The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the seat member is understood to represent fabric and would be continuous throughout the implied areas.

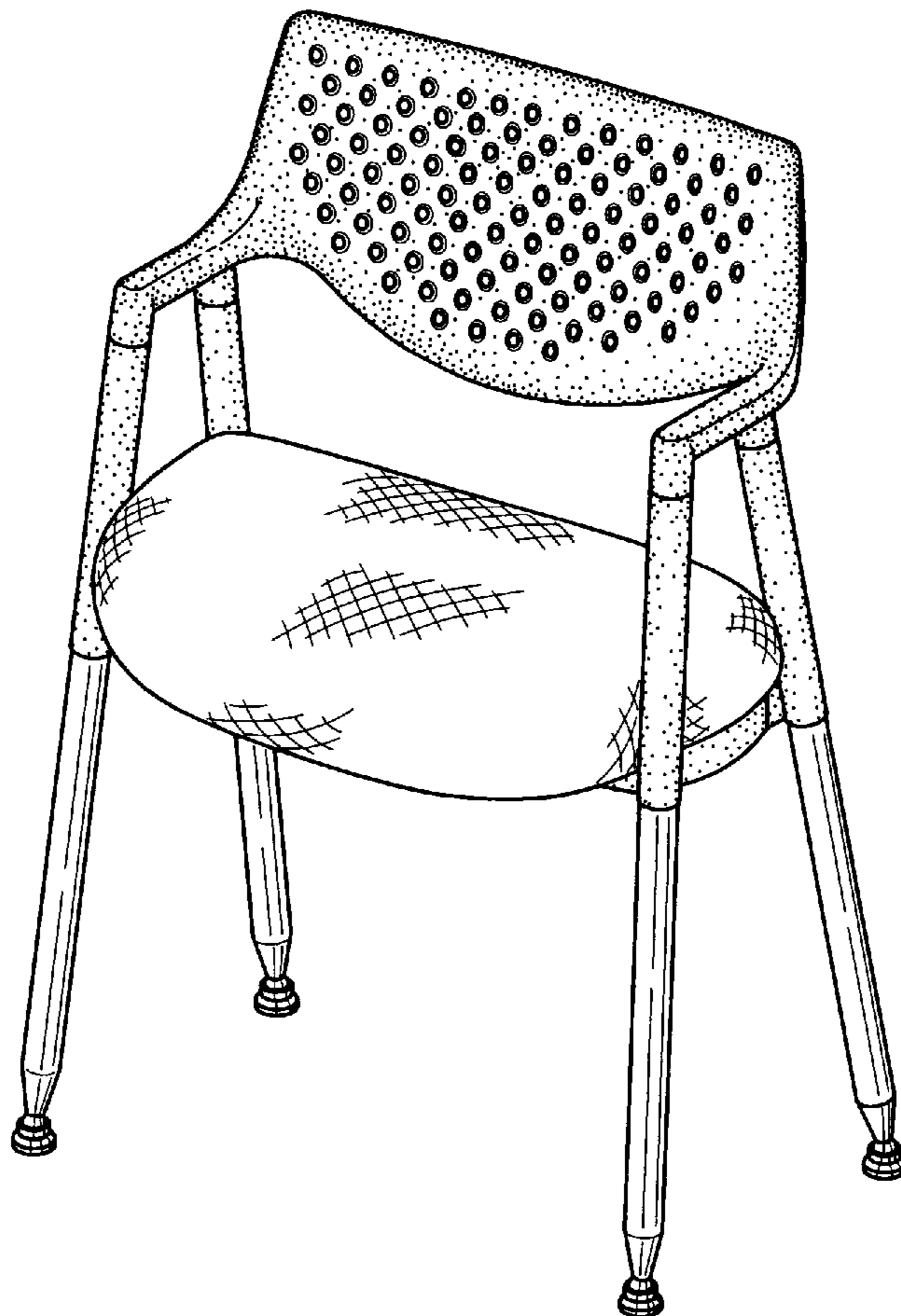

