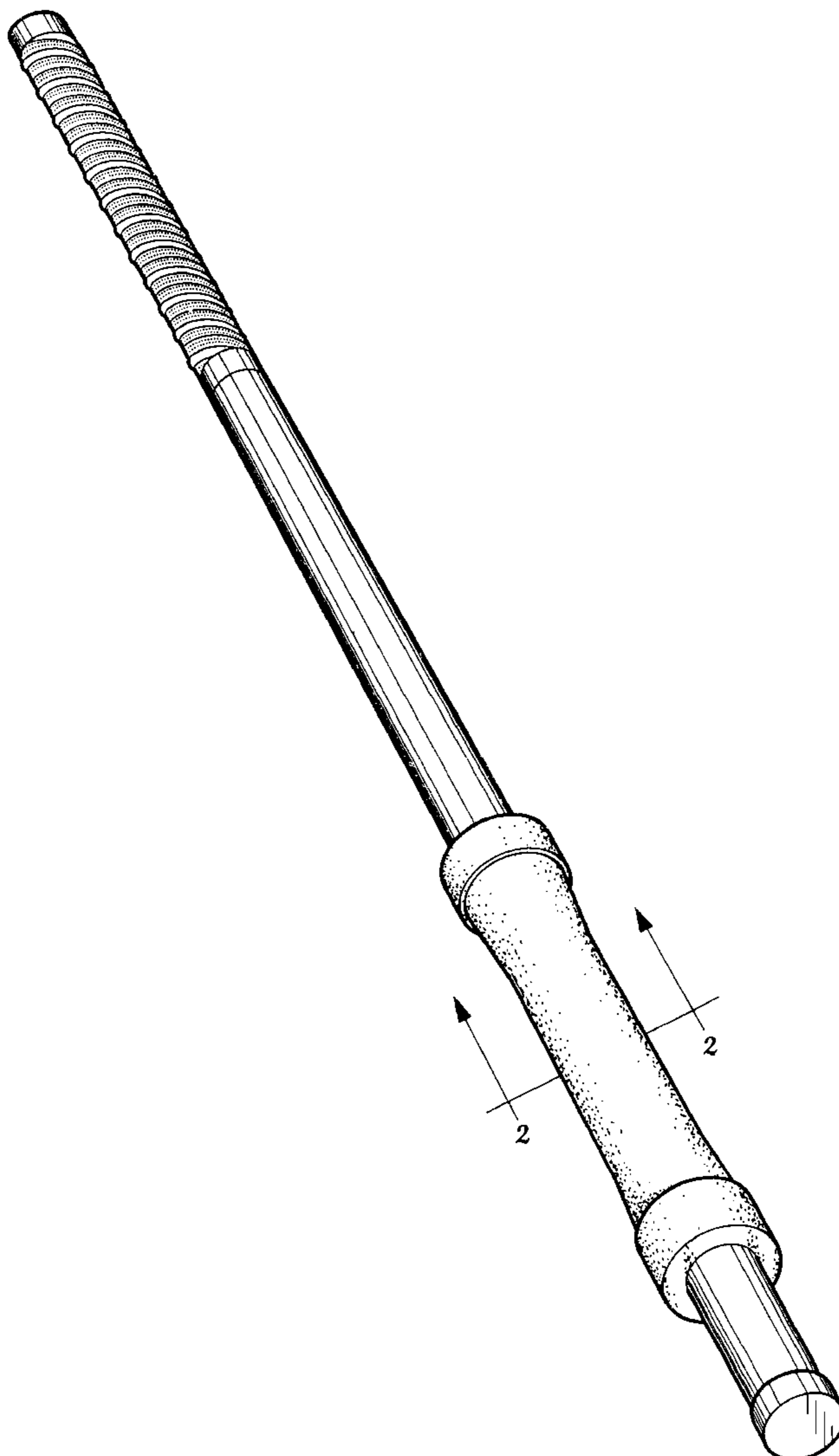
The undisclosed sides of the practice bat are substantially similar to that disclosed in FIG. 1.

