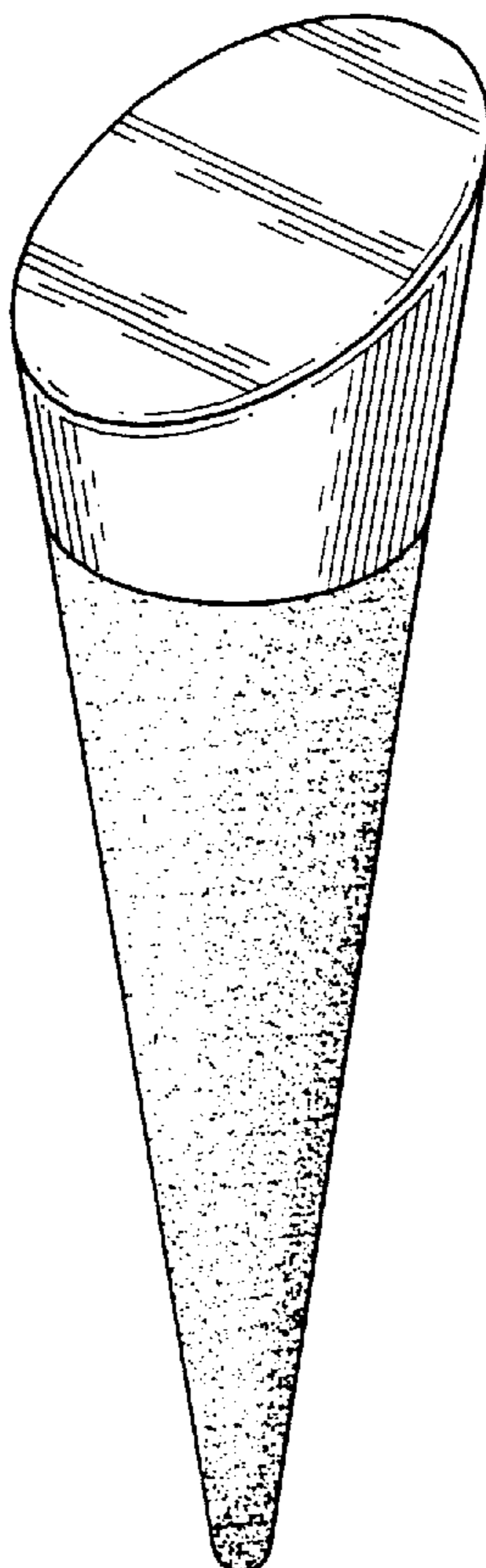
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wine