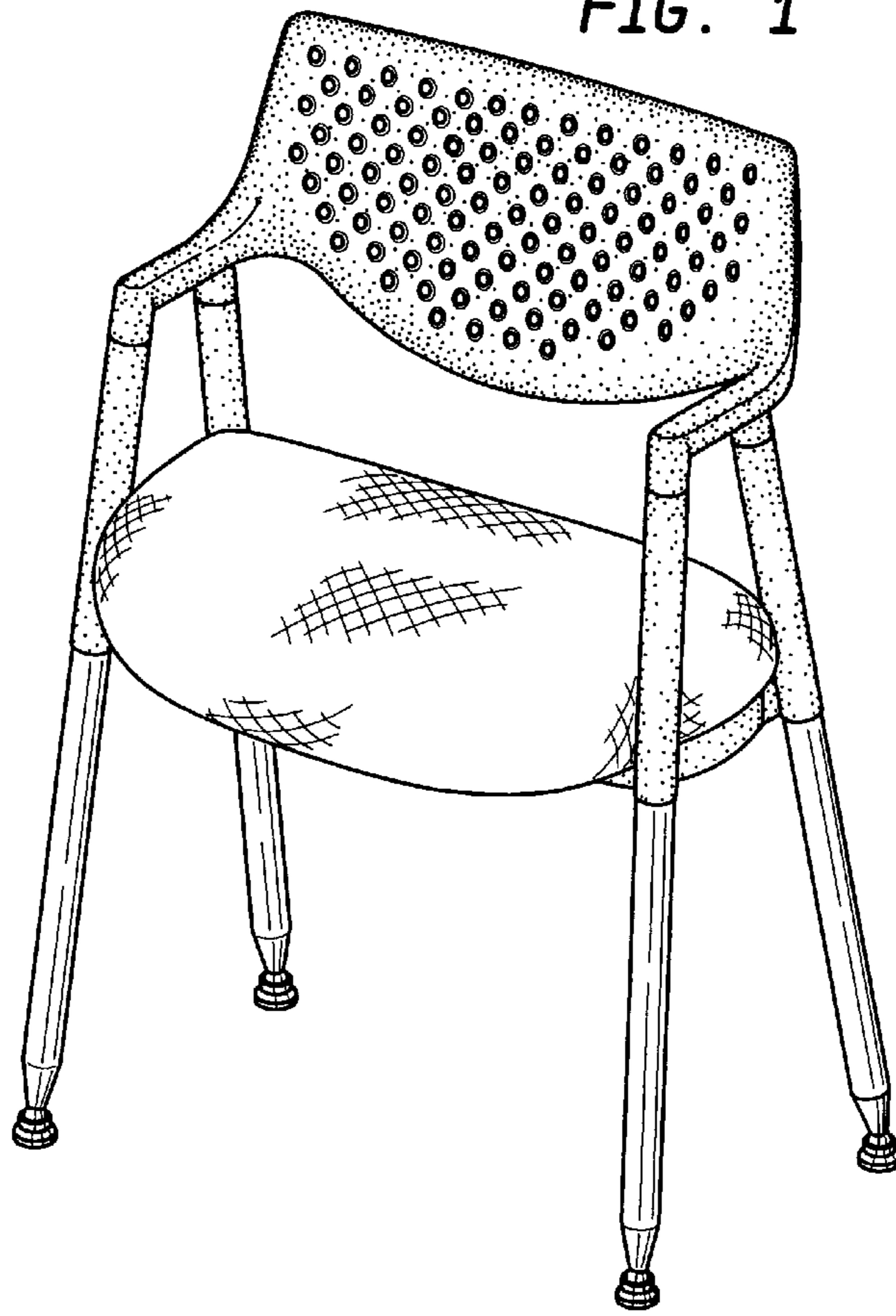

