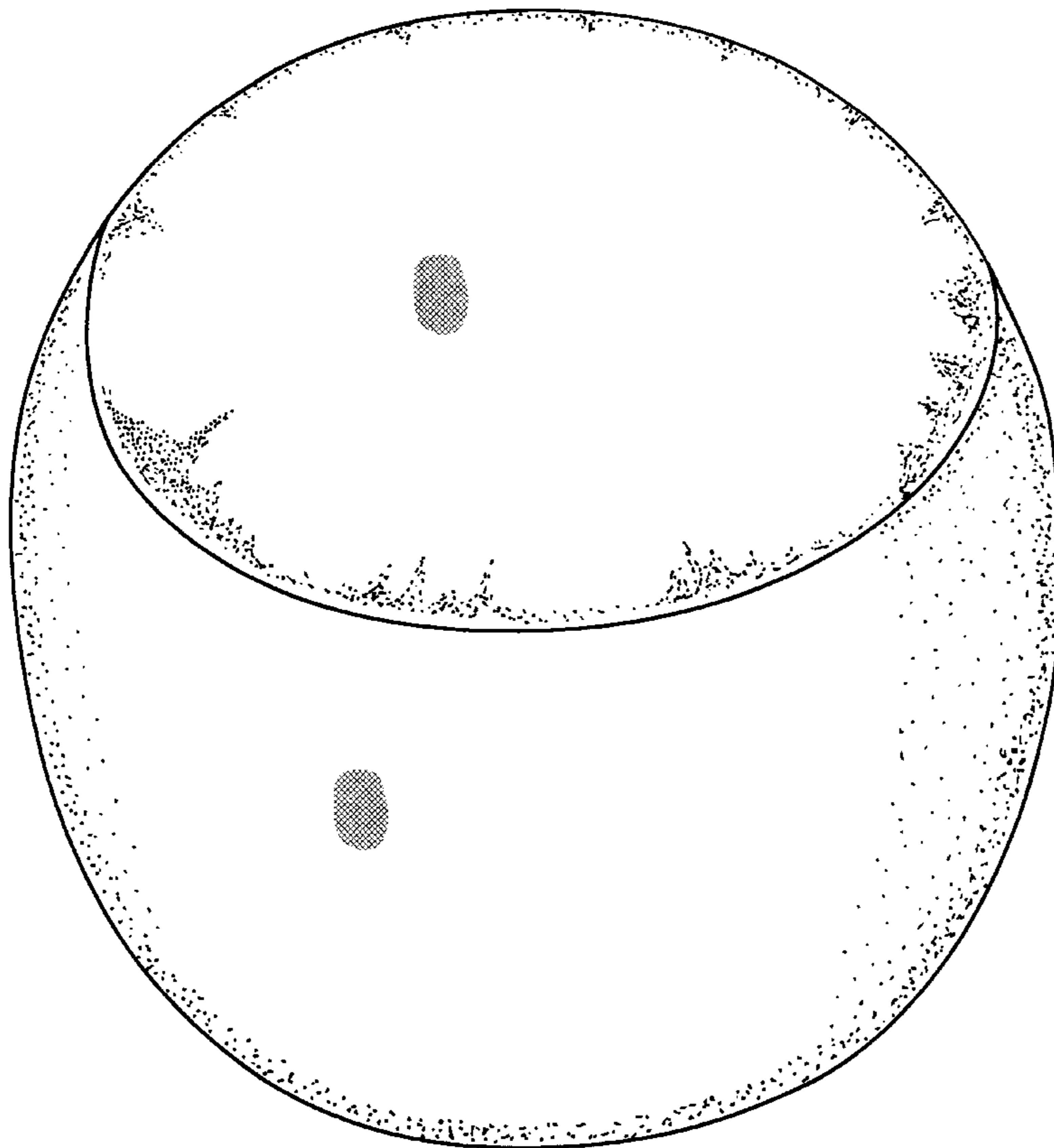
FIG. 4 is a side