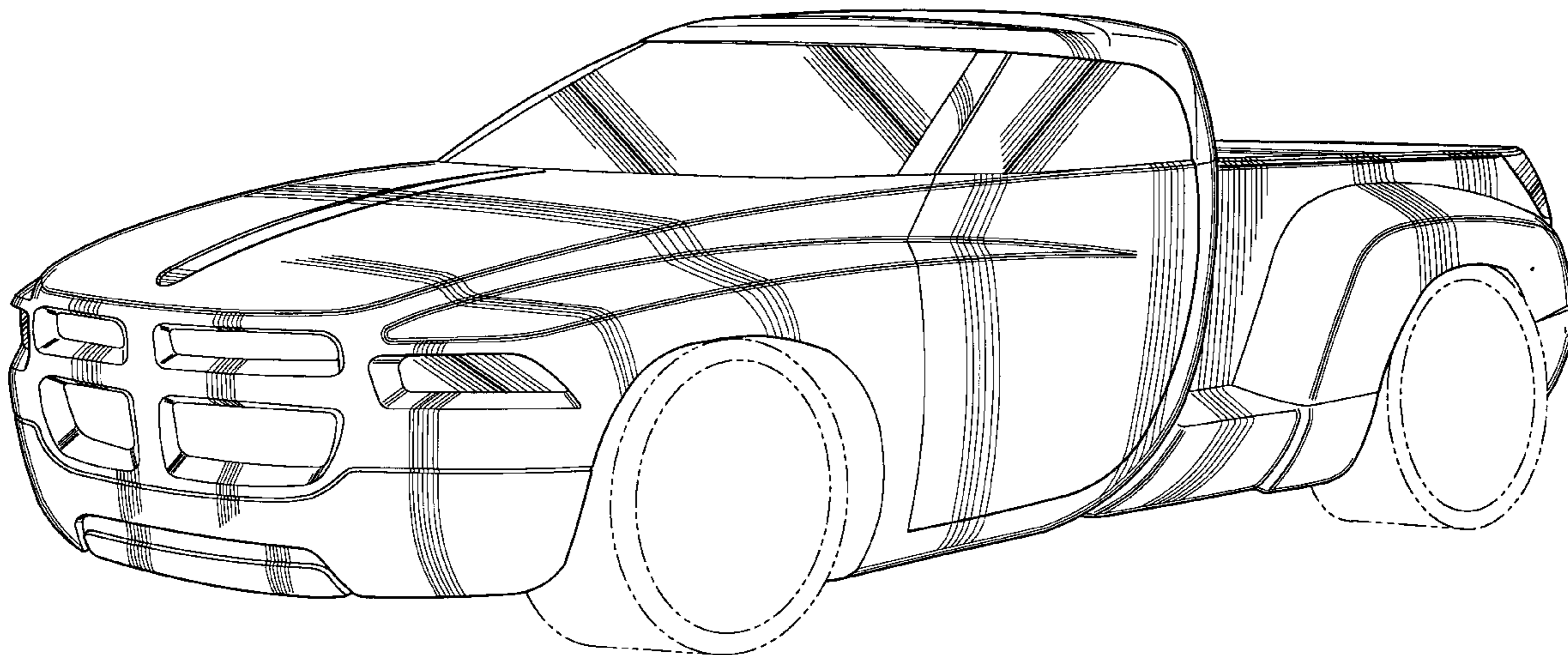
It will be understood that the roof of the vehicle body is plain and unornamented.

