[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a gender preference symbol round jewelry insignia, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a gender preference symbol

round jewelry insignia in a male/female orientation showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1 thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1 thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view taken from the left of FIG. 1 with the right, rear and front sides being mirror images thereof;

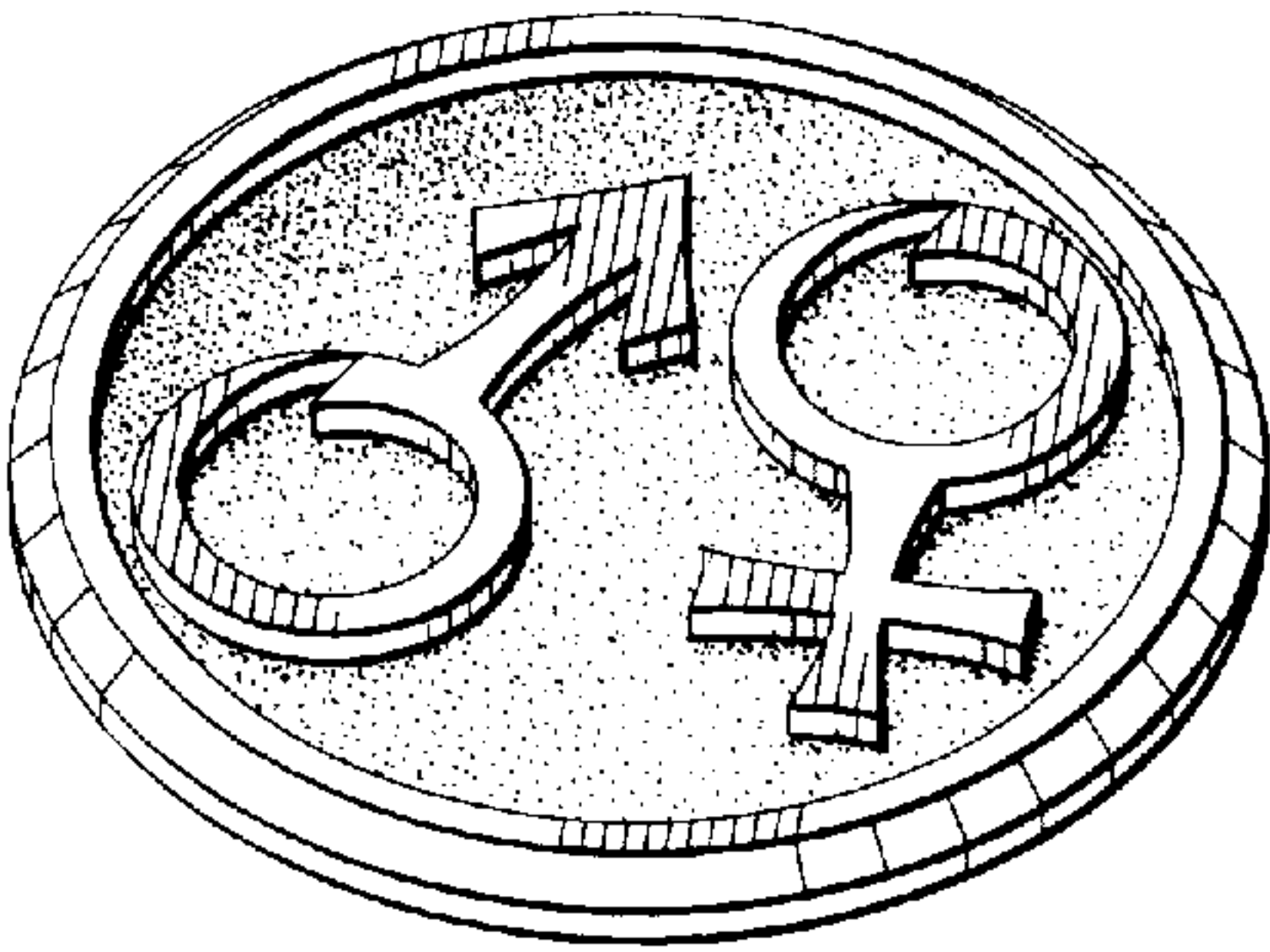
FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a gender preference symbol round jewelry insignia showing a second embodiment of my new design;

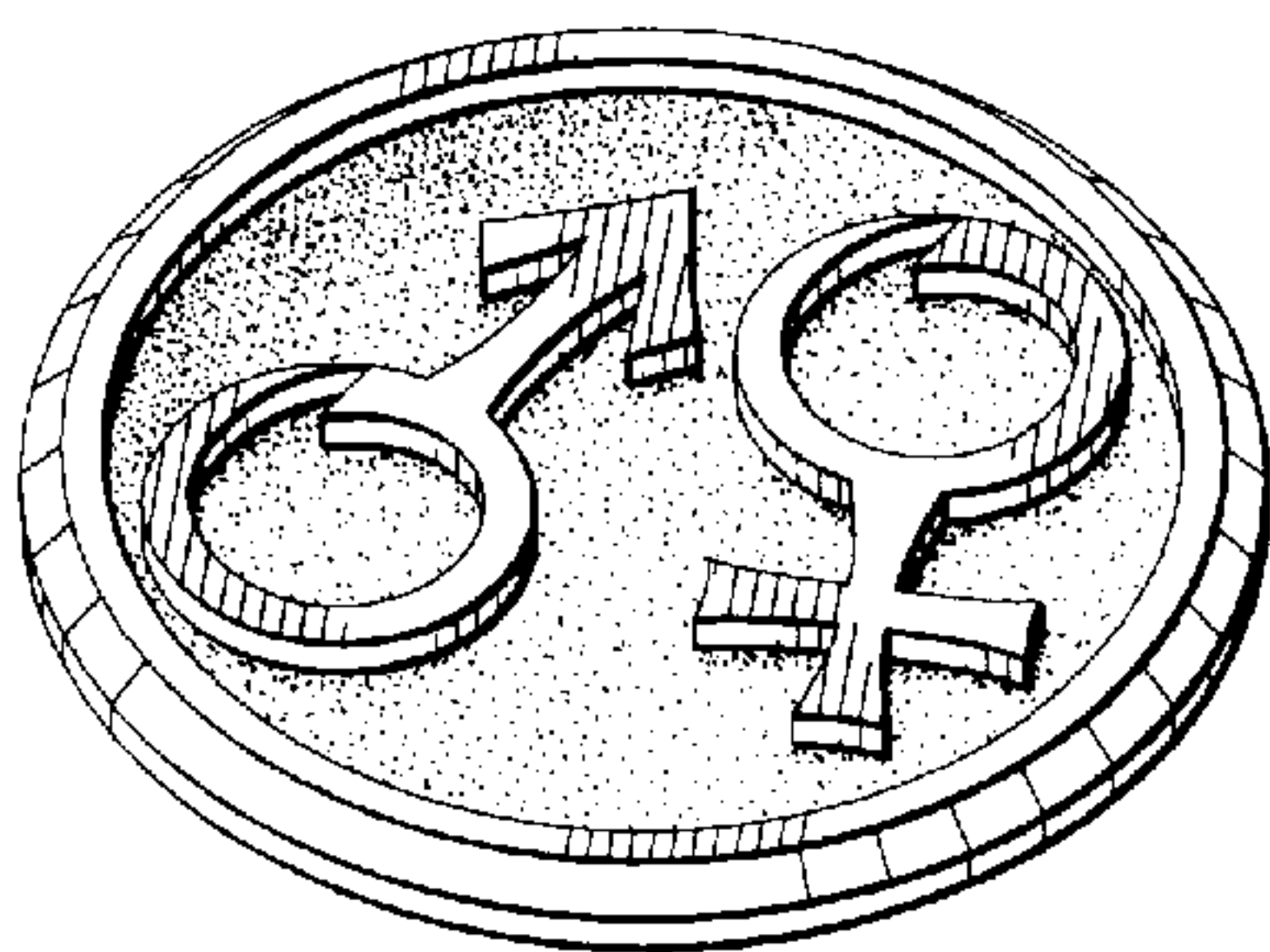
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a gender preference symbol round jewelry insignia showing a third embodiment of my new design; and,

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a gender preference symbol round jewelry insignia showing a fourth embodiment of my new design.