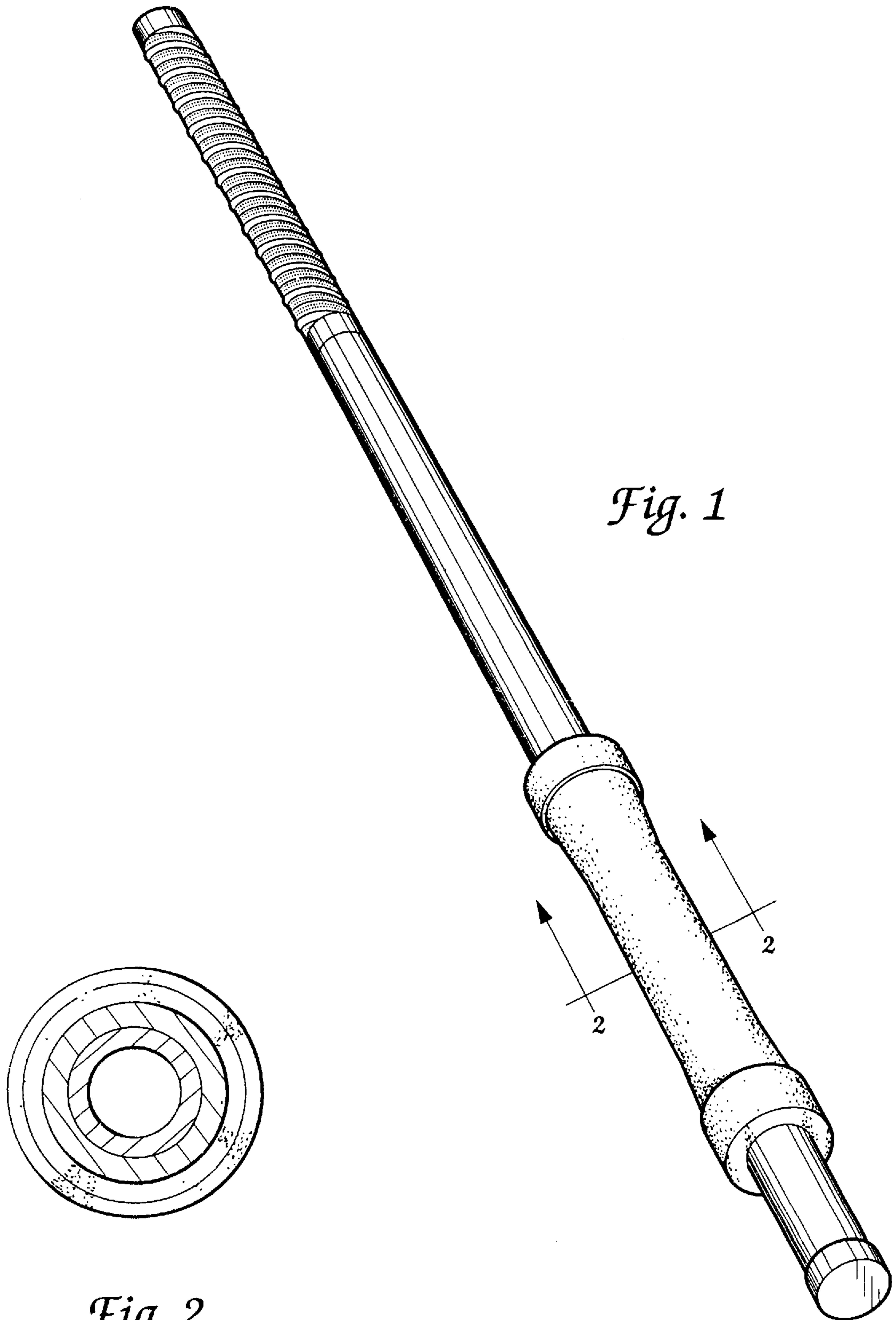
