FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the truck front grille of FIG. 5. The opposite side elevational view is a mirror image of the view shown in FIG. 7.

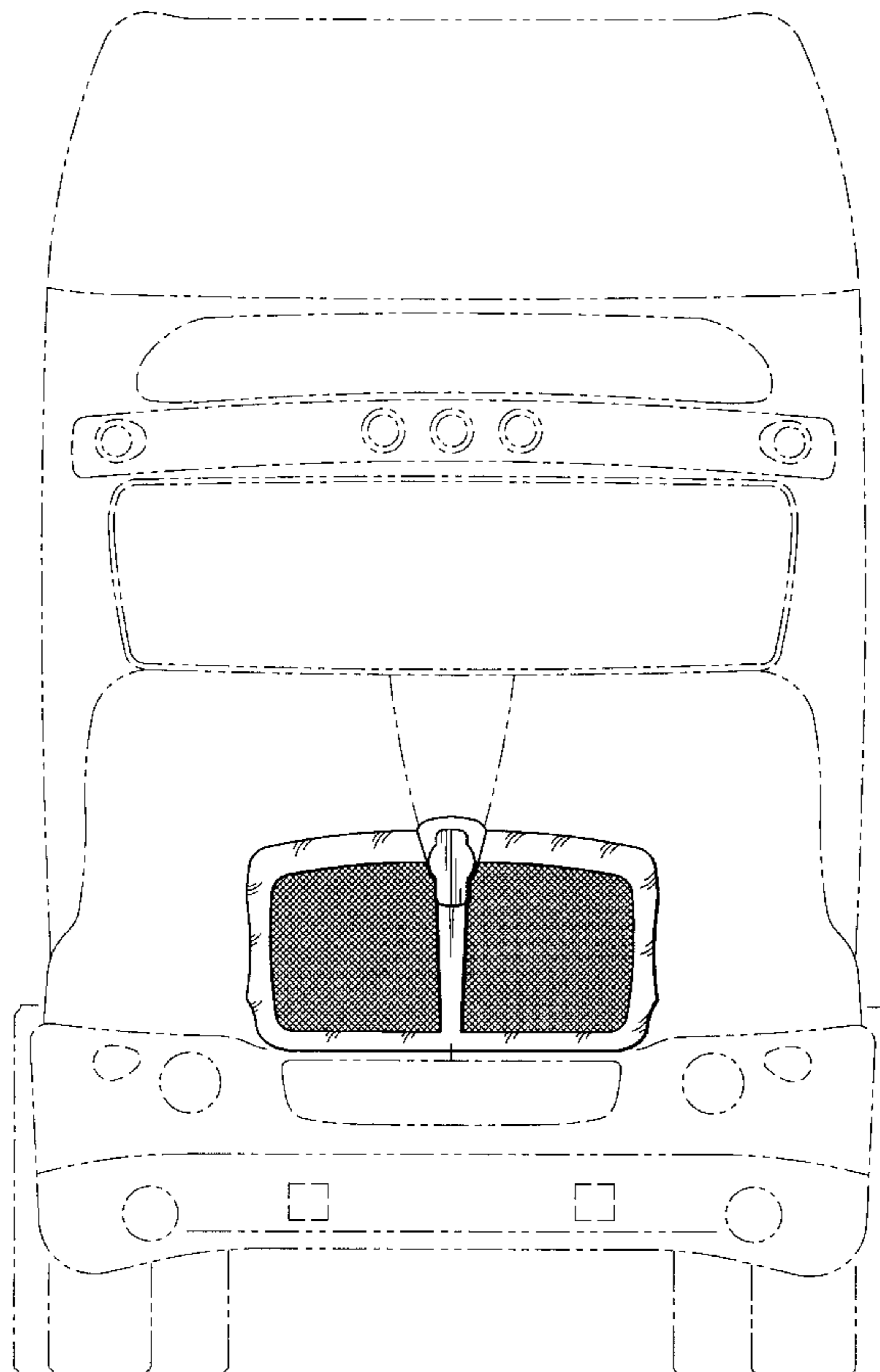

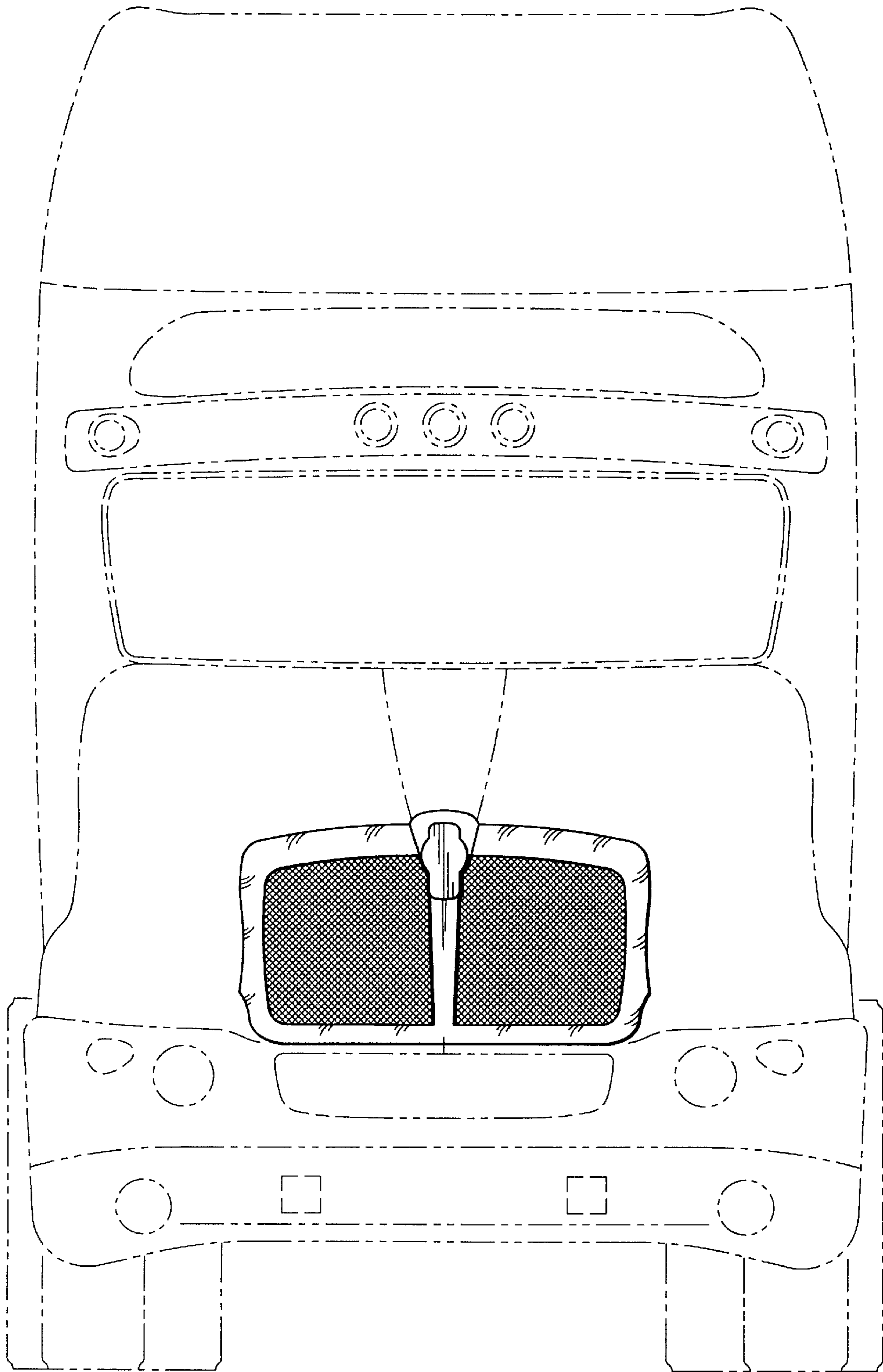
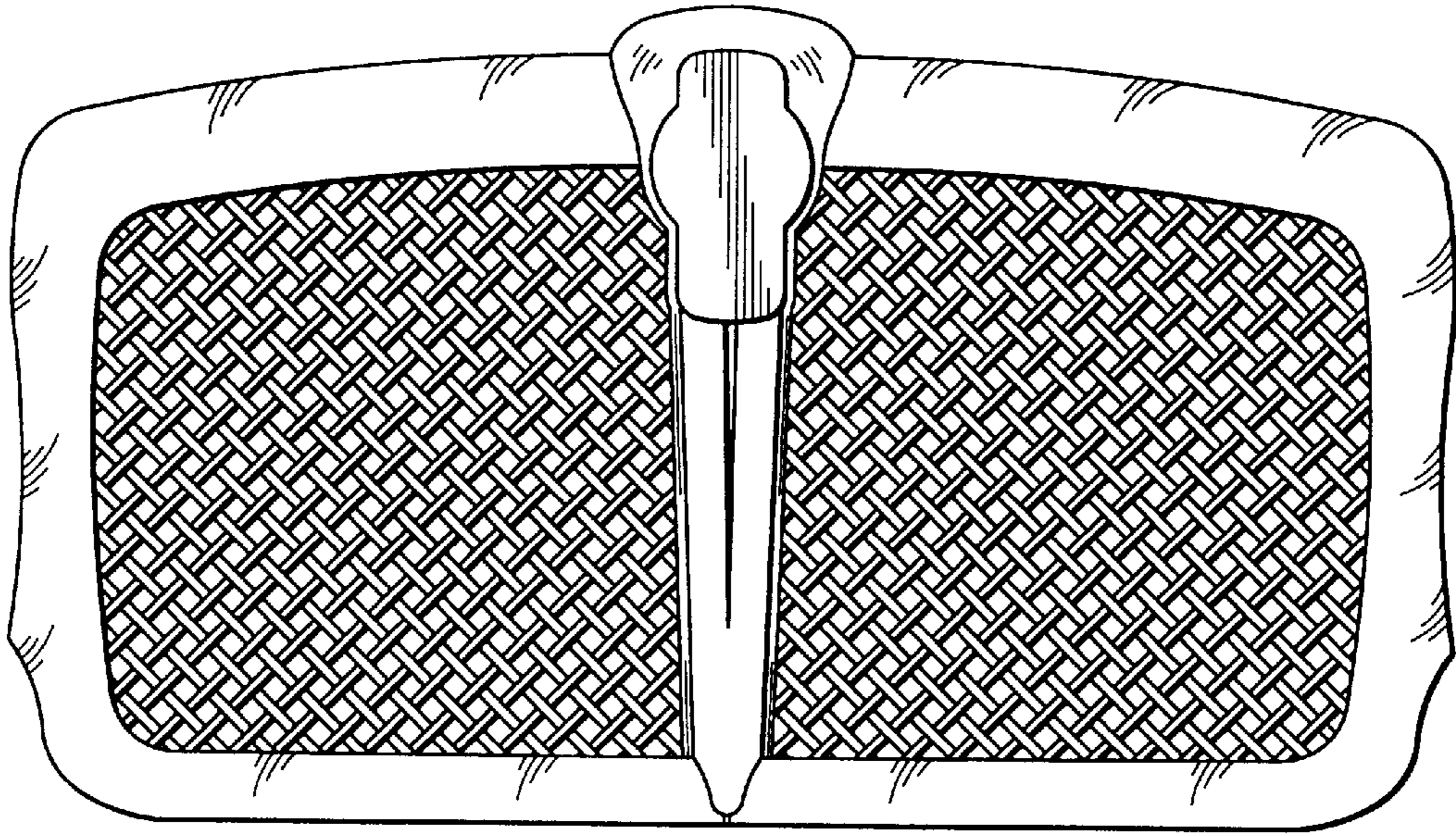
