DESCRIPTION

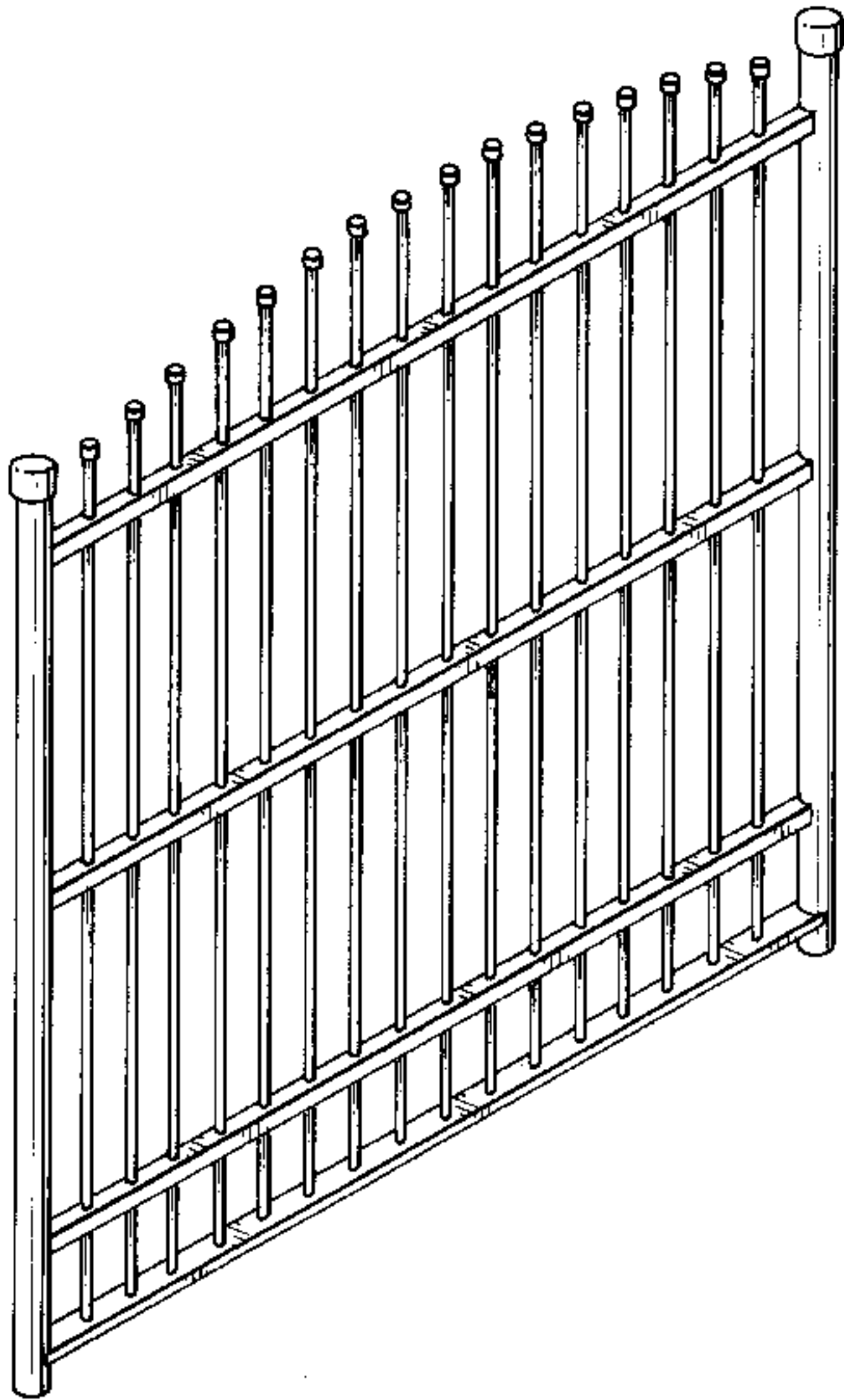