perspective view thereof, opposite that shown in FIG. 2;

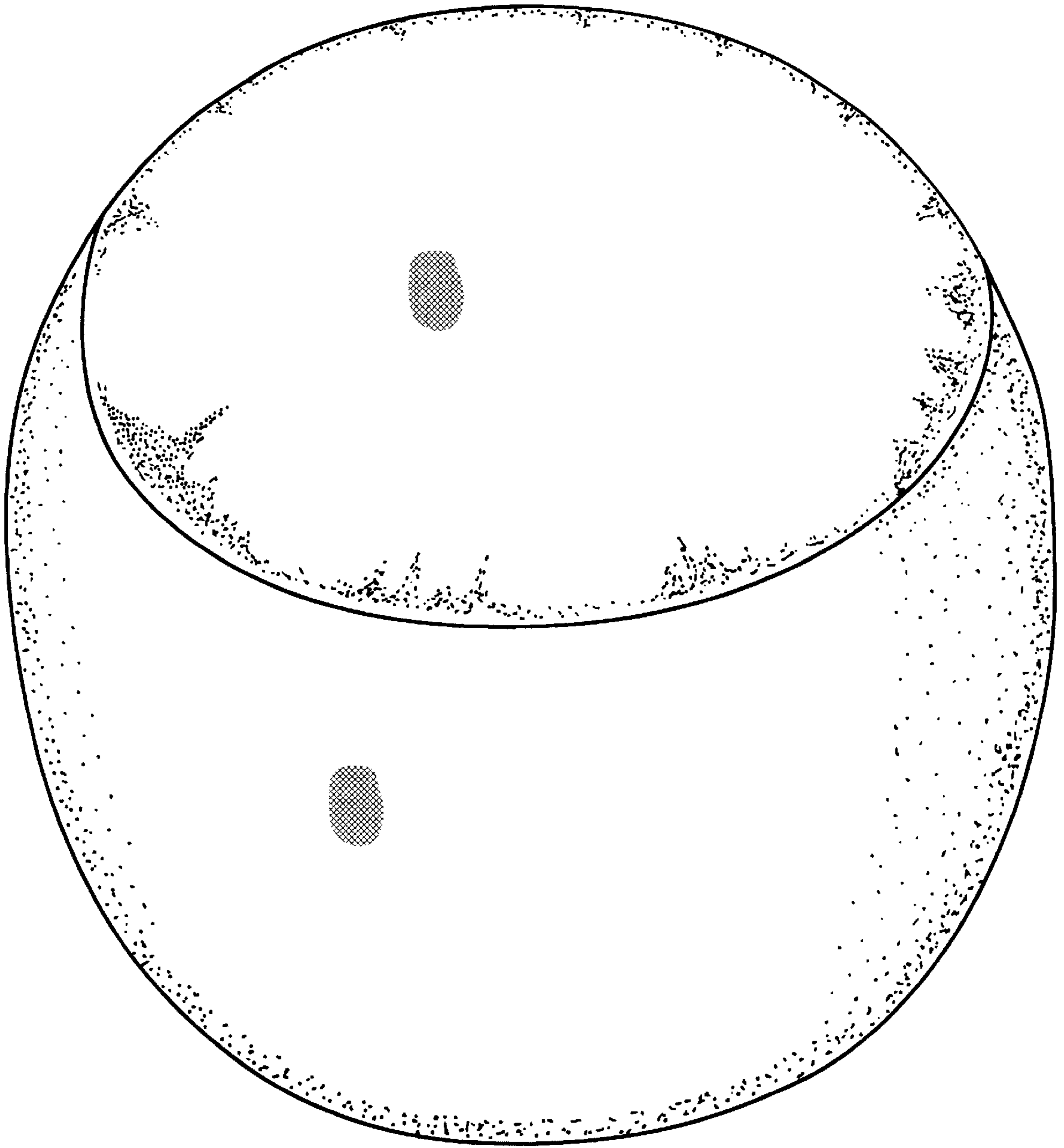