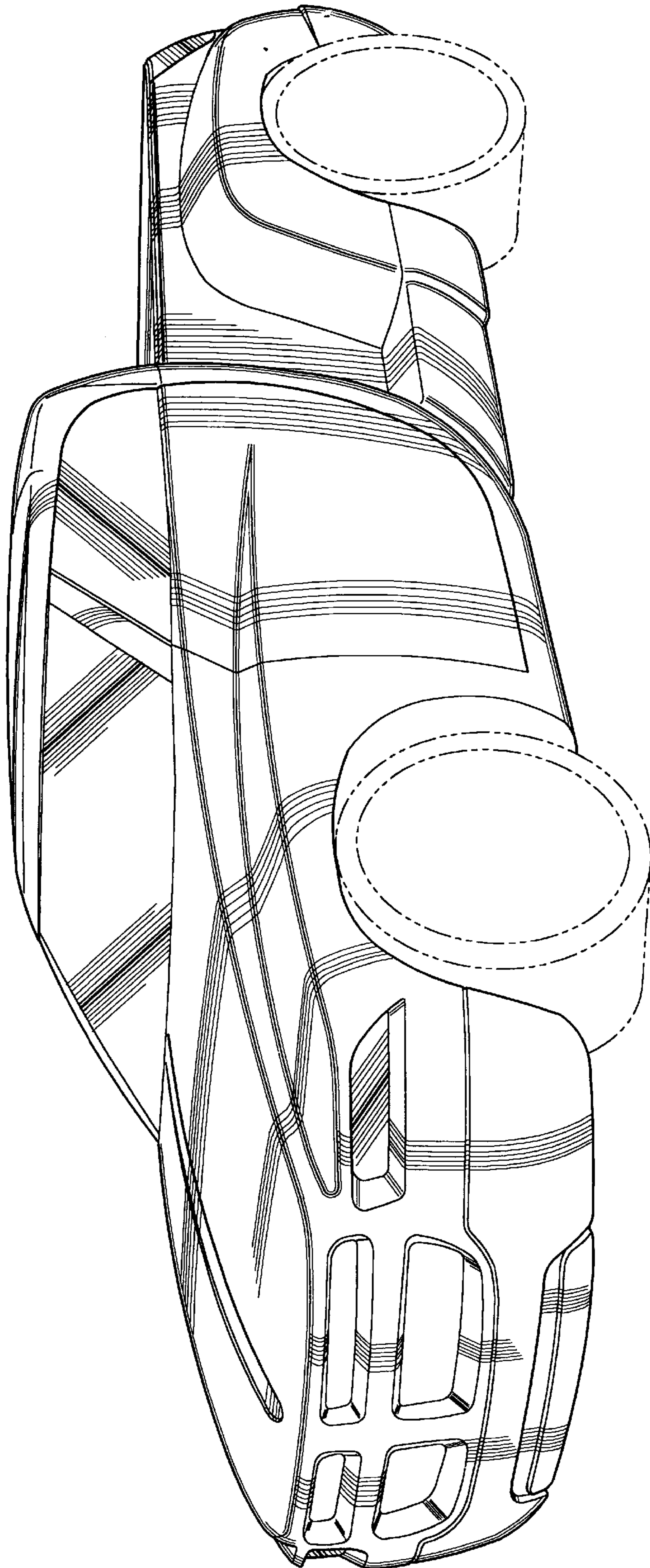

