The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing my new design, the opposite side of the chair being a mirror image of the view shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view taken from the left side of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and,

FIG. 5 is a top view of the design.

The broken line showing of a cushion in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

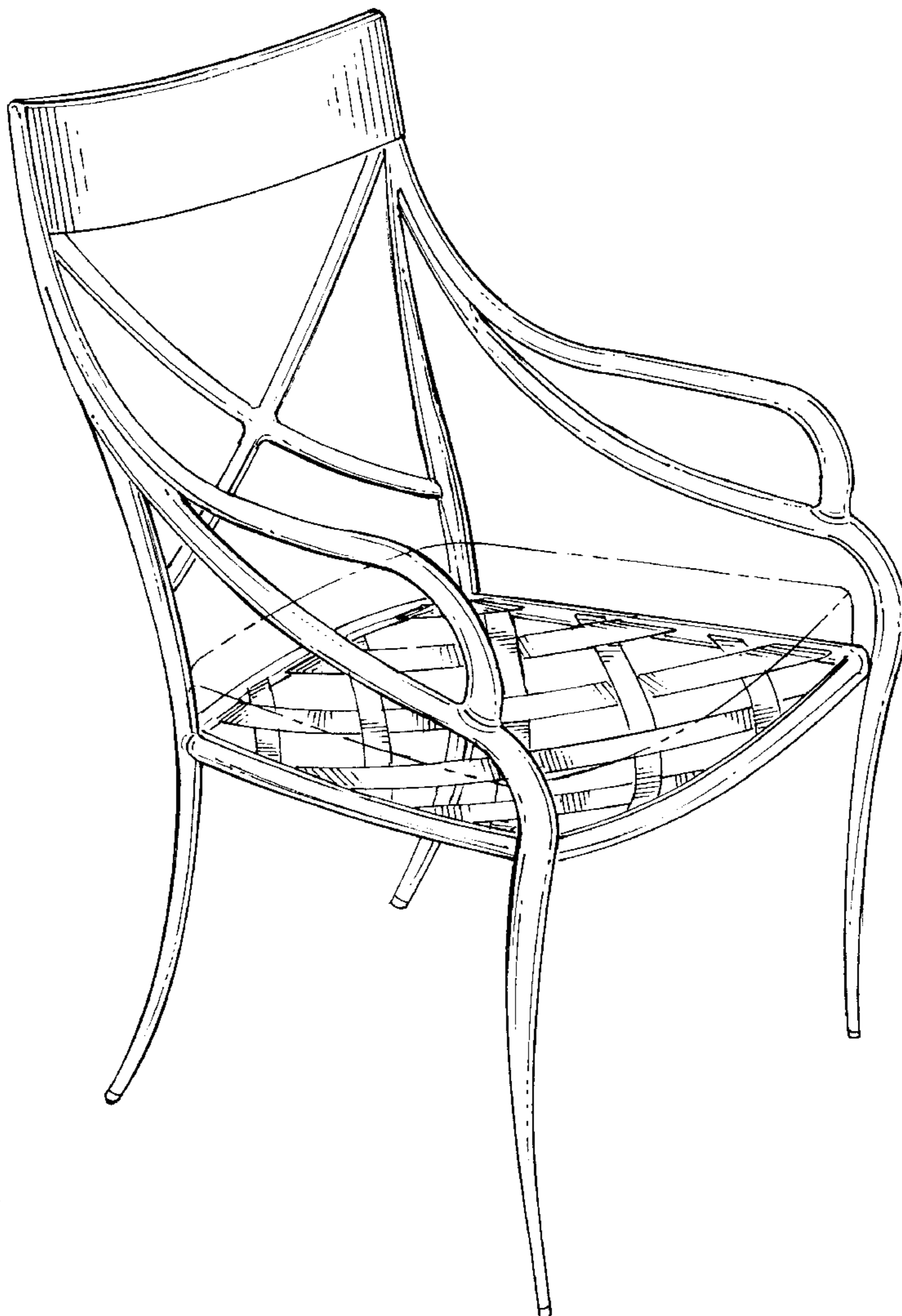
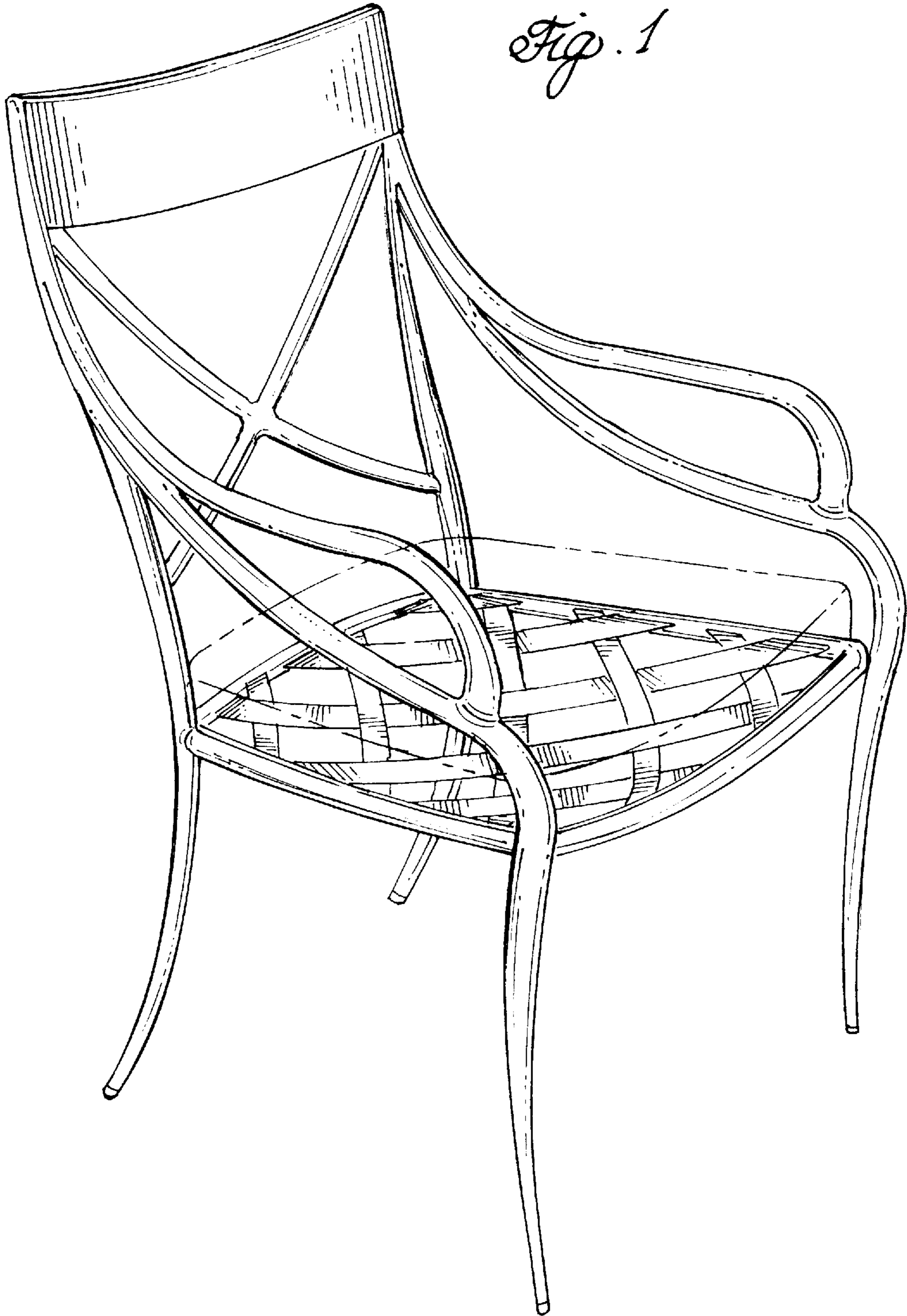

