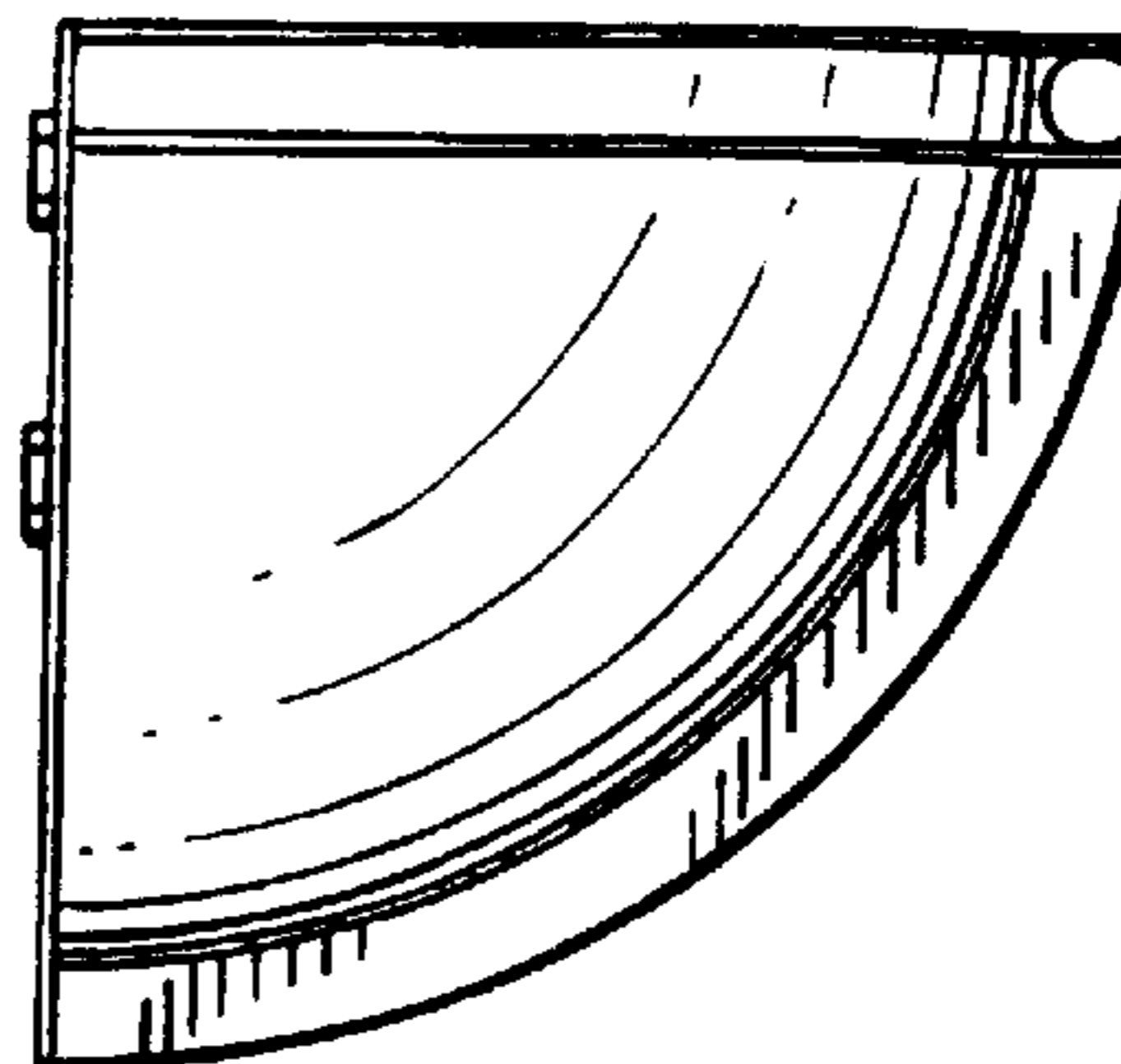
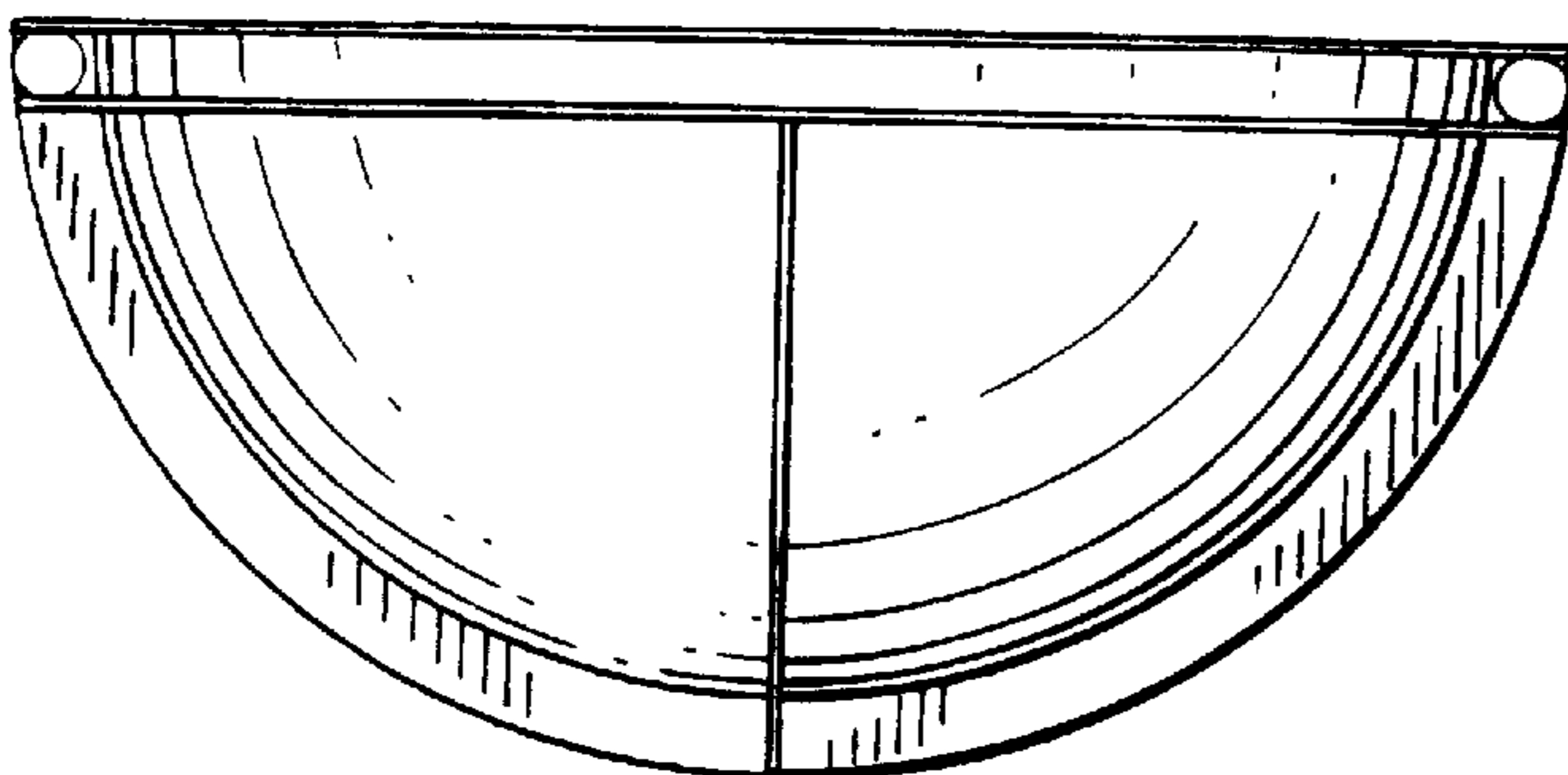