bottle stopper of the present invention;

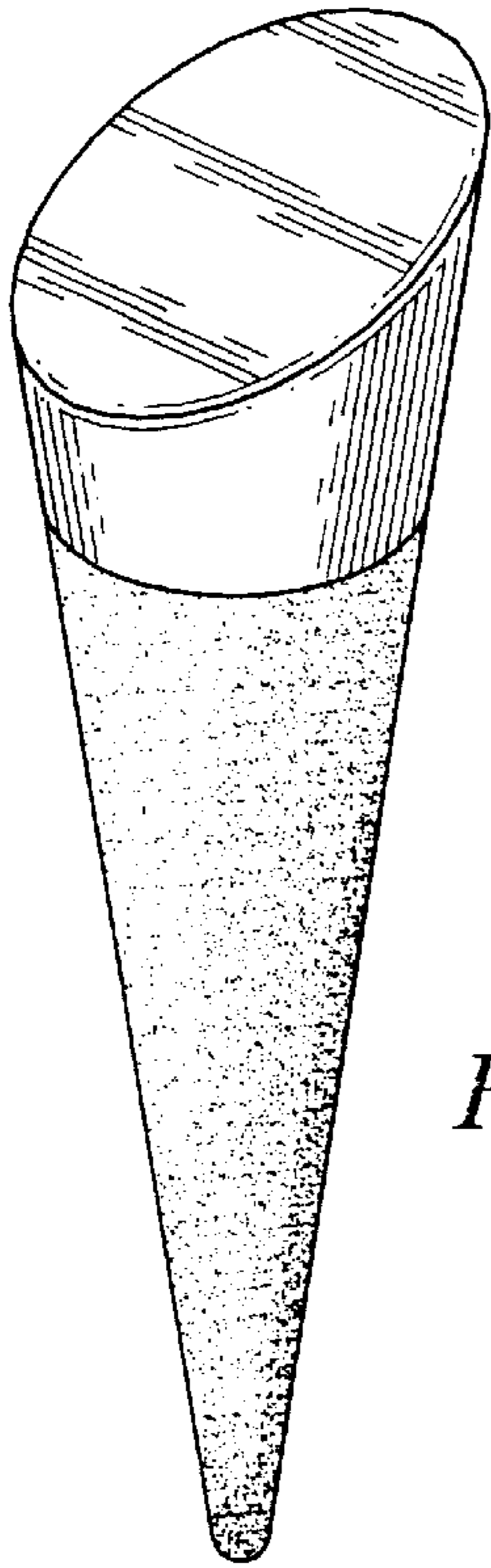

