FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

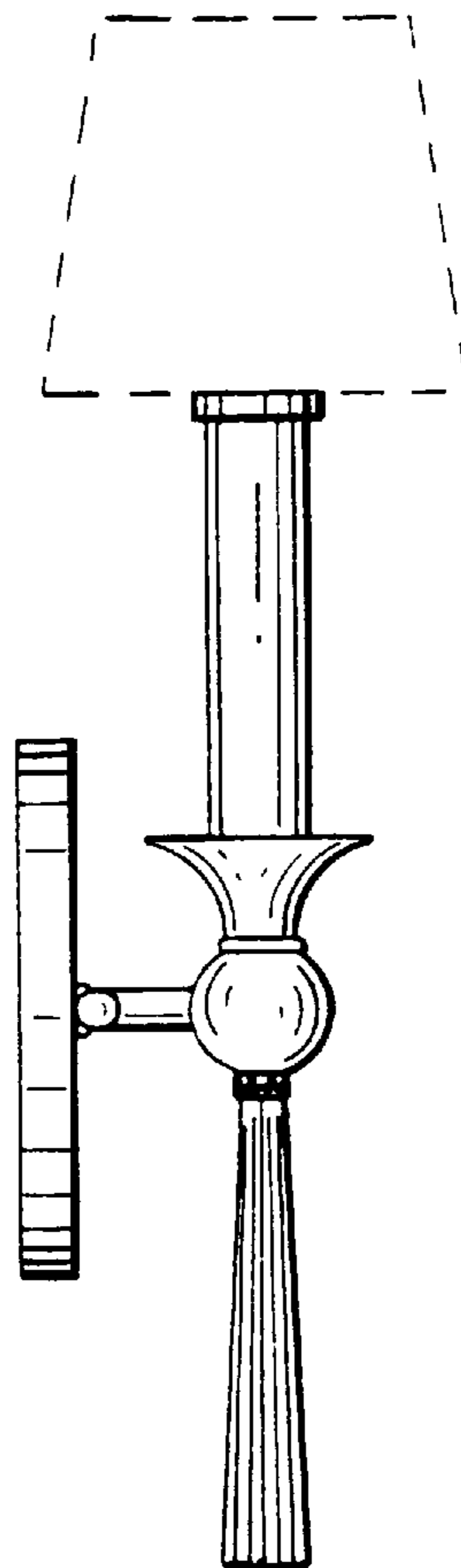