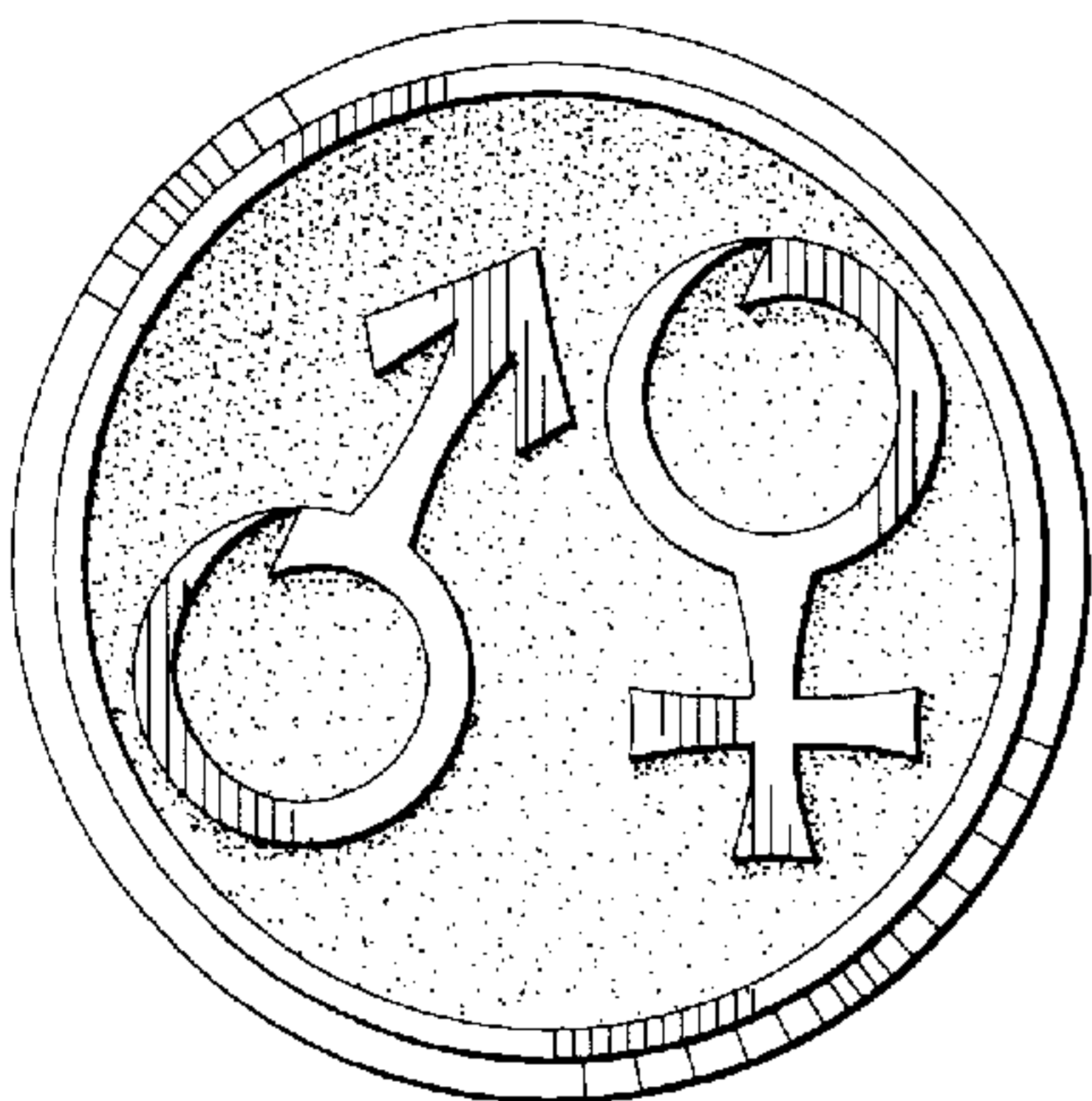
It being understood that all views not shown of the second, third and fourth embodiments are like those shown in FIGS. 3 and 4.