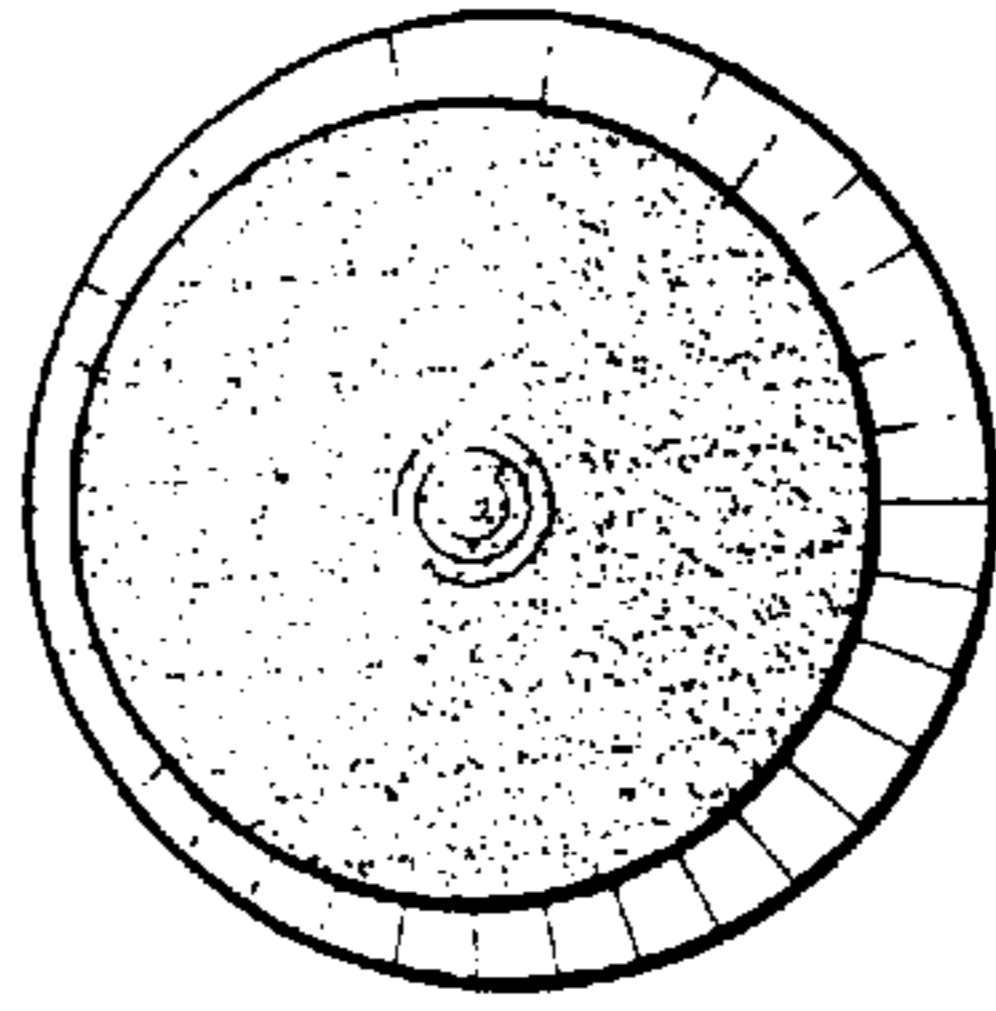

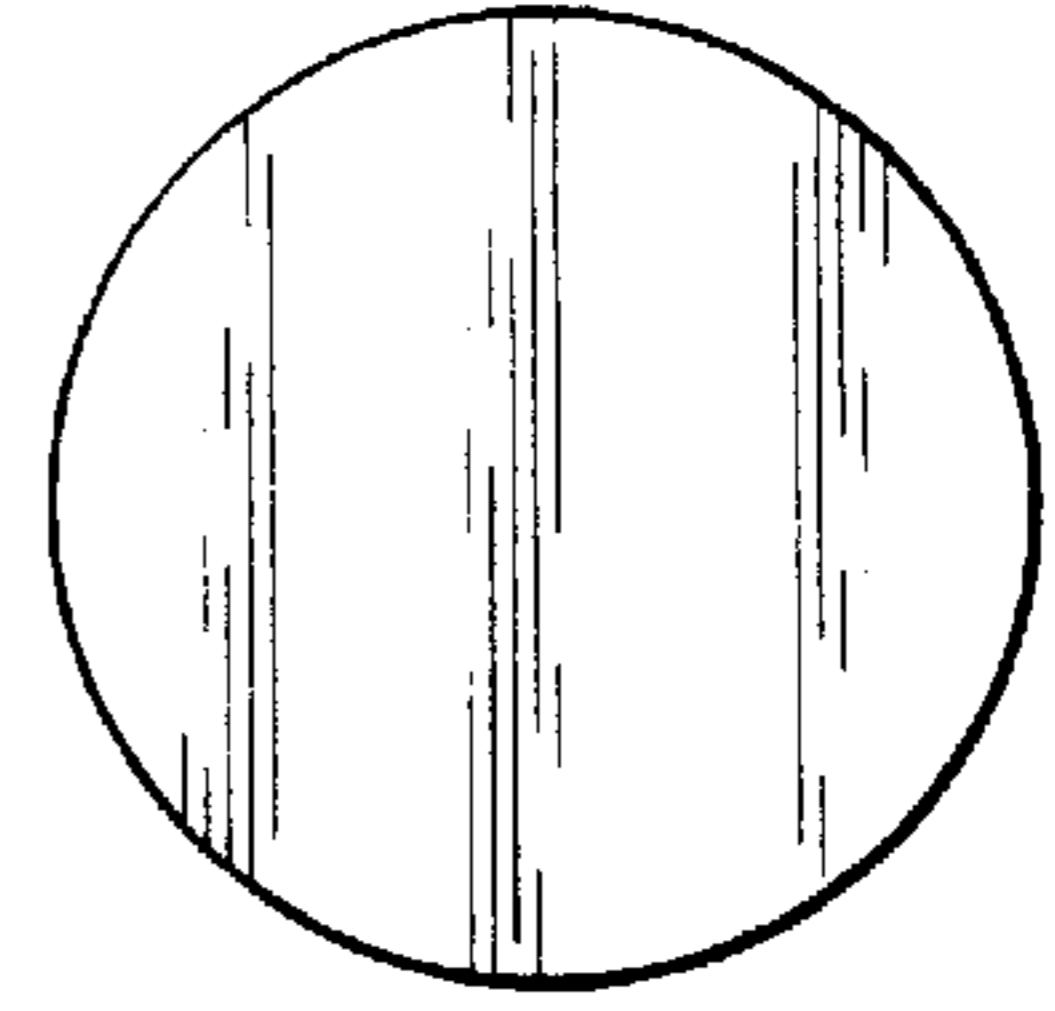

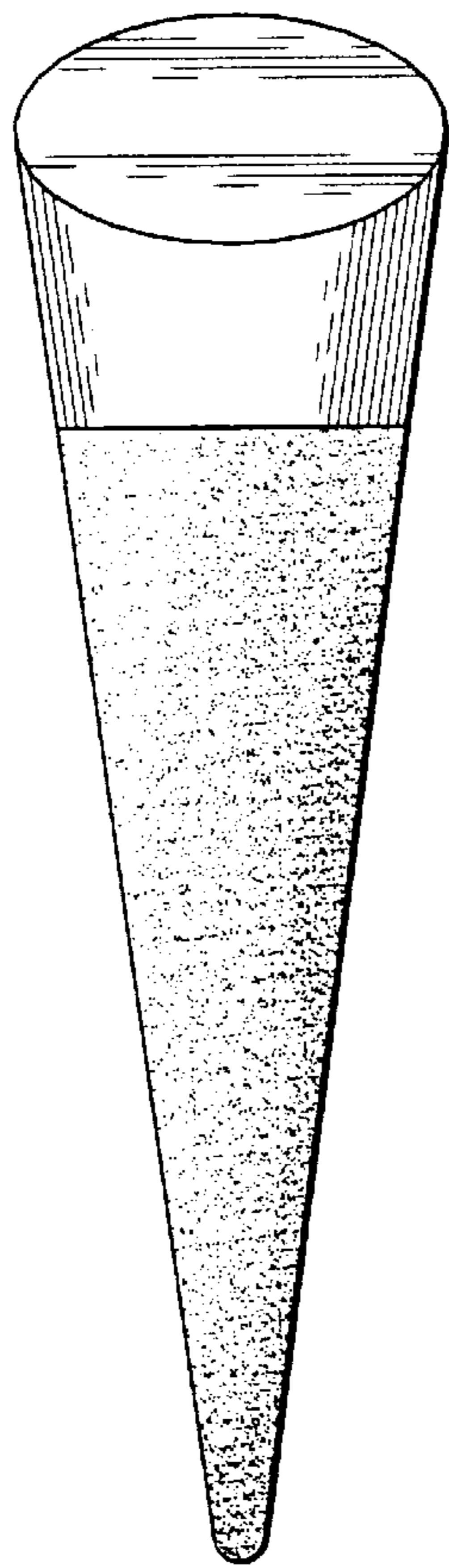