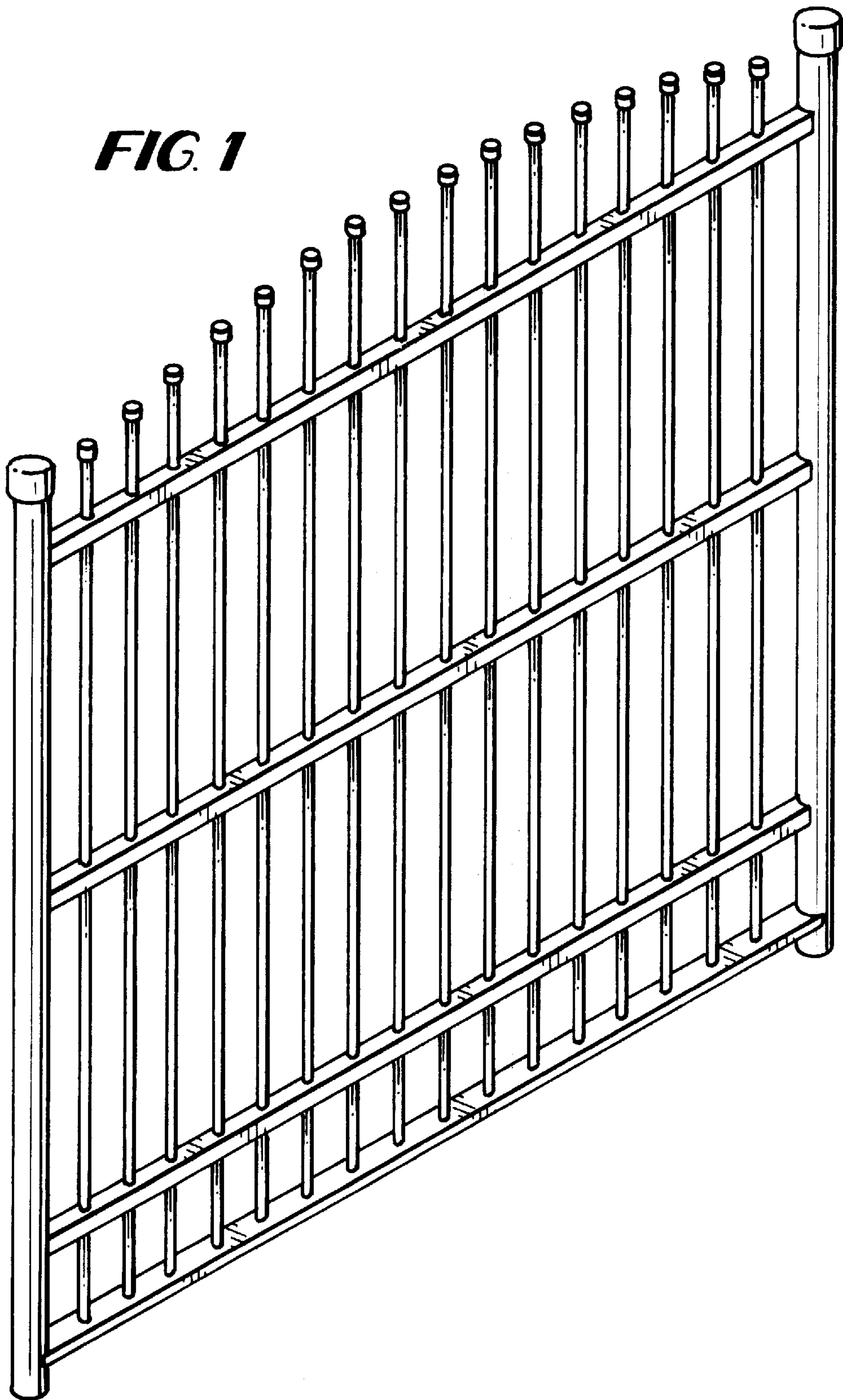

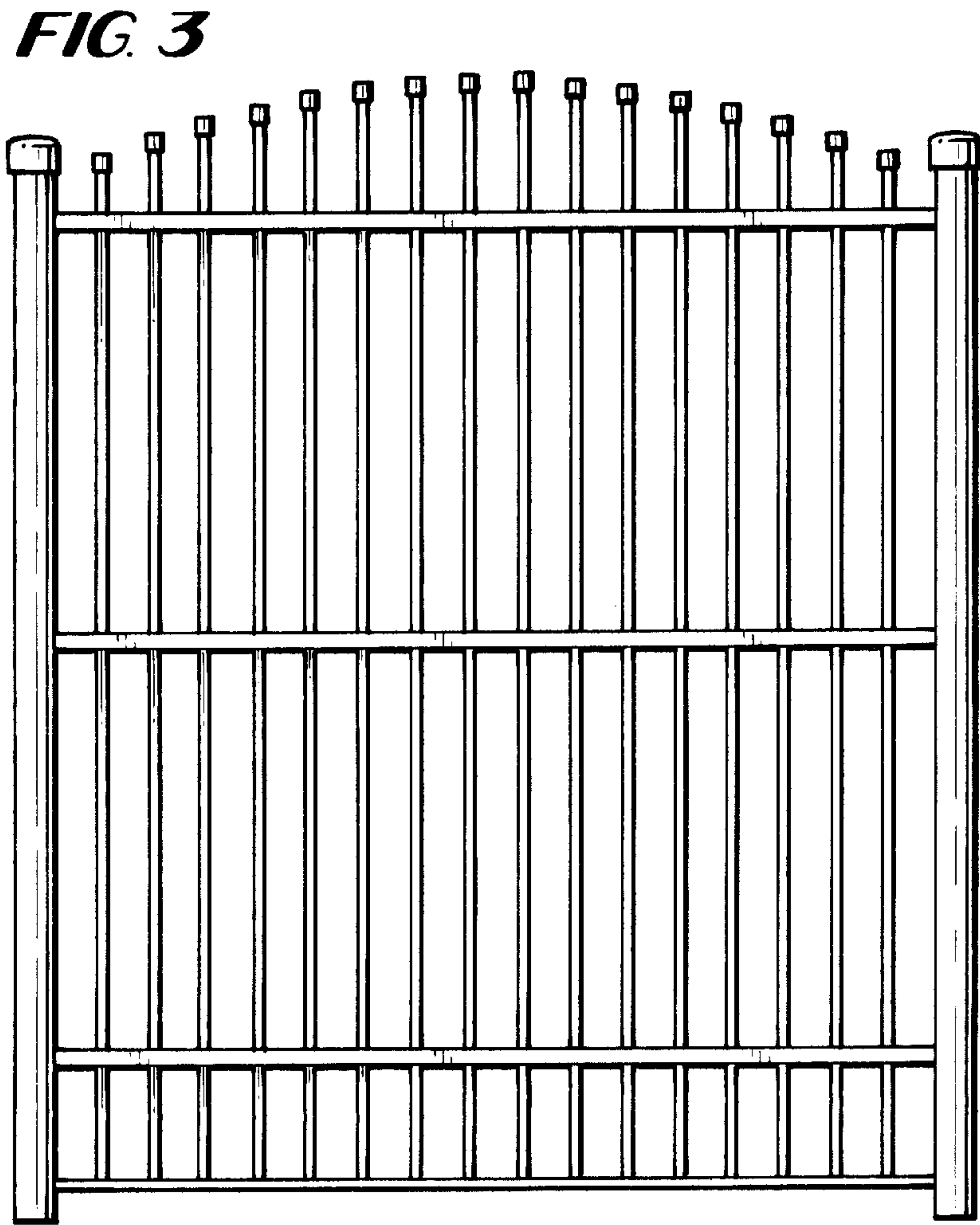

