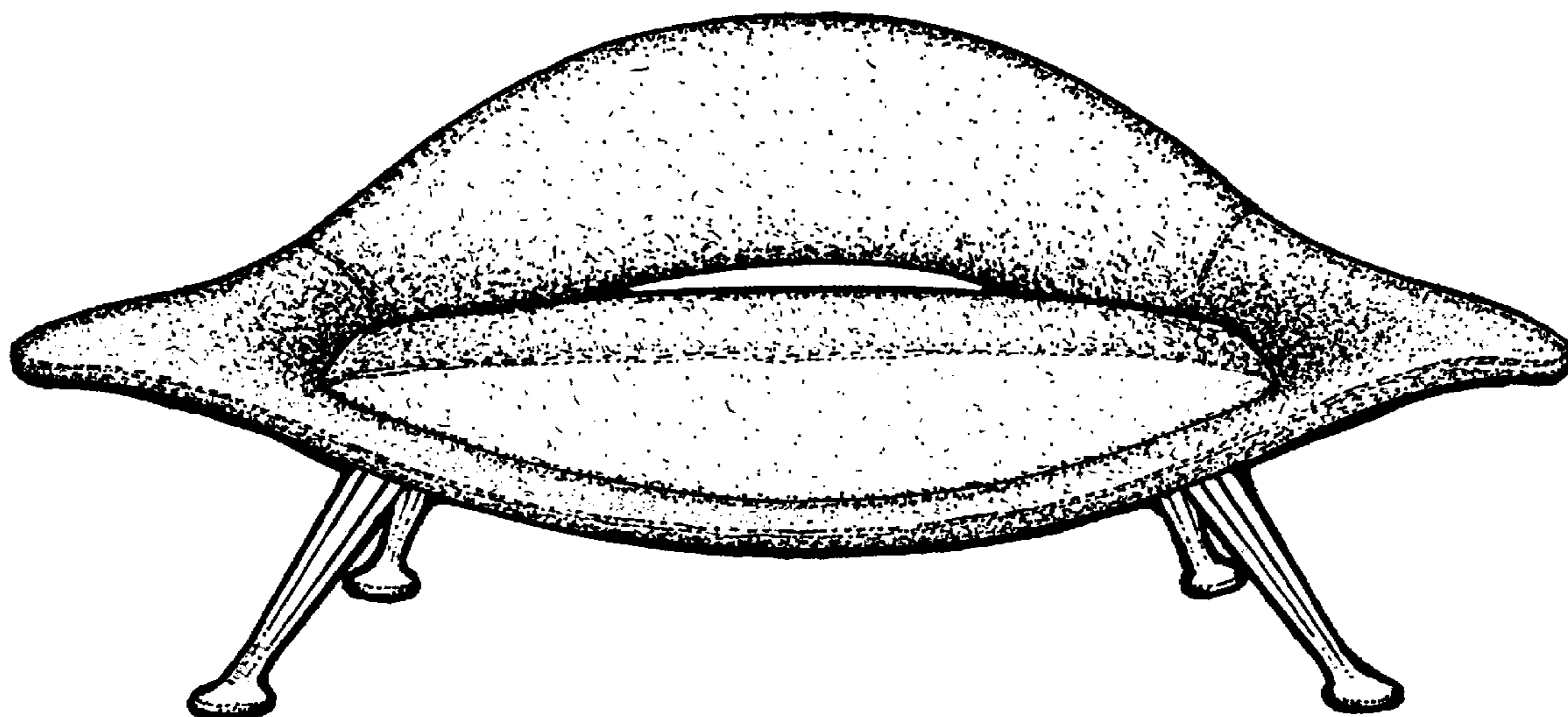
The ornamental design for a seat, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left front perspective view of the seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a right side perspective view of the seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view of the seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top perspective view of the seat shown in FIG. 1; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view of the seat shown in FIG. 1.

The broken lines shown are understood to represent stitching.