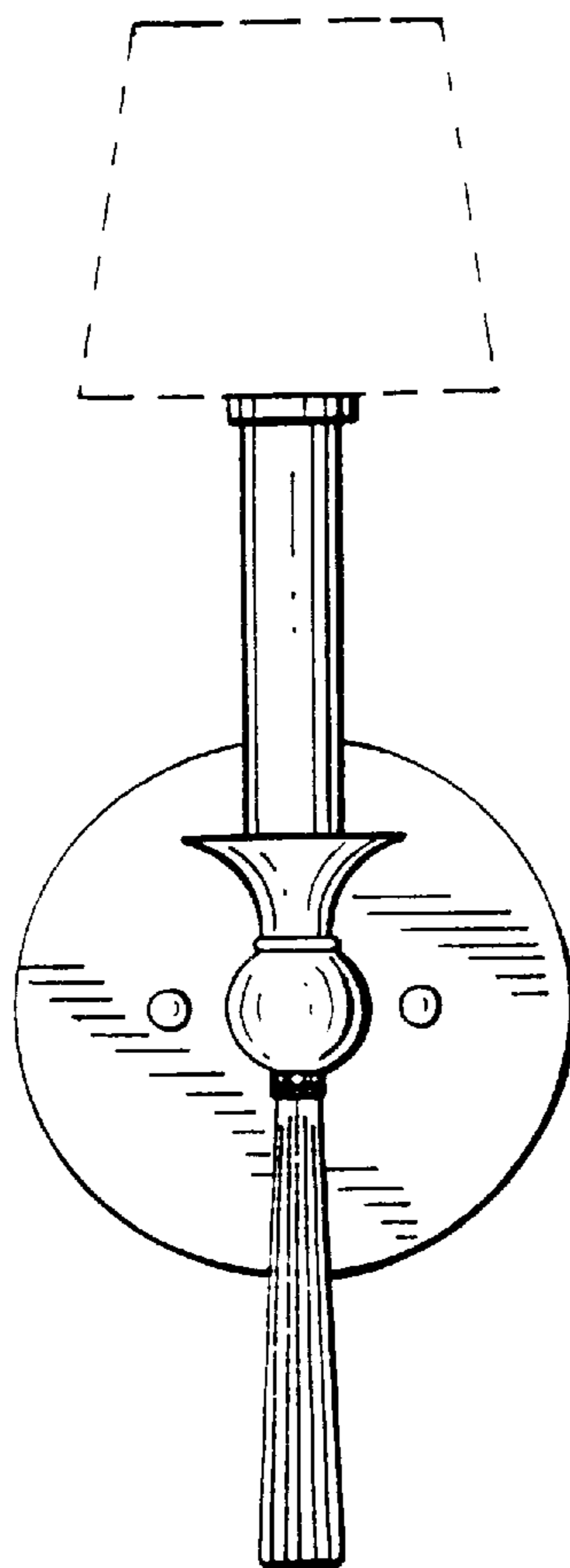