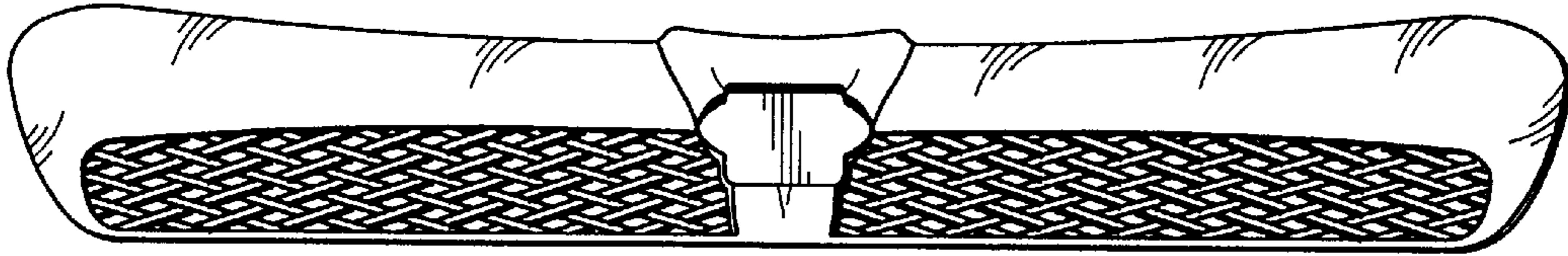

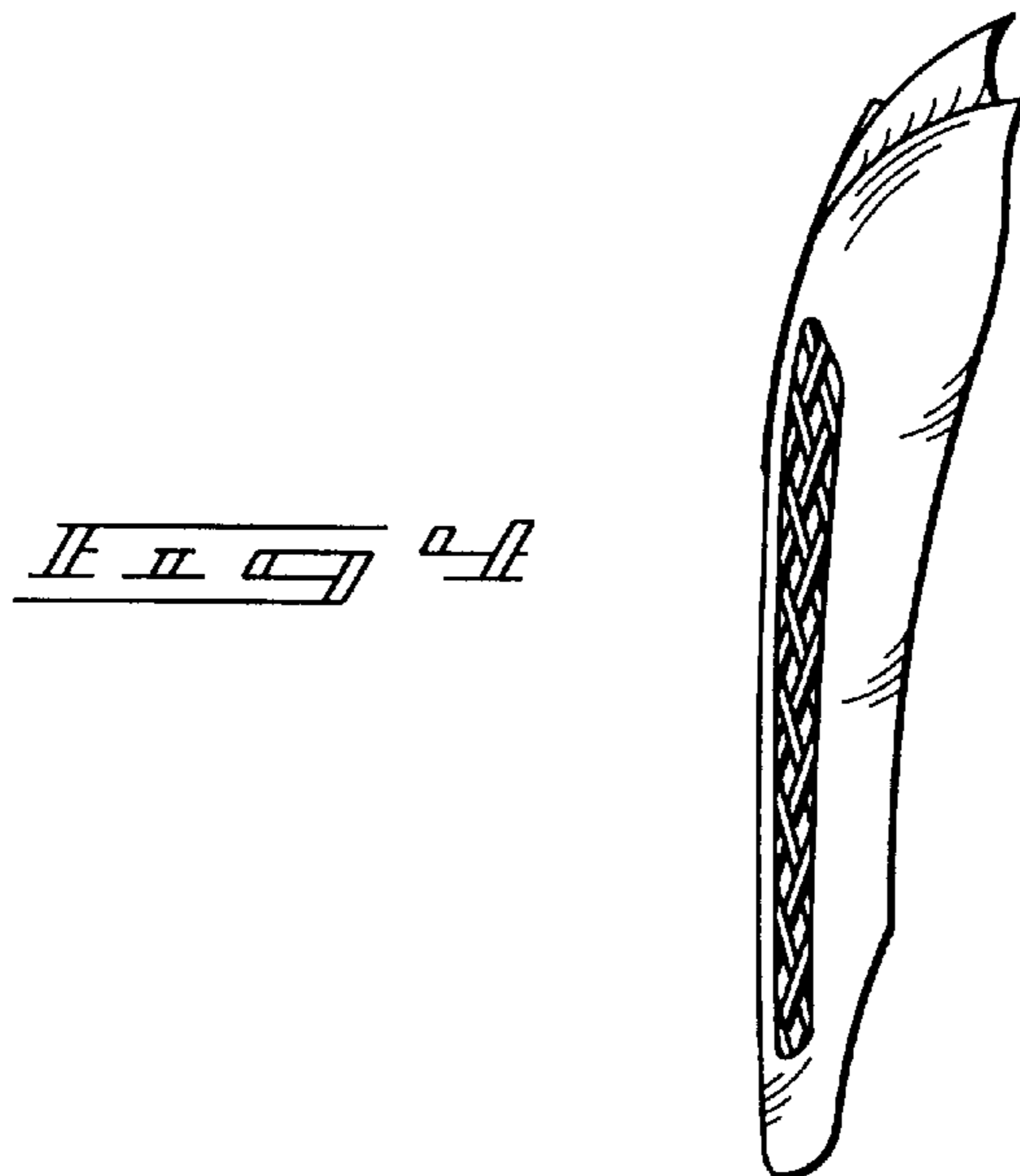