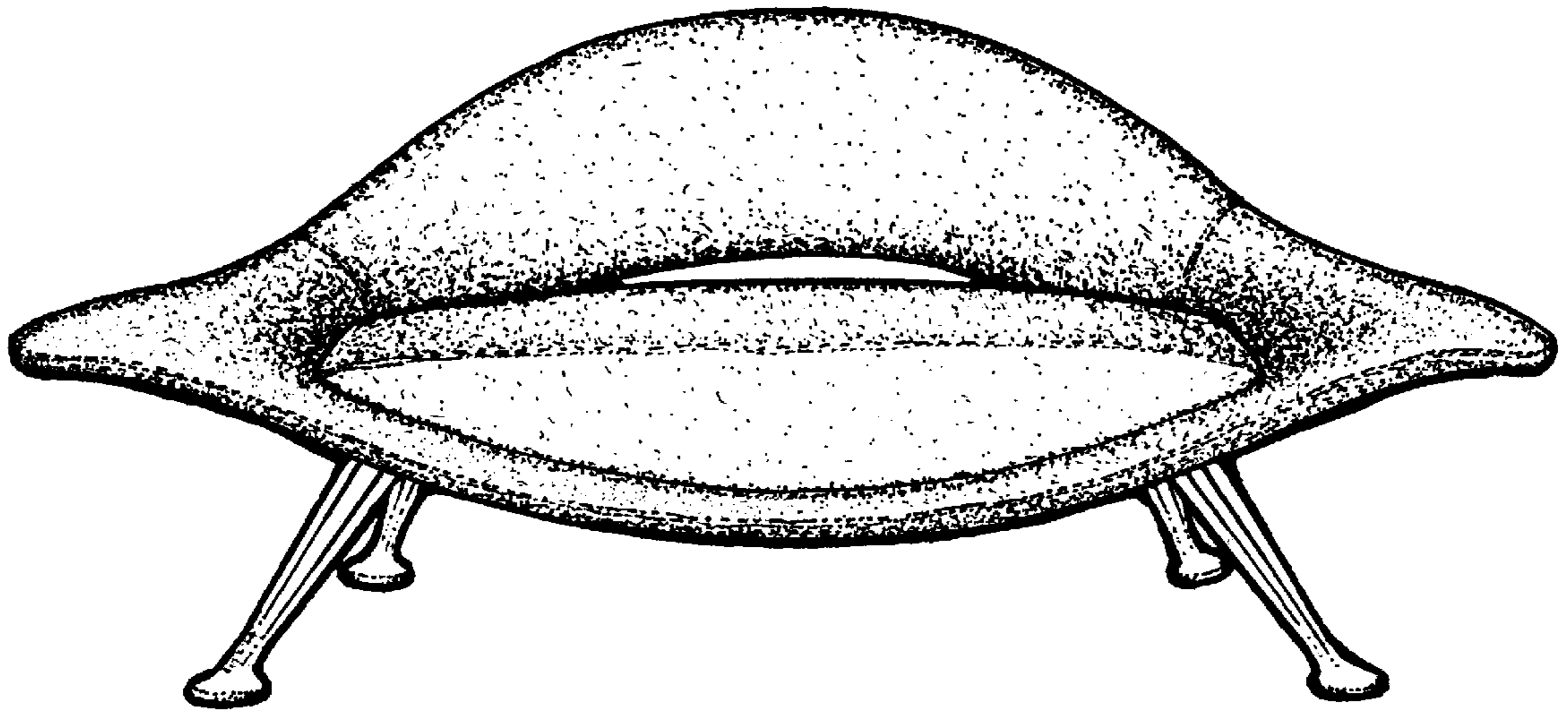