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

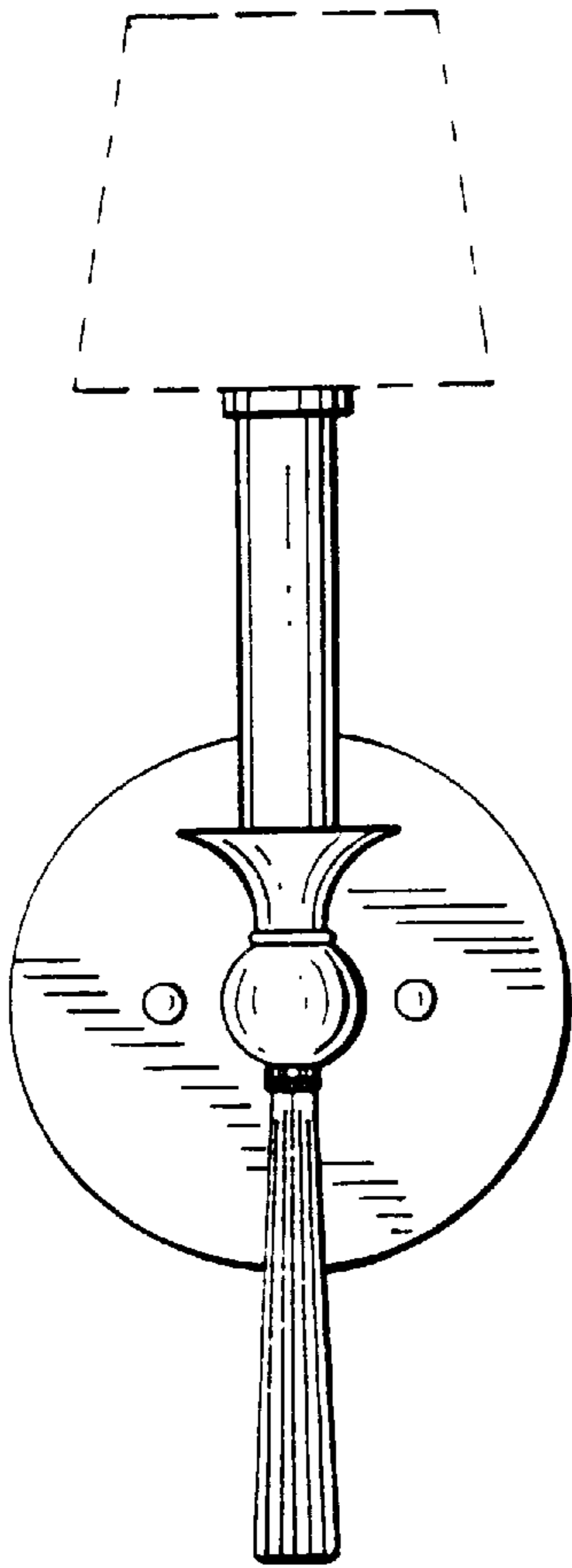