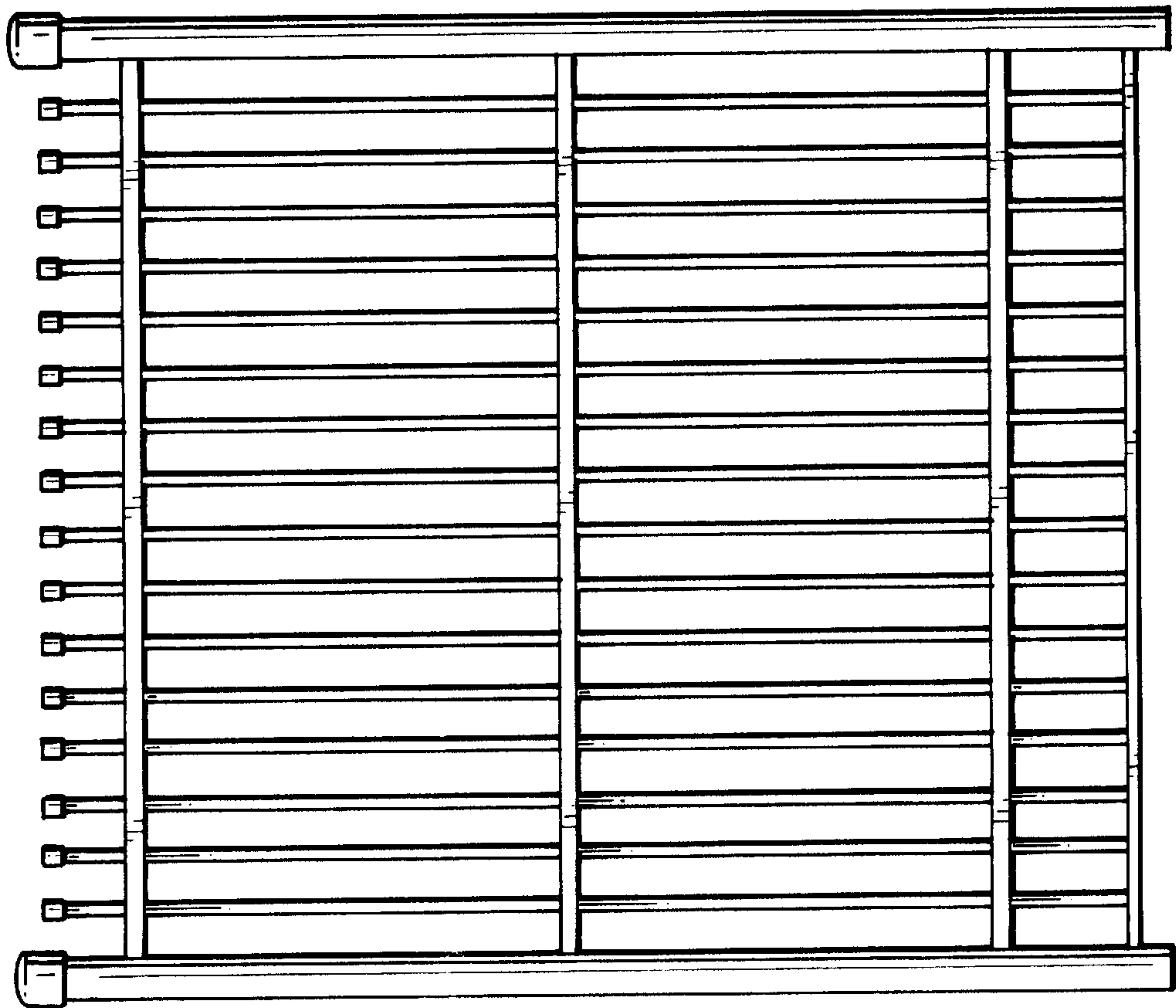

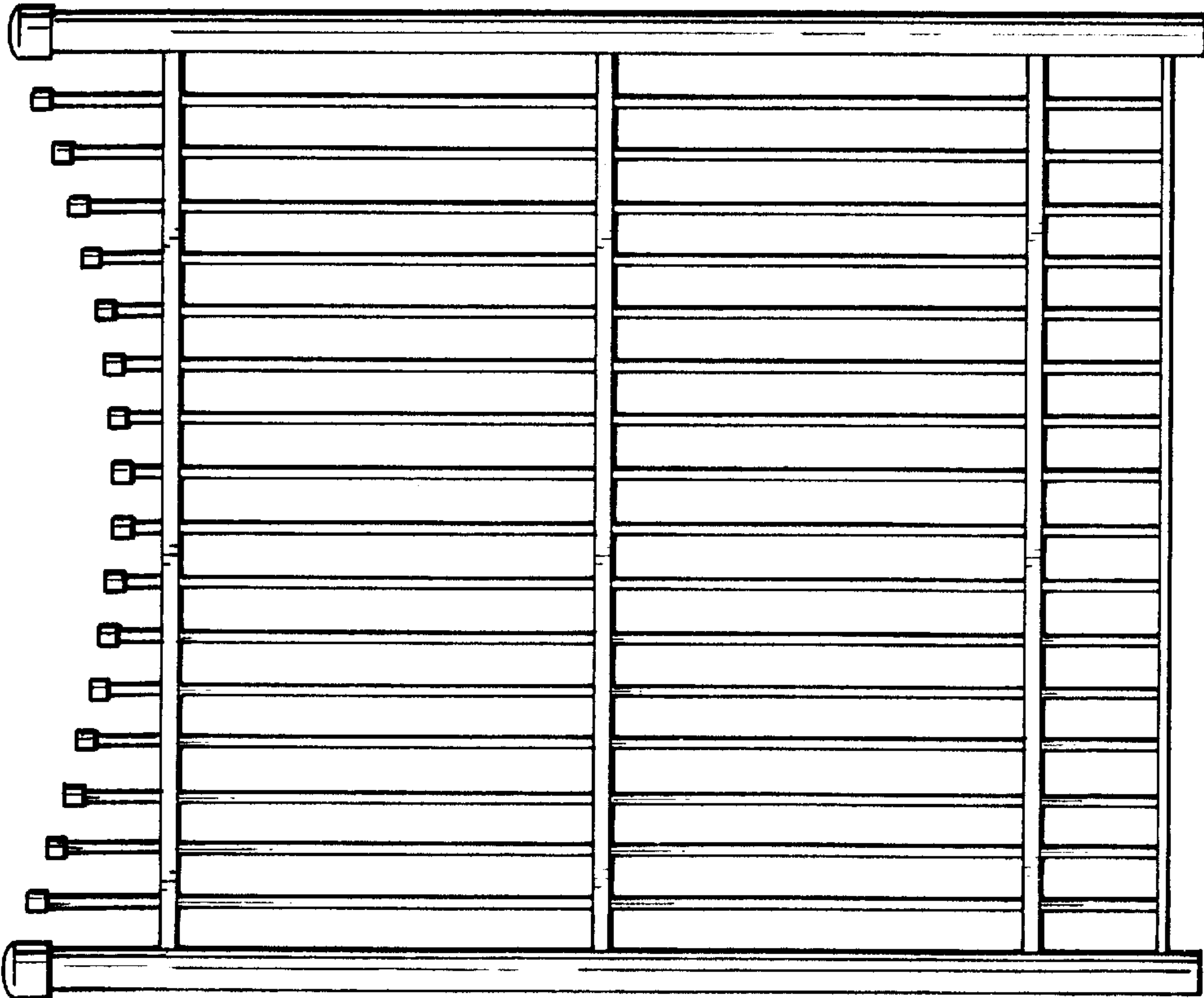