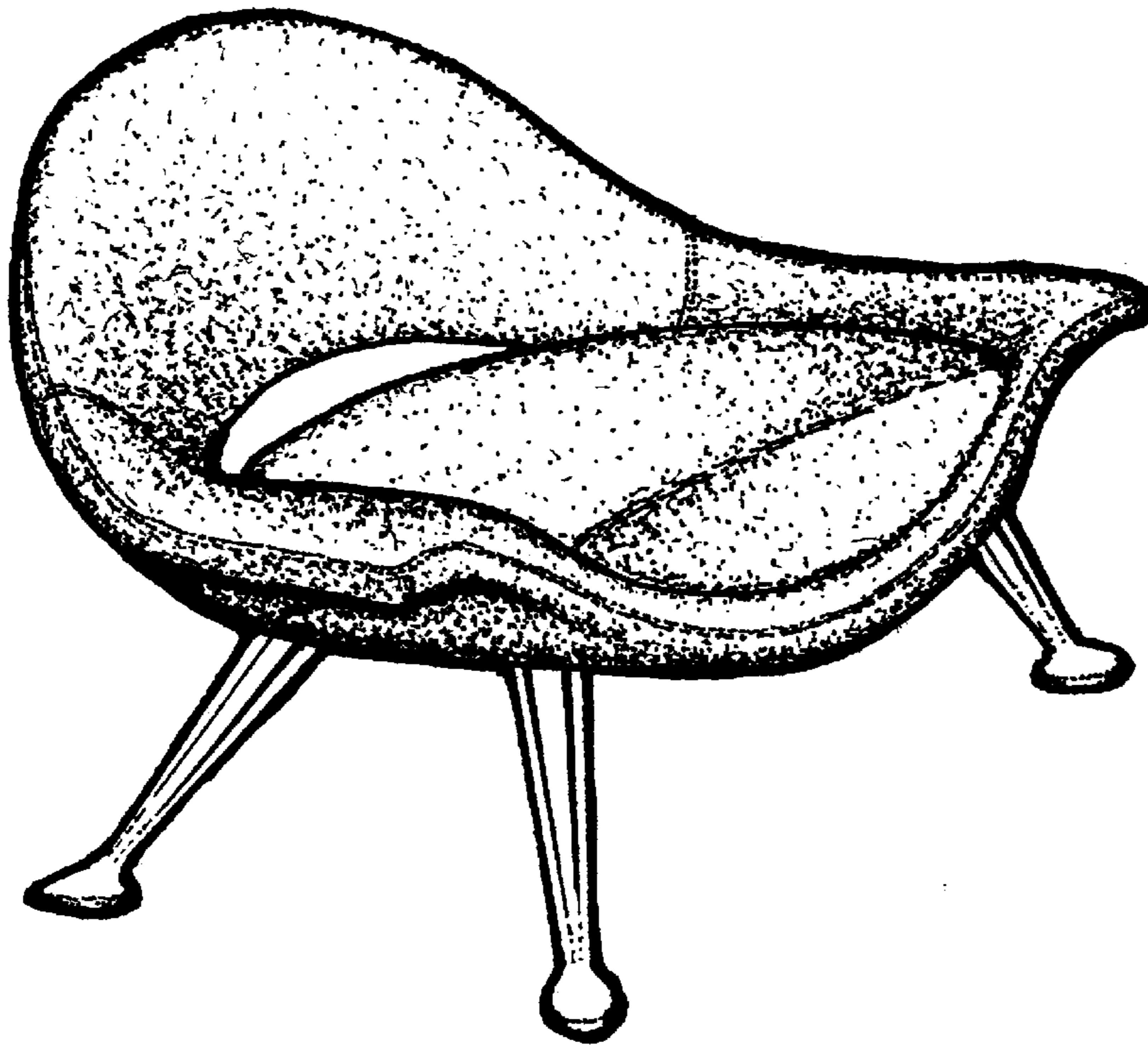