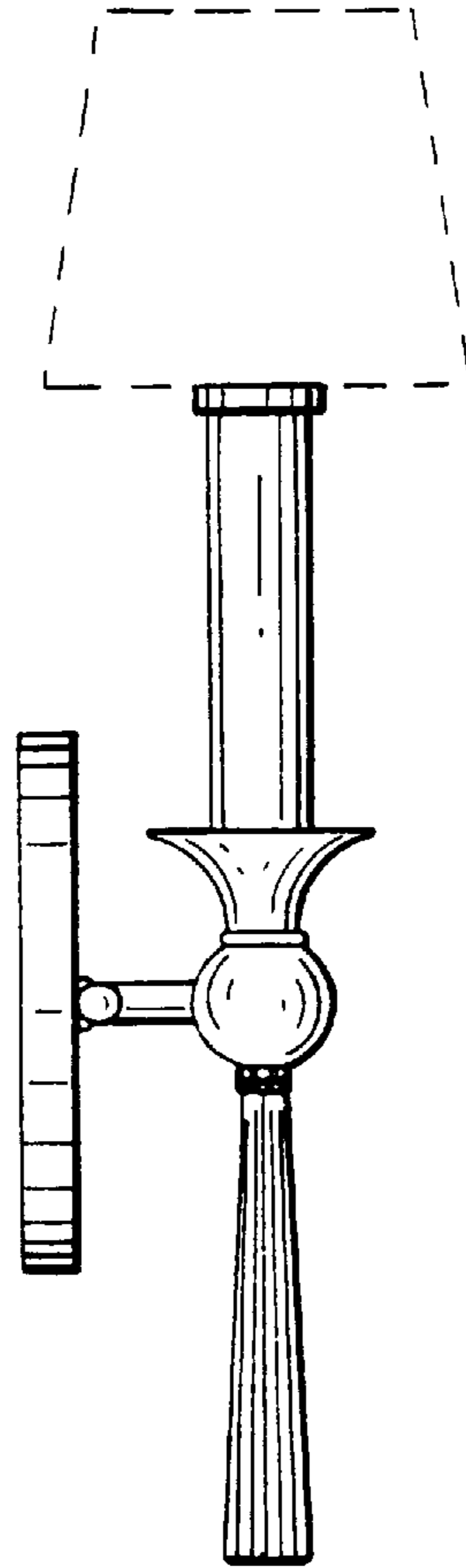

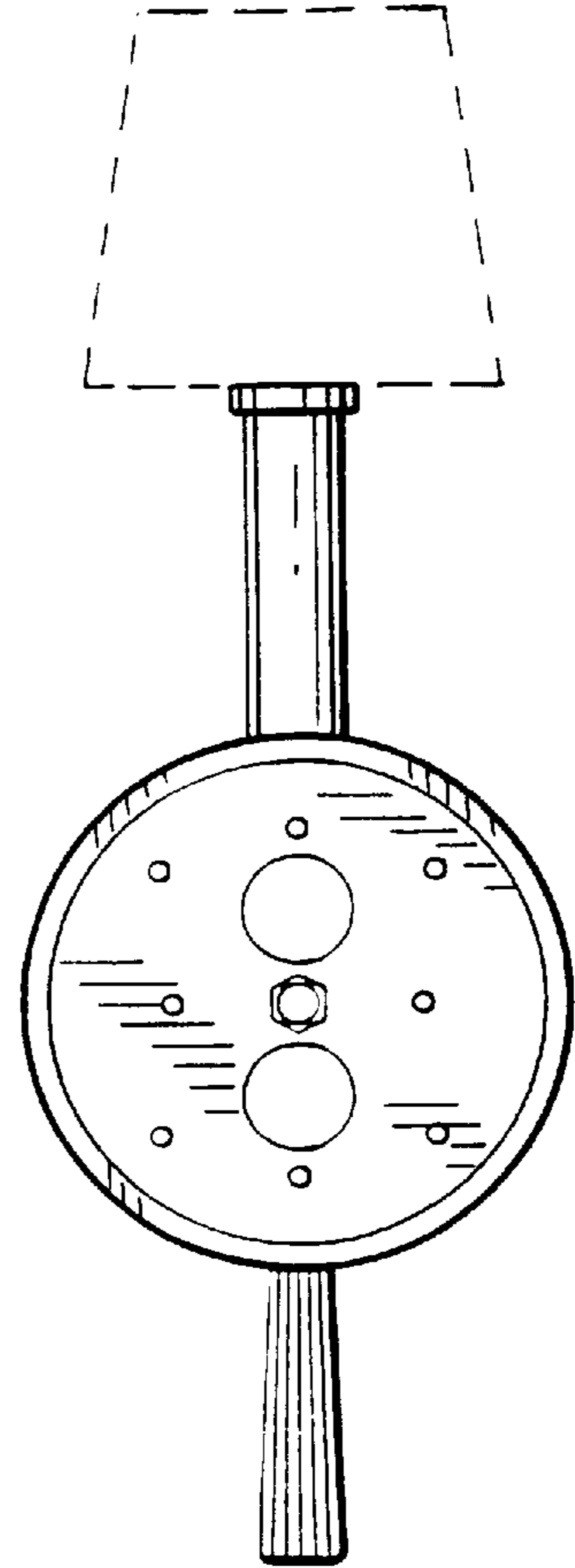

