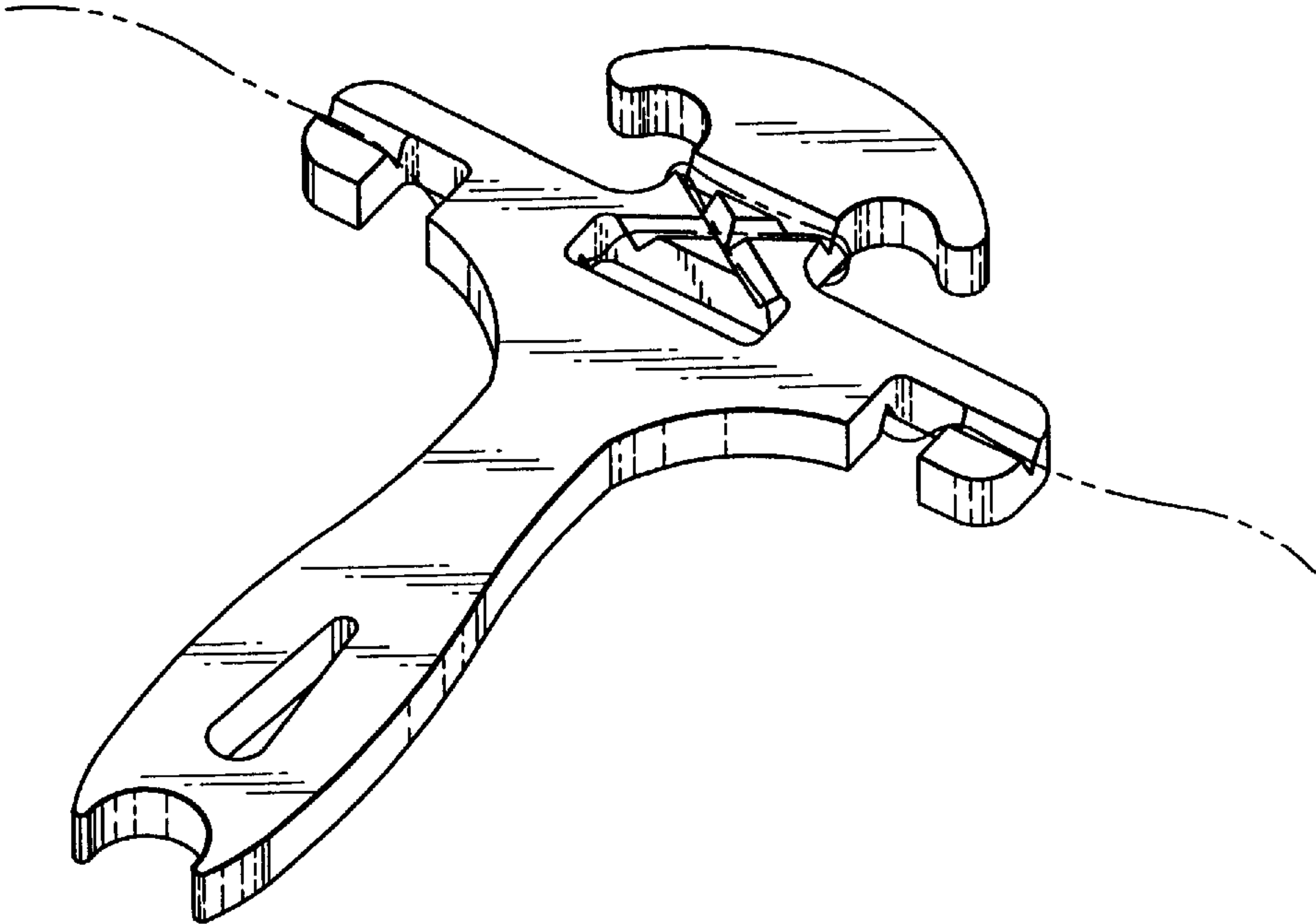
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fishing line drop tool, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fishing line drop tool showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view showing the design for the fishing line drop tool of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view showing the design for the fishing line drop tool of FIG. 1, with the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top elevational view showing the design for the fishing line drop tool of FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear view showing the design for the fishing line drop tool of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view showing the design for the fishing line drop tool of FIG. 1.
