FIGURE 1 is a front elevational view of the rear cavity insert for a golf iron of the present invention.

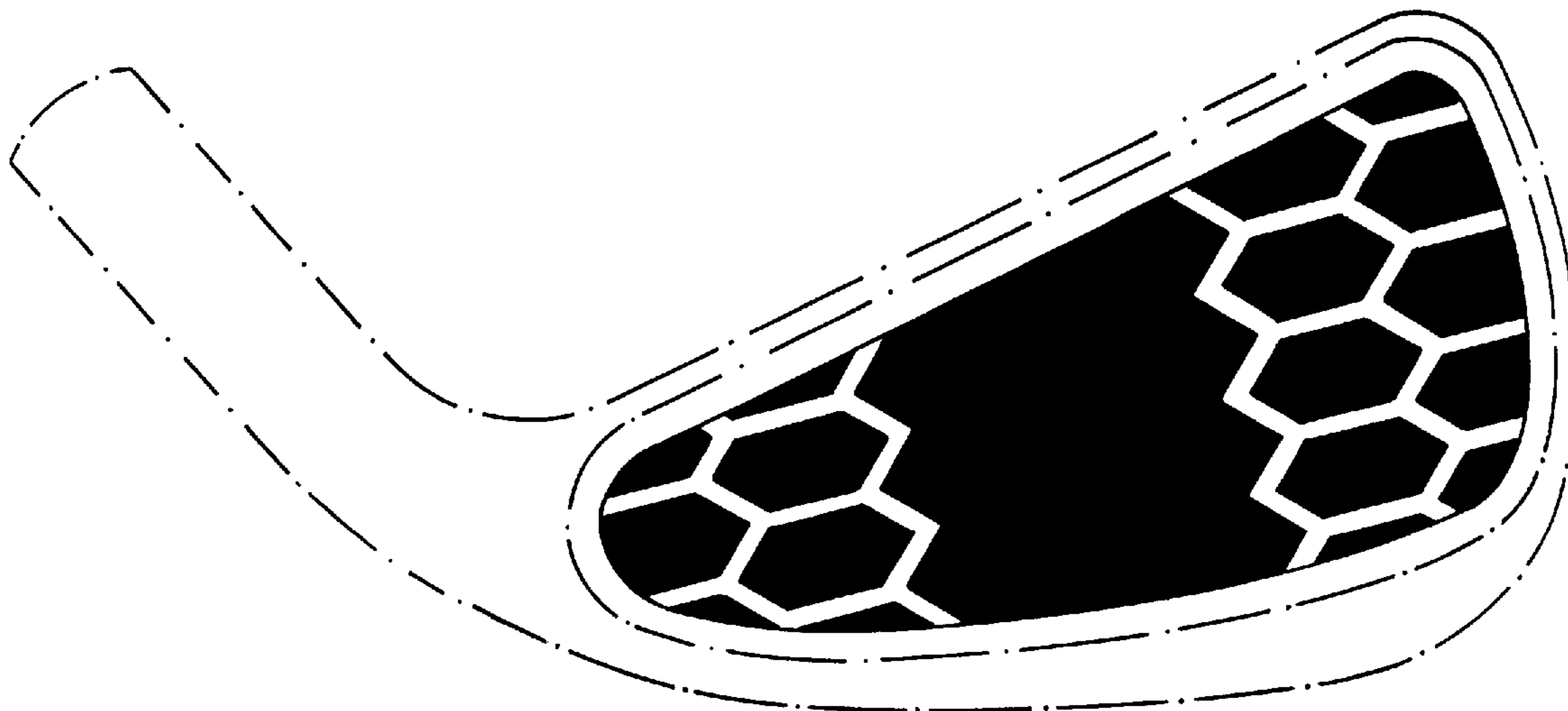
The broken line showing of a golf club head is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