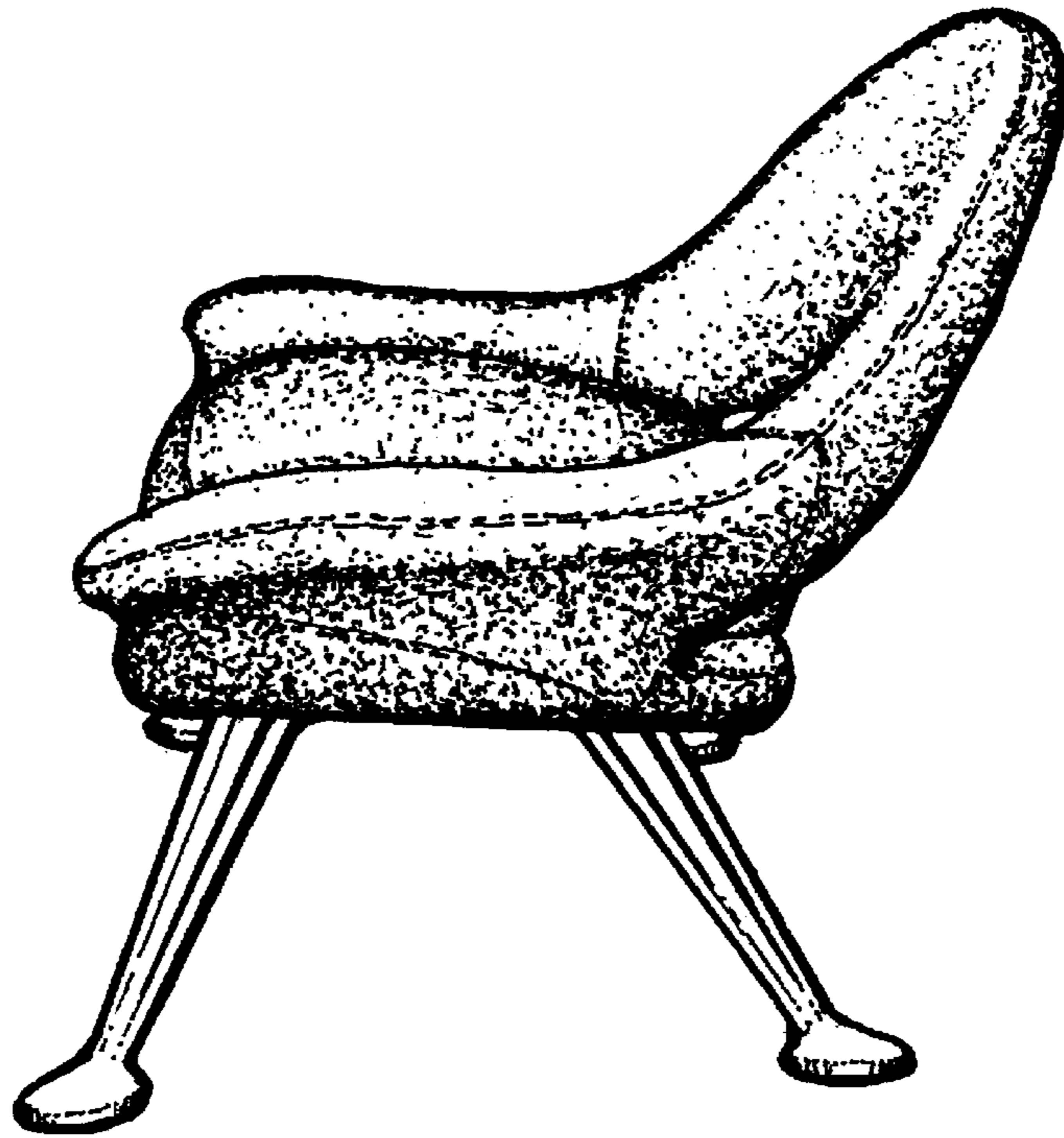