In FIG. 1, the broken lines showing of the fishing line positioned in the grooves of the fishing line drop tool is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

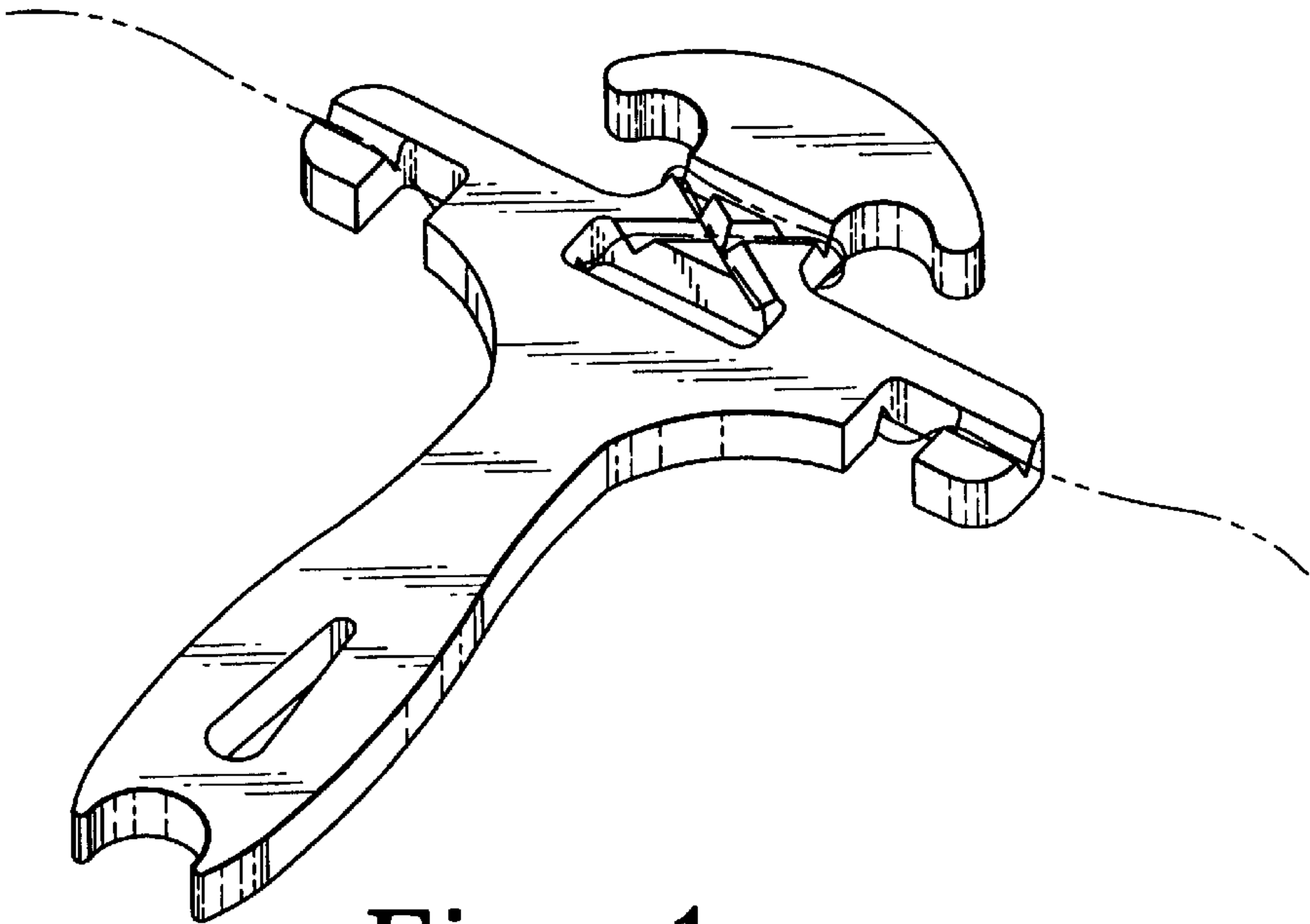