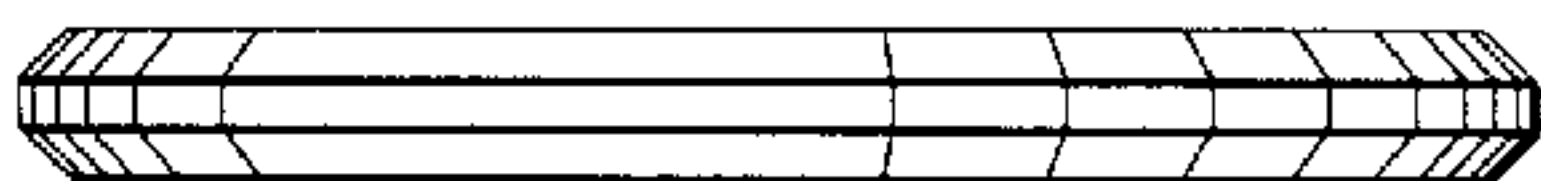




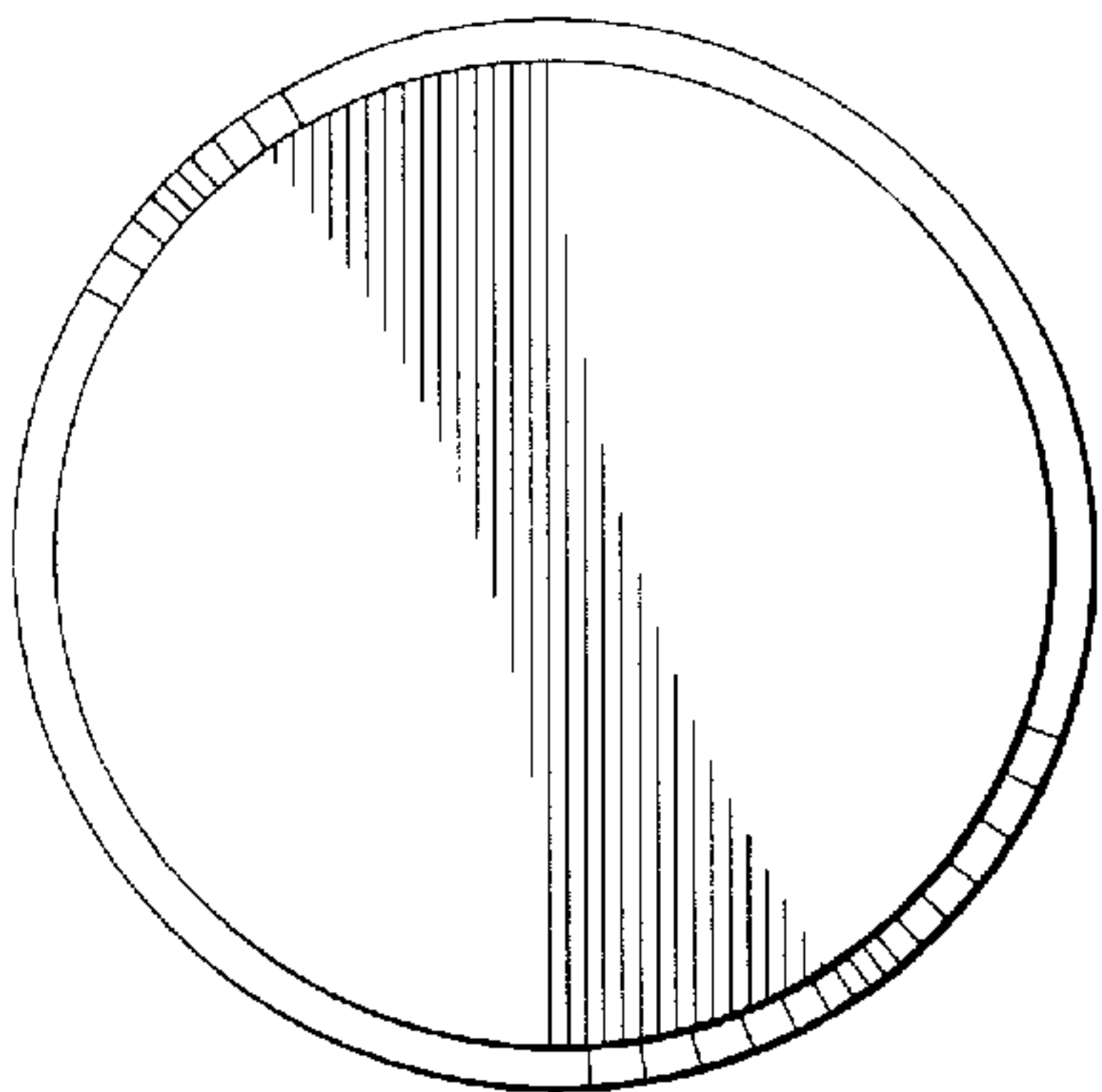