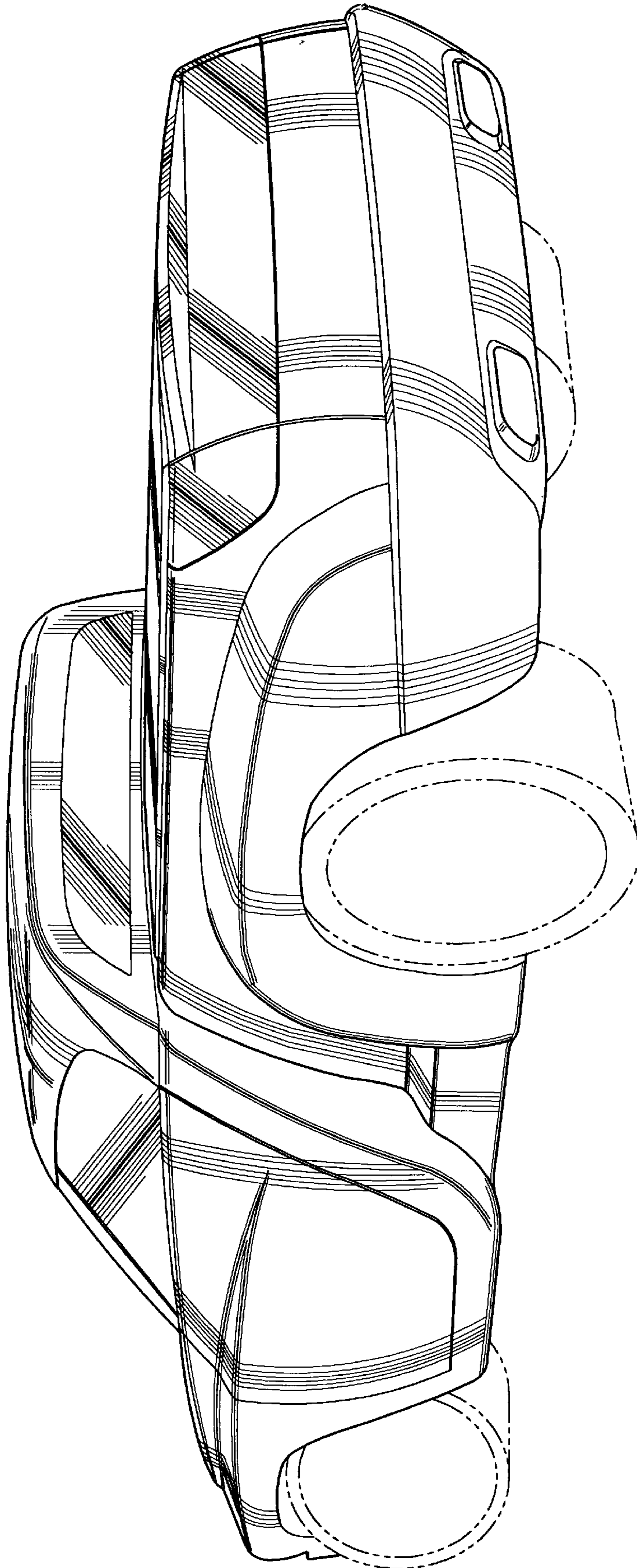

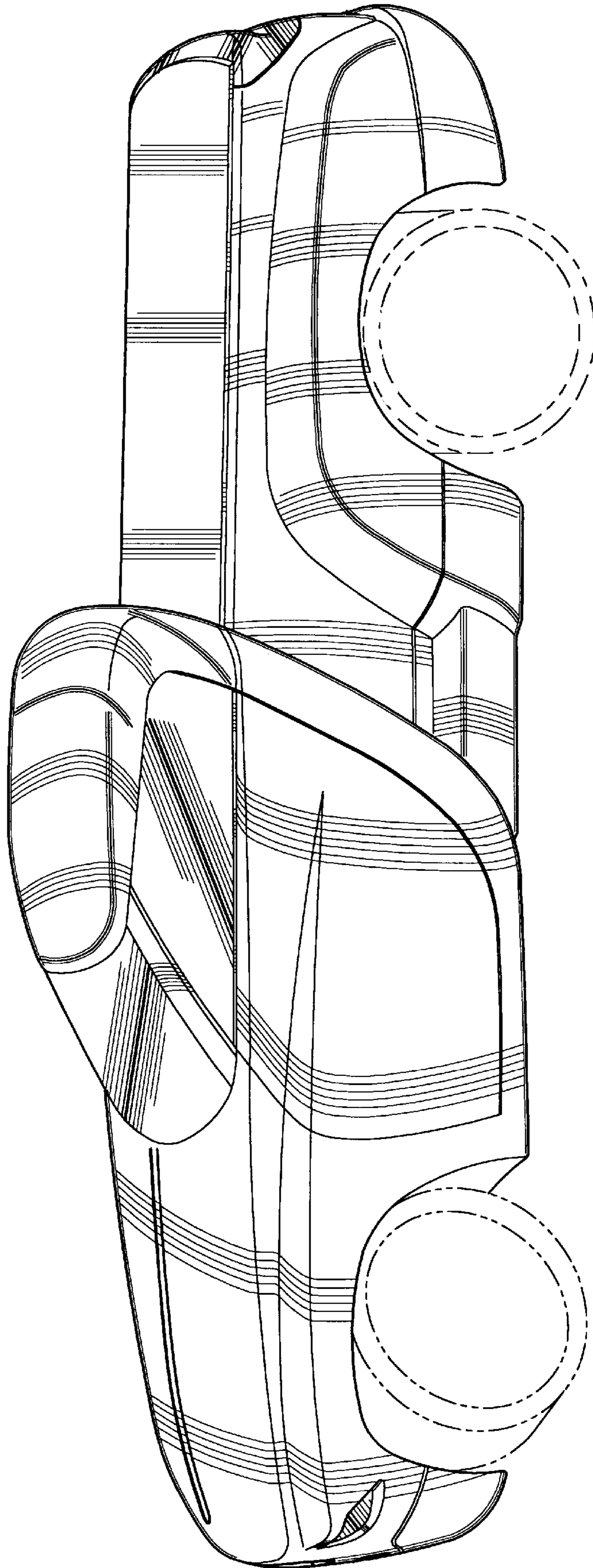