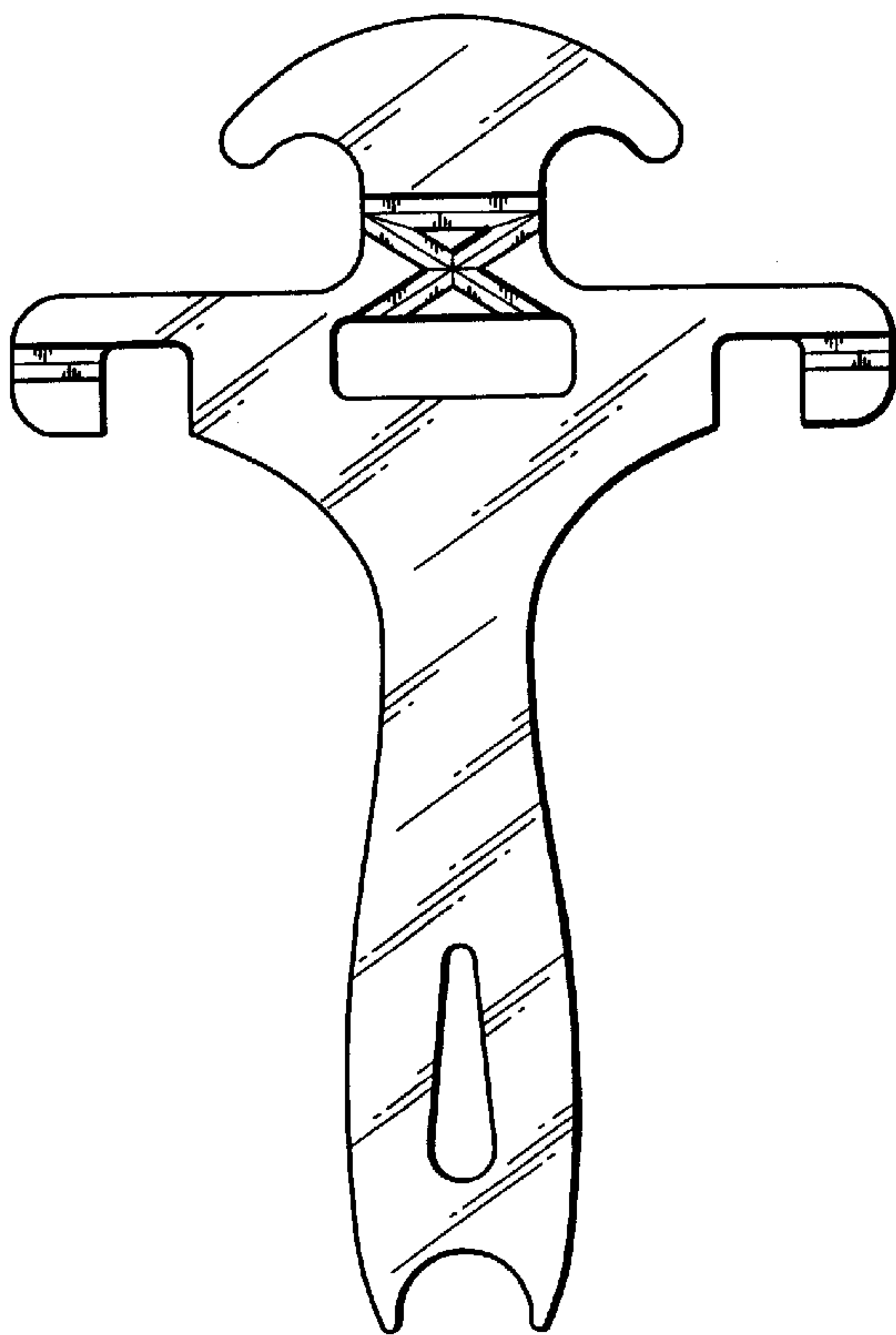

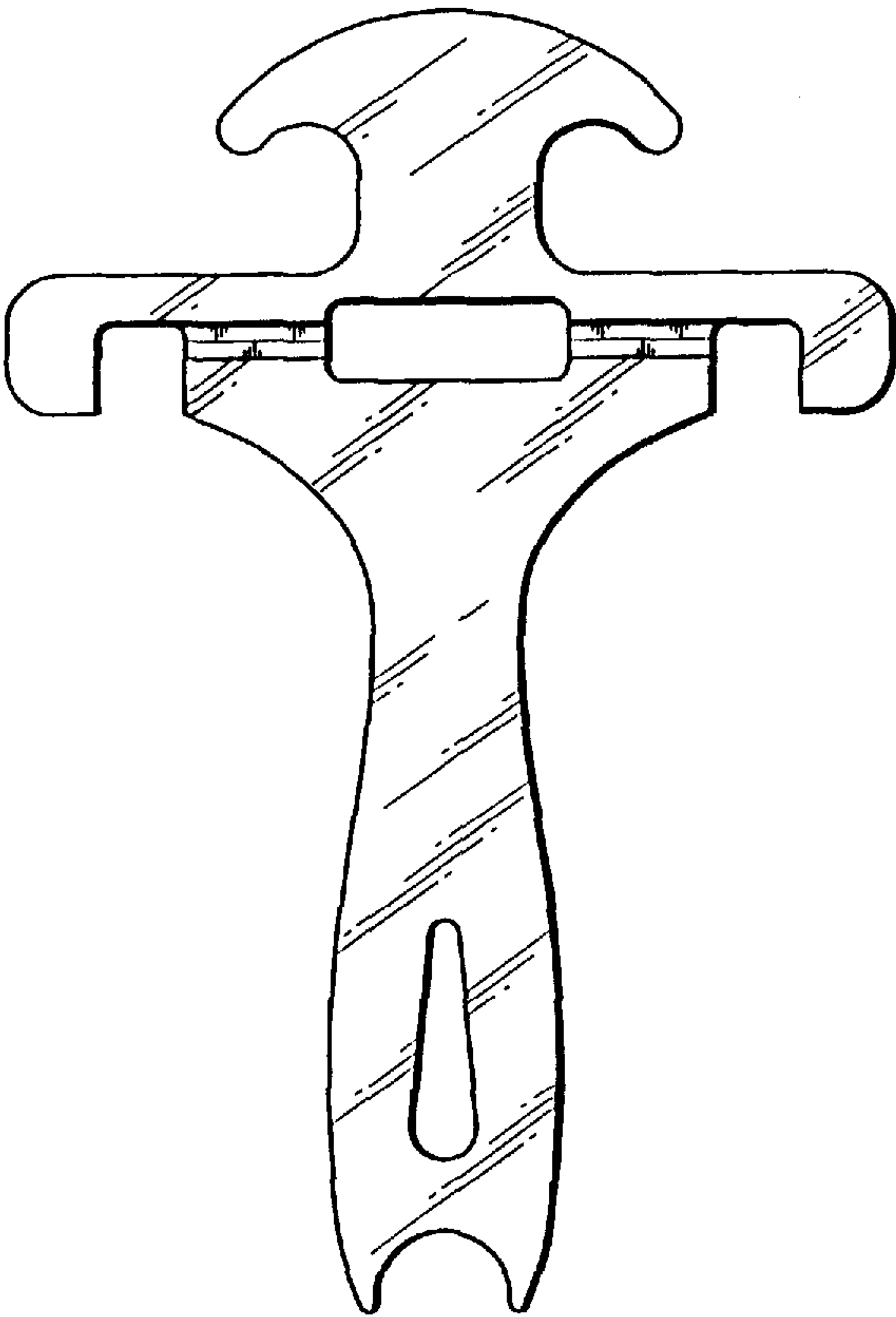