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view embodying my new design for a lighting fixture;

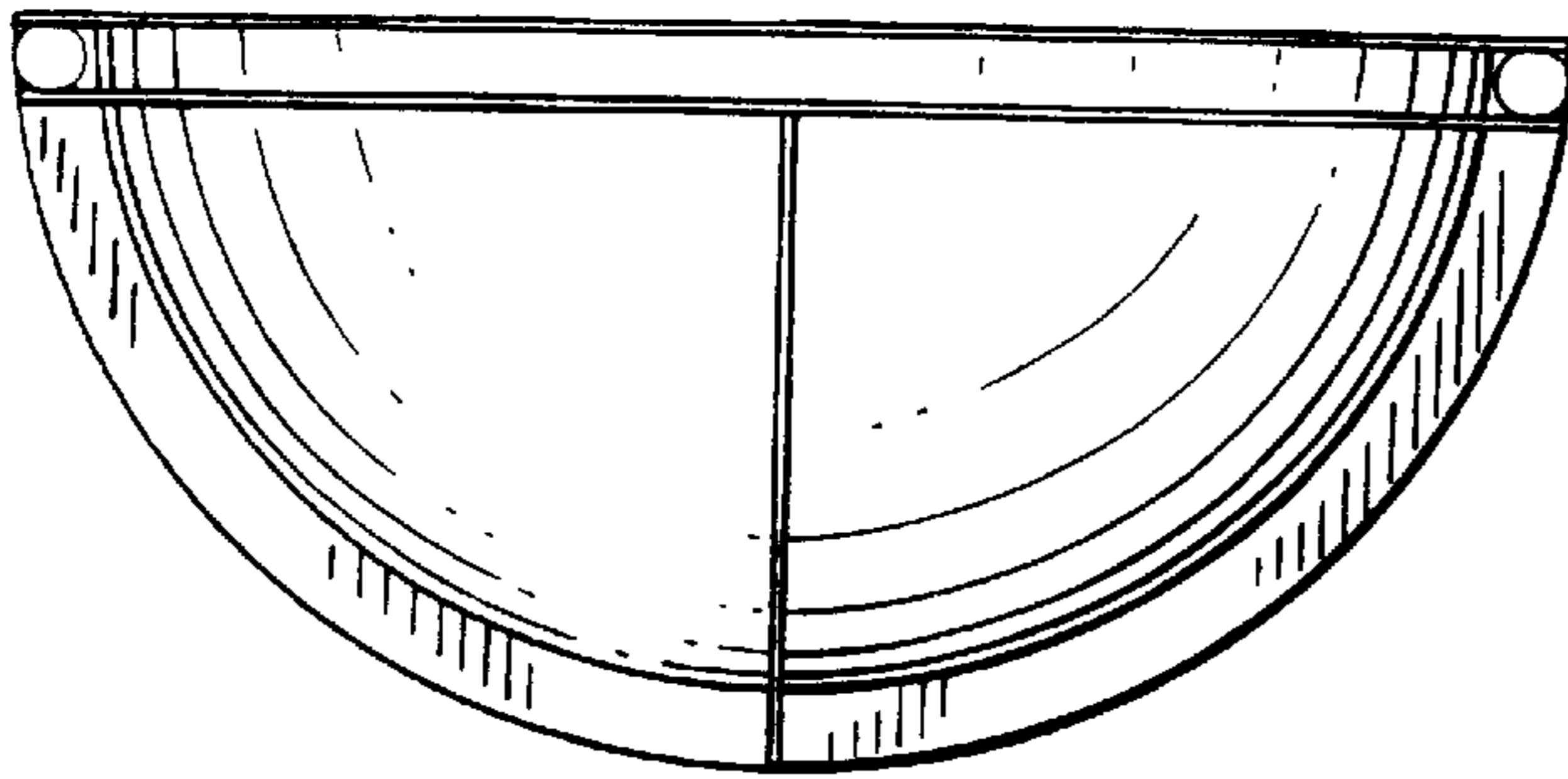
FIG. 2 is a made elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,

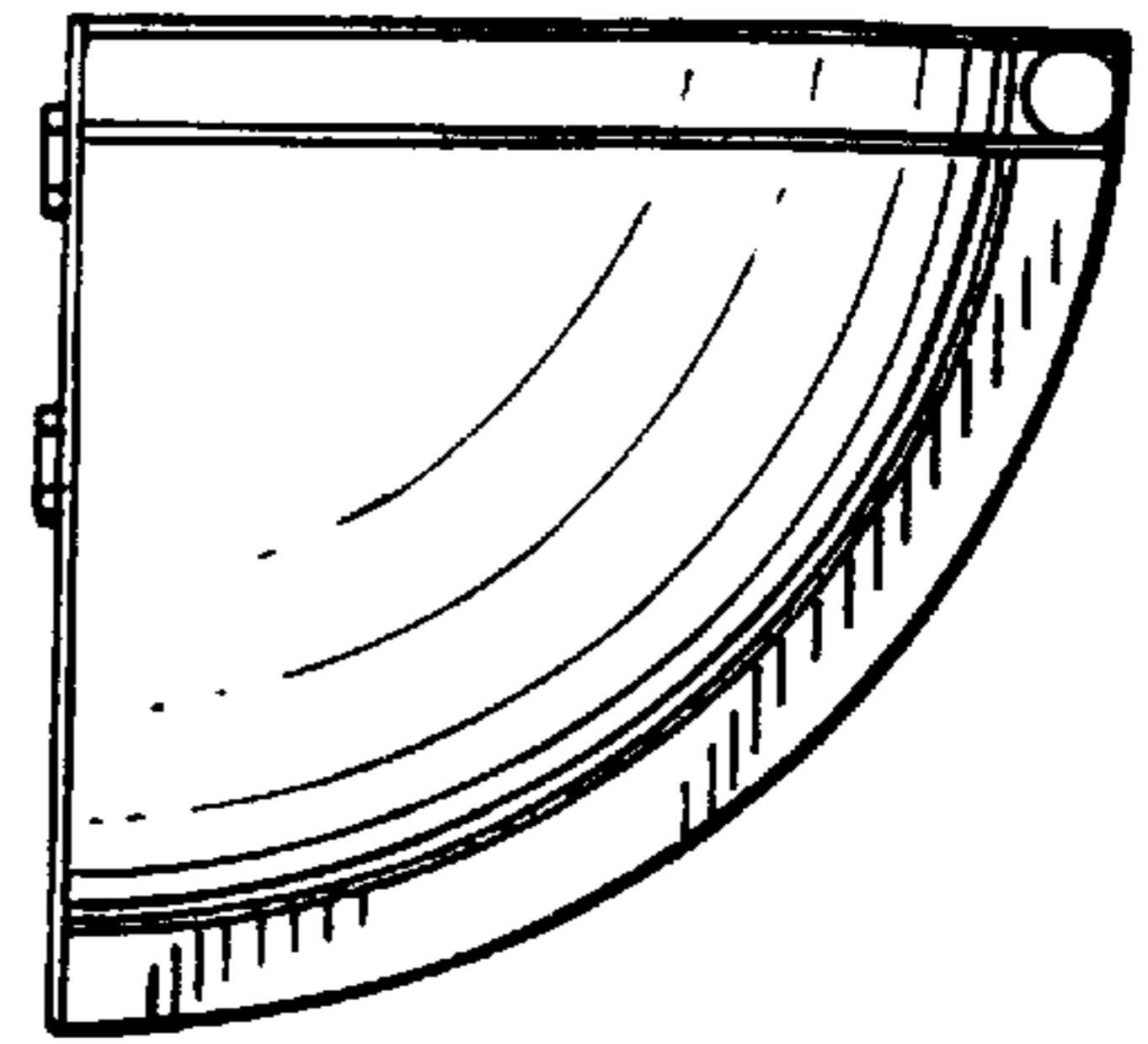
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