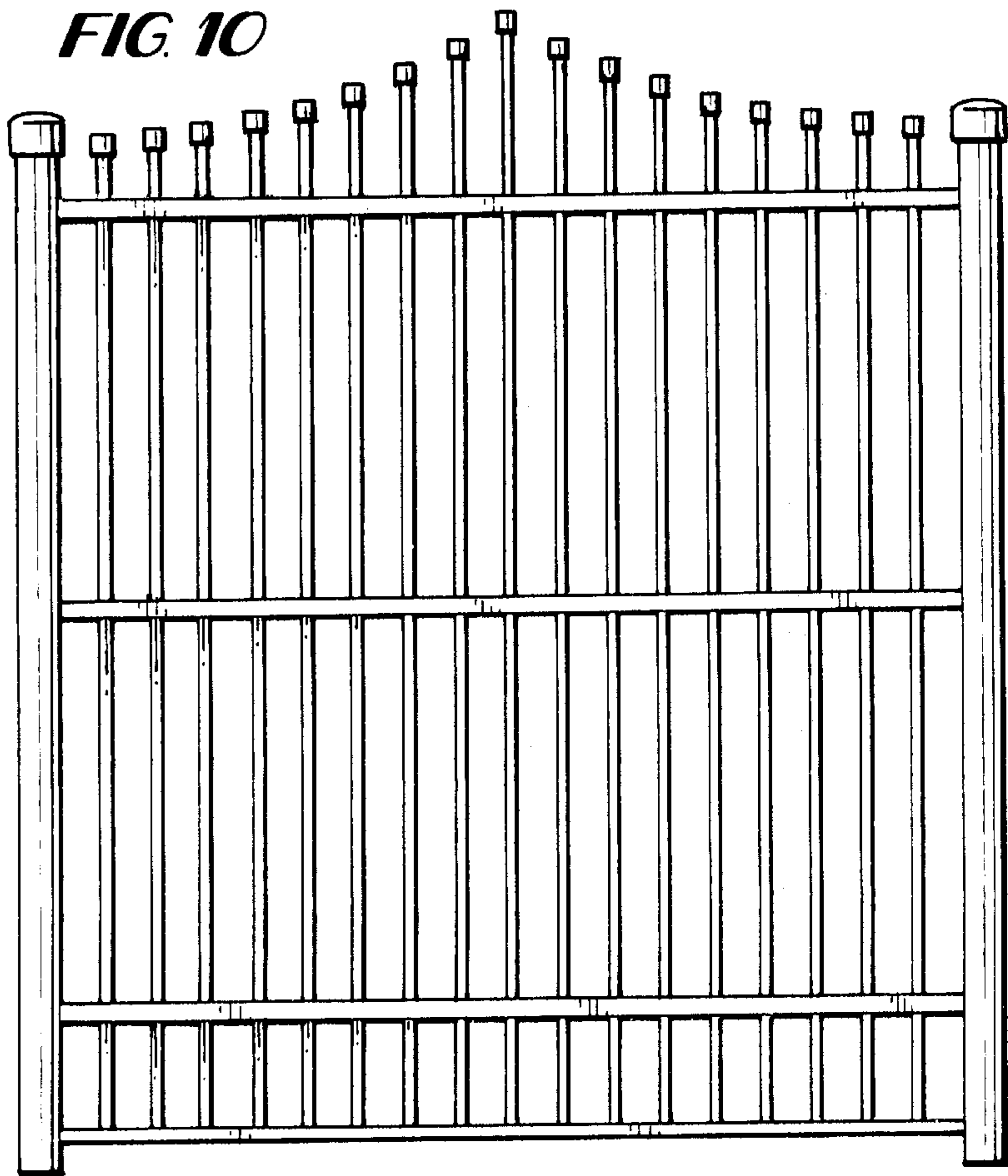