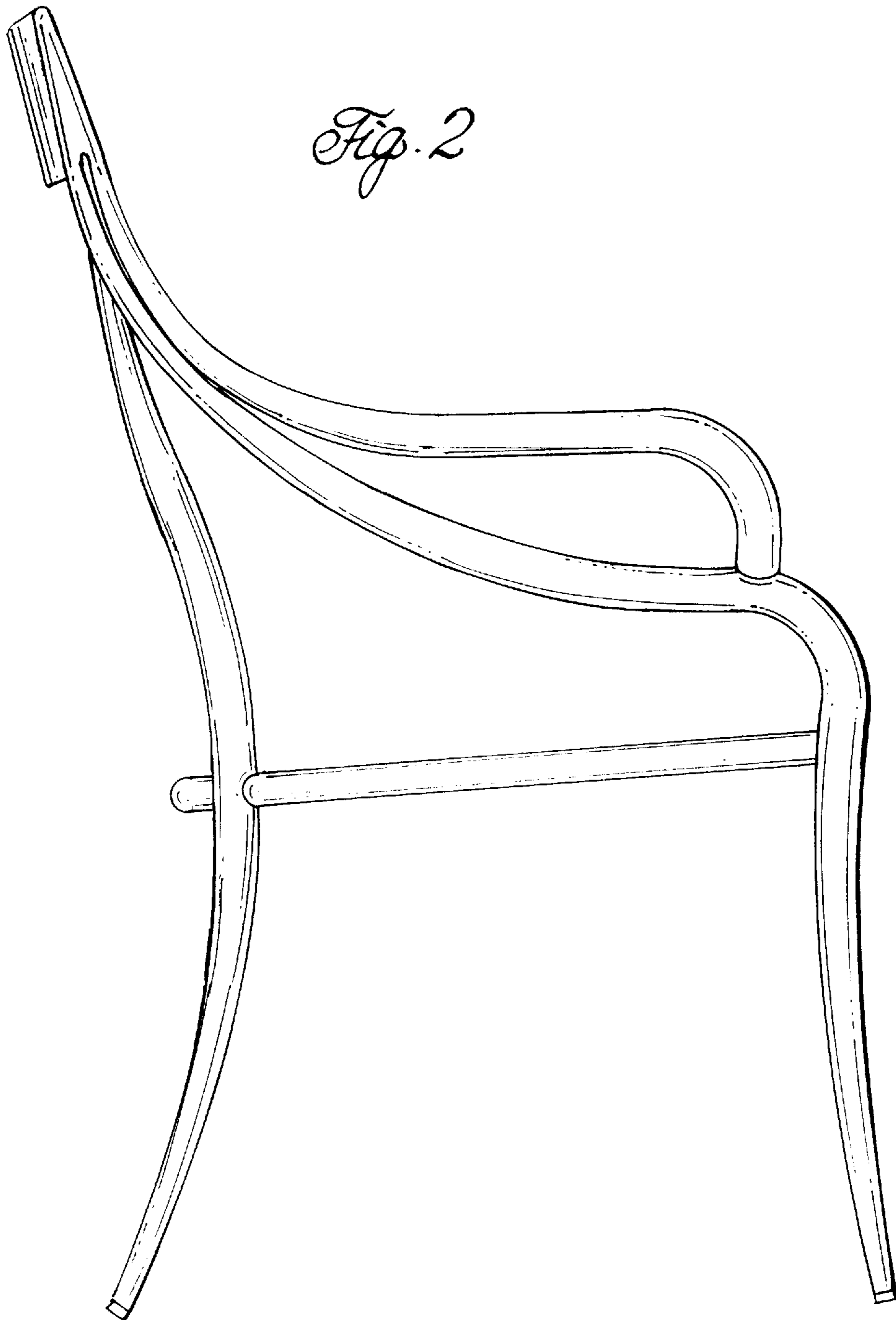

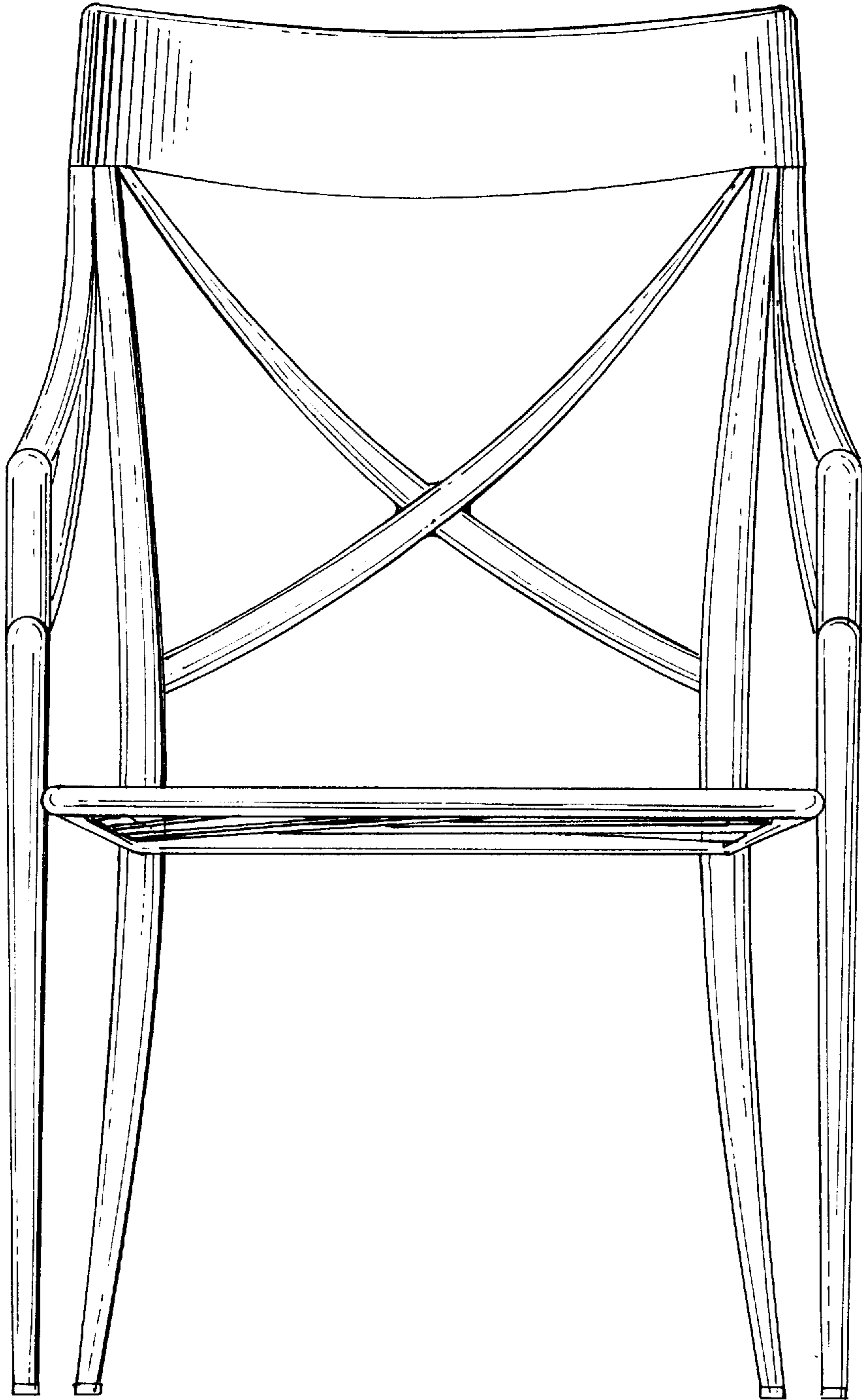

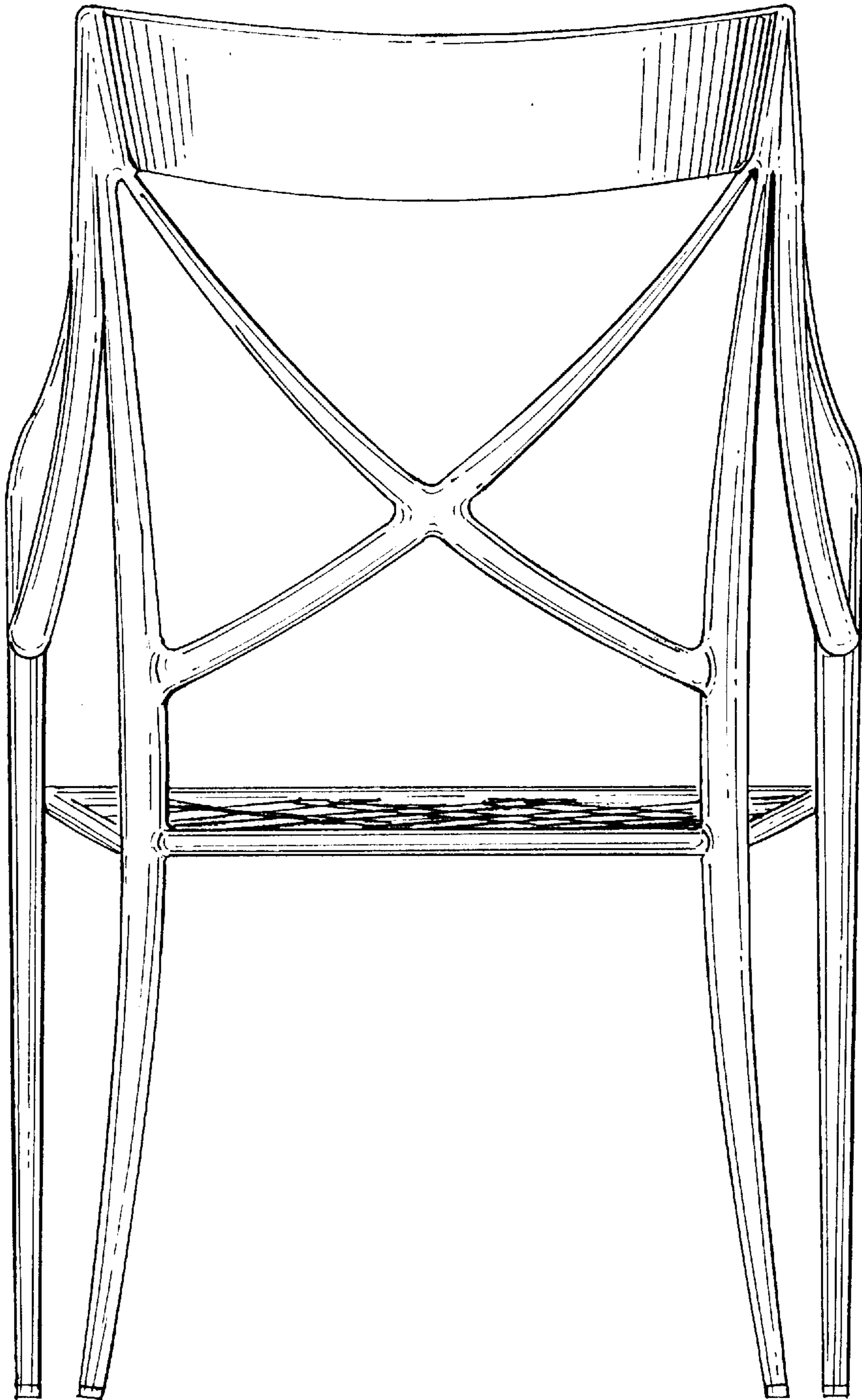