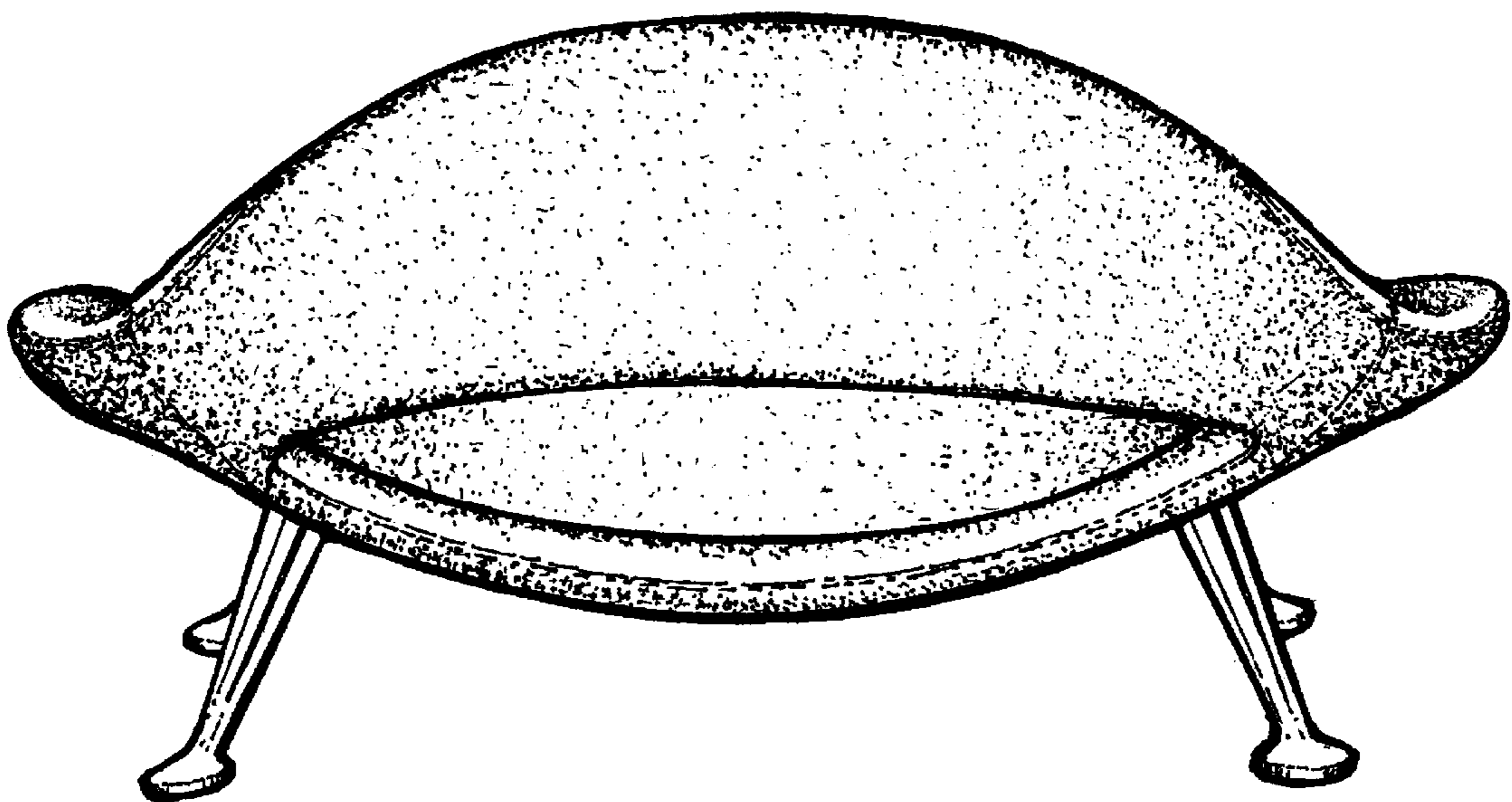