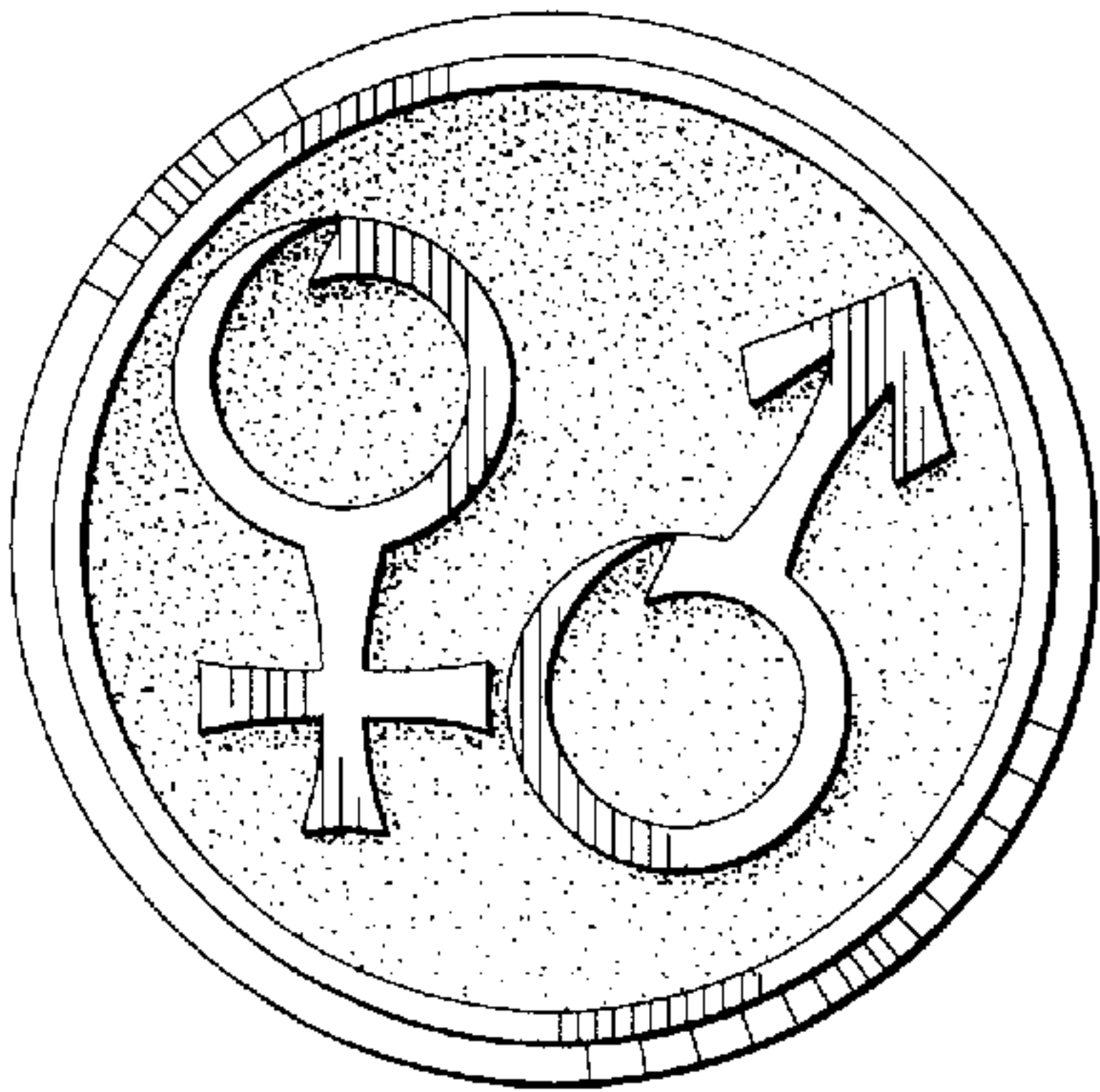

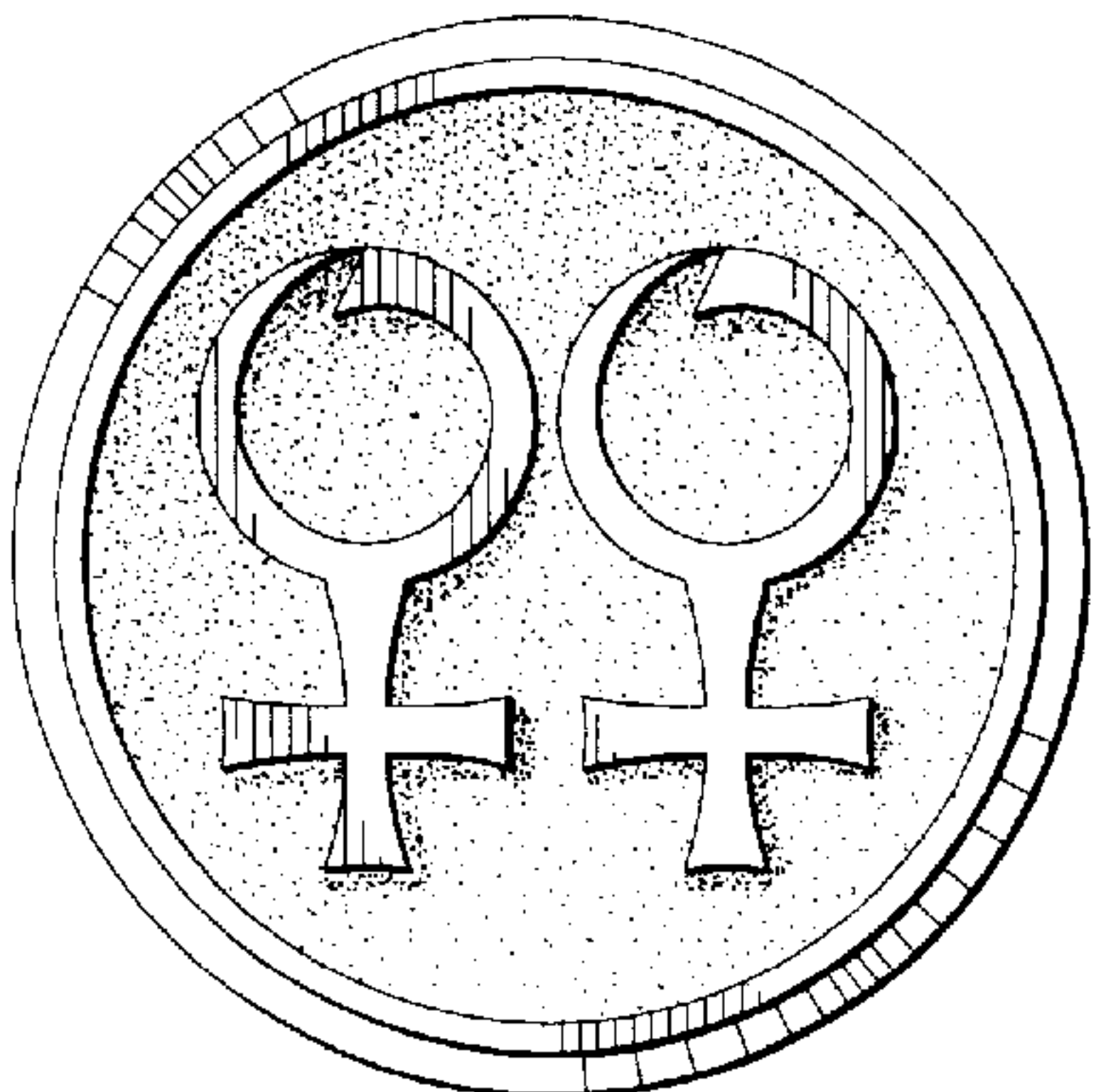