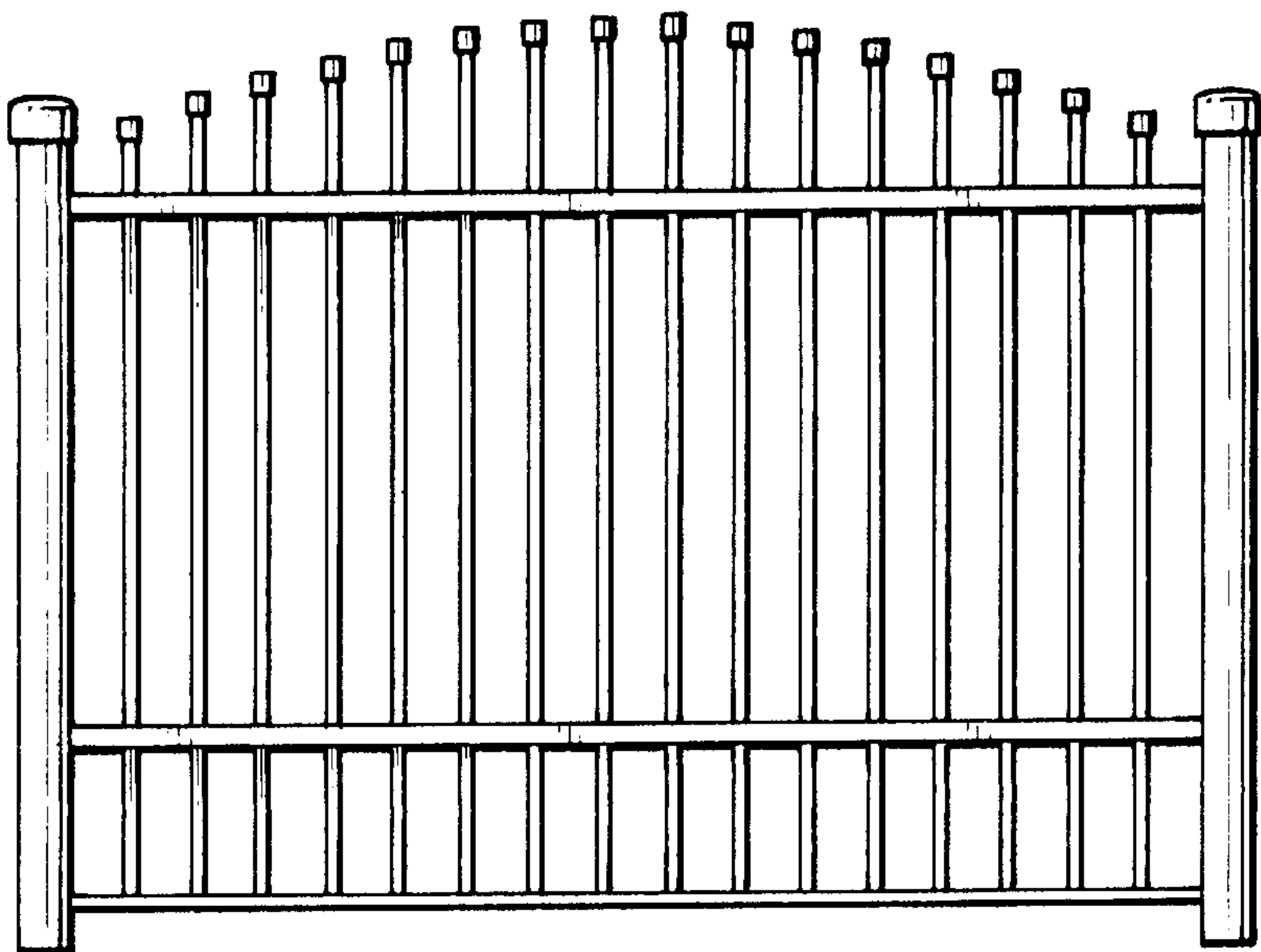

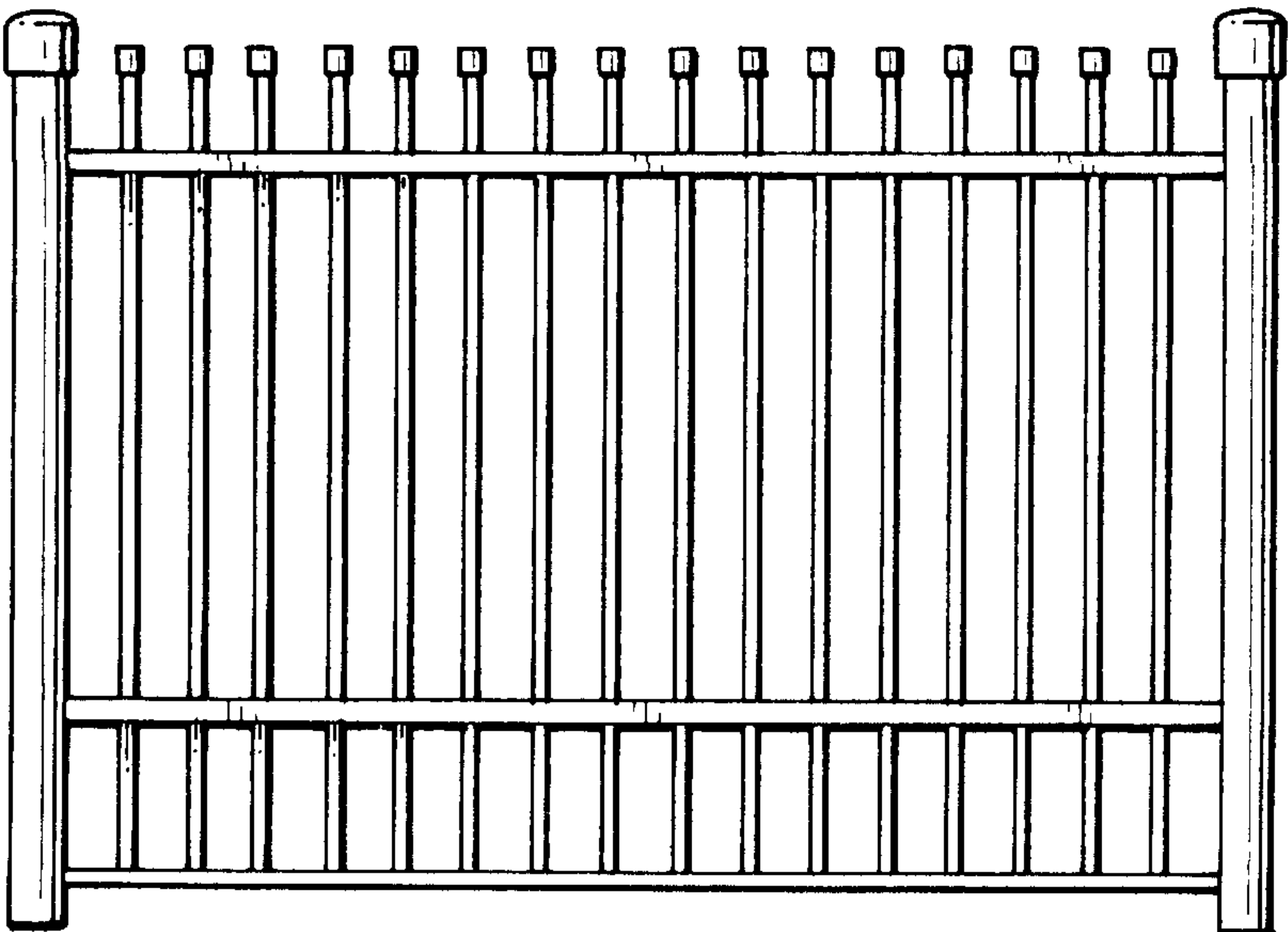