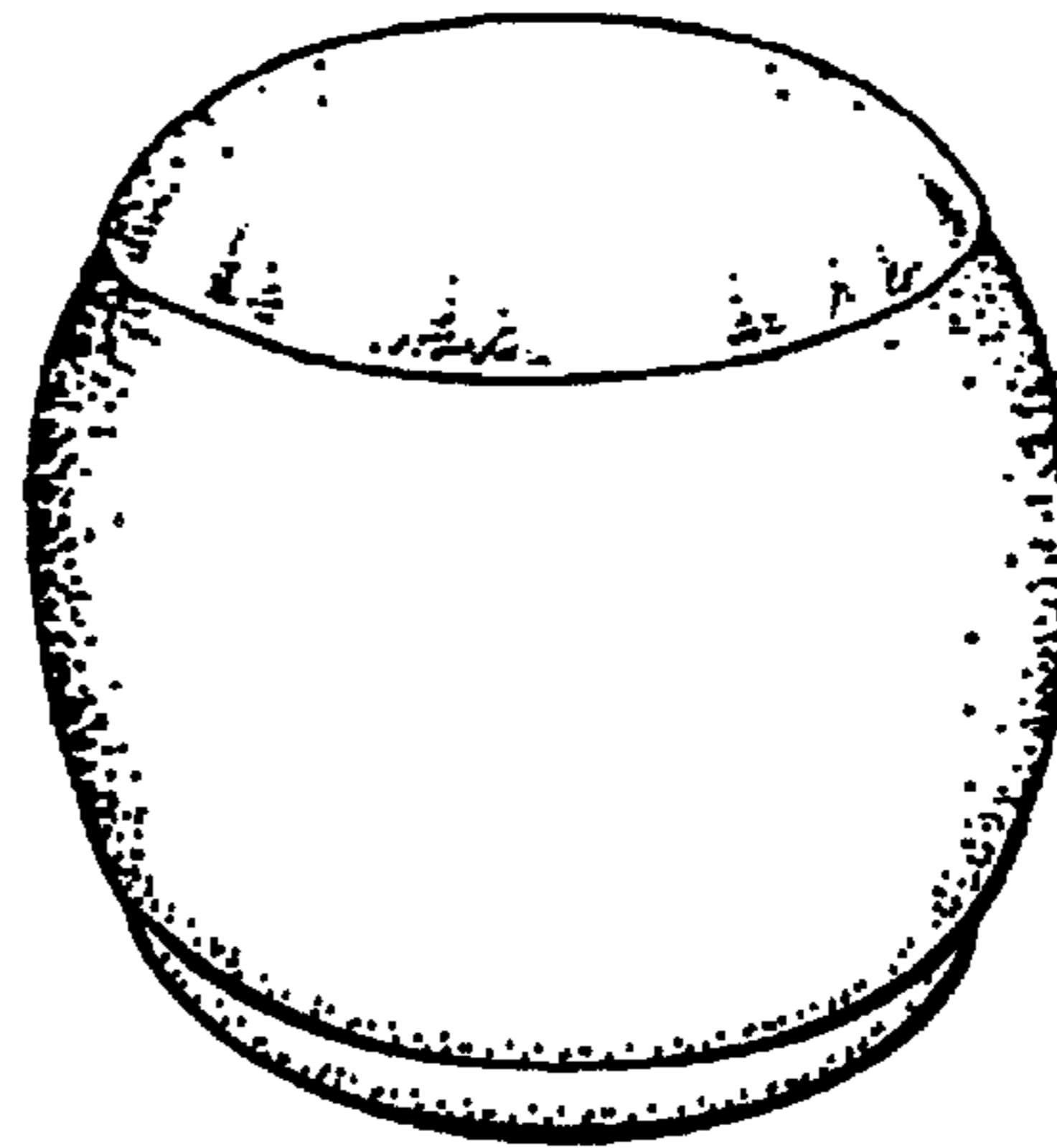

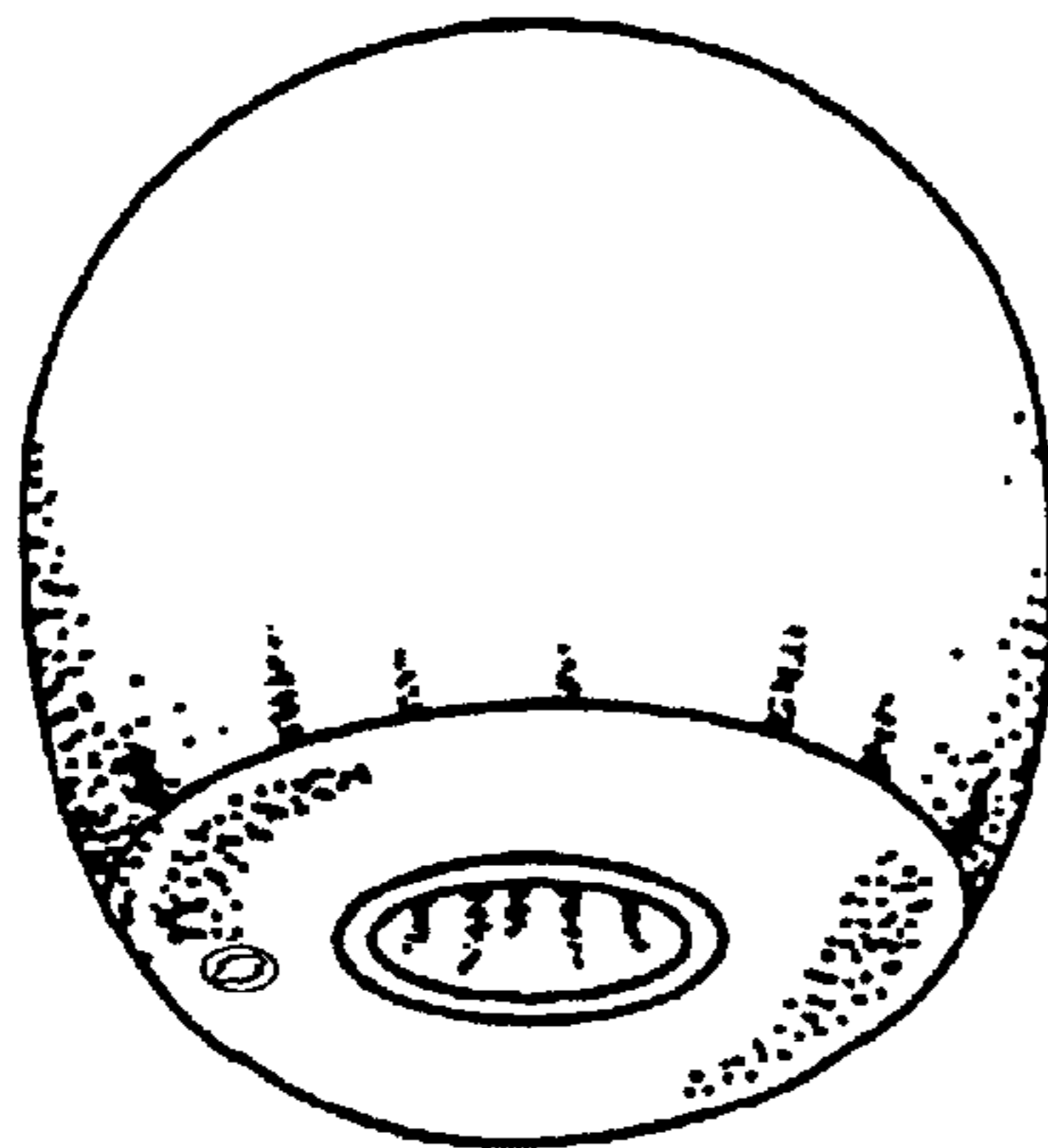