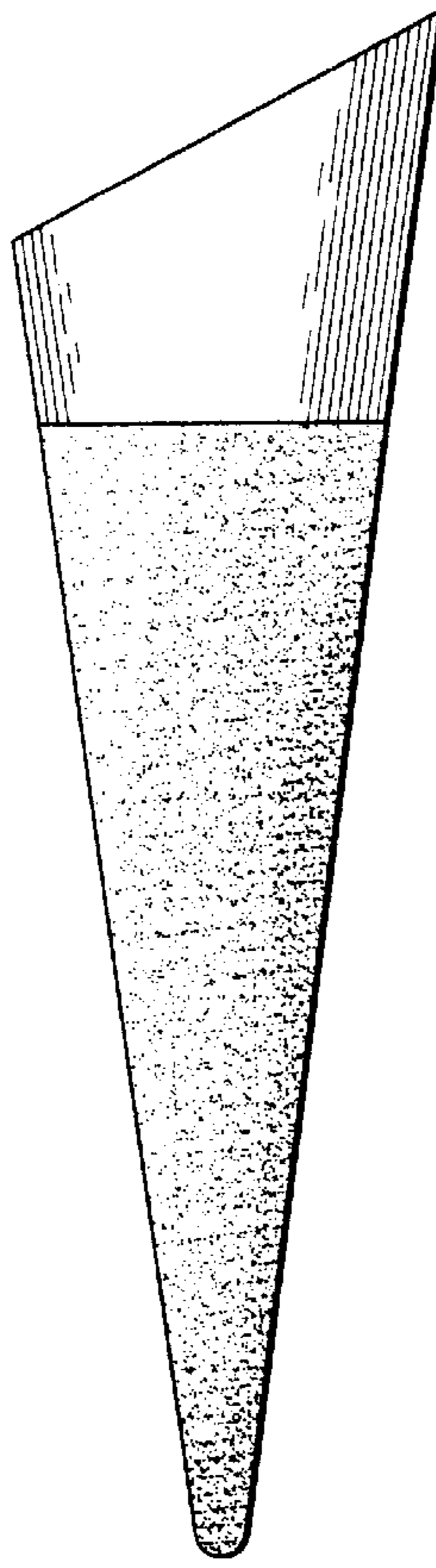

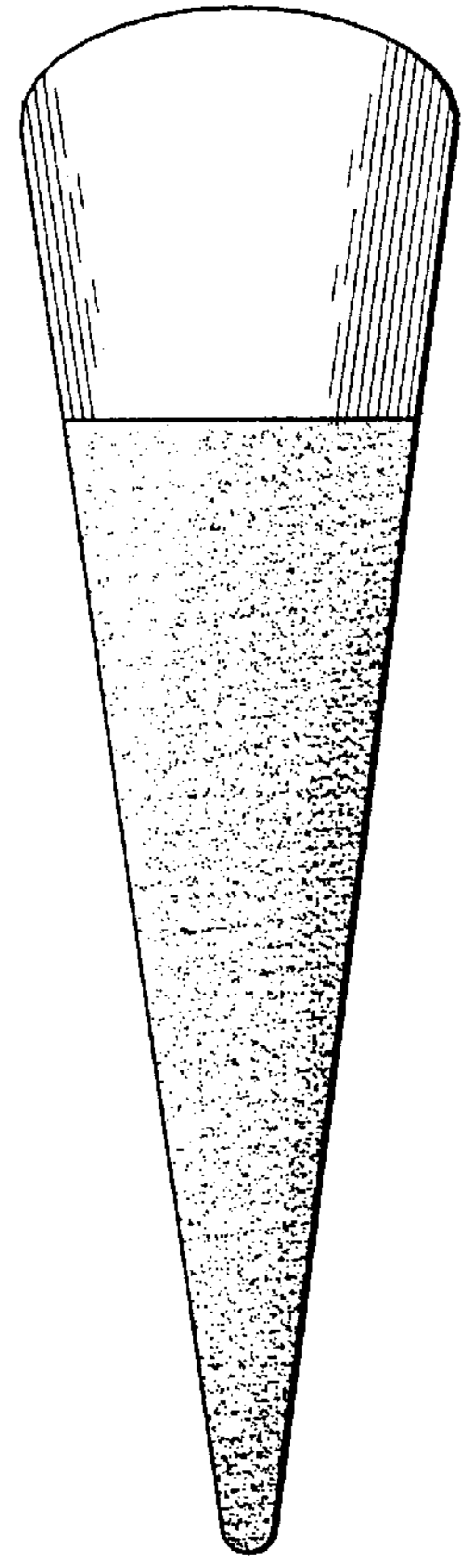