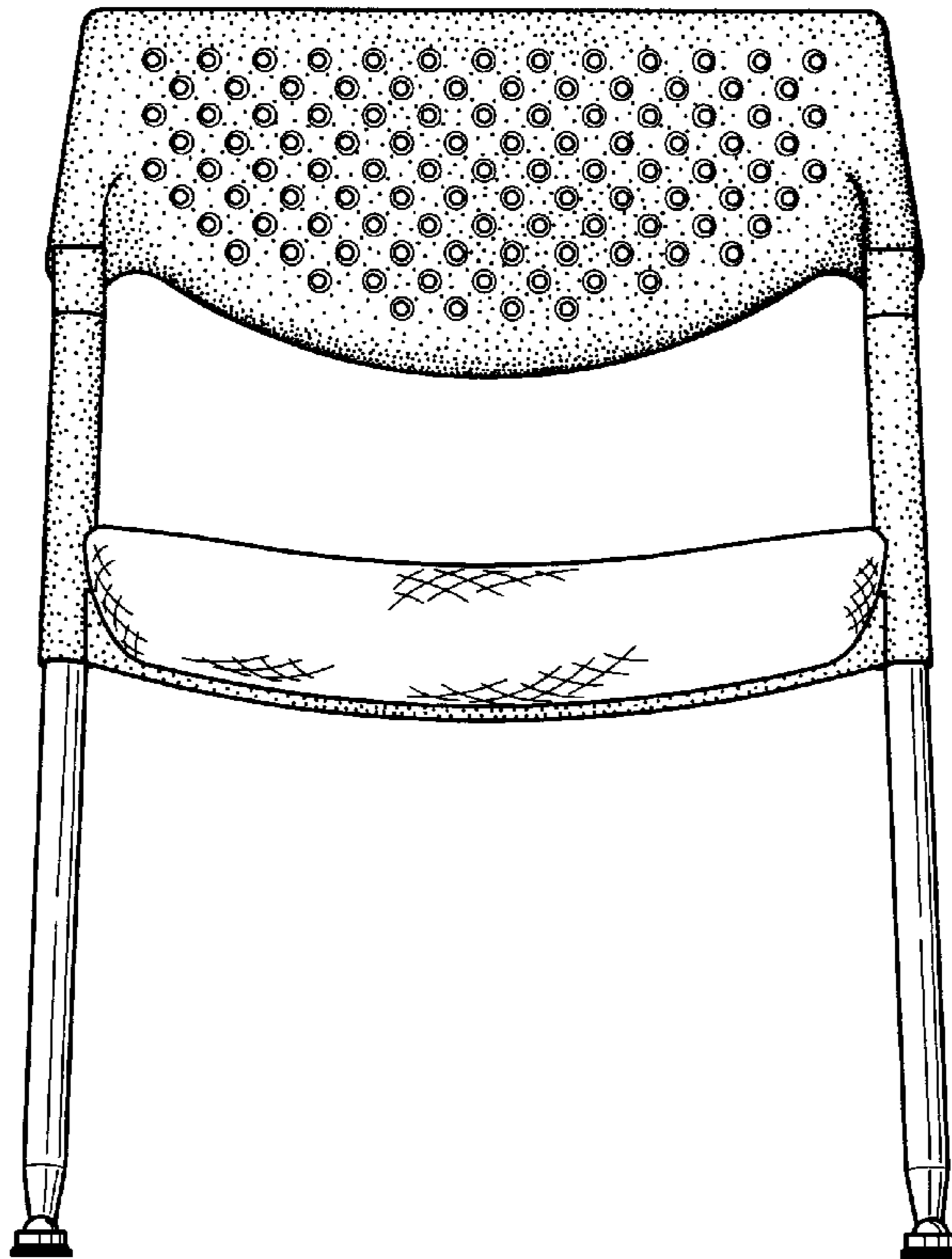

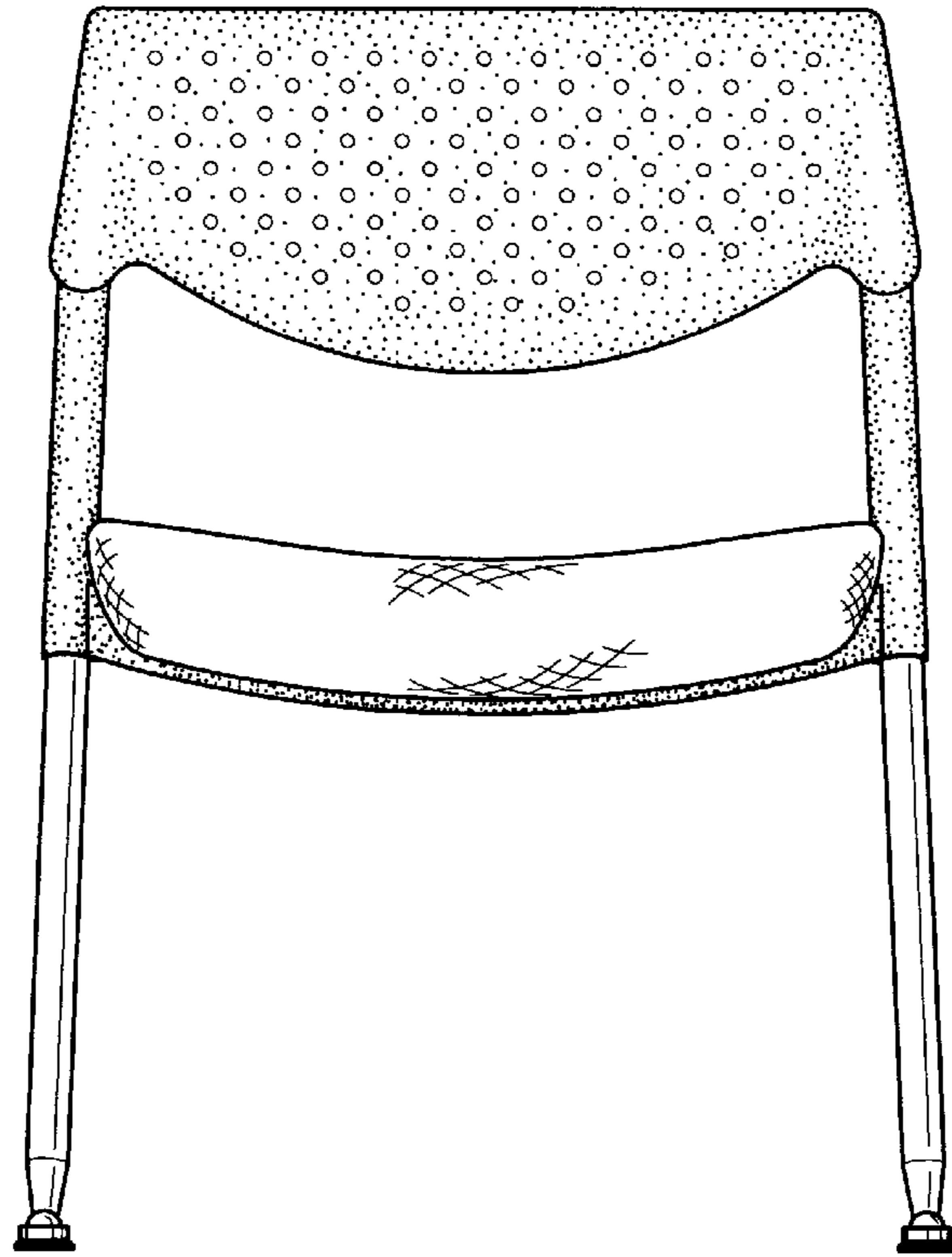