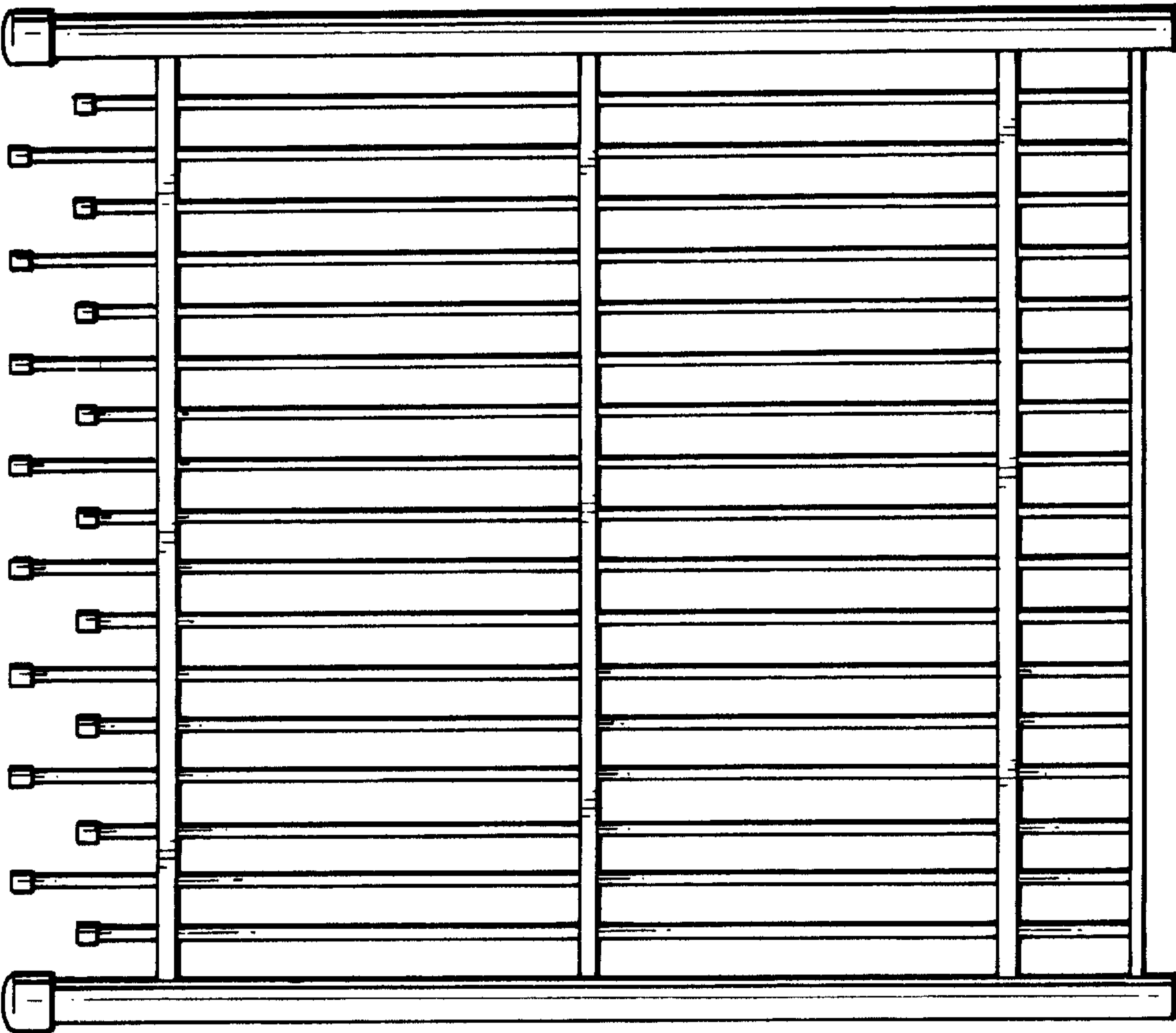

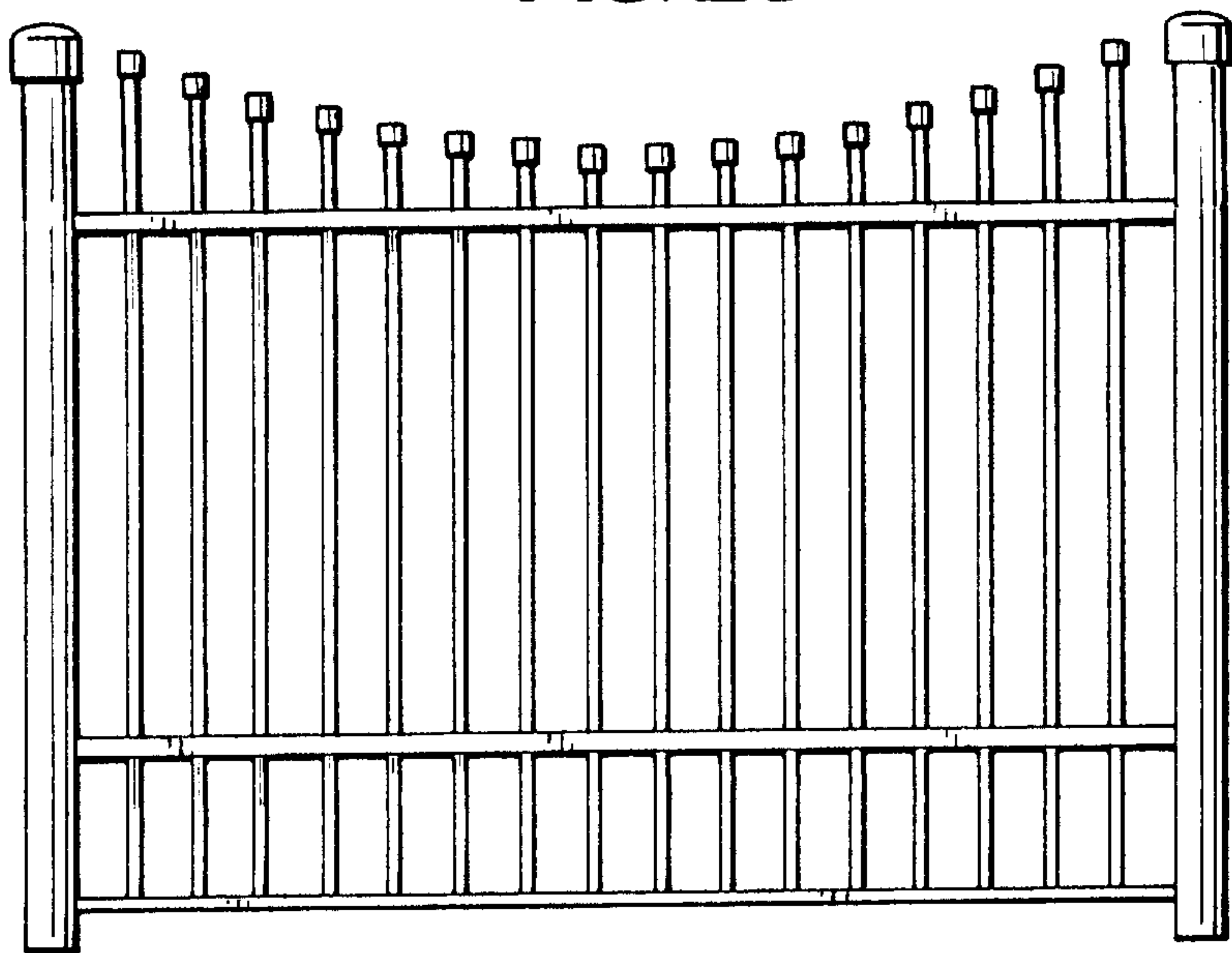