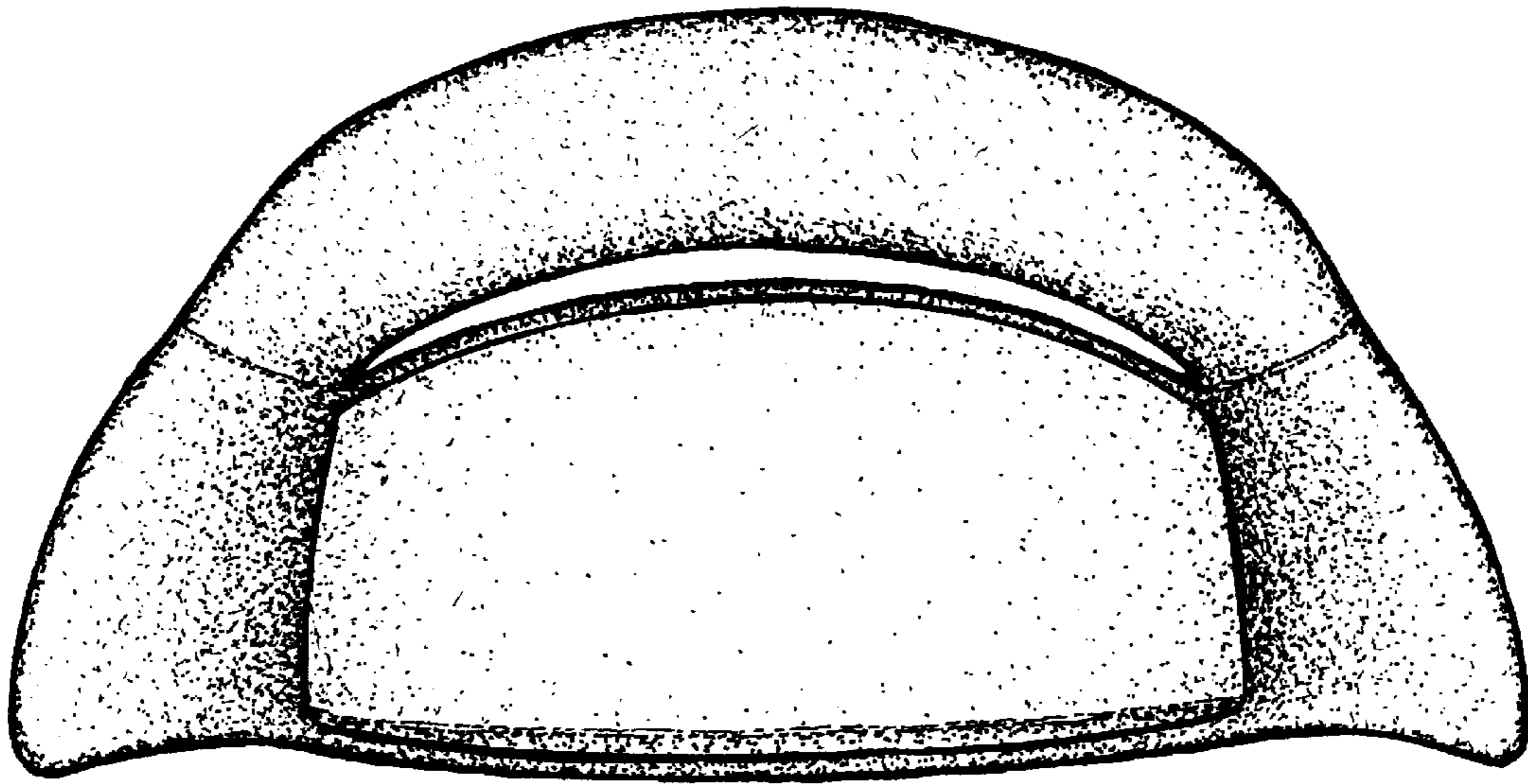