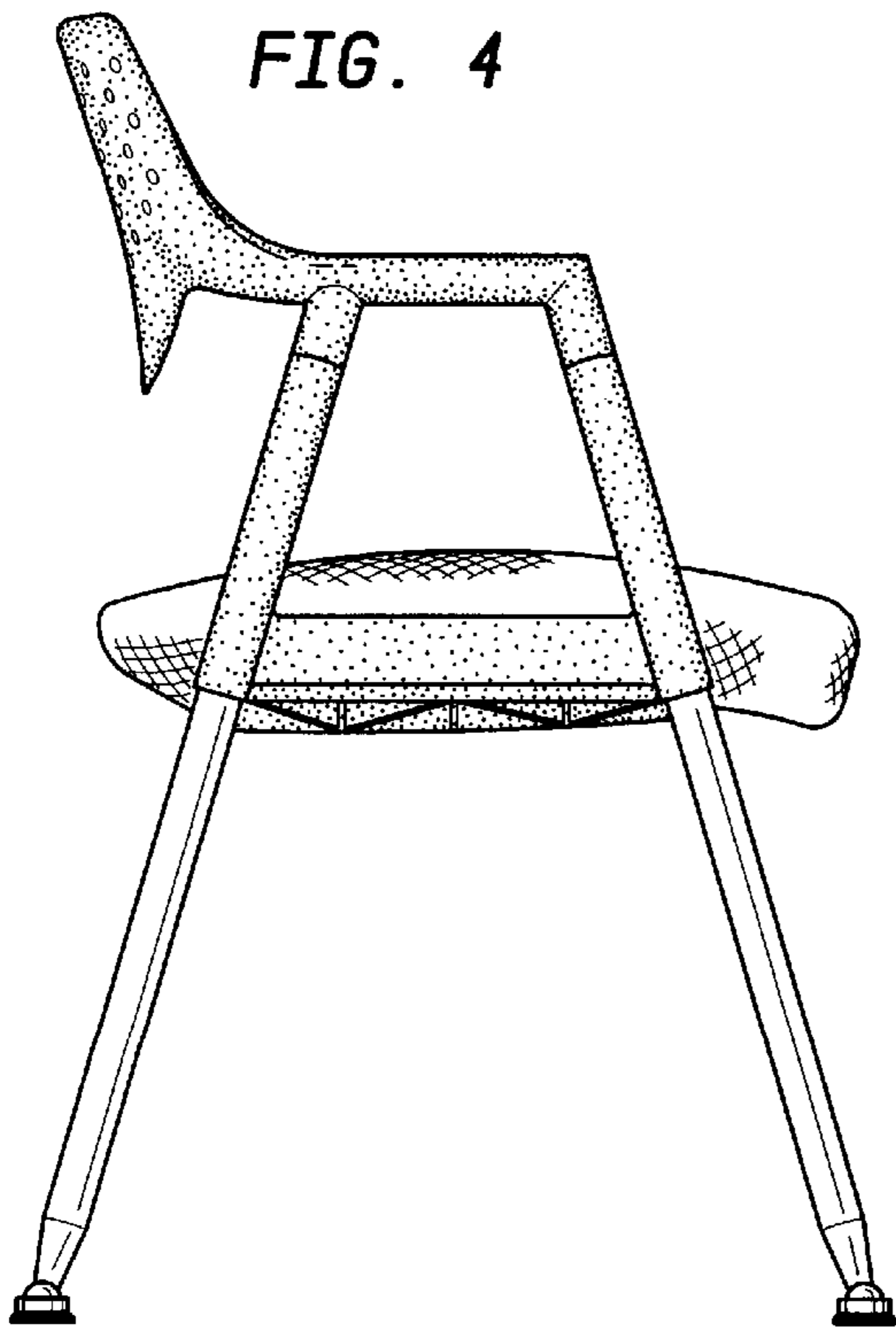