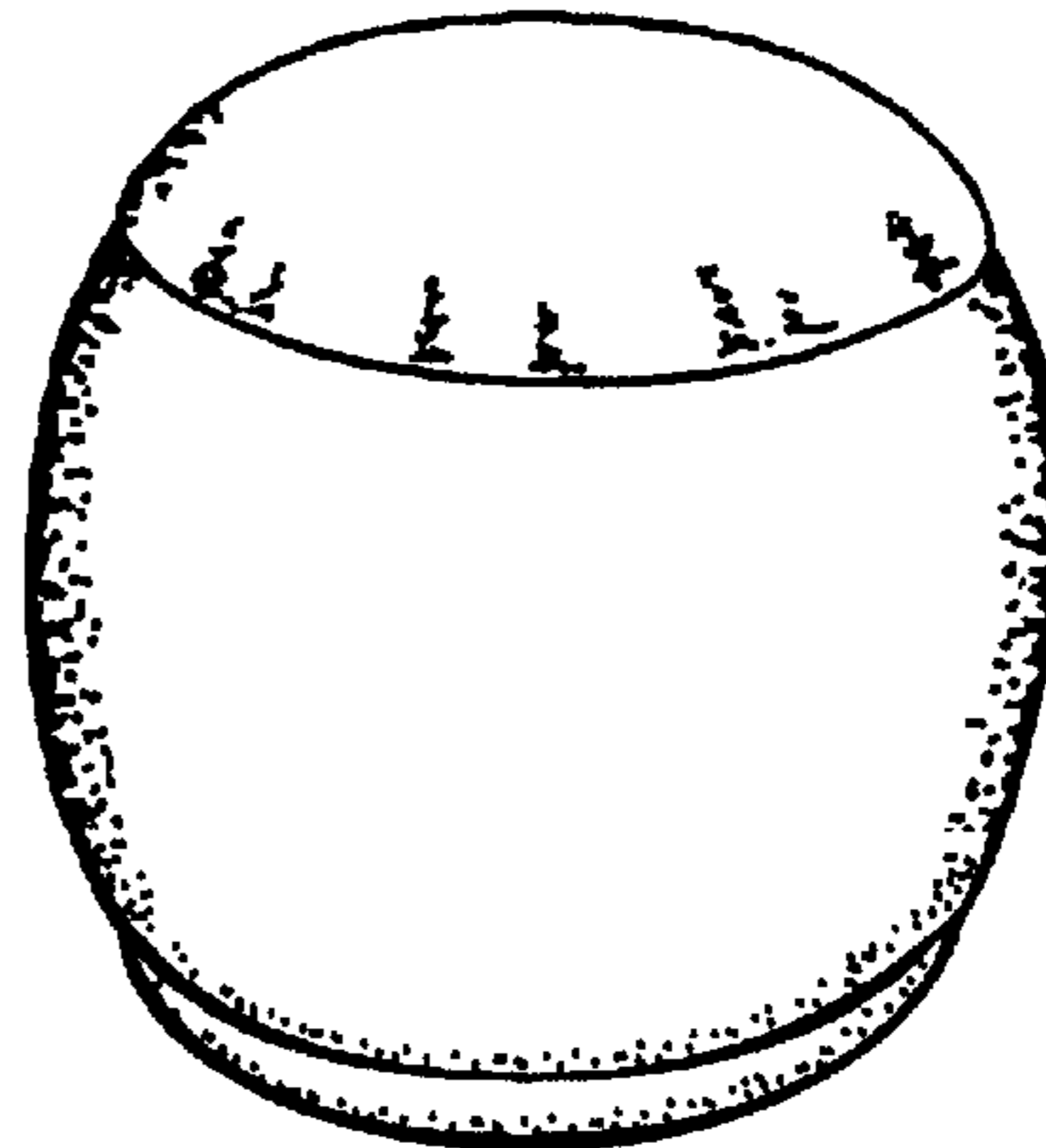