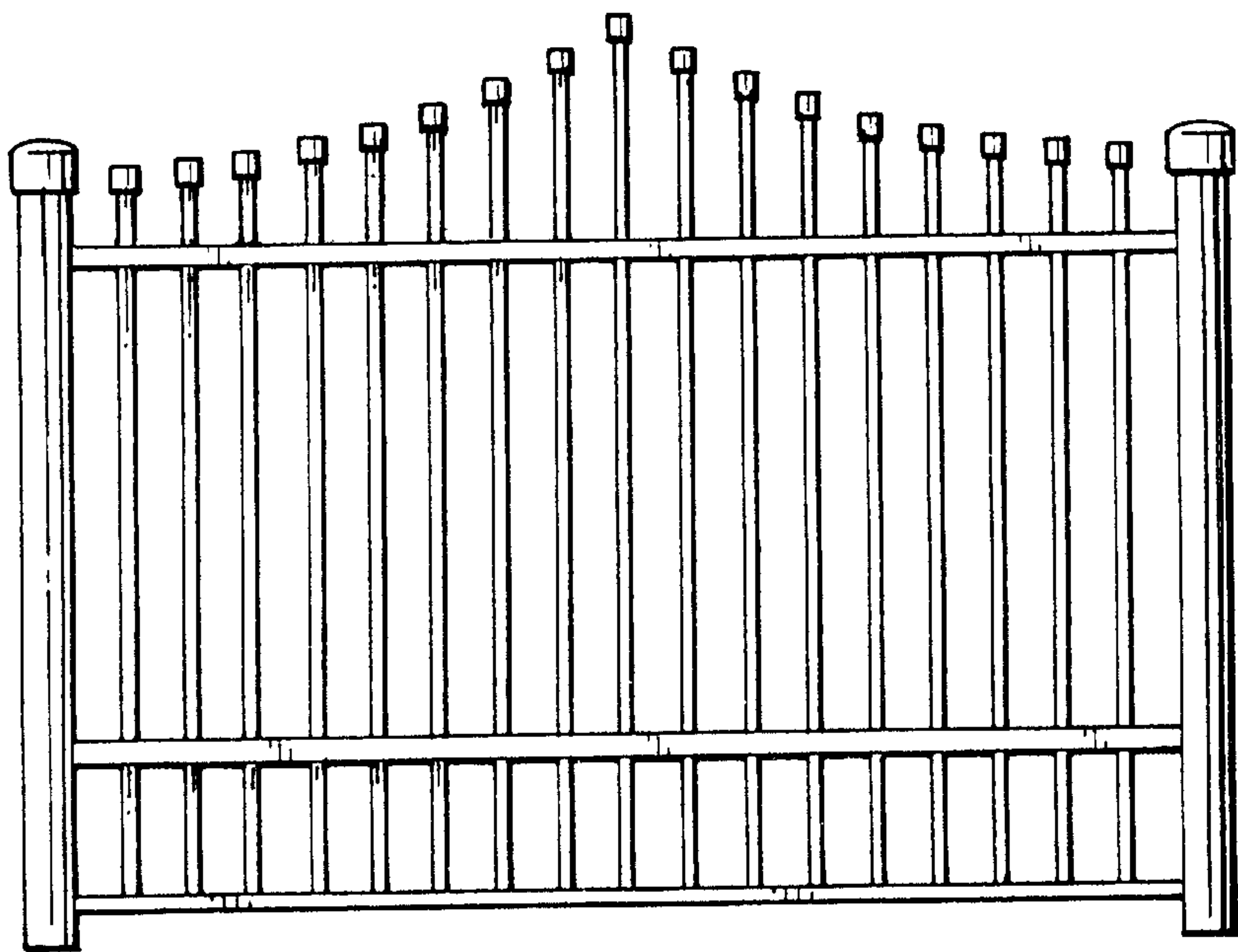

