[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a wedge clubhead, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a golf clubhead embodying my design;

FIG. 2 is an end (heel end) elevational view of the design depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the design depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an end (toe end) elevational view of the design depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a vertical section view taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design depicted in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the design depicted in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the design depicted in FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of a fragmented shaft on FIG. 8 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

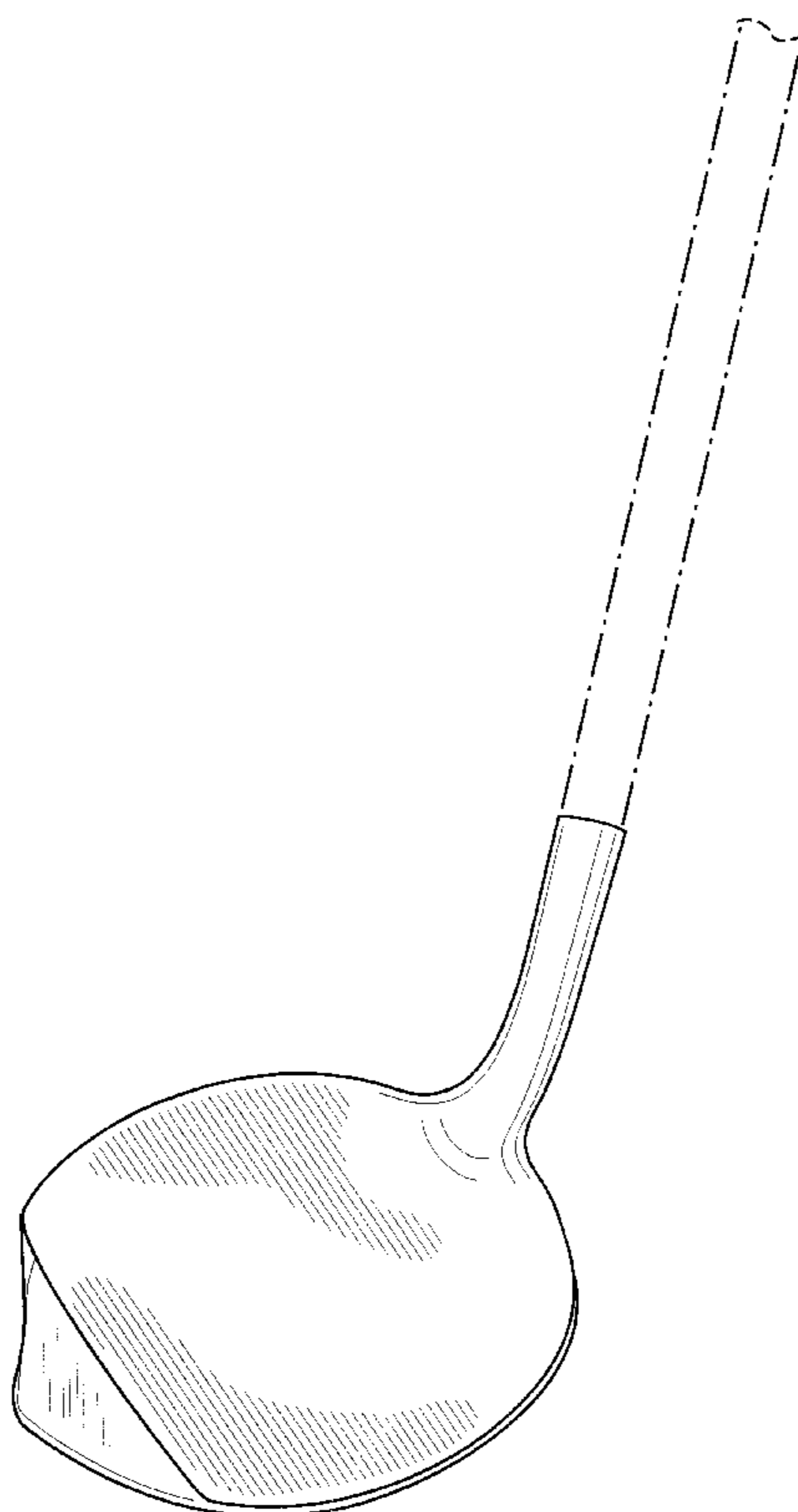

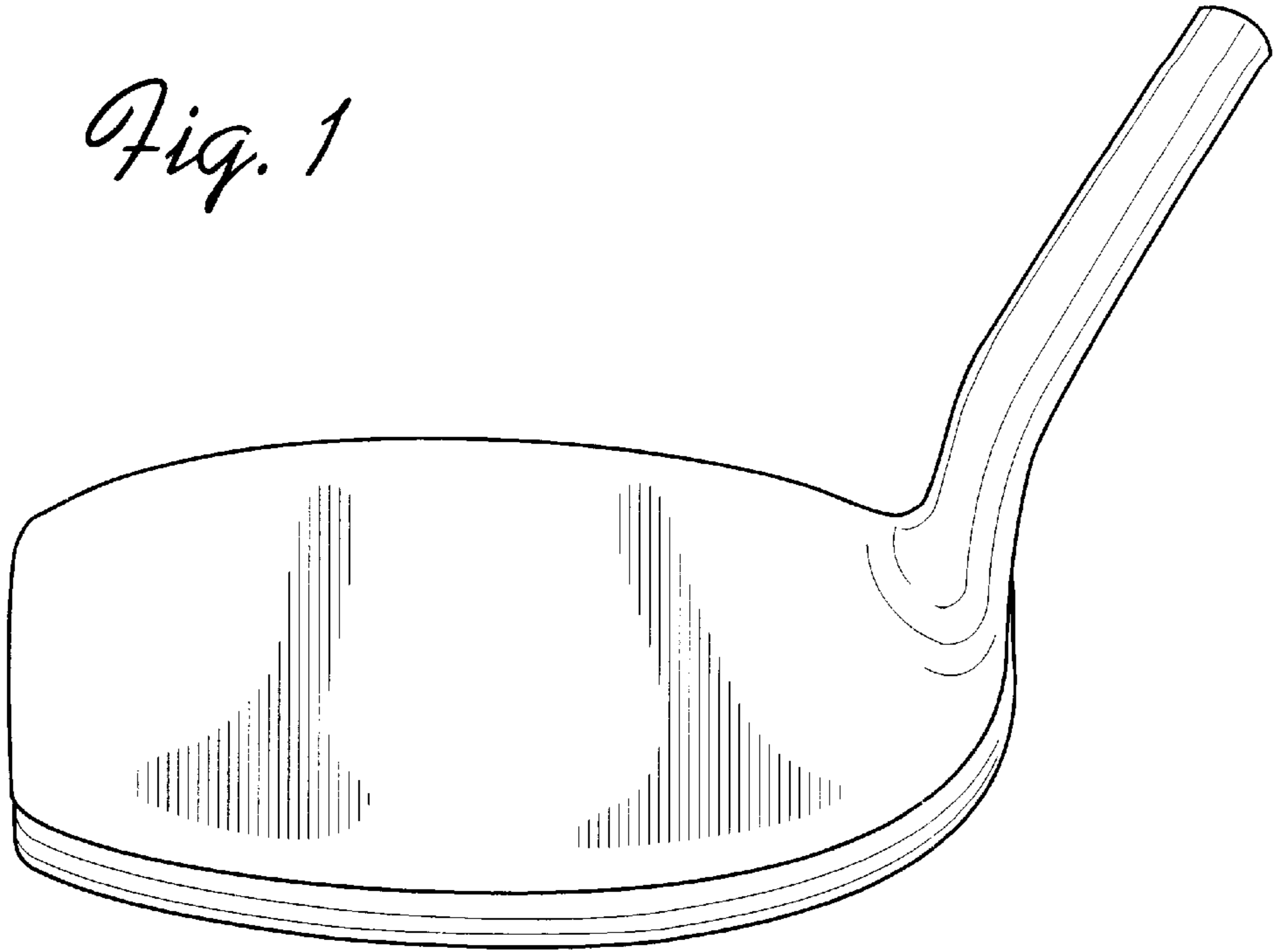
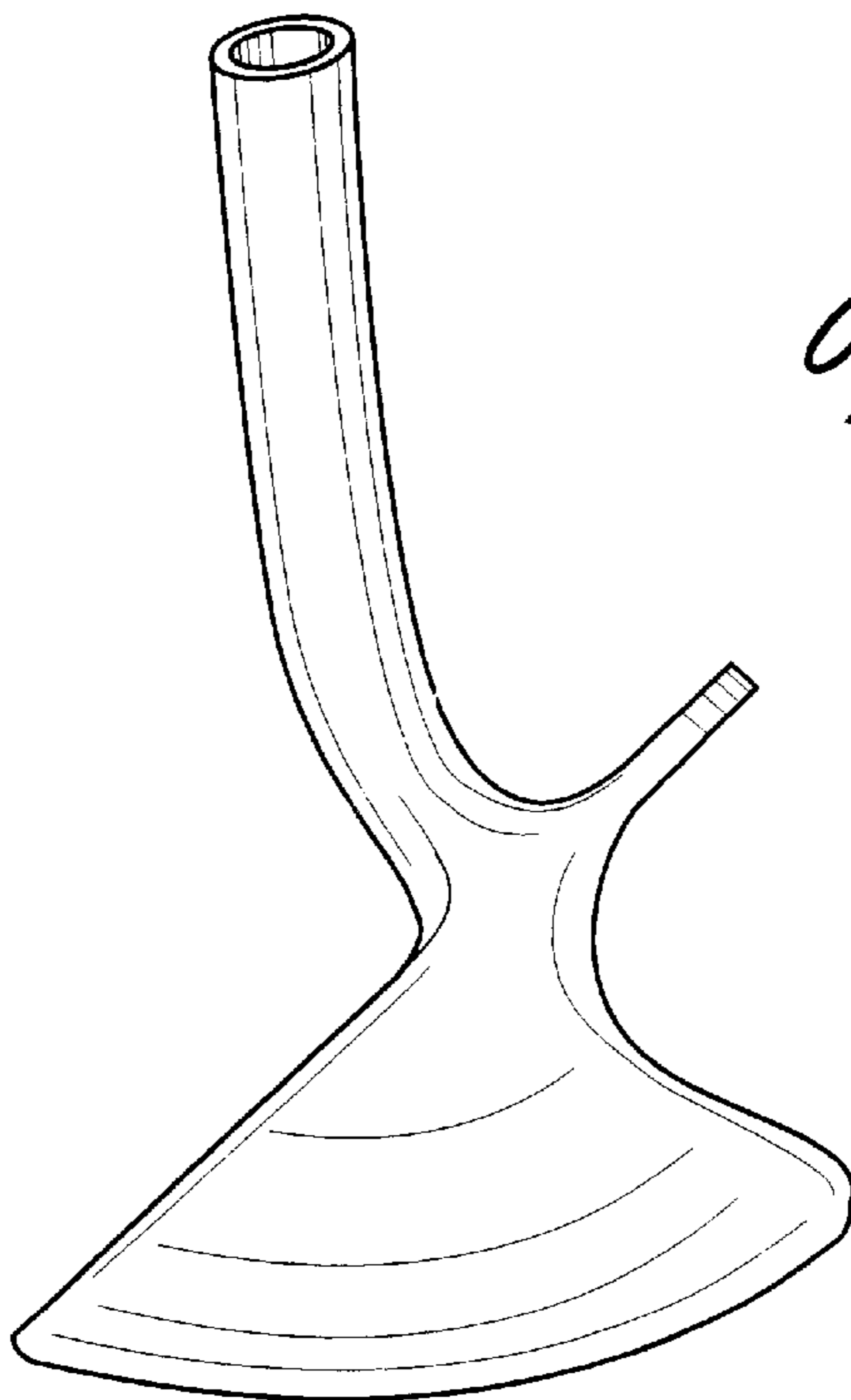