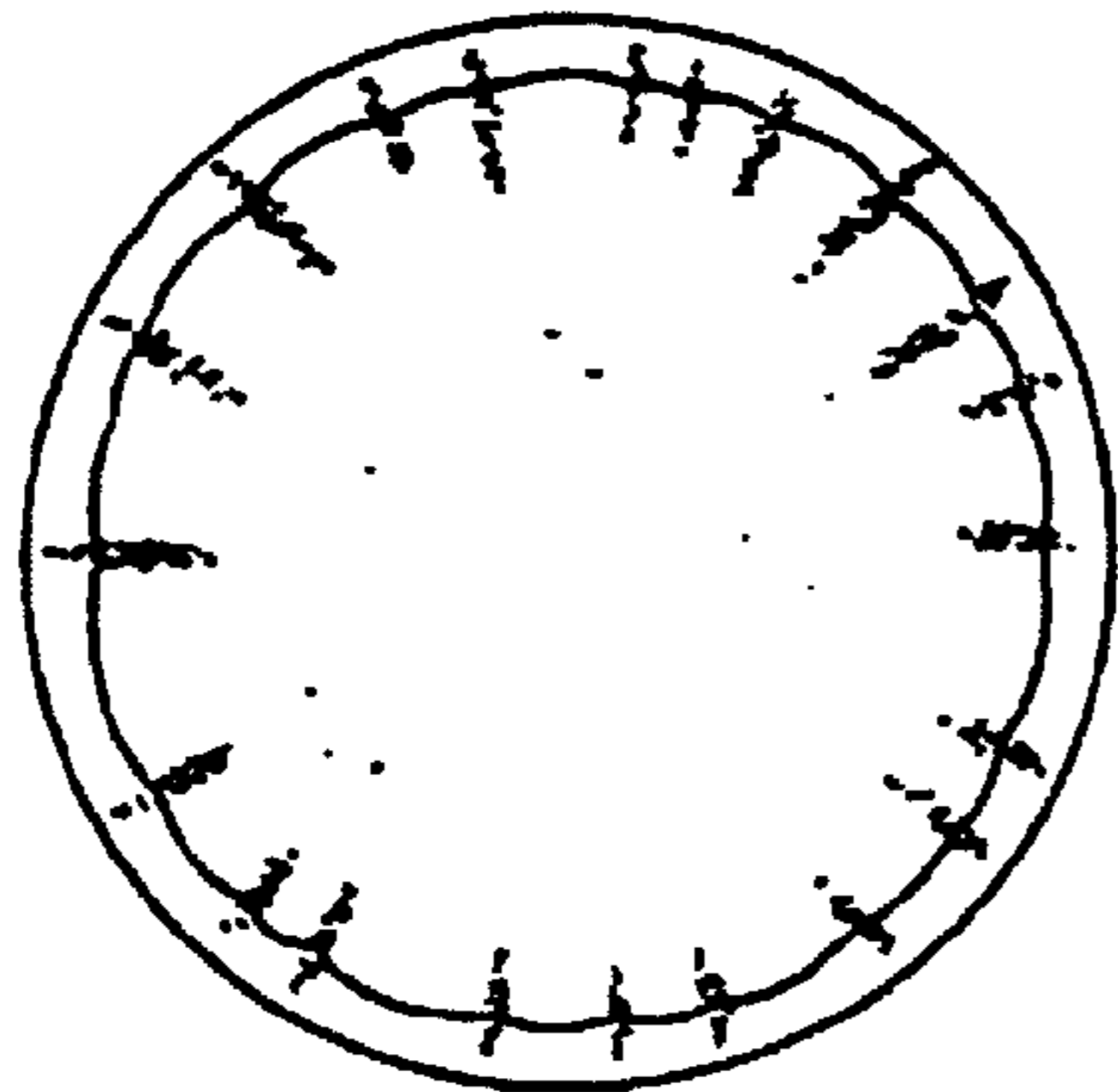

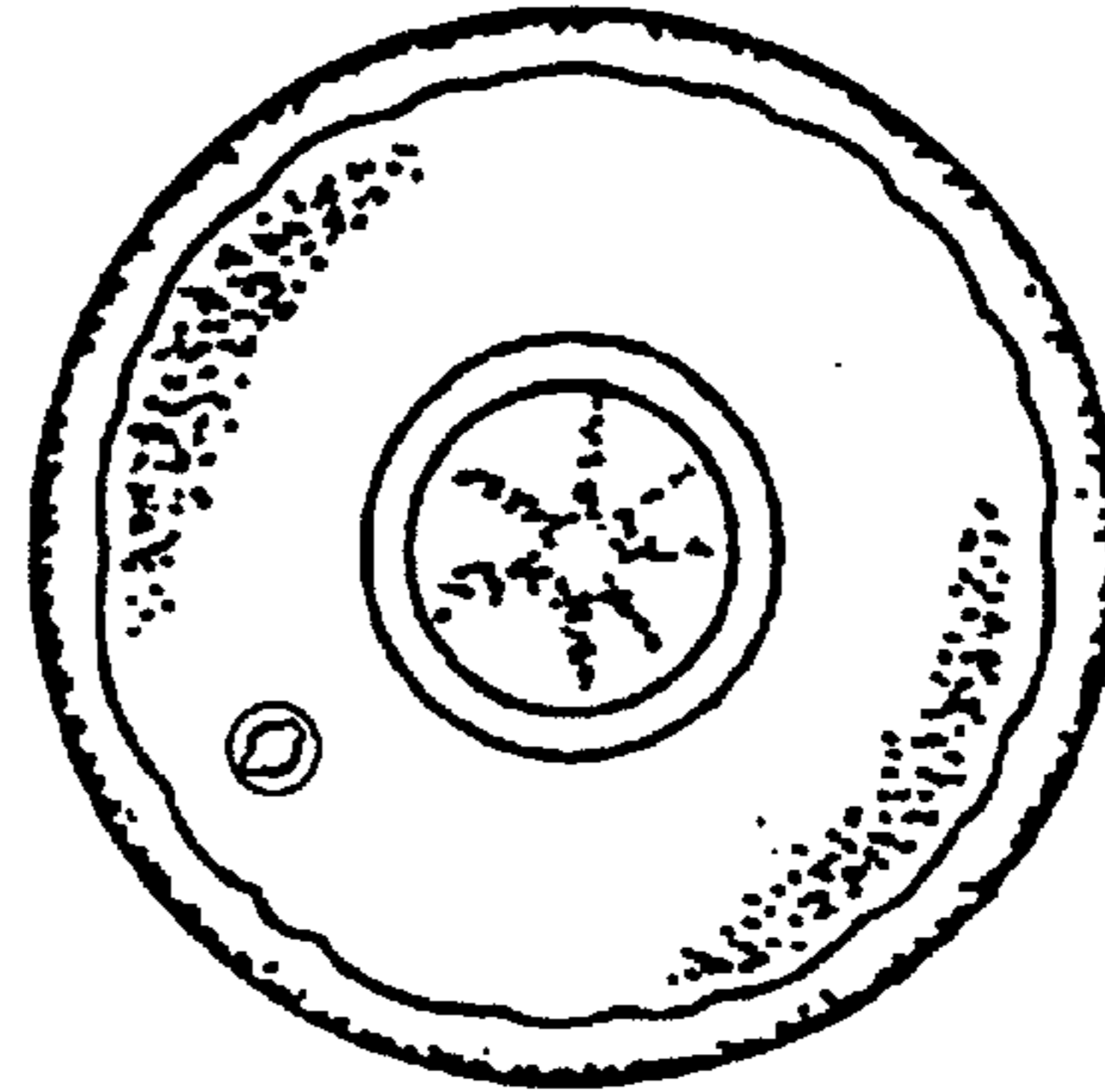