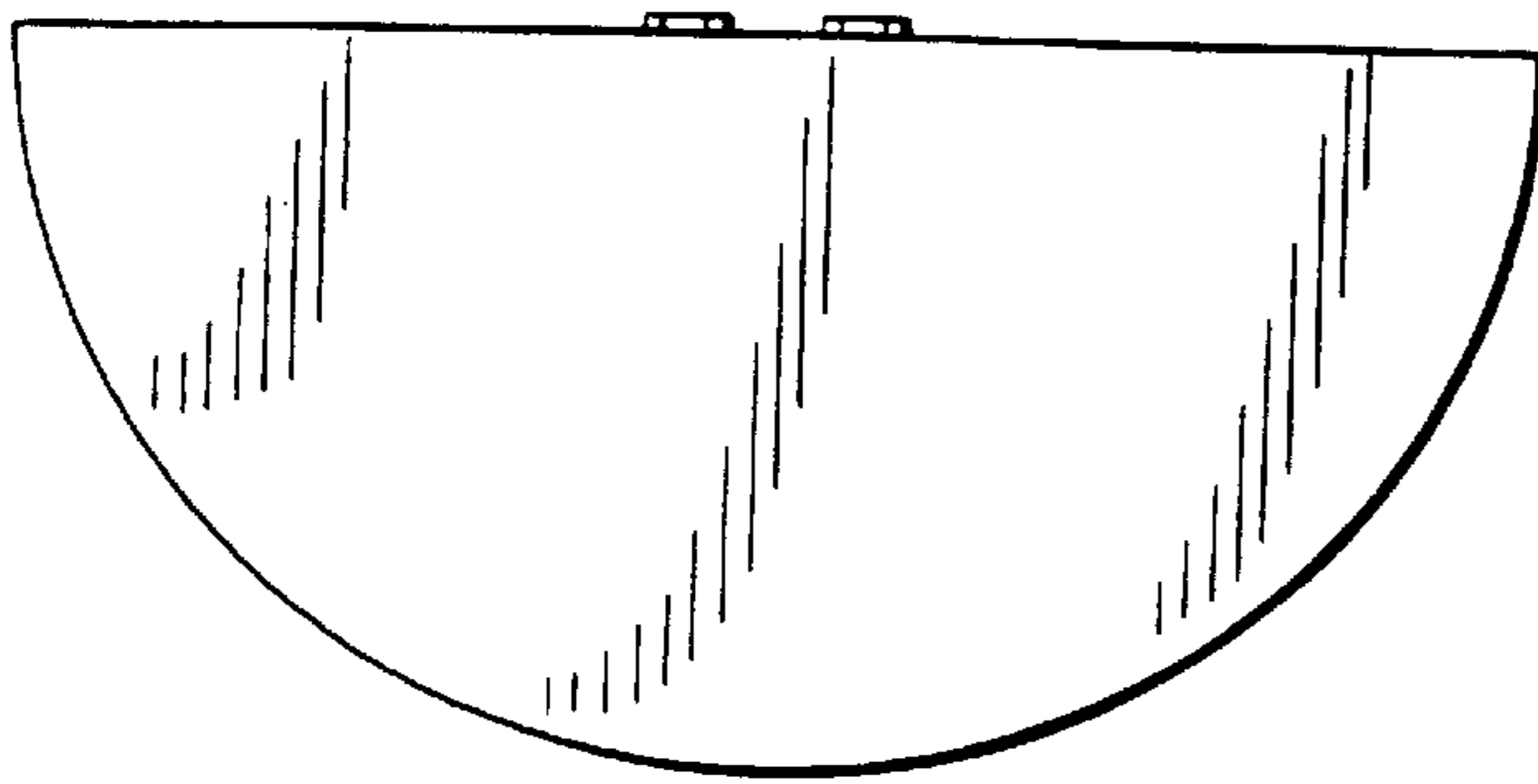




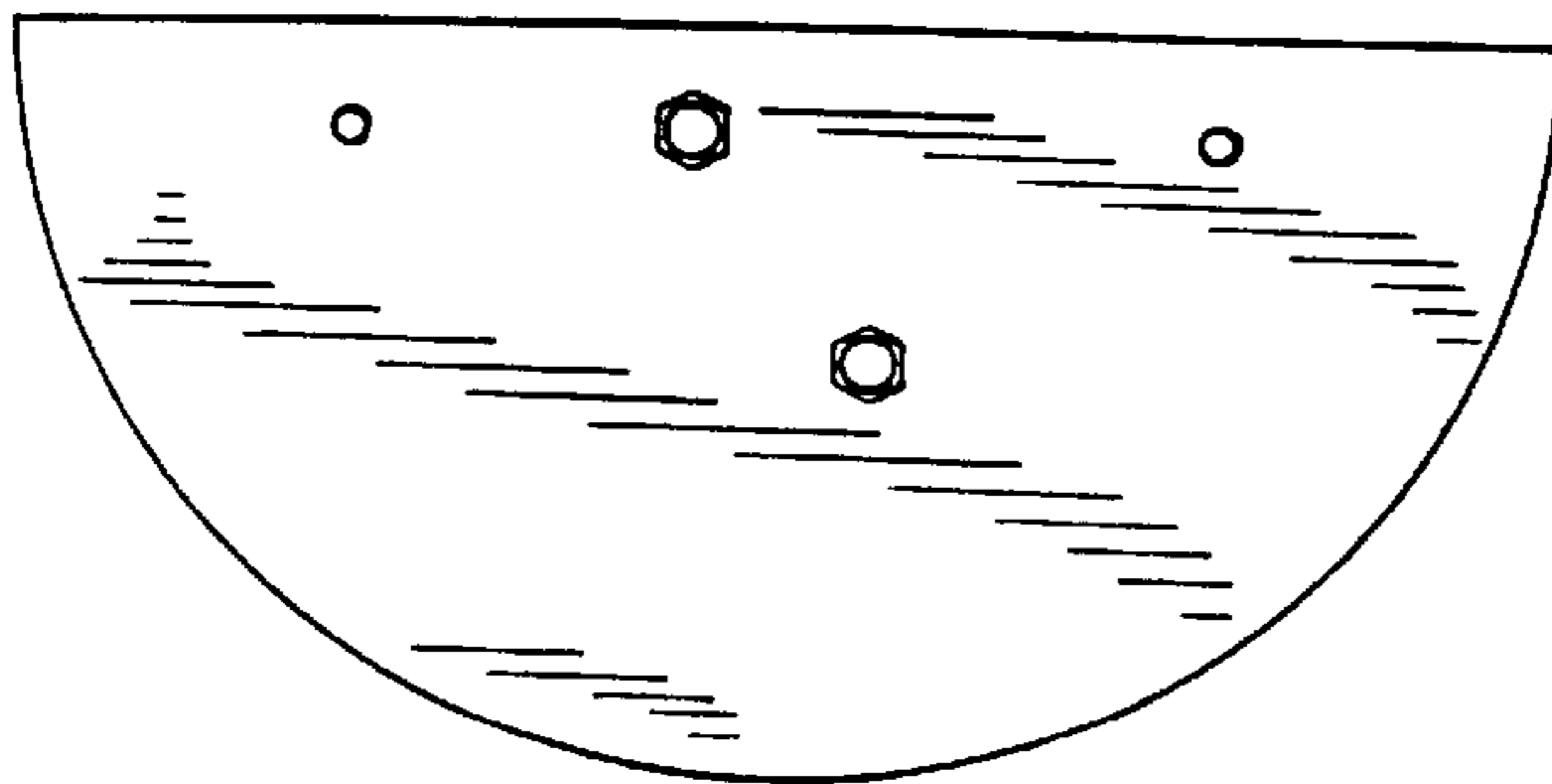