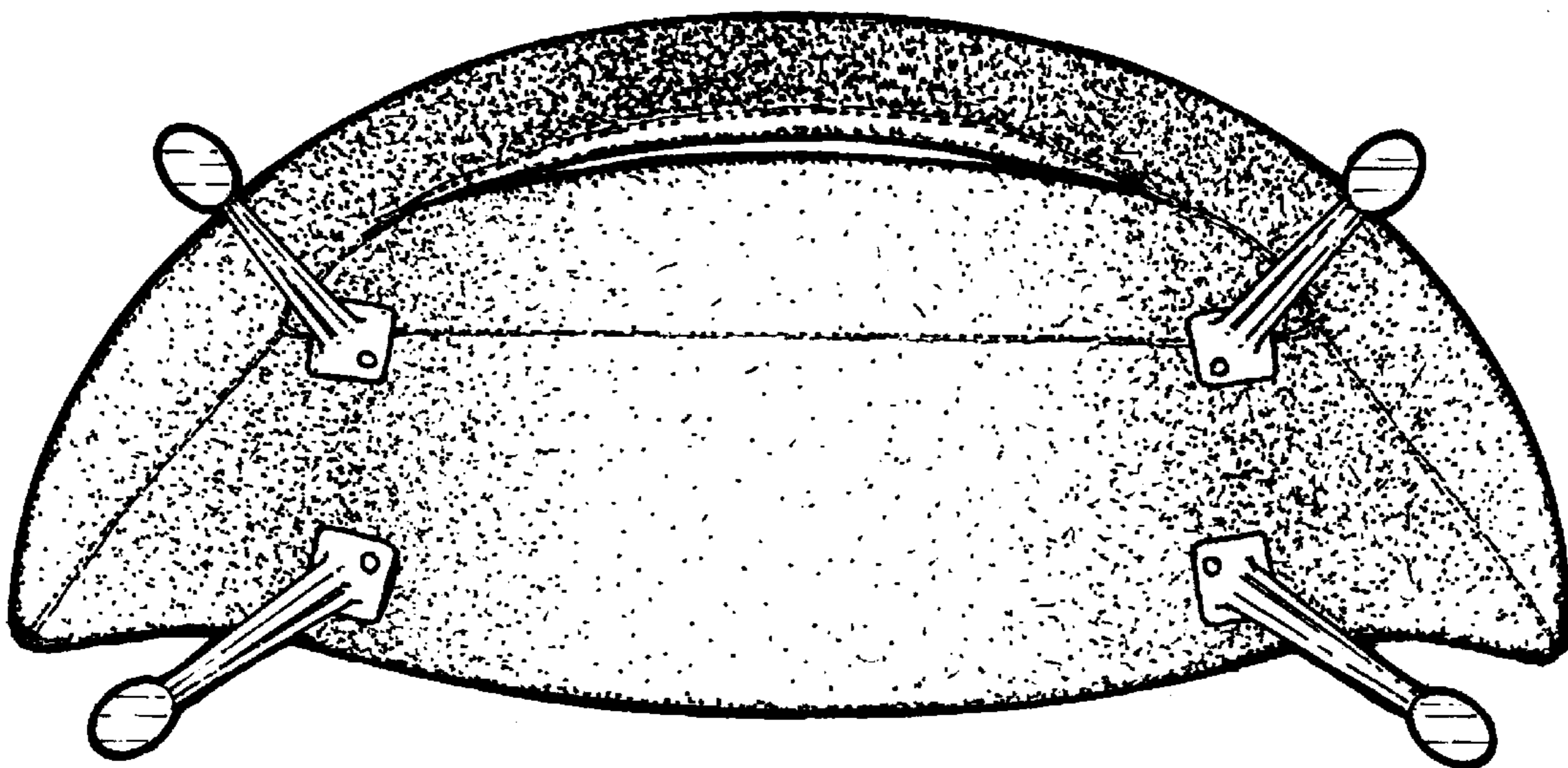