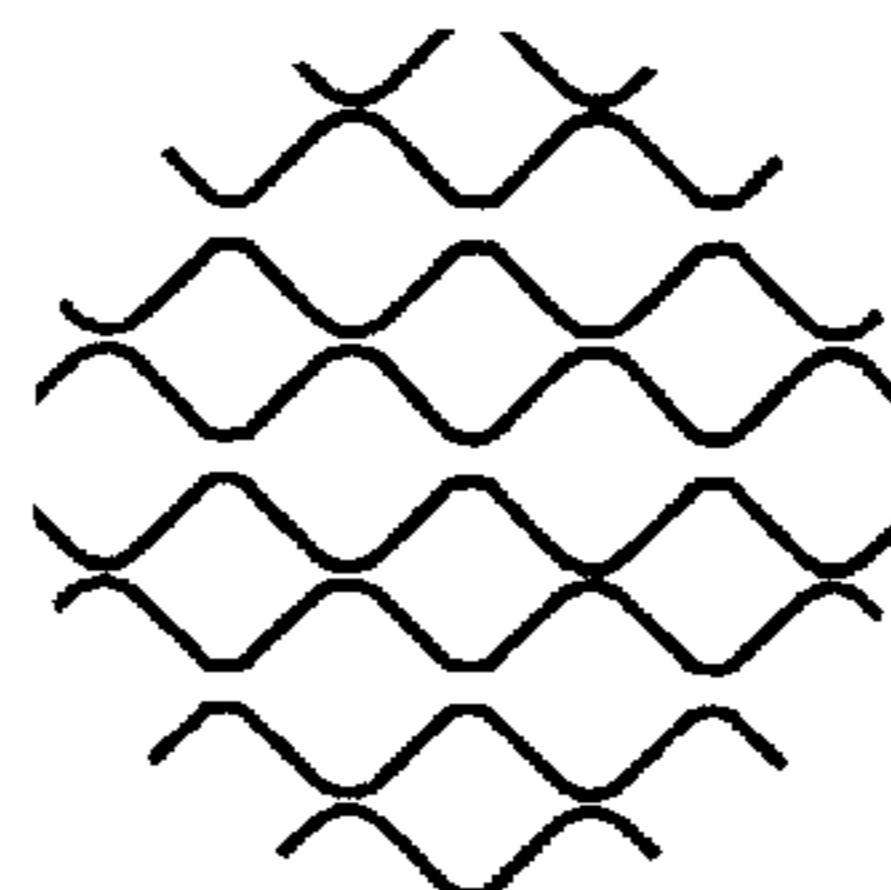