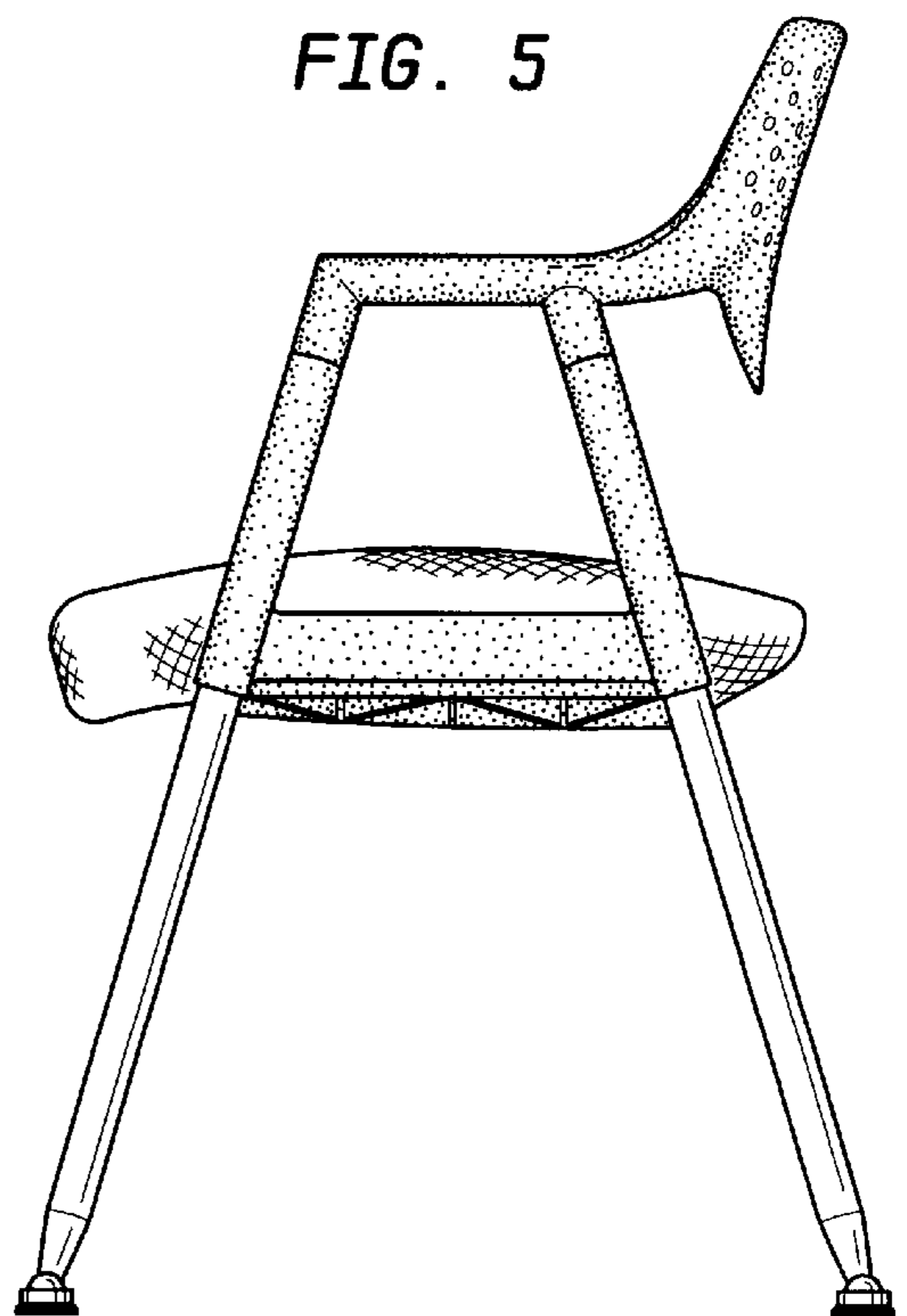

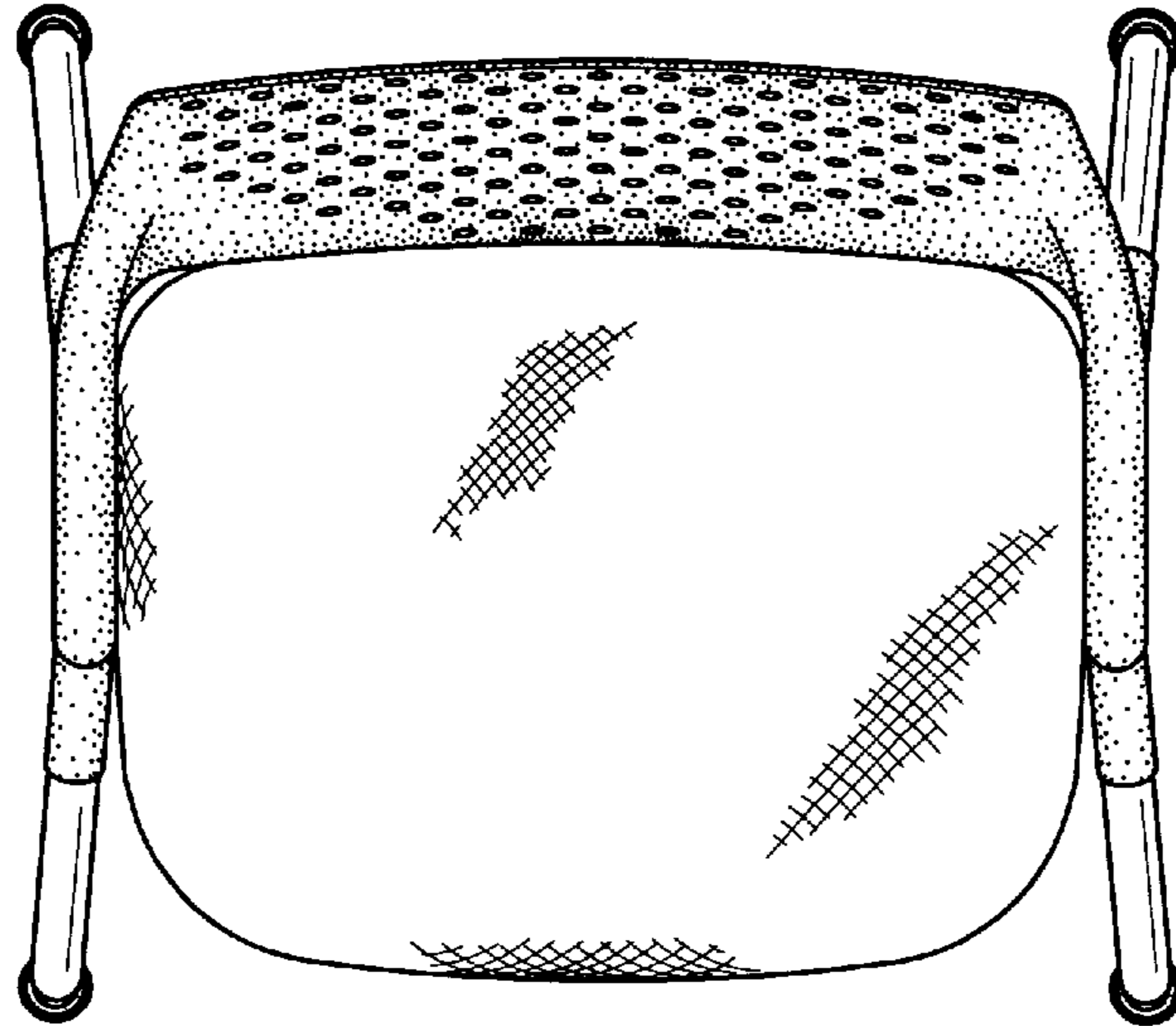