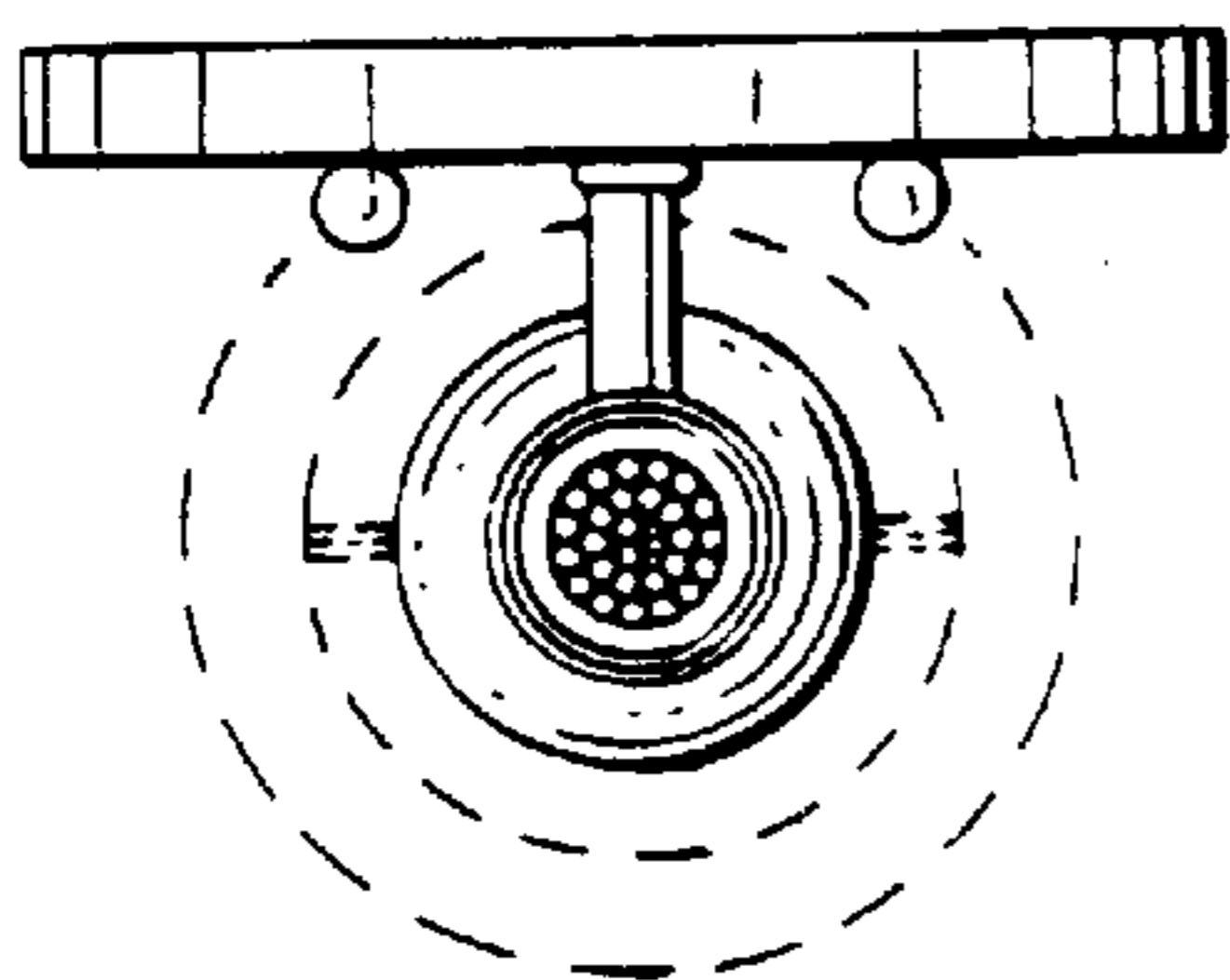

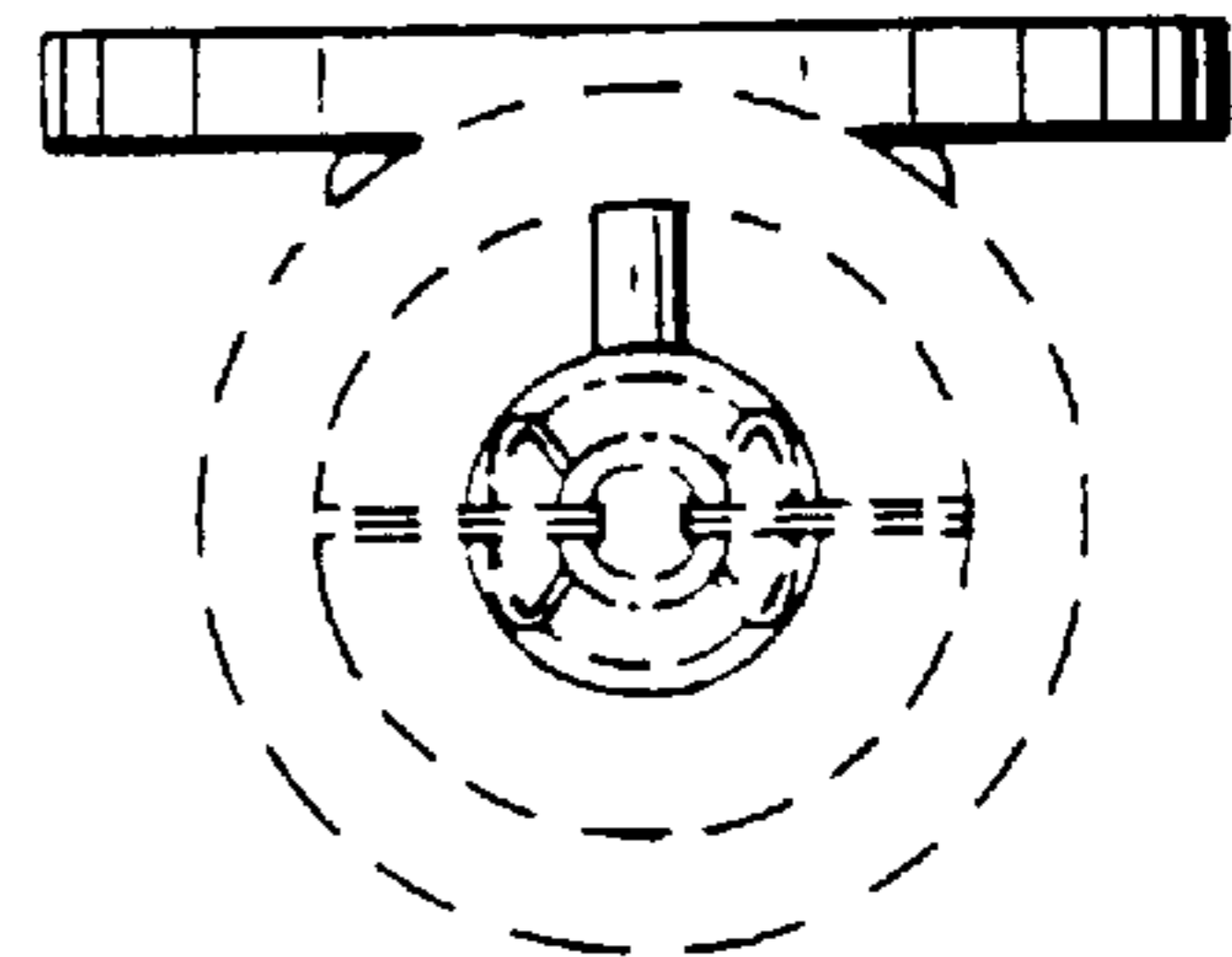