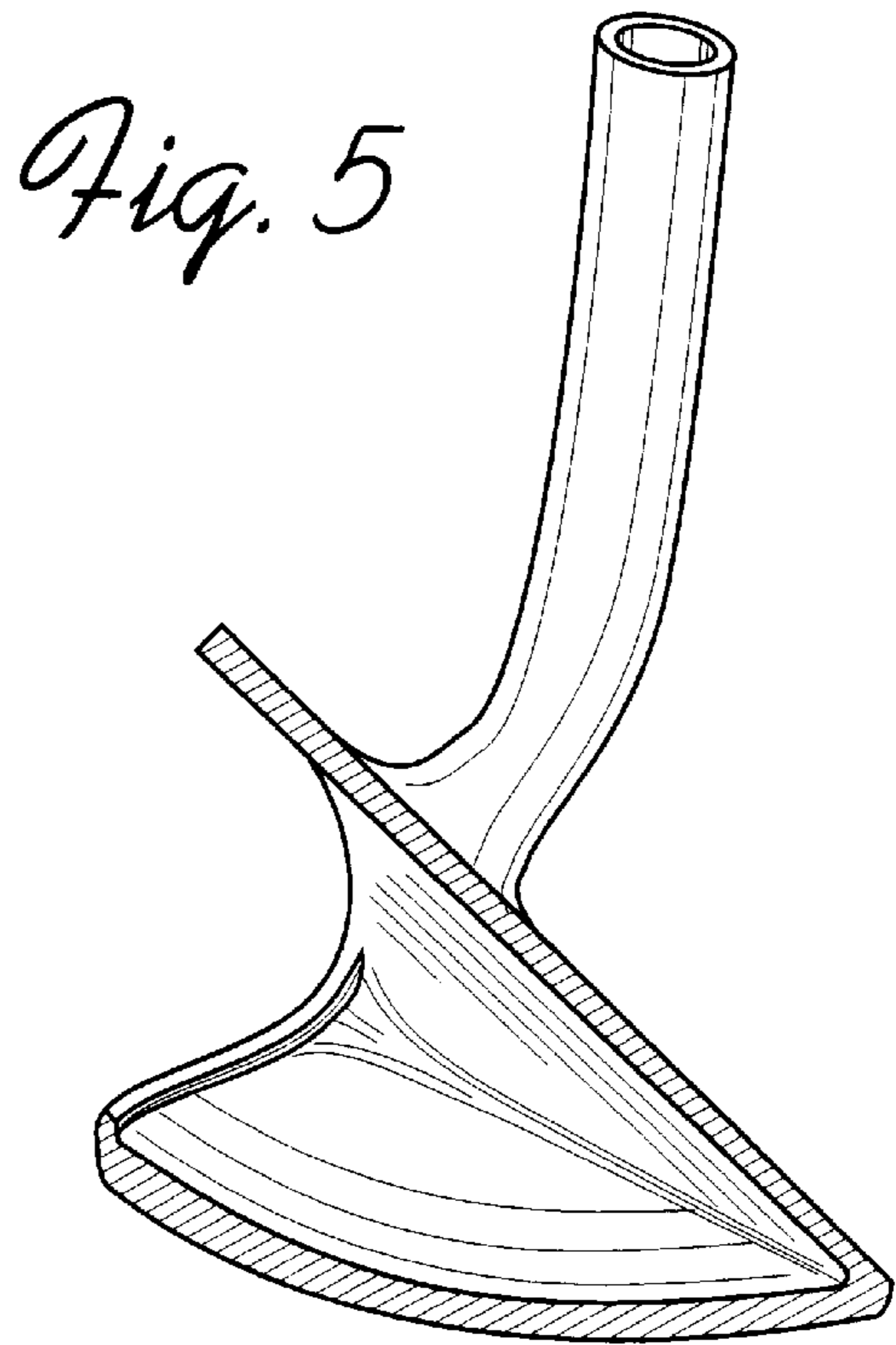
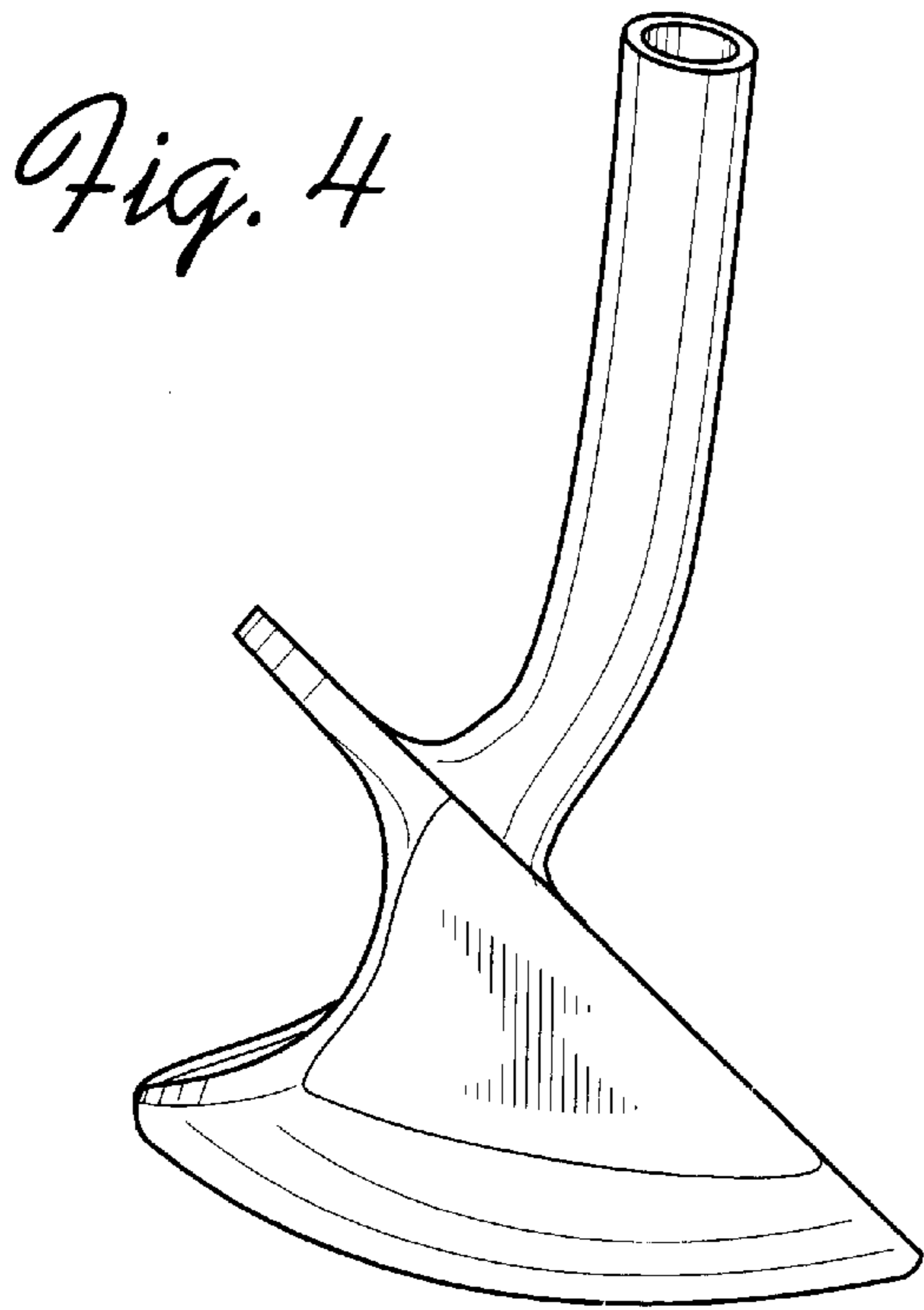
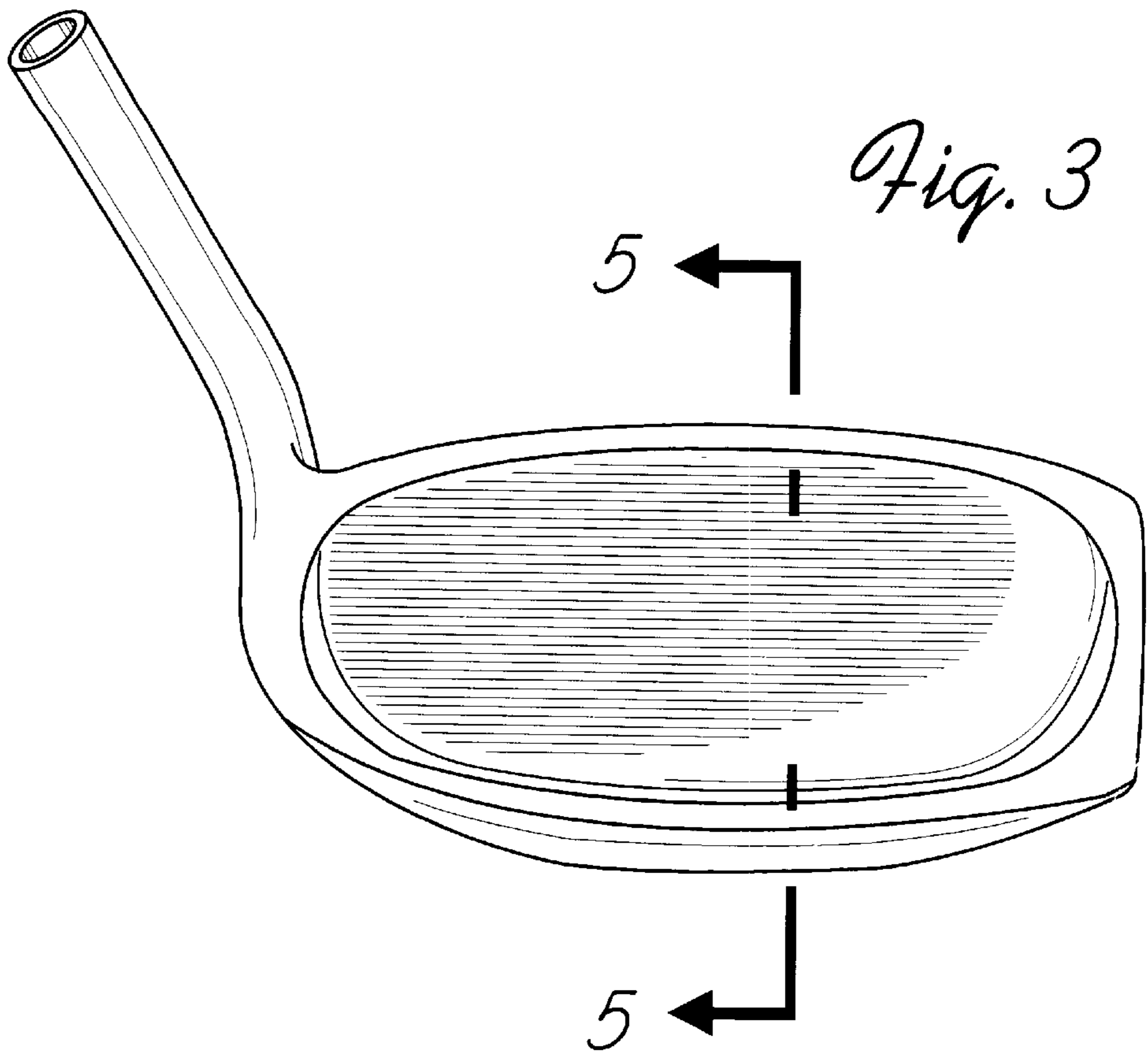

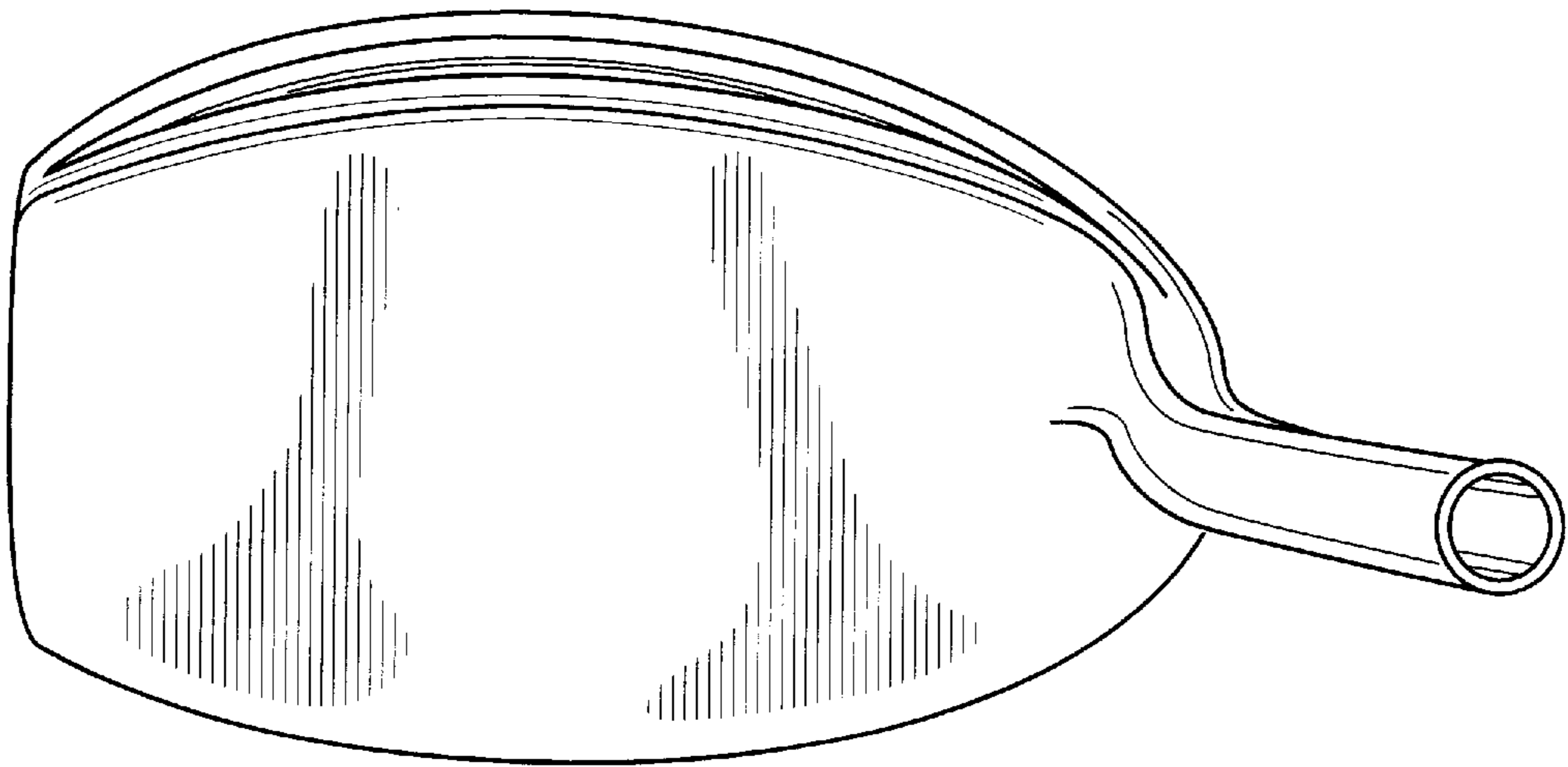