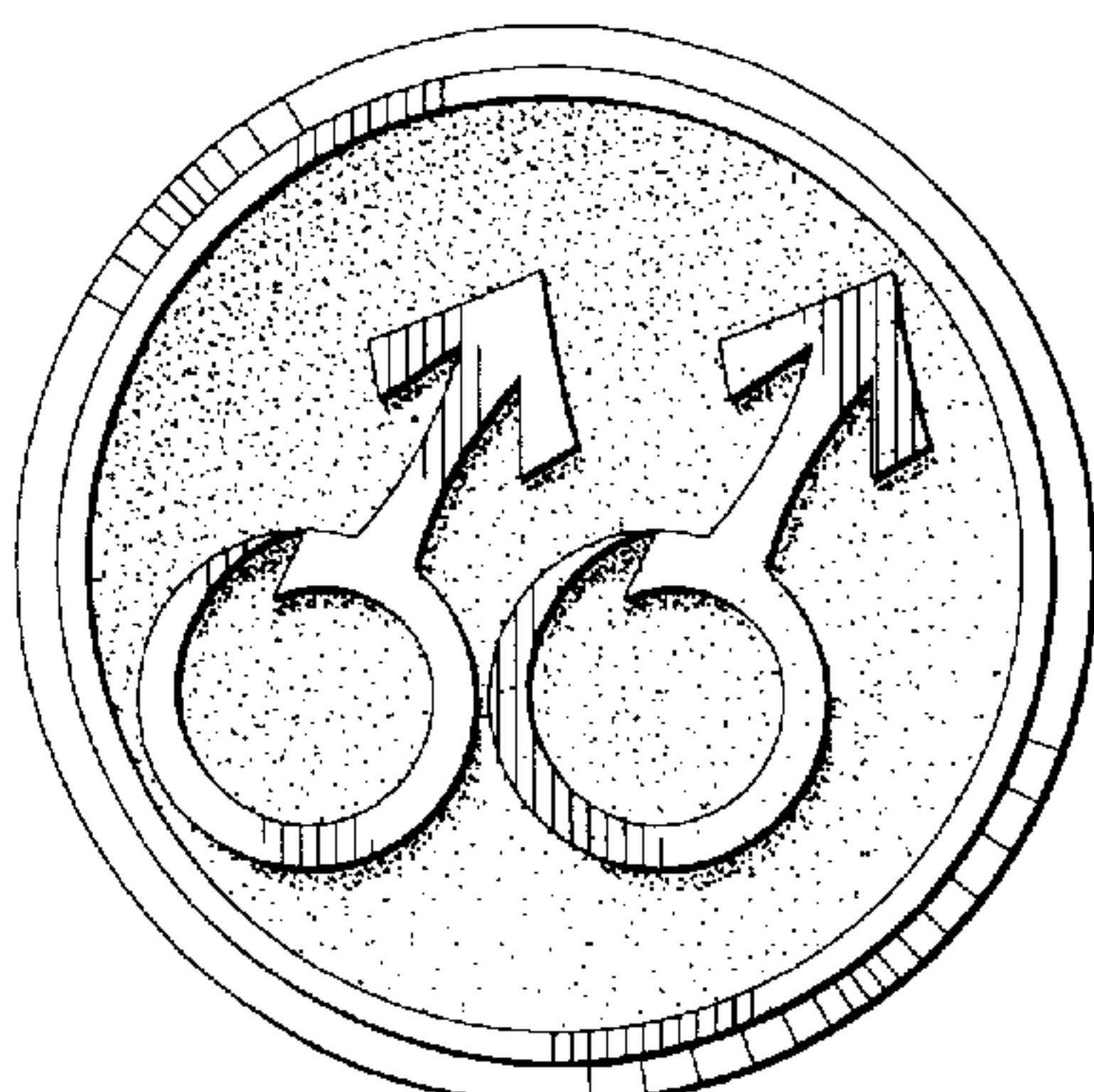