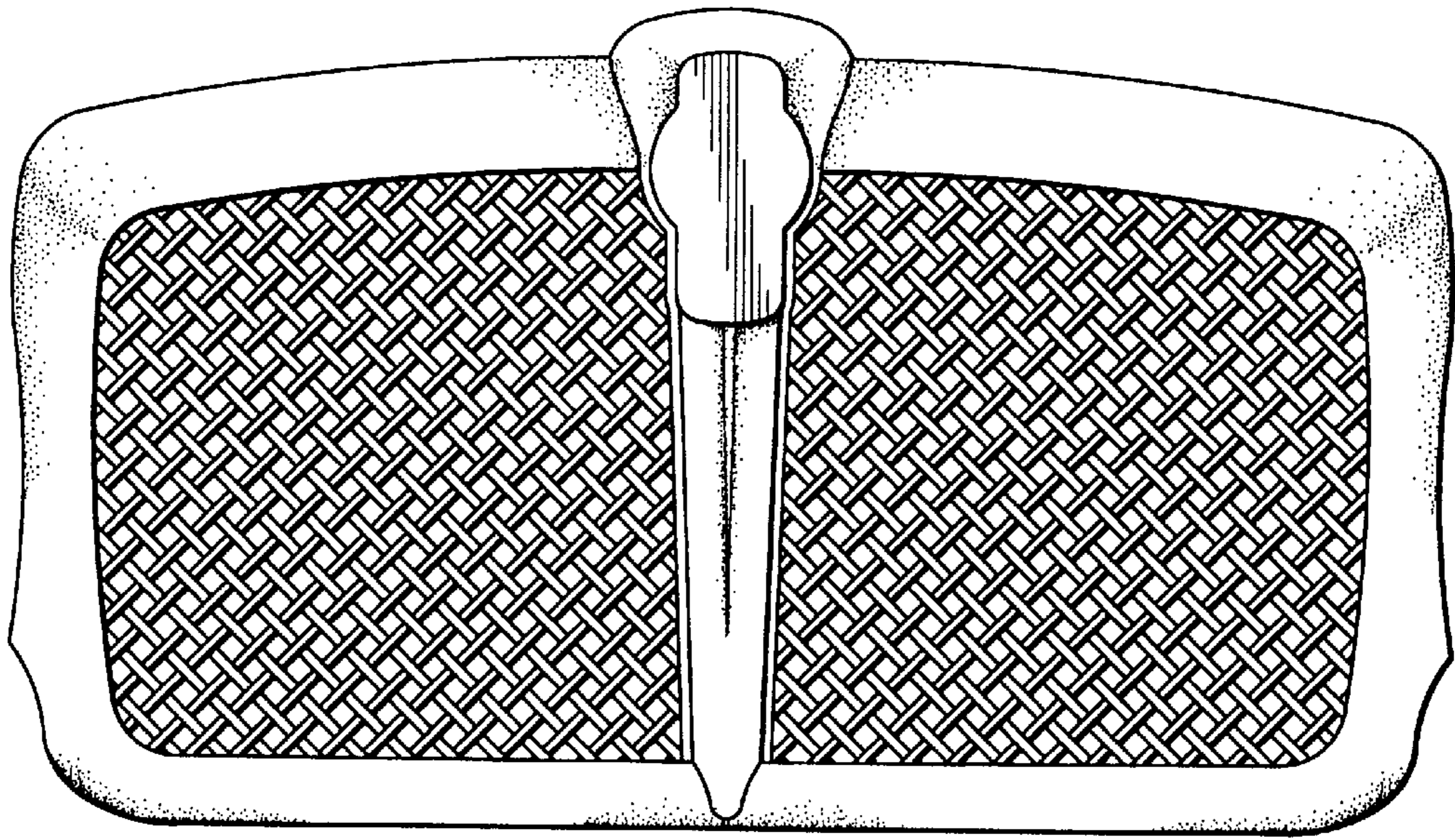

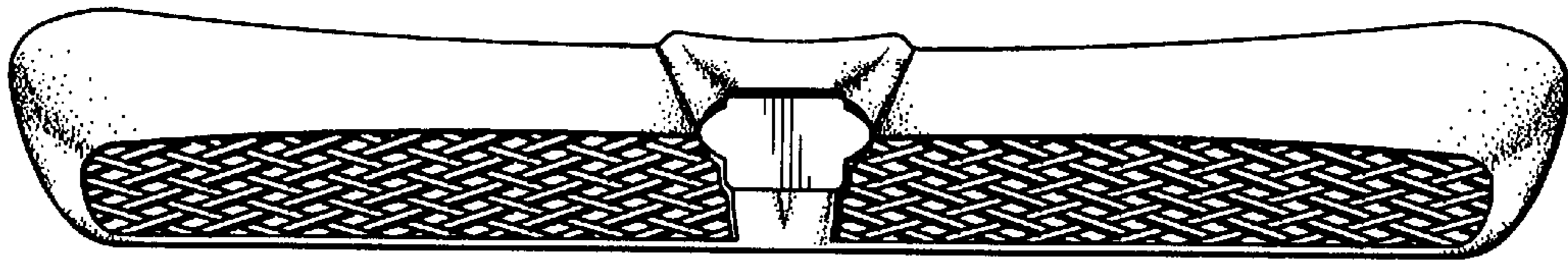