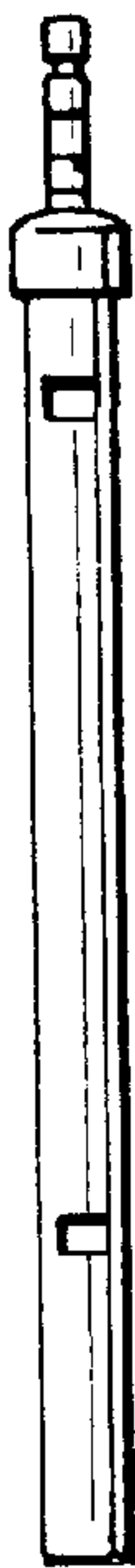

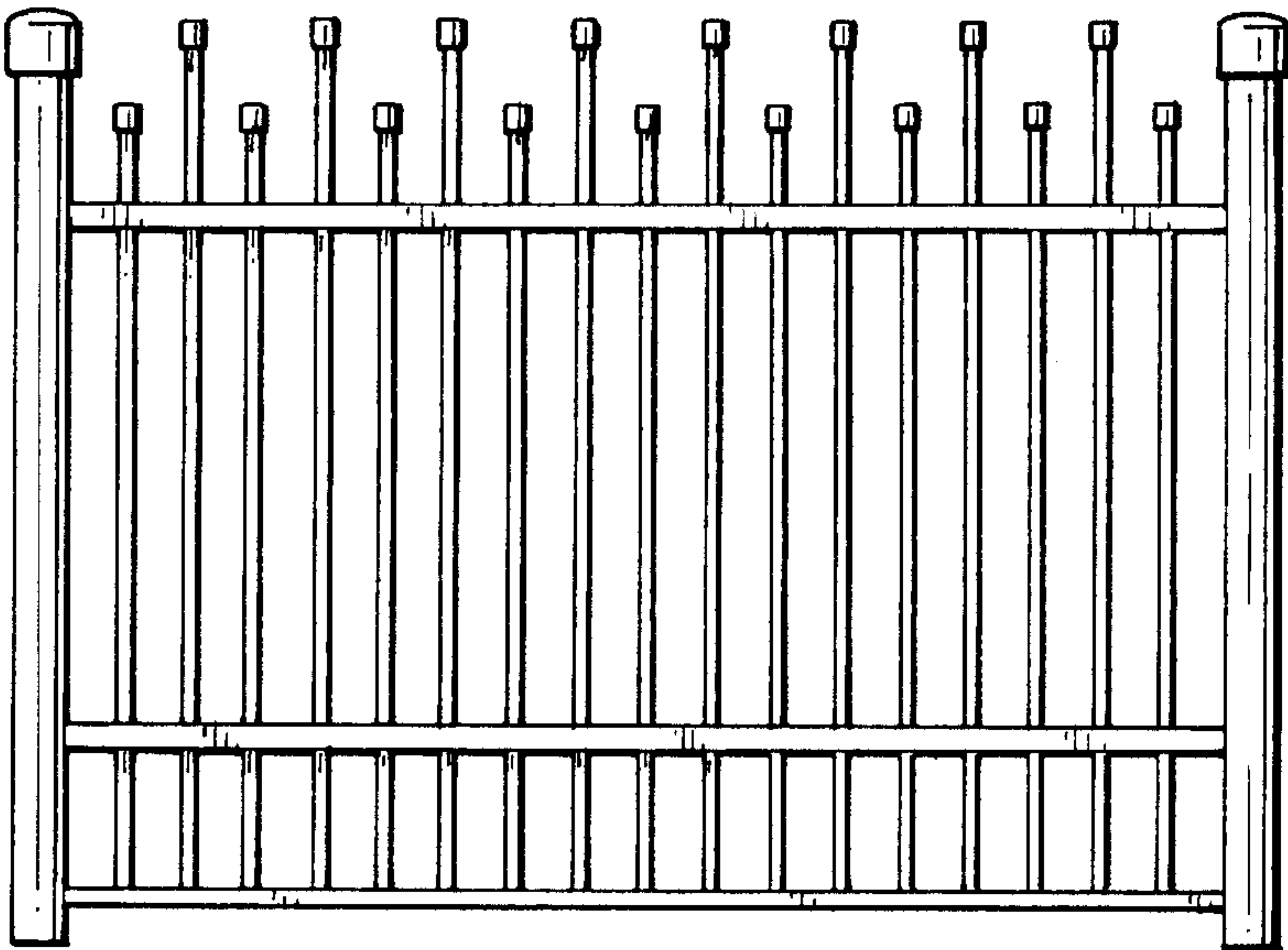
